

 \mathbf{H} is Majesty King Ham-ad bin Isa Al Khalifa issued Decree (42) of 2024 appointing a permanent representative of the Kingdom of Bahrain to the United Nations Office in Geneva, based on the proposal of the Minister of Foreign Affairs, and following the approval of the Cabinet.

Under Article I, His Excellency Ambassador Abdullah Abdullatif Abdullah shall be appointed as Permanent Representative of the Kingdom of Bahrain to the United Nations Office in Geneva, with the title of Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary.

Under Article II, the Minister of Foreign Affairs shall implement this decree, it will be effective from the date of its issuance, and it shall be published in the Official Gazette.

HM the King issued Royal Order (23) of 2024, adjourning the second session of the sixth Legislative Term of the Shura and Representatives councils, as of Tuesday, May 8.

These latest attacks came as Orthodox Christians in Ukraine and Russia celebrated Easter, and as Moscow said its forces had captured another village on the battlefield.

"In Pokrovsk, rocket attacks killed two people and damaged a house," Vadim Filashkin, Ukraine's governor of the Donetsk region, said in a post on Telegram.

Hamas and Israel entrench Gaza truce positions as latest Cairo talks end

Hamas official said yesterday the group's delegation for Gaza truce talks in Cairo was leaving for Qatar, after public disagreement with Israel intensified over demands to end their seven-month

Earlier, Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu said "surrendering" to a demand to end the war would amount to defeat.

The Qatar-based political chief of Hamas, Ismail Haniyeh, countered by accusing Netanyahu of sabotaging the talks.

The Hamas official, who requested anonymity to discuss the negotiations, told AFP that "the meeting with the Egyptian intelligence minister has ended and the Hamas delegation is leaving for Doha for further consultations".

The Hamas negotiators are due back in Cairo tomorrow, said Al-Qahera News, a site linked to Egyptian intelligence







trust is a legal relationship in which a person who has legal rights to property has the duty to hold it for the benefit of another person. Persons benefited by a trust are considered to have "equitable title" to the property because it is being maintained for their benefit. This means that persons are regarded as the real owners even though the trustee has the legal title

Trust, may be created in a number of different ways, owner of the property may declare that he is holding certain property in trust. A mother might state that she is holding shares in trust for her son. The owner of property may transfer property with the expressed intent that the person is not to have the use of it but rather for others benefit.

Moreover, a trust may be created by operation of the law. For example, where a lawyer who represents a client injured in a car accident, receives a settlement payment from the insurance company, the lawver holds the settlement as trustee for his clients. There are many other instances.

Certain special terminologies are used, a person who creates a trust is known as the "donor" or the "settlor". The person who holds the property in trust is known as the "trustee". The person



Important to say that, there are basic elements for the creation of trust, including, the legal capacity of the donor, the donor must intend to create a trust in clear words, the trust must involve specific property or otherwise that the donor has the full right to convey, the beneficiary must be sufficiently identified and the trust must be created for a proper purpose. All must be available in order to give the trust the necessary legal effect.




