## Global cultural landmark

# Peace 'shared duty'

H.E. Dr Al Zayani: A secure Middle East requires Palestinian statehood

The second day of the IISS Manama Dialogue 2025 unfolded under the compelling theme "Securing the Gulf: Diplomacy, Economics and Defence", drawing the world's eyes to Bahrain as regional and international leaders united to chart a shared vision for peace, prosperity, and collective security in the Gulf.

The discussion, rich with conviction and clarity, echoed one message across the hall of the Ritz-Carlton Bahrain, security is not a solitary pursuit, it is a shared responsibility.

### Dialogue Over Division

In a powerful address, His Excellency Dr. Abdullatif bin Rashid Al Zayani, Bahrain's Minister of Foreign Affairs, reminded delegates that the foundation of security lies in dialogue, not discord.

"True security cannot be achieved alone," he said, "It must be built on a vision that unites our peoples, where diversity is strength, and peace is a shared duty."

Dr. Al Zayani underscored Bahrain's unwavering belief that diplomacy and cultural under-

standing remain the surest paths to stability.

He spotlighted Bahrain's leadership in regional and global coalitions that combat terrorism, piracy, and cyber threats, including its role as host of the Combined Maritime Forces, a 47-nation coalition safeguarding vital sea lanes in the Gulf and Red Sea.

"Enduring security depends on genuine cooperation," he affirmed, highlighting new milestones such as the Arab Council of Cybersecurity Resilience and the GCC Joint Defence Agreement, which enshrines the principle that an attack on one is an attack on all.

Transitioning to economics, Al Zayani drew a direct line between prosperity and peace.

"Economic development and integration are not luxuries,

Reiterating Bahrain's steadfast stance on Palestine, he warned that "the dream of a secure and prosperous Middle East will remain incomplete until the Palestinian people achieve their legitimate right to statehood."

### Inclusion and Engagement

Sayyid Badr bin Hamad bin Hamood Al Busaidi, Oman's Foreign Minister, took the stage with a message of inclusion, arguing that the Gulf's long-term stability depends on drawing regional powers closer, not pushing them apart.

"Security cannot be achieved through isolation or exclusion," Reflecting on decades of strained relations with Iran, Al

Busaidi urged a new approach, one rooted in engagement and respect. "History has shown that isolating Iran has never delivered peace. Constructive dialogue, however, can," he said, calling for a comprehensive regional security framework that includes every voice, from Iran to Iraq, to address shared threats such as extremism and trafficking.

### Maritime Security and Connectivity

From Europe's vantage point, Georgios Gerapetritis, Greece's Minister of Foreign Affairs, emphasized that the peace and prosperity of the Gulf are inseparable from global stability.

"With one of the longest coastlines in Europe, Greece understands that freedom of navigation is not just a principle,

it's a promise," he said.

Commending recent progress toward peace in Gaza, he praised the mediation efforts of the United States, Egypt, and Qatar. "The silence of the guns, however partial, is the first whisper of hope," he remarked, reaffirming Greece's commitment to a two-state solution and post-conflict reconstruction.

Gerapetritis also celebrated deepening partnerships with Gulf states, from joint defense projects with Saudi Arabia and the UAE to renewable energy cooperation across the region.

Concluding the session, Luigi Di Maio, the European Union's Special Representative for the Gulf Region, offered a forward-looking perspective: "Securing the Gulf begins with the Gulf itself."

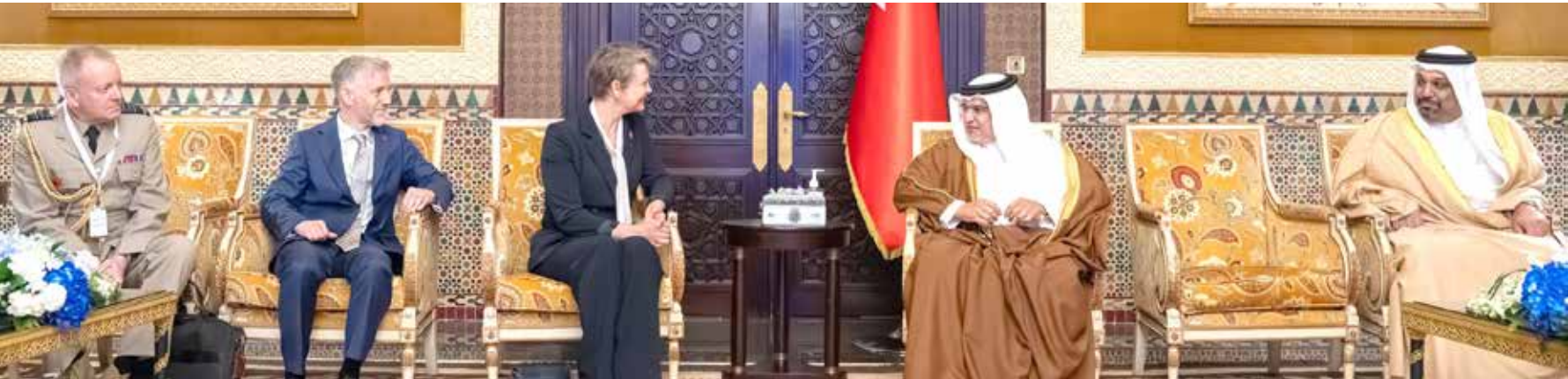

Debt dilemma

● Shura to tackle important issues on international commercial court

Shura Council will take Sup Decree-Laws 8 and 9 of 2024 today to underpin the Bahrain International Commercial Court and review the State's 2023 final account, which shows a wider deficit after over-spending and a 7 per cent rise in public debt.

The Financial and Economic Affairs Committee reports that the non-oil economy grew by 3 per cent in 2023 compared with the 2022 outturn.

Actual spending exceeded the approved budget, which left a larger deficit at year-end.

The committee urges firm steps to rein in expenditure and calls for a tighter debt-management plan to curb further borrowing.

Project costs

It also asks for a review of how ministries and agencies estimate project costs to make better use of public money.

Recurring issues remain: the final account omits a balance sheet and a cash-flow statement and attaches only a receipts-and-payments schedule.

The committee recommends folding the revenues of entities exempt from remitting to the general account into the State's consolidated final account.

Revenue

It notes that the National Audit Office audits revenue and spending chapters but not the annexes, which contain large sums, and that some entities keep breaching their approved limits each year with a rising total.

The Legislative and Legal Affairs Committee, in a separate pair of reports, backs Decree-Law 8 on a set of justice-related treaties and Decree-Law 9 establishing the Bahrain International Commercial Court.

The treaty package is described as the legal base for setting up the court and for it to exercise its powers.

It is intended to bring common rules for exchanging evidence, support recognition of cross-border judgments and agreements, and give friendly settlements international effect.

Measures

The measures also set out a flexible appeal route with an international character for the court's rulings.

The committee says these steps aim to build user trust and strengthen Bahrain's standing as a venue for international commercial dispute resolution.

Global standards

Decree-Law 9 creates a specialised, independent court run to global standards to handle cross-border commercial cases with speed and professionalism and to offer flexible options for parties.

# ‘Historic’ as UK joins C-SIPA to bolster regional security

The Defence Working Group (DWG) has officially welcomed the United Kingdom's accession to the Comprehensive Security Integration and Prosperity Agreement (C-SIPA), marking a significant step toward strengthening regional security and fostering shared prosperity alongside Bahrain and the United States.

The formal welcome ceremony and meeting took place at the Royal Guard Headquarters, under the leadership of His Highness Lieutenant General Shaikh Nasser bin Hamad Al Khalifa, National Security Advisor and Commander of the Royal Guard.

Describing the occasion as a “historic moment,” Shaikh Khalid bin Ali bin Jaber Al Khalifa, Deputy National Security Advisor and Deputy Secretary General of Bahrain's Supreme Defence Council, told the Daily Tribune that the UK's accession to C-SIPA represents a strategic milestone, one that integrates defence co-operation, economic resilience, and technological advancement.

“Today marks the first time the United Kingdom joins Bahrain and the United States in

this framework, reflecting our collective vision for a secure and prosperous region,” said Shaikh Khalid. “C-SIPA is comprehensive by design, it strengthens security cooperation while also enhancing prosperity through innovation, digital infrastruc-

ture, and economic collaboration.”

During the meeting, member states reaffirmed their collective commitment under Article (2) of the agreement, emphasizing that any threat or aggression against one member's sovereignty or territorial integrity would be treated as a matter of grave concern by all.

The discussions underscored C-SIPA's growing importance as a platform for collective security, regional deterrence, and strategic cooperation. Delegates highlighted the need for enhanced coordination to counter external threats and safeguard international stability, reinforcing a shared approach to peace and prosperity in the Gulf.

**Trilateral framework**

His Excellency Alistair Long, the British Ambassador to Bahrain, emphasized that while the trilateral collaboration feels natural, given the long-standing defence ties between the three nations, joining C-SIPA formalizes and strengthens that cooperation even more.

“Practically, it doesn't feel new,” Ambassador Long said. “We've been collaborating closely for years, our naval bases literally operate side by side in Bahrain. But to be in this framework is significant; it gives structure and shared purpose to our co-operation.” He credited Bahrain and the United States for their vision in creating the agreement, which aligns with the UK's belief that security and prosperity are interdependent. Ambassador Long highlighted that C-SIPA also embraces the principles of the international rules-based order, regional inclusivity, and technological advancement.

“This agreement resonates deeply with UK values, it's about building prosperity through security, upholding international norms, and advancing innovation together,” he noted.

# Reckless rage

10-year term upheld for driver who ran down neighbour after sickle threat

● Defendant under influence of drugs

Ten years' jail upheld for a driver who chased a neighbour and deliberately ran him down after threatening him with an iron sickle, the Criminal Court of Appeal ruled.

Appeal judges held that the defendant took narcotics by choice and remains answerable for what followed.

The medical committee found no proof the drug was forced on him, nor that he thought it was anything else.

He is to be punished as if sober, the court added, and the claim that he lacked intent to kill does not change that.

**Abnormal state**

The file states the defendant turned up at the victim's home in an abnormal state.

He looked tense, shouted threats and waved an iron sickle, then left. He later returned to the same area, more aggressive, and chased the victim while holding the same blade.

During the pursuit he smashed a window of the victim's car in view of passers-by.

An eyewitness said he saw the defendant running after the victim with the sickle and shouting that he would kill him.

**Threats**

The witness got the man into a car to calm him, but the defendant fought to get out and kept repeating the threats.

Moments later he moved the vehicle and steered it at the victim. The victim tried to get clear.

The defendant turned the car, accelerated and ran him over, pinning him between vehicles and keeping his foot down.

The witness broke a window, shifted the gear to reverse, cut the engine and pulled the defendant out, while the defendant kept shouting that he would kill the victim.

Medical reports recorded severe injuries, including fractures to both legs caused by strong crush force. Doctors warned such injuries can be fatal if complications arise.

Investigators reported the defendant had recurring family disputes and used narcotics, leaving him quick to anger and violent in conduct. He admitted taking psychotropic substances and causing the incident, adding he could not recall the details because of the drug's effect. Records showed a previous conviction for drug use.

**Maximum penalty**

In court, the Public Prosecution sought the maximum penalty, citing the risk he poses and the need for deterrence.

It charged him with attempted murder for first trying to assault the victim with an iron sickle and then running him over to take his life, causing injuries. The acts came with the felony of using psychotropic substances at the same time and place, and with wilful damage to the victim's property.



His Excellency General Shaikh Rashid bin Abdullah Al Khalifa, Minister of Interior, noted that the IISS Manama Dialogue is among the most prominent international forums hosted by Bahrain, distinguished by its high level of organisation and participation, reflecting the Kingdom's global standing. ## Bahrain retail sales up 2pct in Q1 2025

3.1% yearly rise projected to 2028

The Gulfbase.com says the growth points to continued improvement in commercial activity within the domestic economy.

Bahrain’s retail sales are expected to grow at a compound annual rate of about 3.1 per cent from 2023 to 2028, according to an Alpen Capital study on the GCC retail market.

The firm says the wholesale and retail sector posted real growth of 2 per cent in the first quarter of 2025 and, drawing on its indicators and published state data, projects annual growth of roughly 3 per cent through 2028.

A separate note on Gulfbase.com reports that wholesale and retail activity in Bahrain rose by 2 per cent year on year in 2025.

The site says this points to continued improvement in commercial activity within the domestic economy.

### Drivers

Both sources cite similar drivers: rising household spending power, wider e-commerce use, and upgrades to

retail infrastructure.

They add that the spread of newer shopping centres and a deeper digital shift are expected to support growth in the years ahead.

The analysis states that the next phase requires stronger digital systems across wholesale and retail, wider online marketing channels, and improved logistics and point-of-sale set-ups.

Constraints remain. The reports list the small market size, regional competition, operating cost pressures, and global supply-chain factors as the main challenges.

## Bahrain to witness ‘Supermoon’ on Nov. 5

The Kingdom of Bahrain will be treated to a spectacular celestial event on Wednesday evening, November 5, 2025, when the full moon of Jumada Al-Awwal 1447 AH occurs.

On the same night, the moon will reach its perigee, its closest point to Earth, at an estimated distance of 356,840 kilometres — the nearest the full moon will come to the planet during 2025.

Astronomical researcher Mohammed Redha Al Asfoor explained that this alignment creates the “Supermoon” phenomenon, making the moon appear approximately 14% larger and 30% brighter than when it is at its farthest point from Earth, known as the apogee or “Micro Moon.”

Al Asfoor added that the moon will reach 100% fullness at 4:19 pm local time, rising in the skies of Bahrain at 4:36 pm, just before sunset.

### Visible

It will remain visible to the

naked eye throughout the night, setting at 6:37 am the following morning after sunrise.

# China to exempt some Nexperia chips from export ban

Netherlands invoked a Cold War-era law to take control of Nexperia

- China, in response, banned any re-exports of Nexperia chips to Europe
- Berlin welcomed Beijing's move as a "positive sign"
- Nexperia produces relatively simple technologies such as diodes, voltage regulators and transistors

China said yesterday it will exempt some Nexperia chips from an export ban that was imposed over a row with Dutch officials and has alarmed European businesses. Anxiety over chip shortages began when the Netherlands invoked a Cold War-era law in late September to effectively take control of Nexperia, whose parent company Wingtech is backed by the Chinese government. China, in response, banned

any re-exports of Nexperia chips to Europe and accused the United States of meddling in Dutch legal procedures to remove Nexperia's Chinese CEO. Beijing blamed what it said on Saturday was "the Dutch government's improper intervention in the internal affairs of enterprises" for leading to "the current chaos in the global

supply chain". "We will comprehensively consider the actual situation of enterprises and grant exemptions to exports that meet the criteria," a Chinese commerce ministry spokesperson said in a statement, without offering specifics. The resumption of some Nexperia shipments was part of a

trade deal agreed by Chinese President Xi Jinping and his US counterpart Donald Trump after talks in South Korea on Thursday, the Wall Street Journal reported, citing unidentified sources. Chinese and European Union officials were also to discuss Nexperia while meeting in Brussels, EU spokesman Olof Gill had

said. Those talks on Friday were "a welcome opportunity for both sides to update on... the introduction and implementation of export controls", Gill said in a statement on Saturday. The discussions covered "controls on rare earth elements introduced or proposed by China, as well as an update on controls and developments on the EU side", he said. The statement did not mention Nexperia specifically. Separately, Berlin welcomed Beijing's move as a "positive sign" on Saturday. "The latest reports from China are positive initial signs of an easing of tensions," an economy ministry spokesman told AFP. He stressed that "a final assessment" of the implications of Beijing's announcement was not yet possible.

### Automaker anxiety

Nexperia produces relatively simple technologies such as diodes, voltage regulators and transistors that are nonetheless crucial as vehicles increasingly rely on electronics. Its chips are mainly found in cars but also in a wide range of industrial components, as well

as consumer and mobile electronics such as refrigerators. The company makes them in Europe before sending them to China for finishing and then re-exporting them back to European clients. European carmakers and parts suppliers had warned of shortages of chips supplied by Nexperia that would force stoppages at production lines in Europe. The chipmaker supplies 49 percent of the electronic components used in the European automotive industry, according to German financial daily Handelsblatt. The European auto lobby ACEA warned last month that production would be seriously hit. Nexperia's chips, while widely used, are not "unique" in terms of technology and therefore "easily substitutable", French parts maker Opmobility said. However, suppliers must get the new products approved by automakers, which takes time. Beijing suggested on Saturday that some shipments would resume. Companies experiencing difficulties could contact the commerce ministry or local authorities, the Chinese spokesperson said.

## Food stamps, the bulwark against hunger for over 40 mn Americans

The ongoing budget deadlock in the United States is threatening food security of around 42 million Americans who receive food stamps at the start of each month to help get by. The US Department of Agriculture had said that no money could be paid out on Saturday due to the shutdown. But on Friday, a federal judge helped ease some of the uncertainty at the last minute by ordering the government to use emergency funds to ensure the continuity of the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), which has helped low-income Americans for more

than 60 years. The idea that SNAP assistance could be paused is "truly unprecedented," Meredith Niles, a professor specializing in food policy at the University of Vermont, told AFP. "This has never happened in more than 50 years of the program, despite numerous other government shutdowns," she said. Here's how SNAP works, and what its absence could mean for those affected.

### How does it work?

While food stamps date back to the 1930s during the Great Depression, the SNAP program was created in 1964 and expanded nationwide in 1974, according

to Niles from the University of Vermont. Today, around one-in-eight Americans receive SNAP benefits each month based on income, according to the Department of Agriculture. This costs the federal budget nearly \$100 billion. Beneficiaries have a payment card, similar to a debit card, which they can use in supermarkets, grocery stores, and some farmers' markets. The cards are usually reloaded automatically on the first day of the month. To qualify for SNAP, along with being low-income, recipients must meet certain requirements

-- which can vary from working at least 30 hours a week to being medically deemed unable to work due to disability. "It is an important program for many Americans," Niles said, adding that recipients receive an average of around \$6 per person day. Every day items like fruit, vegetables, canned goods, chips, and pasta are covered by SNAP, while alcohol and pre-prepared meals are not. From January 2026, around ten states also plan to exclude the purchase of soft drinks using SNAP vouchers.

cellence and develop partnerships with leading universities in the region. News in brief

◆ **Indian Sikh** pilgrims have been issued visas for neighbouring Pakistan, the first major allowance after travel between the arch-rival nations was frozen during conflict in May. here was no immediate response from New Delhi, but Indian newspapers reported on Saturday that the government would allow "selected" groups to travel for a 10-day festival to celebrate the founder of the Sikh faith. Tensions remain high between New Delhi and Islamabad, after deadly clashes between the nuclear-armed rivals in May -- the worst fighting since 1999. The Pakistan High Commission in New Delhi said it had issued "over 2,100 visas to Sikh pilgrims from India". Tens of thousands of Sikh pilgrims are expected to flock to Pakistan's city of Nankana Sahib, the birthplace of Guru Nanak. Nankana Sahib lies 85 kilometres (52 miles) west of the border with India. Celebrations are expected to begin on Tuesday.

Over half a million Syrians have returned home from Turkey: Ankara

◆ **Some 550,000 Syrian** refugees in Turkey have returned home following the fall of Bashar al-Assad last December, Turkey's Interior Minister Ali Yerlikaya said yesterday. Almost 2.4 million Syrian refugees remain in Turkey, he said, from the high of more than 3.5 million Syrians who had sheltered there at one point. The UN refugee agency on Friday said that 1.16 million Syrians had returned to the country after Assad's regime fell on December 8, 2024, and some 1.9 million internally displaced people had been able to return to their homes. According to the UN, more than seven million Syrians continue to be internally displaced, and some 4.5 million refugees remain abroad.

◆ **A woman arrested** this week along with four other suspects over the unprecedented jewel heist at the Louvre on Saturday appeared before a magistrate who will decide whether to detain her. The 38-year-old woman was in tears as she confirmed that she lives in the northern La Courneuve suburb of Paris, an AFP journalist said. She has been charged with complicity in organised theft and criminal conspiracy with a view to committing a crime. At the request of the prosecution, the hearing continued behind closed doors. Earlier Saturday, the Paris public prosecutor's office did not specify how many suspects would be brought before the court. Last month, thieves wielding power tools raided the Louvre, the world's most visited art museum, in broad daylight, taking just seven minutes to steal jewellery worth an estimated \$102 million.

China sends youngest astronaut, mice to space station

A crew of three Chinese astronauts, including the country's youngest-ever, docked early Saturday at the Tiangong space station, accompanied by four lab mice.

The Shenzhou-21 spaceship docked at 3:22 am (1922 GMT Friday), China's state news agency Xinhua reported.

That was about three-and-a-half hours after the spaceship departed from the Jiuquan Satellite Launch Center in northwest China, powered aloft by a Long March-2F rocket.

The Tiangong space station -- crewed by teams of three astronauts that are exchanged every six months -- is the crown jewel of China's

space programme, into which billions of dollars have been poured in a bid to catch up with the United States and Russia.

China has bold plans to send a crewed mission to the Moon by the end of the decade and eventually to build a base on the lunar surface.

Mission commander and veteran space pilot Zhang Lu is accompanied by 32-year-old flight engineer Wu Fei, China's youngest astronaut to undertake a space mission, and payload specialist Zhang Hongzhang, 39. The three astronauts waved goodbye to colleagues and family members at the remote launch base in the Gobi Desert as a band played a patriotic song.

Israel says latest Gaza remains not hostages

Hamas reports strikes

Israel said yesterday that three bodies it received from Gaza the night before were not hostages held in the Palestinian territory, as a Hamas security

source reported fresh strikes in the south.

Despite occasional flare-ups, a fragile truce has been holding in Gaza since October 10, based on a US-brokered deal centred on the return of all Israeli hostages, both living and dead.

Israel's military told AFP that a forensic analysis revealed that three bodies it received via the Red Cross on Friday were not those of any of the deceased captives still to be handed over as part of the ceasefire deal.

Hamas's armed wing said Saturday that it had handed over bodies it had not positively identified, alleging Israel had declined its offer to provide samples for testing and "demanded the bodies for examination".

"We handed them over to preempt any enemy claims," the

Ezzedine Al-Qassam Brigades said.

After the start of the truce, Hamas returned the 20 surviving hostages still in its custody and began the process of returning the remains of the dead.

Of the 17 bodies returned since the start of the ceasefire, 15 were Israelis, one was Thai and one was Nepalese.

Hamas has also returned another unidentified body that had not been listed among the 28 missing, as well as the partial remains of a deceased Israeli hostage who had already been recovered early in the war.

That incident drew outrage in Israel, which said the group had violated the agreement by returning the partial remains rather than the body of another hostage.

Israel has accused Hamas of not returning the dead hostages quickly enough, but the Palestinian group says it will take time to locate remains buried in Gaza's ruins.

In its statement Saturday, the Al-Qassam Brigades called on mediators and the Red Cross to provide the "necessary equipment and personnel to work on recovering all the bodies simultaneously".

'Warships opened fire'

Hamas and Israel, meanwhile, have traded accusations of breaking the ceasefire.

A Hamas security source told AFP on Saturday that Israel had carried out several air strikes in the south at dawn, and that "warships opened fire toward the shores of Khan Yunis".

Thousands feared 'in grave danger' in Sudan's El-Fasher after fall to RSF

Thousands of civilians are feared trapped and in imminent danger in the Sudanese city of El-Fasher after its fall to paramilitaries, Doctors Without Borders said Saturday, as Germany's top diplomat described the situation there as "apocalyptic".

At war with the regular army since April 2023, the Rapid Support Forces seized El-Fasher on Sunday, pushing the military out of its last stronghold in Darfur after a grinding 18-month siege marked by starvation and bombardment. Since the city's fall,



RSF members reportedly detaining a fighter known as Abu Lulu (L) in El-Fasher, in war-torn Sudan's western Darfur region. In a statement late on October 30, the RSF said it had detained several fighters accused of "violations that occurred during the liberation" of the city, including Lulu who appeared in multiple videos on his TikTok committing summary executions.

reports have emerged of summary executions, sexual violence, attacks on aid workers, looting and abductions, while communications remain largely cut off. Survivors from El-Fasher who reached the nearby town of Tawila have told AFP of mass killings, children shot before their parents, and civilians beaten and robbed as they fled.

The UN says more than 65,000 people have fled El-Fasher since Sunday but tens of thousands remain trapped. Around 260,000 people were in the city before the RSF's final assault.

US not sending any high-level officials to COP30

The United States will not send any top officials to the COP30 climate talks in Brazil later this month, a White House official said yesterday, as President Donald Trump instead works to boost fossil fuels.

Trump, who withdrew from the Paris climate agreement for a second time upon his return to the White House in January, had not been expected to attend a leaders' summit ahead of the annual UN climate conference in Belem.

But it now appears he will not dispatch any top negotiators to the talks, to be held from November 10 to 21, either.

"The US is not sending any high level representatives to COP30," a White House official said on condition of anonymity.

"The president is directly engaging with leaders around the world on energy issues, which you can see from the historic trade deals and peace deals that all have a significant focus on energy partnerships."

Brazil said Friday that fewer



than 60 world leaders have confirmed they will attend the climate summit on November 6-7 -- held separately this year to ease accommodation pressures.

The leaders of France, Germany, the United Kingdom, the Netherlands, Norway, Colombia, Chile, Cape Verde and Liberia will attend, their governments have confirmed to AFP.

China has said Vice Premier Ding Xuexiang will represent President Xi Jinping.

While Trump also exited the Par-



in his first term, his administration has gone further this time, exerting its clout to boost fossil fuels globally.

This includes, for example, threatening countries with retaliatory measures if they agreed to a carbon pricing system by the UN's International Maritime Organization, effectively curtailing its implementation.

Climate advocates fear the administration could seek to withdraw from the UN Framework Convention on Climate Change -- the treaty that underpins the Paris Agreement.

Doing so could prevent future administrations from re-entering the deal, but it is not clear if the executive branch has the legal authority to undo a Senate-ratified treaty.

Lower level participation

While Trump's administration appears to be ignoring the summit, more than 100 state and local US leaders -- including governors and mayors -- are still expected to join the talks.

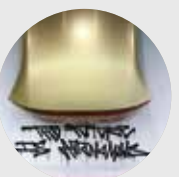

# South Korea hosts Xi as Chinese leader rekindles fraught ties

The talks on the sidelines of the APEC gathering

● Lee welcomed Xi at a grand opening ceremony

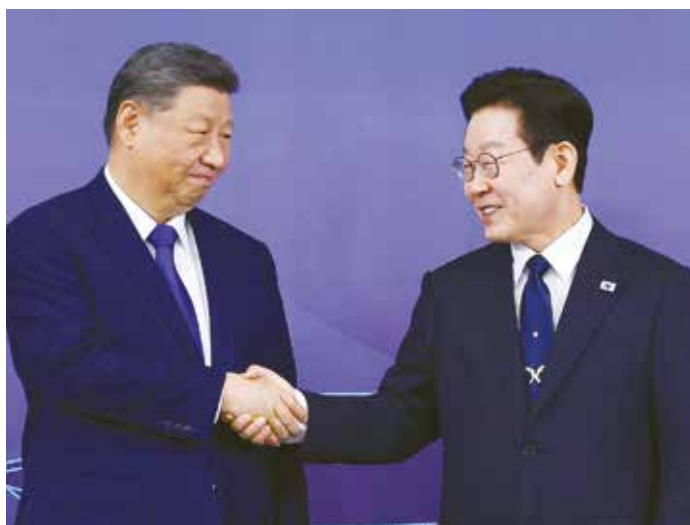
South Korean President Lee Jae Myung hosted Xi Jinping for their first meeting yesterday as the Chinese head of state took centre stage and reforged old ties at an Asian summit from which US leader Donald Trump was largely absent.

The talks on the sidelines of the APEC gathering came on the final day of Xi's first trip to South Korea in more than a decade and a day after his meeting with Canada's premier reset damaged ties.

Trump flew to South Korea for the summit but promptly jettied home on Thursday after sealing a trade war pause with Xi, the pair agreeing to dial down a dispute that has roiled markets and disrupted global supply chains.

His departure left the Chinese leader to take centre stage at the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation summit, where he framed Beijing as a responsible power against the chaos unleashed by the United States on the international order.

Lee welcomed Xi at a grand

opening ceremony complete with soldiers wearing traditional garb. The visit was the Chinese leader's first since 2014 and comes after years of strained ties over everything from trade to cultural disputes.

Lee told Xi he had "long looked forward to meeting you in person" and framed his trip as a reset in relations.

"As our two countries move from a vertical structure of economic cooperation to a more horizontal and mutually beneficial one, we must work together to build a relationship that delivers shared prosperity," Lee told Xi, whose vast economy represents South Korea's largest trading partner.

Xi, in turn, described China and South Korea as "important neighbours that cannot be moved and also partners that cannot be separated".

He told Lee that the two countries should "respect each other's societal differences and development paths... (and) re-

solve contradictions and disagreements through friendly consultation", according to Chinese state broadcaster CCTV.



South Korea and China had renewed their 70 trillion won (\$49 billion) currency swap agreement for another five years, and hoped the deal would "help stabilise the financial and foreign exchange markets of both countries".

The two countries also signed several MOUs, including on a joint response to voice phishing and online scams

## Know your Personal Data Privacy Rights

Not many people know that there is a Personal Data Protection Authority (PDPA) in Bahrain which enforces the provisions of the Personal Data Protection Law of 2018 which protects individual privacy and data security. Because we have fingertip-access to all kinds of tools for recording others on audio and video, we tend to take the responsibility of protecting personal security lightly. We think nothing of photographing somebody across a room or a street and uploading the photo on social media. Or else, we record personal transactions with individuals on our phones and use it as an official record that stays in corporate or our own digital files.

All this is done casually without the understanding of privacy violation. You may order a pizza delivery and have your photo clicked to confirm completion of the delivery. That photo will remain in the pizza company's digital records and also in the delivery person's mobile phone and may be shared without your consent. Or you may be in a group class for stretching and mobility and be photographed or videographed without your permission. These are everyday occasions when we overstep the personal privacy boundary.

Bahrain takes cyber protection very seriously and laws are implemented vigorously. However, there is a gap in building awareness of personal data privacy rights. Neither the person being captured on devices nor the one who is actually capturing the data are aware that they are violating the law. And photos and videos are not the only ways in which personal privacy is infringed. Do you know that if you share a text-message screen-grab or an audio clip of a conversation without the express permission of all parties involved, you are violating PDP laws?

We have a prosperous and state-of-the-art telecoms industry. This sector must take the lead in conducting awareness drives about PDP. We need to mobilise clubs and schools for this so that all age groups are sensitized to the matter. It is something we will all have to actively shape with awareness and by respecting the rules.

# Egypt set to open grand museum in lavish ceremony

After years of delays, Cairo is finally set to open the Grand Egyptian Museum on Saturday -- a long-awaited, billion-dollar showcase of pharaonic grandeur that Egypt hopes will help revive tourism and boost its troubled economy.

Seventy-nine delegations, including 39 heads of state and government, are expected at the ceremony, which begins at 7:30 pm local time (1730 GMT).

Germany, Japan, Saudi Arabia, Belgium, Spain and Denmark will be among those sending representatives, according to a statement from the Egyptian presidency.

In the nights leading up to the opening, shafts of light have illuminated both the pyramids and the museum's colossal facade -- a prelude to Saturday's spectacle.

Set on a gentle slope overlooking the Giza Plateau, just beyond the shadow of the pyramids, the museum was built with major financial and technical support from Japan, and spreads across nearly half a million square metres.

It houses more than 100,000

artefacts, half of which will be on display, making it the world's largest collection devoted to a single civilisation, according to Egyptian officials.

Inside, visitors will enter vast, light-filled halls with soaring ceilings and sand-coloured stone walls that echo the sur-

rounding desert.

At the centre of the main atrium stands an 83-tonne statue of Ramses II, the pharaoh who ruled Egypt for 66 years and presided over its golden age.

Unlike the cramped, century-old Egyptian Museum in central Cairo, the Grand Egyptian

Museum (GEM) features immersive galleries, precision lighting, virtual-reality exhibits and even a children's museum.

One highlight is a live conservation lab, visible through floor-to-ceiling glass, where visitors can watch restorers assembling a 4,500-year-old solar boat buried near Khufu's pyramid, built to carry his soul across the sky with the sun god Ra.

The undisputed star of the show, however, is King Tutankhamun's collection of more than 5,000 objects, many displayed together for the first time.

Details of the boy pharaoh's gold mask display remain under wraps.

The museum opens to the public on Tuesday, showcasing thousands of funerary artefacts previously scattered across Egypt.

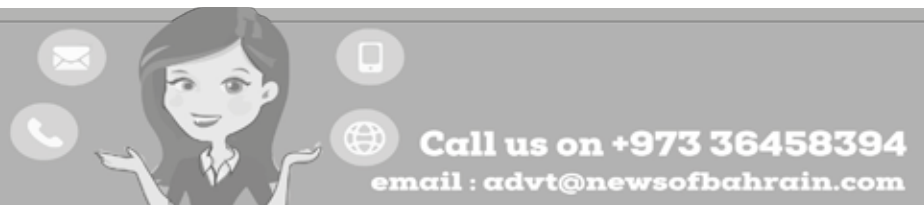

# India captain Kaur sees World Cup final as possible turning point

Winning the ODI World Cup could be a turning point for the women's game in cricket-crazy India, captain Harmanpreet Kaur said on Saturday, and encourage more girls to take the field.

Hosts India face South Africa in the final in Mumbai on Sunday, with both teams hoping to win the women's one-day showpiece for the first time in its 52-year history.

India have been runners-up twice, in 2005 and 2017, and reached their third final after beating seven-time champions Australia in a thriller.

"Last time when we reached the final and came back to India, we saw a big change," Kaur told reporters.

"Women's cricket moved ahead and we saw many girls

on the ground. So I am sure that if we win this final, we will see many more changes and we will see more cricket, not only on the international level but also on the domestic level."

"So I think we are really looking forward to that moment when we will see women's cricket in a more serious manner and we will see more girls (playing)," she said.

Indian players like Kaur and Smriti Mandhana have become household names in the world's most populous nation since the Women's Premier League T20 tournament began in 2023.

Jemimah Rodrigues played a champion's knock with an unbeaten 127 to help India chase down a record 339 against Australia in Thursday's semi-final.

"I think it's a proud mo-

ment for me and the entire team," Kaur said.

"I am sure the entire country must be also very proud of the way we have played the last two games and, yeah, it's a big day."

South Africa, led by Laura Wolvaardt, beat four-time winners England to reach their first ODI World Cup final.

Wolvaardt said the pressure on the home team could work in South Africa's favour.

"I think with the whole crowd behind India, probably a sold-out stadium, it's going to be a very exciting opportunity," Wolvaardt said.

"But at the same time,

I think it puts a lot of pressure on them as well. So yeah, I think it sort of plays in our favour, hopefully."

Kaur said a new winner will be good for the sport.

"Because of that we are seeing more excitement," she said. "And for us to reach the final is also very special, not only for us but for the Indian fans who have been a big support for us."

## Diomande dazzles as Leipzig go two points behind Bayern

Robert Leipzig's teenage forward Yan Diomande scored one goal and forced another as his side beat Stuttgart 3-1 at home on Saturday to move to two points behind Bayern Munich.

Leipzig returned to second spot after Dortmund had leapfrogged the Red Bulls with a 1-0 win at Augsburg on Friday.

Leipzig and Stuttgart enjoyed several chances in an exciting opening half before Diomande forced a breakthrough just before halftime.

The 18-year-old Ivorian dribbled down the right and delivered a low cross which Stuttgart defender Jeff Chabot turned into his own net.

Eight minutes into the second half, Diomande danced through three Stuttgart defenders before blasting a low shot into the bottom corner.

Tiago Tomas scored for Stuttgart to cut Leipzig's lead but Romero made sure of the win when he pounced on a error from visiting goalkeeper Alexander Nuebel and tapped home.

Leipzig were thumped 6-0 by Bayern in their league opener but since then have claimed 22 of a possible 24 points in

the league.

League leaders Bayern can return the gap to five points with a win at home against Bayer Leverkusen later on Saturday.

Diomande was one of an array of talented newcomers to join Leipzig in the summer as the club focused on youth in Jurgen Klopp's first transfer window as football coordinator of Leipzig's parent company Red Bull.

Frankfurt's struggles continued with a 1-1 draw at last-placed Heidenheim, days after Dortmund booted them out of the German Cup.

Frankfurt's Danish defender Rasmus Kristensen scored in the second half to cancel out Budu Zivzivadze's opener.

The draw leaves Eintracht in sixth, having won just once in their past seven matches in all competitions.

Union Berlin and Freiburg played out a scoreless draw in the German capital, with both sides having goals struck off by VAR.

Elsewhere, Borussia Munchengladbach won their first match of the season with a double from Haris Tabakovic in a 4-0 victory at St Pauli.

Jens Stage scored an equaliser with four minutes left as Werder Bremen snatched a 1-1 draw at lowly Mainz.

## Social media fooled by AI video of 'sky stadium' for Saudi 2034 World Cup

An AI-generated video claiming to show one of the football stadiums for the 2034 FIFA World Cup in Saudi Arabia made waves on social media this week -- but it has nothing to do with the kingdom's official plans.

The video of glowing arena built atop a towering skyscraper was shared by thousands of social media accounts, with millions of users believing it was the official visual revealed by Saudi Arabia.

While Riyadh has unveiled plans to build a football area on top of a real estate complex in The Line -- a futuristic new megacity project -- the official plans bear no resemblance to the clip that went viral in recent days.

"This design is completely fake and bears no resemblance

to anything Saudi Arabia is planning. It appears in no official sources," a source close to the matter told AFP.

Several French media outlets, which had referred

to the viral video as a representation of the kingdom's official project, have since deleted or updated their articles.

AFP's digital investigation team traced the video

to the Instagram account "hyporaultraworks", which regularly posts AI-generated content of futuristic stadiums.

The video was described as "an aerial flyby of a skyscraper stadium design" in the caption.

The account holder told AFP on Friday that they were the original creator of the viral clip.

"What started as a simple AI concept has taken on a life of its own -- over 50 million views later, our 'Sky Stadium' design has gone global (and slightly off the rails)," the user also wrote on their Facebook page.

"I had no idea about any Saudi project when I made this," they said, adding it was "purely an imaginative AI concept, exploring what a vertical, skyscraper-style football stadium could look like."
