Iran, Oman Near Deal on Strait of Hormuz Shipping Framework

Iran and Oman are reportedly close to finalising a bilateral framework to manage maritime traffic through the Strait of Hormuz, one of the world's most strategically important shipping routes.

Iran's Foreign Ministry described the negotiations as strictly bilateral talks between the two coastal states, stressing that the discussions are independent of any U.S. demands or political timelines.

According to Iranian and regional officials, the proposed framework would establish separate shipping channels for inbound and outbound vessels. Ships entering the Arabian Gulf would reportedly use a route closer to Iran's coastline, while outbound vessels would travel through a corridor near Oman after notifying Iranian authorities. The arrangement would provide Iran with oversight of maritime traffic while allowing Oman to play a coordinating role.

Officials also said the proposal includes an intermediate shipping corridor that would replace the existing northern and southern routes once implemented. The framework may introduce service charges to cover security, environmental protection and operational costs, with revenues reportedly shared equally between Iran and Oman. However, U.S. officials have disputed Iranian claims regarding vessel approvals, permissions and fees.

Iran Rejects U.S. Position

Tehran dismissed suggestions that the Strait of Hormuz would reopen immediately under a U.S.-backed agreement, insisting that any



full reopening must be linked to the lifting of U.S. naval restrictions on Iranian ports and broader understandings between the two sides.

Oman has remained cautious in its public statements and has not officially confirmed all aspects of Iran's account of the negotiations.

Global Trade at Stake

The Strait of Hormuz, only about 33 kilometres wide at its narrowest point, serves as the primary gateway for a significant share of the world's oil and liquefied natural gas exports.

Since regional tensions escalated, competing navigation arrangements have emerged. The United States has encouraged commercial vessels to use a southern route closer to Omani waters under the protection of allied naval forces. Iran, meanwhile, insists that shipping should follow routes under its supervision, arguing that it has a legitimate security role because much of the waterway lies within or alongside its

territorial waters.

The differing positions have increased uncertainty for shipping companies, driving up insurance costs and raising concerns about potential disruptions to global energy supplies.

Draft Agreement Nearing Completion

Iranian Foreign Ministry spokesman Esmaeil Baqaei said the two countries have agreed on the geographical coordinates of the proposed shipping route and are finalising a joint statement outlining the framework. He added that the agreement could be announced soon if external parties do not interfere in the process.

If approved, the arrangement could provide a temporary mechanism for restoring confidence in commercial shipping while broader diplomatic negotiations continue. However, key questions—including vessel monitoring, intervention rights and operational authority—remain unresolved.

Israel resumes Lebanon strikes as Rome talks seek ceasefire breakthrough

Israel resumed airstrikes on southern Lebanon on Wednesday despite ongoing US-sponsored peace talks in Rome, accusing Hezbollah of violating a ceasefire agreement. Lebanese authorities said at least one person was killed and 11 others were wounded in separate strikes.

The Israeli military said it launched “precise strikes” against Hezbollah targets in response to what it described as a “blatant violation” of the ceasefire. It also issued an evacuation warning for residents of the southern town of Mansouri, urging them to move north for their safety. The warning marked the first such evacuation order since June.

The latest violence came as Lebanese and Israeli delegations met in Rome for the seventh round of US-mediated negotiations aimed at ending months of cross-border hostilities. Talks are focused on expanding pilot security zones, resolving border disputes and advancing a broader peace and security agreement.

A framework agreed in June calls for Hezbollah's disarmament, the gradual withdrawal of Israeli troops from southern Lebanon and



the deployment of the Lebanese army in areas vacated by Israeli forces. However, Hezbollah has rejected the agreement and continues to refuse to surrender its weapons.

Hezbollah leader Naim Qassem dismissed the negotiations, saying they would bring Lebanon “nothing but shame, humiliation and successive compromises.”

Although violence has declined since a preliminary US-Iran agreement and the June ceasefire framework, Lebanon continues to report intermittent Israeli airstrikes, shelling and demolitions in southern villages. Israeli forces still maintain a presence inside a security zone extending several kilometres

into southern Lebanon.

Meanwhile, the United Nations said more than 821,000 displaced Lebanese had returned to their hometowns by the end of July, though over 360,000 people remain displaced. The UN also warned that damage to water and electricity infrastructure continues to affect more than 700,000 residents in southern Lebanon.

The conflict began in March when Hezbollah launched rocket attacks on Israel in support of Iran, prompting Israeli airstrikes and a ground offensive that Lebanon says has killed more than 4,300 people and displaced over one million at the height of the fighting.
