I won't meddle when I am king

Britain's Prince Charles said he will stop meddling in issues he feels strongly about when he eventually becomes king, saying he is "not that stupid".

The heir to the British throne has long been outspoken on issues ranging from climate change and architecture to alternative medicine, and critics have warned that if he continued as sovereign he would put the monarchy at risk.

Speaking ahead of his 70th birthday next week, the eldest son of 92-year-old Queen Elizabeth said the role of monarch was completely different from his position as Prince of Wales.

US warns to stay away from Iranian shipping

Ironman win: Bahrain post releases commemorative stamp

Bahrain Post has issued a Commemorative Stamp marking His Highness Shaikh Nasser bin Hamad Al Khalifa's victory in the IRONMAN World Championship (XC Division) 2018, Kailua-Kona, Hawaii.

The Ministry of Transportation and Telecommunication's Bahrain Post said it was delighted to issue a commemorative stamp crowned by the portrait of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa.

HH Shaikh Nasser bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the representative of His Majesty the King for Charity and Youth Affairs, won first place in the Iron Man World

Championship in Hawaii by covering a distance of 226.26 km at a record time of 9.19 hours.

The Iron Man Championship in Kona City - Hawaii Island, was the largest

in the history of world tournaments in terms of participation and public attendance due to the importance of the championship and in celebration of the 40th anniversary since its inception.

More than 3,000 competitors from 82 countries around the world aged from 18 to 85 participated in the race.

It is worth noting that His Highness has accomplished many notable achievements in other championships including in Germany, Florida, Southeast Asia, the Philippines, South Africa, in addition to the Syracuse Race held in New York, where he was able to achieve a record time in the tournament, and later followed by participating in a race in Texas.

Houthis militarising hospitals in Yemen

Yemen's Houthis are militarising hospitals deliberately in the battleground city of Hodeidah, accused Amnesty International yesterday.

The human rights group said the Houthi militias recently stationed snipers on the roof of a hospital in the May 22 district of the Red Sea port city, calling the action a "stomach-churning development".

It said the move risked "devastating consequences" for the hospital's staff and patients as it puts them in direct danger.

"The presence of Houthi fighters on the hospital's roof violates the international humanitarian law," Samah Hadid, Amnesty's

Middle East campaigns director Samah Hadid said.

"Anyone attacking a hospital under these conditions risks responsibility for war crimes."

A medical source told AFP on Wednesday that the militiamen had forced medical staff out of the May 22 Hospital -- one of Hodeidah's main medical facilities -- and posted snipers on the roof.

Pro-government forces pressed closer to the heart of Hodeidah, whose port serves as the entry point for nearly 80 per cent of commercial imports and nearly all UN-supervised

humanitarian aid.

The Yemeni army had taken control of the May 22 Hospital in Hodeidah and recaptured surrounding areas amid fierce clashes as the Houthi militias continue to lose ground in the strategic port city.

This comes a day after the Yemeni armed forces made strategic gains after reaching al-Saleh city east of Hodeidah as fierce battles are being fought beyond the Kilo 19 area.

According to the latest reports, pro-government forces backed by Saudi-led coalition warplanes advanced inside Hodeidah

Tragedy strikes again

Gunman kills 12 in California music bar

Thousand Oaks, United States

A 28-year-old Marine Corps veteran opened fire in a country music bar packed with college students in California overnight, killing 12 people in-

cluding a police officer who exchanged shots with the gunman, authorities said yesterday.

Terrified patrons scrambled for the exits after the gunman started shooting a handgun in the Borderline Bar and Grill

around 11:20 pm on Wednesday before killing himself, they said.

"They ran out of the back doors, they broke windows. They went through windows. They hid up in the attic, they hid in the bathroom," Ventura

County Sheriff Geoff Dean said.

Dean identified the suspect as Ian David Long, a Marine Corps veteran and resident of Thousand Oaks, an upscale city northwest of Los Angeles.

Long served in the Marine Corps from August 2008 to March 2013 and was a machine gunner.

He attained the rank of corporal and saw combat while deployed in Afghanistan from November 2010 to June 2011.
