

Qatar's policies towards GCC destructive: Shaikh Nasser

A national campaign has been launched to support the Royal Guard Commander, Brigadier His Highness Shaikh Nasser bin Hamad Al Khalifa, who recently affirmed the stance of the Kingdom and regional states against the conspiring policies of Qatar against Bahrain and GCC and Arab countries.

Several new curricula will be introduced next year in the various stages of education, the ministry of education has said.

Dr. Majid Al Nuaimi said.
