King Charles crown set to be 'modified'



Historic St Edward's Crown

London

The historic St Edward's Crown, which has been the centerpiece of the coronation of monarchs in England for more than 350 years, has been removed from the Tower of London to be modified for the coronation of King Charles III next May, Buckingham Palace said.

The crown, which usually forms part of the Crown Jewels on display at the Tower, has been used since the coronation of King Charles II in 1661 after the monarchy was restored following the 10-year republic of Oliver Cromwell.

The St Edward's Crown replaced a medieval version, thought to have dated back to the 11th Century reign of Edward the Confessor which was melted down in 1649.

Putin 'falls down stairs'

Russian president Vladimir Putin has reportedly slipped down five stairs and soiled himself at his official residence in Moscow, amid speculation about the 70-year-old's declining health.

The New York Post reported Vladimir Putin's fall quoting a Telegraph Channel that claimed that the Russian leader landed on his coccyx or tailbone during the fall.

1,700 dead seals on Caspian coast

Bahrain, Israel vow to 'broaden cooperation'

HM King Hamad and President Herzog discuss ways to strengthen bilateral ties

Talks held on regional security, stability and prosperity

Bahrain and Israel vowed to broaden bilateral relations and cooperation, and consolidate joint efforts to achieve regional security, stability and prosperity.

This came as His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa received yesterday Israel President Isaac Herzog, in the presence of His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, at the Gudaibiya Palace.

His Majesty delivered a speech in which he expressed hope that the visit will contribute to enhancing relations between the two countries.

"We are confident that this visit represents an opportunity to witness the beauty of the religious and cultural diversity in our country, and the spirit of friendliness, tolerance and peaceful coexistence among the members of our honorable society of all religions and races," His Majesty said.

Talks focused on ways to bolster cooperation in the economic, trade, investment, scientific, technical, health, educational, youth, tourism and cultural fields.

They also discussed ways to encourage communication between the representatives of the private sector in the two countries, and the exchange of the visits of official delegations, which will contribute to increasing the volume of bilateral trade exchange for the best interest of the two sides.

They also stressed the importance of activating the agreements and memoranda of understanding signed between the two countries in vital areas of common interest, as well as strengthening the role of the joint economic committees in

advancing bilateral economic and trade cooperation, which would serve common interests.

Determination

HM King Hamad and President Herzog affirmed that the Abraham Accords and the Declaration Supporting Peace signed between the two countries embody their determination to promote the values of peace, coexistence and fraternity.

"The Kingdom of Bahrain firmly believes that dialogue and a peaceful and civilised approach are imperative for set-

tling regional and international conflicts and disputes, and ensuring the rights of people to security, development and prosperity," His Majesty said.

He stressed Bahrain's firm support for a just, comprehensive and sustainable peace that guarantees the legitimate rights of the Palestinian people "that will lead to stability, development and prosperity for both the Palestinian and Israeli peoples, as well as all peoples of the region."

The Israeli President expressed thanks and appreciation to HM the King for the warm

Trade and peace are the two key pillars of relations between the Kingdom of Bahrain and Israel, said Foreign Minister Dr Abdullatif Al Zayani yesterday at a press conference held at Four Seasons on the sidelines of the visit of Israeli President Issac Harzog to the Kingdom.

Israel President Issac Harzog arrived yesterday in the Kingdom, the first visit by the Israeli head of state since the two countries normalised relations in 2020.

Speaking at the press con-

ference, Dr Al Zayani stressed on the Kingdom's firm position in support of achieving a just comprehensive and sustainable peace that guarantees the legitimate rights of the Palestinian people.

"We ought to have a thriving firm that makes a significant contribution to both regional and global relations. This will enable religious and cultural diversity among Bahrainis. We also emphasise the Abraham Accords' two-state option, which provides the Palestinians with a guarantee of peace," Dr Al Zayani said.

He emphasised that signing between two nations will have a significant impact on research, education and peace. He urged nations to work together in the future to produce accomplishments and strengthen peace by ensuring that these good deeds continue and inspire others to participate.

"I firmly believe in peace and will work with the government to reaffirm the idea of peace in which people can live side by side regardless of religion or ideology. I also think that Israel as a nation wants peace, and that

the government will endeavour to make that happen," the Foreign Minister said.

"Israel and the Kingdom will operate more strategically because wisdom is everywhere. There is no middle ground; there will undoubtedly be challenges, but this is a continual process that will lead to everyone's security and prosperity."

Dr Al Zayani reiterated the Kingdom's stance about supporting a two-state solution to end the Palestinian crisis. He also highlighted the urgent need to peacefully resolve the ongoing Russia-Ukraine conflict.

The program will streamline registration processes in cooperation with the private sector and correct the legal status of workers to ensure their rights are protected.

LMRA services will be available to all workers to further

enhance security.

Jamsheer added that the Authority has started conducting training workshops for the accredited centres.

She highlighted that the conducted workshops included detailed explanations of the centres' roles and responsibilities in registering workers.

These include receiving permit requests that are then referred to the Authority and

verifying the availability of the required qualifications or professional certificates for professional work permit applications.

She added that the workshops also covered the process of data entry, methods of communication and follow-up with the LMRA regarding developments related to the worker, and clarification regarding the obligations of centres receiving workers applying for a permit.

Obesity rates in Bahrain 'alarming increasing' every year

Obesity numbers are increasing every year which is now becoming an important health concern to combat.

A study was conducted by the Bahrain Medical Society reporting that individuals are suffering with obesity at high rates, and it is mostly occurring within the younger population.

From 2000 to 2020, Bahrain has seen an increasing amount of the population suffering with obesity, and the numbers have not slowed down.

The study finds that “adolescents in the Kingdom of Bahrain are experiencing high obesity rates and there is an increasing urgency to undertake measures to control the problem in the younger generation, to reduce serious outcomes.”

According to the Global Nutrition Report, individuals aged 18 years and older have an estimated 39.5 per cent obesity rate. “Bahrain's obesity prevalence is higher than the regional average of 10.3 per cent for women and 7.5 percent for men.”

There are many elements

which can contribute to obesity which can include both genetics and environmental factors. According to Bahrain Medical Society, there are many factors that cause the development of obesity such as genetic factors, family history, lack of physical activity, gender, income, and nutritional habits.

Children or young people who struggle with obesity at younger ages, find it more difficult to get fit and healthy during their adult stages. This results in an increase of an increase in obese adults as children are not developing healthy habits from a young age, the unhealthy habits develop into their older years, the report states.

PubMed reports that there has been an increase with the availability of convenient high-calorie foods which has resulted in the increase of obesity rates all over the world.

Speaking to The Daily Tribune, Sara Alwatani, a senior dietitian, said: “Everyone deals with different food habits, and fast food and sugary drinks are the most common foods that lead to weight issues or obesity.”

She added: “Both environmental and genetic factors con-

tribute to weight issues and obesity; however, environmental factors seem to be the largest contributor to obesity, especially an individual's choice in lifestyle.”

Obesity is an important public health concern in many countries, and there are many consequences in which individuals could face whilst battling with obesity. These can include, chronic disease, morbidity and mortality, high medical costs, and psychological and social costs.

President of the Supreme Council of Health, Lieutenant General Dr Shaikh Mohammed bin Abdullah Al Khalifa, has said: “Obesity is a top priority in

the national plan to achieve the sustainable development goals.”

He highlighted the Kingdoms efforts to combat obesity under a national scheme that includes various measures such as developing more physical activities, healthy nutrition, establishing specialised clinics, and promoting healthy lifestyles.

Additionally, Dr Shaikh Mohammed bin Abdullah Al Khalifa said, “Bahrain Obesity Academy” will contribute to preparing a comprehensive educational programme for 45 doctors regarding prevention, diagnosis, and management of obesity to enable and provide the necessary assistance to overweight patients.”

2 men 'laundered' money by buying digital currency

Two Asian men laundered money obtained from drug sales by buying digital currency and reselling it, the High Criminal Court heard.

Security investigations revealed that the defendants were part of an international drug trafficking network where their role was to receive sale proceeds and legitimise them through laundering. The first defendant received BD19,000, while the second received BD61,000.

The two defendants conducted laundering operations through three methods: money transfers through exchange companies, cash withdraws from ATMs that were re-positied in banks, and finally, by

buying and reselling digital currency.

The first defendant confessed to receiving those sums and transferring them to his home country despite knowing their origin. He indicated that on one occasion, he contacted the second defendant with a request to use his phone for the transfer of some amounts.

It turned out that the second defendant was in contact with individuals who transferred money, and thus, the two defendants worked together. The sums which they obtained and laundered exceeded BD80,000.

The prosecution charged the defendants with carrying out money laundering operations in the year 2022 with intention of legitimising sums obtained from the sale of narcotics.

OPEC+ keeps steady policy amid weakening economy, Russia cap

OPEC+ agreed to stick to its oil output targets at a meeting yesterday as the oil markets struggle to assess the impact of a slowing Chinese economy on demand and a G7 price cap on Russian oil on supply.

The decision comes two days after the Group of Seven (G7) nations agreed a price cap on Russian oil.

OPEC+, which comprises the Organization of the Petroleum Exporting Countries (OPEC) and allies including Russia, angered the United States and other Western nations in October when it agreed to cut output by 2 million barrels per day (bpd),

about 2% of world demand, from November until the end of 2023. Washington accused the group and one of its leaders, Saudi Arabia, of siding with Russia despite Moscow's war in Ukraine.

OPEC+ argued it had cut out-

put because of a weaker economic outlook. Oil prices have declined since October due to slower Chinese and global growth and higher interest rates, prompting market speculation the group could cut output again.

But yesterday the group of oil producers decided to keep the policy unchanged. Its key ministers will next meet on Feb. 1 for a monitoring committee while a full meeting is scheduled for June 3-4.

On Friday, G7 nations and Australia agreed a \$60 per barrel price cap on Russian seaborne crude oil in a move to deprive President Vladimir Putin of revenue while keeping Russian oil flowing to global markets.

Moscow said it would not sell its oil under the cap and was analysing how to respond.

Many analysts and OPEC ministers have said the price cap is confusing and probably inefficient as Moscow has been sell-

ing most of its oil to countries like China and India, which have refused to condemn the war in Ukraine.

Neither an OPEC meeting on Saturday nor the OPEC+ meeting on Sunday discussed the Russian price cap, sources said.

Russia's Deputy Prime Minister Alexander Novak said on Sunday Russia would rather cut production than supply oil under the price cap and said the cap may affect other producers.

Sources have told Reuters several OPEC+ members have expressed frustration at the cap saying the anti-market measure could ultimately be used by the West against any producer.

The United States said the measure was not aimed at OPEC.

JP Morgan said on Friday that OPEC+ could review production in the new year based on fresh data on Chinese demand trends and consumer compliance with price caps on Russia crude output and tanker flow.

Earlier, local media quoted Finance Minister Mohamed Maaait as saying the issuance was expected to be at \$500 million.

◆ **Three Chinese** astronauts landed back on earth yesterday on board the re-entry capsule of the Shenzhou-14 spacecraft, state broadcaster CCTV reported, bringing to an end a six-month mission on China's space station. The three astronauts - commander Chen Dong and teammates Liu Yang and Cai Xuzhe - who had been overseeing the final, pivotal period of construction at the space station, which was completed in November, all said they were feeling well after landing in audio aired on CCTV. The capsule landed at the Dongfeng site in north China's Inner Mongolia Autonomous region at 8:09 p.m. (1209 GMT), with staff from the space agency declaring the entire mission, which began on June 5, a "complete success", CCTV reported. Staff at the landing site carried out the exhausted-looking crew one by one and by just after 9 p.m. all three had safely exited the capsule, CCTV reported. A new crew of three fellow Chinese astronauts arrived at the space station aboard the Shenzhou-15 to take over from them on Wednesday.

UK could use military to ease strikes, Conservative chairman says



◆ **Britain's government** is looking at bringing in the military to help keep public services running if key workers, including in the state-run National Health Service, take strike action, the chairman of the governing Conservative Party said on Sunday. Britain is already grappling with industrial action in a range of sectors, but now faces strikes by thousands of nurses in England and ambulance workers in England and Wales who plan to walk out later this month over pay and conditions. The government has repeatedly called on workers to halt strike action, saying it could not afford pay rises to

cover inflation and that, even if it could meet their demands, such increases would further fuel inflation. "Our message to the unions is to say 'this is not a time to strike, this is a time to try and negotiate'. But in the absence of that, it is important for the government... to have contingency plans in place," Nadhim Zahawi told Sky News.

◆ **Islamic State claimed** responsibility for an attack on Pakistan's embassy in the Afghan capital Kabul on Friday, via a statement carried by one of the militant group's affiliated channels on Telegram on Sunday. The embassy came under attack on Friday and a Pakistani security guard was wounded by gunfire in what Islamabad called an attempt to assassinate its head of mission, who was unhurt. Islamic State claimed the attack was carried out by two of its members armed with "medium and sniper weapons" and was targeting the ambassador and his guards who were present in the courtyard of the embassy. Taliban authorities have said they are investigating the attack and that the

embassy compound was targeted by gunfire from a nearby building. Police said they had arrested one suspect and recovered two firearms. The attack injured at least one guard and caused damage to the building, the Islamic State said. Pakistan's foreign office said it had seen the reports of IS's claim of responsibility. "Independently and in consultation with the Afghan authorities, we are verifying the veracity of these reports," it said in a statement, adding the attack was a reminder of the risk militant activity posed to the region.

Historic crown to be modified for King Charles's coronation

The historic St Edward's Crown, which has been the centrepiece of the coronation of monarchs in England for more than 350 years, has been removed from the Tower of London to be modified for the coronation of King Charles III next May, Buckingham Palace said.

The crown, which usually forms part of the Crown Jewels on display at the Tower, has been used since the coronation of King Charles II in 1661 after the monarchy was restored following the 10-year republic of Oliver Cromwell. The St Edward's Crown replaced a medieval version, thought to have dated back to the 11th Century reign of Edward the Confessor which was melted down in 1649.

Charles III will be crowned with St Edward's Crown during the solemn ceremony to be held at London's Westminster Abbey on May 6, just as his late mother Queen Elizabeth II was in 1953. He will also wear the Imperial State Crown dur-

ing the service.

The St Edward's Crown, made up of a solid gold frame set with rubies, amethysts, sapphires, garnet, topazes and tourmalines, follows its original medieval forebear in having four crosses-pattée and four fleurs-de-lis. It also has a velvet cap with an ermine band.

Protest-hit Iran abolishes

Protesters in Iran called yesterday for a three-day strike this week, stepping up pressure on authorities after the public prosecutor said the morality police whose detention of a young woman triggered months of protests had been shut down.

There was no confirmation of the closure from the Interior Ministry which is in charge of the morality police, and Iranian state media said Public Prosecutor Mohammad Jafar Montazeri was not responsible for overseeing the force.

Top Iranian officials have repeatedly said Tehran would not change the Islamic Republic's mandatory hijab policy, which requires women to dress modestly and wear headscarves, despite 11 weeks of protests against strict Islamic regulations.

Hundreds of people have been killed in the unrest which erupted in September after the death in custody of Mahsa Amini,

a 22-year-old Kurdish Iranian woman who was detained by the morality police for flouting the hijab rules.

Protesters seeking to maintain their challenge to Iran's clerical rulers have called for a three-day economic strike and a rally to Tehran's Azadi (Freedom) Square on Wednesday, according to individual posts shared on Twitter by accounts unverified by Reuters.

President Ebrahim Raisi is due to address students in Tehran on the same day to mark Student Day in Iran.

Similar calls for strike action and mass mobilisation have in past weeks resulted in an escalation in the unrest which has swept the country - some of the biggest anti-government protests since Iran's 1979 Islamic Revolution.

Indonesia's Mount Semeru erupts, forcing thousands to flee

Indonesia's Mount Semeru erupted Sunday spewing hot ash clouds a mile high and rivers of lava down its side while sparking the evacuation of nearly 2,000 people exactly one year after its last major eruption killed dozens.

The burst from the highest mountain on Indonesia's main island of Java, around 800 kilometres (500 miles) southeast of the capital Jakarta, prompted authorities to raise the alert status for the volcano to the highest level.

Villages around Semeru were being battered by a mix of volcanic ash and monsoon rains. Videos shared with AFP by a local rescue group showed a huge black cloud rising from the volcano, engulfing the sky and blocking the sun.

One resident described the panic when the ash clouds descended on their village.

"It was dark, I could not see anything. It was raining water and ash," the person, who did not want to be named, told AFP.

"I didn't know where to take shelter. I had to flee."

"Hot avalanches" triggered by piles of lava at the top flooded down the 3,676-metre (12,060 feet) mountain, said Abdul Muhari, a spokesperson for Indonesia's National Disas-

ter Mitigation Agency (BNPB).

A spokesperson for Indonesia's Volcanology and Geological Disaster Mitigation Centre (PVMBG) told broadcaster Kompas TV that the higher alert level meant local villages were in danger.

However, no casualties or injuries were reported on Sunday after the PVMBG warned nearby residents not to travel within eight kilometres (five miles) of the crater.

The geological agency said that by evening Semeru was "still in the eruption phase" though the size of the ash clouds was decreasing.

"Overall the activity is still very high," it said in a statement.

The internet in the area was down and phone signals were patchy after the eruption, according to a journalist.

Protesters storm governor's office in southern Syrian city, gunfire heard

Dozens of demonstrators angry over worsening economic conditions in Syria stormed the governor's office in the southern city of Sweida yesterday and set fire to parts of the building amid a heavy exchange of gunfire, the authorities and witnesses said.

Earlier, more than 200 people had gathered around the building in the centre of the Druze-majority city, chanting slogans calling for the overthrow of Syrian President Bashar Assad, they said, amid spiralling prices and economic hardship.

Syrian state media said tens of "outlaws" stormed the governor's office and burned files and official papers.

Three witnesses told Reuters the governor was not in the building which was vacated before protesters stormed

the offices.

"The governor's office was burnt completely from the inside," said Rayan Maarouf, a civic activist and editor of Suwayda 24, a local website that covers the southern region, who said several people were wounded in the exchange of gunshots.

"There was heavy gunfire," Maarouf told Reuters, saying it was not clear from where the shooting came in the heavily policed area.



Shargh daily say there have been fewer sightings of the morality police on the streets in recent weeks as authorities apparently try to avoid provoking more protests.

On Saturday, Montazeri was cited by the semi-official Iranian Labour News Agency as saying that the morality police had been disbanded.

"The same authority which has established this police has shut it down," he was quoted as saying. He said the morality police was not under the judiciary's authority, which "continues to monitor behavioural actions at the community level."

Al Alam state television said foreign media were depicting his comments as "a retreat on the part of the Islamic Republic from its stance on hijab and religious morality as a result of the protests", but that all that could be understood from his comments was that the morality police were not directly related to the judiciary.

EXECUTIONS

State media said four men convicted of cooperating with Israel's spy agency Mossad were executed on Sunday.

They had been arrested in June - before the current unrest sweeping the country - following cooperation between the Ministry of Intelligence and the Revolutionary Guards, Tasnim news agency reported.

The Islamic Republic has long accused arch-enemy Israel of carrying out covert operations on its soil. Tehran has recently accused Israeli and Western intelligence services of plotting a civil war in Iran.

The prime minister's office in Israel, which oversees Mossad, declined to comment.

Iranian state media reported on Wednesday that the country's Supreme Court had upheld the death sentence handed out to the four men "for the crime of cooperating with the intelligence services of the Zionist regime and for kidnapping".

Ethiopia's Tigray forces say they have withdrawn 65% of fighters

More than half of Tigrayan forces have withdrawn from the frontlines, the forces' top commander said, a month after a ceasefire agreement aimed at ending the two-year conflict in Ethiopia's northern Tigray region.

"We have accomplished 65% disengagement of our army," Tadesse Wereda, commander-in-chief of the Tigray People's Liberation Front (TPLF) said in a video posted on the forces' official Facebook page late on Saturday.

"Our army left the front lines and moved to the place prepared for them to camp. Our forces withdrew on vehicles and on foot."

Ethiopian government spokesman Legesse Tulu did not respond to requests for comment.

War erupted in Ethiopia's northern Tigray region in November 2020, pitting the Tigrayan forces against federal troops and their

allies that included fighters from the Amhara region that borders Tigray and Eritrean soldiers.

The fighting has killed thousands, displaced millions and left hundreds of thousands facing famine.

In a surprise diplomatic breakthrough, however, the two sides signed a permanent cessation of hostilities in an African Union (AU)-mediated peace deal on Nov. 2 in South Africa.

Chinese cities ease curbs but full zero-COVID exit seen some way off

More Chinese cities including Urumqi in the far west announced an easing of coronavirus curbs yesterday as China tries to make its zero-COVID policy more targeted and less onerous after unprecedented protests against restrictions last weekend.

Urumqi, the capital of the Xinjiang region and where the protests first erupted, will reopen malls, markets, restaurants and other venues from Monday, authorities said, ending strict lockdowns after months.

There was no sign of any significant unrest this weekend, although police were out in force in the Liangmaqiao area of Beijing and in Shanghai around Wulumuqi Road, which is named after Urumqi. Both sites saw protests a week ago.

A deadly fire last month in Urumqi sparked dozens of protests against COVID curbs in over 20 cities after some social media users said victims had been unable to escape the blaze because their apartment building was locked down. Authorities denied that.

At the global level, bonds play an important role in the financial, corporate and banking business. Very often, many governments and international financial institutions issue bonds whenever there is a need to raise money for certain prime projects or to cover the deficiency in the budget by borrowing from local markets and \ or international investors. We have good examples in big companies, airlines, banks, infrastructure projects and many other sectors, who issued bonds that proved to be very successful due to the good performance of the issuer and the subject-matter of the issue. Herein, generally speaking, the marketing method related to the issuance of bonds varies according to certain merits and many circumstances such as the need to list the market response by publishing a preliminary prospectus and the need to identify the range of the proposed investors who could be interested in the bond. This includes private investors and sophisticated or public investors. The main techniques for marketing bonds could be summarized o include, for example, the "Private placements", in this respect a manager or group of managers subscribe for the whole issue and thereafter places this issue with selected private clients, or in some cases, with a single private investor. These issues may be listed or unlisted and this is primarily used when the issuer is interested to deal with certain person or group of persons as investors.

The "Preliminary Prospectus Offerings", the purpose of this method is to list the market before the managers fix the interest rate and /or any discount (or premium) on subscription. The managers normally contact a group of selected financial institutions and give them brief details of the issue and the issuer and an indication of the terms of the proposed issue. The managers also send out a preliminary prospectus, which omits disclosure of the issue terms and is stated to be subject to future amendments. This is usually known as the "red - herring" or "pathfinder" prospectus. In the light of the response to the prospectus, the managers agree with the issuer on the interest rate and arranges for the issue to be underwritten and then offers the bonds to the interested financial institutions. These financial institutions hold and keep the bonds for themselves or they keep them in for sale to their clients or to the public-at-large, if permitted and allowed by the securities regulations and related laws.

What has been explained above constitutes the traditional method followed mostly in the case of an international Eurobond offering and the same applies, for example, in the case of American and Canadian domestic offerings. However, it has been noticed that many Eurobond issues are nowadays "bought deals". That is to say the managers dispense with the preliminary prospectus, however, the entire issues themselves are on-sale to dealers. The "Impact Day offerings", herein, in this method the managers fix the issue terms with the issuer and announce the offering by public advertisement on an "impact day". Public can apply on certain application forms for the concerned securities within a stated period. The disadvantage of this method, if we could say, is that the managers are not able to fix the issue terms in the light of an initial market response and must hope that the terms they decide on will attract sufficient investor's interest. It is important to note that this is the method used in many domestic offerings and most likely, they are possibly used in many international capital markets.

To conclude, we could say that this market is volatile and there are many factors to be involved, from the issuer and \ or investor perspective. Potential investors need to be fully aware of such investment to achieve their end goals.



Brazilian soccer great Pele said on Saturday he was "strong" and grateful for the widespread support he has been receiving after being hospitalized in Sao Paulo earlier this week as he battles colon cancer.

The 82-year-old said in an Instagram post that he wanted to keep "everyone calm and positive" after a medical report showed he remained in stable condition while also being treated a respiratory infection.

"I'm strong, with a lot of hope and I follow my treatment as usual," Pele said. "I have a lot of faith in God and every message

of love I receive from you all over the world keeps me full of energy".

Pele, one of the greatest footballers of all time if not the greatest, was admitted to hospital on Tuesday to re-evaluate his cancer treatment.

Spin king Nathan Lyon bagged six wickets, including century-maker Kraigg Brathwaite, as Australia ground down a gutsy West Indies to win the first Test in Perth by 164 runs yesterday.

Skipper Brathwaite, who

took the match into a final day with a defiant overnight 101 after Australia declared their second innings at 182-2 on day four, couldn't keep the momentum going against Lyon and was bowled for 110.
