World leaders yesterday joined the Kingdom in celebrating the anniversary of its establishment as an Arab and Muslim country in 1783 by its founder Ahmed Al-Fateh, the 46th Anniversary of its accession to the UN as a full member and the 18th Anniversary of HM the King's Accession to the Throne.

They extended heartfelt congratulations to HM the King, wishing him many happy returns and lauded the landmark achievements attained by the Kingdom under HM King's leadership.
