Bahrain slams Iranian statements as breach of sovereignty

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs strongly rejected recent statements by the Iranian Foreign Ministry spokesperson, describing them as blatant interference in the Kingdom's internal affairs and a clear violation of sovereignty and the principle of non-interference in the domestic matters of states.

The Ministry dismissed Iranian claims as lacking credibility, stressing that attempts to portray Bahrain's legal and sovereign procedures as human rights violations constitute unacceptable politicisation and a deliberate distortion of facts.

It noted that Bahrain has been monitoring what it described as Iran's continued conduct over decades, reiterating that such interference undermines regional security and stability and constitutes a flagrant breach of international law and good-neighbourliness principles.

The Ministry reaffirmed the need for Iran to adhere to the principles of the United Nations Charter, urging it to cease escalatory policies and irresponsible statements, respect state sovereignty, and refrain from interfering in the internal affairs of other countries.

He conveyed the Bahraini monarch's greetings and best wishes for Jordan's continued progress. King Abdullah II, in turn, extended his greetings to King Hamad, wishing Bahrain further development and prosperity. The Crown Prince expressed appreciation for Jordan's solidarity, particularly in light of regional challenges, while reaffirming Bahrain's support for Jordan's security and sovereignty. Bahrain's security and sovereignty are a "red line" that will not be compromised under any circumstances, HH Shaikh Nasser bin Hamad Al Khalifa declared yesterday, reinforcing the firm stance outlined by HM King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa.

HH Shaikh Nasser bin Hamad Al Khalifa, said that betraying the nation or sympathising with its enemies constitutes a "mor-

He further stressed the importance of national awareness and unity, noting that genuine loyalty remains the benchmark of citizenship, while praising the role of Bahraini youth in safeguarding the nation.

Historic Moment

In a separate statement, Interior Minister General Rashid bin Abdullah Al Khalifa described the King's recent media address as a "historic moment" that reinforces the state's foundational principles on security, sovereignty and stability.

He said the message calls for national unity and collective responsibility, warning that any attempt to undermine Bahrain's stability would face firm legal consequences. He added that the Interior Ministry will continue its security duties with resolve, guided by the leader

Fugitive Extradited to Bahrain

The Interior Ministry has announced the extradition of a 32-year-old fugitive to face a court sentence in a theft case.

The International and Interpol Affairs Directorate at the General Directorate of Anti-Corruption and Economic and Electronic Security said the suspect was apprehended following an international notice issued by Interpol, based on an arrest warrant from Bahrain's Public Prosecution and in coordination with friendly countries.

After completing the required legal procedures, the individual was referred to the Public Prosecution.
