BD3m unlicensed investment convict appeals 10-year jail term

An unlicensed 'investment' scheme that drew in more than BD3 million is back before the First High Criminal Court, as the Bahraini man convicted over it fights a 10-year jail term and a BD100,000 fine.

The original ruling also ordered the confiscation of the crime proceeds, repayment of the money to its owners, and temporary compensation of BD6,000 for the first civil claimant and BD1,000 for the second, for material and moral damage.

At the latest hearing, the court heard the defence argue that the dispute with the first complainant was a plain commercial deal, not an investment of others' funds.

Counsel said the second complainant was a friend of the accused and that the amount between them was a loan, which had been paid back in full.

Investor

As for the third complainant, the defence described him as an investor and partner and said that, although he claimed to have handed the accused money, he had produced no proof.

Defence witnesses were also called. They spoke about how they knew the accused and the nature of his dealings with the complainants.

The First High Criminal Court then fixed 13 January next year to give its judgment, and ordered that the accused remain in custody until the verdict.

Woman held for embezzling BD25,000 from employer account

The Ministry of Interior announced that the Northern Governorate Police Directorate has arrested a 30-year-old Asian woman for embezzling more than BD25,000 from her elderly employer's account.

The suspect allegedly transferred the funds to her personal account using an electronic application.

The Northern Police Directorate stated that, upon receiving the report, the authorities immediately launched an investigation and successfully apprehended the suspect.

Legal procedures are currently underway in preparation for referring the case to the Public Prosecution.

Tax relief

MP seeks VAT-free zone near Khalifa Port to support storage and re-export operations

MP Hassan Ebrahim is pushing for a free zone near Khalifa Port where companies would be able to store and re-export goods without paying value added tax (VAT) in advance, with VAT only charged on consignments released into the Bahraini market after sale.

The text asks for the zone to be created close to Khalifa Port so that firms can bring in cargo, keep it in storage and ship it on to other countries without VAT being collected, so long as the goods do not enter Bahrain.

Under the scheme, VAT would be linked to actual sales rather than to the arrival of shipments.

Goods

Tax would fall due when goods leave the free zone for domestic buyers, instead of being charged at the border.

According to the explanatory memorandum, this is aimed in particular at easing cash-flow strain for small and medium-sized businesses that struggle when taxes are paid up front.

The memorandum roots the plan in Article 10(a) of the Constitution, which states that the national economy is based on social justice and fair co-operation between public and pri-

vate activity, with economic development and prosperity for citizens pursued within the law.

Ebrahim presents the proposed zone as one way to support that framework while keeping pace with changing trade patterns.

Infrastructure

Choosing a location near Khalifa Port is described as an attempt to make better use of the port's existing infrastruc-

ture and its role as a busy trade route.

The free zone is pitched as a hub for supply chains and transit trade, giving Bahrain extra weight on the Gulf logistics map at a time when international companies are looking for storage centres with flexible terms, lower costs and smooth cargo handling.

Goods brought into the zone for onward shipment would be exempt from VAT, which, the memorandum argues, would make Bahrain more attractive to companies whose business models depend on re-export. Linking tax to realised income, rather than to warehouse stock, is presented as a way to help firms expand imports and keep goods moving without early tax demands acting as a brake.

50 illegal workers detained, 83 deported



LMRA conducts 1,817 inspection campaigns and visits

Fifty violating and irregular workers were detained, and 83 others were deported, following 1,817 inspection campaigns and visits conducted by the Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) between 23 and 29 November 2025.

The inspection campaigns and visits also resulted in monitoring a number of violations related to the provisions of a number of regulating laws, especially the Labour Market Regulatory Authority and the Residency Laws in the Kingdom of Bahrain, noting that legal measures were taken regarding the observed violations.

The Authority pointed out that 1,780 inspection visits were carried out on various shops in all governorates, in addition to 37 joint inspection campaigns, 17 campaigns in the Capital Governorate, 4

campaigns in the Muharraq Governorate, 7 campaigns in the Northern Governorate and 9 campaigns in the Southern Governorate.

The government entities that participated in the campaigns are the Ministry of Interior, represented by the Nationality, Passports and Residence Affairs (NPRA), the Governorate's respective Police Directorate, the General Directorate of Crime Detection and Forensic Science, and the General Directorate of Verdict Enforcement and Alternative Sentencing, as well as the Ministry of Industry and Commerce, the Ministry of Municipalities Affairs and Agriculture, the Bahrain Tourism and Exhibition Authority, and the Social Insurance Organization.

The Authority affirmed the continuation of joint coordination with government agencies to intensify inspection campaigns in all governorates of the Kingdom, and to address any violations or practices that negatively affect the stability and competitiveness of the labour market or harm economic and social security of the Kingdom.

Mild 3.3 quake recorded in Bahrain

Residents buzzing after light jolt

Bahrain experienced an unusual late-night jolt early yesterday after a light earthquake of magnitude 3.3 was recorded within the kingdom's territory, according to the Meteorological Directorate.

The tremor occurred at 23:58 UTC (2:58 AM local time) on 1 December 2025, with its epicentre located at 26.07°N, 50.60°E, likely in the Riffa area.

While no damage or injuries were reported, the quake sparked a wave of mixed reactions across the country.


Many residents slept through the event entirely, but others, particularly in Riffa, Zallaq, Saar, parts of Manama, and Hamala, described feeling a brief, unexpected shake.

Sensation


Speaking to The Daily Tribune, a Riffa resident said they woke to what felt like someone lightly nudging the bed, while another compared the sensation to “a slightly heavy shake moving through the building.”

Earthquakes originating inside Bahrain are extremely rare, as the country lies far from major tectonic fault lines.

Most tremors felt locally in

the past have been triggered by distant seismic activity from the Zagros belt in Iran and Iraq, one of the region's most active geological zones. The recent uptick in mild tremors across the wider Gulf has drawn attention. Just days ago, Saudi Arabia recorded a small earthquake measuring 3.43 in magnitude.

Factors

Experts say the region's sensitivity to seismic events is be-

coming more noticeable due to a combination of natural and human-linked factors. Across the Gulf, tremors are often tied to distant earthquakes in the Zagros Mountains, where intense tectonic pressure routinely produces seismic waves that can travel far across the region.

The Gulf's deep sedimentary basin is known to amplify these long-period waves, making even remote quakes feel stronger onshore.

Bahrain debt rises by 8pc to BD19.3bln

Hidden borrowing has pushed Bahrain's real public debt above the official BD19.3 billion figure, the National Audit Office warns in a new 600-page report that tracks billions in loans taken directly by ministries and state bodies.

According to the report, gross public debt rose by eight per cent from BD17.9bn at the end of 2023 to BD19.3bn a year later.

Interest costs climbed from BD843m in 2023 to BD945m in 2024. On top of the recorded debt, ministries and other public bodies borrowed directly from external funds and banks, taking the total to an estimated BD4.9bn in 2024, up from BD3.9bn a year earlier, without those loans appearing in the Finance and National Economy Ministry's debt register.

The Finance Ministry said it partly agreed with the observation.

Plans

It linked its debt-management work to wider plans to narrow the budget gap and said smaller deficits would reduce the need to borrow, subject to market conditions and liquidity.

It added that it works with the Central Bank of Bahrain to secure lower-cost funding. On direct borrowing by public bodies, the ministry cited Article 108(b) of the Constitution, which allows municipalities and public institutions to borrow

under their own laws, and said such loans are not classified as government debt as they are not guaranteed by the state.

The deficit between income and spending widened. The Audit Office reported that the shortfall rose from BD774m in 2023 to BD1.026bn in 2024, an increase of 33 per cent.

Income

The ministry attributed this mainly to an 11 per cent fall in oil income, a 13 per cent increase in interest payments and a five per

cent rise in project spending.

Total state revenues dropped from BD3,196m in 2023 to BD3,026m in 2024, a fall of five per cent. Oil income slipped from BD2,035m to BD1,820m.

The report also noted that Bapco Energies had yet to transfer BD66.4m in 2024 returns to the Treasury, as required under the 2023-2024 budget law.

Dues

The ministry said it shared the aim of collecting all dues and was following up with the company.

Though still under development, the butterfly section features carefully designed houses and meticulously arranged floral patches, offering a thriving habitat for these delicate creatures.

Jumaa explained that the project is envisioned as an immersive, educational environment, allowing visitors to follow the butterflies' growth and life cycle firsthand.

It is a testament to the farm's commitment to sustainability and to creating an experience that is both enchanting and enlightening.

Precision

The bee farming section remains a marvel of organisation and natural precision. Neatly aligned beehives host various species, each hive operating as a self-contained kingdom.

Builder bees meticulously construct the hive, forager bees tirelessly gather nectar, and guards vigilantly defend the colony's entrance.



High ranking bees maintain a protective circle around the queen, safeguarding the heart of the hive.

On rare occasions, a wandering bee from a neighbouring hive may spark a brief clash between colonies, yet the intricate social order persists undisturbed. Honey harvesting relies on a traditional technique.

Smoke gently calms the bees, allowing honey to be collected safely.

The queen bee produces royal jelly, a prized product renowned for its purity and exceptional value.

Feature

Jumaa has recently introduced a truly unique feature to the farm.

He creates intricate 3D wax sculptures, shapes and even personalised names, which are then placed inside the hives.

The bees produce honey directly on these three-dimensional designs, turning each sculpture into an edible, artistic creation.

This innovation has made the farm one of a kind, combining craftsmanship, creativity and natural processes in a way that is entirely new in Bahrain.

Adding to the farm's allure is a fresh-water spring that emerges beside the sea, producing naturally sweet water amidst the surrounding saltwater.

2,485 illegal fishing traps and nets seize

One of the largest renewable energy initiatives in Bahrain's education sector, the project aims to diversify energy sources,

es, reduce reliance on natural gas, and lower pollution levels.

The system will feature 64,606 solar panels on parking lots (24.7 MW) and on the ground (21.5 MW), with a total capacity of 46.2 MW and an expected annual output of 70 GWh. It is projected to cut carbon emissions by 35,000 tons per year.

H.E. Kamal said that the project, costing approximately BD9 million, will serve as a model for future renewable energy initiatives supporting Bahrain's sustainability goals.

He emphasised the collaboration between government institutions and the university's role in maximizing available space for clean energy.





◆ **Iran has announced** the discovery of a major gold deposit at one of the country's biggest mines for the precious metal, local media reported yesterday. The new vein structure was found at the privately owned Shadan gold mine in the eastern province of South Khorasan, which Fars news agency described as "among the country's most important". The agency said the new reserves have been officially validated by the Ministry of Industry, Mines and Trade. "The proven reserves of the Shadan gold mine in the east of the country have experienced a significant increase following the discovery of a vast gold vein," the report said. It added that the vein holds some "7.95 million tonnes of oxide gold ore and 53.1 million tonnes of sulphide gold ore." The former is usually significantly easier and cheaper to mine. Iran has not officially disclosed the amount of its national gold reserves but claims to have significantly increased its purchases in recent years.

◆ **Hong Kong police say arrested 13 for manslaughter over fire**

◆ **Hong Kong police** said yesterday they had arrested a total of 13 people for manslaughter over a deadly fire that ripped through an apartment complex last week, killing at least 146. Chan Tung, director of crime and security of the Hong Kong Police Force, said they "have immediately begun comprehensive investigation along the lines of manslaughter", leading to the arrests of "a total of 13 people, including 12 men and one woman". Tung told a news conference those arrested were aged between 40 and 77. Officials also announced that some of the exterior netting used on scaffolding at the housing estate did not meet fire-resistance standards. "Samples collected from seven locations across high, middle and low floors in four buildings... did not meet the fire resistance test standards," the city's chief secretary Eric Chan told reporters.

◆ **US President Donald Trump** warned Israel yesterday against destabilizing Syria and its new leadership, days after a deadly operation by Israeli forces in the south of the country. "It is very important that Israel maintain a strong and true dialogue with Syria, and that nothing takes place that will interfere with Syria's evolution into a prosperous State," Trump said on his Truth Social platform. Trump said he was "very satisfied" with Syria's performance under former Islamist rebel President Ahmed al-Sharaa, who made a historic visit to the White House in November. Trump has been pushing for a security pact between Israel and Syria since Sharaa's Islamist coalition overthrew longtime ruler Bashar al-Assad a year ago. But tensions have risen over hundreds of strikes by Israel on Syria. In the deadliest so far, Israeli forces killed 13 people on Friday in an operation in southern Syria, saying they targeted an Islamist group.

WHO backs GLP-1 treatments to tackle obesity epidemic

A range of blockbuster weight-loss and diabetes drugs could help shift the trajectory of the global obesity epidemic, which affects over one billion people worldwide, the World Health Organization said yesterday.

Not 'a magic bullet'

A new generation of appetite-suppressing drugs called GLP-1 agonists -- which includes blockbuster brands Ozempic and Mounjaro -- has become massively popular in recent years.

On Monday, the United Nations health agency issued its first guidelines on how such drugs could be used as a key tool for treating obesity in adults as a chronic, relapsing disease.

More than 3.7 million people died from illnesses related to being overweight or obese in 2022, according to WHO figures -- more than top infectious killers malaria, tuberculosis and HIV combined.

The number of people living with obesity will double by 2030 unless decisive action is taken to stem the rise, the agency estimates.

"Obesity is one of the most serious public challenges of our time," WHO chief Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus told reporters from the agency's Geneva headquarters.

"These new medicines are a powerful clinical tool, offering

The new guidelines call for GLP-1 therapies to be used by adults, excluding pregnant women, "for the long-term treatment of obesity", which it defines as a Body Mass Index (BMI) of 30 or higher.

WHO stressed that while the efficacy of the therapies in treating obesity was "evident", it was issuing "conditional recommendations" for use since more data was needed on efficacy and safety over longer periods.

The agency also emphasised that the medication alone would not reverse the trend in obesity, which it recognised as a complex, chronic disease and a major driver of non-communicable diseases, including cardiovascular disease, type-2 diabetes and some types of cancer.

The new guidelines suggest the therapies could be coupled with "intensive behavioural interventions", promoting healthy diet and physical activity, amid indications such shifts may enhance treatment outcomes.

Trump-backed candidate holds narrow lead for Honduras presidency

A conservative candidate backed by US President Donald Trump narrowly leads a right-wing rival in Honduras's presidential election, according to partial results from the electoral commission released Monday.

Nasry Asfura, 67, had 40 percent of the votes and led Salvador Nasralla by just 0.2 percentage points, with 56 percent of votes counted, according to the National Electoral Council (CNE).

Both candidates were more than 20 percentage points ahead of Rixi Moncada, 60, of ruling leftist Libre party, who was trailing heavily, signaling another

Latin American nation poised to swing rightward.

The campaign was dominated by Trump's threat to cut aid if his favored candidate Asfura, who is nicknamed "grandad," were to lose.

The vote count from Sunday's election has progressed slowly, and final results could take days.

Many Hondurans have fled grinding poverty and violence to the United States, including minors fearing forced recruitment by gangs, although this escape route is no longer a viable option under Trump.

In the final days of the race, the US leader threw his weight behind former Tegucigalpa mayor Asfura, whose campaign slogan was "Grandad, at your service!"

That intervention upended a contest that is still too close to call, in a country plagued by drug trafficking and gang activity.

Lawmakers and hundreds of mayors will also be elected in the fiercely polarized nation, which is also one of the most violent in Latin America.

"If he (Asfura) doesn't win, the United States will not be throwing good money after bad,"

Trump wrote Friday on his Truth Social platform.

'Not because of Trump'

Trump's comments marked another brazen intervention in another country's politics, echoing threats he made in support of Argentine President Javier Milei's party in recent midterms.

Before Sunday's vote, Trump also made the shock announcement that he would pardon former Honduran president Juan Orlando Hernandez, of Asfura's National Party.

Hernandez is serving a 45-year prison sentence in the United States for cocaine trafficking and other charges.

Some Hondurans have welcomed Trump's intervention, saying they hope it might mean Honduran migrants will be allowed to remain in the United States.

But others have rejected his meddling in the vote.

"I vote for whomever I please, not because of what Trump has said, because the truth is I live off my work, not off politicians," Esmeralda Rodriguez, a 56-year-old fruit seller, told AFP.

Nearly 30,000 Honduran migrants have been deported from the United States since Trump returned to office in January.

The clampdown has dealt a severe blow to the country of 11 million people, where remittances accounted for 27 percent of GDP last year.

After voting in the capital Tegucigalpa, Asfura denied that the planned pardon would benefit him, saying: "This issue has been circulating for months, and it has nothing to do with the elections."

Zelensky in Paris seeking support

President Volodymyr Zelensky on Monday sought to reinforce European support for Ukraine at a potentially pivotal moment in Kyiv's battle against the Russian invasion, meeting President Emmanuel Macron in Paris as Washington pushed a plan to end the war.

Over three-and-a-half years into Russia's full-scale invasion of its neighbour, an AFP analysis of data from the US-based Institute for the Study of War (ISW) showed the Russian army made its biggest advance in Ukraine for a year in November.

The plan to end the war is championed by US President Donald Trump but European countries fear it risks forcing Kyiv to cave in to Russian demands, notably on territory.

The situation has been further complicated by a corruption scandal that has rocked Zelensky's inner circle and forced the dismissal last week of his top ne-

gotiator and chief of staff Andriy Yermak.

US and Ukrainian negotiators held hours of what both sides called "productive" talks in Florida on Sunday, with Trump declaring on Air Force One "there's a good chance we can make a

deal".

Amid a flurry of American-led diplomacy, US envoy Steve Witkoff is due to meet Russian President Vladimir Putin in Moscow on Tuesday.

But he first held a new meeting with Ukrainian negotiator

Rustem Umerov, the country's security council secretary, in Florida, senior sources familiar with the matter told AFP, adding "there are still questions" on the US plan.

"We managed to achieve significant progress, although certain issues require further refinement," said Umerov.

The sources said Zelensky "expects to see Umerov in Ireland" during a visit on Tuesday to hear a detailed report on the Florida talks.

Zelensky and Macron also spoke by telephone to Witkoff and Umerov in Florida, the Elysee said.

"We share the view that the war must be brought to a fair end," Zelensky wrote on X after the talks which also included phone conversations with other European leaders including British Prime Minister Keir Starmer.

Macron and Zelensky were due to hold a joint news conference in Paris.

Israel to deploy 'Iron Beam' laser defence

To enhance interception of drones and other projectiles

● Iron Dome offers short-range protection against missiles and rockets

● Major milestone in a project more than a decade old

Israel's defence ministry announced yesterday the completion of a laser air defence system known as "Iron Beam", which will be deployed by the end of December.

"The Iron Beam laser system is expected to fundamentally change the rules of engagement on the battlefield," Daniel Gold, head of defence ministry research and development, told a defence summit in Tel Aviv.

"With development complete and a comprehensive testing programme that has validated the system's capabilities," he added, promising to deliver "initial operational capability" by the end of the year.

The announcement comes as Israeli military steps up its strikes against Hezbollah and its infrastructure, despite a ceasefire that began just over a year ago.

Contacted by AFP, the defence ministry refused to provide more details on what exactly would happen on that date.

The announcement marks a major milestone in a project more than a decade old, de-

veloped jointly with the state-owned arms company Rafael and Israeli private defence group Elbit.

The laser system seeks to enhance Israel's interception of drones and other projectiles, and will supplement other aerial defence capacities such as the more well-known Iron Dome.

Iron Dome offers short-range protection against missiles and rockets. The David's Sling system and successive generations of Arrow missiles are Israeli-American technology built to bring down ballistic missiles.

During the 12-day war launched by Israel against Iran in June, the country's missile defence system failed to intercept all the projectiles fired by Tehran toward Israeli territory. Israel has since acknowledged being hit by more than 50 missiles during the war with Iran, resulting in 28 deaths.

The new system is "a ground-based high-power laser air defence system designed to counter aerial threats", Rafael said.

The company added that the system has the "unique advantage of rapidly neutralising threats using laser technology at negligible cost".

Taiwan says test flights of US fighter jets to start this month

Test flights of US F-16V fighter jets built for Taiwan will start this month, a Taiwanese Air Force official said Monday, but warned of "very serious delays" in delivery.

The \$8 billion deal for 66 warplanes was approved during US President Donald Trump's first term in the White House, with delivery scheduled for 2026. Speaking in parliament, Air Force Chief of Staff Lee Ching-jan said flight tests of the new fighters would be carried out "earlier" than planned this month.

"For now, 54 aircraft have entered the assembly line, compared with 50 in October. The progress is being accelerated," Lee said.

Defence Minister Wellington Koo said last month that Lockheed Martin, the US defence contractor building the jets, had ramped up production, running two shifts every weekday.

"There are 50 aircraft on the assembly line at the same time, and some airframes have already completed structural assembly," Koo said.

But Koo said it would be "challenging" for all the aircraft to be delivered in 2026.

Taiwan is seeking to strengthen its defences to deter China, which claims the democratic island is part of its territory and has threatened to use force to annex it.

The F-16V -- a fourth-generation multi-role fighter -- is a significantly upgraded version of

Taiwan's ageing F-16 A/B jets. Taiwan completed upgrades of 141 older F-16s to the V standard in late 2023.

The United States does not have formal diplomatic relations with Taiwan, but Washington remains Taipei's most important backer and biggest arms supplier.

It has sold billions of dollars in weapons to Taiwan -- including fighter jets, missiles, and warships -- as part of its commitment to help the island maintain sufficient self-defence capabilities.

Bangladesh court sentences former PM's sister, UK lawmaker

A Bangladesh court sentenced Sheikh Rehana, sister of former premier Sheikh Hasina, to seven years in prison on Monday for corruption in a case involving the grabbing of lucrative plots in the capital.

Rehana's daughter Tulip Siddiq, who is a British lawmaker, was handed a two-year sentence in the same case, said Khan Mainul Hasan, prosecutor for the Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC).

Hasina, who was given the death penalty for crimes against humanity last month, and 14 other government officials were condemned to five years of imprisonment.

The 78-year-old former premier has sought refuge in In-

dia since her ouster last year following a student-led uprising, but Rehana's whereabouts remain unknown.

Siddiq, who resigned as British anti-corruption minister in January after being named in graft probes in Bangladesh, called the trial "flawed and farcical from the beginning to the end".

Asia floods death toll tops 1,160 as troops aid survivors

Padang, Indonesia

The toll in deadly flooding and landslides across parts of Asia climbed past 1,160 yesterday as hardest-hit Sri Lanka and Indonesia deployed military personnel to help survivors. Separate weather systems brought torrential, extended rainfall to the island of Sri Lanka and large parts of Indonesia's Sumatra, southern Thailand and northern Malaysia last week. Much of the region is currently in its

monsoon season but climate change is producing more extreme rain events and turbo-charging storms.

The World Health Organization said it was deploying rapid response teams and critical supplies to the region.

The UN agency's chief Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus told reporters in Geneva that it was "another reminder of how climate change is driving more frequent and more extreme weather events, with disastrous effects".

Kremlin says Putin to meet US envoy Witkoff today afternoon

Moscow, Russia

Russian President Vladimir Putin will hold talks on Ukraine with US envoy Steve Witkoff in Moscow today afternoon, the Kremlin said.

The pair will meet after American and Ukrainian officials held negotiations on a US plan that Washington wants to be a basis to end fighting between Moscow and Kyiv.

"The meeting with Witkoff is planned for tomorrow," Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov told reporters, including from AFP, in a briefing on Monday, adding that it will take place "in the second half of the day."

Putin last week repeated his maximalist demands for Moscow to drop its offensive: for Kyiv to surrender territories Moscow claims as its own, saying his army will take them by force otherwise.

Witkoff has met Putin in the Kremlin several times.

The US official has faced

criticism for his approach in talks with Moscow, with an initial US plan to end the war widely seen as heeding to much of the Kremlin's demands.

The EU has said the coming week could be "pivotal" for Ukraine.

Ukraine's Volodymyr Zelenskyy was in Paris on Monday, seeking to boost European support for Kyiv, while US President Donald Trump expressed optimism for a potential deal to end almost four years of war.





F1 title race tightens after Qatar drama

● McLaren's strategy error costs them victory

After another bungled team performance from McLaren, Max Verstappen is now within reach of what seemed to be an improbable fifth consecutive drivers' world championship.

Lando Norris, after two dominant and polished triumphs in Latin America, has rediscovered his self-doubts and will make the short trip from Doha to Abu Dhabi with a lead of only 12 points ahead of Red Bull's Verstappen.

His McLaren team-mate Oscar Piastri, the fastest driver, also lost out in his team's strategic pit-stop blunder and fell to third, a further four points adrift, ahead of a three-way showdown in the desert on Sunday.

Here we look at three things we learned from the Qatar Grand Prix:

McLaren contorted by 'papaya rules'

After two weekends of self-inflicted damage to their drivers' championship ambitions, McLaren have one chance left to avoid ultimate sporting disaster at the Yas Marina circuit by gifting the drivers' crown to a rival after clinching the teams' title with months to spare.

But, confined as they seem to be by their own "papaya rules" that require complete equality in support and opportunity for both Norris and Piastri, they cannot allow for any more mistakes.

Or they have to abandon equality and issue team orders that require Piastri to support Norris.

They had both cars disqualified for a technical error in Las Vegas and then, in Qatar, took the decision not to pit both cars at the same time under the safety car on lap seven when every other driver pitted.

It was a basic blunder made

because they wanted to maintain fairness and a two-car stop with race leader Piastri coming in first ahead of Norris, who was third on track behind Verstappen, would have disadvantaged the Briton.

"Potentially, I would have lost time," said Norris. "A bit of time, maybe. I wouldn't have lost a position, I don't think. But there's nothing I can do about it."

Piastri said: "On a personal level, I feel like I've lost a win. In hindsight, it's pretty obvious what we should have done. It's gut-wrenchingly painful for me."

Team chief Andrea Stella admitted it was a team mistake and had cost them a win and a podium finish as the pair finished second and fourth.

But Zak Brown, the chief executive officer who has championed giving both drivers equal backing, was unusually quiet.

Verstappen has composure and momentum

Described by Brown as comparable to a horror movie monster, Verstappen has laughed at McLaren's mistakes and claimed last week that, if he

"On pure pace, it will be tough in Abu Dhabi," he said. "But a race like today shows that it's not always straightforward at a Grand Prix and a lot can happen."

"So, I'm probably relying a bit on that. It's all possible now, of course. We'll see... I don't really worry about it too much."

Relaxed, joking and enjoying teasing his rivals, Verstappen has a chance to complete a remarkable run with a spectacular title triumph.

Hamilton downcast, Ferrari in disarray

Lewis Hamilton and Charles Leclerc were equally despondent after finishing 12th and eighth, vanquished by all their main rivals and left with little optimism for the future even if Hamilton, humiliated in qualifying for the second consecutive Grand Prix, spoke of hope.

Both lacked confidence in the car and with other teams like Aston Martin, with Adrian Newey appointed as team chief, and Mercedes, with an envied new power unit on the way for 2026, on the march, the outlook is bleak.

Thunder down Blazers to avenge lone defeat of season

The NBA champion Oklahoma City Thunder avenged their only defeat of the season on Sunday, using a fourth-quarter surge to beat the Portland Trail Blazers 123-115 and improve to 20-1.

Shai Gilgeous-Alexander scored 26 points to lead six Thunder players to score in double figures.

With their 12th straight win Oklahoma City are off to the best start since the 2015-16 Golden State Warriors opened the season 21-0.

Reigning NBA Most Valuable Player Gilgeous-Alexander's 93rd straight game with at least 20 points is the second-longest such streak behind Wilt Chamberlain's 126 straight set from October 1961-January 1963.

He surpassed a 92-game streak set by Chamberlain from

February 1963-March 1964.

Center Chet Holmgren added 19 points, nine rebounds, three blocked shots and a steal for the Thunder, who opened the final period on an 8-0 scoring run to gain the upper hand in a tense clash that featured 15 lead changes.

OKC suffered their only defeat of the season against the Blazers on November 5, when the Thunder squandered a 22-point lead and fell 121-119 at Portland.

The Blazers again put them to the test, emerging from a back-and-forth first half with a 55-54 lead and taking an 87-85 lead

into the final period.

Deni Avdija led the Trail Blazers with a triple-double of 31 points, 19 rebounds and 10 assists, but the Thunder wouldn't be denied.

Aaron Wiggins came up with a steal and a basket to launch the fourth-quarter opening burst. Holmgren produced a massive block then made a layup.

Jalen Williams threw down with another steal and a layup and suddenly the Thunder had a six-point lead less than two minutes into the final frame.

"(We) got a lot of turnovers in that stretch, which goes down to playing hard, being in the right spots, really cracking down on the game plan," said Williams, who played his second game since returning from off-season wrist surgery. "I think that kind of opened up the game."

Hosts stunned as Bahrain eye strong opening

The FIFA Arab Cup returned to Doha with all the tension and unpredictability the region has come to expect, and on opening night, Group A delivered two seismic jolts. Syria's disciplined 1-0 win over Tunisia at Ahmad bin Ali Stadium set the tone, before Palestine stunned hosts Qatar with a late own goal at Al Bayt Stadium, capping an extraordi-

nary first chapter to a tournament once again staged in World Cup-calibre surrounds.

Tunisia, with the lively PSG academy product Ismael Gharbi and veteran full-back Ali Maaloul, seized early control. They camped in the Syrian half, stitching neat sequences through Moutaz Neffati and repeatedly attacking down both channels. Gharbi forced Syrian goalkeeper Shaher Alshaker into an early save, while Maaloul went close with a curling free-kick. Yet Syria, guided by Spanish coach José Lana's compact and disciplined approach, slowed the rhythm, blocked lanes and disrupted every Tunisian surge.

Then came the moment of the night. Three minutes into the second half, the match changed direction. Omar Kharbin, Syria's talismanic forward, stepped over a free-kick 25 yards out and bent a stunning strike into the top

corner. The goal silenced the Tunisian bench and reminded the crowd of the quality once showcased across Qatar's venues during the 2022 World Cup. Tunisia responded with urgency. Gharbi weaved into tight areas, striker

Seifeddine Jaziri tried catching the keeper off his line and waves of red shirts pushed forward. Syria held their ground with remarkable resolve and closed out a famous opening win.

If that upset raised eyebrows,

the late drama in Al Khor lifted them higher still. Qatar controlled long stretches, attacking through Akram Afif's set pieces and the introduction of Edmilson Junior after the interval. Palestine, however, grew in belief,

carving chances for Oday Dabagh and Zeid Qunbar before finally forcing the breakthrough. Deep into added time, Sultan Al Brake inadvertently turned the ball into his own net, sealing a 1-0 Palestinian win that left Al Bayt stunned.

Today's action continues with Morocco facing Comoros, Egypt meeting Kuwait at the iconic Lusail Stadium, and Saudi Arabia clashing with Oman in Education City.

For Bahrain, attention now shifts to tomorrow's Group D opener against Iraq at Stadium 974. The national team has spent the past week preparing in Doha, with head coach Dragan Talajic insisting his side "have much more quality" while acknowledging the challenge ahead. "It's important to start positively and insha'Allah the Bahraini people will be behind us. We will do it all together for our kingdom," he said.

Boycott urges England to 'use their brains' in quest to level Ashes

Geoffrey Boycott has urged England to "use their brains" as Ben Stokes's men go in search of an Ashes series-leveling win in this week's second Test in Brisbane.

England fell 1-0 down in the five-match series following a humiliating eight-wicket loss to Australia inside two days in last month's first Test in Perth.

Batting collapses cost England dear as the tourists lost five wickets for 12 runs in their first innings and four for 11 in their second.

Former England opener Boycott insisted Stokes's men could win at Brisbane's Gabba ground with a more measured approach.

Bahrain's Arab Cup Run Stalled

Bahrain's senior men's volleyball team suffered their first defeat in the Arab Challenge Cup in Amman, Jordan, going down 3-1 to Egypt last night. After a re-sounding 3-0 win over Palestine in their opener, the Bahrainis faced a far much tougher opponent in the North African side.

The first set saw Egypt seize the early initiative, claiming it 30-28. Bahrain responded in the second set, edging Egypt 25-23 thanks to sharp attacking from Naser Anan and Ali Ebrahim. Their precise spikes

Despite the setback, Bahrain showed flashes of quality. Coach Arnaud Jossierand praised the team's fight in the second set and emphasised the need for sharp-

er execution in upcoming matches. The squad, including Mohammed Anan, Mahmood Alafyah, Abbas Al Khabbaz, and Sayed Hashim Issa, will aim to bounce back when they face Kuwait tonight at 7pm. Bahrain then take on Tunisia on Thursday at 3pm and conclude their campaign against host Jordan on Friday evening. The Arab Challenge Cup, organised by the Arab Volleyball Association in cooperation with the Jordan Volleyball Federation, remains a key platform for regional teams to test themselves ahead of the international season.
