Tug of war over solar duty cuts

Shura divisions emerge over customs exemptions for renewable energy

● Proposal seeks customs duty exemptions for renewable and energy-saving systems

● Supporters cite investment boost and reduced pressure on the power grid

● Finance committee warns of potential impact on public revenues

Shura Council members and the Financial and Economic Affairs Committee are set for a policy face-off this Sunday as they meet to debate customs exemptions for renewable energy equipment.

Supporters argue that eas-

ing customs duties would encourage investment in clean energy and help reduce pressure on the national power grid, while opponents warn of a potential hit to state revenues.

The draft law, presented in revised form, seeks to attract investment into renewable energy projects and forms part of Bahrain Economic Vision 2030.

The Council will examine a revised supplementary report from the Public Utilities and Environment Committee, submitted by Shura Council members Talal Al Mannai, Dalal Al

Zayed, Mohammed Ali Hassan, Jumaa Al Kaabi and Ali Al Aradi.

However, the Financial and Economic Affairs Committee has cautioned that the proposal could have a direct impact on public income.

The draft legislation proposes exempting all systems, devices and equipment linked to renewable energy sources and energy-saving measures – along with their production inputs – from customs duties.

The committee noted that Article 1 defines renewable energy to include solar, wind, geothermal and biogas, extending the exemption to systems using any of those sources. It warned the wide scope could affect public revenues, as the exemption is not limited to industrial inputs.

Amendments also revise the definition of "the Authority" to one designated by decree, avoiding conflict with a separate draft law regulating the electricity and water sector before the Council of Representatives, which would repeal the 2007 decree establishing the

Electricity and Water Authority.

A second paragraph has been added to Article 13, reaffirming the customs exemption while requiring the competent minister to set the terms for its application.

The Public Utilities and Environment Committee, chaired by Dr Mohammed Ali Hassan, has recommended the proposal proceed for consideration after discussions on the revised text.

Bahrain has officially assumed its non-permanent seat on the United Nations Security Council for 2026–2027, a move signalling the Kingdom’s commitment to peace, coexistence, solidarity, and shared prosperity, Foreign Minister Dr

Abdullahatif bin Rashid Al Zayani said.

Speaking on the occasion, Dr Al Zayani said the membership reflects Bahrain’s diplomatic and humanitarian approach under the leadership of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa and the directives of His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown

Prince and Prime Minister. He noted that this marks Bahrain’s second Security Council membership in nearly three decades, highlighting growing international confidence in the Kingdom’s diplomacy.

Palestinian cause

Dr Al Zayani outlined Bahrain’s priorities on the Council,

including supporting the Palestinian cause, promoting multi-lateral cooperation, combating terrorism and violent extremism, advancing an international treaty criminalising hate speech, and addressing global challenges such as climate change, food security, cybersecurity, and sustainable development. He emphasised Bahrain’s role in

securing maritime navigation, protecting global energy trade, and advocating for a Middle East free of weapons of mass destruction.

The minister also said Bahrain seeks to contribute to the development of the United Nations system, enhancing its effectiveness, transparency, and inclusiveness, ensuring broader

representation of developing countries in decision-making, and strengthening global governance. He highlighted initiatives proposed by the Crown Prince to advance international cooperation, including calls for an international treaty to govern artificial intelligence, promote fairness in global financial and economic institutions, and deepen cooperation to tackle environmental, climate, health, and economic challenges, supporting the Sustainable Development Goals and the Pact for the Future.

Dr Al Zayani stressed that, under the guidance of His Majesty the King, the Crown Prince, and the collective efforts of Team Bahrain, the Kingdom will continue its longstanding diplomatic engagement of more than five decades as an active international partner, committed to peace and stability, dialogue and coexistence, solidarity, human rights, and sustainable development, in pursuit of a more peaceful, just, and prosperous world.



The UN Security Council has 15 members: 5 permanent members (China, France, Russia, the United Kingdom, and the United States) and 10 non-permanent members elected for two-year terms by the UN General Assembly.

Non-permanent members cannot be immediately re-elected after serving a term, and seats are allocated by regional groups to ensure geographical representation.

Non-permanent members participate in decision-making on international peace and security, including sanctions, peacekeeping missions, and resolutions, giving smaller nations a voice in global security affairs.

Civil Defence tames Manama house fire in record time

A fire that broke out in a house in Manama yesterday was quickly brought under control thanks to the swift action of the Civil Defence team. Miraculously, no one was injured. Onlookers praised the team for preventing the flames from spreading to neighbouring homes. Residents reported seeing thick black smoke billowing into the sky as parts of the house were engulfed in flames.



Officials suspect an electrical short circuit may have sparked the fire. Responding officers arrived shortly after the emergency alert, braving intense heat and smoke to contain the blaze.

The full extent of the damage is still being assessed, with authorities confirming that all safety procedures were followed and the area secured in line with regulations.

Expat limits hit a wall: Shura Council says ‘No’ again

Committee says existing laws already protect Bahrainis’ priority

Existing safeguards for Bahrainis in public-sector jobs make the draft redundant, officials say.

Expat contract rules already covered by law, committee stresses in fresh review.

Draft law faces pushback as authorities highlight successful localisation measures.

The Legislative and Legal Affairs Committee of the Shura Council has urged members to reject the draft, noting that the Civil Service Law already prioritises Bahraini nationals and sets clear rules for employing non-Bahrainis.



A controversial draft law requiring expatriates to hold a master’s degree and at least 10 years’ experience to work in Bahrain’s public sector is facing another rejection by the Shura Council. Critics say the proposed rules are redundant, as similar safeguards already exist under current Civil Service regulations.

The Legislative and Legal Affairs Committee of the Shura

Council has urged members to reject the draft, noting that the Civil Service Law already prioritises Bahraini nationals and sets clear rules for employing non-Bahrainis.

The Council is scheduled to vote on the draft for a second time on Sunday, following its return by the Council of Representatives. MPs had supported the proposal, which also includes limiting expat contracts to two years with one possible

renewal and requiring contractors to train Bahraini staff. However, the Shura Council previously rejected it in principle and referred it back—a stance the committee has repeated.

Citing Article 16 of the Constitution, the committee highlighted that public office is reserved for Bahrainis, with non-Bahrainis allowed only under specific legal conditions. Current law already permits exceptions only when no suitable Bahraini

candidate is available, with implementation details handled by the Civil Service Bureau.

The draft’s main conditions—providing the absence of a Bahraini candidate, setting education and work-experience requirements, and reassessing the need

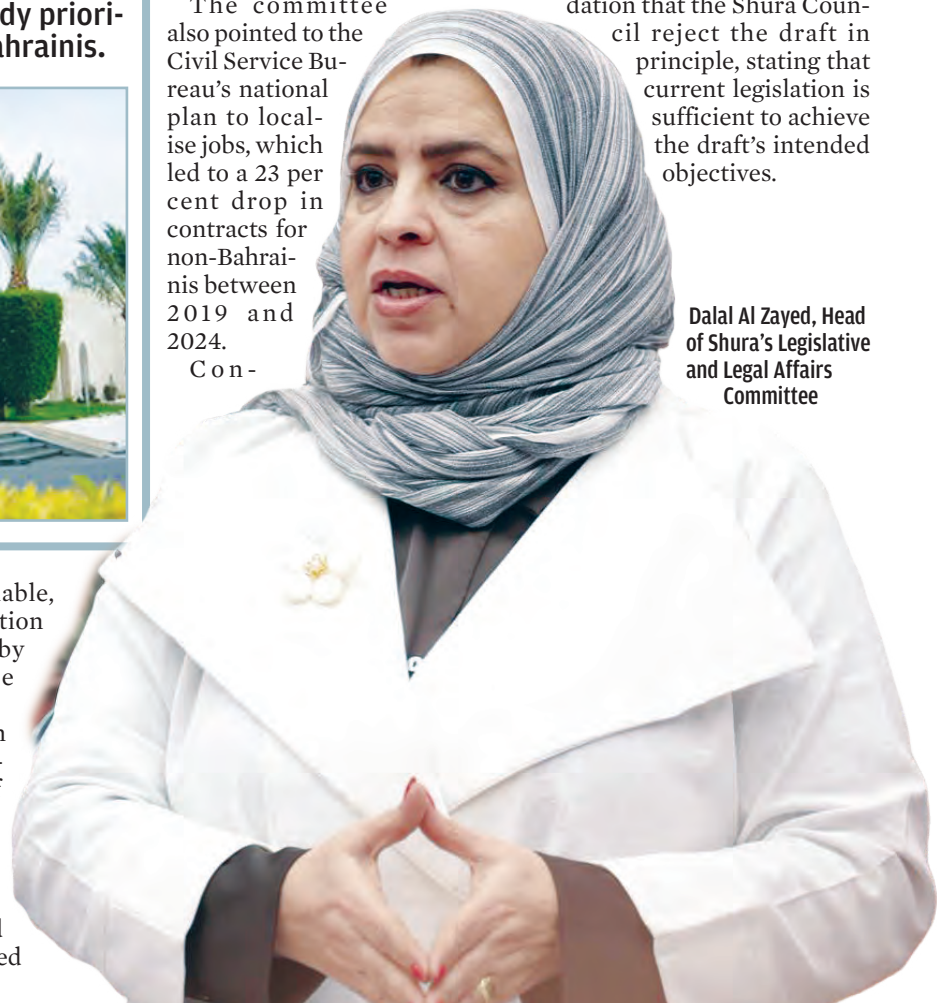
at contract renewal—are already addressed by existing rules.

The committee also pointed to the Civil Service Bureau’s national plan to localise jobs, which led to a 23 per cent drop in contracts for non-Bahrainis between 2019 and 2024.

Con-

cluding its review, the committee reaffirmed its recommendation that the Shura Council reject the draft in principle, stating that current legislation is sufficient to achieve the draft’s intended objectives.

Shura to vote on hosting international arbitration court

The Council’s Committee on Foreign Affairs, Defence and National Security has recommended approval of the draft law.

The agreement would make Bahrain the first country in the Middle East to sign a host country agreement with the Permanent Court of Arbitration

The Shura Council will vote at its next meeting on a draft law to approve an agreement that would allow Bahrain to host the Permanent Court of Arbitration, an international body that settles disputes between states, companies and organisations.

The Council’s Committee on Foreign Af-

fairs, Defence and National Security has recommended approval of the draft law.

If approved, the agreement would see Bahrain provide office space, meeting rooms and administrative support for the court,

helping it conduct arbitration hearings in the Kingdom.

The agreement also sets out legal protections needed for the court to work independently. These apply to arbitrators, court staff and people involved in cases, such as lawyers, witnesses and experts. Bahraini nationals involved would receive limited protections, strictly linked to their official duties.

Officials stressed that these protections are intended to

support justice, not personal benefit, and can be lifted if they are misused or interfere with legal proceedings.

The agreement also makes it easier for non-Bahrainis involved in cases to enter and stay in Bahrain, including visa facilitation and freedom of movement, subject to security rules.

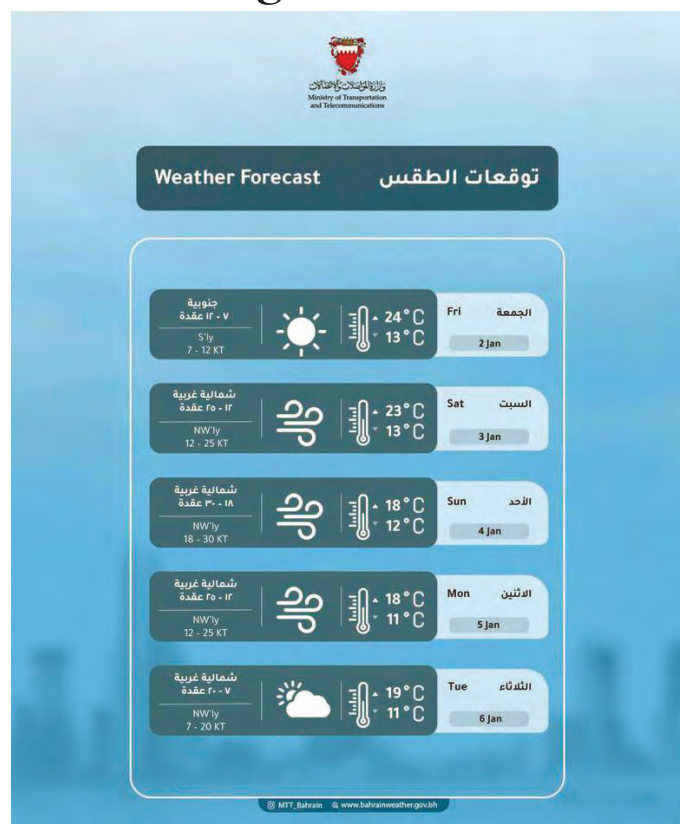
It further clarifies that Bahrain would not be held responsible for decisions or actions taken by the court while carrying out its work. Any dispute between Bahrain and the court would be settled through consultations or arbitration.

In its report, the committee noted that similar host country agreements already exist between the court and several countries, including Argentina, Chile, China (for Hong Kong), Costa Rica, Djibouti, India, Ireland, Malaysia, Mauritius, Portugal, Singapore, South Africa, Uruguay and Vietnam, as well as an office in Austria.

It said the agreement would make Bahrain the first country in the Middle East to sign a host country agreement with the Permanent Court of Arbitration.

The committee recommended that the draft law be approved as presented.

Cold spell to peak Monday as winds strengthen

The Meteorology Department at the Ministry of Transportation and Communications has forecast the return of northerly winds starting Saturday, following a brief easing in wind intensity on Thursday and Friday.

Bahrain International Airport is the main gateway to the Kingdom of Bahrain and has been in operation since 1932, making it one of the oldest international airports in the Gulf region.

Bahrain International Airport saw eight million passengers pass through its terminals between January and November 2025, according to the latest monthly figures released by the Ministry of Transportation and Telecommunications. During the same period, the airport recorded over 97,000 aircraft movements. August was the busiest month of the year, with 951,795 passengers and 9,029 arriving and departing flights. July also

witnessed heavy traffic, with 865,753 passengers and 8,748 movements. The year opened strongly in January with 812,527 passengers, followed by 736,625 in February, with arrivals and departures almost evenly split at 374,027 and 358,313 respectively. Aircraft movements in February reached 7,661, while over 48,000 flights crossed Bahraini airspace that month. Passenger numbers dipped to their lowest in March, at

594,824, alongside 7,395 aircraft movements. Numbers then rose steadily: April recorded 808,793 passengers and 8,533 movements, May had 744,625 passengers and 8,568 movements, and June saw 780,771 passengers with 8,011 movements. After the summer peak, September eased to 766,394 passengers and 8,377 movements, before October climbed again to 851,981 passengers and 8,532 movements. Overflights continued to be significant, with more than 500,000 aircraft transiting Bahraini airspace during the first 11 months of 2025—averaging



roughly 45,000 per month, with peaks in February, July, and August. Cargo and airmail volumes handled at the airport exceeded

360,000 tonnes between January and November, covering inbound, outbound, and transit freight. March, July, and October were particularly strong months, with transit cargo typically accounting for one-third to 40 per cent of total volumes, and inbound cargo surpassing outbound shipments overall.

President Donald Trump has delayed steeper US tariffs on some imported furniture items for a year, ordering the postponement shortly

before they were due to take effect yesterday.

The increase had been planned under an earlier tranche of sector-specific tariffs imposed by Trump, part of a slate of duties he has rolled out since returning to the White House.

But with US households feeling the pinch from elevated costs of living, Trump late Wednesday pushed the planned tariffs -- 30 percent on certain upholstered furniture and 50 percent on kitchen cabinets and vanities -- to January 1, 2027.

"Given the ongoing productive negotiations regarding the imports of wood products, the President is delaying the tariff increase to allow for further negotiations to occur with other countries," the White House said in a statement announcing the move.

Trump's tariffs in 2025 affect-

ed goods ranging from steel to autos, and more investigations -- that could lead to new levies -- are underway.

In October, a 10 percent duty on imported softwood timber and lumber came into effect, along with a 25-percent duty on certain upholstered furniture and kitchen cabinets.

These tariffs were justified by the Trump administration as a means to boost US industries and protect national security.

The higher rates originally set to take effect Thursday would have impacted imports from countries like Vietnam and China, which have been key suppliers of imported furniture to the United States.

The Supreme Court is due to rule on the legality of country-wide tariffs, imposed under the International Emergency Economic Powers Act.

Bulgaria adopts the euro, nearly 20 years after joining the EU

Bulgaria yesterday became the 21st country to switch to the euro, a milestone met with both cheers and fears, nearly 20 years after the Balkan nation joined the European Union.

At midnight (2200 GMT Wednesday), Bulgaria gave up the lev, in use since the late 19th century, and Bulgarian euro coins were projected onto the central bank's building.

"I warmly welcome Bulgaria to the euro family," said Christine Lagarde, president of the European Central Bank, calling the euro a "powerful symbol"



of "shared values and collective strength".

"Great! It works!" exclaimed Dimitar, a 43-year-old man after withdrawing 100 euros from an automated teller machine shortly after midnight.

Successive governments in

the country of 6.4 million people have advocated joining the euro, hoping that it will boost the economy of the European Union's poorest member, reinforce ties to the West and protect against Russia's influence.

But Bulgarians have long been

divided over the switch, with many worrying the introduction could usher in higher prices and add to the political instability rattling the country.

In a speech broadcast shortly before midnight, President Rumen Radev hailed it as the

"final step" in Bulgaria's EU integration, as thousands of people braved sub-zero temperatures in the capital Sofia to celebrate the New Year.

Radev however voiced regret that Bulgarians had not been consulted by referendum on the adoption.

"This refusal was one of the dramatic symptoms of the deep divide between the political class and the people, confirmed by mass demonstrations across the country."

Anti-corruption protests swept a conservative-led government from office in mid-De-

cember, leaving a country anxious about inflation on the verge of its eighth election in five years.

"People are afraid that prices will rise, while salaries will remain the same," a woman in her 40s who declined to give her name told AFP in Sofia.

At one of the city's largest markets, stalls displayed prices of everything from groceries to New Year's Eve essentials like sparklers in both levs and euros.

"The whole of Europe has managed with the euro, we'll manage too," retiree Vlad told AFP.

China's BYD logs record EV sales in 2025

● **The figure puts BYD in pole position to outstrip Elon Musk's Tesla**

Chinese auto giant BYD sold 2.26 million electric vehicles last year, a company statement showed Thursday, setting a new record for any firm globally.

The figure puts BYD in pole position to outstrip Elon Musk's Tesla in the annual category for the first time, with the lagging Texas-based firm having previously announced 1.22 million in 2025 EV sales by the end of September.

Tesla is expected to announce its total EV sales for last year on Friday.

Shenzhen-based BYD, which also produces hybrid cars, announced the data in a statement

published to the Hong Kong Stock Exchange, where it is listed. Known as "Biyadi" in Chi-

nese -- or by the English slogan "Build Your Dreams" -- BYD was founded in 1995, originally

specialising in battery manufacturing.

The automotive juggernaut

has come to dominate China's highly competitive new energy vehicle market -- the world's largest. Now it is seeking to expand its presence overseas, as increasingly price-wary consumption patterns in China weigh on profitability. BYD and its Chinese competitors face hefty tariffs in the United States.

But its success is growing in Southeast Asia, the Middle East, and even Europe -- to the consternation of traditional industry heavyweights from the continent.

Tesla narrowly beat BYD in annual EV sales in 2024, with US company's 1.79 million just outpacing the latter's 1.76 million.

This year, Musk's firm has seen sales struggle in key markets over the CEO's political support of US President Donald Trump and far-right politicians.

Tesla has also faced rising EV competition from BYD and other Chinese companies, as well as from European giants.

N. Korea's Kim hails 'invincible alliance' with Russia in New Year's letter

◆ North Korean leader Kim Jong Un has praised his troops fighting abroad as forging an "invincible alliance" with Russia in a new year's message, state media said yesterday. Pyongyang has sent thousands of troops to support Russia's nearly four-year invasion of Ukraine, according to South Korean and Western intelligence agencies. At least 600 have died and thousands more have sustained injuries, according to South Korean estimates.

◆ US President Donald Trump hosted Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu at a glittering New Year's Eve party at his lavish Mar-a-Lago resort on Wednesday, according to social media. Netanyahu, who arrived at the US president's Palm Beach residence on Monday, was spotted alongside tuxedo-clad Trump Wednesday night in a social media post from conservative influencer Michael Solakiewicz. Trump had joked that the Israeli leader could attend the party during meetings Monday to discuss the fragile Gaza ceasefire and other regional geopolitical concerns in the Middle East.

Taiwan's president vows to defend sovereignty after China drills

◆ Taiwanese President Lai Ching-te vowed yesterday to defend the democratic island's sovereignty in a New Year's speech, after China carried out military drills. Beijing launched missiles and deployed dozens of fighter jets, navy ships and coastguard vessels this week to encircle Taiwan's main island, in exercises condemned by Taipei as "highly provocative". China claims democratic Taiwan is part of its territory and has threatened to use force to annex it.

Trump blames bruised hand on aspirin, denies falling asleep

US President Donald Trump blamed aspirin for large bruises on his hand and denied falling asleep while attending public meetings in an interview with The Wall Street Journal published yesterday. In the interview defending his health, Trump also changed his previous statement about receiving an MRI scan in October, saying it was instead a quicker CT scan. Trump, who at 79 is the oldest person to assume the US presidency, told the Journal "my health is perfect" and expressed frustration with scrutiny of his well-being. Trump has based much of his political image on projecting vigor -- whether through his frequent interactions with journalists, constant social media posting, or AI memes depicting him as a superhero. However, the first year of his second term in office has raised growing questions. His right hand shows persistent bruising, often covered with thick makeup and at times a bandage, and his ankles have appeared swollen.

On occasion, Trump has clearly struggled to keep his eyes open, including during a televised Oval Office meeting with health representatives in November -- a politically sensitive issue for someone who constantly frames his Democratic predecessor Joe Biden as "sleepy." Russia blames Ukraine for deadly New Year drone strike

Moscow says a Ukrainian strike killed at least 20 civilians celebrating New Year's Eve

- Kyiv yet to comment on allegations
- Zelensky says Ukraine near peace deal
- Russia fired 200 drones at Ukraine overnight

Russia yesterday said Kyiv was behind a deadly drone strike on a hotel in the Moscow-held part of Ukraine's southern Kherson region that killed at least 20 people celebrating the New Year. The accusations come at a crunch moment after weeks of diplomacy aimed at brokering an end to the near four-year war, and as Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky said his country was "10 percent" away from a peace deal. According to a Russia-appointed governor of the Kherson region, Vladimir Saldo, "the enemy" fired three drones that "struck a cafe and hotel on the Black Sea coast in Khorly" where "civilians were celebrating the New Year". Kyiv has not commented on the allegations. Russia's Investigative Committee said it had opened a probe into the attack which had "killed more than 20 people and injured many more." A building gutted by fire, piles of smouldering rubble and charred bodies were seen in pictures that Saldo posted on Telegram. Russian foreign ministry

spokeswoman Maria Zakharova accused Ukraine of carrying out a "terrorist" attack against the civilian population. Zelensky said Russia was carrying the war "into the New Year" with more than 200 drones fired overnight, mainly targeting energy facilities. "A significant number of consumers" were cut off from power, Ukraine's power operator Ukrenergo said. Railway and port infrastructure was also damaged in the latest barrage. New talks in sight Ukraine came under intense pressure in 2025, both from Russian bombardment and on the battlefield, where it has steadily ceded ground to the Russian army.

An AFP analysis based on Ukrainian air force data showed a slight fall in overnight Russian drone and missile attacks on Ukraine in December. Russia fired at least 5,134 drones in overnight attacks in the final month of 2025, six percent less than the month before, while the number of missiles fell by 18 percent in the same period, according to the data. However, the same data showed Ukraine destroyed a smaller share of the total sum of missiles and drones in December -- 80 percent, compared with 82 percent in November. US President Donald Trump, who regularly complains he does not receive credit as a peacemaker, has engaged in talks with both sides in a bid to end the fighting.

Fresh clashes kill three in Iran cost-of-living protests

Protesters and security forces clashed in western Iran yesterday, with three people reported killed, the first deaths since the cost-of-living demonstrations broke out. The protests began on Sunday in Tehran, where shopkeepers went on strike over high prices and economic stagnation, and have since spread to other parts of the country. Yesterday, the Fars news agency reported two civilians were killed in fresh clashes between security forces and protesters in the city of Lordegan. "Some protesters began throwing stones at the city's administrative buildings, including the provincial governor's office, the mosque, the Martyrs' Foundation, the town hall and banks," Fars said, adding that police responded with tear gas. Fars added that the buildings were "severely damaged" and police arrested several people described as "ringleaders".

State media has labelled demonstrators as rioters during previous protest movements. Earlier yesterday, state television reported that a member of Iran's security forces was killed overnight during protests in the western city of Kouhdasht. "A 21-year-old member of the Basij from the city of Kouhdasht

Pourali said that "during the demonstrations in Kouhdasht, 13 police officers and Basij members were injured by stone throwing". 'End up in hell' The demonstrations are smaller than the last major outbreak of unrest in 2022, triggered by the death in custody of Mahsa Amini, who was arrested for allegedly violating Iran's strict dress code for women. Her death sparked a nationwide wave of anger that left several hundred people dead, including dozens of members of the security forces. The latest protests began peacefully in the capital and spread after students from at least 10 universities joined in on Tuesday. Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian has sought to calm tensions, acknowledging protesters' "legitimate demands", and called on the government yesterday to take action to improve the economic situation.



Dozens believed killed in Swiss New Year fire

Fire at crowded Crans-Montana bar leaves multiple dead and 100 injured

● Blaze breaks out just after midnight

● Victims include multiple nationalities, say police

● Authorities rule out terror or planned attack

● Birthday candles may have sparked ceiling fire

Dozens are presumed dead after a fire ripped through a crowded bar in the luxury Swiss ski resort of Crans-Montana as young revellers rang in the new year yesterday, with witnesses describing scenes of “panic”.

Horrified bystanders told of people trying to break through the windows of the bar to escape, as others, covered in burns, poured into the street.

Police, firefighters and rescuers rushed to the popular resort, which is set to host the Ski World Cup from January 30, after the fire broke out in the early hours of New Year's Day.

“I am in shock,” Alexie Laguerre told Swiss public broadcaster RTS.

The 18-year-old had been walking with a group of friends past the Le Constellation bar, a popular spot with young people and tourists, when they noticed smoke and flames emerging from the venue and called the police.

“People were running through the flames... People were using chairs to try to break the windows.”

Frederic Gisler, police commander in the Wallis canton in

southwestern Switzerland, told reporters that “several dozen people are presumed to have died”, while around 100 people had been wounded, many of them seriously.

Two young French women, Emma and Albane, told French broadcaster BFMTV that they had been able to escape the “panic” in the bar shortly after the fire broke out.

They said “birthday candles” placed on champagne bottles had got too close to the ceiling.

“Seconds later, the entire ceiling was burning,” one of them told the broadcaster, estimating that there were around 200 people in the venue at the time, mainly aged between 15 and 20.

‘Terrible tragedy’

A tourist from New York, who filmed bright orange flames pouring from the bar, told AFP he saw people running and screaming.

Authorities said they were still investigating the causes of the fire, which erupted shortly before 1:30 am (0030 GMT), but said they did not believe it had been caused by an “attack”.

The emergency unit at the main hospital in the Wallis was full, with the injured being transported to various hospitals across Switzerland.

More than a dozen victims had been transported to the Zurich University Hospital in northern Switzerland, while at least 22 people suffering from serious burns had been taken to main hospital in Lausanne, and six had been taken to Geneva, the Keystone-ATS news agency reported.

Guy Parmelin, who took over the Swiss presidency yesterday, decried a “terrible tragedy”.

“What was meant to be a moment of joy has turned the first day of the year in Crans-Montana into a day of mourning affecting the entire country and beyond,”

he said on X.

Swiss authorities told reporters that it was too early to provide an exact number of victims.

Rush to identify victims

They however acknowledged that given Crans-Montana's popularity with tourists around the world, they expected a number of foreign nationals to be among the dead.

At least two French citizens were among the injured, according to initial reports from the French foreign ministry.

Le Constellation has a capacity of 300 people, plus another 40 people on its terrace, according to the Crans-Montana website.

Ambulances were still parked outside the bar hours later, and broken windows could be seen.

Wallis's chief prosecutor Beatrice Pilloud said that significant resources were being mobilised “to identify the victims and return their bodies as quickly as

possible to the families”.

‘Screaming for help’

Early reports had suggested a large explosion might have caused the fire.

But Stephane Ganzer, head of Wallis's security department, however said that “the initial investigation shows... the explosion was in fact a consequence of the fire”.

“There is absolutely no question of a terrorist attack,” stressed Pilloud, the prosecutor.

Alex, 21, meanwhile told RTS that he had arrived at the scene shortly after a loud explosion sounded.

Enveloped in a strong smell of gas mixed with the smell of melted plastic, he said he saw people fleeing the bar with burns and “people screaming for help”.

Then he said he remembered that there was only a narrow set of stairs up from a large basement locale in the building, and worried dozens might remain trapped.

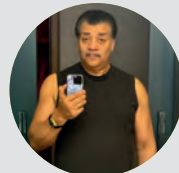

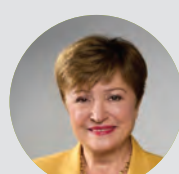

Trump says pulling National Guard from three cities -- for now

President Donald Trump said Wednesday he was withdrawing National Guard troops from Chicago, Los Angeles and Portland, following a series of legal setbacks over his military deployments in US cities.

The Republican had sent troops into several cities run by Democrats during his first year back in power, in what he called a crackdown on illegal immigration and crime.

Local leaders slammed the moves as authoritarian overreach and launched a string of successful legal challenges, with the US Supreme Court last week blocking the Chicago deployment.

Leftist Mamdani takes over as New York mayor under Trump shadow

Zohran Mamdani, the young Upstart of the US left, was sworn in yesterday to take over as New York mayor for a term sure to see him cross swords with President Donald Trump.

After the clocks struck midnight, bringing in 2026, Mamdani took his oath of office at an abandoned subway stop to begin managing the United States' largest city. He is New York's first Muslim mayor.

His office said the understated venue beneath City Hall reflected his commitment to working people, after the

Justin Bieber wants music industry to be ‘made safer’

Justin Bieber wants the music industry to be made “safer” and “more honest”. The 31-year-old singer was catapulted to fame as a child star and spent his formative years in the spotlight but he suffered numerous troubles including an arrest on suspicion of driving under the influence that led to him being convicted of a reckless driving charge in 2014, and Bieber is now adamant

he wasn’t properly protected as he was growing up. In a series of posts on Instagram, Bieber credited his Christian faith with helping him through his pain. He wrote: “I grew up in a system that rewarded my gift but didn’t always protect my soul. “There were moments I felt used, rushed, shaped into something I didn’t fully choose. That kind of pressure leaves wounds you don’t see on stage. I’ve carried anger, I’ve asked God why.

“But Jesus keeps meeting me in the middle of the pain - not excusing what hurt me but teaching me how not to become bitter.” He added: “I’m not speaking as a victim still bleeding – I’m speaking as someone restored. Because I’m healed, I can forgive. Not to pretend injustice didn’t happen, but so it doesn’t keep living through me.” Bieber went on to declare he wants to see real changes in the music industry, adding: “I don’t want revenge. I want redemption. I

don’t want to destroy the industry. I want it transformed. “What happened to me was real but it doesn’t get the final word. Jesus didn’t help me cope, he restored my identity. I’m not a product. I’m not what the industry demanded. I’m a son. “Because I’m healed, I can forgive - not to excuse injustice, but to make sure it doesn’t keep reproducing itself through me. “I don’t want to burn the music industry down. I want to see

it made new – safer, more honest, more human.” Bieber returned to music this year releasing his albums Swag and Swag II but he has since admitted he’s reluctant to tour again because he doesn’t want to spend too much time away from his wife Hailey and their young son Jack.

Trump joins criticism of Clooney’s French passport

US President Donald Trump piled on criticism Wednesday of a decision to grant Hollywood superstar George Clooney French passports after a junior government official in Paris labelled the move a “double standard”. An official decree seen by AFP on Monday showed that 64-year-old Oscar winner Clooney, his wife Amal Alamuddin Clooney and their two children had become French citizens. Trump, whose administration has backed anti-immigration parties in Europe, said that Paris was welcome to the “Ocean’s Eleven” star, a long-term Democratic supporter, fundraiser and a vocal critic of the president. “Good News! George and Amal Clooney, two of the worst political prognosticators of all time, have officially become citizens of France which is, sadly, in the midst of a major crime

problem because of their absolutely horrendous handling of immigration,” Trump said on his Truth Social network. The news of Clooney and his family becoming French comes ahead of language requirements for citizenship being toughened for everyone else under new immigration rules from January 1.

A junior member of President Emmanuel Macron’s government had also criticised the decision to award passports despite Clooney speaking poor French. “Personally, I understand the feeling of some French people of a double standard,” Marie-Pierre Vedrenne, a junior interior minister,

told the France Info radio station. “We need to be careful about the message we’re sending.” Her boss, Interior Minister Laurent Nunez, and the foreign ministry however defended the decision. The civil code states that “French nationality may be conferred by naturalization, upon the proposal of the minister of foreign affairs, to any French-speaking foreigner who applies for it and who contributes through their distinguished service to France’s influence and the prosperity of its international economic relations.” But Clooney has admitted that his French remains poor despite hundreds of lessons. Under the new immigration rules from Thursday, applicants will need a certificate showing they have a level of French that could get them into a French university. They will also have to pass a civic knowledge test.

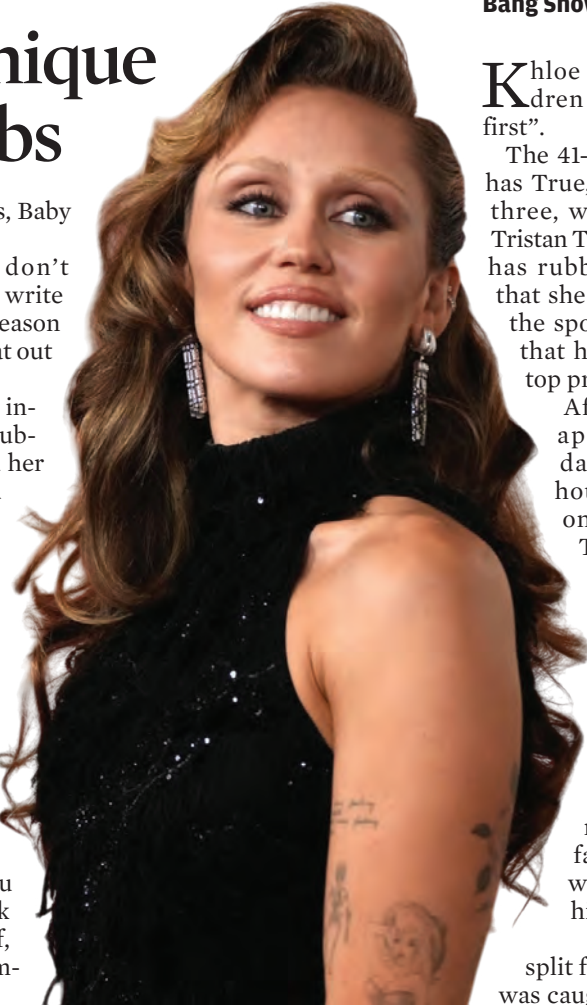
Miley Cyrus reveals unique technique for landing movie songwriting jobs

Miley Cyrus pitches her songwriting skills to legendary filmmakers and Hollywood stars at events to get involved in movies. The 33-year-old singer-songwriter scored the responsibility of making the credit song - Dream As One - for Avatar: Fire and Ash after she told the film’s director, James Cameron, 71, that she was up for doing it at Disney’s D23 Expo in August 2024. Miley - who was honored as a Disney Legend alongside James at the event - told People: “I kind of throw it out there as I always do. Asked if offering original music is her “tried and true method” of landing gigs on the big screen, Miley said: “No, literally, that’s why I went to the Oscars this year. Everybody that came up and introduced themselves, I said, ‘Well, if you need any music, I’m around.’” The star - who landed a cameo role in 2024’s Drive-Away Dolls - even offered music to the creators

of the Netflix series, Baby Reindeer. Miley said: “I don’t know what I would write for Baby Reindeer season two, but I threw that out there!” Elsewhere in her interview with the publication, she shared her love for music and movies, being able to “become embedded”. Miley explained: “I really feel myself attached to songs. There’s certain songs that even if they were written for the film or just a song used in the film, like I Will Always Love You, you immediately think of the movie itself, and they become embedded.”

‘Sincaraz’ set to dominate as 2026 tennis season kicks off

After a dominant 2025, Alcaraz and Sinner headline the new tennis season’s launch

● **United Cup begins season today**

● **Sabalenka favourite for women’s title**

● **Djokovic chases elusive 25th major**

Carlos Alcaraz and Jannik Sinner are set for more world domination in 2026, starting at the Australian Open, while Aryna Sabalenka is bubbling with confidence as she chases further Grand Slam success.

The new season gets under way on Friday with the mixed-teams United Cup in Perth and Sydney, headlined by women’s world number two Iga Swiatek and men’s world number three Alexander Zverev.

Top-ranked Sabalenka, who is pursuing a third Melbourne Park trophy, starts at the Brisbane International from January 4-11 in a stellar field also boasting Australian Open champion Madison Keys and fourth-ranked Amanda Anisimova.

Alcaraz and Sinner, or “Sincaraz” as they have been dubbed, play an exhibition in South Korea on January 10 in their only warm-up before the Australian Open eight days later.

While Spanish sensation Alcaraz bumped his Italian rival from the season-ending world number one spot, Sinner had the last laugh by edging him to retain his ATP Finals title in Turin.

It capped a stellar year in which Sinner retained his Australian Open crown and added a landmark triumph at Wim-

bledon among six titles, despite missing three months over a doping ban.

“I feel like a better player than last year,” said Sinner after completing his 2025 campaign with 58 wins and just six defeats.

“A lot of wins and not many losses. And in the losses I had, I tried to see the positive thing and tried to use it to evolve me as a player.”

Alcaraz was similarly dominant, clocking a 71-9 win-loss record with eight titles including the French Open and US Open.

But he is yet to go beyond the quarter-finals at the Australian Open, losing to Novak Djokovic in the last eight in 2025.

It is the only Slam missing from his resume and the 22-year-old will start afresh with a new

coach after his shock split from Juan Carlos Ferrero, who mentored him since he was 15.

Djokovic last hurrah?

Djokovic begins what could be his last year on tour at the Adelaide International starting on January 12, still chasing an elusive record 25th major crown and 11th Australian Open title.

Now 38, he has had to settle for a secondary role since Sinner and Alcaraz took control of the men’s tour, making the semis at all four majors in 2025 but not going further.

“I can do only as much as I can do,” he admitted after defeat at the US Open.

“It will be very difficult for me in the future to overcome the

hurdle of Sinner or Alcaraz in a best-of-five in a Grand Slam.”

Since his last Slam title, in 2023 at the US Open, Alcaraz or Sinner have shared all eight majors.

A resurgent Felix Auger-Aliassime, Taylor Fritz and Alex de Minaur, ranked five, six and seven respectively, all feature at the United Cup, while Daniil Medvedev and a returning Nick Kyrgios play in Brisbane.

Sabalenka heads into the new season as undoubted world number one, having collected a second US Open title while also winning events at Brisbane, Madrid and Miami.

The Belarusian is favourite for a third Australian Open crown and fifth Slam title, although the likes of Swiatek, Coco Gauff

and Elena Rybakina will have something to say.

“The Australian Open is very special to me,” said Sabalenka, who lost a three-set thriller to Keys in the 2025 decider and heads to Australia after losing the controversial “Battle of the Sexes” clash to Kyrgios in Dubai.

“Winning it twice gives me confidence, but every year brings a new challenge. I’m excited to return and see what I can achieve.”

Challenging her on Pat Rafter Arena in Brisbane will be Keys, along with fellow top-10 stars Rybakina, Anisimova, Jessica Pegula and Mirra Andreeva.

Swiatek leads Poland in Sydney at the United Cup, again teaming up with Hubert Hurkacz in their quest for revenge after being beaten by Team USA in the final in 2025 and Germany a year earlier.

The United States are spearheaded by Gauff and Fritz, while four-time major winner Naomi Osaka plays the event for the first time, representing Japan.

Ivory Coast top AFCON group ahead of Cameroon, Algeria win again

Reigning champions Ivory Coast pipped Cameroon to top spot in their group after Algeria maintained their perfect record as the first round of the Africa Cup of Nations concluded on Wednesday.

The Ivorians and the Indomitable Lions of Cameroon came into their last Group F matches with identical records, leaving open the possibility that a drawing of lots would be required to determine their final positions.

But in the end the Ivorians finished in first place in Group F on goals scored after coming from two goals down to beat already-eliminated Gabon 3-2 while Cameroon defeated Mozambique 2-1.

Both sides finished on seven points with Mozambique on three points and Gabon on one. Mozambique go through as one of the four best third-placed sides.

Ivory Coast found themselves two goals behind after just 21 minutes in Marrakesh, with Guelor Kanga pouncing on a handling error by goalkeeper Alban Lafont to put Gabon in front.

Los Angeles FC marksman Denis Bouanga then fired in Gabon’s second, leaving Emerse Fae’s team up against it.

However, Wilfried Zaha squared for Jean-Philippe Krasso to pull one back just before the interval and Aston Villa’s Evann Guessand headed in an

84th-minute equaliser.

The stage was then set for youngster Bazoumana Toure to get the winner for the Elephants in injury time.

Looking to become the first nation since Egypt in 2010 to retain the AFCON title, they will now play Burkina Faso in the last

16 in Marrakesh next Tuesday.

In Agadir, a great strike by Geny Catamo gave Mozambique the lead midway through the first half but Cameroon were level before the half-hour mark.

Nene somehow turned the ball into his own net after initially managing to deflect Frank

Magri’s shot onto the post.

A superb 55th-minute strike by the young Bayer Leverkusen forward Christian Kofane then gave Cameroon the win.

Finishing second in the section means five-time champions Cameroon will play South Africa in the last 16 in Rabat on Sunday.

Hosts Morocco or outsiders Tanzania will face the winners of that tie in the quarter-finals.

Meanwhile Mozambique, who are through to the knockout stage for the first time, will take on Nigeria next.

Sudan beaten by Burkina Faso

Two-time former champions Algeria completed the group stage with a perfect record as they beat Equatorial Guinea 3-1 in Rabat to finish with nine points from three games in Group E.

With Algeria already through as group winners and Equatorial Guinea eliminated, nothing was riding on the game in Morocco’s capital.

A much-changed Algeria team were three goals to the good by half-time, with Zineddine Belaid, Fares Chaibi and Ibrahim Maza all on target.

Chelsea part ways with Enzo Maresca

Italian leaves with Chelsea fifth in the league after a poor run of form

- Maresca leaves Chelsea after 18 months in charge
- One win in last seven Premier League matches
- Relationship with board reportedly deteriorated in recent

Enzo Maresca has left his role as Chelsea head coach after 18 months in charge, the Premier League club announced yesterday.

“Chelsea Football Club and head coach Enzo Maresca have parted company,” said a club statement.

The Italian’s exit from Stamford Bridge comes with the club fifth in the Premier League table -- 15 points adrift of leaders and London rivals Arsenal -- with one win in their last seven top-flight games.

Speculation about Maresca’s position increased during Chelsea’s poor run of recent results amid reports of a worsening relationship between the coach and the club’s hierarchy.

“With key objectives still to play for across four competitions including qualification for Champions League football, Enzo and the club believe a change gives the team the best chance of getting the season back on track,” said the club statement.

Maresca did not attend the post-match press conference

following a frantic 2-2 draw with Bournemouth on Tuesday, although his absence was attributed to illness.

Maresca’s decision to substitute Cole Palmer just after the hour mark during the Bournemouth game was booed by Chelsea fans.

The draw meant Chelsea had dropped 13 points at home from winning positions this season -- the bulk of the 15-point deficit between the Blues and Arsenal.

Maresca has stood by comments made on December 13 after a league win at home to Everton when he said many people at Chelsea “didn’t support me and the team”.

He repeatedly refused to clarify the comments, although he insisted they were not an attack on the club’s supporters.



Despite his recent struggles, Maresca guided Chelsea to significant silverware in 2025, winning both the UEFA Europa Conference League and the FIFA Club World Cup during his tenure

The 45-year-old said the days leading up to the 2-0 victory over Everton were “the worst

48 hours” of his time at Chelsea.

Maresca’s stock at Chelsea was high after the Blues beat Barcelona 3-0 in the Champions League in November.

But damaging defeats by Leeds, Atalanta and Villa increased the pressure on the Blues boss.

Maresca’s contract had been due to run until the summer of 2029, with a club option of a further year.

The former Leicester manager was appointed as successor to Mauricio Pochettino in June 2024.

Chelsea won the Europa Conference League and the Club World Cup in 2025 and Maresca also led them back into the Champions League via a fourth-placed finish in the Premier League.

Tsitsipas considered quitting tennis during injury-hit 2025

Stefanos Tsitsipas said yesterday he seriously considered retiring from tennis in the depths of a struggle with serious back pain during much of the 2025 season.

But the former world number three, now ranked 36th after playing just two Davis Cup matches since a second-round exit at the US Open, said his ongoing medical treatment appeared to be paying dividends.

“I’m most excited to see how my actual training responds with regard to my back,” the 27-year-old said as he prepared to open his 2026 campaign for Greece at the mixed-teams United Cup in Perth, Australia.

“My biggest concern was if I could finish a match,” added the 2023 Australian Open finalist, who said the injury haunted him “for the last six or eight months”.

“I would ask: ‘Can I play another match without pain?’”

“I got really scared after the US Open loss (to Germany’s Daniel Altmaier). I could not walk for two days. That’s when you reconsider the future of your career.”

Tsitsipas said that after various medical consultations he was now satisfied with his current care plan.

“My biggest win for 2026 would be to not have to worry about finishing matches,” he said, adding that he completed five weeks of off-season train-

ing without pain.

“It makes great feedback knowing you had a pre-season without pain -- I hope it stays that way. I want to deliver for 2026 and the United Cup.

“I put in the work. The most important thing is full belief that I can come back to where I was. I will try everything to do that.”

Greece have become regulars in the four-year history of the United Cup, played in Perth and Sydney, with fellow comeback hopeful Maria Sakkari, also a former world number three, joining Tsitsipas in the team.

“We are here again, with a good team and great spirit. We are prepared for war -- we are Greek. We’re going big,” Tsitsipas said.

Neymar extending Santos deal: reports

Neymar has agreed to renew his contract with Santos until the end of 2026, a source close to the negotiations told AFP.

On Wednesday, Santos, Pele’s former club, posted a cryptic video on social media showing an aerial view of their Vila Belmiro stadium with the date December 31, 2026, accompanied by the text: “The time is coming”, without mentioning Neymar, whose initial contract expired at midnight on December 31.

Neymar’s first season back at his first club was interrupted by injuries, but the 33-year-old scored four times as Santos won their last three games to move out of the relegation places on the final day of the season in December.

After the season, he underwent an operation to repair a damaged meniscus in his left

knee. Santos said on December 22 that the operation was performed by Brazil’s national team doctor and was successful.

Neymar, who played for Barcelona, Paris Saint-Germain and Al-Hilal in Saudi Arabia is the top scorer for the Brazil with 79 goals, two more than Pele.

He has not played for the national team since October 2023, when he suffered a knee injury against Uruguay.

Cummins, Hazlewood in spin-heavy Australia squad for T20 World Cup

Pat Cummins and Josh Hazlewood were yesterday named in a spin-heavy provisional Australian squad for this year’s Twenty20 World Cup after their Ashes campaign was ruined by injury.

Test skipper Cummins only played one of the five Ashes Tests against England, in Adelaide, as he slowly recovers from a lower back issue, while Hazlewood (Achilles) missed the entire series.

Cummins will have another scan on his back later this month to determine whether he will be fit for the tournament in India and Sri Lanka beginning on February 7.

Hazlewood and big-hitter Tim David (hamstring) are also on the comeback trail, but are expected to be ready.

“Pat Cummins, Josh Hazlewood and Tim David are tracking well and we are confident

they will be available for the World Cup,” chief selector George Bailey said.

“This is a preliminary squad so should changes need to be made they will ahead of the sup- port period.”

Left-arm spinners Matt Kuhnemann and Cooper Connolly were additions to a largely settled 15-man squad, alongside chief tweaker Adam Zampa and part-timer Glenn Maxwell.

Australia’s group-stage

matches are all being played in Sri Lanka with the expectation of spin-friendly surfaces.

In a surprise, Australia opted against a back-up wicketkeeper for Josh Inglis and no left-arm pace replacement for Mitchell Starc, who has retired from the 20-over game.

The fast-bowling attack is led by Cummins and Hazlewood, along with Nathan Ellis and Xavier Bartlett, plus all-rounders Cameron Green and Marcus Stoinis. All are right-handers.

“The T20 side has enjoyed a long run of recent success which enabled the panel to choose a balance of players across the variety of conditions Sri Lanka and India may present,” Bailey added.

Australia open their account on February 11 in Colombo against Ireland.

They will name a separate squad for a T20 series against Pakistan that precedes the World Cup.
