◆ A powerful explosion at an Indian chemical factory killed at least 12 people and injured several others on Monday, turning chunks of the building into rubble, a fire officer said. "We have recovered 12 bodies so far," said B Nagehswara Rao, district fire official at the site of the blast in Sangareddy in India's southern

Telangana state. "We are searching through the debris for more bodies." Footage on Indian television showed plumes of black smoke soaring into the sky. Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy said that the "death of several people has caused great distress"

US to revoke visas for Glastonbury band over anti-Israel chant

♦ The United **States** said Monday it was revoking visas for the British punk-rap

group Bob Vylan, which led a chant at the Glastonbury festival calling for death to the Israeli military. Deputy Secretary of State Christopher Landau said that the United States has "revoked the US visas for the members of the Bob Vylan band in light of their hateful tirade at Glastonbury, including leading the crowd in death chants." "Foreigners who glorify violence and hatred are not welcome visitors to our country," he posted on X. President Donald Trump's administration has aggressively revoked visas, mostly of students, over anti-Israel activism. Bob Vylan, a London-based duo combining punk riffs and hip-hop delivery whose lyricism often tackles racism, led a chant of "Death to the IDF," the initials of the Israel Defense Forces, at the celebrated music festival

◆ Iran's judiciary said at least 935 people were killed in the country during its 12-day war with Israel, state media reported yesterday, nearly a week since a ceasefire took hold. "During the 12-day war waged by the Zionist regime against our country, 935 martyrs have been identified so far," the official IRNA news agency quoted judiciary spokesman Asghar

Jahangir as saying. The death toll included 132 women and 38 children, Jahangir said. German navy

◆ Germany's defence minister said yesterday the country would send navy ships to patrol the Arctic to patrol Arctic waters, citing the threat from a Russian military build-up in the region. "Maritime

threats are mounting... To name but a few, Russia is militarising the Arctic," Defence Minister Boris Pistorius told a press conference. "We are seeing an increasing activity of Russian submarines operating in that area," the minister added, speaking alongside his Danish counterpart, Troels Lund Poulsen. Therefore, "as early as this year, Germany will show its presence in the North Atlantic and the Arctic," Pistorius said.
