This year's programme included several specialised field visits, such as to the Military Museum and the Bahrain Football Association, to highlight the importance of sports in character building and promoting team spirit.


Participants also visited the Alba Club as a model of socially responsible industrial institutions, and the King Fahad Causeway to learn about the services provided at border checkpoints.

gricultural production in Bahrain climbed to 58,597.5 tonnes in 2024, marking a rise of 55 per cent over the past decade.

The figure stood at 37,806.5 tonnes in 2015, according to newly published data.

Vegetables made up the largest share, with output almost doubling to 28,600 tonnes.

Farmers appear to have focused on crops that meet everyday local needs, particularly those that require short supply chains.

Greenhouse farming came next.

anking business is an old business of volatile & vivid nature. What is peculiar to this business is, it is global international nature all over. 



ando Norris trimmed McLaren team-mate Oscar Piastri's lead in the drivers' world championship to just nine points yesterday when he switched tactics to lead him home by just 0.698 seconds in a thrilling finish at the Hungarian Grand Prix.

The 25-year-old Briton, who moved from a two-stop strategy to one stop, held off series leader Piastri, on fresher tyres, over the closing laps of a strategic contest to claim McLaren's 200th victory and their record 13th win in Hungary.

It was Norris's first win at the Hungaroring in the event's 40th race, avenging his 'team orders' defeat in 2024 when Piastri claimed his maiden success, his fifth victory of the season and the ninth of his career.
