#### **Appeals Court rejects** embezzlement case for lack of evidence

The Appeals Court rejected an embezzlement case filed by an owner of a cleaning company against his partner, citing lack of proof.

The duo reportedly established the company in 2005 but decided to expand by launching a new company in 2010 under the name of the defendant.

However, their disagreements grew, prompting the plaintiff to file a lawsuit against his partner accusing him of pocketing BD1,121,955.

He told the court that the defendant was managing the company and he requested him to sign blank cheques to ensure the smoothness of operations in the company.

According to the plaintiff's statements before prosecutors, he took advantage of the signed cheques and deposited them into the account of another company that he owned.

"He stole more than BD1 million of the company's money. We wanted to expand the company but he badly exploited my faith in him and took the money for himself," he said.

The defendant also summoned witnesses who testified in his favour. Nevertheless, the High Criminal Court and the High Appeals Court rejected the lawsuit after it was found that the two were still dealing with each other, while an accounting expert refuted the plaintiff's claims that his partner embezzled the said amount.


