

Bahrain Metro project’s first phase presented to investors

The \$2 billion Bahrain Metro project was introduced for the first time yesterday to international investors and developers during a virtual workshop organised by the Ministry of Transport and Communications.

The introductory workshop showcasing the first phase of the mega urban rail transit network project was chaired by Transportation and Telecommunications Minister Kamal bin Ahmed Mohammed. Senior officials including Finance and National Economy Minister Shaikh Salman bin Khalifa Al Khalifa took part in the online event entitled “Bahrain Metro Market Consultation.”

It introduced the project and presented the most important findings of previous studies including technical, financial

and legal aspects, in preparation for launching a global tender and bidding process for the qualification of developers.

The project will be implemented in partnership with the private sector.

It will cover a total area of 109 kilometres with four transit lines to be developed in phases.

Phase one will be made up of two lines with an estimated length of 28.6 kilometres. These will include 20 stations with two interchanges and will link Bahrain International Airport as well as major residential areas, commercial areas and school districts.

The project will surely improve the quality of life of citizens by providing a fast, comfortable, reliable and sustainable transportation system in the Kingdom.

National Space Science Authority engineers and technicians publish more than 10 scientific papers in 2020

Work is underway to publish 20 scientific papers this year


Focus on artificial intelligence applications, data analysis and space images

The engineers and technicians of the National Space Science Authority (NSSA) have published more than 10 scientific papers last year.

Work is underway to publish 20 scientific papers this year in international refereed journals and international conferences specialised in the field of building satellites and their applications, in addition to participating in conferences specialised in artificial intelligence applications in the field of space science, data analysis and space images.

Dr Mohammed Ibrahim Al Asiri, CEO of the NSSA, said that

this amount of research has resulted in cooperation with various parties in the framework of internal and external cooperation agreements.

One of the research studies came in collaboration with the University of Bahrain to study

the use of artificial intelligence techniques in the detection of leaks of gases in automatic control aircraft. Other research came in cooperation with Khalifa University of Science and Technology which focused on micro-satellites, which were

designed and developed by the Bahrain Space Team in cooperation with several specialised international bodies.

Dr Al Asiri said that some research studies dealt carefully with solving problems related to satellite systems, such as improving the quality of the communication system and increasing the capacity of the data that are carried in the ground stations.

He explained that among the distinguished research studies was the development of a control system and setting directions for the satellite using the "FPGA Board" that depends on the processing technology.

In parallel, the results of this research proved that the time taken to obtain satellite direction is faster than the programmes deployed in the market while ensuring the required

accuracy.

Dr Al Asiri said that some research studies have specialised in artificial intelligence applications, such as designing artificial intelligence algorithms to classify the pilot who operates an aircraft, the control mechanism while maintaining the accuracy of the mission in real time, pointing to the multiplicity of research in the fields of satellite data analysis such as applications of artificial intelligence in the detection of oil slicks using multiple technologies and software.

Digital transformation 'milestone' for Bahrain

iGA migrates essential government services to various digital channels last year

● Al Qaed outlines Kingdom's digital transformation programme achievements

The Information & eGovernment Authority (iGA) has successfully migrated all essential government services to various digital channels in 2020.

iGA Chief Executive Mohamed Ali Al Qaed said that this is a major milestone in the Kingdom's digital transformation efforts, particularly in the face of the challenges imposed by the global spread of COVID-19.

Al Qaed participated in a remote media briefing organised by the National Communication Centre as part of a series of government media briefings focused on the achievements of the Kingdom's digital transformation programme last year.

He noted that reaching this advanced stage in digital transformation stems from His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa's vision, which asserts the importance of deploying advanced technologies in the provision of government services.

Al Qaed also credited the realisation of this vision to the

bahrain.bh, 16 via self-service kiosks, and 97 via smartphone applications downloadable from the eGovernment app store, bahrain.bh/apps.

The eServices have played a key role in allowing the government to reduce operational costs by 82%, and have allowed users to carry out their transactions online with 69% higher efficiency compared to traditional

methods, thereby saving time to complete transactions by 76%.

Al Qaed cited an increase in financial transactions in 2020 by 38% compared to 2019, as the total number of transactions was over 2,200,000 across all government entities.

Total revenues collected from various digital channels increased by 48%, collecting a record of BD230 million, and surpassing the BD200 million mark for the first time. The National Portal received over 11 million visits.

Al Qaed highlighted several factors that led to the acceleration of digital transformation in 2020, including the Supreme Committee for Information and Communication Technology's directives, implemented in coordination with the iGA, and the iGA's efforts to restructure government service procedures and complete national digital transformation plans as part of the Kingdom's overall strategy.

This led to the re-engineering of 82 services, which are now more advanced and efficient.

Al Qaed said that deploying modern technologies and Artificial Intelligence (AI) in the development of government services has supported business continuity across the public sector, including the judicial sector, by helping to streamline procedures.

Dilmunia Canal is Bahrain's new tourist attraction

The 1.7km canal is the Kingdom's largest man-made water structure, stretching from the Dilmunia Marina in the north to Dilmunia Garden in the south.

The Dilmunia Canal development is being managed by Ithmaar Development Company (IDC), the Development Manager of the 125-hectare Dilmunia megaproject. The Real Estate Regulatory Authority (RERA) of Bahrain said it attaches prime importance to protecting buyers' right in the Golden Gate project.

RERA said in December 2020 that it was suspending the license awarded to GG Developers SPC for the project, citing violations of the provisions of Law 27/2017 promulgating the real estate sector regulations.

The authority had granted Golden Gate two licenses, a RERA Developers License for auditing and qualifying developers and a RERA Off-plan Sale Development License.

Yesterday, RERA said the authority had agreed to implement the best solution proposed.

This is "to preserve and ensure the interest of all parties in this project including developer, investors and buyers," RERA board members aid.

"The buyers' rights come first when implementing solutions for the 'Golden Gate project', RERA added.

The decision came as the RERA director held a virtual meeting yesterday headed by Sheikh Salman bin Abdullah bin Ham-

ad Al Khalifa, the President of Survey and Land Registration and Chairman of the Board of Directors of Real Estate Regulatory Authority.

Moving on, the board reviewed developments in real estate sectors and owners' association in various projects.

The board viewed that the "real estate sector today is working at a good pace despite the circumstances that face the world's economy."

"RERA is working hard to develop suitable solutions to the problems and obstacles experienced by institutions and developers and real estate development projects to achieve success," Sheikh Mohammed said.

OPEC+ considering oil output roll over for April, sources say

OPEC and other oil producers, a group known as OPEC+, are considering rolling over production cuts into April instead of raising output as a recovery in oil demand remains fragile due to the coronavirus crisis, three OPEC+ sources told Reuters.

OPEC+ ministers hold a full meeting on Thursday.

The market has been expecting OPEC+ to ease production cuts by around 500,000 barrels per day (bpd) from April.

Saudi Arabia has also been expected to end its voluntary production cut of an additional 1 million bpd.


But three OPEC+ sources said on Wednesday some key OPEC members had suggested keeping OPEC+ output unchanged.

Oil prices jumped by about \$1 per barrel on the news to trade near \$64 per barrel.

called for "cautious optimism" ties in the physical markets and citing "underlying uncertain- macro sentiment, including

risks from COVID-19 mutations that are still on the rise".

OPEC expects global oil demand in 2021 to grow by 5.8 million bpd to about 96 million bpd. That would still be lower than demand in 2019 which was about 100 million bpd.

Russia has been widely expected to push for more increases. But in February it failed to raise output despite being allowed to do so by OPEC+ as harsh winter weather hit output at mature fields.

JP Morgan, which said it spoke to Russia's representative on the OPEC+ technical committee Denis Deryushkin, reported that Russia saw some rationale in raising output as the oil market was in a 500,000 bpd deficit.

"Russia believes that if output is maintained at current levels, the market would move into an even more severe deficit," the bank said. "As such, production needs to be restored, but the speed and amount are yet to be decided."

Volkswagen CEO tweets, Musk-style, on market-cap milestone

When the market value of Germany's Volkswagen rose above the 100-billion-euro mark yesterday for the first time since 2015, the boss of the normally staid carmaker took to Twitter, Elon Musk-style, to crow about it.

VW shares soared as much as 6% after investment bank UBS raised its price target on the stock by 50% and said the company's new electric vehicle platform was set to challenge Tesla's dominance in the battery electric vehicle (BEV) market.

Herbert Diess, chief executive of VW Group, highlighted the UBS note on Twitter and shared the market capitalisation milestone.

"The market has been waiting for our #BEV-ramp-up and wanted to see some proof points," Diess posted.

Google won't use other web tracking tools after phasing out cookies

Alphabet Inc's Google will not build or use alternate tools to track web browsing traffic once it begins phasing out existing technology from its Chrome browser next year, it said in a blog post yesterday, in a move that will reshape how online advertising works.

Google first announced it would get rid of third-party cookies, which for decades has enabled online ads, early last year to meet growing data privacy standards in Europe and the United States.

Privacy activists for years have criticised tech companies including Google for using cookies to gather web browsing records across websites they don't own, enabling them to develop profiles on users' interests to serve personalised ads.

Now, Google is pledging it will not use other technology to replace the cookie or build features inside Chrome to allow itself access to that data, though it continues to test ways for businesses to target ads to large groups of anonymous users with common interests.

"Keeping the internet open and accessible for everyone requires all of us to do more to protect privacy – and that means an end to not only third-party cookies, but also any technology used for tracking individual people as they browse the web," Google said in the blog post.

Rival advertising tech companies are building tools to identify users across the web anonymously, including Criteo SA and The Trade Desk.

Total studying all-electric LNG plant in Oman

No mystery, top American pandemic expert lists nine govt actions behind plummeting Covid cases in India

There has been a global puzzlement at how India has managed to dramatically lower the spread of Covid-19 cases and fatality rates over the last few months, with some experts calling it a "mystery", but American scientist Yaneer Bar-Yam has said credit should go to the government for being able to identify and leverage its strengths to limit the spread of the infection.

Bar-Yam, who specialises in quantitative analysis of pandemics, said underlying factors such as previous successful response efforts in pandemics, less urbanisation that limits travel and rates of community transmission, limited travel and localised tourism were all important in mitigating the impact of Covid-19.

But he pointed out that swift government action of "restricting/regulating movement to increasing public health capacity to meet the increasing demands of the pandemic," were equally essential as India seems to have done enough to emerge successful in limiting the impact of the virus.

In September last year, India was confirming nearly 1 lakh cases a day, but that figure has dropped to approximately 12,000 as the country has effectively flattened the curve. The case fatality rate has also dropped sharply.

Highlighting steps taken by the government, Bar-Yam said that in particular decisions to impose severe restrictions on travel, stop gatherings, targeted localized lockdowns, school closures, had proven effective in controlling the outbreak. Other major steps like effective public communication, improvements in case identification, rapid ramping of industrial production of masks and other personal protective equipment (PPE) and testing capacity, have also contributed, he added.

Bar-Yam said that India's success showed that time and



travel are key to controlling pandemics. "The message to go out from India therefore is 'restrict travel in areas wherein cases are there, isolate cases and don't allow them to transmit infection,'" he wrote.

In a paper published on his website endcoronavirus.org, he listed the nine major government actions because of which India had managed to tame the infection as well as it has:

◆ He described the zoning of the country into three zones – red, orange and green – for localised lockdowns as probably the most effective step taken by the government last April. While severe restrictions were imposed in affected districts, there was partial lifting of restrictions in unaffected districts, along with the opening up of some sectors to meet the economic challenge.

◆ Restriction on travel was the second most important step, as travel was regulated through issue of e-pass with checks on state borders across the country. The regulation of travel continues into 2021 as travel has not been fully de-regulated, he said.

◆ Isolation and contact

tracing of individuals who test

positive to Covid-19, and quarantining of primary high-risk contacts has been an effective strategy.

◆ The government shut

down all colleges and schools

for an extended period, and

the recent reopening has been partial and only in the context of the very low number of cases recently.

◆ Bar-Yam said highlighted the contribution of the Indian industry, which he said responded like never before by producing masks and personal protective equipment at great pace not only to meet the country's requirements, but also to supply to the world.

◆ India has gone from a single lab that could perform RT-PCR tests for Covid-19 to over 2300 in a short span of time, and this number has reduced the test result return time and also strengthened isolation and quarantine strategy.

◆ From cautionary caller tunes on phones to heavy fines for not wearing masks, spreading public awareness about Covid-19 risks has been a major initiative of the government, and this has meant the population more willingly accepted restriction guidelines.

◆ The American scientist also praised the response in high-density urban areas, which posed the greatest challenge, but the refinement of lockdowns, travel restrictions, rapid case identification, and communication found in other locations, has helped limited the spread.

◆ He said that the vaccination drive, which is the largest in the world, is also expected to have an increasingly significant impact on the outbreak control in India.

Myanmar security forces opened fire on protests against military rule on Wednesday, killing at least 13 people, witnesses and media reported, a day after neighbouring countries called for restraint and offered to help Myanmar resolve the crisis.

The security forces resorted to live fire with little warning in several towns and cities, witnesses said, as the junta appeared more determined than ever to stamp out protests against the Feb. 1 coup that ousted the elected government of Aung San Suu Kyi.

Pregnant woman, five others killed as ambulance hits land mine in Burkina Faso

A pregnant woman and five other people died when an ambulance carrying them hit a land mine in northern Burkina Faso, in an area that has come under repeated militant attacks, the government said.

The ambulance was carrying the woman, her husband, a girl and two other women between the towns of Gaskindé and Namissiguia, near Burkina Faso's border with Mali on Tuesday, the government said.

No group immediately claimed responsibility for laying the land mine.

Attacks in Burkina Faso by fighters linked to Al Qaeda and Islamic State have risen sharply over the last three years, displacing more than a million people. Last month, Burkina Faso's government for the first time said that it was open to talks with Islamist militants to try to end the insurgency, a position echoed by authorities in neighbouring Mali.

Rockets land at Iraqi air base hosting US forces

At least 10 rockets landed on Wednesday at Iraq's Ain al-Asad air base that hosts United States, coalition and Iraqi forces, the Iraqi military said.

It was the second rocket attack in Iraq this month and came two days before Pope Francis is due to visit the country.

The attack caused no significant losses, Iraqi's military said without going into further detail.

A Baghdad Operations Command official told Reuters earlier that about 13 rockets were launched from a location about 8 km (5 miles) from the base, which is in western Anbar province.

Another Iraqi security

source and a government official who spoke on condition of anonymity said the rockets were launched from the Baider area, west of Baghda city.

The Pope will visit Iraq from March 5-8 despite deteriorating security in some parts of the country.

The military justified the coup saying its complaints of voter fraud in the Nov. 8 vote were ignored. Suu Kyi's party won by a landslide, earning a second term. The election commission said the vote was fair.

"We will continue this fight and win. We shall overcome this and win," she said.

On Tuesday, the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) failed to make a breakthrough in a virtual foreign ministers' meeting on Myanmar.

While united in a call for restraint, only four members - Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines

and Singapore - called for the release of Suu Kyi and other detainees.

"We expressed ASEAN's readiness to assist Myanmar in a positive, peaceful and constructive manner," the ASEAN chair, Brunei, said in a statement.

Myanmar's state media said the military-appointed foreign minister, Wunna Maung Lwin, attended the conference and "apprised the meeting of voting irregularities" in a November election.

Junta leader Senior General Min Aung Hlaing has pledged to hold new elections but given no time frame.

Suu Kyi, 75, has been held incommunicado since the coup but appeared at a court hearing via video conferencing this week and looked in good health, a lawyer said. She is one of nearly 1,300 people who have been detained, according to activists.

Ousted President Win Myint is facing two new charges, his lawyer, Khin Maung Zaw, said, including one for a breach of the constitution that is punishable by up to three years in prison.

Thai navy sailors braved choppy waters to launch a dramatic rescue this week after discovering four cats had been abandoned on a sinking ship that caught fire off a paradise island.

The cats are now being cared for by their rescuers at their command post on the island of Koh Lipe.

Cambodia's Royal Turtle lays eggs in captivity for first time



An endangered turtle bred in captivity laid eggs for the first time in Cambodia, conservationists said this week, in a massive win for animal protection in the kingdom.

The animal was among five Royal Turtles -- once feared extinct in the country -- that laid more than 70 eggs.

Cambodia is home to several populations of endangered turtles, whose numbers have dwindled due to demand for them in Vietnam and China as delicacies and for use in traditional medicine. Royal Turtles, formally classified as Southern River Terrapins, were pushed to the brink of extinction by hunting and sand mining, which destroys the banks where they lay their eggs.
