Campaign engines start

MPs reopen offices and shift districts ahead of 2026 parliamentary election

Preparations for Bahrain's next parliamentary election have begun to stir, with a string of quiet but telling moves by political figures, former MPs and social activists.

As the current Council enters its final legislative stretch, a growing number of familiar names have reappeared in public, giving rise to talk of an early, undeclared contest already taking shape.

Media appearances have increased. So too have social initiatives and local engagements by figures who had kept a low profile for years.

Some had gone entirely silent or stopped their political activity altogether.

Several have now returned with renewed visibility, drawing attention across social plat-

forms, television and community events.

A number of sitting MPs have also reopened constituency offices or set up new ones.

Spaces

These spaces had remained shut or were not established at

all during the past few years.

Observers see this as a bid to reconnect directly with voters before what is expected to be a competitive season.

Some MPs have gone further. According to sources familiar with their plans, a few have formally changed their place of residence.

That move, which is allowed by law, enables them to contest elections in different districts.

Repositioning

It is being read as part of a broader repositioning effort as they seek new ground ahead of the vote.

Activity has not been limited to solo efforts. There are early signs of group coordination.

Former contenders and political activists have been meeting and exploring ways to align.

The goal appears to be to build early ties among likely entrants in the coming race and to lay the foundations for possible alliances.

In parallel, current and former MPs have stepped up their presence in the media.

Beyond interviews and written statements, some have launched community projects and voiced opinions on local matters.

These actions are seen by many as efforts to stay in the public eye and rebuild trust among voters.

No formal election schedule has been announced.

Preparations

Even so, the pace of movement on the ground suggests that preparations have already begun.

With summer 2026 widely anticipated as the expected timeframe, the months ahead are likely to bring more appearances, louder rhetoric and, in some cases, direct rivalry.

For now, Bahrain's electorate is watching closely, weighing the return of old names and the early positioning that points to a contest already in motion.

Bahrain-US ties

Green sector thrives

Bahrain’s farm output jumps 55% over decade; vegetable production nearly doubles

Agricultural production in Bahrain climbed to 58,597.5 tonnes in 2024, marking a rise of 55 per cent over the past decade.

The figure stood at 37,806.5 tonnes in 2015, according to newly published data.

Vegetables made up the largest share, with output almost doubling to 28,600 tonnes.

Farmers appear to have focused on crops that meet everyday local needs, particularly those that require short supply chains.

Greenhouse farming came next.

Growing conditions

Produce grown under cover rose from 9,405 tonnes in 2015 to 15,900 tonnes last year, suggesting a marked shift towards controlled growing conditions



in response to soil and climate limits. Date production remained relatively steady.

The harvest stood at 13,200 tonnes in 2015 and moved within a narrow band over the following years, reaching 14,000 tonnes in 2024.

Change

Fruits, once an afterthought in the figures, showed the fastest change in pace.

From barely 1.5 tonnes in 2015 and 2016, output rose to

2.8 tonnes in 2021.

It then surged to 62 tonnes in 2022, 78 tonnes in 2023, and nearly hit triple digits with 97.5 tonnes last year.

The rise across all categories comes amid a mix of public backing, expansion in year-round farm projects and efforts aimed at building up food self-reliance while cutting back on foreign imports.

Al Mawasim launches Hajj Media Campaign

The Al Mawasim Hajj and Umrah Campaign launched its media campaign for the 1447 Hijri Hajj season on Saturday evening with a public event at Seef Mall’s Cinema Hall 10.

The gathering drew a mix of prominent personalities, journalists, online contributors, and those with a strong interest in religious affairs.

Among those present were Dr Abdulrahman Hashem Shalli, general supervisor of Centre 99 at Al Bait Guests Company for the pilgrims of Bahrain’s Hajj mission, and MP Abdulwahid Abdulaziz Qarata.

Also in attendance were invited guests and several pilgrims who had appeared in the campaign’s documentary Perfect Score.

The evening opened with

a short welcome, followed by the screening of the film.

It followed a group of pilgrims from their preparations through to the rites themselves.

The audience responded warmly to its moving scenes and vivid footage.

It also showed the level of support provided throughout, from accommodation to daily guidance.

A brief ceremony was held to recognise journalists, campaign staff and social media users who had helped share last year’s work with the public.

Speaking at the event, Jassim Abul, who leads the campaign, said this media effort was part of a wider plan to improve what is offered this year.

The aim, he said, is to make the process easier for pilgrims and ensure they feel safe and well looked after.

Salmaniya multi-story building fire

A multi-story residential building in the Salmaniya area was evacuated as a precautionary measure after a fire broke out in one of its apartments, the General Directorate of Civil Defense has confirmed. Firefighters swiftly responded to the incident,

successfully containing and extinguishing the blaze. No injuries were reported.

The National Ambulance Service was present at the scene and took all necessary precautionary measures.

Meanwhile, relevant authorities have launched an investigation to determine the cause of the fire.

Ithmaar Bank announces half-year profits

Ithmaar Bank B.S.C. (closed), a Bahrain-based Islamic retail bank, reported profits for the first half of the year as it announced its financial results for the six-month period ended 30 June 2025.

The announcement, by Ithmaar Bank Chairman His Royal Highness Prince Amr Al Faisal, follows the review and approval of the Board of Directors of the Bank's consolidated financial results.

The results show a net profit attributable to equity holders of the Bank for the three-month period ended 30 June 2025 of BD1.47 million compared to the

net profit of BD3.53 million reported for the same period in 2024. Total profit for the three-month period ended 30 June

2025 was BD3.33 million, compared to a net profit of BD5.78 million for the same period in 2024. The decrease is mainly

due to reduced spreads in their overseas business resulting from the decreasing profit rate environment.

The results also show a net profit attributable to equity holders for the six-month period ended 30 June 2025 of BD2.80 million, compared to a net profit of BD7.78 million for the same period in 2024. Total profit for the six-month period ended 30 June 2025 was BD7.10 million, compared to a net profit of BD13.52 million for the same period in 2024.

"On behalf of Ithmaar Bank Board of Directors, I am pleased to announce that despite the challenging global economic

situation, the Bank continued to report profit for the half-year," said HRH Prince Amr. "This is due to the Bank's continuous efforts and focus to achieve further growth in its core Islamic banking business in Bahrain and Pakistan and further enhancing the value of its strategic investments," he said.

Ithmaar Bank's Chief Executive Officer, Maysan Al Maskati stated that "the financial results show that the Bank's efforts to continuously grow its core business and enhance its corporate customers Islamic banking experience had paid off".

"As a result of the Bank's continued efforts, the liquidi-

ty position has also improved, as reflected by an increase in its Liquidity Coverage Ratio (LCR) to 112 percent at 30 June 2025 from 104 percent at 31 December 2024," said Al Maskati. "Furthermore, the deposit mobilisation efforts have yielded positive results as the quasi-equity liabilities has crossed BD1 billion mark, reaching BD1.07 billion at 30 June 2025 compared to BD0.96 billion at 31 December 2024," he said.

Total owners' equity increased to BD53.34 million as at 30 June 2025, a 5.5 percent increase from BD50.54 million as at 31 December 2024.

Eight OPEC+ countries raise production by 547,000 bpd

Current production is about 41-42 million barrels a day

The eight OPEC+ countries said yesterday they will increase production by 547,000 barrels a day in a move which analysts say aims to regain market share amid resilient crude prices.

Saudi Arabia, Russia, Iraq, United Arab Emirates, Kuwait, Kazakhstan, Algeria and Oman currently produce about 41-42 million barrels a day, so the in-

crease is about 1.5 percent.

Analysts said there was unlikely to be a major impact on prices, with the Brent reference oil currently selling at about \$70 a barrel.

"The eight participating countries will implement a production adjustment of 547,000 barrels per day in September 2025 from August 2025 required production level," said a statement

released after a meeting that agreed the hike.

The eight key oil-producers, who started increasing production in April, affirmed their commitment to market stability on "current healthy oil market fundamentals," an OPEC statement read.

"OPEC+ has passed the first test -- unwinding 2.2 million barrels per day (since April) without crashing prices or compromising unity," said Jorge Leon, analyst at Rystad Energy.

"But the next task will be even harder: deciding if and when to unwind the remaining 1.66 million barrels, all while navigating geopolitical tension and preserving cohesion," said Leon.

The statement said the decision came "in view of a steady global economic outlook and current healthy market fundamentals, as reflected in the low oil inventories."

The OPEC+ countries agreed

in December to start a gradual return from April 2025 of the 2.2 million barrels per day of previous production cuts.

The statement said that "the phase-out of the additional voluntary production adjustments may be paused or reversed subject to evolving market conditions."

The eight added they will hold monthly meetings for a regular review of market conditions.

In a bid to boost prices, the wider OPEC+ group -- comprising the 12-nation Organization of the Petroleum Exporting Countries (OPEC) and its allies -- in recent years had agreed to three different tranches of output cuts that amounted to almost six million bpd in total.

Prior to the announcement, UBS analyst Giovanni Staunovo had suggested the quota increase was "largely priced in" on energy markets with the price of Brent, the global oil benchmark, ex-

pected to remain near its current level of around \$70 per barrel after Sunday's decision.



In 2023, the United States became the first country in history to produce more than 12 million barrels of crude oil per day on average for an entire year -- surpassing both Saudi Arabia and Russia. This surge was driven largely by the shale oil boom in Texas and North Dakota, making the U.S. not only the world's top oil producer but also largely energy-independent for the first time in decades.

US trade advisor says Trump tariff rates unlikely to change

Washington, United States

New US tariff rates are "pretty much set" with little immediate room for negotiation, Donald Trump's trade advisor said in remarks aired Sunday, also defending the president's politically driven levies against Brazil.

Trump, who has wielded tariffs as a tool of American economic might, has set tariff rates for dozens of economies including the European Union at between 10 and 41 percent come August 7, his new hard deadline for the duties.

In a pre-taped interview broadcast Sunday on CBS's "Face the Nation," US Trade Representative Jamieson Greer said "the coming days" are not likely to see changes in the tariff rates.

"A lot of these are set rates pursuant to deals. Some of these deals are announced, some are not, others depend on the level of the trade deficit or surplus we may have with the country," Greer said.

"These tariff rates are pretty much set."

Undoubtedly some trade ministers "want to talk more and see how they can work in a different way with the United States," he added.

But "we're seeing truly the contours of the president's tariff plan right now with these rates."

Last Thursday, the former real estate developer announced hiked tariff rates on dozens of US trade partners.

They will kick in on August 7 instead of August 1, which had previously been touted as a hard deadline.

Among the countries facing steep new levies is Brazil. South America's largest

economy is being hit with 50 percent tariffs on exports to the United States -- albeit with significant exemptions for key products such as aircraft and orange juice.

Trump has openly admitted he is punishing Brazil for prosecuting his political ally Jair Bolsonaro, the ex-president accused of plotting a coup in a bid to cling to power. The US president has described the case as a "witch hunt."

Greer said it was not unusual for Trump to use tariff tools for geopolitical purposes.

"The president has seen in Brazil, like he's seen in other countries, a misuse of law, a misuse of democracy," Greer told CBS. "It is normal to use these tools for geopolitical issues."

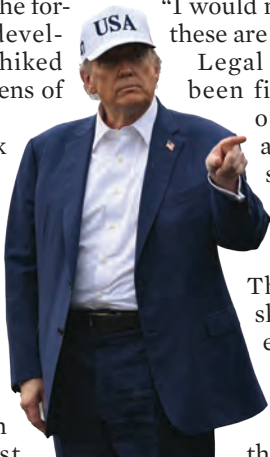
Trump was "elected to assess the foreign affairs situation... and take appropriate action," he added.

Meanwhile White House economic advisor Kevin Hassett said that while talks are expected to continue over the next week with some US trade partners, he concurred with Greer's tariffs assessment in that the bulk of the rates "are more or less locked in."

Asked by the host of NBC's Sunday talk show "Meet the Press with Kristen Welker" if Trump could change tariff rates should financial markets react negatively, Hassett said: "I would rule it out, because these are the final deals."

Legal challenges have been filed against some of Trump's tariffs arguing he overstepped his authority.

An appeals court panel on Thursday appeared skeptical of the government's arguments, though the case may be ultimately decided at the Supreme Court.

DR Congo, Rwanda outline deal on mining, economic cooperation: US

The Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and Rwanda have reached an outline economic cooperation accord during their first talks since signing a peace deal, the United States announced.

A peace agreement reached in June aimed to end decades of conflict in eastern Congo. It was overseen by Washington which has sought to increase its access to the region's vast mineral wealth.

The "economic integration framework" initiated on Friday is part of the peace accord, the US State Department said.

It is designed, according to the peace deal, to introduce greater transparency into supply chains for critical minerals such as coltan and lithium and should be effective by the end of September.

The State Department said the two countries had agreed to coordinate "in areas including energy, infrastructure, mining, national park management and tourism, and public health", without giving further details.

"These milestones represent concrete progress in advancing security, economic cooperation, and the shared pursuit of peace and prosperity under the Peace Agreement," Massad Boulos, President Donald Trump's senior advisor on Africa, posted on X.

Eastern DRC, a region bordering Rwanda with abundant natural resources, saw a fresh surge of violence this year when the M23 armed group, backed by Rwandan troops, captured the

key cities of Goma and Bukavu. After months of broken truces, the DRC and M23 signed a declaration of principle on June 19 reaffirming their commitment to a permanent ceasefire.

Two days earlier, the Kinshasa government inked an agreement with US group Kobold Metals, which specialises in exploring for critical metals.

DRC President Felix Tshise-kedi said in April he had met US envoy Massad Boulos to discuss access to minerals.

Coveted minerals

The DRC is the world's leading producer of cobalt.

It also has deposits of gold and other valuable minerals including coltan, a metallic ore that is vital in making phones and laptops, and lithium, which is essential for electric car batteries.

On Thursday and Friday, representatives from the DRC and Rwanda, alongside observers from the United States, Qatar and the African Union, held

their first meetings in Washington since signing the peace deal.

The US said the economic framework and a meeting on Thursday of the countries' peace deal monitoring committee were a "significant step", saying the African neighbours were "taking meaningful actions to advance security and economic cooperation".

The peace deal has been welcomed by the African Union and the United Nations, even if analysts remain sceptical about the chances of long-term peace while militias still hold sway in much of eastern DRC.

The UN says thousands have been killed in the recent unrest and hundreds of thousands displaced.

Rwanda denies providing military support to the M23 but says its security has long been threatened by the presence in the region of the Democratic Forces for the Liberation of Rwanda (FDLR), established by ethnic Hutus linked to the massacres of Tutsis in the 1994 Rwandan genocide.

Kinshasa and the M23 have given themselves until August 8 to start talks on a comprehensive peace accord, to be signed by August 17.

Analysts view such deadlines as unrealistic, especially given the M23's reluctance to withdraw from areas it controls.

Athens mayor clashes with Israel ambassador over antisemitic graffiti

The mayor of Athens became embroiled in a war of words Sunday with the Israeli ambassador to Greece who accused city authorities of not doing enough to clean up antisemitic graffiti.

Ambassador Noam Katz told the Kathimerini daily in comments published Sunday that Israeli tourists felt "uncomfortable" in Athens because the mayor Haris Doukas does not act against "organised minorities" who put up anti-Jewish graffiti.

Doukas responded within hours on X: We have proved our strong opposition to violence and racism and we do not take lessons in democracy from those who kill civilians.

"Athens, capital of a demo-

cratic country, fully respects its free expression of its citizens," visitors and supports the right of the Socialist PASOK party mayor

added.

"It is revolting that the ambassador concentrates on graffiti (that is clearly wiped off)

while an unprecedented genocide is taking place in Gaza," Doukas added.

Greece, as well as several

other European nations, has seen a number of left-wing led pro-Palestinian demonstrations. A cruise ship carrying Israeli tourists around the Greek islands was greeted by demonstrations in several ports.

While following a pro-Arab policy for several decades, Greece has since 2010 stepped up links with Israel, notably on security and energy.

Since the Gaza war started in October 2023, with the Hamas attack on Israel, a growing number of Israelis have visited Greece and started investing in its property market.

According to the Athens mayor, the number of Israelis who have secured Greek residents permits by buying property increased by 90 percent last year.

Assange joins **pro-Palestinian**
protest on Sydney Harbour Bridge

Tens of thousands of pro-Palestinian protesters including WikiLeaks founder Julian Assange marched across the Sydney Harbour Bridge yesterday, closing the world famous landmark.

Assange, who returned to Australia last year after his release from a high-security British prison, was pictured surrounded by family and marching alongside former Australian foreign minister and New South Wales premier Bob Carr.

France, Britain and Canada have in recent weeks voiced, in some cases qualified, intentions to diplomatically recognise a Palestinian state as international concern and criticism have grown

over malnutrition in Gaza.

Australia has called for an end to the war in Gaza but has so far stopped short of a decision to recognise a Palestinian state.

But in a joint statement with more than a dozen other nations on Tuesday it expressed the "willingness or the positive consideration... to recognise the state of Palestine as an essential step towards the two-State solution".

The pro-Palestinian crowd braved heavy winds and rain to march across the bridge, chanting "ceasefire now" and "free Palestine".

New South Wales police said it had deployed hundreds of extra staff across Sydney for the march.

Mehreen Faruqi, the New South Wales senator for the left-wing Greens party, told the crowd gathered

at central Sydney's Lang Park that the march would "make history".

She called for the "harshest sanctions on Israel", accusing its forces of "massacring" Gazans, and criticised New South Wales premier Chris Minns for saying the protest should not go ahead.

Dozens of marchers held up banners listing the names of thousands of Palestinian children killed since the Gaza war broke out after an October 2023 attack by Palestinian militant group Hamas.

Labor backbench MP Ed Husic attended the march and called for his ruling party, led by Prime Minister Anthony Albanese, to recognise a Palestinian state.

Assange did not address the crowd or talk to the media.



Julian Assange started hacking computers when he was just 16 years old, using the alias "Mendax"—inspired by the Latin phrase "splendide mendax," meaning "nobly untruthful." By his early twenties, he had hacked into major organisations including NASA and the Pentagon, which later led to a police investigation and a fine, but he avoided jail. This early experience laid the groundwork for his later creation of WikiLeaks in 2006.

Pope's 'Jubilee of Youth' ends with mass for 1 million pilgrims

lee holy year -- was an enormous undertaking for the Vatican, with a half a million young pilgrims in Rome for most of the week.

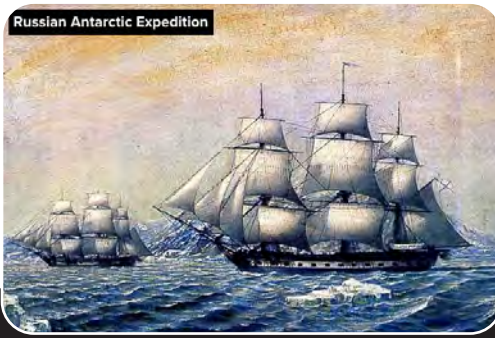
On Saturday night, before a twilight vigil led by the pope, organisers said there were 800,000

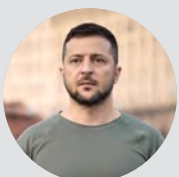

Palestinians protest Gaza war

One of the largest marches took place in Ramallah

Thousands of Palestinians protested in the occupied West Bank's major cities yesterday against the war in Gaza and in support of Palestinians held in Israeli prisons.

One of the largest marches took place in Ramallah, the seat of the Palestinian Authority located just north of Jerusalem, with hundreds gathering at the main square, waving Palestinian flags.

Many protesters carried photos of Palestinians killed or imprisoned by Israel, as well as photos depicting the hunger crisis unfolding in the Gaza Strip, where UN-backed experts

have warned that a "famine is unfolding".

"My son is in (Israel's) Megido prison and he suffers from many things, such as the lack of medicine the lack of food," Rula Ghanem, a Palestinian academic and writer who took part in the march, told AFP.

She told AFP that her son had lost 10 kilograms and suffered from scabies in jail.

The number of Palestinians jailed by Israel skyrocketed after the start of the war in Gaza, some for violent acts, but some also for posting political statements on social media, the Palestinian Commission of Detainees' and Ex-Detainees' Affairs says.

The commission's spokesman Thaer Shriteh told AFP: "The international community is a partner in all this suffering, as long as it does not intervene quickly to save the Palestinian people and save the prisoners inside the prisons and detention centre."

A group of protesters dressed as skeletons and carried dolls around to symbolise the Gaza

war's dire effect on children, who are most at risk of malnutrition.

Israel has heavily restricted the entry of aid into Gaza, which was already under blockade for 15 years before the war began.

UN agencies, humanitarian groups and analysts say that much of the trickle of food aid that Israel allows in is looted or diverted in chaotic circumstances.

"We hope that our stand today will have an impact in supporting our people in Gaza and the hungry children in Gaza," said 39-year-old Tagreed Zia-da, one of the protesters at the Ramallah march.

Protests were held Sunday in other major Palestinian cities such as Nablus in the north and Hebron in the south, with many government employees receiving a day off to attend the demonstrations.

While there have been somewhat regular demonstrations against the war in Gaza, they are rarely coordinated across various cities in the West Bank.

Israeli far-right minister prays on Al-Aqsa compound in Jerusalem

Israel's far-right National Security Minister Itamar Ben Gvir publicly conducted yesterday a Jewish prayer on the Al-Aqsa compound in east Jerusalem -- a highly contentious move that violates a long-held understanding at the site.

The Al-Aqsa compound is Islam's third-holiest site, and is also Judaism's holiest place, revered as the site of the first and second Jewish temples.

Jewish religious ritu-

als are prohibited there by a long-standing agreement between Israel and Jordan, custodian of the site.

In recent years, the understanding, known as the "status quo" has been repeatedly violated by Jewish visitors, including members of Israel's parliament.

Ben Gvir's Sunday visit however marked the first time a prayer was publicly recited by a government minister, according to Israeli media.

At least 27 migrants dead in shipwreck off Yemen

Dubai, United Arab Emirates

At least 27 migrants are dead and more than 100 missing following a sinking off the coast of Yemen, two security sources in the southern province of Abyan told AFP on Sunday.

"At this stage, the deaths of 27 people are confirmed, their bodies have been recovered," one security source said, adding that "searches are ongoing".

A second source said "150 people were on board the vessel that sank", also reporting 27 dead.

Dormant Russia volcano erupts for first time in 450 years

A volcano erupted for the first time in 450 years in Russia's eastern Kamchatka region, the nation's emergency authority said Sunday, days after one of the strongest earthquakes on record hit the region.

Pictures released by Russian state media show a towering plume of ash spewing from the Krashennnikov volcano, which last erupted in 1550, according to the Smithsonian Institution's Global Volcanism Program.

The plume is estimated to have reached an altitude of 6,000 metres (19,700 feet), Kamchatka's Ministry of Emergency Situations said in a post on Telegram.

"The plume is spreading eastward from the volcano toward the Pacific Ocean. There are no populated areas along its path, and no ashfall has been recorded in inhabited localities," the ministry said.

The volcano has been assigned an "orange" aviation hazard code, the ministry add-

ed, meaning flights in the area may be disrupted.

It came after Klyuchevskoy, another volcano in the region -- the highest active in Europe and Asia -- erupted on Wednesday.

Eruptions of Klyuchevskoy are quite common, with at least 18 occurring since 2000, according to the Global Volcanism Program.

Both recent eruptions followed one of the strongest earthquakes ever recorded, which struck on Wednesday, sparking tsunami warnings and evacuations of millions of people from coastal areas from Japan to Hawaii to Ecuador.

The worst damage was seen in Russia, where a tsunami crashed through the port of Severo-Kurilsk and submerged a fishing plant, officials said.

The magnitude 8.8 quake struck off Petropavlovsk on Russia's Kamchatka peninsula and was the strongest since 2011 when a magnitude 9.1 quake off Japan caused a tsunami that killed more than 15,000 people.

New Zealand woman arrested after travelling with child in suitcase

A New Zealand woman was arrested on Sunday after travelling on a bus with a two-year-old girl trapped in her luggage.

Detective Inspector Simon Harrison said the woman had been charged with ill-treatment and neglect of a child.

Police were called to a bus depot in Kaiwaka -- 100 kilometres (62 miles) north of Auckland -- after the bus driver became concerned about a bag moving during a scheduled stop.

"When the driver opened the suitcase, they discovered the two-year-old girl," Harrison

son said.

"The little girl was reported to be very hot, but otherwise appeared physically unharmed."

The luggage had been stored beneath the bus passengers, in a separate compartment.

Harrison said the girl is in hospital undergoing an extensive medical assessment.

A 27-year-old woman was arrested.

Harrison said the driver prevented "what could have been a far worse outcome".

He said further charges are possible. New Zealand's Ministry for Children, Oranga Tamariki, had been notified.



Tesla mulls smaller electric truck

Tesla is exploring the possibility of launching a smaller electric pickup truck, following a lukewarm market response to its larger Cybertruck model. Speaking at a Tesla owners

and investors event in California, Lars Moravy, Tesla's Vice President of Engineering, confirmed ongoing internal discussions about a compact truck. "We always talked about making a smaller pickup," he said, noting that the current Cybertruck is too large for certain markets. Moravy also indicated that

Tesla is assessing opportunities in the medium truck and small van segment, particularly as the company continues development in autonomous vehicle technology. "We look at those options and we think about, OK, that kind of service is useful not just for people, but also for goods," he said. Tesla does not currently of-

fer a delivery-focused vehicle. However, Moravy said the company has been actively working within its design studio to address that potential market. While the Cybertruck has been marketed as a lifestyle vehicle, a more practical, mid-sized electric truck could broaden Tesla's appeal if introduced.

Chevrolet launches 2026 Cruze sedan for Middle East market

Chevrolet has introduced the 2026 Cruze sedan, which will be sold exclusively in the Middle East. The model will be offered in two variants: LS and LT.

The new Cruze features a black honeycomb split grille, LED headlights, dual-element LED taillights, a rear spoiler, and 16-inch aluminium alloy wheels. Available exterior colours include Abalone White Tricoat, Black Kettle Metallic, Sharkskin Metallic, and Rip Tide Blue Metallic. Inside, the sedan comes with dual 10.25-inch screens—one for the instrument cluster and the other for the infotainment system. A six-speaker sound system, Android Auto, and Apple CarPlay are standard. The LT variant adds features such as leatherette seats in Captain Blue, a flat-bottom leather-wrapped steering wheel, sunroof, keyless start, heated and power-adjustable side



mirrors, and a six-way manually adjustable driver's seat. The vehicle is powered by a 1.5-litre four-cylinder petrol engine that delivers 111 bhp and 141 Nm of torque, paired with a six-speed dual-clutch automatic transmission. Standard safety features include two airbags, a rear-view camera, cruise control, and emergency braking warning. The LT trim includes four airbags and rear park assist. The 2026 Chevrolet Cruze will be available in Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, Qatar, Oman, Jordan, Lebanon, Iraq, and Bahrain.

Tata Motors to acquire Italian truck maker Iveco for \$4.5 billion

Tata Motors is set to acquire Italian truck maker Iveco. The \$4.5 billion deal is said to be the second-largest acquisition by the Indian conglomerate after Corus. As per media reports, the board of Tata Motors and Iveco will be meeting on July 30, 2025, to finalize the transaction. Tata Motors will buy 27.1% from Exor, the invest-

ment company of the Agnelli family – the principal shareholder. Exor also controls 43.1% of the voting rights. Iveco recently confirmed its plans to break up the company and sell its defence and commercial units to separate buyers. The company said that it was in "ongoing, advanced" talks with different parties. "The board of directors of the company is in the process of carefully reviewi



BMW M2 CS sets compact class record at Nürburgring Nordschleife

The BMW M2 CS has recorded the fastest lap time for a compact car at the Nürburgring Nordschleife. Driven by BMW M development engineer Jörg Weidinger, the vehicle completed the

20.823-kilometre circuit in 7 minutes and 25.5 seconds, improving the previous best in its category by eight seconds. This marks a significant improvement over the earlier record for the M2 model, also set by Weidinger in April 2023,

with a time of 7:38.7. In the mid-size segment, the BMW M3 CS Touring posted a lap time of 7:29.490, making it the fastest production Touring model on the Nürburgring Nordschleife to date. The previous record for

this body style was set in 2022 by the BMW M3 Touring, with a time of 7:35.060. Among other recent timings from BMW's mid-size lineup, the M4 CSL remains the fastest with a 7:18.137 lap, fol-

lowed by the M4 CS at 7:21.989 and the M3 CS at 7:28.760. All recorded times were achieved under the supervision of a neutral testing organization to ensure adherence to production vehicle standards.

The Nürburgring Nordschleife, often referred to as the "Green Hell," is widely regarded as one of the most demanding circuits globally. The 20.832-kilometre track features over 70 turns and is commonly used as a benchmark for vehicle performance testing.

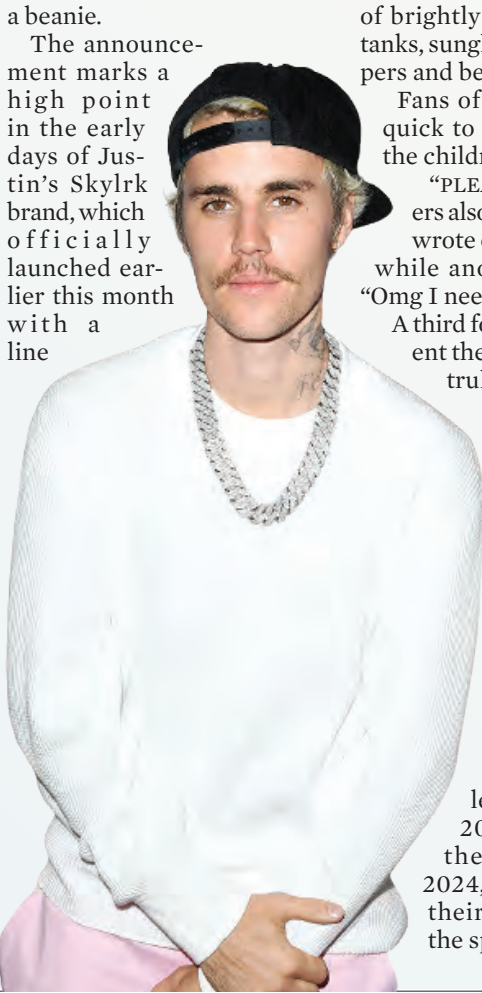

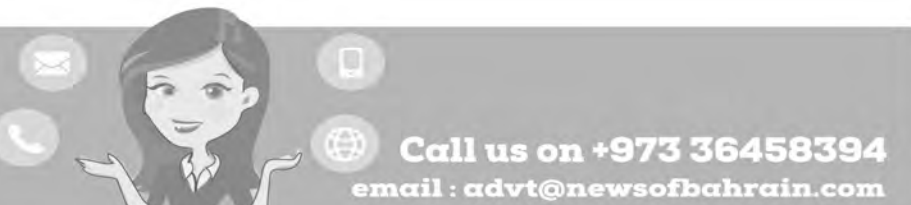

Zverev and Popyrin book Toronto quarter-final clash

Zverev advances to fifth Canadian Masters quarter-final after Cerundolo exits hurt

Top-seeded Alexander Zverev advanced to an ATP Toronto Masters quarter-final against defending champion Alexei Popyrin as his fourth-round opponent Francisco Cerundolo was forced to retire with an abdominal injury on Saturday.

Germany's Zverev secured a 6-4, 1-0 victory, Argentina's Cerundolo taking a medical timeout after the fifth game and finally calling a halt after less than an hour on court.

Australia's Popyrin won his ninth straight match in Canada, beating ninth seed Holger Rune 4-6, 6-2, 6-3.

The 26th-ranked Aussie profitted from nearly 40 unforced errors from his Danish opponent, who has been taking occasional advice from Andre Agassi.

With Popyrin on the horizon, Zverev said he was headed back to the practice court after his abbreviated victory, but he paid tribute to Cerundolo first.

"He's an incredible player, we

saved a break point with his sixth ace against Rune as he served for victory in the final game, finishing the job with a lob winner which left Rune flat-footed.

"I just let go of the pressure and it worked out for me," added Popyrin, who said dropping the first set did not sit well.

"I told myself to keep going and managed to play ag-

Karen Khachanov reached his second straight prestige quarter-final, ambushing eighth seed Casper Ruud 6-4, 7-5 to continue his ATP hot streak.

Khachanov next faces Alex Michelsen, who claimed his first Masters last-eight place with a 6-3, 6-3 victory over fellow American and good friend Learner Tien.

Khachanov was playing his first tournament

since reaching the Wimbledon quarter-finals last month.

The world number 16 reeled off 18 straight points on serve over the first and second sets and produced love games in his final two service games of the match.

Norway's Ruud, playing his second event after skipping Wimbledon because of injury, was never able to gain control, although he rallied from 4-2 down in the second set to level at 4-4 before Khachanov got back on track.

"I had nothing to complain about until this point," Khachanov said. "I tried to control play and my game plan was working, especially with the first serves.

"It became difficult, but I'm super-glad I was able to put everything together at the end and finish the match."

Michelsen took full advantage of 42 unforced errors from Tien to close out their match in 81 minutes.

"It feels really good," the 20-year-old winner said. "It's uncharted territory from now on. I'm super-happy to be in the quarters."

Michelsen said that despite the raft of errors from Tien he had to take care with his own forehand to claim the victory.

"I hit my forehand super-well today and I knew that if I didn't I would be in trouble," he said.

Canadian teen Mboko stuns top-seeded Gauff in Montreal

Canadian teenager Victoria Mboko took down top-seeded American Coco Gauff 6-1, 6-4 on Saturday, thrilling the home crowd as she reached the quarter-finals of the WTA 1000 tournament in Montreal.

The 18-year-old wild card saved all four break points she faced, and broke reigning French Open champion Gauff three times on the way to a comprehensive victory in just 62 minutes.

"I don't even know what to say still, I was kind of shocked about it all," said Mboko, adding that the support of the home crowd had buoyed her late in the second set.

"I just remember in the last game when I was up 5-4, the crowd kind of started cheering even louder, and everything got super noisy," she said. "I kind of used that as more fuel for myself

and to pump myself up a little bit more.

"I think it helped me tremendously, especially in the last game, since they were so encouraging me. It was just amazing."

Mboko started the season ranked 333rd in the world and has worked her way up to 85 but the win over Gauff -- who she took to three sets in Rome in May -- is the biggest win of her career.

"Playing Coco is obviously never easy. She's number two in the world, and it has been such a great opportunity for me to play against someone like her," Mboko said. "I was just happy I kept my composure today and I pulled it through."

Gauff, who had a combined 37 double faults as she struggled through her first two matches, was caught flat-footed as the Canadian teen raced through the

first set in 25 minutes.

Gauff buckled down in the second, but she was unable to convert three break chances in the seventh game -- coming up short on a drop shot and smacking a forehand into the net on the first two.

She gained another chance only to hit a service return long, then flew a volley wide to give Mboko a game point, duly converted when Gauff fired a forehand

long.

Down 15-30 in the ninth game, Mboko leveled at 30-30 with a blistering backhand, then closed out the hold for a 5-4 lead.

Serving to stay in the match, Gauff fell in a quick 0-30 hole and double-faulted to give Mboko a match point, on which the American hit a backhand into the net.

"She played a really great match, that's basically it," Gauff said.

"I haven't played the best in this tournament, so I knew that it would be tough. I just felt like I could do better today, but I also knew that if I took my foot off the gas a little bit that she would take advantage of those moments, and she did."

Mboko will next play Spain's Jessica Bouzas Maneiro, who

won a see-saw battle with China's Zhu Lin 7-5, 1-6, 6-2.

Former Wimbledon champion Elena Rybakina outlasted Dayana Yastremska 5-7, 6-2, 7-5 to book a quarter-final clash with Marta Kostyuk.

Kazakhstan's Rybakina, the 2022 Wimbledon champion who won her first title in more than a year at Strasbourg in May, was slowed by nine double faults.

But she ultimately had enough to get past Ukraine's Yastremska, breaking her twice in the third set and sealing it on her fourth match point.

She'll face another Ukrainian in Kostyuk, who came from behind to beat American McCartney Kessler 5-7, 6-3, 6-3.

Rain leaves Oval Test on a knife edge

Brook, Root hundreds set England for record chase, but rain and India's attack keep finale balanced

Harry Brook and Joe Root both hit hundreds before England's series finale against India was left on a knife edge after an Oval downpour cut short yesterday's fourth day.

England were 339-6 when play was abandoned at 1703 GMT, with the hosts now needing a further 35 runs to reach a target of 374 on Monday's final day.

India, meanwhile, require four wickets to end the five-match series level at 2-2.

England were faltering at 106-3 following the loss of stand-in captain Ollie Pope.

But the Yorkshire duo of Brook (111) and Root (105) turned the tide with a fourth-wicket stand of 195 that left England cruising to a 3-1 series win with more than a day to spare.

But Brook's exit sparked a mini-collapse that saw England lose three wickets for 36 runs, with Root also unable to finish the job.

And when bad light halted

play at 1630 GMT, England were 339-6, with Jamie Smith (two not out) and Jamie Overton (nought not out) on their Surrey home ground.

A huge downpour then effectively prevented any hope of a resumption yesterday.

The most any side have made in the fourth innings to win a Test at the Oval is England's 263 in a one-wicket victory over Australia back in 1902.

But aggressive batting has been a cornerstone of England's approach to Test cricket since captain Ben Stokes, ruled out

of this match with a shoulder injury, and coach Brendon McCullum joined forces in 2022.

England started this series with the 10th highest successful run chase in Test history after they knocked off a target of 371 for a five-wicket win over India in the opener at Headingley in June.

Brook made an immediate impact when he came out to bat yesterday, at one stage hitting 27 runs in the space of eight balls.

The talented 26-year-old charged down the pitch to loft Akash Deep for an extraordi-

nary six over cover despite heavy cloud cover in London favouring India's quicks.

Brook escape

He almost holed out to fine leg off Prasidh Krishna but Mohammed Siraj was unable to stop himself stepping onto the boundary rope, which meant a six for Brook.

India captain Shubman Gill let the game drift and it was not until the 43rd over, with England 190-3, that he introduced spin -- in the shape of Washington Sundar.

Next ball a two to third man took Brook to a 91-ball century, including 12 fours and two sixes, his second of the series.

Brook's innings ended in appropriately spectacular fashion when, going for another big hit off Deep, his bat flew out of his hands. As the blade soared towards square leg, the ball looped to mid-off where Siraj held the catch.

Root's typically elegant straight-driven four off Siraj took him to 98 not out at tea, with the former England captain completing his 39th Test century following the interval, reaching the landmark in just 137 balls, including 12 fours.

Root, however, fell soon afterwards, when caught behind flicking at a Krishna delivery to leave England 337-6.

Messi exits early with injury in Miami's Leagues Cup win

Lionel Messi suffered an injury and was removed in the 11th minute of Inter Miami's Leagues Cup penalty kicks victory over Mexico's Necaxa on Saturday at Fort Lauderdale's Chase Stadium.

The 38-year-old Argentine superstar forward appeared to be having treatment on his upper right leg or groin before making his exit under his own power and walking to the locker room.

Haris caught Keacy Carty for a duck three balls later but Holder swatted a six to end the 18th over, West Indies still needing 24 to win.

Romario Shepherd smashed a six and a four off Hasan Ali in the 19th over to leave West Indies on 126 for seven entering the final over.

Shaheen Shah Afridi allowed Holder a run but then took Shepherd's wicket lbw for 15. He allowed newcomer Shamar Joseph a run that pulled West Indies within six runs with three balls remaining.

Lando Norris trimmed McLaren team-mate Oscar Piastri's lead in the drivers' world championship to just nine points yesterday when he switched tactics to lead him home by just 0.698 seconds in a thrilling finish at the Hungarian Grand Prix.

The 25-year-old Briton, who moved from a two-stop strategy to one stop, held off series leader Piastri, on fresher tyres, over the closing laps of a strategic contest to claim McLaren's 200th victory and their record 13th win in Hungary.

It was Norris's first win at the Hungaroring in the event's 40th race, avenging his 'team orders' defeat in 2024 when Piastri claimed his maiden success, his fifth victory of the season and the ninth of his career.

The dominant McLaren

pair finished 22 seconds clear of third-placed George Russell of Mercedes with pole sitter Charles Leclerc of Ferrari fourth,

grumbling at the Italian team's poor planning after he slipped out of the leading position.

"I wasn't planning to do a one-stop," said Norris.

"But it was the only option to get back into things and it was tough. Oscar was pushing all the way."

Piastri said he had done all he could to triumph.

"It was great racing," he said.

"Lando did a great job."

His drive brought McLaren their fourth consecutive 1-2 finish.

Two-time champion Fernando Alonso came home fifth for Aston Martin ahead of Sauber's Gabriel Bortoletto, Lance Stroll in the second Aston Martin, rookie Liam Lawson of Racing Bulls and frustrated four-time champion Max Verstappen of Red Bull.

Mercedes' rookie Kimi Antonelli was 10th ahead of Racing Bulls' Isack Hadjar with seven-time champion Lewis Hamilton 12th in the second Ferrari, 24 hours after declaring himself underserving of their race seat.

Classic scrap

The track temperature was

only 31 degrees, encouraging thoughts of a one-stop race as tyre-wear decreased and Leclerc controlled the pace ahead of Piastri, Russell and Norris.

Piastri pitted on lap 18, seeking an undercut. He returned in fifth as Leclerc responded to stay ahead.

Norris inherited the lead and had a 10-second advantage, as the Monegasque regained second, with Piastri third.

He then chose to stay out until pitting, in just 1.9 seconds, for hards on lap 31, rejoining fourth and facing a long run home.

At the front, Leclerc responded to an apparent 'bluff' call from McLaren and pitted, falling to fourth and gifting Piastri the lead ahead of a rapid Norris as the race dissolved into a strategy and tyre-management contest between the two McLarens.

Norris revelled in his delayed

one-stop tactic as Piastri made a second pit on lap 45, the Briton leading with a frustrated Ferrari second, Leclerc blaming his team for bungling his plan before being passed by Piastri around Turn One on lap 51.

This left Norris, on ageing tyres, leading his team-mate in a classic scrap to the flag, negotiating traffic and separated by half a second over the final laps.

On lap 68, the Australian went close to passing in Turn One and on lap 69, he locked up.

"Remember how we go racing," Piastri's engineer Tom Stallard reminded him.

For Leclerc, soon left a distant third by the two McLarens, it was another pole wasted – the 15th time he failed to convert pole into a win in 16 attempts – and it grew worse when Russell, after two attempts, passed him on lap 63.
