Pope Francis is expected to return home on Saturday after what will have been three nights in hospital with bronchitis, and will attend Palm Sunday services, the Vatican said.

The 86-year-old has responded well to antibiotics and on Thursday evening shared pizza with staff looking after him at Rome's Gemelli hospital, spokesman Matteo Bruni said.

The Argentine pontiff, who had part of one lung removed creasing health issues in recent years, and it was his second stay in hospital since 2021.

Yesterday morning, he had breakfast, read some newspapers and did some work in the private papal suite on hospital's 10th floor where he was admitted on Wednesday after complaining of breathing problems.
