EU hits Google with 2.95 bn euro fine

Brussels, Belgium

The EU yesterday slapped Google with a massive 2.95 billion euro (\$3.47 billion) antitrust fine for favouring its own advertising services, despite President Donald Trump's warnings not to target US big tech.

Google vowed to appeal the decision.

"Google abused its dominant position in adtech harming publishers, advertisers, and consumers. This behaviour is illegal under EU antitrust rules," EU competition chief Teresa Ribera said.

Gaza high-rises now under fire

● Fear deepens as Israel army targets tall buildings in Gaza

Those high-rise buildings still standing in Gaza are now targets, the Israeli army has said.

The announcement has

pushed residents, especially children already living in fear, into deeper anxiety.

"The news about Israel beginning to bomb towers and apartment buildings is terrifying. Everyone is scared and doesn't know where to go," said Ahmed Abu Wutfa, 45, who is staying in his relatives' partially destroyed fifth-floor apartment in western Gaza City.

"My children are terrified, and so am I. There is no safe place — we only hope that death comes quickly," he told AFP by telephone.

On Thursday, the Israeli military struck a high-rise in Gaza City, saying it was targeting structures used by Hamas, particularly tall buildings.

The latest escalation comes

as Israel steps up its campaign to capture the Palestinian territory's largest urban centre after nearly two years of devastating war. The military has been expanding its forces, intensifying bombardments, and operating on the outskirts of Gaza City.

In a statement on Thursday, the army said it had "identified significant Hamas activity within a wide variety of infrastructure sites in Gaza City, and particularly in high-rise buildings."

"In the coming days, the [Israeli military] will strike structures that have been converted into terrorist infrastructure in Gaza City: cameras, observation command centres, sniper and anti-tank firing positions, command-and-control compounds," the statement added.

Less than an hour later, the army issued another statement confirming it had struck one such high-rise, claiming Hamas had used it "to advance and execute attacks against [Israeli] troops in the area."



Israeli Defence Minister Israel Katz said in a statement on Friday that: "the bolt has now been removed from the gates of hell in Gaza".

Arab bloc says no peace without end to 'hostile' Israel actions

Cairo, Egypt

The Arab League has said that peaceful coexistence in the Middle East cannot be achieved without a Palestinian state and an end to what it described as Israel's "hostile practices".

In a resolution submitted by Egypt and Saudi Arabia and adopted on Thursday, the League said that "the failure to reach a just solution to the Palestinian cause and the hostile practices of the occupying power" remain major obstacles to "peaceful coexistence" in the region.

The resolution was part of a wider meeting in Cairo which wrapped up on Friday with Arab foreign ministers endorsing a "Joint Vision for Security and Cooperation in the region".

Captain denies intentionally dragging anchor that cut Baltic cable

Helsinki, Finland

The captain of a ship believed to belong to Russia's so-called shadow fleet yesterday denied intentionally dragging an anchor that damaged Baltic Sea cables in an alleged act of sabotage.

Captain Davit Vadachkoria, a Georgian national, and two senior officers of the Cook Islands-registered oil tanker Eagle S are accused of dragging the ship's anchor on the seabed for around 90 kilometres (56 miles), damaging five undersea cables in the Gulf of Finland on December 25, 2024.

Family escapes Salmaniya blaze

Father's extinguisher effort fails as flames spread

A quiet Friday afternoon in Salmaniya turned into chaos when a sudden spark from a split air conditioner ignited a fire that consumed an entire family home, forcing seven residents and their domestic worker to flee with nothing but their lives.

Futile attempt

Family members recounted



Family members recounted that the father rushed to douse the flames with a household fire extinguisher, but the blaze spread too quickly.

that the father rushed to douse the flames with a household fire extinguisher, but the blaze spread too quickly. Within minutes, smoke and flames engulfed the house, shattering windows

and sending glass flying into the street. The family escaped in panic, abandoning all belongings, and sought refuge with a neighbour.

Rapid response

Eyewitnesses said neighbours rushed to help, while five Civil Defense vehicles arrived swiftly and managed to bring the fire under control before it spread further. Despite the intensity of the blaze, no injuries were reported.

Ongoing probe

Civil Defense teams have launched an investigation into the exact cause of the outbreak. Witnesses confirmed that the force of the flames left the house severely damaged, though quick action by emergency crews prevented wider devastation.

The incident has been de-

scribed by residents as a stark reminder of how quickly electrical sparks can turn into infernos, underlining the need for vigilance and regular maintenance of household appliances.

Nearly 4,821 Bahrainis, families and individuals, received aid from the Royal Humanitarian Foundation (RHF) over the course of 2024, new figures show.

Living allowances accounted for the largest share, with 2,455 families supported. Marriage assistance reached 1,348 people, while 760 benefitted from medical aid. Fire relief covered 84 families and individuals. The foundation also furnished 20 homes, helped 50 families with appliances, extended study support to 25 people and aided 79 under the debt-relief scheme.

The total number of beneficiaries marked a 17 per cent rise on the previous year, when

4,128 families and individuals were assisted.

Monthly sponsorships added further reach, with 6,518 widows and 4,550 orphans supported. Each person in these categories receives a monthly sum of 60 dinars.

Formed by decree, the foundation carries a remit that spans social, health and educational aid. Its programmes range from caring for widows, orphans and the elderly to supporting people with special needs. It also backs non-profit projects such as orphanages, kindergartens, homes for the elderly, centres for children and people with disabilities, and family rehabilitation schemes. In addition, it contributes to long-term development by supporting small and medium-sized enterprises and allocating land for social and charitable work.

On the International Day of Charity, Bahrain reinforced that its charitable work is not confined to symbolic gestures but is part of a state structure designed to ensure sustained social support.

In a statement, Shaikh Dr. Rashid bin Mohammed bin Fetais Al Hajri, Chairman of the Sunni Endowments Council, stressed that charitable work in Bahrain is rooted in the directives of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa, who places citizens at the core of national

development. He said these efforts go beyond seasonal campaigns and reflect a deliberate, institutional strategy of giving.

Institutional roots

Shaikh Al Hajri highlighted the establishment of the Endowment Banking Department in 1995 as a turning point that allowed charitable projects to be organised and expanded.

This foundation, he explained, transformed generosity into a national practice with long-term sustainability.

Comprehensive programmes

The Council today manages a wide range of programmes. It provides monthly aid to families in need. During Ramadan, it organises Iftar banquets as

well as initiatives called Iftar on the Road and Iftar for the Fast-ing. It also ensures the provision of fountain water. Social welfare measures include marriage support, summer appliances, housing furnishings, emergency relief, Eid clothing and the distribution of sacrificial animals. Housing welfare programmes cover rental assistance and

home renovations. Educational support is extended through the sponsorship of university students and the distribution of school bags. The Council also contributes to healthcare assistance.

Royal and government backing

Shaikh Al Hajri expressed appreciation to His Majesty the

King for continuous support, which motivates and strengthens the Council's work. He praised the backing of the government led by His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, Crown Prince and Prime Minister, noting that it ensures effective programme delivery.

8,700 emergency incidents logged in July

Emergency services handled 8,700 incidents in July 2025, according to Interior Ministry data, led by 4,979 National Ambulance calls and 2,352 handled by the Operations Centre and Emergency Police Patrols.

Police reports were divided into 5 per cent security cases, 31 per cent traffic matters and 64 per cent other response incidents. The Coast Guard dealt with 162 reports. They included 105 search-and-rescue operations and vessel breakdowns, 11 maritime accidents and 46 assists at sea. Civil Defence responded to 1,207 calls, among

them 222 fires, 575 assistance requests, 112 traffic accidents and 16 reports of fallen trees, poles and advertising hoardings. Within the National Ambulance total were 3,647 medical cases, 476 transfers from private hospitals and health centres, 394 traffic accidents, 31 fires and 431 miscellaneous incidents.

Mutual pledges

He noted Bahrain's active role in supporting risk reduction measures and its contribution to building stronger systems of protection at both national and



international levels.

Ambassador Abdulla congratulated Kalantarli on his appointment and underlined Bahrain's commitment to maintain and expand cooperation with the ICDO.

Strengthening resilience

The ambassador highlighted Bahrain's willingness to support international efforts to build more resilient and sustainable communities, as well

The meeting signalled the importance Bahrain places on strengthening partnerships with global institutions dedicated to disaster preparedness and humanitarian protection, reflecting its ongoing engagement in safeguarding lives and property.

Bahrain put 29.28 per cent of its economy into investment in 2024, according to IMF data. The share

places the kingdom fourth in the Arab world, after Algeria, Libya and Saudi Arabia, and 37th out of 170 countries worldwide. It sits above the global average of 23.62 per cent. Investment here means

spending on factories, equipment, buildings and infrastructure, as well as additions to stock. Sales of valuable items such as art and jewellery are netted off.

Beyond oil

The figures line up with an effort to widen the economy beyond oil by building up financial services, tourism and manufacturing. A high investment share helps bring in foreign capital,

create jobs and sharpen the economy's edge.

Policy has focused on modern infrastructure, support for new ideas and the spread of digital technology across sectors. That leaves more room for small

and medium-sized firms to grow.

International bodies often take high investment rates as a sign that an economy can sustain growth, raise productivity and keep steadier conditions.

Bahrain–Egypt trade hits \$467m in 2024, Metals lead exports

Bahrain's trade with Egypt reached \$467m in 2024, driven by metal exports from Manama and a steady flow of Egyptian consumer goods, figures from the Bahrain Chamber of Commerce and Industry show. The balance puts Egypt among Bahrain's largest overseas markets, and sits within a much wider \$25.2bn trade relationship between Cairo and the Gulf recorded the year before.

Iron ore

Iron ore led Bahrain's shipments to Egypt with a value of \$164.4m. It was followed by unalloyed aluminium wire at \$75.8m and unwrought aluminium alloys worth \$34.5m. Semi-finished rolled products

added \$24.3m, with semi-manufactured iron and steel contributing \$10m. Copper pipes stood at \$5.9m, while exports of double-cab pickup trucks stood at \$5.8m. Other items included polyethylene terephthalate sheets worth \$5.1m, aluminium electrical cables with a steel core at \$4.2m, and alloyed aluminium wire at \$3.9m.

Imports

Imports ran to \$112m, with fruit and consumer goods taking the lead. Fresh or dried oranges topped the list at \$6.2m, trailed by television receivers at \$5.9m and pipe tobacco at \$5.3m. Smart televisions and women's sanitary pads were each worth \$4.5m. Toothpaste accounted for \$3.1m, while chocolate bars and blocks stood at \$3m. Potatoes, both fresh and

chilled, reached \$2.7m, with mangoes at the same figure, and frozen potatoes slightly less at \$2.6m.

Trade between the GCC and Egypt as a whole hit \$25.2bn in 2023, according to the GCC Statistical Centre. Exports from Gulf states to Egypt stood at \$16.6bn, while imports were \$8.6bn, leaving a surplus of \$8bn. Oil and petroleum products led with \$8.2bn, almost half the total. Plastics and related goods followed at \$1.8bn, then electrical machinery and kit at 6 per cent. On the import side, oil and petroleum products again featured at \$2.8bn, with gold and precious stones at 11.6 per cent and electrical equipment at 8.1 per cent. Fruit, copper goods and other items made up the rest, together worth \$4.1bn.

Tesla proposes package for Musk that could top \$1 trillion

Tesla unveiled yesterday a proposed compensation package for Elon Musk that could top \$1 trillion if the controversial CEO delivers on his vision for stratospheric growth from new technologies.

The plan potentially provides Musk -- already the world's wealthiest person -- with up to 12 percent of additional total company shares, according to a filing with the US Securities and Exchange Commission.

To reach the full award, Tesla must reach a market capitalization of "at least \$8.5 trillion by 2035," according to the filing, which announced a shareholder vote on the proposal in November.

Tesla's current market capitalization is just over \$1 trillion, down somewhat from its peak following recent weak earnings. Analysts have attributed some of the sales woes to Musk's embrace of far-right politicians, which has sparked criticism.

But Musk has described Tesla's potential growth as nearly boundless, saying in July that if the company delivers on its vision for autonomous driving and artificial intelligence, "Tesla will be the most valuable company in the world by far."

Tesla shares rallied on the announcement of the plan, which directly links Musk's potential pay to long-term shareholder performance, a popular ap-

proach with investors.

Earlier this month, Tesla announced an "interim" compensation award worth about \$29 billion for Musk, asserting the need to retain the outspoken CEO at a moment of fierce competition for top talent.

The developments come as Tesla challenges a Delaware court ruling that struck down a 2018 package for Musk of about \$55.8 billion.

Tesla Chair Robyn Denholm and board member Kathleen Wilson-Thompson described the new package as a "super ambitious incentive package for a pioneering, ambitious and unique CEO" in a letter to shareholders.

"We believe that Elon's singular vision is vital to navigating this critical inflection point," they said in the letter, which also set conditions of having one million robotaxis in commercial operation and one million AI bots.

"If Elon achieves all the performance milestones under this principle-based 2025 CEO Performance Award, his leadership will propel Tesla to become the most valuable company in history."

But Tesla also alluded to the possibility that the unprecedentedly massive pay package may worsen a public backlash to Tesla and Musk, whose fortune is estimated at around \$435 billion.

"Adverse public perception of the 2025 CEO Performance Award, even if it is baseless or satisfactorily addressed, may result in negative publicity for Tesla, which could materially and adversely affect our business, results of operations or financial condition," the filing said.

Musk was the most unpopular of 14 public figures polled by Gallup in August. It placed the billionaire just below Israeli leader Benjamin Netanyahu and US President Donald Trump.

Musk had a 33% favorable and 61% unfavorable rating, according to the poll.

Sri Lanka bus plunges
off precipice, 15 dead



◆ A Sri Lankan bus carrying local tourists visiting lush tea plantation hill towns plunged nearly 1,000 feet (300 metres), with the crash killing 15 people, police said yesterday. The accident took place on Thursday night in the mountainous Ella area, about 130 kilometres (81 miles) east of the capital. Sixteen others on board were injured. The group was returning home after a holiday in the cooler hills when the bus hit another vehicle, crashed through guardrails and then shot over the side. The accident is the worst since May, when 23 passengers died in a bus crash in Kotmale..

Pakistan's

It prompted a call by Filippo Grandi, the UN High Commissioner for Refugees: "Given the circumstances, I appeal to the (government of Pakistan) to pause the implementation of the Illegal Foreigners Repatriation Plan."

Pentagon says Venezuelan planes
buzzed US ship in 'highly provocative move'



◆ The Pentagon said two Venezuelan military planes flew near a US Navy vessel in international waters Thursday in a "highly provocative" move that marked a new escalation in the standoff over Washington's Caribbean deployment. "The cartel running Venezuela is strongly advised not to pursue any further effort to obstruct, deter or interfere with

counter-narcotics and counter-terror operations carried out by the US military," the Defense Department said on X. Washington has deployed warships in the south Caribbean as tensions rise between US President Donald Trump and Venezuelan leader Nicolas Maduro, whom the United States accuses of leading a drug cartel.

President Donald Trump is changing the name of the Department of Defense to the Department of War, the White House announced Thursday, insisting the rebrand will project a more powerful image. While the department's official name is set in law, Trump in an executive order is authorizing use of the new label as a "secondary title" by his administration, a White House document said.

Defense officials are permitted to use to use "secondary titles such as 'Secretary of War,'...in official correspondence, public communications, ceremonial contexts, and non-statutory documents within the executive branch," according to the document. It was not immediately clear when Trump planned to sign the order, but his public schedule for yesterday said he would be signing executive orders in the afternoon as well as making an announcement in the

Oval Office.

The president, a marketing-savvy real estate developer, has repeatedly said in recent weeks that he was mulling such a change.

Late last month, the 79-year-old Republican claimed the Defense Department's title was too "defensive."

The Department of War "was the name when we won World War I, we won World War II, we won everything," he told reporters on August 25. According to the White House document, the name change "conveys a stronger message of readiness and resolve."

Established in the early days of US independence, the Department of War historically oversaw American land forces.

A government reorganization after World War II brought it along with the US Navy and Air Force under the unified National Military Establishment, which in 1949 was retitled to the Department of Defense.

WHO chief urges Israel to stop
Gaza starvation 'catastrophe'

Israel accused of preventing humanitarian aid as famine claims hundreds of lives

● WHO reports 370 deaths from malnutrition

● Calls starvation a "war crime"

● UN declared Gaza famine two weeks ago

The World Health Organization chief yesterday urged Israel to stop the "catastrophe" of people starving to death in Gaza, saying at least 370 people have died from malnutrition since the war began.

"This is a catastrophe that Israel could have prevented, and could stop at any time," Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus told reporters.

"Starvation of civilians as a method of war is a war crime that can never be tolerated: doing so in one conflict risks legitimising its use in future conflicts," he said.

His comments came two weeks after the United Nations declared a famine in Gaza, blaming the "systematic obstruction" of humanitarian deliveries by Israel.

Israel has vehemently denied that its actions had caused famine in Gaza, insisting instead the territory was suffering from a "man-made shortage engineered by Hamas".

The health ministry in Hamas-run Gaza reported yesterday that 373 people, including 134 children, had died from starvation and malnutrition in the besieged Palestinian territory since the war there erupted in October 2023.

Tedros repeated the number

and said that it included "more than 300 just in the past two months".

"People are starving to death while the food that could save them sits on trucks a short dis-

tance away," he lamented.

"The most intolerable part of this man-made disaster is that it could be stopped right now," he said, questioning why Israel was allowing the situation to persist.

"The starvation of the people of Gaza will not make Israel safer, nor will it facilitate the release of the hostages," he insisted.

The WHO chief also stressed that "where hunger goes, disease follows".

"Lack of food and clean water and cramped living conditions are leaving people with weakened immune systems exposed to more disease," he said.

He said that in the past month

alone, more than 100 cases had been reported of Guillain-Barre Syndrome, which can occur after other infection and lead to paralysis.

He also decried that there are currently more than 15,000 patients in Gaza in need of urgent specialised care who are awaiting evacuation.

"More than 700 people have died while waiting for medical evacuation, including almost 140 children," he said.

"We call on the government of Israel to end this inhumane war," Tedros said.

"If it will not, I call on its allies to use their influence to stop it"

Finland to sign declaration on two-
state solution for Israel, Palestinians

Finland said Friday it would sign a French-Saudi declaration on a two-state solution between Israelis and the Palestinians but stopped short of announcing a date for recognising Palestinian statehood.

"The process led by France and Saudi Arabia is the most significant international effort in years to create the conditions for a two-state solution," Foreign Minister Elina Valtonen wrote on X.

Finland's coalition government is split on the question of recognising Palestinian statehood, with the far-right Finns Party and the Christian Democrats both opposed.

"Finland is committed to

recognising the state of Palestine at some point in the future," Valtonen told reporters, without elaborating about a possible date.

Finnish President Alexander Stubb announced in early August that he was ready to recognise Palestinian statehood if the government were to present him with a proposal.

The head of state has limited powers but coordinates foreign policy in close cooperation with the government.

Numerous countries, including France and Britain, have vowed to recognise Palestinian statehood on the sidelines of the 80th UN General Assembly in September.

US sanctions Palestinian
rights groups over ICC probe

The United States has imposed sanctions on three leading Palestinian NGOs, accusing them of supporting International Criminal Court efforts to prosecute Israeli nationals.

The move is the latest in Washington's effort to hobble the ICC, which has sought arrest warrants for Israeli officials over alleged war crimes in Gaza. The court has also pursued cases against Hamas leaders.

Secretary of State Marco Rubio on Thursday designated Al-Haq, Al Mezan Center for Human Rights, and the Palestinian Centre for Human Rights under an executive order targeting entities that assist ICC investigations into Israel.

"These entities have directly engaged in efforts by the International Criminal Court to investigate, arrest, detain, or prosecute Israeli nationals, without Israel's consent," Rubio said.

Ministers walk out of Lebanon cabinet discussion on Hezbollah disarmament

Five ministers walked out of a Lebanese cabinet meeting yesterday called to discuss efforts to disarm Hezbollah, state media reported, with the group adamant it would hold onto its weapons.

The walkout by the ministers, including those from Hezbollah and its ally the Amal movement, happened as Lebanon's army chief entered the meeting to present a plan for disarming the group, local media reported.

The official National News

Agency (NNA) reported that they had left the meeting, but did not say why.

The Lebanese government had ordered the military to draw up plans to disarm the once-dominant militant group by the end of the year, having come under pressure from the United States

and Israeli strikes.

Hezbollah and Amal ministers have three times now walked out of cabinet talks over disarmament. Multi-confessional Lebanon has a sect-based power-sharing system in which legitimacy unofficially derives from consensus.

Putin threatens to target any Western troops sent to Ukraine

Zelensky says thousands could join peacekeeping effort despite Kremlin's sharp warning

- Putin calls Western troops "legitimate targets"
- Zelensky confirms plan for "thousands" of troops
- France, UK lead peacekeeping force initiative

President Vladimir Putin warned yesterday that any Western forces deployed to Ukraine would be "legitimate" targets for Russia's army, as Ukrainian counterpart Volodymyr Zelensky said "thousands" could be sent as part of a peacekeeping force.

Two dozen countries, led by France and Britain, pledged Thursday to join a "reassurance" force on land, at sea and in the air to patrol any agreement to end the war, unleashed by Russia's February 2022 invasion.

Tens of thousands have been killed in three-and-a-half years of fighting, which has forced millions from their homes and destroyed much of eastern and southern Ukraine in Europe's bloodiest conflict since World War II.

Kyiv says security guarantees, backed by Western troops, are crucial to any pace deal, in order to ensure Russia does not re-invade in the future.

"If some troops appear there, especially now during the fight-

ing, we proceed from the premise that they will be legitimate targets," Putin said at an economic forum in the far eastern city of Vladivostok.

He added that the deployment of such a force was not conducive to long-term peace and said Ukraine's closer military ties with the West were one of what he calls the "root causes" of the conflict.

Ukraine's allies have not revealed any specific details of the plan, including how many troops it would involve and how specific countries would contribute.

Zelensky said yesterday there was an agreement for "thousands" of troops, but did not give a specific figure.

"It will definitely not be single digits, but in the thousands. And that is a fact, but it is still a little too early to talk about it," he said during a press conference with European Council President Antonio Costa in western Ukraine.

'None of his business'

In Kyiv, foreign ministry spokesman Georgiy Tykhy slammed Putin's rejection of the deployment.

"He's not the one to decide. Putin has made a mistake by deciding that he can place his troops across the border in Ukraine, and now it is none of his business whom Ukraine invites to its territory to protect its security," he said at a briefing in response to a

question by AFP.

French President Emmanuel Macron said Thursday 26 countries had "formally committed -- some others have not yet taken a position -- to deploy as a 'reassurance force' troops in Ukraine, or be present on the ground, in the sea, or in the air."

The ground troops would not be deployed "on the front line", Macron said, but be there in a bid to "prevent any new major aggression".

Despite the West and Ukraine advancing preparations for a possible peacekeeping force, there are few signs Kyiv and Moscow are close to striking a deal.

Multiple rounds of diplomacy have failed to yield anything

more than prisoner exchanges.

Moscow is calling for Ukraine to cede even more territory and wants international recognition of regions captured and occupied by its forces as part of Russia.

Kyiv has ruled the demands out as "old ultimatums".

Putin said yesterday that if a deal could be struck, there was no need for the troops.

Ukraine and many leaders in Europe have accused Putin of paying only lip-service to the idea of halting his offensive, trying to play for time and keep US President Donald Trump engaged while his troops capture more territory.

The Kremlin leader earlier this week said his troops were advancing across the entire front line and that he would continue to fight if a peace deal was not reached.

Conservative Thai tycoon wins parliament vote to become PM

Right-wing Thai tycoon Anutin Charnvirakul was confirmed yesterday by parliament as the nation's next prime minister, ousting the dominant populist Shinawatra dynasty.

The Shinawatras have been a mainstay of Thai politics for the past two decades, sparring with the pro-monarchy, pro-military establishment that views them as a threat to traditional social order.

Their Pheu Thai party has monopolised the top office since 2023 elections, but they have been bedevilled by a series of setbacks and a court ruling that resulted in dynasty heiress Paetongtarn Shinawatra's sacking as prime minister last week.

Construction magnate Anutin Charnvirakul rushed into the power vacuum, cobbling together a coalition of opposition blocs to shut out Pheu Thai.

Thaksin Shinawatra, the dynasty patriarch, flew out of the

kingdom in the hours ahead of yesterday's vote and was bound for Dubai, where he said he would visit friends and seek medical treatment.

Anutin won 311 votes, securing a comfortable majority of the 492 MPs in the National Assembly's lower house, official final results showed -- comfortably outstripping Pheu Thai's candidate.

Starmer shakes up top team after deputy Rayner quits

UK Prime Minister Keir Starmer overhauled his ministerial team yesterday in a bid to reset his embattled government after deputy premier Angela Rayner resigned for underpaying a property tax.

Rayner, a figurehead among Labour's left-wing base, quit after an investigation found that she had breached the ministerial code over the purchase of a flat in southern England.

Her departure prompted Starmer to carry out the first major cabinet reshuffle of his stuttering 14-month-old premiership, during which the hard-right Reform UK party has overtaken Labour in popularity.

Starmer replaced Rayner with Foreign Secretary David Lammy, whose post as Britain's top diplomat will be taken by interior minister Yvette Cooper, the BBC reported.

Justice Secretary Shabana Mahmood will succeed Cooper at the Home Office, while Lammy will also take on the justice brief, the broadcaster added.

The shake-up comes after Rayner's resignation dealt the latest blow to Starmer's flagging government that has lurched from one storm to another since he became prime minister in July last year.

R eigning champion and world number one Aryna Sabalenka will play Amanda Anisimova in the US Open final after the American ended the run of Japanese star Naomi Osaka on Thursday.

Sabalenka overcame Pegula 4-6, 6-3, 6-4 in a re-run of last year's final and is seeking to become the first player to successfully defend the title in New York since Serena Williams in 2014.

The 27-year-old from Belarus is through to her third successive US Open final.

"It was a really tough match -- she (Pegula) played incredible tennis as always and I had to work really hard to get this win," said Sabalenka.

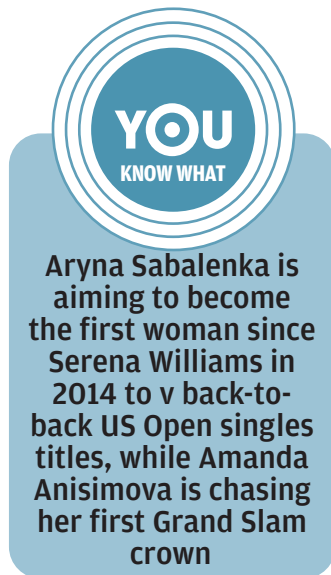
"Just super happy to be back in the final and hopefully I can go all the way again."

Sabalenka has now made the final at four of the last five Grand Slams but has not added to her haul of three majors since winning the 2024 US Open.

She finished runner-up at the Australian Open and Roland Garros earlier this year.

She landed the first blow in the sixth game against Pegula, who saved a pair of break points before the Belarusian's persistence paid off as she surged into a 4-2 lead.

A sloppy service game from Sabalenka allowed Pegula to respond immediately. The American then held to level at 4-4 and put the pressure right back on the top seed.

An error from Sabalenka gave Pegula another break for a 5-4 advantage and she served out to love to take the first set, to the delight of the Arthur Ashe Stadium crowd.

Sabalenka reset though and roared back to reel off the first three games of

the second set, an early break the difference as she sent the match to a deciding set.

A break to open the third set saw Sabalenka edge 2-0 ahead. She scrambled to save three break points and stay in control at 4-2 in and fought off another in the eighth game to close in on victory.

Pegula held and forced Sabalenka to get over the line on her own serve. She eventually converted a third match point with a crunching forehand winner to her palpable relief.

"It was too good from her today at some points," said Pegula.

Wimbledon rematch in final

Sabalenka will try to avenge her Wimbledon semi-final loss to Anisimova on Saturday.

The eighth-seeded Anisimova reached her second major final in a row after rallying to over- come Osaka 6-7 (4/7), 7-6

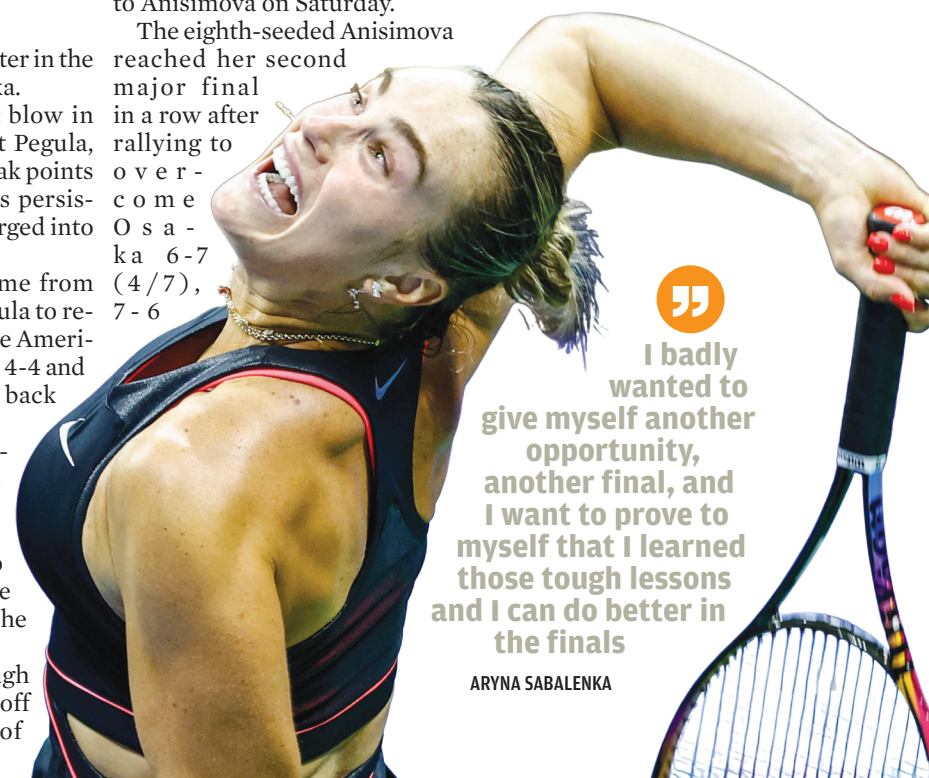
(7/3), 6-3 in a match that stretched well past midnight in New York.

"I wasn't sure I would make it past the finish line. I tried to dig deep. It was a huge fight out there," said Anisimova.

"It means the world. I'm trying to process that right now, it's a dream come true. The hope is to be the champion but I'm in the final now and I'm excited."

Osaka, seeded 23rd, was enjoying her best Grand Slam run since winning her second Australian Open title in 2021 -- the last of her four major crowns.

She looked on course to go a step further after taking the first set in a tie-break, boasting a 26-1 record at this level when doing so.

F1 title pretender Norris fastest in second Monza practice

L ando Norris was fastest in the second practice session at the Italian Grand Prix yesterday as the McLaren driver bids to cut into his teammate Osar Piastri's handy Formula One championship lead.

Briton Norris topped the times with a fastest lap of one minute 19.878 seconds, less than one hundredth of a second faster than Ferrari's home hope Charles Leclerc and Carlos Sainz of Williams.

The 25-year-old trails Piastri by 34 points in the drivers' standings after a mechanical failure forced him out of last weekend's Dutch GP in the final laps.

Norris will hope that a broken wing mirror early in the session won't bring him more bad luck, although it didn't affect his performance yesterday.

Piastri, who did not take part in the day's first practice session, was fourth fastest, 0.181s off the pace after also suffering a damaged mirror soon after heading out onto the track.

The Australian was just ahead of Lewis Hamilton who is trying to give Ferrari fans some joy at the Temple of Speed after a disappointing first season with the sport's most popular team.

Hamilton, a seven-time world champion, hasn't won a single GP and has failed to even claim a podium finish with Ferrari, who will be backed by an army of fans all weekend.

The 40-year-old is 200 points behind Piastri and has a five-place grid penalty for this weekend after failing to slow down in a yellow flag zone on his way to the grid at the Dutch GP.

He was fastest when Ferrari

claimed a one-two in the first session which was interrupted for around 10 minutes after French rookie Isack Hadjar, who claimed his first F1 podium last weekend at Zandvoort, careered into the gravel and sprayed it onto the track.

Italian Kimi Antonelli, who was announced as a Mercedes driver at Monza last year, slid out of the second practice session in the opening minutes.

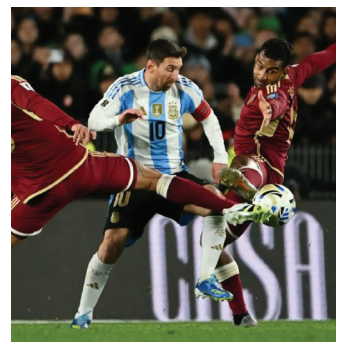
Messi hits emotional brace as Uruguay, Colombia, Paraguay seal World Cup spots

China too strong as Bahrain's run ends

Abdulkadir's 29-Point Double-Double Not Enough in U16 Asia Cup Knockouts

Bahrain's dream run at the FIBA U16 Asia Cup 2025 came to a halt yesterday at the M Bank Arena in Ulaanbaatar, losing 84-69 to three-time champions China in the quarter-finals. The result ended Bahrain's hopes of a semi-final appearance, but they remain in the 5th-8th classification stage. Meanwhile, China advanced to the last four and secured qualification to the FIBA U17 World Cup in Turkey, along with New Zealand, Australia, and Japan.

China Dictates Early Pace

China set the tone from the opening tip, building a 21-16 first-quarter lead behind the sharpshooting of Chen Yuxiu, who drained three triples in the first half. By halftime, Bahrain trailed 42-31, struggling to contain China's size and rebounding. Despite Hassan Abdulkadir's relentless effort inside, including a string of second-chance points, China's composure allowed them to extend their advantage to as many as 23 points. Guard Shi Minghao provided steady scoring alongside Fujian forward Zhang Chunzhi, who dominated the boards.

Abdulkadir Battles Alone

Without the injured Somto Patrick, Bahrain leaned heavily on Abdulkadir. The 6'8 forward poured in a game-high 29 points and grabbed 21 rebounds, recording his third straight double-double of the tournament. His effort, however, came against waves of Chinese

defenders as Bahrain struggled to find consistent scoring from elsewhere.

Ali Husain Mohamed contributed six assists to keep Bahrain's offense flowing, while Hussain

Fuad added energy on both ends. Still, China's depth proved decisive, with Zhang's 19 points and 11 rebounds anchoring a well-balanced attack.

What's Next

China advance to today's semi-finals, where they face New Zealand at 11:30 AM after the Crocs' 92-69 win over Iran. On the other side of the bracket, Australia meet Japan at 2 PM, following their victories over Korea and Chinese Taipei, respectively.

For Bahrain, attention now shifts to the classification rounds, beginning with a 5th-8th place match against Iran at 6:30 AM today. Korea's match against Chinese Taipei will follow at 9 AM. Despite the setback, Bahrain's quarter-final run was their best Asia Cup showing since 2013, with Hassan Abdulkadir's breakout performance emerging as one of the tournament's standout stories.

Wang's China controls quarter-final to dismiss Bahrain

China's 84-69 win over Bahrain in yesterday's U16 Asia Cup quarter-final was as much about control as it was about firepower. At the M Bank Arena in Ulaanbaatar, the three-time champions used sharp perimeter shooting, rim protection, and balanced execution to keep Bahrain at arm's length and book their place in both the semi-finals and next year's U17 World Cup in Turkey.

Q1: Chen Sparks Early Rhythm

Bahrain struck first through Hassan Abdulkadir's dunks and Yousif Me-

shaei's floaters, but China's guard Chen Yuxiu steadied the response. His three-pointer and late free throws swung the momentum, while Feiyan Lyu's jumper closed the period 21-16. The opening frame highlighted the contrast: Bahrain crashing the paint through Abdulkadir, China stretching the floor and drawing fouls.

Q2: Zhang Breaks Open the Lead

The second quarter shifted on Chunzhi Zhang's corner triple, assisted by Chen, which pushed China's lead into double digits. Zhang then added a layup, while Ziyi Zhang's free throws punished Bahrain's turnovers. Abdulkadir kept fighting on the glass, but with no Somto Patrick to relieve the pressure, Bahrain struggled to create reliable secondary scoring. By halftime, China led 42-31, having dictated tempo with spacing and ball movement.

Q3: Zhou and Zhao Deliver the Blow

China's depth told after the break. Zhanfeng Zhou buried back-to-back threes, stretching the lead to 21, while Boxin Zhao turned the paint into a no-go zone with multiple rejections. Abdulkadir answered with power moves inside, but Bahrain were increasingly isolated in their attack. The third quarter ended 68-50, effectively sealing the contest.

Q4: Bahrain Falter Under Pressure

Bahrain showed fight in the final quarter, with Abdulkadir and Hussain Fuad trimming the margin. Yet technical fouls cost them valuable points, and Chunzhi Zhang's dagger three in the closing minutes iced the game. China's composure and defensive discipline outweighed Bahrain's spirit, closing the night 84-69.

Almeida wins Vuelta 'queen stage' ahead of leader Vingegaard amid protests

Portuguese rider Joao Almeida climbed to victory in the 'queen' stage 13 of the Vuelta a Espana yesterday, just ahead of Danish race leader Jonas Vingegaard as repeated roadside pro-Palestinian protests continued to upset the peloton. Almeida pipped Vingegaard on the line with Australian Jai Hindley crossing in third place, 28 seconds off the pace after the 202.7-kilometre run between Cabezón de la Sal and

the Angliru climb, a steep mountain road in Asturias in northern Spain. Visme-Lease a Bike rider Vingegaard leads Team UAE's Almeida by 46sec in the overall standings with Britain's Tom Pidcock of Q36.5 third at 2min 18sec.

ute lead over the peloton.

Almeida and Vingegaard pulled ahead with three kilometres left to reach the summit, after shaking off Hindley and American Sepp Kuss.

Vingegaard stayed behind the Portuguese rider for the remainder of the race. The longest stage of this year's race also took its toll on the peloton with Spaniard Pablo Castillejo, winner of two stages in the last edition, tearfully exiting the race after a crash on the Alto La Mozqueta descent.
