Alba honours top contractors

US sanctions Houthi leaders

The US yesterday sanctioned seven Houthi leaders and an individual who sent Yemeni civilians to fight for Russia in Ukraine, a day after reimposing a terrorist designation against the Yemeni militant group.

The Iran-backed rebels control much of Yemen, including the capital Sanaa, and have launched missile and drone attacks at Israel since the war in Gaza broke out in October 2023.

The seven sanctioned leaders "have smuggled military-grade items and weapon systems into Houthi-controlled areas of Yemen and also negotiated Houthi weapons procurements from Russia," the US Treasury Department said in a statement, using an alternative spelling for the group.

4.75kg of drugs found in suitcase at Bahrain airport

A smuggling attempt fell apart at Bahrain International Airport when a customs officer discovered 4.75kg of drugs glued beneath a suitcase lining, triggering a string of arrests that exposed a cross-border trafficking ring.

The officer, stationed at the airport, became wary of two passengers and their luggage.

A closer look turned suspicion into certainty. Buried beneath the inner lining of their bags, hidden with adhesive, were black nylon packets stuffed with what appeared to be crystal meth.

Faced with the find, the pair wasted no time in pointing fingers. They claimed the drugs belonged to an Asian man still in his home country – the one who had arranged their travel.

HM King back from successful Arab summit



His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa, current President of the Arab Summit, returned to the Kingdom of Bahrain after leading the Kingdom's delegation to the extraordinary session of the Arab League Council at the summit level (Palestine Summit). HM the King also chaired the summit proceedings, which were hosted by Egypt in its Administrative Capital in Cairo, at the invitation of His Excellency Abdel Fattah El Sisi, President of the Arab Republic of Egypt. His Majesty the King was bid farewell at Cairo International Airport by Dr. Khaled Abdel Ghaffar, Deputy Prime Minister for Human Development and Minister of Health and Population of Egypt, along with Fawzia bint Abdullah Zainal, Bahrain's Ambassador to Egypt and Permanent Representative to the Arab League.

Time to rebuild

MPs rally support for fund to restore ageing neighbourhoods amid opposition

Calls for a fund to fix Bahrain's ageing neighbourhoods have picked up steam, with MPs warning that years of patchy maintenance and sluggish upgrades have left many areas in a sorry state.

Their proposal, which seeks government backing alongside private investment, won the support of the Southern Municipal Council yesterday – but not all councils are on board.

MPS Hamad Al Doy, Mohammed Mousa, and Hassan Ebrahim have proposed setting up an independent board to manage funding and prioritise areas most in need.

Comprising officials, community groups, and businesses, the board would rely on field studies to determine where upgrades should begin.

Feedback

Parliament's Public Utilities and Environment Committee had requested feedback from municipal councils across the country regarding the proposed fund. However, responses have

The Southern Municipal Council welcomed the plan, with chairman Abdullah Ibrahim AbdulLatif stressing the need for stronger collaboration between the public and private sectors to accelerate work.

"This has been running for 18 years, yet demand keeps growing. Getting businesses involved would speed up the work and help more people," he said.

Government cash

Councillor Hamad Al Zaabi echoed this, arguing that relying solely on government cash would not get the job done.

"Real progress comes when

With municipal councils divided, the question now is whether Parliament will take the plan forward or reconsider its approach.

businesses, communities, and authorities work together. It can't all be left to the state," he said.

The council will now seek talks with the Minister of Municipalities Affairs and Agriculture to explore funding options.

Yet, on Monday, the Muharraq Municipal Council rejected the



proposal after a split vote, with members warning it would shift responsibility from the government to private donors.

Charitable contribution

Councillor Fadhel Al Oud argued that approving the fund would make the public reliant on charitable contributions.

"The government has already told Parliament it cannot establish such a fund. Once private donations dry up, promised developments may never materialise," he said.

His concerns reflect wider worries about sustainability, with critics fearing that once the fund is depleted, the govern-

ment will refuse to step in. The push to fix old neighbourhoods is not new.

Home repairs and renovations

Since 2006, the Urban and Rural Development Project has carried out more than 12,000 home repairs and renovations, including adding rain barriers. AbdulLatif noted that the work has strong backing from the top.

"His Majesty the King and His Royal Highness the Crown Prince and Prime Minister have always supported this programme, knowing how much it helps low-income families," he said.

Swinging for growth

Plan for new golf course in Southern Governorate promises tourism, jobs and investment

A golf course could be built in the Southern Governorate after winning backing from the municipal council, with supporters arguing it would bring tourists, jobs and investment.

The plan, approved yesterday, is expected to draw players from abroad, particularly from countries where golf has a strong following, while lifting property values and encouraging new businesses.

Southern Municipal Council chairman Abdulla Abdullatif said the benefits go beyond the sport itself.

“Golf encourages an active way of life, and a well-placed course would be more than just a playing field – it could be a place for community events, training for young players and social gatherings,” he said.

Businesses

The idea is to put the governorate on the map as a golfing destination, with restaurants, hotels and other businesses likely to follow.

Abdullatif said the project would open up work in management, groundskeeping and hospitality, giving a push to the local economy.

“A golf course can attract further investment to the area

– hotels, restaurants, and leisure facilities would naturally follow,” he said.

The plan presents the course as an environmental asset, with supporters arguing it would add greenery, conserve resources and support local wildlife.

The design, they say, could include water-saving measures and steps to protect plant and animal life.

“If done right, it won’t just be a sporting venue – it’ll enhance the scenery and provide a natural refuge,” Abdullatif said.

The next step will be a closer look at whether the plan stacks up financially and how it might change the area in the long run.

Unused government money to fund projects and pensions

Unused government funds would be redirected into development projects or the pension system under a draft law before Parliament.

The proposal, put forward by MP Basma Mubarak, seeks to stop unspent money from gathering dust in ministry budgets and instead put it to work in areas that need it.

If passed, funds left over from government budgets would be pooled into a new account under the Ministry of Finance and National Economy.

Projects

Money set aside for projects that never got off the ground

or were indefinitely shelved would be redirected to either high-priority infrastructure or the pension and social insurance fund.

Mubarak said the plan was about making better use of public money.

“Government budgets should

serve the people, not sit unused while key projects stall or pension funds struggle. This proposal ensures every dinar is put to work,” she said.

Reports

Government departments would have to file yearly reports detailing unused funds and projects that had been delayed or abandoned.

A panel, chaired by the Finance Ministry and including the National Audit Office (NAO) and the Social Insurance Organisation (SIO), would oversee allocations to ensure spending was above board.

If approved, the changes would take effect at the start of the next financial year.

Pharmaceutical manufacturing zone

A proposal to set up a pharmaceutical manufacturing zone has been forwarded to Parliament, aiming to secure Bahrain’s medicine supply and reduce reliance on imports.

MP Ahmed Al Salloom, who submitted the request, said the move would strengthen reserves and help the country manage shortages more effectively.

He pointed to increasing efforts abroad to produce medicines locally, especially after

the Covid-19 pandemic exposed flaws in global supply chains.

Expansion

“Expanding local production

means fewer shortages and less last-minute scrambling for supplies,” he said.

The plan calls for a dedicated industrial zone with incentives to attract pharmaceutical firms, ensuring a reliable supply of medicines for both urgent and long-term health conditions.

Al Salloom said the proposal would bolster Bahrain’s standing in the industry, adding that a strategically located manufacturing hub could attract investment and strengthen supply lines.

- 12- A) Approval of the Board of Directors' recommendation for the Bank to borrow by issuing debt instruments (including bonds or Sukuk or Additional Tier 1 Capital) in one or more tranches from time to time and in any currency, provided that the maximum aggregate amount does not exceed the limit specified in agenda item number 11 above. The issuance could be executed through either the launch of a stand-alone debt instrument or through the launch and implementation of a Euro Medium-Term Note (EMTN) Program at times and under terms determined by the Board of Directors, including terms related to issuance price, issuance date, maturity date, interest rate, early redemption, or deferred payment of the bonds ("Bond Program"). The Board of Directors shall be authorized to approve the issuance of debt instruments within a period of two years from the date of the resolution authorizing such issuance.
 - B) Approval to authorize the Board of Directors to grant and provide appropriate security over any of the Bank's assets, including but not limited to various types of mortgages, assignments, and transfers, as deemed appropriate by the Board of Directors at its discretion, to secure the Bank's obligations under the Bond Program.
 - C) Approval to authorize the Board of Directors to negotiate, approve, and establish all terms and conditions related to the Bond Program, to grant and provide guarantees, to undertake all necessary procedures with the relevant authorities, to obtain the required approvals from regulatory bodies (including the Central Bank of Bahrain), and to sign on behalf of the Bank, whenever necessary or appropriate, all contracts, documents, and related papers. The Board shall also be authorized to issue the necessary powers of attorney and delegations to any person or persons, as required, to undertake any procedures, actions, or sign any documents necessary for the implementation of its resolutions related to the Bond Program.
- 13- A) To discuss the proposal of the Board of Directors relating to amendments to the current variable remuneration policy and the share incentives scheme and share plan and endorsing it for approval.
 - B) To authorize the Board of Directors and/ or the Nomination, Remuneration, Governance and Sustainability Committee to issue the detailed regulations, documentation, policies and rules necessary for the implementation of the policies, (including, but not limited to, size of awards, terms and allocation of share awards, key performance metrics, share-buy back rules, risk adjustments etc.) from time to time, subject to obtaining of the Central Bank of Bahrain approval, where required.
- 14- To discuss any other matters in accordance with Article 207 of the Commercial Companies Law.

Note: The required voting percentage to approve the above-mentioned resolutions by the Ordinary Shareholders Assembly is the majority of shares represented at the meeting.

Musk fails in bid to block OpenAI becoming for-profit business

A US judge on Tuesday denied Elon Musk's request to prevent OpenAI from becoming a for-profit business in a loss for the Tesla tycoon amid his feud with Sam Altman.

US District Court Judge Yvonne Gonzalez Rogers ruled that Musk and his xAI startup failed to prove an injunction against OpenAI was necessary as the case heads to trial.

Musk sued in California federal court to stop OpenAI from transitioning from a nonprofit to a for-profit business, arguing the startup violated antitrust law and betrayed his trust in their mission as a co-founder of OpenAI.

The judge wrote that, while Musk did not prove the need for an injunction, she is prepared to expedite a trial on that claim later this year.



Trump jokes 'nobody has heard' of Lesotho
♦ US President Donald Trump on Tuesday mocked tiny Lesotho as a country "nobody has ever heard of" as he defended his sweeping cuts in aid. Trump highlighted the landlocked African constitutional monarchy during an address to Congress as he gave a long list of past US aid projects. "Eight million dollars to promote LGBTQ+ in the African nation of Lesotho," Trump said, struggling with the pronunciation. "Which nobody has ever heard of," Trump added, as Republican lawmakers laughed and Vice President JD Vance and Speaker Mike Johnson grinned behind him.

Philippine rescuers found the wreckage of a missing FA-50 fighter jet and the bodies of its two crew members yesterday in a mountainous region of the country's south. The FA-50 fighter jet had gone missing a day earlier while on a mission to provide air support for troops fighting communist rebels in northern Mindanao. Lieutenant General Luis Rex Bergante, commander of Eastern Mindanao Command, told AFP the two crewmen had been found inside the wreckage. "The bodies were found inside the aircraft. There was an attempt to open a parachute and eject," he said.

Europe's Ariane 6 rocket launch rescheduled to March 6
♦ The first commercial mission of Europe's new heavy-lift rocket Ariane 6 has been rescheduled for Thursday, French company Arianespace announced, after an "anomaly" forced a last-minute postponement. The already twice-delayed rocket was slated to lift off Monday, but had to be delayed after the discovery of a dysfunctional valve. The high-profile mission aims to carry a French military satellite into orbit, as well as more broadly to establish independent European access to space, without reliance on either the United States or Russia. It comes as Europe's commercial space industry struggles to remain competitive in the face of Elon Musk's SpaceX.

World's biggest iceberg runs aground, sparing wildlife haven island

The world's biggest iceberg appears to have run aground roughly 70 kilometres from a remote Antarctic island, potentially sparing the crucial wildlife haven from being hit, a research organisation said. The colossal iceberg A23a -- which is more than twice the size of Greater London and weighs nearly one trillion tonnes -- has been drifting north from Antarctica towards South Georgia island since 2020. This had raised fears it could collide with the island or run aground in shallower water near it, potentially disrupting the ability of penguins and seals to feed their young. However, the gigantic wall of ice has been stuck 73 kilometres (45 miles) from the island since March 1, according to a statement from the British Antarctic Survey (BAS). "If the iceberg stays grounded, we don't expect it to significantly affect the local wildlife," BAS oceanographer Andrew Meijers said. "In the last few decades,

the many icebergs that end up taking this route through the Southern Ocean soon break up, disperse and melt," added Meijers, who encountered A23a in late 2023 and has tracked its fate via satellite ever since. Satellite images analysed by AFP showed that the closest edge of the roughly 3,300-square-kilometre iceberg had stopped more than 70 kilometres from the island in late February. It remains unclear whether the iceberg is stuck for good. "It will be interesting to see what will happen now," Meijers added. The world's biggest and oldest iceberg calved from the Antarctic shelf in 1986. It remained stuck for over 30 years before finally breaking free in 2020, its lumbering journey north sometimes delayed by ocean forces that kept it spinning in place. Satellite imagery had previously suggested it was not crumbling into smaller chunks along the familiar path that such icebergs take. However a 19-kilometre chunk broke off in January.

Suicide bombers kill 18 in Pakistan

Attack on army compound in Bannu leaves 13 civilians and five soldiers dead

Thirteen civilians and five soldiers were killed when suicide bombers drove two explosive-laden cars into an army compound in northwestern Pakistan, the military said yesterday. Four children were among those killed in Tuesday's attack, which involved four suicide bombers, with fighting raging into the early hours of yesterday. The attack took place in Bannu, a district in the turbulent Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province close to Afghanistan and adjacent to the formerly self-governed tribal areas, once a hotbed for militancy. "The terrorists entered Bannu Cantt from two different directions and, after an intense operation lasting several hours until this morning, all attackers were eliminated," provincial minister Pakhtoon Yar Khan told AFP, adding that four children and three women were killed. Plumes of grey smoke rose into the air after the two explosions, with gunfire heard throughout the night. "In this intense exchange of

fire, five brave soldiers, after putting up a heroic resistance, embraced martyrdom in the line of duty," the military said in a statement yesterday, adding that 13 civilians were also killed. The statement said 16 "terrorists", including four suicide bombers, were killed, while a nearby mosque and residential area were severely damaged. Thousands of people, including security officials, attended funerals for 12 of the civilians held at a sports complex in Bannu yesterday afternoon. Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif denounced the attackers as "cowardly terrorists who target innocent civilians during the holy month of Ramadan" and said they "deserve no mercy." "Apocalyptic devastation" The attack was claimed by a faction of the Hafiz Gul Bahadur armed group, which actively supported the Afghan Taliban in its war against the US-led NATO coalition between 2001 and 2021. "The force of the explosion threw me several feet away... The explosion was so intense that it caused significant damage to the neighbourhood," Nadir Ali Shah, 40, told AFP from hospital as he received treatment for head and leg wounds. "It was a scene of apocalyptic devastation." A police official, who asked not to be identified because he was

of failing to root out militants sheltering on Afghan soil as they prepare to stage assaults on Pakistan, a charge the Taliban government denies. The military said it has "unequivocally confirmed the physical involvement of Afghan nationals" in the attack, which they said was "orchestrated and directed" by militant leaders operating from Afghanistan. "Pakistan expects the Interim Afghan Government to uphold its responsibilities and deny its soil for terrorist activities against Pakistan," the statement said. Hafiz Gul Bahadur carried out another attack on the same compound last July, detonating a car bomb against the boundary wall, killing eight Pakistani soldiers. Last year was the deadliest in attacks that killed more than 1,600 people, according to Islamabad-based analysis group the Center for Research and Security Studies.

Ailing pope 'rested well' but misses start of Lent

Pope Francis rested well during his 19th night in hospital with pneumonia, the Vatican said yesterday, as celebrations for the Lent religious season started without him. The 88-year-old head of the Catholic Church has suffered a worrying series of respiratory attacks since his admission to the Gemelli in Rome on February 14, the most recent on Monday. The pope "rested well overnight", the Vatican said yesterday morning. The previous evening it said he would wear an oxygen mask during the night. Francis had passed a calm day on Tuesday after Monday's two episodes of acute respiratory failure, with the Vatican reporting he had no fever, was "alert" and cooperating with his treatment.

Greenland rejects Trump pledge to make the island American

Greenland's prime minister yesterday hit back at President Donald Trump's pledge to take the Arctic territory "one way or the other", insisting that islanders did not see their future with the United States or even Denmark. Mute Egede rejected Trump's expansionist ambitions to annex the sparsely populated but mineral-rich and strategically placed island, in a partisan address to the US Congress in Washington on Tuesday. "We don't want to be Americans, or Danes either. We are Greenlanders. The Americans and their leader must understand that," Egede wrote in a Facebook post. "We are not for sale and can't just be taken. Our future is decided by us in Greenland," he said, six days before the island's legislative elections where the longstanding question of independence tops the agenda.

'America is back,' Trump declares in divisive Congress speech

Donald Trump declared "America is back" Tuesday in his first address to Congress since returning to power, touting his radical policies in the face of raucous Democratic hostility while proclaiming a breakthrough on Ukraine. In the longest presidential speech to lawmakers on record, the Republican repeatedly hailed billionaire advisor Elon Musk's controversial assault on the federal bureaucracy and said his administration was "just getting started". "The American Dream is unstoppable," said Trump in a speech lasting over one hour and 40 minutes, which beat Bill Clinton's record for his State of the Union speech in 2000. Almost every line got loud applause from Republican Party members, including on two occasions when Trump singled out SpaceX and Tesla tycoon Musk, who stood up to salute Congress. But protests also began within minutes.

Can Gulf Air Explore Leasing or Chartering to Sustain Calicut Operations?

Gulf Air's decision to discontinue flights to Calicut has shocked frequent travellers like myself. As someone from South Kerala, my final destination is usually Calicut, and I have long relied on Gulf Air for its direct connectivity from Bahrain. The convenience of a nonstop flight is invaluable for many Indian expatriates. On my last trip from Calicut to Bahrain, I observed nearly 90% occupancy on the flight. Indians make up the largest expatriate community in Bahrain, with unofficial estimates suggesting that over 50% are Keralites—many hail from the Malabar region, making direct flights to Calicut crucial. Discontinuing the Calicut route and reducing Cochin flights will create major inconveniences, especially for those travelling for business and family visits. While Gulf Air may focus on increasing transit passengers from destinations like Goa and Bangalore, this decision risks alienating a core segment of loyal passengers. Airlines worldwide struggle with financial losses due to rising fuel costs, labour expenses, and high debts. Countries like Argentina, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, India, and South Africa have privatised their national carriers to improve efficiency. Despite various strategic measures, Gulf Air faces financial challenges and must take drastic steps to attain profit. Instead of completely withdrawing from the Bahrain-Calicut sector, Gulf Air could consider a leasing or chartering model to maintain operations while ensuring financial sustainability.

As a result, Muslims are encouraged to dedicate time to reciting, understanding, and reflecting upon the Quran. Many aim to complete its recitation at least once during the month, while

others attend nightly Taraweeh prayers to listen to its recitation in congregation. The connection with the Quran during Ramadan serves as a reminder of divine guidance and the importance of implementing its teachings in daily life.

Mercy and forgiveness

Ramadan is also a month of immense mercy and forgiveness. The Prophet (PBUH) said,

"Whoever fasts during Ramadan with faith and seeking reward, his past sins will be forgiven" (Bukhari, Muslim). This hadith emphasizes the power of sincere worship in this sacred month. Muslims engage in increased supplication (dua), seeking Allah's pardon for past mistakes and praying for His blessings in both this life and the Hereafter. The last ten nights hold special significance, particularly

Laylatul Qadr (the Night of Decree), which is described in the Quran as "better than a thousand months" (Surah Al-Qadr 97:3). On this night, Allah's mercy descends abundantly, and sincere prayers are accepted.

Charity and generosity

Acts of charity and generosity define Ramadan, as the rewards for good deeds are multiplied. The Prophet (PBUH) was known to be even more generous in this month, encouraging believers to help the less fortunate. Many give Zakat (obligatory charity) and Sadaqah (voluntary charity) to ensure that those in need can also experience the joy of Ramadan. Feeding others, whether through providing Iftar meals or supporting charitable causes, brings immense blessings. This emphasis on giving fosters a sense of community and reminds Muslims of their responsibility toward others.

The fast is broken each day at sunset with Iftar, often beginning with dates and water, following the Sunnah of the Prophet (PBUH). This moment of breaking the fast is a time of gratitude, where Muslims reflect on the blessings they have and

make heartfelt supplications. The communal aspect of Iftar, whether with family, friends, or at the mosque, strengthens bonds and fosters a spirit of unity.

As Ramadan comes to an end, the celebration of Eid-ul-Fitr marks the completion of this blessed journey. It is a day of joy, gratitude, and togetherness, where Muslims gather for prayers, share meals, and give charity (Zakat-ul-Fitr) to ensure that even the less fortunate can celebrate. However, the true success of Ramadan lies in carrying forward its lessons—maintaining Taqwa, continuing acts of kindness, and preserving the connection with Allah throughout the year.

Gift

Ramadan is a gift from Allah, a chance for spiritual renewal and personal growth. It is a reminder that true fulfillment comes not from material possessions but from sincere worship, gratitude, and service to others. By embracing the essence of Ramadan, Muslims strengthen their faith, purify their hearts, and prepare for the journey ahead with renewed commitment and devotion.

Ramadan Recipe

Namoura (Syrup-Soaked Semolina Cake)

Yield: 20 to 24 pieces
Time: 1hr

Namoura, a cake made from semolina flour, is soaked in syrup while it's still warm. The cake has no eggs, but this version gets its rich flavor and texture from aerated yogurt, which goes bubbly within minutes of being mixed with a little baking soda

Ingredients

For the Syrup

- 2 cups/400 grams granulated sugar
- 1 tablespoon freshly squeezed lemon juice
- 1¼ teaspoons lavender extract, vanilla extract or rose water

For the Cake

- ¾ cup/170 grams unsalted butter (1½ sticks), melted, plus more for coating the pan
- 3 cups/490 grams semolina flour
- ¾ cup/150 grams granulated sugar
- 1 cup/227 grams plain whole-milk yogurt
- 2½ teaspoons baking soda
- ¼ cup/29 grams slivered almonds

Method:

1. In a small saucepan over high heat, boil sugar and 1 cup/240 milliliters of water, stirring until the sugar is dissolved. Reduce the

heat to a simmer, add lemon juice and extract, and stir to combine. Simmer until thickened into a syrup, about 2 minutes. Remove from the heat and set aside to cool.

2. Heat oven to 400 degrees. Coat a 9-by-13-inch baking dish with butter. Place the semolina, melted butter and sugar in a large bowl and stir until well combined; set aside.

3. Place the yogurt and baking soda in a medium bowl and stir to combine. Set aside until



the mixture has nearly doubled in size, about 10 minutes.

4. Pour the yogurt mixture over

the semolina mixture and mix well to combine. Transfer to the buttered baking dish and press into an even layer. Using a knife, score the surface of the namoura on the diagonal into 2-inch diamond-shaped pieces. Top each diamond in the center with an almond. Bake until golden brown, 25 to 30 minutes.

5. Place baking dish on a wire rack and drizzle the cooled syrup over the top of the hot namoura. Let cool to room temperature before recutting along the scored lines and serving.







Bahrain unveil squad for World Cup qualifiers

Bahrain's national football team has officially named its squad for the next phase of the 2026 FIFA World Cup qualifiers, and this group has the makings of something special. The announcement, made ahead of a crucial stretch of matches, carries the weight of a nation's dreams—to finally reach the World Cup finals for the first time in history.

Carefully curated

The 26-man roster, shared by the Bahrain Football Association, is a carefully curated mix of experience and youthful energy, a testament to coach Dragan Talajic's vision for this campaign. Leading the goal-keeping unit are Sayed Mohammed Jaffer and the ever-reliable Ebrahim Lutfalla, whose heroics have kept Bahrain in contention time and again. Defenders like Waleed Al-Hayam, Abdulla Al-Khalasi, and Sayed Baqer form a sturdy backline, with Al-Khalasi already proving his worth by scoring the lone goal in Bahrain's 1-0 upset over Australia in September 2024.

In midfield, names like Komail Al-Aswad and Mohammed Al-Hardan stand out—Al-Aswad's playmaking, with two assists in the third round, has

been a bright spot, while Al-Hardan's tenacity anchors the center. Up top, forwards Mahdi Abduljabbar and Abdulla Yusuf bring the firepower, each with two goals in this round, alongside Ali Madan, whose flair on the wing has troubled defenses across Asia.

Bahrain finds itself in Group C of the third round, a gauntlet that includes Japan, Australia, Saudi Arabia, China PR, and Indonesia. With five matches played, Bahrain sits third with 8 points, having secured a gritty away win over Australia (1-0), thanks to a goal from Al-Khalasi, and hard-fought draws against Indonesia (2-2), with Marhoon scoring a brace, and Saudi Ara-

bia (0-0). But losses to Japan (0-5) and China (2-3) have shown the fine margins they're navigating. Japan leads the group with 13 points, followed by Australia (9) and Bahrain (8), while Saudi Arabia (7), China (4), and Indonesia (4) trail. The top two teams will qualify directly for the 2026 World Cup, with third and fourth advancing to further rounds—a tight race that leaves little room for error.

Japan Looms Large

The next test is a formidable one: an away clash against group leaders Japan on March 20. Japan has been ruthless, scoring 18 goals in five matches, and Bahrain will need their defense,

New Zealand secured their place in a seventh ICC final and fourth in the ODI format, overpowering South Africa by 50 runs in a record-breaking Champions Trophy semi-final in Lahore yesterday.

The Black Caps will now face India in Sunday's final in Dubai, riding high after posting the tournament's highest score of 326 for 6 and defending it with authority.

Rachin Ravindra led the charge with his fifth ODI cen-

ture—all scored in ICC events—his third consecutive ton against Glenn Phillips added rapid 49s while Kane Williamson notched South Africa. Daryl Mitchell and off 37 and 27 balls respectively,

Rachin Ravindra and Kane Williamson's 164-run partnership set a Champions Trophy record, while David Miller scored a century off the final ball of the match in a losing effort

South Africa's chase faltered despite a promising 105-run

stand between Bavuma and van der Dussen, undone by their own fielding lapses and an off-day with the ball.

Dropped catches, including a crucial miss of Williamson on 56, and a failure to adapt to the pitch's demands allowed New Zealand's batsmen to dominate.

Ravindra and Williamson's 164-run second-wicket partnership—the highest in Champions Trophy history—set the tone, blending aggression and composure. Ravindra's strike rate soared above 100, while Williamson patiently built his innings, accelerating late to devastating effect.

Steve Smith retires from one-day cricket after semi-final loss

Steve Smith has retired from one-day internationals following the defeat to India in the Champions Trophy semi-finals, Cricket Australia said yesterday.

The 35-year-old batsman, who led the team in the absence of regular skipper Pat Cummins, will continue to play Tests and T20 internationals.

Smith told his team-mates of his decision to retire immediately after Australia's four-wicket defeat in Dubai on Tuesday, having top-scored with 73 in his side's 264 all out.

"It has been a great ride and I have loved every minute of it," Smith said in a Cricket Australia press release.

After making his debut against the West Indies in 2010 as a leg-spinning all-rounder, Smith went on to play 170 ODIs, scoring 5,800 runs at an average of 43.28.

He smacked 12 centuries and 35 half-centuries, and was a member of Australia's 2015 and 2023 World Cup-winning teams.

"There have been so many

amazing times and wonderful memories," Smith said.

"Winning two World Cups was a great highlight along with the many fantastic team-mates who shared the journey.

"Now is a great opportunity for people to start preparing for the 2027 World Cup so it feels like the right time to make way.

"Test cricket remains a priority and I am really looking forward to the World Test Championship Final (in June), the West Indies in the winter and then England at home.

"I feel I still have a lot to contribute on that stage."

Smith, who also took 28 wickets at 34.67, was the Australian men's ODI player of the year in 2015 and 2021.

He was also in the ICC men's ODI team of the year in 2015.
