New York

You've probably heard the word near-daily since March. It has dominated nearly every corner of the world since then. And there's no better word to sum up the unbelievable year that was 2020.

"Pandemic" is the Word of the Year for both Merriam-Webster and Dictionary.com.

It informed top searches on both sites and reshaped the language we use daily, both companies said.

Merriam-Webster, the dictionary publisher, said people looked up "pandemic" with "remarkable frequency" throughout the year - particularly on March 11, when the World Health Organization officially declared Covid-19 a pandemic. On that day, searches for "pandemic" spiked 115,806% compared to the same day in 2019.

Bahrain reports no new deaths from coronavirus

Bahrain reported zero COVID-19 deaths in the past 24 hours and 181 new cases yesterday, according to the Health Ministry.

The Kingdom's death toll currently stands at 341 and total cases at 87,137.

Health authorities also reported 216 additional recoveries.

Following 10,503 tests conducted yesterday, the fresh infections included 91 expatriate workers, 81 contacts, and nine travellers.

Bahrain yesterday celebrated the Bahraini Women's Day 2020 as a glorious national event launched in 2008 by Her Royal Highness Princess Sabeeka bint Ibrahim Al Khalifa, Wife of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa and President of the Supreme Council for Women.

The theme of the occasion was "I read, learned, participated" to mark Bahraini women's partnership in building the nation.

Over the 12 years since its launch, the celebration has gained in significance and glamour as Bahraini women have entered new important areas with boldness and courage.

They have competently and deservedly served their families and country and helped, alongside men, promote national prosperity and development within a civilised Bahraini society in which the standards of competitiveness, sustainability

and balance are strengthened among genders.

Under HRH Princess Sabeeka's initiative, the theme of Bahraini Women's Day 2020 was devoted to celebrating women in diplomacy.

She drew up a clear action plan for the Supreme Council for Women (SCW) to shed light on the progress of women in diplomatic action by clarifying the dimensions and effects of their participation and contributions on enriching the field and enhancing Bahrain's international standing.

Despite the exceptional circumstances imposed by the COVID-19 pandemic on Bahrain and the world, the SCW has worked hard to celebrate in a manner that befits the achievements, progress and dedication of Bahraini women while taking all precautionary measures.

The council has organised throughout the year many events that included meetings and focus groups and in cooperation with partners, in particular the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Mohammed bin Mubarak Al Khalifa Academy for Diplomatic Studies. Several Bahraini diplomatic missions abroad also organised similar events.

The story of diplomacy in Bahrain as a sovereign country started in September 1971, when the flag of the country was hoisted at the headquarters of the United Nations for the first time, marking Bahrain's joining formally the UN as a full member state.

Since then, Bahrain worked successfully on strengthening and expanding its network of



diplomatic relations and consolidating its presence internationally.

Bahraini women were not late in catching up with the progress in the diplomatic field as they joined the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 1972. A Bahraini woman was appointed as advisor in the Permanent Mission to the United Nations in 1988, as the third secretary in the Department of Arab Affairs in 1991 and as the second secretary in the Department of the Gulf Cooperation Council in 1992.

Soon after he assumed power in 1999, HM King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa accorded special attention to Bahraini women.

In 2001, he appointed the first woman ambassador to France and non-resident ambassador to Belgium, Switzerland, Spain and permanent delegate to UNESCO.

The first female plenipotentiary minister was appointed in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 2001 and the first woman member of the Advisory Board of the Supreme Council of the Gulf Cooperation Council was appointed in 2003.

In 2006, a Bahraini woman was nominated as President of the General Assembly of the United Nations, becoming the first Arab and Muslim woman to hold this high-level position.

A year later, the second woman ambassador in Bahrain's history was appointed in China and a woman was appointed as the Chargé d'Affaires of the Bah-

raini embassy in Kuwait with the rank of advisor.

In 2008, a third Bahraini woman was appointed ambassador to the US and three years later, a fourth ambassador was appointed to the United Kingdom.

In 2011, a Bahraini woman was appointed as assistant undersecretary for Arab, Afro-Asian affairs and organisations at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs before she became in

2017 the undersecretary of the ministry in a precedent in the Arab world.

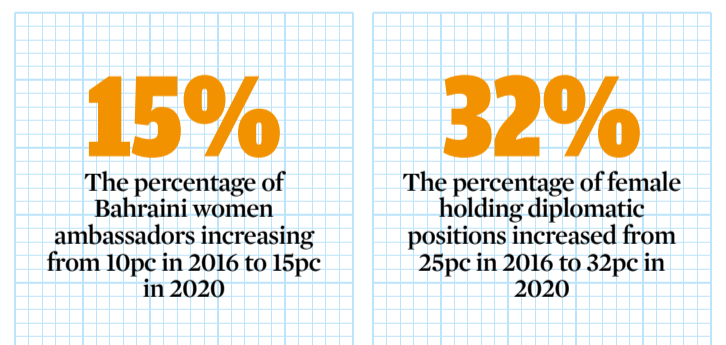
In 2012, a Bahraini woman was appointed as the director of the Department of Americas Affairs at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and two years later, another Bahraini woman was appointed to head the European affairs at the ministry.

In 2015, the fifth woman ambassador was appointed to Belgium, Luxembourg and Denmark and as Representative of Bahrain in the European Union and NATO.

In 2016, an executive director was appointed at the Shaikh Mohammed bin Mubarak Academy for Diplomatic Studies with the rank of Assistant Undersecretary, and in 2017, four more women were appointed as directors at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

Lifetime risk of diabetes 'alarming'

Studies show it's preventable but a leading cause of death worldwide today

● A Sedentary lifestyle is the primary indicator for the incidence of this health problem

Fast-related stories are spilling out of the headlines, spreading like mayonnaise over the pages of various newspapers and magazines.

Diabetes, an incurable condition in which the body can't break down sugars in the blood and hardening of the blood vessels, is a major public health problem that is approaching epidemic proportions globally, according to the World Health Organization (WHO).

Worldwide, the prevalence of chronic, non-communicable diseases is increasing at an alarming rate.

About 18 million people die every year from cardiovascular disease, for which diabetes and hypertension are major predisposing factors.

Today, more than 1.7 billion adults worldwide are overweight, and 312 million of them are obese. Besides, at least 155 million children worldwide are overweight or obese. A diabetes epidemic is underway.

In the Kingdom of Bahrain, about 15% of those surveyed by the National Health Survey have

diabetes.

Indeed, it is the sedentary lifestyle which is the primary indicator for the incidence of diabetes.

There were other contributing factors that cause diabetes such as spending a great deal of time indoors, having little access to sports and other physical activities, socialising frequently where eating is the main activity, repeated pregnancy and employing maids to do housework.

Practically speaking, no one is immune. We now know that diabetes is a greater health problem today than drinking or even smoking.

WHO experts believe diabetes will soon be the number one cause of all preventable deaths in the world. Not cigarette smoking or drug use, but diabetes.

Chronic medical problems caused by diabetes include almost all modern diseases: high blood pressure, stroke, blindness, gallbladder problems, sleep apnoea, gout – the list just goes on and on.

People around the world are struggling with diabetes more than ever.

What is to blame for this health problem?

We are told this is how we should eat: breakfast like a king, lunch like a prince, and dinner like a pauper.

But in today's fast-paced world, few have the time to enjoy a big breakfast or prepare a nutritious lunch. Most of us resort to fast-food options during the day, grabbing something quick to eat while scurrying off to a meeting. Fastfood chains

are popping up everywhere and people are struggling to resist the temptation.

The main home-cooked meal is now consumed in the evening, when little if any physical activity follows. The inevitable consequence: more and more people are gaining weight.

As reliable access to healthy foods declines, the likelihood of being overweight goes up. As processed foods rich in sugar and fat have become cheaper than fruits and vegetables, the poor in particular are paying a high price with obesity rates soaring, followed by diabetes.

Stress aggravates diabetes. Stress raises blood sugar levels, activates fat cells, impairs glucose tolerance, increases insulin resistance and impacts blood pressure.

'The Nurse and Diabetes'

The Kingdom of Bahrain has joined the other countries and health organisations to mark the World Diabetes Day celebrated this year under the theme "The Nurse and Diabetes" to enhance people's awareness and help them avoid the disease and protect diabetic patients from dangerous complications.

The event also recognised the active role of nurses in caring for diabetic patients and supporting them.

Health Minister Faeqa bint Said Al Saleh said that the world is witnessing a steady increase in the incidence of non-communicable chronic diseases, including diabetes, noting that in Bahrain, the National Health Survey indicated that about 15% of those surveyed have diabetes.

She stressed the ministry's keenness to provide the best, safest and most effective health care for patients with diabetes, through specialised diabetes clinics in health centres and endocrine clinics in secondary care. She underlined programmes for early detection of diabetes complications and the availability of specialists to treat complications from various spe-

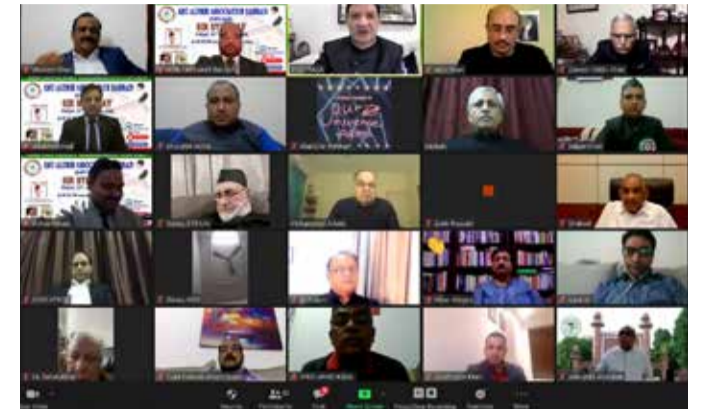

Libra renamed Diem

Facebook-backed cryptocurrency Libra has been rebranded "Diem" in a renewed effort to gain regulatory approval by stressing the project's independence.

Plans for Libra, first floated by Facebook last year, were slimmed-down in April after regulators and central banks raised concerns it could upend financial stability, erode control over monetary policy and threaten privacy.

Stuart Levey, CEO of the Geneva-based Diem Association behind the planned digital coin, said. "The original name was tied to an early iteration of the project that received a difficult reception from regulators. We have dramatically changed that proposition," Levey told Reuters.

Diem, which means "day" in Latin, now aims to initially launch a single dollar-backed digital coin, he added.

He declined to comment on timing for the launch, which the Financial Times reported last week could be as early



as January, saying only that it would only go ahead after approval by the Swiss markets watchdog.

Facebook, which changed the name of its payments unit Calibra to Novi Financial in May, remains one of 27 members of the Diem Association, formerly the Libra Association. Novi's head, David Marcus, is one of Diem's five board members.

"They are a critically-important member of the association," said Levey of Facebook's continuing involvement.

The project has said it would develop policies on anti-money laundering, terrorist financing and sanctions compliance and has ditched earlier plans to allow anyone to join its network.

Bitcoin off record highs, slumps 7pc in volatile trade

Bitcoin fell as much as 7 per cent against the dollar yesterday as the fledgling currency was back to its volatile self after having scaled a record peak earlier in the day.

The world's most popular cryptocurrency was last down 6pc at \$18,500 as of 1241 GMT. The price drop in bitcoin, which some investors saw as an evolving safe-haven, coincided with spot gold's 1.6pc rise.

Smaller coins ethereum and XRP, which often move in tandem with bitcoin, fell 7.3pc and 8.8pc, respectively.

Bitcoin has gained 160pc this year, fuelled by demand for riskier assets amid unprecedented fiscal and monetary stimulus, hunger for assets perceived as resistant to inflation, and expectations that cryptocurrencies will win mainstream acceptance.

Bitcoin's 12-year history has been peppered with steep gains and equally sharp drops. Compared to traditional assets, its market is highly opaque.

"Gold seems to be deriving strength from a tired dollar and mixed comments from US Federal Reserve Chair Jerome Powell and Treasury Secretary Steve Mnuchin," said Lukman Otunuga, senior research analyst at FXTM.

"Concerns over spiking coronavirus cases are also contributing to the metal's upside despite the growing optimism around vaccine developments."

In remarks released on Monday, Powell said the U.S. is entering "challenging" few months, while a potential vaccine faces

challenges of production and mass distribution before its economic impact becomes clear.

Meanwhile, the US recorded 10,000 coronavirus deaths and over 1.1 million new cases last week.

Puerto Rico’s famed Arecibo telescope collapses

The renowned Arecibo Observatory telescope in Puerto Rico collapsed on Tuesday, officials said, weeks after an announcement that the vast structure would be dismantled due to its decrepit and dangerous condition.

Two cables holding the instruments platform above the 1,000 feet (300 meter) diameter radio dish had snapped in recent months, and engineers had warned that it was on the brink of collapse.

“We can confirm the platform fell and that we have reports of no injuries. We will release additional details as they are confirmed,” Rob Margetta, spokesman for the National Science Foundation,

said.

The telescope was one of the largest in the world and has been a tool for many astronomical discoveries, as well as being famous for its dramatic scale and setting.

An action scene from the James Bond film “GoldenEye” took place above the telescope, and in the film “Contact” an astronomer played by Jodie Foster used the observatory in her quest for alien signals.

Abel Mendez, director of the Planetary Habitability Laboratory at the University of Puerto Rico at Arecibo, said the platform collapsed shortly before 8:00am (1200 GMT).

He described it as “a total disaster.”

The telescope was in operation until August this year.

Thai court fires warning on eve of PM ruling

Thailand’s constitutional court yesterday warned against “vulgar” criticism of its rulings, on the eve of a crucial judgement that could see Prime Minister Prayut Chan-O-Cha forced out of office.

The court will today hand down a verdict on whether Prayut has broken rules by living in an army house, despite the fact the former general is no longer in the military top brass.

Losing the case could see Prayut, who came to power in a 2014 coup, thrown out as premier.

The ruling follows months of street protests calling for Prayut to quit, and one pro-democracy group plans to rally outside the court on Wednesday.

But the court urged people to stay away and warned that excessive criticism could lead to prosecution.

“A person shall enjoy the liberty to express opinions, but criticism of rulings made with vulgar, sarcastic or threatening words will be considered a violation of the law,” the court said in a statement.

"I don't know why I haven't broken down," the doctor said. "My nurses cry in the middle of the day."

Varon said the isolation of the Covid unit was difficult for many patients, particularly the elderly.

"You can imagine," he said. "You are inside a room where people are coming in space-suits. "When you are an elderly individual, it's more difficult because you are alone," he said.

"Some of them cry. Some of them try to escape," he said. "We actually had somebody who tried to escape through a window the other day."

Carrie Underwood reveals she considered not competing on ‘American Idol’ due to fear

Carrie Underwood almost didn’t travel to Los Angeles to take part in her star-making run on “American Idol.”

in St. Louis, getting the ‘golden ticket’ to Hollywood, every contestant’s dream, I was terrified,” the star explained. “Every time I had to sing in front of the judges, I’d get nervous the way I did in church that first time. Then I’d say a prayer and leave it in God’s hands.”

When the time came for her to actually leave her hometown for Los Angeles, she said that she broke down on the way to the airport when the reality of what she was about to do hit her all at once.

“All at once, it was just too much. Going out to Los Angeles by myself,

competing with all those other people who were so talented. I burst into tears,” she said. “My dad turned to me in the backseat. ‘Carrie,’ he said, ‘we can go home right now, and we don’t ever have to talk about it again.’”

Luckily the star found her courage and agreed to make the trip that would ultimately lead her to an “American Idol” win. She credits her ability to persevere despite her own fear with her small-town upbringing.

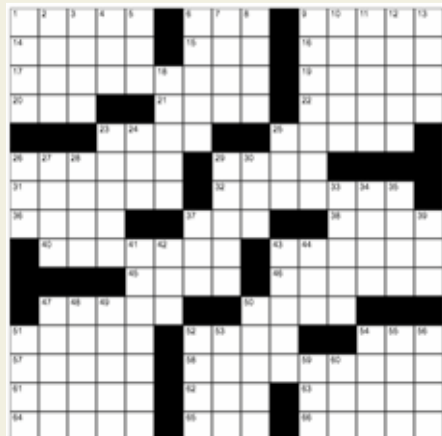

Bahrain International Circuit (BIC) is all set to have plenty of firsts at this weekend's Formula 1 Rolex Sakhir Grand Prix, taking place Friday to Sunday at "The Home of Motorsport in the Middle East".

It will be the first time that the BIC will host back-to-back F1 races, having successfully hosted the Gulf Air Bahrain Grand Prix last weekend.

The event will also be the first time BIC's 3.543-kilometre Outer Circuit will be used for a competitive race, posing a first-time challenge for the drivers and an all-new spectacle for motorsport fans around the world to enjoy for the first time.

Furthermore, the Rolex Sakhir Grand Prix is set to feature a total of 87 laps, putting it first on the highest number of laps list from all races in the 2020 F1 season.

The weekend's events the 16th and penultimate round of this year's FIA F1 World Championship.

The Outer Circuit it features contrasting characteristics to BIC's GP Track layout, which was used for the Gulf Air Bahrain Grand Prix, with qualifying lap times predicted to be under 55

seconds and race laps expected to be below 60 seconds.

That will set the grid for the Rolex Sakhir Grand Prix mega event, scheduled for an 8.10pm start time on Sunday night, which is three hours later than the start time of last weekend's Gulf Air Bahrain Grand Prix.

BIC will once again be welcoming Bahrain's heroes for this weekend's race. The circuit

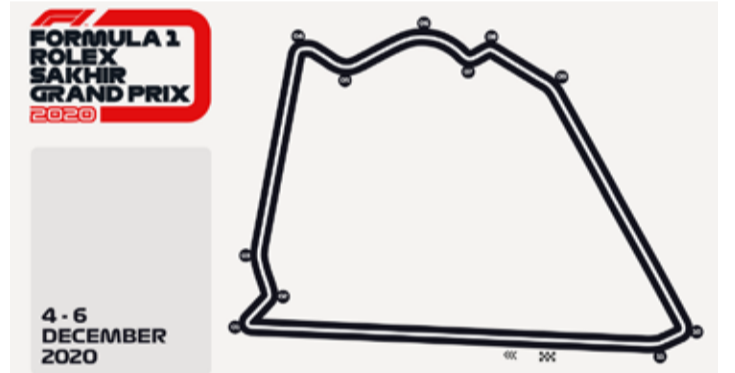

Ocon upbeat for 'special' challenge

Renault DP World F1 Team driver Esteban Ocon admits that the upcoming Formula 1 Rolex Sakhir Grand Prix 2020 is "a little bit of an unknown", but says he is looking forward to taking on the "spe-

cial" challenge this weekend at Bahrain International Circuit (BIC).

Ocon had an impressive drive last Sunday piloting the team's #31 R.S.20 car at the F1 Gulf Air Bahrain Grand Prix 2020. He had an important points finish in ninth place overall, kicking off what he hopes is a favourable F1 double-header in the Kingdom.

Speaking to TDT in an exclusive online interview prior to last weekend's events, the Frenchman said that he is ready for the all-new challenges brought about by Bahrain's second race

of the year, which is to be held along BIC's 3.543-kilometre Outer Circuit over a season-high 87 laps.

"It's a bit of an unknown obviously next week, how it's going to be, but it's going to be something very special with lots of laps in the race, little corners, and quick laps overall," Ocon told TDT.

"But we love challenges as drivers and as teams and we look forward to getting started there also next week."

The 24-year-old expressed his delight in being back in Bahrain

and the way things are run here both on and off the race track. "It's a place I love to come; we always have a fantastic welcome in Bahrain and I feel the organisation of the Grand Prix is fantastic," Ocon said.

"From the moment we arrived at the airport to the testing on site, to the cars' organisation and how everything is organised, it's just brilliant.

"Bahrain has the motorsport spirit and that's fantastic. It's a great place to be racing as well in the first week. It's one of the easiest tracks to overtake of the year, we have some great challenges, big braking, which makes it a good show."

Strong campaign

Ocon has enjoyed a strong campaign in 2020, finishing in the points in nine out of 15 races so far while helping Renault contend for third overall in the constructors' championship. But he knows there is still plenty of room for improvement, and is continuing to push as the season comes to a close.

"It's been a good progression during the season, but I am not 100 per cent happy with how

everything has went," Ocon said. "I feel that the potential is here, we have the performance, but it hasn't always paid off."

"The aim [over the last races] is to maximise and extract the best out of the package we have in our hands with the R.S.20. Obviously we have the fight for third, which is mega important for us in the constructors' championship—we have Ferrari who are coming very strong, McLaren will be more or less on home soil, there will be Racing Point as well who are also very very competitive—so it's going to be a very tight end of season. But if we do our job the best way possible, potentially we have a chance to get what we want."

In 2021, Ocon will have a new partner racing with him at Renault as two-time F1 world champion Fernando Alonso takes the place of Daniel Ricciardo, who will be moving on to McLaren.

Ocon says he is excited about working alongside Alonso, who won both his two F1 titles with Renault in 2005 and 2006, and hopes to continue improving as he heads into his second full season with the team.

"In a way, I will miss Daniel as he is a great guy to work with, but having Fernando coming in and joining the team is going to be great," Ocon said. "I have a great relationship with Fernando, he is going to bring some new information from his side and that's good, and I look forward."

"Solving the little things I could have done better this year, that's going to be my aim [in 2021]. Just come back to the same place and do better earlier in the year."

"The second year on the same team is usually a lot easier to handle everything and to work with the people around you. You

know what to expect, they know what you need, and usually your life is a lot easier on the second year.

"On that, I expect to do a stronger first part of the season, and the rest we will see."

Seven-time F1 world champion Lewis Hamilton expressed his regret yesterday to be missing this weekend's Formula 1 Rolex Sakhir Grand Prix, after it was announced that he had tested positive for COVID-19.

In a post on social media, Hamilton said he is "gutted" about not being able to compete in the season's penultimate round, and urged others to look after one another and stay pos-

been in order to stay safe. "Unfortunately, even though I returned three negative results this past week, I woke up yes-

terday morning with mild symptoms and requested another test which came back positive.

"I've immediately gone into self-isolation for 10 days."

He added: "I'm gutted not to be able to race this weekend but my priority is to follow the protocols and advice to protect others. I'm really lucky that I feel OK with only mild symptoms and will do my best to stay fit and healthy."

"Please look after yourselves out there, you can never be too careful. These are worrying times for everyone and we need to make sure we are looking after ourselves and each other. Stay positive."

Mercedes F1 team's announcement of Hamilton testing positive came earlier in the

day yesterday. A team statement read: "Lewis was tested three times last week and returned a negative result each time, the last of which was on Sunday afternoon at the Bahrain International Circuit as part of the standard race weekend testing programme."

"However, he woke up on Monday morning with mild symptoms and was informed at the same time that a contact prior to arrival in Bahrain had subsequently tested positive. Lewis therefore took a further test and returned a positive result. This has since been confirmed by a retest."

Mercedes said that they will announce Hamilton's replacement for the Sakhir Grand Prix in due course.
