The 54-year-old veteran tactician will be joining the coaching staff currently led by head coach Odjie Mamon. Armed with vast experience

as player and coach, Souza de Brito will help the Philippine women's team prepare for the upcoming Southeast Asian Games to be held in Hanoi, Vietnam from Nov. 21 to Dec. 2 this year.

He was a member of the 1992 Brazilian men's volleyball team that captured an Olympic gold.

Souza de Brito would become an Olympic champ again, this time as Brazil's women's volleyball coach in Beijing in 2008.

He was also a champion coach at the club level, winning titles in his home nation as well as in Turkey and Japan.
