"I'm happy and blessed to still be able to play for the Alaska Aces," said the 26-year-old Teng who could easily serve as the franchise's face under coach Jeffrey Cariaso. The hardworking guard out

Lukaku scored with the first chance at the San Siro, then laid on Matteo Darmian for Inter's second in the 69th minute. Romelu Lukaku shoots to score Alexis Sanchez came off the bench to add a third with 13 minutes to go.

"We're first in the standings and it's a good feeling," said Lukaku as Inter try to deny Juventus a 10th consecutive league title after finishing runners-up last season.
