Sophia Loren

n 1982, Sophia Loren served 18 days in jail for tax evasion.

Pamela Anderson

Pamela Anderson has a history of tax trouble. In 2009, a lien was filed against her for \$1.7 million. In 2012, the IRS (Internal Revenue Servicethe US government agency responsible for tax collection and tax law enforcement) filed a lien claiming that she owed \$259,395.75 for unpaid taxes, and *«* the state of California said she owed \$112,118.90.

Kelly Osbourne

In 2011, it was reported that Kelly Osbourne owed more than \$30,000 in back taxes to the state of California.

Judy Garland

Judy Garland owed hundreds of thousands of dollars in back taxes.

Richard Hatch

Al Sharpton

In 1989, Al Sharpton was charged and later acquitted of tax evasion. In 2009, the IRS filed a lien against Sharpton of over \$538,000 in back taxes.

Nicolas Cage

In 2009, the IRS claimed that Nicolas Cage failed to pay over \$6.2 million in federal income tax for the year 2007. The IRS also filed a lien against Cage for more than \$350,000 in unpaid taxes dating from 2002 to 2004.
