Economic gateway

61 initiatives, 33 agreements worth \$17bln signal investor confidence in Bahrain

The Cabinet has stressed the importance of the third edition of the Gateway Gulf Investment Forum 2025, hosted by the Kingdom of Bahrain under the patronage of His Royal Highness the Crown Prince and Prime Minister.

It noted that the forum serves as leading regional economic platform, showcasing promising investment opportunities in the Kingdom and beyond, and reinforcing Bahrain's position as a regional hub for investment.

The Cabinet also welcomed the announcement of 61 initiatives and 33 agreements for new projects with a total value of approximately \$17 billion, noting that the forum's successful organisation and international participation reflected the efforts of the organisers, including the Bahrain Economic Development Board.

The forum drew to a close yesterday, capping two days of announcements, panel debates and signing ceremonies that demonstrated how Bahrain is turning its Vision 2030 strategy into action.

After using day one to unveil \$17 billion worth of projects and declare that the Kingdom

was entering an "age of intelligence," the forum continued with agreements ranging from aviation and logistics to energy and technology.

Speakers stressed that the next phase of diversification will be driven by digital infrastructure, sustainable development and people-centred policies.

Chaired by His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, yesterday at Gudaibiya Palace, the Cabinet extended its congratulations to His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa on the Kingdom's successful organisation of the IISS Manama Dialogue 2025,

affirming that the forum's discussions contribute to strengthening international understanding and cooperation in support of regional and global security.

Successful hosting

The Cabinet commended the Kingdom's successful hosting of the 3rd Asian Youth Games, held under the patronage of HM the King. It also praised the organisers and celebrated the achievements of Bahraini athletes.

The Cabinet noted the contributions of both His Highness Shaikh Nasser bin Hamad Al Khalifa, His Majesty the King's Representative for Humanitarian Works and Youth Affairs

and the Chairman of the Supreme Council for Youth and Sports, and His Highness Shaikh Khalid bin Hamad Al Khalifa, First Deputy Chairman of the Supreme Council for Youth and Sports (SCYS), President of the General Sports Authority (GSA), and President of the Bahrain Olympic Committee (BOC), in advancing the Kingdom's achievements across the youth and sports sectors.

Shutdown scenario

Millions of Americans to get reduced food aid

The White House will send only partial payments to 42 million Americans who rely on food stamps to buy groceries, as the government shutdown crippling public services nears record length, officials told a judge yesterday.

Two federal courts ruled last

week that President Donald Trump's administration must use a \$4.65 billion emergency fund toward the estimated \$9 billion cost for November's payments before cutting off the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP).

Officials for the Agriculture Department, which oversees the program, said in a filing to a fed-

eral court in Rhode Island they would not make up the shortfall with other funding sources, meaning "50 percent of eligible households' current allotments" would be disbursed.

Democrats' blockade of a House of Representatives stop-gap funding bill looks almost certain to hit its 36th day on Wednesday, which would beat

the record for the longest shutdown in history.

As each week goes by, more Americans are feeling the pain from government services being suspended.

At the heart of the fight is money to help Americans cover health insurance under the Affordable Care Act, better known as Obamacare.

Those subsidies - a lifeline for more than 20 million people - are set to expire at year's end and, unless Congress acts, premiums will skyrocket when the new sign-up period opens Saturday.

But Washington's warring parties are deadlocked, as Democrats refuse to reopen the government without a deal.

Transportation, Sustainable Development ministers chart Bahrain's shift to tech-driven, sustainable growth at Gateway Gulf

- **New causeways, 5G and data links boost connectivity**
- **Decarbonisation targets reshape aviation and ports**
- **Human capital and private sector drive diversification**

Bahrain's next phase of economic diversification will hinge on connectivity, sustainability and human capital, senior ministers said at the Gateway Gulf Investment Forum yesterday, outlining how

the Kingdom is evolving from infrastructure-led development to innovation-led growth. H.E. Dr. Shaikh Abdullah bin Ahmed Al Khalifa, Minister of Transportation and Telecommunications, said Bahrain aims to develop a centre for excellence in aviation and logistics built on 75 years of experience. "Our main gateways - air, land and sea - are being developed for speed, quality and efficiency," H.E. said, noting four pillars of focus: commercial airlines, private jets, cargo operations and maintenance, repair and overhaul (MRO). His Excellency cited ongoing cooperation with partners, along with new partnerships being announced, adding that Bahrain's port, run by APM Terminals, has been named among the most efficient ports. Plans include upgrading marine, yacht and

logistics services to strengthen regional supply chains, the Minister said. H.E. Shaikh Abdulla also highlighted two strategic infrastructure projects - the 40 km Bahrain-Saudi causeway that will include a rail line and the wider GCC Rail Network. "These will enhance connectivity and boost economic integration," H.E. said. The Minister said Bahrain now enjoys 100 per cent 5G coverage, backed by new data centres and subsea cable links

connecting the Kingdom to 40 countries. "These investments position Bahrain as a digital gateway for the region," H.E. said. **Sustainability focus** On green growth, H.E. Shaikh Abdulla revealed Bahrain's ports have reduced emissions by over 60 per cent through renewable energy, electrification and energy optimisation. "We aim to make Bahrain the first regional port fully powered by solar en-

ergy," H.E. said. H.E. added that aviation sustainability efforts include electrifying ground equipment and preparing for sustainable aviation fuel, alongside GCC-wide plans to create a unified Gulf upper airspace to shorten routes and cut fuel burn.

Human capital

H.E. Noor bint Ali Al Khulaif, Minister of Sustainable Development and Chief Executive of the Bahrain Economic Development Board, said Bahrain's success lies in relying on the private sector as the driver of growth, with government as facilitator. Her Excellency noted that no single sector now exceeds 20 per cent of GDP, with financial services, manufacturing, logistics, and technology all expanding. "We have the right enablers - a cloud-first government, compet-

itive regulation and adaptable human capital," she said. H.E. Alkhulaif emphasised future readiness through education and skills reform. "We're aligning university outcomes with future market needs - using human capital to influence the direction of our economy," she said, crediting Tamkeen for its continuous workforce development. **Partnership model** Her Excellency also said Bahrain's public-private partnership (PPP) framework allows major infrastructure such as social housing, cloud connectivity, and data centres to be led by the private sector, reducing fiscal pressure while spurring investment. "The goal is clear," Alkhulaif said. "To make Bahrain future-ready - agile, digital, and driven by people."

Governance, Growth and Generations

Bahrain's Minister of Finance and National Economy, His Excellency Shaikh Salman bin Khalifa Al Khalifa, and Lubna Olayan, Chair of the Corporate Board of The Olayan Group and Chair of Saudi Awwal Bank, shared the stage at the Gateway Gulf Investment Forum in Manama yesterday, exploring how technology, governance, and leadership are reshaping the region's economic landscape. H.E. Shaikh Salman began the discussion by highlighting Olayan's pioneering role in corporate governance across the region's family enterprises. His Excellency noted that the group's early adoption of strong internal structures and professional management had long set it apart. Lubna Olayan recalled her late father's advice when she became CEO. "My father told me to listen very carefully to lawyers and accountants, but not to let them make the decisions," she said, smiling as she described his practical wisdom. She added that he "barely finished high school" yet "always went to the best advisers" and "was an amazing listener - listen, learn, and then make your decision." Asked whether the younger generation has it easier, Lubna

said every era brings its own challenges. "Every generation has its challenges," she said. "The pioneers had hard lives, and the young today live in the land of plenty - and that by itself is difficult." **AI and inequality** The discussion turned to artificial intelligence, which both speakers described as a force that could either empower or disrupt. Lubna warned that while AI could improve lives, its misuse could deepen inequality. "One of my biggest worries is employment," she said. "A stable country needs a large middle class. We have to make sure that AI does not cause the middle class to shrink and make the wealthy wealthier." She added, "If we can use AI to build up the middle class of our society, then I would say this is the right use of technology."

Public-private drive

H.E. Shaikh Salman said the Gulf's advantage lies in the speed and scale at which governments can act to support private enterprise. "One of the advantages we have is the speed at which governments can move - deploying resources, pushing forward regulations and legislation, and focusing on upskilling human capital," he said. "We like to say that the government has to do what we need to do and get out of the way of the private sector and let private enterprise make its capital allocation decisions." Lubna agreed, praising the cooperation between Gulf governments and family businesses. "Almost 60 to 65 percent of total GDP in the Gulf is due to family businesses," she said. "I haven't seen more cooperation between the private sector

and government than I've seen here." Optimism and opportunity Lubna said she remains optimistic about the future despite global tensions. "Yes, I have worries - about geopolitics and about not keeping an eye on those left behind," she said. "But I'm an optimist. I believe future generations will learn and correct what we have neglected." H.E. Shaikh Salman echoed that sentiment. "Whenever I want to get an optimistic view, I spend time with our young people - it refocuses how much opportunity we have and our duty to empower them," His Excellency said. The conversation closed on a note of shared confidence that the Gulf's public and private sectors are moving in tandem to build a sustainable, opportunity-driven future for the next generation.

Bahrain Lands AirAsia Deal

Bahrain is set to strengthen its aviation footprint after signing a Letter of Intent with Capital A Berhad, parent company of AirAsia, to explore establishing Bahrain as AirAsia's Middle East hub. The deal, formalised during the Gateway Gulf Investment Forum yesterday, marks the start of a partnership that could connect ASEAN markets with the Gulf's fast-growing aviation corridor. The agreement outlines collaboration across future airline operations, logistics, maintenance and talent development, seen as part of the Kingdom's drive to anchor high-value sectors under Vision 2030. H.E. Dr. Shaikh Abdullah bin Ahmed Al Khalifa, Minister of Transportation and Telecommunications, said the initiative

would help establish a complete aviation ecosystem at Bahrain International Airport, covering AirAsia's operations, Bahrain Hub, Asia Digital Engineering and Teleport, as a specialist in cargo logistics. "This initiative will bring new opportunities to Bahrain," H.E. said. "It aligns with our Economic Vision 2030 by strengthening our global connectivity, creating skilled jobs for citizens and giving a significant boost to our GDP. We look forward to embarking on this exciting journey with Tony Fernandes and his team as we open a new chapter in Bahrain's aviation growth." Tony Fernandes, CEO of Capital A, said the partnership represented a new venture for AirAsia beyond Southeast Asia. "Today marks a new venture in the airline industry, to look at building a hub outside our own region," he said.

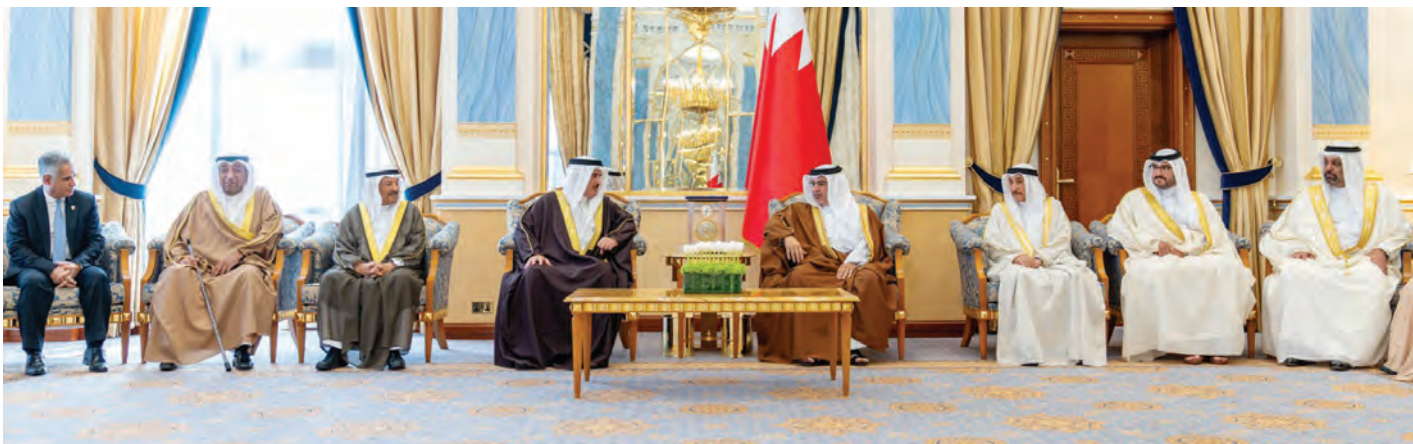

‘Tumoooh’ loan added to housing finance scheme

A new ‘Tumoooh’ loan has been added to Bahrain’s housing-finance scheme, under Decision No. 950 of 2025 that amends the 2022 rules on financing services.

The move keeps the supplementary loan ceiling at BD20,000 and allows joint applications by spouses, with each paying instalments in line with the share financed.

Issued by Minister of Housing and Urban Planning, Her Excellency Amna bint Ahmed Al Rumaihi, the decision recasts supplementary finance as two strands.

Renovation Finance remains for repairs and renewal of a family’s current home.

Eligible borrowers

‘Tumoooh’ is the new strand. It lets eligible borrowers lift an earlier housing loan so they can sell their present flat and buy another home under ministry rules, without losing access to support.

‘Tumoooh’ is aimed at middle-income households.

Income at application and allocation must be between BD600 and BD1,200.

The applicant, or a family member, needs to hold an existing housing loan tied to a ti-

three months.

Neither the applicant nor the immediate family may have drawn a supplementary loan before, and they may not own any property other than the one tied to the application during the three years before filing and up to allocation.

The family must live in Bahrain on a permanent basis.

Renovation Finance carries its own bands and tests. Household income must sit between BD120 and BD1,200 at application and allocation.

The applicant or a family member must own at least a share in the sole family home to be repaired.

Ten years must have elapsed since the family last took any housing help to acquire a home, from the government or elsewhere.

Technical report

If the home to be repaired is a

title-deed flat, a technical report will set the scope of works and an estimate; the loan granted will be the lower of that estimate or the amount allowed by income.

Spouses can apply together for either strand so long as their combined income meets the floor and stays within the ceiling for the chosen loan at both stages.

Each pays the instalment tied to their share unless they agree on a different split.

To run the scheme, a technical committee will study cases and rule on the works and other technical points for both Renovation Finance and ‘Tumoooh’.

The decision also adds formal definitions for ‘Tumoooh’ and for the technical committee, and updates article headings from the 2022 rules to cover the setting of housing-finance values and joint spousal eligibility.

EV charger grid links require EWA approval

New rules put all EV charging under the Electricity and Water Authority, giving owners six months to comply on installation, grid connection and pricing.

Decision No. 1 of 2025, issued by Minister of Electricity and Water Affairs, His Excellency Yasser Humaidan, covers all charging across the Kingdom.

No charger may be linked to the grid without the Authority’s prior approval and a signed connection agreement.

Equipment must meet technical, health, safety and environmental standards and be installed by contractors the Authority has approved.

The Authority will set and update connection terms, run an annual cap on total charger capacity linked to the network, publish lists of approved

contractors, consultants and equipment, and keep a national register of owners and chargers. Once the yearly cap is hit, applications will still be taken and handled in order of receipt.

Contractors

Owners must apply through approved contractors, secure any other clearances, and switch on only after an Authority inspection.

They must fit a single two-way tariff meter to record power drawn from, and sent to, the system, provide any required remote-communication links for non-personal chargers, follow maker test and maintenance schedules, notify the Authority of changes to operations and post clear user instructions at commercial sites.

Sending power from vehicles back to the grid is banned unless the Authority gives advance approval.

Convicted for fake work permits

The Public Prosecution announced that the Second Minor Criminal Court has convicted five defendants for illegally obtaining and retaining work permits through fictitious commercial entities.

The court sentenced three of them to three months in prison, ordered their permanent deportation from Bahrain following the completion of their sentences, and imposed total

finances amounting to BD138,000 on all defendants.

According to case details, inspection reports from the Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) revealed irregularities during routine field checks of commercial establishments.

Inspectors discovered 50 commercial registrations issued under a single address, and further investigations identified the owners of those records.

It was later found that one of them had obtained two additional registrations at different addresses, bringing the total to 52 fake commercial records — all belonging to non-existent companies.

Jail term for accountant upheld

The Court of Cassation upheld rulings issued by both the First Instance and Appeals Courts, sentencing an accountant to five years in prison and ordering him to repay BD41,770.795 to his employer — the Gulf Aviation Academy — in addition to an equal fine.

The court also referred the civil claim to the competent

According to case details, the 36-year-old defendant, who served as Senior Accountant and Acting Head of Finance and Accounts at the Gulf Aviation Academy between January 2021 and April 2022, was found guilty of embezzling BD54,121.

He reportedly diverted funds for his own benefit instead of depositing them into the academy’s official accounts.

18 illegal workers detained and 78 violators deported

Eighteen violating and irregular workers were detained, and 78 violators deported, following 1,684 inspection campaigns and visits conducted by the Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) between 26 October and 1 November 2025.

The inspection campaigns and visits also resulted in monitoring a number of violations related to the provisions of a number of regulating laws, especially the Labour Market Regulatory Authority and the Residency Laws in the Kingdom of Bahrain, noting that legal measures were taken regarding the observed violations.

The Authority pointed out that 1,658 inspection visits were carried out on various shops in all governorates, in addition to 26 joint inspection campaigns, 12 campaigns in the Capital



Governorate, 7 campaigns in the Muharraq Governorate, 3 campaigns in the Northern Gov-

ernorate and 4 campaigns in the Southern Governorate.

The government entities that

participated in the campaigns are the Ministry of Interior, represented by the Nationality, Passports and Residence Affairs (NPRA), the Governorate’s respective Police Directorate, the General Directorate of Verdict Enforcement and Alternative Sentencing, the General Directorate of Crime Detection and Forensic Science, the Ministry of Industry and Commerce, as well as the Bahrain Tourism and Exhibition Authority, and the Social Insurance Organization.

The Authority affirmed the continuation of joint coordination with government agencies to intensify inspection campaigns in all governorates of the Kingdom, and to address any violations or practices that negatively affect the stability and competitiveness of the labour market or harm economic and social security of the Kingdom.

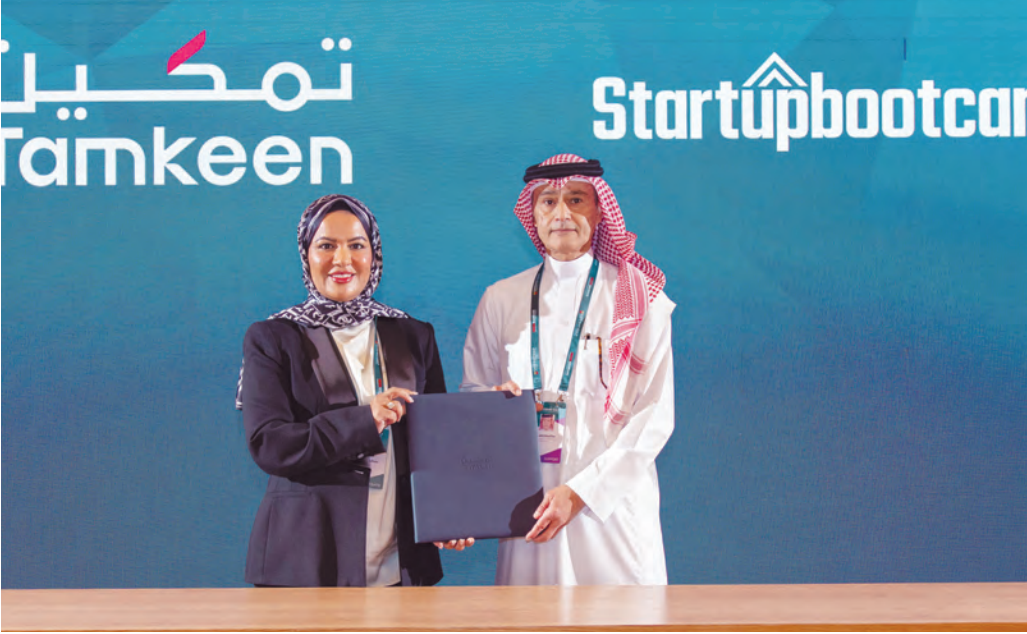

OpenAI signs \$38 bn infrastructure deal with cloud giant AWS

ChatGPT-maker OpenAI signed a \$38 billion deal Monday with Amazon’s AWS cloud computing arm, as the artificial intelligence company continues on a major partnership spree that has also included Oracle, Broadcom, AMD and chip-making juggernaut Nvidia.

Under the seven-year agreement, OpenAI, which is partly owned by AWS’s archival Microsoft, will gain access to computing resources including hundreds of thousands of state-of-the-art Nvidia GPUs, the crucial component of the generative artificial intelligence revolution.

The deal, which will grow over its multi-year term, will also give access to tens of mil-

lions of more conventional CPUs that will be used for the everyday deployment of so-called agentic AI.

“Scaling frontier AI requires massive, reliable compute,” said OpenAI co-founder and CEO Sam Altman in a joint statement. “Our partnership with AWS strengthens the broad compute ecosystem that will power this next era and bring advanced AI to everyone.”

OpenAI will immediately begin utilizing AWS computing, with all capacity targeted to be used before the end of 2026, and the ability to expand further in the coming years. By some estimates, OpenAI has inked approximately \$1 trillion worth of infrastructure deals in 2025.

◆ **US tech giant Microsoft** yesterday announced \$15.2 billion in investments in artificial intelligence and cloud computing in the United Arab Emirates. Microsoft's vice chairman and president Brad Smith said Microsoft had invested \$7.3 billion in the Gulf country since 2023 and would spend \$7.9 billion more by the end of 2029. The deal sent US chip-maker Nvidia shares up 2.6 percent, buoyed by hopes the AI juggernaut could see access for its most advanced chips expand to more markets. "This is not money raised in the UAE. It's money we're spending in the UAE," Smith wrote in a blog post published during a visit to Abu Dhabi. Smith said the investments had been encouraged by both the US and UAE governments and had involved a partnership with the country's G42 sovereign artificial intelligence company.



Microsoft unveils \$15.2 billion AI investments in UAE

◆ **A train derailed** yesterday morning after a reported landslide in the remote hills of northwest England, leaving four people with minor injuries, emergency and rail services said. Dozens of passengers were led off the 4:28 am (0428 GMT) Avanti West Coast service train from Glasgow in Scotland to London Euston station after it derailed at Shap, Cumbria, a gateway to the more mountainous Lake District. "The incident followed a suspected landslide in the area which has been experiencing significant adverse weather conditions and extremely heavy rainfall continues to compound the issue," Network Rail said in a statement. "The front carriage came off the tracks but remained upright," transport police said, adding that 85 people were escorted off the train. The incident blocked all train services running north of the northwestern city of Preston, rail services said. "We're investigating a train derailment near Shap in Cumbria following a report by a train driver," a Network Rail spokesperson said.

UK train derailment leaves four slightly injured

◆ **Denmark inaugurated** one of Europe's few low-carbon hydrogen plants yesterday, a sector touted as a key to cleaner energy but plagued with challenges. Using eight electrolyzers powered by solar and wind energy, the HySynergy project will produce around eight tonnes of hydrogen a day in its first phase, to be transported to a nearby refinery and to Germany. Hydrogen has been touted as a potential energy game-changer that could decarbonise industry and heavy transport. Unlike fossil fuels, which emit planet-warming carbon, hydrogen simply produces water vapor when burned. But producing so-called "green hydrogen" remains a challenge, and the sector is still struggling to take off in Europe, with a multitude of projects abandoned or delayed.

French police recover \$32 mn in precious metals after gold lab heist

Armed robbers who used explosives to break into a gold refining laboratory in Lyon last week made off with metals worth \$32 million, all of which police recovered shortly afterwards, a French prosecutor said Monday. The audacious raid in the eastern city took place on Thursday last week, with police swiftly arresting the suspected perpetrators and seizing 306 kilograms (675 pounds) of precious metals, mostly gold. Six people -- five men and one woman, aged from 30 to 40 -- were detained shortly after the incident at Pourquerey Laboratories, Lyon prosecutor Thierry Dran said during a Monday press conference.

"These are seasoned criminals," he said. The five men have previous convictions, three of whom for armed robbery. The woman, who has no criminal record, and one of the men denied involvement, while the other four remained silent during questioning, the prosecutor said. Dran said he had requested they be charged with several offences, including criminal conspiracy and robbery with violence, and placed in pre-trial detention, though it was not immediately clear if all six would face the same charges. Officials had initially valued the haul at \$13.8 million, but Dran said Monday its true worth was \$32 million -- more than double that amount.

Israel returns 45 bodies to Gaza

Israel returned the bodies of 45 Palestinians to Gaza yesterday, bringing the total number handed over under the ceasefire deal to 270, the health ministry in the Hamas-run territory said. Under a ceasefire deal brokered by US President Donald Trump, Israel was to turn over the bodies of 15 Palestinians for every deceased Israeli returned.

Following forensic identification, Israel confirmed Monday that remains handed over by Hamas the day before belonged to three hostages seized by Hamas during the October 7, 2023 attack that sparked the war. The remains were those of American-Israeli Captain Omer Neutra, 21 years old at the time of his abduction, Corporal Oz Daniel, 19, and Colonel Assaf Hamami, 40, the highest-ranking officer killed by Hamas.

Hamas's armed wing said it had found the remains earlier on Sunday "along the route of one of the tunnels in the southern Gaza Strip". Hamas had been holding 48 hostages in Gaza when the truce came into effect on October 10, including 20 who were alive. Since the start of the truce, Hamas has released the 20 surviving hostages and begun handing over the remains of 28 deceased captives. Of the latter, it has so far re-

turned 20 -- including 18 Israelis, one Thai national and one Nepali. Israel has accused Hamas of dragging its feet in returning the bodies, while the Palestinian group says the process is slow because many remains are buried beneath Gaza's rubble. It has repeatedly called on mediators and the Red Cross to provide it with the necessary equipment and personnel to recover the bodies.

Violence in Sudan's El-Fasher could be war crimes, says top court

The International Criminal Court warned on Monday that atrocities committed in Sudan's El-Fasher could amount to crimes against humanity and war crimes, as the UN said that thousands had fled a neighbouring region where paramilitaries have turned their focus. According to United Nations figures, more than 36,000 civilians have fled towns and villages in the Kordofan region between October 26 and last Friday, while the paramilitary Rapid Support Forces warned it was amassing along a new front line. Kordofan is a strategic area linking the vast western region of Darfur with Khartoum, the capital. The widening of the war

comes just over a week after the RSF took control of El-Fasher -- the army's last stronghold in Darfur -- where reports of mass

killings, sexual violence, looting and abductions have emerged in the aftermath. The RSF has set up a rival administration in Darfur to the pro-army government operating out of the Red Sea city of Port Sudan. Residents on Monday reported a major surge in both RSF and army forces across towns and villages in North Kordofan state. The two sides are vying for El-Obeid, the North Kordofan state capital and a key logistics and command hub that links Darfur to Khartoum. Suleiman Babiker, who lives in Um Smeima, west of El-Obeid, told AFP that following the paramilitary capture of El-Fasher, "the number of RSF vehicles increased".

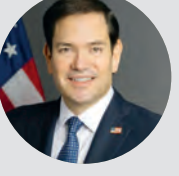

"Russia's testing, and China's testing, but they don't talk about it," he told CBS's "60 Minutes" program, in an interview released Sunday.

"I don't want to be the only country that doesn't test," he said, adding North Korea and Pakistan to the list of nations allegedly testing their arsenals.

Confusion has surrounded Trump's order that the United States begin testing, particularly if he meant conducting the country's first nuclear explosion since 1992.

The 79-year-old Republican first made his surprise announcement by social media post on Thursday, minutes before entering a summit with Chinese leader Xi Jinping in South Korea.

The announcement came in the wake of Russia saying it had tested a new nuclear-powered

cruise missile, the Burevestnik, and a nuclear-powered and nuclear-capable underwater drone.

Asked directly if he planned for the United States to detonate a nuclear weapon for the first time in more than three decades, Trump told CBS: "I'm saying that we're going to test nuclear weapons like other countries do, yes."

No country other than North Korea is known to have conducted a nuclear detonation for decades.

Russia and China have not carried out such tests since 1990 and 1996 respectively.

Pressed on the topic, Trump said: "They don't go and tell you about it."

"As powerful as they are, this is a big world. You don't necessarily know where they're testing."

"They test way underground where people don't know exactly what's happening with the test. You feel a little bit of a vibration," he added.

Asked about the comments Monday, China's foreign ministry denied conducting nuclear weapons tests.

As a "responsible nucle-

ar-weapons state, China has always... upheld a self-defence nuclear strategy and abided by its commitment to suspend nuclear testing", spokeswoman Mao Ning said at a regular press conference in Beijing.

She added that China hopes the United States will "take concrete actions to safeguard the international nuclear disarmament and non-proliferation regime and maintain global strategic balance and stability".

Trump's energy secretary on Sunday downplayed that the United States was planning to set off a nuclear explosion.

"I think the tests we're talking about right now are system tests. These are not nuclear explosions," Chris Wright said in a Fox News interview.

"These are what we call 'non-critical explosions,' so you're testing all the other parts of a nuclear weapon to make sure they deliver the appropriate geometry and they set up the nuclear explosion," he said.

The United States has been a signatory since 1996 to the Comprehensive Nuclear-Test-Ban Treaty, which bans all atomic test explosions, whether for military or civilian purposes.

Afghan govt says quake kills 20, injures over 500

A strong earthquake killed at least 20 people in northern Afghanistan, authorities said Monday, just months after another deadly tremor that left the country reeling.

The 6.3-magnitude quake struck overnight at a depth of 28 kilometres (17 miles) with the epicentre near the city of Mazar-i-Sharif, according to the US Geological Survey.

"All the houses were struck and people were hurt," resident Ahmad Khan told AFP in Tashqurghan village as people searched through the rubble.

"We're asking the government to help with reconstruction."

Christian, Muslim Nigerians push back on threatened US strikes

Nigerians across the religious spectrum pushed back Monday on US President Donald Trump's threats of military intervention over the killing of Christians in the country.

Africa's most populous country, which is roughly evenly split between a mostly Christian south and Muslim-majority north, is home to myriad conflicts, which experts say kill both Christians and Muslims without distinction. Claims of Christian "persecution" in Nigeria have found traction online among the US and European right in recent weeks.

"Christians are being killed, we can't deny the fact that Muslims are (also) being killed," Danjuma Dickson Auta, a Christian and community leader, told AFP.

Trump said on social media over the weekend that he had asked the Pentagon to map out a possible plan of attack.

Asked by an AFP reporter aboard Air Force One if he was considering putting US troops on the ground or using air strikes, Trump replied: "Could be, I mean, a lot of things -- I envisage a lot of things."

"They're killing the Christians and killing them in very large numbers," he said Sunday. "We're not going to allow that to happen."

Medieval tower partially collapses in Rome, trapping worker

A medieval tower in central Rome that was under renovation partially collapsed yesterday, with one worker believed to be trapped alive under rubble, authorities said.

Part of the Torre dei Conti collapsed just after 11:30 am (1030 GMT), sending rubble into the street and a thick white cloud of dust into the air.

"It's a very complex situation for the firefighters because there is a person trapped inside," Rome Prefect Lamberto Giannini told reporters.

"There are signs -- we don't know the condition -- but there are signs that he is still alive," he said.

The tower is in a busy area, just off the Imperial Forum and close to the Colosseum, Italy's top tourist site.

Three workers inside the tower were evacuated, with one taken to hospital in critical condition, a firefighter spokesman told AFP.

Rome Mayor Roberto Gualtieri and Italian Culture Minister Alessandro Giuli were present as firefighters cordoned off the street and moved back crowds.

A second partial collapse of the tower about one and a half hours later sent up further billowing clouds of dust.

After the first collapse, firefighters managed to "put up some protection" around the trapped man, so when the second collapse occurred, "they obviously shielded him", Giannini said.

With dust still in the air, firefighters used cranes to reach tower windows, while a drone entered through another window for an inspection.

An AFP journalist witnessed the arrival of specialised search and rescue firefighter units.

One worker inside at the time of the first collapse told AFP he escaped from a balcony. "It was not safe. I just want to go home," said the man, white dust covering his uniform, who gave his name as Ottaviano and his age as 67.

The Torre dei Conti, dating from the early 13th century, was being restored with European Union funds.

Prefect Giannini said the rescue operation would be long and difficult.

"It will be a very long operation because we have to try to save the person, but we also have to try to mitigate... the enormous risks faced by the people trying to carry out the rescue," he said.

"We hope the outcome will be good, but it is not easy."

Sitra look to bounce back in Gulf Club campaign

Bahrain's representatives face Kuwait's Al Qadsia seeking revival

Bahrain's Sitra Club will aim to claim their first win in the 2025-26 AGCFF Gulf Club Champions League when they host Kuwait's Al Qadsia tonight at Khalifa Sports City Stadium in Isa Town. Kick-off is at 6pm.

The fixture is Sitra's third Group A outing, and the team enters eager to build on their recent improvement. "We have great respect for Al Qadsia, but we're well prepared for this match. Staying focused

and disciplined will be the key to a positive result."

Al Saadoun's words reflected

the growing belief within the squad after their improved defensive showing against Zak-

ho. The goalless draw showed greater composure and structure compared to their open-

ing match in Abu Dhabi, where three late goals from Al Ain turned a close contest into a heavy defeat.

Speaking alongside his coach, midfielder Abdulwasea Almatari echoed the determination in the camp. "This match means a lot to us, and we'll fight to get that first victory that keeps us in the running," Almatari said. "We know how important this game is for our fans, and we'll do everything we can to make them proud."

That sense of resolve will be crucial against an Al Qadsia side also searching for their first points of the campaign. The Kuwaitis have lost both their opening fixtures, 3-1 to Zakho and 1-0 to Al Ain, and now arrive in Bahrain under similar pressure to respond.

Sitra remain Bahrain's sole representatives in this year's Gulf Club Champions League. Their qualification followed an impressive third-place finish in the 2024-25 Nasser bin Hamad Bahrain Premier Football League, earning them the chance to compete among the Gulf's elite.

Muharraq's Fightback Denied by Washington's Triple-Double

Bahrain's Muharraq Club came within touching distance of their first win in the 2025-26 FIBA West Asia Super League (WASL), but ultimately lost 89-87 to Shabab Al Ahli in a fascinating Group B match last night in Dubai. The game at Sheikh Saeed Bin Maktoum Sports Hall featured four quarters of high-intensity basketball as both teams searched for their first win of the campaign.

Muharraq entered the match-up aiming to rebound from a 95-81 defeat to Kuwait's Kazma SC. Shabab Al Ahli, the reigning UAE League champions, were also looking to respond after losing their opener to Saudi Arabia's Al Ittihad. With both sides eager to recover, the contest carried

The second quarter remained tightly contested. Muharraq's Kerwin Roach Jr. attacked the rim confidently while Mohammed Hamoda added crucial perimeter shots. Shabab Al Ahli countered with Washington's playmaking, Dixon's scoring bursts, and Qais Alshabebi's second-chance points to enter halftime ahead 50-46.

Shabab Al Ahli surged to a double-digit lead in the third, but Muharraq head coach Peter Maria Schomers urged his players to stay disciplined and keep pushing. The response came late, as Roach, Hamilton, and Mohamed Juma combined for

a 10-2 run that trimmed the gap to two points in the final minute. Despite their late momentum, Muharraq could not convert on key chances, with missed shots sealing the result.

Washington recorded 23 points, 13 rebounds, and 12 assists, while Dixon scored 30 points for Shabab Al Ahli. Head coach Miodrag Perisic praised his players' effort but admitted his side "must manage leads better." For Muharraq, Roach tallied 24 points and eight assists, Hamilton added 22, and Ameer and West contributed solid support. Schomers said he was "proud of the fight" but noted that execution in critical moments remains a focus.

Muharraq will now look to bounce back when they host Al Ittihad on November 10 at the BBA Arena.

India hails maiden women's World Cup cricket title as game-changer

India celebrated a watershed moment in its sporting history yesterday after the women's cricket team won their first World Cup crown, with greats of the game saying it would inspire future generations.

A packed DY Patil Stadium in Mumbai saw hosts India defeat South Africa by 52 runs on Sunday, adding a women's trophy to the country's four men's World Cup titles, starting with the first in 1983.

"1983 inspired an entire generation to dream big and chase those dreams. Today, our women's cricket team has done something truly special," batting legend Sachin Tendulkar posted on social media.

"They have inspired countless young girls across the country to pick up a bat and ball, take the field and believe that they too can lift that trophy one day."

"This is a defining moment in the journey of Indian women's cricket," he added.

Fans celebrated at home and on the streets, with crowds in the capital Delhi waving Indian flags and setting off fireworks.

Virat Kohli, the star batsman from the men's team, described the triumph as "an inspiration for generations to come".

"You've made every Indian proud with your fearless cricket and belief throughout," Kohli wrote on X.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi said the "historic win will motivate future champions to take up sports".

India posted 298-7, with Shafali Verma smashing a quickfire 87 and Deepti Sharma making a run-a-ball 58.

South Africa's chase was led by captain Laura Wolvaardt's fighting 101 but regular wickets, including Sharma's match-winning 5-39, saw them dismissed for 246 off 45.3 overs.

which played in India's first Women's World Cup appearance in 1978, including captain Diana Edulji, were in attendance when India lifted the trophy shortly after midnight to deafening cheers from a 45,000 crowd.

The scenes of jubilation contrasted sharply with 2005, when India's runners-up position merited only a small mention in newspapers.

"It's just that there were ups and downs, but the team had self-belief," India skipper Harmanpreet Kaur told reporters after the win.

Sinner, Alcaraz to meet in South Korea exhibition match

Eyes on championship homecoming

Mokaev and Kooheji Ready to Headline BRAVE's Centennial Card

- Kingdom hosts BRAVE 100 & 101
- Local fighter seeks personal redemption
- Mokaev returns for first title

The stage is set for a defining week in Bahraini mixed martial arts. On Friday, November 7, Khalifa Sports City Arena in Isa Town will host BRAVE Combat Federation 100, a landmark event highlighting the Kingdom's growing influence in MMA, followed by BRAVE 101 on November 9, at the same venue.

The centennial card will deliver three world title fights, starting with Mohammad Fakhredine, BRAVE's first homegrown star and current Middleweight Champion, who faces Alex Lohore for the Super Welterweight crown. The action then moves to the co-main event, which will crown the first-ever Flyweight World Champion as Muhammad "The Punisher" Mokaev returns to take on Ireland's Gerard Burns. The night then reaches its climax in the main event, where Bahrain's own Hamza Kooheji challenges Serbia's Borislav Nikolic for the Bantamweight World Championship.

Together, these bouts capture the essence of BRAVE's journey, bringing elite competition to Bahraini soil while exhibiting the fighters who built its foundation.

Both Kooheji and Mokaev enter BRAVE CF 100 in top form after convincing

wins at BRAVE CF 91 in Bahrain last December. Kooheji stopped Alperen Karabulut by TKO (ground and pound) at 1:23 of Round 2, while Mokaev submitted Joevincent So with a Darce choke at 1:52 of Round 1. Those wins now lead them to the biggest nights of their careers.

A Return Written in Destiny

For Mokaev, BRAVE 100 is both a title opportunity and a symbolic return to Bahrain. Born in Buynaksk, Russia, and fighting out of Manchester, England, the 25-year-old was one of BRAVE's brightest prospects before moving

to the UFC and returns as an undefeated athlete chasing his first world title.

"It feels amazing fighting for my first professional title here", Mokaev told The Daily Tribune. "In the UFC, I fought tough opponents for experience, not a belt. This time, it feels written in my life to come back to Bahrain, take the belt, and see what's next."

His opponent, Gerard Burns, brings confidence and knockout power. In a recent fight, Burns choked out his opponent while screaming

"Mokaev! Mokaev!" to signal he was ready for the next challenge. Mokaev, however, remains unfazed. "If anyone can beat me, they'll have to be perfect. Every fight, I defend my name and that's my motivation," he said. Speaking of the upcoming championship, Mokaev added, "Winning my first world title here would mean everything."

Heart of a Nation

While Mokaev returns to redis-

cover his roots, Hamza Kooheji fights to fulfill a lifelong dream at home. The 32-year-old has been at the heart of Bahraini MMA since its earliest days, representing the Kingdom when the sport was still emerging. Since BRAVE's founding in 2016, he has earned nine victories in 11 appearances and inspired countless young athletes. Now, Kooheji has a chance at the world championship that has long eluded him, offering an opportunity for personal redemption. He came close at BRAVE CF 57 in 2022, losing a split decision, a result that continues to drive him forward.

His opponent, reigning champi-

on Borislav Nikolic, earned the Bantamweight World Championship in one of BRAVE Combat Federation's most remarkable comebacks at BRAVE CF 96 in Ljubljana, Slovenia. Facing Nicholas Hwende, Nikolic executed a flawless Ninja Choke in Round 4 despite both eyes being swollen shut. For the Serbian, defending the title now in Bahrain is a challenge he embraces.

"Being a champion isn't about where you fight, it's about who you are inside that cage," Nikolic said. "I respect Hamza's support, but I am not intimidated. I want to earn Bahrainis respect, not break their hearts."

For Kooheji, the symbolism is impossible to ignore. Returning to Khalifa Sports City, where his first title bid fell short, a win would mean closing a chapter and honoring the support of his fans.

The Final Countdown

In the final days before fight night, the fighters remain calm and focused. Mokaev speaks of destiny; Kooheji speaks of duty. For Bahrain, BRAVE CF 100 stands as both a tribute to the past and a preview of what is to come. The lights at Khalifa Sports City will shine bright on November 7, but the real weight rests on two men stepping into the cage, each fighting for gold and the place that made them.
