India edge England in Oval epic

ohammed Siraj was the hero as India beat England by just six runs in a thrilling fifth Test at the Oval yesterday to end the series level

England, set 374 to win, were bowled out for 367, with fast bowler Siraj taking 5-104, including a sensational burst of 3-9 yesterday's final morning.

It is India's narrowest winning margin in a Test match.
