

HM King: Judicial independence key to justice

He also commended Bahrain's longstanding judicial tradition and the pioneering achievements it has attained.

The newly appointed judges expressed their appreciation for the royal trust bestowed upon them, emphasising their dedication to upholding the rule of law with integrity and sincerity.

Trump order commits US to defend Qatar

Washington

President Donald Trump has issued an executive order pledging that the United States will guarantee the security of the State of Qatar, affirming Washington's commitment to use all means, including military force if necessary, to defend its territorial integrity and vital infrastructure against any external aggression.

The White House, in a statement, said the US regards any armed attack on Qatar as a direct threat to US peace and security.

It pointed to the long-standing cooperation between the two countries, particularly in security and military fields, noting that Qatar hosts US forces and provides essential support for vital regional operations.

The statement added that Qatar has demonstrated its role as a steadfast strategic ally of the US through its prominent efforts in mediation and in contributing to the settlement of regional and international disputes.

'Last' warning

Intensified assault looms as Israel advises Gazans to flee main city for their safety

Israel issued a final warning yesterday for people to flee Gaza's main city, as Hamas weighed US President Donald Trump's plan to end nearly two years of war in the Palestinian territory.

Witnesses reported heavy bombardment in Gaza City, as Israel's defence minister, Israel Katz, said the army was tightening its encirclement of the city.

"This is the last opportunity for Gaza residents who wish to do so to move south and leave Hamas operatives isolated in Gaza City," Katz posted on X.

Katz said the military had seized the Netzarim corridor, linking central Gaza to the western coast, effectively cutting the north of Gaza off from the south.

Checkpoints

Anyone leaving Gaza City for the south would have to pass through Israeli military checkpoints, he added.

The announcement came hours after the military said it was closing the last remaining route for people to travel from southern Gaza to the north.

In Gaza City, 60-year-old Rabah al-Halabi, sheltering in a tent on the grounds of Al-Shifa Hospital, described relentless explosions.

"I will not leave because the situation in Gaza City is no dif-

ferent from the situation in the southern Gaza Strip," he told AFP by telephone.

Dangerous

"All areas are dangerous, the bombing is everywhere, and

displacement is terrifying and humiliating," he said.

"We are waiting for death, or perhaps relief from God and for the truce to come."

Hamas said Katz's comments were "a prelude to the escalation

of war crimes being committed by his army".

The International Committee of the Red Cross said intensified military operations had forced it to temporarily suspend activities in Gaza City.

Halt

Days earlier, the Doctors Without Borders charity halted its work in the city, where some UN agencies and aid organisations still operate.

Meanwhile, Hamas was examining a peace plan proposed by Trump and backed by Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu.

The plan calls for a ceasefire, the release of hostages within 72 hours, Hamas's disarmament and a gradual Israeli withdrawal from Gaza.

A Palestinian source close to Hamas's leaders told AFP that "no final decision" had been made and that "the movement will likely need two to three days".

"Hamas wants to amend some of the items such as the disarmament clause and the expulsion of Hamas," the source said.

Bahrain and the United States have signed a border-security memorandum that opens a new phase in the Kingdom’s pursuit of easier travel and stronger commercial ties with America.

During his official visit to Washington, Interior Minister H.E. General Shaikh Rashid bin Abdullah Al Khalifa met US Secretary of Homeland Security Kristi Noem and confirmed Bahrain’s aspiration to join the US Visa Waiver Program. The minister said this goal reflects years of mutual trust and steady cooperation between the two countries.

Strategic framework

The memorandum, signed at the Department of Homeland Security, complements the Comprehensive Security Integration and Prosperity Agreement (C-SIPA). It focuses on exchanging information to protect both nations, including checks on borders, immigration, and travellers to prevent entry of individuals considered ineligible because of terrorism, crime, or national-security concerns.

The minister noted that the

pact aligns with the priorities of both governments, such as border protection, supply-chain security, and the strengthening of strategic alliances. H.E. added that Bahrain’s record in community security, including alternative sentencing and open-prisons initiatives, demonstrates how reforms can reinforce national stability.

H.E. said the accord coincides with the launch of Gulf Air’s first direct flight to New York’s John F. Kennedy International

Airport on October 1, describing it as a vital link that will expand business, tourism, education, and cultural opportunities.

According to the minister, this dual milestone, the memorandum and the flight, shows how security cooperation and economic connectivity can progress together.

Broader cooperation

Discussions also covered artificial intelligence, cybersecurity, maritime security, and capacity building. Both sides agreed to study the formation of a joint committee to coordinate future initiatives. The minister reaffirmed that these efforts are guided by His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa’s reform project, which has made justice, coexistence, and openness central to Bahrain’s security approach.

H.E. concluded that the memorandum strengthens a partnership that has endured for more than a century, placing Bahrain and the United States on a shared path toward security, prosperity, and wider international cooperation.

Fake funeral, real prison

Insurance fraud as death certificate forgery lands brothers and wife in jail

The First High Criminal Court sentenced two brothers to 10 years in prison each, and the wife of one of them to one year in jail and a BD2,000 fine, after they forged a death certificate to claim BD188,000 in life insurance. The court also ordered the three defendants to repay BD5,001 in temporary compensation to the insurance company, confiscated the forged death certificate, and ruled that the first defendant and his wife be deported after serving their sentences.

Scam

The elaborate scam began when the first defendant, a



44-year-old investor, insured his life in favor of his wife in April 2023 for BD188,000.

Just four months later, his "death" was reported, support-

ed by a forged death certificate from an Asian country.

However, suspicions were raised as there was no record of burial or funeral prayers, and

even the gravedigger and local imam denied any knowledge of the supposed death.

Further investigations by the insurance company and private investigators revealed the first defendant was still alive.

Testimonies and video evidence showed his direct involvement in orchestrating the forgery with the help of his brother, a 46-year-old businessman, and his wife.

Evidence

The forged certificate, bearing official stamps, was presented in Bahrain's courts in an attempt to secure the insurance payout.

The court found the trio guilty of forgery, use of forged documents, and attempted fraud.

Their plan was thwarted before the payout was made.

Electronic fraud

Asian worker jailed, fined, and faces deportation over fake payments scam

The First High Criminal Court sentenced a 40-year-old Asian restaurant worker to years in prison, fined him BD1,000, and ordered his deportation after serving his sentence, after convicting him of electronic fraud.

According to the Public Prosecution, the defendant used stolen bank cards issued by foreign banks to pay electricity and water bills worth BD 2,453.

He unlawfully accessed banking systems and used verification codes belonging to the cardholders, enabling him to fraudulently seize funds.

Information systems

The prosecution charged him with using an electronic signature belonging to others,

illegally accessing information systems, and attempting to obtain money through fraudulent means.

Investigations began after a payment company reported suspicious activity involving stolen cards used to pay utility bills.

Transactions

The company later discovered the transactions were made with cards reported stolen abroad.

Upon interrogation, the defendant admitted to settling bills for others in exchange for cash, claiming another accomplice provided the stolen cards and carried out some of the payments.

The court, however, found sufficient evidence linking him to the fraudulent transactions and convicted him accordingly.

433 illegal fishing traps and nets seized

The Ministry of Interior affirmed its continued efforts to protect marine wealth and ensure the sustainability of natural resources.

During September 2025, the Coast Guard Command seized

392 illegal marine traps (gar-goor) in addition to 41 illegal fishing nets.

The Coast Guard Command clarified that the necessary legal measures have been taken regarding these violations, noting that intensive inspection campaigns will continue to curb

maritime violations, with the aim of ensuring that fishermen adhere to applicable laws and regulations, in order to preserve the environment and marine resources in the Kingdom of Bahrain.

BD13,634 payout for former employee

Labour court awards a former employee BD13,634 in wage arrears, gratuity and leave in lieu, compels a return ticket and service certificate, and applies stepped interest up to 12 per cent.

Ruling on 30 September 2025, the First High Labour Court ordered a company to pay BD2,652,533 in unpaid wages, BD9,926,039 as end-of-service, and BD1,055,754 in lieu of annual leave.

Interest on late wages runs

at 6 per cent for the first six months of delay, then rises by one point for each month after, capped at 12 per cent, from the due dates until payment.

Employment link

The court also required a return ticket and a service certificate, and dismissed the action against a second defendant for lack of an employment link.

The court found the claimant worked under a Bahrain permit first issued on 13 March 2008 and left on 26 March 2024.

It treated BD686 as the basic wage.

An attempt to tie the Bahraini entity to a Saudi showroom failed; the records showed separate companies and the Saudi registration had lapsed.

Evidence from the Labour

Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) confirmed the permit's renewals through to 12 March 2026.

Wages from December 2023 to 26 March 2024 were judged outstanding as no proof of payment was produced.

End-of-service was calculated on 15 years, 11 months and 19 days to 29 February 2024, with later periods falling under the 2023 gratuity scheme for non-Bahrainis in the private sector.

A claim for overtime was rejected as attendance logs did not prove extra hours.

OpenAI launches Sora 2 with TikTok-style app

OpenAI on Tuesday released Sora 2, its most advanced video generation model yet, alongside a TikTok-style social app that will let users insert themselves into AI-created scenes through a feature called "cameos."

The company behind ChatGPT described the release as a major leap forward in artificial intelligence's ability to create realistic video.

The system can now generate synchronized dialogue, sound effects, and physically accurate motion, according to the company.

"Sora 2 can do things that are exceptionally difficult -- and in some cases outright impossible -- for earlier video generation models," OpenAI said, pointing to examples like capturing Olympic gymnastics routines or basketball moves. Unlike earlier systems that would "morph objects and deform reality" to fulfill text prompts, Sora 2 better follows real-world physics, the company said.

Sora 2 replaces last year's Sora and represents the latest salvo in the AI arms race that began with ChatGPT's launch in 2022.

In video generation, OpenAI faces stiff competition from Google, Runway AI, and Midjourney, all of which offer apps that can produce short clips in seconds -- tools that are either celebrated or feared as potential replacements for human-created content.

Perhaps more surprising than Sora 2 itself is the standalone social app, Sora.

The platform will allow users to appear in AI-generated videos with what OpenAI calls "remarkable fidelity" of both appearance and voice.

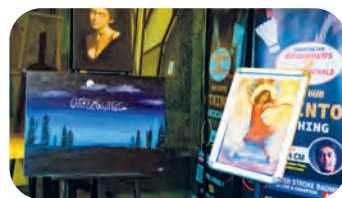

News in brief

◆ **The French navy was** yesterday on board a tanker from Russia's "shadow fleet" stationed off France, AFP journalists at the scene said, after data showed it was off the Danish coast last month during mysterious drone flights. The Boracay, a Benin-flagged vessel blacklisted by the European Union for being part of Russia's sanction-busting "shadow fleet" of ageing oil tankers, was stationed off Denmark from September 22 to 25, according to ship tracking data analysed by AFP. Drones have been sighted across Denmark, including over military sites, since September 22, prompting brief closures at several airports and a ban on all civilian drone flights until Friday. French military personnel were Wednesday on the deck of the tanker, now stationed off the coast of western France, AFP journalists who overflew the area said.



French navy boards Russia 'shadow fleet' ship

◆ **Three suspected** members of Palestinian group Hamas were arrested in Berlin yesterday for allegedly planning attacks on Jewish and Israeli sites, German prosecutors said, with weapons and ammunition also seized. The suspects were "foreign operatives" of Hamas, who have "have been involved in procuring firearms and ammunition for the organisation" in Germany, said federal prosecutors in a statement. An AK-47 assault rifle and several pistols, along with a stash of ammunition, were seized when the suspects were arrested, it said. "The weapons were to be used by Hamas for deadly attacks targeting Israeli or Jewish institutions in Germany," added the statement.

◆ **Mobile networks** and the internet were restored across Afghanistan on Wednesday, 48 hours after the Taliban authorities shut down telecommunications. Confusion gripped the South Asian country on Monday night when mobile phone service and the internet went down without warning, freezing businesses and cutting Afghans off from the rest of the world. The massive blackout came weeks after the government began cutting high-speed internet connections to some provinces to prevent "immorality", on the orders of shadowy supreme leader Hibatullah Akhundzada. AFP journalists reported on Wednesday that mobile phone signals and wifi had returned to provinces across the country, including Kandahar in the south, Khost in the east, central Ghazni, and Herat in the west. The Taliban government has yet to comment on the telecommunications shutdown. On Wednesday night, hundreds of Afghans poured onto the streets in the capital Kabul, spreading the word that the internet was back.

UK tabloid accused of spying on Prince William's 21st birthday party

A UK tabloid allegedly spied on Prince William's "Out of Africa"-themed 21st birthday using a private investigator, it was alleged at the High Court in London on Wednesday. The claim emerged during a court hearing, which is part of his brother Prince Harry's latest legal battle with the British media.



King Charles III's younger son, who has had a turbulent relationship with the press, claims he was the victim of privacy breaches through alleged phone-hacking and the use of private investigators by a UK newspaper group. Harry's lawyer David Sherborne said in written submissions to the court that an invoice, dated August 25, 2023 and titled "Out of Africa Story Royal Party Enqs", related to William, who is now heir to the throne. Sherborne claimed this invoice was linked to a Daily Mail story from June 2003, with "extensive" details about William's 21st birthday party before it took place. Elton John's husband David Furnish and British actor Sadie Frost are taking legal action alongside Prince Harry against Associated Newspapers, and both were present in the courtroom for part of Wednesday's hearing. Harry apparently dialled in to the proceedings remotely.

A link allowed multiple people to watch the preliminary hearing, ahead of a trial of up to nine weeks which could be held at the same court next year. One user appeared on the remote link screen as "Prince Harry". Harry, John, Furnish and Frost are part of a group of seven high-profile complainants in the case against Associated Newspapers, publisher of the Daily Mail and Mail on Sunday. The group also includes actor Elizabeth Hurley. The seven, represented in court by Sherborne, accuse the publisher of allegedly carrying out or commissioning unlawful activities to obtain stories. These include allegedly hiring private investigators to place listening devices inside cars, impersonating individuals to obtain medical information, burglaries to order, and accessing and recording private phone conversations.

Deadly family drama shuts Oktoberfest for a day

A 57-year-old man opened fire on his parents with a self-made weapon

- **Police said he likely killed his 90-year-old father**
- **His 21-year-old daughter, a German-Brazilian dual national, was also injured**
- **The man ran off after a police helicopter spotted him in the garden**

A German man went on a deadly gun, explosives and arson rampage against his family and then killed himself on Wednesday, sparking security fears in Munich that shuttered the Oktoberfest for seven hours. A note he had dropped in a nearby letterbox included a vague threat to the world-famous beer festival, leading authorities to close the event while police with sniffer dogs searched the site. Munich mayor Dieter Reiter then gave the all-clear in the afternoon and the event reopened in the evening. The day of drama started before dawn when the 57-year-old man opened fire on his parents with a self-made weapon. He then set their house on fire, having earlier booby-trapped the building. Police said he likely killed his 90-year-old father, whose body was seen but could not be recovered from the still-burning house in the city's leafy northern Lerchenau district. The man also shot his 81-year-old mother, who was later taken to hospital with wounds not considered life-threatening.

His 21-year-old daughter, a German-Brazilian dual national, was also injured but could be rescued by firefighters from the first floor, having threatened to jump to escape the flames, police said. The unnamed man ran off after a police helicopter spotted him in the garden. After a short pursuit, he stopped in a lakeside park and shot himself in the head, police said. He was still alive when pursuing officers reached him on foot but soon succumbed to his wound, they said. Bomb squads were called in because the man had rigged up the building with explosives -- reportedly grenades attached to trip wires -- and was also carrying an explosives-laden backpack. "It appears, incomprehensible as it may be, that this was solely a family matter," he added. He said the man had previously been involved in a paternity dispute around the 21-year-old woman. Hermann added that the man had denied being the father and accused an institute that had confirmed his paternity of accepting bribes, in a petition to the Bavarian state parliament. City authorities responded to the alarm by announcing the temporary closure of the Oktoberfest, considered the world's largest such folk gathering. The festivities, held from September 20 to October 5 this year, welcomed 6.7 million visitors in 2024. It was previously hit by a 1980 attack when a far-right group detonated a pipe bomb, killing 13 people and wounding more than 200.

US govt shutdown begins after Congress fails to reach deal

The US government began shutting down Wednesday after lawmakers and President Donald Trump failed to break a budget impasse during acrimonious talks that hinged on Democratic demands for health care funding. Republicans and Democrats immediately blamed each other for the deadlock that will impact hundreds of thousands of government workers and the millions of Americans who use the services they provide. The shutdown, which will stop work at multiple federal departments and agencies, comes as deep partisan divisions in Washington have raised fears over the length and consequences of the halt. Trump threatened to punish Democrats and their voters by



The US Capitol Visitor Center is closed to visitors on the first day of the US government shutdown in Washington, DC, targeting progressive priorities and forcing mass public sector job cuts during the first stoppage since the one during his previous term.

"So we'd be laying off a lot of people that are going to be very affected. And they're Democrats, they're going to be Democrats," Trump told reporters, adding a Democratic leaders Chuck Schumer and Hakeem Jeffries said in a statement that "Trump and Republicans have now shut down the federal government because they do not want to protect the health care of the American people."

Gaza aid flotilla defies Israeli 'intimidation tactics'

45 vessels carrying activists and politicians on way

A flotilla carrying aid to war-battered Gaza said yesterday that it would stay its course despite what it called “intimidation tactics” by the Israeli military.

The Global Sumud Flotilla -- around 45 vessels carrying activists and politicians including Swedish climate campaigner Greta Thunberg -- left Spain last month aiming to break Israel's blockade of the Palestinian territory, where the UN says famine has set in.

“In the early hours of this morning, Israeli occupation naval forces launched an intimidatory operation against the Global Sumud Flotilla,” the organisers said as the vessels approached waters off Egypt, where Israel has intercepted previous attempts.

Spain and Italy, which both sent naval escorts, urged the ships to halt before entering Israel's declared exclusion zone off Gaza.

After a 10-day stop in Tun-

At least 46 dead in Gaza as Israel steps up offensive

Gaza City, Palestinian Territories

Gaza's civil defence agency said yesterday that Israeli forces had killed at least 46 people, including 36 in Gaza City, which Israel's defence minister has told residents to flee. Mahmud Bassal, a spokesman for the rescue agency operating under Hamas authority, said several

deaths resulted from attacks in the north of the territory, to the west of Gaza City.

Drone strikes also killed two people in Al-Zawayda and two people at a camp in Nuseirat, both in central Gaza, Bassal added.

Two aid seekers were killed by Israeli gunfire southwest of Khan Yunis in southern Gaza, he said.

sia, where organisers reported two drone attacks, the flotilla resumed its journey on September 15.

One of its main ships, the Alma, was “aggressively circled by an Israeli warship”, the group said, before another vessel, the Sirius, was subjected to “similar harassing manoeuvres”.

Marie Mesmeur, a French lawmaker aboard the Sirius, said that she saw at least two unidentified ships, one “very, very close”, and that during the encounter radar and internet communications were cut.

‘Stop now’

The flotilla said on X it re-

tion minister, Oscar Lopez, had urged the flotilla not to cross into Israel's declared exclusion zone, extending 150 nautical miles off Gaza.

“Our message to the flotilla has been clear: do not enter that zone,” he told Spanish public television, adding that Spain's naval escort would not cross into the exclusion area.

Italy, too, urged the activists to “stop now” after its frigate also halted at the 150-nautical-mile limit, broadcasting radio messages to the activists' vessels asking them to abandon their mission.

The activists said Spain and Italy's decision was an attempt to “sabotage” their endeavours.

South Africa called for “utmost restraint and caution against any unilateral actions that could escalate the situation or endanger human life”.

In a joint statement, Italy and Greece appealed to Israeli authorities to “guarantee the safety and integrity of the flotilla's participants”.

Rome and Athens also urged the flotilla to “refrain from any initiative that could be exploited by those who still reject peace”.

Spanish Prime Minister Pedro Sanchez said the activists “do not represent a danger or a threat to Israel”, hoping that

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin “Netanyahu's government will not represent a threat to this flotilla either”.

Speaking ahead of a European Council meeting Wednesday, Italian Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni called on the activists to halt their voyage, saying it could jeopardise US President Donald Trump's latest proposed Gaza peace plan, currently still under negotiation.



In May 2010, an international flotilla of six ships, known as the Gaza Freedom Flotilla, attempted to deliver humanitarian aid and break Israel's naval blockade of Gaza. Israeli forces intercepted the ships in international waters, leading to a raid on the Turkish ship Mavi Marmara, where nine activists were killed (a tenth later died of injuries).

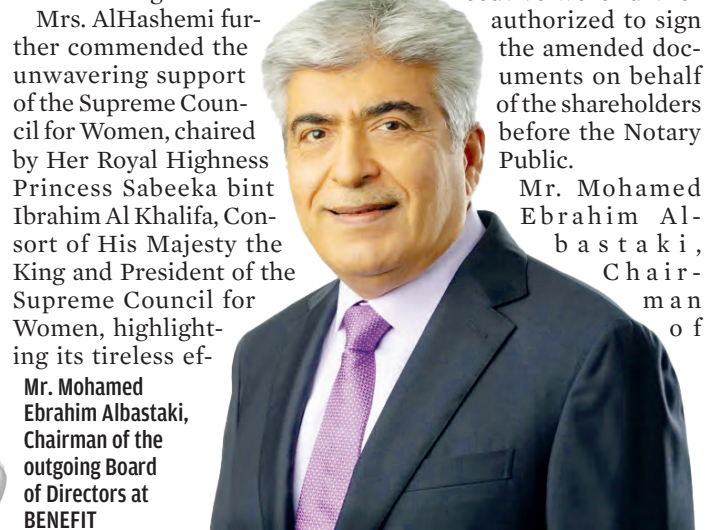

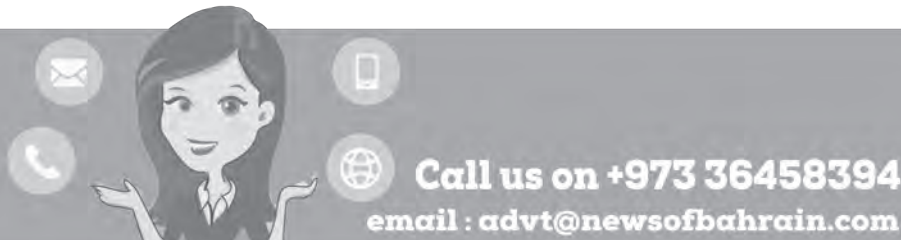
management, water conservation, and the harmful effects of plastic.

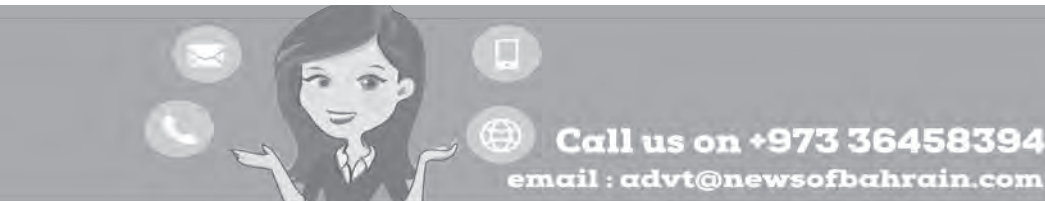

Bahrain is set for a busy night of boxing tomorrow as the GCC Boxing Open Air Event returns to Dilmun Club. Around 30 bouts are scheduled, featuring fighters from Bahrain, Saudi Arabia, the UAE, Qatar, Kuwait, and Oman across youth, junior, and elite divisions.

Building on Last Year

National coach Tony Davis told TDT that this year's tournament is an improvement on the April event.

"We wanted to get more fighters registered, so I reached out to the other nations," Davis said. "We've had over 150 sign-ups. With only one day, we focused on matching the more experienced fighters to make sure every bout is competitive and

"I want two of our boxers to get real ring experience," Davis said. "We'll have Qatar's national team, plus fighters from the UAE and Saudi Arabia. It's a solid test before the Asian Youth Games."

Beyond regional competition, Davis is also preparing his team for another familiar opponent in the British Army.

"We'll face the British Army for the third year in a row," he

said. "HH Shaikh Khalid attended the last two, and this event sets us up for the Royal Rumble IV, which includes the British Army, Royal Air Force, and Royal Navy."

Davis reflected on the growth of boxing in Bahrain over the last six and a half years. "Back in 2018-2019, there wasn't much competitive boxing. Now, the level of events and fighters shows how far we've come. Not many people can put these events on — we've had five world champions involved, some still active, others part of DAZN commentary. It's a strong position for the sport here."

He also revealed to the Daily Tribune that he will be stepping down as Bahrain National Boxing Coach after the Asian Youth Games, ending a remarkable chapter in which he has transformed the sport in the kingdom.

Bahrain will field 25 boxers in tomorrow's event, including four national team members: Maryam Khamis, Israel Davis, Prakash Limbu, and Mohamed Mehdi Sahak.

India to play 'grinding cricket' in West Indies Tests

India captain Shubman Gill said yesterday that his team plans to grind down the opposition on turning pitches as they begin their home season with two Tests against the West Indies.

The opening Test starts Thursday at the world's largest cricket stadium in Ahmedabad, with India strong favourites for a 2-0 series win.

A young Indian team under Gill showed promise in a 2-2 draw during their five-Test series in England, which concluded in August.

That series was Gill's first as captain -- and the first without greats Virat Kohli, Rohit Sharma and Ravichandran Ashwin, who have all retired.

The 26-year-old said Indian pitches present a distinct challenge.

"We are looking to play some hard grinding cricket," Gill told reporters.

He pointed out that in recent years Tests in India rarely took the full five days, in contrast to England, where the Tests "went pretty deep".

But Gill said India was not

"looking for any easy (way) out options" and insisted the team had "the skill-set to be able to play on any kind of wicket, or any situation."

India's ploy of offering rank turners backfired last year when New Zealand swept the hosts 3-0 in Tests.

Gill said the pitches against the West Indies would offer the teams better balance between bat and ball.

"We would be looking to play on wickets that offer both to the batsmen and to the bowlers," said Gill.

'Normal' Sinner thrashes Tien in Beijing for 21st title

Jannik Sinner won the 21st title of his career by thrashing American teenager Learner Tien 6-2, 6-2 in the China Open final yesterday.

The Italian lifted the trophy for the second time on Beijing's hard courts, having done so on his tournament debut in 2023, and a return to world number one is within view.

Sinner's only ever loss on the centre Diamond Court has been to great rival and top-ranked Carlos Alcaraz, who won last year's final in three gripping sets.

"A very, very special place for me," said the victorious Sinner, who got past a couple three-set scares and a bout of diarrhoea to reach the final.

Alcaraz was not defending his title in the Chinese capital and on Tuesday won the Japan Open in Tokyo.

Sinner is the third man to win multiple China Open titles, matching Rafael Nadal's record at two but so far well short of Novak Djokovic's six.

"I always say comparing me to Novak, he's in a different league with everything he has achieved in his career," Sinner, a four-time Grand Slam champion, said.

"I'm just a normal 24-year-old who tries to play the best tennis possible."

But he added that his silverware collection has outgrown his home, telling reporters his trophies go "in my parents' place always".

"My apartment is quite small, so there's not a lot of space."

Sinner broke immediately in the first set on the way to outclassing the 19-year-old Tien, who was in his first ATP

final.

The world no. 52 got a rare chance to break in the second game of the second set but Sinner quickly retook control, ending a one-sided match with 10 aces over the 1h 12min final.

"I thought he served well today. Just getting a lot of free points on his serve. I couldn't really get a great read," Tien said.

really tough."

Tien was bidding to become Beijing's lowest-ranked champion in tournament history.

At 19 years and nine months, Tien would also have been the second-youngest American ATP Tour champion since Andy Roddick in 2002.

As it was, he was never really in it, despite some flashes of his rich potential.

"You are showing throughout the whole season what a talent you are," Sinner said in the aftermath.

Sinner's emphatic win was his third title this season, after victories at the Australian Open and Wimbledon.

He may now be able to snatch back the top ranking before the season ends after Alcaraz pulled out of the Shanghai Masters injured on Tuesday.

Swiatek out with a whimper as Navarro stuns top seed in Beijing

Iga Swiatek imploded in the final set as Emma Navarro stunned the top seed and 2023 China Open champion 6-4, 4-6, 6-0 in Beijing yesterday.

The six-time Grand Slam champion hit 70 unforced errors across the 2h 28min struggle, her second most ever in a 1000-level match.

World no. 17 Navarro plays either fellow American Jessica Pegula or Ukrainian Marta Kostyuk in the quarter-finals.
