Representatives, who refused to disclose their identities, had said they would not attend the sessions scheduled for today to hear the four-speaker can-

An AlAyam report quoting them said the sessions are illegal and clearly violate constitution.

Members pointed out that all candidates will receive proper time to address the parliament, and the members are free to elect anybody. "There is no need to hold a session before that."

"Holding such sessions will only deny the rights of others who desire to run for the positions and limits the number of candidates to four.

"These actions would only cause a rift between deputies and negatively affect the performance of the parliament," the members pointed out.
