

### **UK police 'may'** have shot victim killed in synagogue attack

U<sup>K</sup> police said yesterday they may have shot two victims, including one who died, as officers responded to an attack on worshippers at a Manchester synagogue marking a Jewish holiday.

The admission came as Prime Minister Keir Starmer visited the scene of Thursday's car ramming and stabbings. Two men were killed and three people were seriously wounded, heightening fears for Jewish communities across Britain.

"This was a dreadful attack, a terrorist attack to inflict fear, attacking Jews because they are Jews," the UK leader told a group of emergency responders in the northwest English city.

### **First wolf-dog** hybrid confirmed in Greece

Aprominent Greek wild-life group yesterday said it had confirmed the first case of a wolf-dog hybrid in the north of the country.

The Callisto group -which is currently involved in efforts to trap a rogue wolf in Halkidiki, northern Greece -- said the hybrid was found near the northern city of Thessaloniki.

"This is the first genetic (case) to be confirmed in Greece," Callisto biologist Aimilia Ioakimeidou told a conference in Athens.

The animal is 45% wolf and 55% canine according to DNA testing, she said.

It was discovered during tests on 50 wolf samples from the Greek mainland, Ioakimeidou said.

The leadership of Hamas is reportedly divided over former US President Donald Trump's plan to end nearly two years of devastating war in Gaza.

Meanwhile, Trump vesterday said Hamas has until 2200 GMT on Sunday to accept his 20-point plan for peace in Gaza, warning the Palestinian group faced "all hell" if it did not agree to the terms.

"If this LAST CHANCE agreement is not reached, all HELL, like no one has ever seen before, will break out against Hamas," Trump posted on his Truth Social platform.

The source told AFP that "the first opinion supports unconditional approval, as the priority is a ceasefire under Trump's guarantees, with mediators ensuring Israel implements the plan. The second has serious reservations regarding key clauses... They favour conditional approval with clarifications reflecting Hamas's and the resistance factions' demands."



The proposal, backed by Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, calls for a ceasefire, the release of hostages within 72 hours, Hamas's disarmament and a gradual Israeli withdrawal from Gaza. That would be followed by a post-war transitional authority headed by Trump himself.

### **India and China** to resume direct flights after 5 years New Delhi, India

Tndia and China will re-**⊥**sume direct flights between their two countries this month after a five-year suspension, officials said, with bookings opening yes-

terday. Direct flights between the world's two most populous countries were suspended during the Covid-19 pandemic in 2020 and were not resumed.

Following technical discussions, "it has now been agreed that direct air services connecting designated points in India and China can resume by late October", an Indian government statement released on Thursday said.

Indigo, India's largest commercial operator, said on Thursday it would start direct daily flights between Kolkata and Guangzhou from October 26 and later expand operations to New Delhi.



### **Carrefour name** disappears from **Arab stores as Israel boycotters** claim victory

**¬**he Carrefour name has The Carrelour American disappeared from storefronts in some Arab countries, with pro-Palestinian shoppers and activists hailing the shift as a victory for their boycott of brands perceived as being linked to Israel.

The French multinational has long been in the crosshairs of Palestinian supporters, who accuse it of selling products from Israeli settlements and partnering with Israeli firms operating there.

The group has denied operating in the settlements in the occupied West Bank, which are considered illegal under international law.

But in the past year Majid Al Futtaim, the group that operates the Carrefour franchise in the Middle East, has closed the brand's supermarkets in Jordan, Oman, Kuwait and Bahrain.

It has since reopened under the new name HyperMax, citing "growing demand for locally sourced products and services in a number of our markets".



Attorney Amal Lari, representing the insurance company, welcomed the ruling and said the evidence-including video footage, witness testimony, and embassy confirmation—proved the fraud beyond doubt.

The case dates back to April 2023, when the first defendant purchased a \$500,000 life insurance policy. In August that year, his wife filed a civil lawsuit claiming the payout, presenting the forged certificate. However, investigations later revealed that the man was alive, and that the fraudulent plan had been coordinated by the defendants in Bahrain and abroad.

Witnesses, including hotel staff, later testified that the second defendant openly discussed forging the death certificate and bribing officials to secure the

> The scheme unraveled when Darwin casually walked into a police station five years later, claiming amnesia, sparking one of the most bizarre insurance fraud cases in UK history. Both he and his wife were eventually jailed for conspiracy to commit fraud.

In 2003, John Darwin, a former British teacher, faked his own death in a canoeing accident to claim life insurance and pension payouts worth over £250,000. He secretly lived in a small flat near his house while his wife collected the insurance money, even appearing on television as a grieving widow.

Thailand (2007) - FIFA suspended the Football Association of Thailand after the government interfered in the federation's internal affairs. The suspension prevented Thai teams from participating in international matches until the federation regained independence.



FIFA statutes require that national football associations and sports federations operate independently from government interference. This technical autonomy ensures that decisions regarding professionalism, player contracts, and competitions are made solely by the federations, without political or administrative pressure. Failure to maintain independence can lead to sanctions, including suspension from international competitions.



Pakistan (2017) - FIFA suspended the Pakistan Football Federation after the government dissolved the executive committee and interfered in internal elections. The suspension barred Pakistan from participating in international competitions until autonomy was restored.

## Gold, Cards, and Burglary: Man gets 5-year sentence

The High Criminal Court of Appeal has upheld a five-year prison sentence for a 38-year-old man involved in a series of offences that began with a home break-in and ended with the use of stolen bank cards to sell gold.

The court heard that the defendant entered an empty house through a window, drank water and juice, and moved through the rooms, taking the maid's clothes and phone, as well as clothing and a watch. When the residents returned, he fled in a car, which he drove away using its keys left

He later attempted to sell gold using a stolen bank card and carried out multiple transactions with another person's card. Police arrested him shortly afterward.

The case began when a victim returned home to find his bank card and gold jewellery

The defendant entered an empty house through a window, drank water and juice, and moved through the rooms, taking the maid's clothes and phone, as well as clothing and a watch. When the residents returned, he fled in a car, which he drove away using its keys left inside.

A shop owner who trades in gifts, watches, and jewellery told police the defendant tried to sell gold using the second victim's ID. The shop later discovered that the seller did not match the cardholder, although the two bore a resemblance.

Prosecutors said the offences occurred in June 2024. Charges included using another person's ID for gain, forging a private document (a gold-sale receipt), using the forged receipt, theft of cash and property, and driving another person's vehicle without permission.

According to the case file, the chain of events began when the man attempted to collect a drug dead drop. Passers-by spotted him and gave chase, prompting him to jump a wall to hide, after which the break-in occurred.

Bualoi slammed into central Vietnam late Sunday with winds of 130 kilometres (80 miles) per hour, and lingered over land for almost 12 hours. Heavy rain from the storm inundated the capital Hanoi



## Djokovic fires up Shanghai bid

ovak Djokovic said he had to "fire up all engines" as he overcame a stodgy first set to reach the third round of the Shanghai Masters yesterday, beating fellow veteran Marin Cilic 7-6 (7/2), 6-4.

The 38-year-old Serb is chasing a record-extending fifth title in Shanghai, where he was greeted by rapturous cheers as he entered a stadium packed with adoring Chinese fans.
