A royal gift for families

HRH CP, PM boosts support for low-income families

As people all over the world celebrated the close of 2025 with fireworks and festivities, families here in Bahrain received a unique gift, helping them step into 2026 with a big sigh of relief.

HRH the Crown Prince and Prime Minister yesterday lent a helping hand to low-income families by increasing their financial support, easing household pressures and spreading optimism across the Kingdom.

The move takes effect this month, as the Ministry of So-

cial Development enhances assistance under the cost-of-living allowance scheme:

- Increasing the allowance to BHD 130 per month for families where the primary income earner earns less than BHD 300 per month.
- Increasing the allowance to BHD 97 per month for families where the primary income earner earns between BHD 301 and BHD 700 per month.
- Increasing the allowance to BHD 75 per month for families where the primary income earner earns between BHD 701 and BHD 1,000 per month.

The initiative reflects the Royal Directives of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa, reinforcing a vision of comprehensive development that places citizens at

the heart of national priorities.

It also highlights His Royal Highness's ongoing commitment to strengthening social services

and expanding welfare programmes for low-income households, in line with government priorities to enhance living standards and support citizens throughout the Kingdom.

With this timely relief, Bahraini families can now step into 2026 with renewed optimism, bold ambitions, and the reassurance that the Kingdom stands with them in building a brighter future.



Israel to ban 37 aid groups operating in Gaza

Israel plans to ban 37 aid organisations from operating in Gaza from Thursday unless they hand over detailed information on their Palestinian staff, despite mounting criticism from the United Nations and the European Union.

Several NGOs have told AFP the new rules will have a major impact on food and medical shipments to Gaza, and humanitarian groups warn there is already not enough aid to cover the devastated territory's needs.

Police arrest 18-year-old for exploiting girls via social media

The suspect was detained by the Southern Governorate Police Directorate following a complaint filed by the girls' parents, the Interior Ministry said. Three jobs initiative hits a major milestone

New Year celebrations go nationwide

Eight sites, one moment

Bahrain closed the 2025 Holidays Season with a New Year celebration that unfolded across the Kingdom rather than from a single focal point, as fireworks and drone displays lit up eight locations simultaneously at midnight.

Crowds gathered across key destinations including The Avenues mall, Seef District, Bahrain Harbour, Four Seasons Hotel Bahrain Bay, Marassi Al Bahrain, Bahrain Beach Bay, Bahrain World Trade Center and the area between Shaikh Hamad Causeway and Shaikh Isa bin Salman Causeway in Manama, creating a panoramic midnight experience visible across multiple governorates.

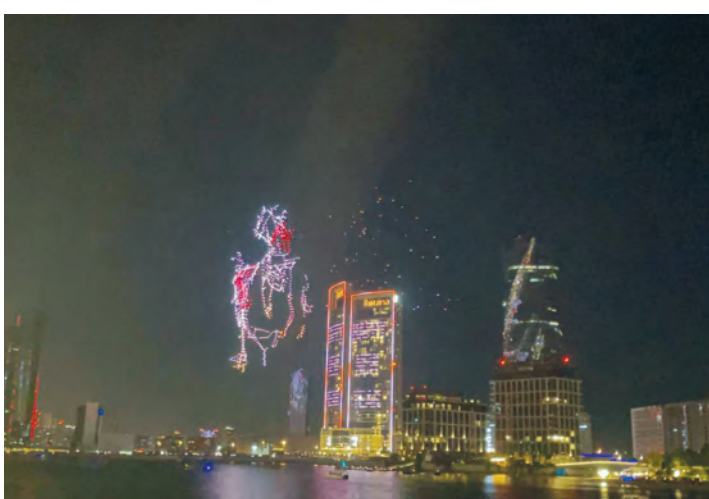
Instead of concentrating festivities in one zone, the celebrations were deliberately distributed, allowing residents and visitors to witness the spectacle from different parts of the Kingdom while easing congestion and offering multiple viewing options.

The highlight of the night was the largest drone show in Bahrain's history, featuring 2,500 drones, including 1,100 firework drones that rose up to 400 metres. Fireworks reached heights of between 250 and 300 metres during the 10-minute aerial display that illuminated Bahrain's skyline.

Adding to the visual impact, the Four Seasons Hotel Bahrain Bay hosted large-scale 3D light projections on its façade,

Bahrain Tourism and Exhibitions Authority chief executive Sara Ahmed Buhiji said New

Year celebrations had become a core fixture of Bahrain's festive calendar and were being

developed progressively to meet visitor expectations and tourism sector goals.

She said the expansion of venues this year, alongside the introduction of the Kingdom's largest drone show, reflected a strategy aimed at strengthening the tourism impact of major events while making use of Bahrain's advanced infrastructure.

The 2025 celebrations also marked the first inclusion of the Four Seasons Hotel Bahrain Bay and the Bahrain World Trade Center as official New Year venues. At The Avenues mall, the number of show points was expanded significantly, rising from three in previous years to nine.

Season Finale

The New Year event brought down the curtain on the fourth edition of the Bahrain Holidays Season, which over recent months delivered a wide range of cultural, entertainment and artistic programmes that attracted large audiences from across Bahrain and the region.

The season highlighted the Kingdom's growing capacity to host large-scale, multi-location events that cater to diverse audiences while reinforcing Bahrain's position as a regional destination for tourism and entertainment.

Dead-drop drug dealer jailed for 10 years

A Bahraini criminal court has sentenced an Asian national to 10 years' imprisonment and fined him BD5,000 after convicting him of drug trafficking.

Investigators said the accused used a "dead drop" method, hiding narcotic substances near a cemetery and close to an unfinished building to avoid direct handovers. The case came to light after police received a



A dead-drop method is a way of delivering or exchanging illegal items—most commonly drugs—without the buyer and seller meeting each other.

tip-off from a delivery worker, prompting surveillance of the area.

Officers later recovered concealed packages containing narcotic substances, along with

empty plastic bags and adhesive materials used for packaging.

The suspect was arrested while attempting to leave the country via the King Fahd Causeway, where a police sniff-

er dog alerted officers to drugs hidden inside his personal belongings. Laboratory analysis confirmed the substances to be cannabis.

During questioning, the defendant admitted possessing the drugs, claiming they were for personal use, and said he had attempted to dispose of them before inspection.

The court ordered the confiscation of the seized vehicle and ruled that the defendant be deported upon completion of his sentence.

Deputy PM plants 191,000th tree

Bahrain exceeds annual afforestation target for 2025

In line with the directives of HRH Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, Shaikh Khalid bin Abdullah Al Khalifa, Deputy Prime Minister, planted and watered the 191,000th tree at Manama Municipality, surpassing the annual 2025 target under Bahrain's national afforestation plan. The milestone marks the completion of the year's afforestation works.

The initiative was attended by ministers and senior officials.

Wael bin Nasser Al Mubarak,

Minister of Municipalities Affairs and Agriculture, said achieving the annual afforestation target for the third consecutive year demonstrates Bahrain's commitment to environmental sustainability, in line with the comprehensive development process guided by His Majesty the King and HRH the Crown Prince.

To date, 2.4 million trees have been planted across Bahrain, representing 67% of the 3.6 million tree target set for 2035. Mangrove planting has also exceeded expectations, with 2.2 million saplings planted—138% of the 1.6 million target for 2035.

MPs step in as illegal renting complaints mount in Hoorat A'ali

Growing complaints over illegal renting of residential flats in Block 714, Hoorat A'ali, have pushed a group of MPs to move an urgent motion calling for immediate inspections.

The motion, submitted by MP Hassan Ebrahim along with four other MPs, urges the relevant authorities to carry out on-the-ground inspection campaigns to identify unlawful lettings, ensure flats are being used in line with housing regulations, and verify compliance with safety, licensing and Civil Defence requirements.

Mr Ebrahim said residents—particularly families living in

Block 714—have raised increasing concerns in recent months. According to complaints received, a number of flats have been illegally subdivided, sublet without approval, or used for purposes that do not match their residential designation.

Residents have linked these practices to overcrowding, repeated disturbances and a loss of privacy for neighbouring households. Mr Ebrahim said the situation has also contributed to violations of safety standards and could involve unlicensed commercial activities operating from residential properties.

He noted that weak inspection coverage in some housing areas has allowed such practices to continue unchecked, stressing the need for a coordinated, multi-agency inspection campaign to restore order and ensure equal application of the law.

The urgent motion calls for legal and administrative action against violators under existing legislation, along with a detailed report outlining the findings,

enforcement measures taken and steps to prevent repeat offences through continued monitoring.

Mr Ebrahim also cited residents' concerns over behaviour linked to some flats that does not meet public decency and social norms, causing ongoing nuisance in Block 714 and surrounding areas. He added that some property owners reside outside Bahrain and rent their units to expatriate labour in an unregulated manner, leading to excessive occupancy and further disruption.

He said the motion was filed amid fears that the alleged violations are affecting daily life, placing additional pressure on public services and undermining the rights of residents who comply with the law.



Crash victim wins BD25,000 payout after 25 days in coma

A Bahraini court has ordered an insurance company to pay BD25,097 in compensation to a pedestrian who sustained a fractured jaw, partial memory loss and a permanent disability assessed at 40% following a road traffic accident.

The court also ruled that statutory interest of 3% per year be paid from the date the claim was filed until full settlement. In addition, the two defendants were ordered to cover legal fees and the costs of the court-appointed medical committee.

Lawyer Mohammed Al Mahdi said his client was walking on a public road when he was struck by a vehicle driven by the first defendant. The victim suffered multiple injuries and fractures and spent 25 days in intensive care after slipping into a coma, before later regaining consciousness.

The driver had previously been convicted in a related criminal case. Prosecutors established that the accident resulted from negligence, citing the driver's failure to exercise due care and caution, and driving in a manner that endangered pedestrians using the roadway.

Gulf Air reports strong operational performance

Gulf Air delivered a strong operational performance in November 2025, underscoring sustained demand across its route network. The national carrier carried 603,351 passengers during the month and operated 4,376 flights, recording a robust passenger load factor of 87%, a sign of effective capacity management and steady travel demand. Year-on-year figures show notable growth, with passenger numbers rising 27% from 474,917 in November 2024, while flights increased 10% from 3,996. The load factor also climbed sharply from 74.8% to 87%, highlighting improved network utilisation and operational efficiency.

Xi says China to hit 2025 growth target of ‘around 5%’

China’s economy is expected to have grown “around five percent” in 2025, President Xi Jinping said on Wednesday, despite “pressure” during a year he described as “very unusual”, state media reported. The announcement came in Xi’s New Year’s Eve speech to a top political consultative body that was reported by state news agency Xinhua.

Stocks pull lower at end of record year for markets

● **Fed officials see future rate cuts as appropriate**

Stock markets mostly retreated yesterday in thin trading, following a year of record gains for key assets as central banks cut interest rates and the tech sector boomed thanks to the growth of artificial intelligence. Wall Street’s main indices slid lower at the start of the final trading day of 2025, with little fresh economic data apart from a drop in both first-time and continuing claims for jobless benefits last week. They are set to post double-digit gains for 2025 with the tech-heavy Nasdaq Composite up over 21% for the year. “Generally speaking, 2025 was a spectacular year for equities,” said Briefing.com analyst Patrick O’Hare. Across the globe, stock markets have struck record highs and enjoyed double-digit gains in 2025, thanks in large part to interest-rate cuts from the US Federal Reserve following drops to inflation. London’s benchmark FTSE 100 index, which set a fresh record high on Tuesday close to 10,000 points, jumped more than 21% in 2025 -- the biggest

gain for 16 years. Frankfurt rallied 23% in 2025, while Paris saw an annual gain of more than 10%. In Asia, Seoul stocks rocketed 75% higher, while Hong Kong’s Hang Seng index jumped 28%, and Tokyo’s Nikkei 225 won more than 26%. “To push meaningfully higher in 2026, equities will need confirmation that the Fed can deliver at least the two rate cuts still priced by the market, with growth unimpeded,” noted Stephen Innes of SPI Asset Management. Minutes of the Fed’s policy meeting in December, which were released on Tuesday, indicated that most of its officials see future rate cuts as appropriate, should inflation cool over time as expected. A surge in the tech sector on the back of the vast amounts of cash pumped into AI also helped push stocks to record highs, but concerns that valuations of AI stocks are too high gnawed at investors late in 2025. AI chip juggernaut Nvidia became the world’s first \$5 trillion company at the end of October, while its current worth stands at around \$4.5 trillion. The price of gold, seen as a safe haven investment, scored multiple record highs this year. The precious metal has benefited from weakness to the dollar caused by the Fed’s rate cuts

and economic growth concerns triggered by President Donald Trump’s tariffs war. On Wednesday, the price of silver slid further having struck record highs in December. Oil prices have retreated nearly 20% over the year, pressured by an oversupplied market. Bitcoin, emphasising the volatile nature of the cryptocurrency sector, soared to a record high above \$126,000 in October before ending the year around \$88,000.

China says to impose extra 55% tariffs on some beef imports

China said yesterday it will impose additional 55 percent tariffs on some beef imports from countries including Brazil, Australia and the United States that exceed a certain quantity from January 1. The price of beef in China has trended downwards in recent years, with analysts blaming oversupply and a lack of demand as the world’s second-largest economy has slowed. At the same time imports have surged, with China representing a hugely important market for countries such as Brazil, Argentina and Australia. Investigators found beef imports had damaged China’s domestic industry, Beijing’s commerce ministry said in a statement. The probe covered fresh, frozen, bone-in and boneless beef. The extra tariffs apply for three years -- until December 31, 2028. The ministry described the levies as “safeguards” and said they would be gradually relaxed. Countries have been assigned annual quotas and beef sent to China will be subject to the extra 55 percent levy if imports go beyond that amount. Quotas expand slightly each year. In 2026, Brazil has an import quota of 1.1 million tons while Argentina has a cap of roughly half that.

Japanese women MPs want more seats, the porcelain kind

Nearly 60 women lawmakers in Japan, including Prime Minister Sanae Takaichi, have submitted a petition calling for more toilets in the parliament building to match their improved representation. Although the number of women politicians rose at the last election -- and despite Takaichi becoming the first female prime minister in October -- Japanese politics remains massively male-dominated.

This is reflected by there being only one lavatory containing two cubicles near the Diet’s main plenary session hall for the 73 women elected to the lower house, according to the petition.

“Before plenary sessions start, truly so many women lawmakers have to form long queues in front of the

restroom,” said Yasuko Komiyama from the opposition Constitutional Democratic Party.

She was speaking after submitting the cross-party appeal signed by 58 women to Yasukazu Hamada, the chair of the lower house committee on rules and administration, earlier this month.

The Diet building was finished in 1936, nearly a decade before women got the vote in December 1945 following Japan’s defeat in World War II.

The entire lower house building has 12 men’s toilets with 67 stalls and nine women’s facilities with a total of 22 cubicles, according to the Yomiuri Shimbun newspaper.

Japan ranked 118 out of 148 this year in the World Economic Forum’s Global Gender Gap Report. Women are also grossly under-represented in business and the media.

World welcomes 2026

Global parties reflect on a year of war, tariffs, and climate crises

New Year’s Eve revellers toasted the end of 2025 yesterday, waving goodbye to 12 months packed with Trump tariffs, a Gaza truce and vain hopes for peace in Ukraine. It was one of the warmest years on record, the stifling heat stoking wildfires in Europe, droughts in Africa and deadly rains across Southeast Asia.

There was a sombre tinge to celebrations in Australia’s harbour city Sydney, the self-proclaimed “New Year’s capital of the world”.

Barely two weeks have passed since a father and son allegedly opened fire on a Jewish festival at Bondi Beach, killing 15 people in the nation’s deadliest mass shooting for almost 30 years.

Parties paused for a minute of silence at 11:00 pm (1200 GMT) as the famed Sydney Harbour Bridge was bathed in white light to symbolise peace.

“Right now, the joy that we usually feel at the start of a new year is tempered by the sadness of the old,” Australia’s Prime Minister Anthony Albanese said in a video message.

Hundreds of thousands of spectators lined Sydney’s foreshore, with nine tonnes of fireworks set off from the stroke of midnight.

Residents and tourists gathered by the city’s harbour and boats dotted the water to secure the best viewing spots near the Sydney Opera House.

“The fireworks have always been on my bucket list and I’m so happy to be here,” said Susana

Suisuikl, an English tourist.

Security was tighter than usual, with squads of heavily armed police patrolling the crowds.

Pacific nations including Kiribati and New Zealand were the first to see in the new year, kicking off a chain of celebrations stretching from glitzy New York to the Hogmanay festival on the chilly streets of Scotland.

More than two million people are expected to pack Brazil’s lively Copacabana Beach for what authorities have called the world’s biggest New Year’s Eve party.

In Hong Kong, a major New Year fireworks display planned for Victoria Harbour was cancelled to pay homage to 161 peo-

ple killed in a housing estate fire in November.

Truce and tariffs

Labubu dolls became a worldwide craze in 2025, thieves plundered the Louvre in a daring heist, and K-pop heartthrobs BTS

made their long-awaited return.

The world lost pioneering zoologist Jane Goodall, the Vatican chose a new pope and the assassination of right-wing activist Charlie Kirk laid bare America’s deep political divisions.

Donald Trump returned to the White House in January, launching a tariff blitz that sent global markets into meltdown.

Trump used his Truth Social platform to lash out at his sliding approval ratings ahead of 2026 midterm elections.

“Isn’t it nice to have a STRONG BORDER, No Inflation, a powerful Military, and great Economy??? Happy New Year!” he wrote.

But many expect tough times to continue in 2026.

Israel to ban 37 aid groups operating in Gaza

Israel has said 37 aid organisations will be banned from operating in Gaza from Thursday unless they comply with guidelines requiring detailed information on Palestinian staff, drawing criticism from the United Nations and the European Union.

Several NGOs have said the new rules will have a major impact on food and medical shipments to Gaza, at a time when humanitarian organisations say the amount of aid getting in is inadequate to the devastated territory’s needs.

Israel’s deadline for NGOs to provide the details expires at midnight yesterday.

“They refuse to provide lists of their Palestinian employees because they know, just as we know, that some of them are involved in terrorism or linked to Hamas,” spokesman for the Ministry of Diaspora Affairs and Combating Antisemitism, Gilad Zwick said, naming 37 NGOs that had so far failed to meet the new requirements.

“I highly doubt that what they haven’t done for 10 months, they will suddenly do in less than 12 hours,” Zwick said. “We certainly won’t accept any cooperation that is just for show, simply to get

an extension.”

The ministry had said in a statement yesterday that the move was part of Israel’s decision to “strengthen and update” regulations governing the activities of international NGOs in the Palestinian territory.

A fragile ceasefire has been in place in Gaza since October,

following a deadly war waged by Israel in response to Hamas’s unprecedented attack on Israeli territory on October 7, 2023.

For Israel, it says the new regulation aims to prevent bodies it accuses of supporting terrorism from operating in the Palestinian territories.

On Tuesday, Israel specified

that “acts of de-legitimising Israel” or denial of events surrounding Hamas’ October 7 attack would be “grounds for license withdrawal”.

Israel has singled out international medical charity Doctors Without Borders (MSF), alleging that it had two employees who were members of Palestinian armed groups Islamic Jihad and Hamas.

Apart from MSF, some of the 37 NGOs to be hit with the ban are the Norwegian Refugee Council, World Vision International, CARE and Oxfam, according to the list given by Zwick.

‘Guarantee access’

Yesterday, the United Nations rights chief Volker Turk described Israel’s decision as “outrageous”, calling on states to urgently insist Israel shift course.

“Israel’s suspension of numerous aid agencies from Gaza is outrageous,” he said in a statement, warning that “such arbitrary suspensions make an already intolerable situation even worse for the people of Gaza”.

The European Union also warned that Israel’s decision would block “life-saving” assistance from reaching Gazans.

Bangladesh mourns ex-PM Khaleda Zia with state funeral

Massive crowds gather in Dhaka as Bangladesh honours the legacy of its first female prime minister

Bangladesh bid farewell yesterday to former prime minister Khaleda Zia in a state funeral that drew vast crowds mourning a towering leader whose career defined the country's politics for decades.

Zia, the first woman to serve as prime minister in the South Asian nation of 170 million people, died on Tuesday aged 80.

Flags were flown at half-mast and thousands of security officers lined roads as her body was carried through the streets of the capital Dhaka by a vehicle in the colours of the national flag.

A sea of mourners gathered outside parliament and packed streets leading to it, many waving national flags as well as those of her Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP), before prayers were held over her coffin.

Retired government official Minhaz Uddin, 70, said he had never voted for Zia, but came to honour the three-time prime minister.

"I came here with my grandson, just to say goodbye to a veteran politician whose contri-

butions will always be remembered," he said.

"Khaleda Zia has been an inspiration," mourner Sharmina Siraj told AFP, adding that "it is difficult to imagine women in leadership positions anytime soon".

The 40-year-old mother of two said stipends introduced by Zia to support girls' education "had a huge impact on the lives of our girls".

'Legacy lives on'

Despite years of ill health and imprisonment, Zia had vowed

to campaign in elections set for February 12 -- the first vote since a mass uprising toppled her arch-rival Sheikh Hasina in 2024.

Zia's BNP is widely considered a frontrunner, and her son Tarique Rahman, 60, who returned to Bangladesh last week after 17 years in exile, is seen as a potential prime minister if they win a majority.

"She is no more, but her legacy lives on -- and so does the BNP," said Jenny Parvez, 37, who travelled for several hours with her family to watch the funeral cortege pass.

The interim government, led by Nobel Peace Prize winner Muhammad Yunus, declared three days of national mourning and an elaborate state funeral.

Yunus said Bangladesh had "lost a great guardian".

Zia's body was then interred alongside her late husband, Ziaur Rahman, who was assassinated in 1981 during his time as president.

Leaders and members of the armed forces laid wreaths, and a bugle sounded as the burial took place.

'Unbreakable'

Tarique Rahman said in a statement that "the country mourns the loss of a guiding presence that shaped its democratic aspirations".

His mother, he added, "endured repeated arrests, denial of medical care, and relentless persecution", but "her resilience... was unbreakable."

Suffering from a raft of health issues, Zia was rushed to hospital in late November, where her condition gradually deteriorated despite treatment.

Nevertheless, hours before her death, party workers had on Monday submitted nomination papers on her behalf for three constituencies for next year's polls.

Thailand releases 18 Cambodian soldiers held since July

Thailand yesterday released 18 Cambodian soldiers held for five months as prisoners of war, days after a fresh truce between the nations ended weeks of deadly fighting along their contested frontier.

A decades-old border dispute between the Southeast Asian neighbours erupted into military clashes several times this year, with the latest round of fighting in December killing dozens of people and displacing

more than a million.

"I am so happy. I can't wait to see him. I miss him so much," 51-year-old Voeung Vy, the father of one of the soldiers captured in late July, told AFP.

He said he would welcome his son home in the capital, Phnom Penh.

Cambodia's defence ministry said the 18 soldiers were "released and safely returned to the motherland" through a border crossing yesterday morning after being detained for 155 days.

Bihar touts power sector gains in 2025 with free electricity, record revenue

Bihar's energy sector posted significant gains in 2025, with the state government citing improved power supply, financial turnaround and rising investment as key achievements under Chief Minister Nitish Kumar.

Officials said Bihar ensured round-the-clock, affordable and sustainable electricity during the year, with rising demand reflecting industrial growth and rapid infrastructure development. Energy Minister Bijendra Prasad Yadav said the increase in power consumption signalled expanding investment, adding that 2025 marked a year of innovation and self-reliance for the department.

A flagship measure was the provision of free electricity of up to 125 units per month to domestic consumers, benefiting around 90 percent of households. The state allocated subsidies worth nearly Rs. 19,800 crore in the 2025-26 financial year. Farmers also received



power for irrigation at sharply reduced rates, lowering costs compared with diesel and supporting higher incomes.

The government reported efficiency gains, with aggregate technical and commercial losses falling below the national average and power distribution companies posting profits of more than Rs. 2,000 crore in 2024-25. Bihar also attracted large investments in renewa-

ble and thermal energy projects, including pumped storage schemes and a proposed 2,400-megawatt thermal power plant in Bhagalpur.

Officials said the energy sector generated thousands of jobs during the year and earned multiple national awards for service delivery, innovation and consumer satisfaction, reinforcing Bihar's growing profile in India's power sector.

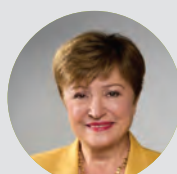

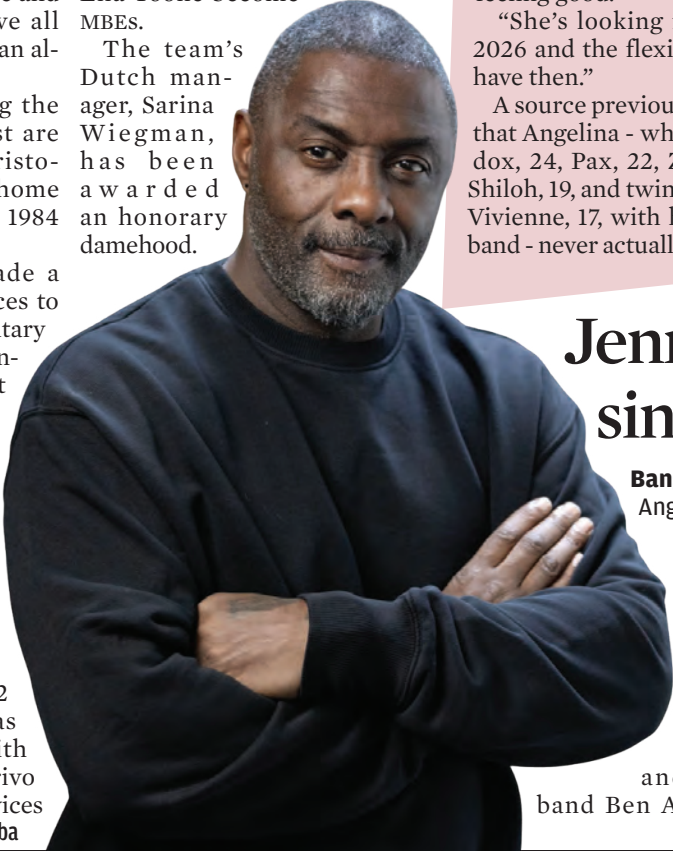

Arteta hails Arsenal belief

Arsenal manager Mikel Arteta believes his side are starting to see the benefits of their hard work as the Gunners head into 2026 at the top of the Premier League.

“All the sacrifices and commitment that you put in gets reflected in results and great performances and that’s so satisfying, but we know there’s still so much to play for.”

The Spaniard added: “It’s a great way to end the year, that’s for sure. We’ll have a good night with our families (on New Year’s Eve), but then the next day we are in, and we have to go to Bournemouth (on Saturday), and we know what that means.”

Ace spinner Rashid Khan will lead a strong Afghanistan squad announced yesterday for next year’s Twenty20 World Cup.

Rashid’s spin partner Muejeb Ur Rahman and fast bowler Fazalhaq Farooqi have also been recalled to the 15-member squad for the tournament in India and Sri Lanka.

Also returning after a shoulder injury is fast bowler Naveen-ul-Haq, who last played in a T20I for Afghanistan against Zimbabwe in December 2024.

Afghanistan Cricket Board chief executive Naseeb Khan said the team can improve on their semi-final finish in the last World Cup in the United States and West Indies two years ago.

“Afghanistan had a terrific run in the previous T20I World Cup and we hope for even better results this year, which will be played in Asian conditions,” Naseeb said in a statement.

Afghanistan beat New Zealand, West Indies, Australia and Bangladesh on their way to the semi-finals two years ago.

They will play West Indies in a three-match T20I lead-up series in the United Arab Emirates (UAE) ahead of the World Cup.

Rashid’s side is placed in Group D alongside New Zealand, South Africa, the UAE and Canada in the 20-team tournament that starts in India and Sri Lanka from February 7.

Senegal top AFCON group ahead of DR Congo as Tanzania make history

- Senegal beat Benin 3-0 to win Group D
- DR Congo defeat Botswana 3-0

Senegal advanced to the Africa Cup of Nations last 16 as winners of their group on Tuesday, leaving the Democratic Republic of Congo facing a heavyweight tie against Algeria while Tanzania reached the knockout stage for the first time.

Sadio Mane’s Senegal, African champions in 2022, defeated Benin 3-0 in Tangier to top Group D on goal difference ahead of the Leopards, who won by the same margin against Botswana in Rabat.

Abdoulaye Seck and Habib Diallo scored either side of half-time for the Lions of Teranga before skipper Kalidou Koulibaly was sent off. Cherif Ndiaye converted a penalty deep in injury time.

Ex-Chelsea playmaker Gael Kakuta, now based in Turkey, was in outstanding form with

two goals and an assist as DR Congo saw off already-eliminated Botswana.

His backheel set up Nathanael Mbuku for the opener at Al Medina Stadium in Morocco’s capital, and Kakuta then converted a penalty late in the first half.

Kakuta got his second and his team’s third on the hour mark and the Leopards then had a

fourth goal scored by Piston Mayele ruled out by VAR for a handball.

It looked at one point as though Senegal and DR Congo might end the group stage with identical records, leaving open the possibility of a drawing of lots to decide their final positions.

In the end both finish with seven points from three games

with Senegal on top by a difference of just two goals.

Pape Thiaw’s team now have a kinder draw as they remain in Tangier for a last-16 tie on Saturday against the third-place finisher in Group E, either Burkina Faso or Sudan.

The Leopards, in contrast, must play 2019 champions Algeria next Tuesday with the winner of that potentially hav-

ing to face Nigeria in the quarter-finals.

“We wanted a fourth goal to maybe force a drawing of lots, and we wanted to score as many goals as possible to try to win the group,” said Sebastian Desabre, the Democratic Republic of Congo coach.

“It wasn’t to be but I’m not disappointed, I’m proud. We have achieved the objective of reaching the last 16.”

Benin’s three points are enough for them to go through as one of the best third-placed teams.

It will be just their second appearance in the AFCON knockout stages, with their reward a tie against Mohamed Salah’s Egypt on Monday.

Tanzania made history in progressing from their group for the first time, 45 years after their maiden AFCON appearance, by drawing 1-1 with fellow qualifiers Tunisia in Rabat.

Ismael Gharbi converted a penalty just before half-time for Tunisia and Feisal Salum levelled early in the second half.

Tanzania have still to win in 12 matches spanning four AFCON appearances. They squeezed into the round of 16 after two draws and one loss.

Amorim still ‘really confident’ about Man Utd **potential** despite Wolves draw

Manager insists United will be stronger once injuries ease after Wolves stalemate

Ruben Amorim is still optimistic about Manchester United’s prospects this season despite ending a torrid 2025 with a lacklustre 1-1 draw at home to strugglers Wolves.

Rob Edwards’ side arrived at Old Trafford on a run of 11 successive Premier League defeats, the Midlands club firmly at the foot of the table with a mere two points from 18 matches.

But they left Old Trafford with a third point of the campaign after Joshua Zirkzee’s deflected opener for United was cancelled out by Ladislav Krejci in a draw that took place just three weeks after Amorim’s men won 4-1 at Molineux.

Nevertheless, the 40-year-old Portuguese boss added: “But I’m really confident when we recover all the players that we are going to be a strong team. There is no doubts in my mind.”

United’s first match of 2026 is away to longstanding bitter rivals Leeds on Sunday, with Amorim saying he is “not going to risk anyone” by making existing injury issues worse.

But the Red Devils would dearly like some inspiration that was missing against Wolves, with Amorim replacing goalscorer Zirkzee -- who came in for the injured Mount -- at half-time to bring on teenager Jack Fletcher.

Amorim confirmed the decision was “just tactical”, saying: “We need to do what the game was asking.

“We were struggling, they put a lot of men in the middle of the park, and with Jack we balanced that. I think we recover the ball faster in the in the second half.

“In the first half, we struggled a little bit to recover the ball, so I’m just looking not for their age and the experience. In this moment, I just look what I can do to win the game.”

United reverted to Amorim’s favoured three-man defence having previously won with a back four and Wolves boss Rob Edwards was proud of his side after they secured a first point since he took charge last month.

“It’s nice to take something from the game,” Edwards said ahead of Saturday’s match against fellow strugglers West Ham. “I do feel it’s the least we deserve. I do. It’s progress. Overall, it was a really good performance.”

Caballero defends Maresca after Palmer substitution sparks jeers

But Maresca, who was absent from his post-match media duties due to an illness, remains an “example” to everyone at the club according to Caballero.

“Any supporter wants to have the best players on the pitch,” he said. “We want to have that as well. But Cole is coming from a long injury.
