# Brick attack horror

Asian worker sentenced to life for killing roommate during prayer

● Appeal court appoints lawyer; Next hearing set for October 12

The High Criminal Court of Appeal has decided to appoint a defense lawyer for an Asian worker sentenced to life imprisonment for the premeditated murder of his roommate, whom he fatally struck with a brick while the victim was performing prayer.

The court also ordered the confiscation of the murder weapon and the defendant's deportation following the completion of his sentence.

The next hearing has been scheduled for October 12.

## Crime

According to case details, the incident occurred on March 8, 2025, when the defendant deliberately killed his colleague after planning the crime and preparing a rough-edged red brick as a weapon.

Taking advantage of the quietness of their shared accommodation and the victim's distraction during prayer, the



defendant ambushed him and struck his head multiple times, intending to end his life.

A forensic report confirmed that the victim sustained multiple skull fractures in the frontal, temporal, parietal, and zygomatic bones, along with brain hemorrhage, tissue damage, and cardiac and respiratory failure.

## Single strike

Experts concluded that the fatal injuries resulted from repeated violent blows with a solid object and could not have been caused by a single strike.

Witnesses testified that they saw the defendant standing over the victim's body, holding the blood-stained brick.

One worker immediately in-

tervened and seized the weapon, while another witness, aged 21, said he was awakened by screams and saw the defendant attacking the victim before threatening anyone who tried to stop him.

## Call

The restaurant owner, who employed both men, testified that he received a call from other workers informing him of the attack.

Upon arriving at the scene, he found the victim lying motionless and bleeding heavily from his head and face.

A forensic analysis of the brick revealed mixed human traces belonging to both the defendant and the victim, supporting the

prosecution's reconstruction of the crime.

## Vital areas

The medical examiner confirmed that death was caused by repeated forceful blows to the head and face, indicating the strikes were intentionally directed at vital areas.

The Public Prosecution charged the defendant with premeditated murder, accusing him of intentionally killing the victim by repeatedly striking his head with a brick until he succumbed to his injuries.

## Road achievements

# Life sentence for smuggling 350kg of hashish

The High Criminal Court has set October 12 to hear an appeal filed by a defendant sentenced to life imprisonment in a major drug trafficking case, in order to assign a defense lawyer

to represent him.

Earlier, the court had convicted four defendants of drug trafficking, sentencing each to life imprisonment and imposing a BD5,000 fine.

Two other defendants received 10-year prison sentences and the same fine, while a

female Arab national was sentenced to one year in prison and fined BD1,000 for drug use.

The court also ordered her deportation upon completion of her sentence and confiscation of all seized narcotics.

The case began after the Anti-Narcotics Department at the

General Directorate of Criminal Investigation and Forensic Science received intelligence about an international network smuggling drugs into Bahrain through its territorial waters.

The first and second defendants were responsible for collecting shipments of hashish.

# Prosperity path

Bahrain set for one of Gulf's strongest economic growth rates this year

Bahrain is on track for one of the Gulf's strongest growth rates in 2025, helped by lower interest rates, livelier oil output and steady diversification work.

It ranked second in the GCC for economic performance in 2024, behind the UAE, and is expected to repeat that standing next year.

Capital Economics pegs real GDP growth at about 3.4 per cent in 2026, citing higher crude production and firmer non-oil activity.

## Refining

The Ministry of Finance and National Economy projects 4.4 per cent growth in the non-oil economy, which folds in refining.

Oil still pays the bills. Fitch Ratings says it provides more than 60 per cent of state income.

Capacity at the Sitra refinery rose from 267,000 barrels a day in 2023 to 300,000 in 2024, with a target of 400,000 by the end of



2025, according to S&P Global Commodity Insights.

## Supply

Bahrain is looking to use shifts in global supply chains and its close ties with the United States to its advantage.

It counts among the region's

largest exporters of aluminium and steel.

It has also drawn the Gulf's highest foreign direct investment as a share of GDP, a result linked by analysts to a competitive rule-set, lower running costs, a skilled workforce and a strong position on the map.

## Bahrain funds 90 Arab renewable energy projects worth \$113bn

Bahrain and four Arab partners financed 90 renewable-energy projects between 2003 and 2024, about a quarter of the region's foreign-led total, at a cost of US\$113 billion and creating roughly 22,000 jobs, according to Dhaman's 2025 report.

Across the Arab world, the report counts 360 foreign-led renewable projects over 22 years, drawing more than US\$351bn and adding upwards of 83,000 jobs.

Egypt, Morocco, the UAE, Mauritania and Jordan together hosted 248 projects, a 69 per cent share worth about US\$291bn, or 83 per cent of the total value, supporting close to 68,000 jobs.

The UAE led by project count, spending and jobs. It took 57 projects, 16 per cent of the total, worth more than US\$88.5bn, equal to a 25 per cent share, and generated over 16,000 jobs.

## Jobs

The ten largest investing companies together accounted for roughly a quarter of projects, 40 per cent of capital outlay and 38 per cent of new jobs.


By company, Saudi Arabia's ACWA Power led in project number with 20, or 6 per cent of the total.

The UAE's Infinity Power topped estimated spending at about US\$34bn, near 10 per cent. India's ACME ranked first for jobs created with more than 4,000, about 5.2 per cent.

# Bitcoin hits record high above \$125,000

Bitcoin reached a new record high on Sunday, rising above the \$125,000 mark. The cryptocurrency reached \$125,689, shooting above its

previous August record of around \$124,500. Bitcoin has enjoyed a strong upward momentum with investors cautious about the US government's shutdown.

Gains in US shares have also supported bitcoin's rise, while

investors have looked to safe haven assets while US lawmakers negotiate over funding the federal government, Bloomberg News said. US President Donald Trump and his family have also been big promoters of cryptocurrencies and are involved in

various crypto endeavours that have inflated his wealth.

Trump's embrace of digital assets has reversed years of US government scepticism towards the crypto industry under his Democratic predecessor Joe Biden, with the US House of

Representatives passing three landmark cryptocurrency bills in July. These regulatory changes have seen the value of bitcoin soar.

"With many assets including equities, gold and even collectibles like Pokemon cards

hitting all time highs, it's no surprise Bitcoin is benefiting from the dollar debasement narrative," Joshua Lim, co-head of markets at crypto prime brokerage firm FalconX, was quoted by Bloomberg News as saying.

# Trump's budget 'grim reaper' eyeing big cuts amid shutdown

He is perhaps the most powerful man in Washington at the moment, after Donald Trump.

Russell Vought, the right-wing ideologue who heads the Office of Management and Budget, is using the US government shutdown to deliver his brand of shock therapy to American bureaucracy.

Shutdowns usually result in hundreds of thousands of federal workers being placed on temporary unpaid leave.

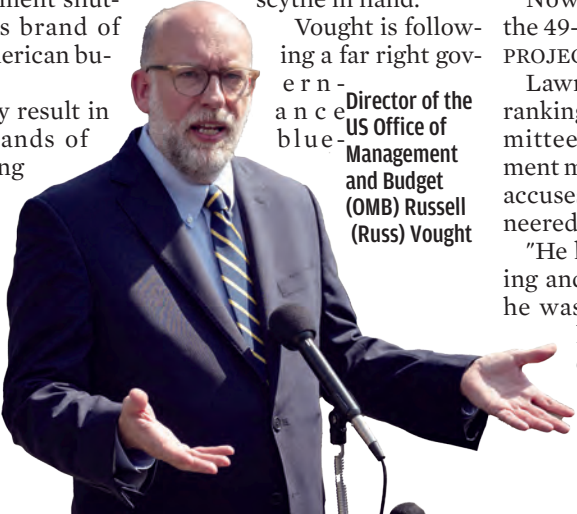
But this time, the White House has said mass firings are "imminent."

Trump has

tapped Vought to tell him "which of the many Democrat Agencies... he recommends to be cut."

He even posted on his Truth Social platform an AI-generated video depicting the budget chief as the grim reaper walking through Washington, scythe in hand.

Vought is following a far right governance blueprint.

print, Project 2025, which he helped author.

During his reelection campaign, Trump distanced himself from the ultra-conservative policy plan, which envisions vastly expanded executive control over sharply reduced federal government.

Now Trump is referring to the 49-year-old Vought as "he of PROJECT 2025 Fame."

Lawmaker Rosa DeLauro, the ranking Democrat on the committee that allocates government money to federal agencies, accuses Vought of having "engineered" the shutdown.

"He has been scheming, hoping and planning for this since he was last in office, building his plan to dismantle essential government

functions with no regard for the working class, the middle class, and vulnerable Americans who depend on them," she said on Wednesday, day one of the shutdown.

Shutdowns are brought about by lawmakers' failure to pass an annual budget bill that funds the government.

### 'Dismantle the bureaucracy' -

Born in the northeastern state of Connecticut, Vought graduated from a small evangelical Christian college before earning a law degree and becoming a staffer for Republican lawmakers, then a lobbyist for the conservative Heritage Foundation.

He joined the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) and became its director during

Trump's first term.

Vought spent president Joe Biden's term in office planning for a fresh conservative takeover over of government from his own think tank, the Center for Renewing America.

The goal: instituting efficiency in what he saw as a bloated government.

Trump "has to move executive as fast and as aggressively as possible, with a radical constitutional perspective, to be able to dismantle that bureaucracy," he told conservative political commentator Tucker Carlson after Trump's reelection in November 2024.

In September, he called the US government "the woke and weaponized administrative state" of civil servants who re-

sist the directives of an elected president.

### 'Trauma'

Vought was swiftly confirmed by the Senate for a second stint as OMB director in February 2025. But it was tech tycoon Elon Musk who wielded the cost-cutting chainsaw in the early months of the Trump administration.

That reportedly irritated Vought, who disagreed with parts of Musk's approach, sources told The New York Times.

But the OMB director was on board for the abrupt dismantling of government agencies.

"Yes, I called for trauma within bureaucracies. Bureaucracies hate the American people," he said in November.

# Opec+ plus to raise oil production by 137,000 barrels a day in November

The increase was less than many analysts expected

- OPEC expects global oil demand to increase by 1.3 million barrels a day in 2025
- Russia currently produces around 9.25 million barrels per day and has a maximum production capacity of 9.45 million

Saudi Arabia, Russia and six other members of Opec+ yesterday decided to raise their production quotas by 137,000 barrels per day in November, as they continue to push for greater market share.

“In view of a steady global economic outlook and current healthy market fundamentals, as reflected in the low oil inventories, the eight participating countries decided to implement a production adjustment of 137 thousand barrels per day” from October’s levels, the group said in a statement after an on-line meeting.

The increase was less than many analysts expected, with the cartel seeking to avoid pressuring prices amid weak demand.

“OPEC+8 stepped carefully after witnessing how nervous the market had become” in light of market rumours that production could be hiked by 500,000 barrels a day, said Jorge Leon, analyst at Rystad Energy.

“The group is walking a tight-rope between maintaining stability and clawing back market share in a surplus environment,”



he added.

In the past few months, Saudi Arabia, Russia, Iraq, the United Arab Emirates, Kuwait, Kazakhstan, Oman and Algeria have already raised their quotas by more than 2.5 million barrels a day.

Opec+’s priority at the start of the year was to maintain prices high by limiting supply, but it changed strategy starting in April and is now seeking to gain market share from other producers such as the United States, Brazil, Canada, Guyana and Argentina.

The production increases come as the International En-

ergy Agency forecasts that oil demand will only increase by 700,000 barrels a day between 2025 and 2026.

OPEC, generally more optimistic in its reports, expects global oil demand to increase by 1.3 million barrels a day in 2025 and by another 1.4 million in 2026.

A barrel of Brent, the global benchmark for crude, was trading below \$65 on Friday, down about 8 percent in one week, weighed down by fears of a significant production increase by the cartel.

Russia, the largest producer in the cartel after Saudi Arabia, depends on high prices to finance

OPEC+ includes not only the 13 members of the Organization of the Petroleum Exporting Countries (OPEC) but also 10 other major oil-producing nations – most notably Russia. This broader alliance was formed in 2016 to stabilise global oil prices, and together, OPEC+ nations control over 40% of the world’s oil supply and about 80% of proven reserves.

and has a maximum production capacity of 9.45 million compared to around 10 million before the war, Homayoun Falakshahi, an analyst at Kpler, told AFP.

Ukrainian strikes on Russian refineries have intensified since August, causing “an increase in Russian crude oil exports, as it cannot be used domestically,” making the country even more dependent on selling oil abroad, Arne Lohmann Rasmussen, an analyst at Global Risk Management, told AFP.

## Iran approves plan to slash four zeros from currency

Iran’s parliament on Sunday approved a plan to remove four zeros from the national currency, the rial, which has sharply depreciated as the country grapples with renewed sanctions.

Lawmakers passed the bill two months after a parliamentary commission revived the long-stalled proposal aimed at simplifying transactions, the legislature’s website said.

Under the plan, 10,000 current rials will be replaced by one new rial.

Both versions will circulate for up to three years, with the central bank given two years to launch the transition.

The rial has hit repeated record lows in recent days, according to black market trackers, amid the reimposition of United Nations sanctions on Iran.

Britain, France and Germany -- signatories to Iran’s moribund 2015 nuclear deal -- last month triggered the “snap-back” mechanism to restore the international sanctions

On Sunday, the rial was trading at about 1,115,000 to the US dollar, compared with around 920,000 when the plan was revived in early August.

The redenomination was first floated in 2019 but later shelved.

It still requires approval by the Guardian Council and the signature of President Masoud Pezeshkian to take effect.

In daily life, Iranians drop a zero from the rial and use the resulting figure, called the toman, for most transactions.

◆ **At least three Indian** states have banned a cough syrup after several children died allegedly after consuming the product, said local authorities and reports. The death of at least nine children, all aged under five, since late August, in the states of Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan have been linked to a cough medicine they were prescribed. India's health ministry Saturday said laboratory tests on samples of the syrup the children had consumed revealed it was contaminated with diethylene glycol (DEG), a toxic substance used in industrial solvents that can be fatal if ingested even in small amounts. "The samples are found to contain DEG beyond the permissible limit," the ministry said in a statement. The product sold under the brand name Coldrif Cough Syrup was manufactured by Sresan Pharma at a unit in the southern state of Tamil Nadu. "The sale of this syrup has been banned throughout Madhya Pradesh," said Mohan Yadav, chief minister of the centra

◆ **Four hard-left French** deputies who were detained by Israel after boarding a Gaza-bound flotilla have declared a hunger strike, their party said. "We have no news from them" apart from "brief exchanges with their lawyers and with the French consul who was able to visit them," hard-left France Unbowed member of European Parliament Manon Aubry told French radio station Franceinfo yesterday. "Their detention conditions are difficult," she said, describing more than 10 people per cell and difficulty accessing water. France Unbowed announced yesterday that two of its national deputies, Francois Piquemal and Marie Mesmeur, and two of its MEPs, Rima Hassan and Emma Fourreau, had declared a hunger strike "in solidarity with the Palestinian people". Aubry called on French authorities to repatriate their nationals. Israel detained 30 French citizens after intercepting the Global Sumud Flotilla, a fleet of 45 ships that aimed to break Israel's siege on Gaza and deliver humanitarian aid to Palestinians in the territory.

◆ **Bangladesh's defence** force said it has deployed warships and patrol aircraft as part of a special surveillance operation to protect a prized fish from illegal fishing during its spawning season. The herring-like hilsa, Bangladesh's national fish and a much-loved delicacy in West Bengal in neighbouring India, return from the Bay of Bengal to rivers each year to lay eggs. Bangladeshi authorities said on Saturday they had imposed a three-week ban on fishing from October 4-25 to safeguard the spawning areas. The defence force's Inter-Service Public Relations said in a statement that 17 navy warships and patrol helicopters had been deployed to enforce the ban and protect the fish.

Smugglers' balloons disrupt flights at Vilnius airport

More than 20 balloons used to smuggle counterfeit cigarettes from Belarus to Lithuania disrupted operations at Vilnius airport overnight and affected around 30 flights, local authorities said yesterday.

EU and NATO member Lithuania is sensitive to airspace violations following two incidents in July involving Russian drones that came from neighbouring Belarus. One of the drones was carrying explosives.

"Flights at Vilnius airport were disrupted from 22:15 pm (1915 GMT) on Saturday until 4:40 am on Sunday," Darius Buta, national crisis management centre representative, told AFP.

He said around 30 flights were delayed, cancelled or

diverted. Around 25 balloons violated Lithuanian airspace, including two near Vilnius airport, he said, adding that 11 had been discovered by Sunday morning.

Similar balloons had landed in Lithuania earlier this year, including at the airport, and border guards have had the right to shoot them down since 2024.

Smugglers use weather balloons to transport Belarusian cigarette packets that are then sold in the European Union, where tobacco is more expensive.

Lithuania recorded 966 such balloons into the country last year and 544 this year, Buta said.

"The use of drones and weather balloons by smugglers is considered a criminal activity, but not an act of sabotage or a provocation," Buta said.

Hamas keen to reach deal

Eager to begin prisoner exchange 'immediately': official

A senior Hamas official yesterday said the Palestinian group is eager to reach an agreement to end the war and implement a prisoner swap with Israel, as negotiators converge in Egypt for talks.

Israeli and Hamas negotiators are set to iron out details during talks in Egypt in a bid to end nearly two years of war in Gaza, after Hamas approved a peace plan proposed by US President Donald Trump.

Hamas negotiators travelling from Doha are expected to arrive in Cairo on Sunday before heading to Sharm el-Sheikh to participate in indirect negotiations with the Israeli delegation, the official said on condition of anonymity, as he was not authorised to speak

Israel defence minister says about 900,000 Palestinians displaced from Gaza City

Jerusalem, Undefined

Israeli Defence Minister Israel Katz said yesterday that the military's offensive in Gaza City has so far displaced approximately 900,000 Palestinians. "The decision to occupy Gaza, the collapse of multi-storey buildings, and the intensity of IDF operations in the city have led to the evacuation of

roughly 900,000 residents to the south, creating immense pressure on Hamas and the countries that support it," Katz said in a speech in Jerusalem.

Before the start of the military assault in late August, the United Nations estimated that roughly one million people lived in and around Gaza City, the largest urban centre in the Gaza Strip.

Trump says Gaza deal talks to go on 'couple' days

Washington, United States

President Donald Trump on Sunday said talks on implementing a truce for Gaza will take days, while his foreign policy chief Marco Rubio warned that Israel needs to stop bombing for a hostage release to happen.

"They're in negotiations right now as we speak. They've started the negotiations. It'll last a couple of days," Trump told reporters at the White House.

"We'll see how it turns out.

But I'm hearing it's going very well," he added.

In a text exchange with CNN released Sunday, Trump said "yes" when asked if Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu was on board with ending the military campaign in Gaza. Negotiators from Israel and Hamas were set to hold talks in the Egyptian resort town of Sharm El-Sheikh, with Netanyahu expressing hope that hostages held in Gaza could be released within days.

But Rubio called for a halt to Israeli bombing on Gaza.

on the matter.

"Hamas is very keen to reach an agreement to end the war and immediately begin the prisoner

exchange process in accordance with the field conditions," he said. "The occupation must not obstruct the implementation of

President Trump's plan. If the occupation has genuine intentions to reach an agreement, Hamas is ready." A Palestinian source close to Hamas told AFP that the two delegations would be in the same building but away from media coverage.

"The negotiations aim to discuss the timeline for preparing field conditions for the transfer of captives held in Gaza, as a prelude to launching the prisoner exchange process," he added.

"During communications with mediators, Hamas insisted that it is essential for Israel to halt military operations across all areas of the Gaza Strip, cease all air, reconnaissance, and drone activity, and withdraw from inside Gaza City," the source said.

"In parallel with the cessation of Israeli military activity, Hamas and the resistance factions will also halt their military operations and actions," he added.

The talks are also expected to include discussions of maps to be provided by Israel showing withdrawal routes and timelines, which will coincide with the prisoner exchange process, the source said. The Hamas delegation will also present lists of Palestinian prisoners who must be released by Israel in return for the Israeli captives, he said.

According to Trump's plan, Israel is expected to release 250 Palestinian prisoners with life sentences and more than 1,700 detainees from the Gaza Strip who were arrested after October 7, 2023, when Hamas attacked Israel, triggering the ongoing war.

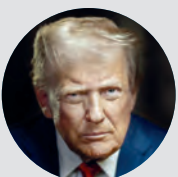

## Boy hospitalised in Thailand after attack by escaped lion

● The lion attacked the child, who was hospitalised with unspecified injuries, while he was walking on a public road

A lion kept at a private home in Thailand got loose and attacked a young boy, leaving him in hospital, the wildlife department said yesterday.

The lion attacked the child, who was hospitalised with unspecified injuries, while he was walking on a public road Saturday night in western Kanchanaburi province, about a two-hour drive from the capital Bangkok, the department said in a statement.

Local media said the boy was on his way home from playing with other children when the big cat pounced on him.

The lion's owner, who the wildlife department identified only as Parinya, was charged with violating wildlife protection laws, and faces up to six

months in prison and a 50,000 baht (\$1,500) fine if convicted.

The lion was seized by authorities, the department said, adding that a wildlife breeding centre had prepared a new home for it.

Parinya told local TV he was "shocked" when he learned of the attack, saying the female lion got loose after it was removed

from its cage while it was being renovated.

"I apologise for what happened, it was an accident," he said, adding that he will pay compensation and for the boy's medical treatment.

In its statement, the wildlife department urged people who "keep wild animals to be aware of the potential dangers,

as all animals have a ferocious instinct".

"Any unforeseen incident that affects the life and property of others will be punished and prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law," it added.

Since 2022, Thai law has required owners to register and microchip lions, and inform authorities before moving them,

but there are few enclosure or welfare requirements.

Last month, a zookeeper was mauled to death by several lions at a safari park on the outskirts of Bangkok, raising scrutiny of the facility, which offers lion- and tiger-feeding trips for about \$40 per person.



Lion ownership is legal in Thailand, where the captive population has exploded in recent years, with nearly 500 registered in zoos, breeding farms, petting cafes and homes. But experts have warned the trend endangers animals and humans, and likely fuels illicit trade domestically and abroad.

## N.Korea says 'special assets' deployed against South

The United States stations about 28,500 troops in the South

Kim Jong Un said North Korea deployed "special assets" in response to what he called Washington's arms build-up in the South, state media reported Sunday.

The United States stations about 28,500 troops in the South to fend off military threats from the nuclear-armed North and last month conducted a joint military exercise with its security allies South Korea and Japan.

Pyongyang routinely denounces such drills as rehearsals for invasion, while the allies insist they are defensive in nature. "The US-ROK nuclear alli-

ance is making rapid progress, and they are conducting various kinds of exercises to execute dangerous scenarios," Kim said in a speech marking the open-

ing of a weapons exhibition in Pyongyang on Saturday, carried by the official Korean Central News Agency (KCNA).

"In direct proportion to the

US military's arms buildup in the ROK region, our strategic concern about this region has also grown, and accordingly we have assigned our special assets to the major targets," he said, adding he was "closely watching" the military development across the border.

"The enemy... will have to worry about which direction their security environment is moving in," he added without clarifying what the special assets were. Photos released by KCNA show Kim walking past weapons, including a missile, surrounded by North Korean generals in an indoor exhibition centre.

### Hundreds of thousands turn out at pro-Palestinian marches in Europe

Huge numbers turned out at pro-Palestinian rallies in Europe on Saturday, calling for an immediate end to the war in Gaza and the release of activists on board a flotilla carrying humanitarian aid to the territory.

The police in Rome said some 250,000 turned out for a fourth day of protests, after Israel intercepted the 45-strong flotilla seeking to reach Gaza earlier this week.

Some 70,000 people took to the streets in Barcelona, according to the police, while the government in Madrid said nearly 92,000 marched in the Spanish capital.

Elsewhere, several thousand people marched through the centre of the Irish capital, Dublin, to mark what organisers said was "two years of genocide" in Gaza.

With Ireland, Spain is one of the fiercest European critics of Israel's military offensive in Gaza, which was sparked by Hamas militants' October 7, 2023, attack on Israeli communities near the Gaza Strip.

But in Italy, Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni's hard-right government has been criticised for its inaction on the siege of the Palestinian territory.

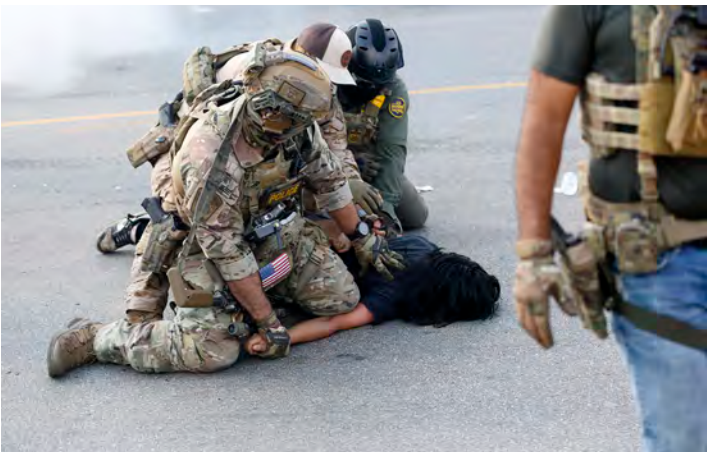
## Trump administration declares US cities war zones

The Trump administration branded Chicago a "war zone" Sunday as a justification for deploying soldiers against the will of local Democratic officials, while a judge blocked the White House from sending troops to another Democrat-run city.

An escalating political crisis across the country pits President Donald Trump's anti-crime and migration crackdown against opposition Democrats who accuse him of an authoritarian power grab.

In the newest flashpoint, Trump late Saturday author-

ized deployment of 300 National Guard soldiers to Chicago, the third-largest city in the United States, despite the opposition of elected leaders including the mayor and state Governor JB Pritzker.

Homeland Security Secretary Kristi Noem defended the move on Sunday, claiming on Fox News that Chicago is "a war zone."

But Pritzker, speaking on CNN's "State of the Union" show, accused Republicans of aiming to sow "mayhem on the ground. They want to create the war zone, so that they can send in even more troops."

This £6.5 million boost shows Britain leading the way in space innovation. It's an exciting time for our space sector and great news for British businesses reaching for the stars.

The space funding boost, announced during the International Astronautical Congress (IAC) in Sydney, demonstrates the UK's commitment to international partnerships and a wide range of areas where the space sector can contribute to economic growth.

As set out in the Government's Industrial Strategy, the UK Space Agency is increasing bilateral research & development funding with international allies. The IBF is a critical mechanism for this, providing targeted support for UK-led international collaborations and building capabilities and partnerships across the global space sector.

Today's announcement follows the agreement between NASA and the UK Space Agency to develop AI models to support future exploration missions, under the Transatlantic Tech Prosperity Deal, as well as the successful launch of the NASA IMAP mission on 23 September, for which UK scientists contributed a key instrument.

## Landslides and floods kill 63 in Nepal, India

Torrential downpours have lashed Nepal since Friday

Landslides and floods triggered by heavy downpours in Nepal and neighbouring India have killed more than 60 people, officials said yesterday, as rescue workers raced to reach cut-off communities in remote mountainous terrain.

tainous terrain.

Torrential downpours have lashed Nepal since Friday, leaving rivers in spate and many areas in the Himalayan nation inundated.

At least 43 people have died in rain-triggered disasters and five are missing, Shanti Mahat, spokeswoman for Nepal's National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Authority, told AFP.

At least 37 were killed by landslides in the worst-affected eastern district of Illam.

"Heavy rains overnight caused the landslides," said local district official Sunita Nepal.

"With roads blocked, some areas are difficult to reach. Rescue workers are heading there on foot."

Rivers in the capital Kathmandu have also swelled, inundating settlements along their banks.

Security personnel were deployed to assist rescue efforts with helicopters and motorboats. "There is some damage, but thanks to the authorities' prior flood alert, we were able to move some belongings to a safe place," said vegetable seller Rajan Khadga, 38.

Landslides have blocked several highways and disrupted flights, leaving hundreds of travellers -- many returning after celebrating the Hindu festival of Dashain -- stranded.

Prime Minister Sushila Karki said government agencies were "fully prepared for rescue and relief".

"Your safety is our utmost concern. Do not hesitate to seek necessary assistance," she said in an address, adding that the government has declared Sunday and Monday public holidays and urged people not to travel unless necessary.

Across the border in India, at least 20 people were killed in the tea-growing hill district of Darjeeling in West Bengal state after heavy overnight rain unleashed flash floods and landslides that destroyed homes and infrastructure.

"In the wake of last night's

heavy cyclone in the Darjeeling hills, over 20 people have lost their lives," said Harsh Vardhan Shringla, a lawmaker in India's upper house.

Footage on Indian television news showed rescue workers using cables to access cut-off regions as raging waters smashed into bridges and caved in roads.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi said he was "pained by the loss of lives".

"The situation in Darjeeling and surrounding areas is being closely monitored in the wake of heavy rains and landslides," he said in a statement on social media.

Monsoon rains, usually from

June to September, bring widespread death and destruction every year across South Asia, but the number of fatal floods and landslides has increased in recent years.

Experts say climate change has worsened their schedule, frequency and intensity.

The Kathmandu-based International Centre for Integrated Mountain Development warned in June that communities faced heightened disaster risks this monsoon season.

"Rising temperatures and more extreme rain raise the risk of water-induced disasters such as floods, landslides, and debris flows," it said.



The India-Nepal landscape ranges from the flat, fertile plains of the Terai region to the rugged peaks of the Himalayas, creating one of the world's greatest altitudinal variations -- from just 60 metres above sea level to over 8,000 metres within a span of less than 200 kilometres.

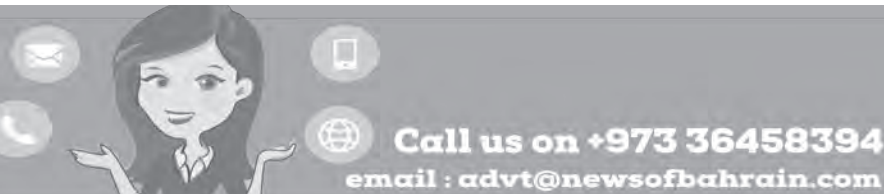

Bahrain International Circuit (BIC), ‘The Home of Motorsport in the Middle East’, hosted a thrilling opening round of National Race Day this 2025/2026 season in Sakhir.

The meeting featured the Bahrain Touring Car Challenge (BTCC) and Time Attack, with plenty of exciting action from day to night along BIC’s 2.550-kilometre Inner Track.

Ali Almansoori secured a sensational double in the two BTCC races, while winning in Time Attack were Omar Adel Alkhudhur, Fares Almutari, Yazeed Al-

saheel, Hamad Salah Albalooshi, Ibrahim Al Sharidah, Sulaiman Alsaheel, and Hisham Bediea Al Bediae.

### BTCC Race One Results

Almansoori defended his position well over the first 15-lap race and took the chequered flag in 20:19.298 – enjoying a 6.375s gap from runner-up Moaaz Elzahravi, also driving a Honda

Civic. Ahmed Bajnaid completed the podium placers in third a distant 26.300s from the winner.

James Taylor in an Acura RSX DC5 claimed fourth place, while Hamad Khamis and Rakan Al Fayez, both in Honda Civics, were fifth and sixth, respectively, to round out the final classification.

### BTCC Race Two Results

In race two, Khamis started at the front but Almansoori emerged victorious once more. This time, he had a bigger gap at the finish, completing the distance in 20:37.175 – 7.379s clear of Bajnaid in second place. Elzahravi came third 13.249s back.

Taylor was fourth while Al Fayez took fifth.

### Time Attack MA and MB Classes

Meanwhile, in Time Attack, Alkhudur triumphed in the competition’s MA class with a best

time of 1:15.915. Fahad Abdulrahman Almulhem and Abdulla Sahel Shukri joined him on their podium.

Almutari secured his victory in the MB class with a fastest time of 1:20.167. Mazen Dabbous and Maan Mahmoud Aljabrah were second and third, respectively.

### Time Attack SA and SB Classes

Yazeed Alsaheel claimed the SA category, posting a top time of 1:11.373 for first place. Mohamed Sami Aldosseri was second and Mohamed Abdulla Alghamdi finished third.

Albalooshi was the victor in the SB class with a mark of 1:24.765, while Fahad Saleh Alkuwari was the runner-up and Layla Hasan Alqasmi came third.

### Time Attack SU and UL Classes

Week 4 of the Nasser bin Hamad Premier League concluded last night with two contrasting fixtures that told plenty about where the title race might be heading. At Khalifa Sports City Stadium, Al Khaldiya slumped to a 3-1 defeat against a spirited Malkiya, while defending champions Muharraq eased past Bahrain Club 2-0 at Shaikh Ali bin Mohammed bin Isa Al Khalifa Stadium.

der Ali Ashoor showed no improvement, with the team starting struggling from the outset against Malkiya. They fell behind inside 15 minutes when Ayyob El Amloud turned a cross from Hassan Hilal into his own net as it was bound for Nani at the back post.

Malkiya could have doubled their advantage soon after. A clumsy challenge by Dominique Mendy gave them a penalty, but Mohammed AlFaleh saw his spot-kick saved brilliantly by Khaldiya keeper Ricardo Silva, who dived low to his right.

That miss proved costly. Just before the break, Saïffedine Bouha was tripped in the area, and Joel Beya kept his nerve from twelve yards to restore parity. Both sides traded half-chances in a scrappy second half until Malkiya struck again with 20 minutes left.

Moroccan midfielder Abdulhalim Abbou spotted Mohammed Salem unmarked and sent a defence-splitting pass

through the middle. Salem raced clear and calmly slotted past Hamad Al Doseri to make it 3-1 to Malkiya and keep their unbeaten streak alive.

**Champions in control**

Over in Muharraq, the title holders looked every inch the champions. Nandinho’s men controlled the game well, with

the in-form Edimar Ribeiro da Costa Juninho once again at the heart of everything.

The Brazilian forward opened the scoring just before the half-hour mark, chesting down a perfectly weighted pass from Mohammed Hardan and rifling home a thunderous volley that left the goalkeeper rooted. Seven minutes later, the pair combined again as Hardan’s delivery met Juninho’s glancing header, nestling low into the corner for 2-0.

**The state of play**

With four rounds gone, Muharraq lead the table with three wins and a draw. Riffa trail just behind after their 3-0 win yesterday, while Malkiya sit third with two wins and two draws. Al Khaldiya, inconsistent and unconvincing, have slipped to fifth with two wins and two defeats. Bahrain Club remain rock bottom and still searching for their first point of the season.

The league now pauses until Week 5 kicks off on October 17.



# Russell wins Singapore GP as McLaren seal constructors' title

McLaren clinches constructors' championship with six races to spare

● PIASTRI leads drivers' championship by 22 points

Mercedes' George Russell won the Singapore Grand Prix yesterday ahead of Max Verstappen and Lando Norris, as McLaren clinched the Formula One constructors' championship.

Oscar Piastri was fourth, meaning his lead over McLaren teammate Norris at the top of the drivers' standings was cut to 22 points.

The 27 points scored by Piastri and Norris were more than enough for McLaren to equal the record set by Red Bull in 2023 by winning the team title with six races to spare.

It was McLaren's second title in a row and 10th in the team's history, and was won despite their two drivers clashing in the opening turns with sparks flying as Norris got the better of Piastri.

"They have driven brilliantly all season. You can't win the constructors' without two awesome racing drivers," said McLaren CEO Zak Brown.

"As you can see, we are letting them race. That was a bit more of a nail-biter there, but they race hard, they race clean, they race to win.

"A lot of racing to go and hopefully a lot more victories for both of them."

Russell was overjoyed to win the sweltering night race for the first time, saying it was payback

for his final-lap crash two years ago while pushing for victory on the Marina Bay street circuit.

"It feels amazing, especially after what happened a couple of years ago. That was a bit of a missed opportunity, but we more than made up for it today," said the Englishman, who started on pole.

"We don't really know where this performance came from, but really, really happy."

Dutchman Verstappen was relieved to finish second for Red Bull.

"I think the whole race was quite difficult, more difficult than I hoped for, for a lot of dif-

ferent reasons," said the four-time world champion, who remains third in the title race, 63 points behind Australia's Piastri.

"There's a few things that we need to understand why they went wrong today.

"But around here even if you have more pace, you can't pass without anything crazy happening. So I think second was the maximum result."

**'Not fair'**

Kimi Antonelli crossed the line fifth in a Mercedes, followed by the Ferraris of Charles Leclerc and Lewis Hamilton.

Fernando Alonso, Oliver Bear-

man and Carlos Sainz rounded out the top 10.

Russell got away cleanly from Verstappen at the start, but the drama all happened behind.

Norris, from fifth on the grid, darted past Antonelli and dived up the inside of Piastri, who started third, at turn one.

Norris was flying and clipped the back of Verstappen on the way to barging his way into third place in a wheel-to-wheel clash with teammate Piastri.

The championship leader was not impressed. "So are we cool with Lando just barging me out of the way there? What's the go there?" Piastri complained on

McLaren secured their 10th team title and their second in a row by earning 27 points at Singapore, enough to equal the record set by Red Bull in 2023 for winning the constructors' championship with six races to spare

and not order Norris to swap places.

"That's not fair. I'm sorry, that's not fair," Piastri said.

Norris disagreed. "It was good racing," he said.

After pitting for hard tyres, the leading four emerged in the same order, though Verstappen was reporting downshift problems with his gearbox that felt "like a handbrake".

By lap 41 of the 62 Norris had the ailing Verstappen in his sights but found it impossible to get close enough to pass on a circuit where overtaking is notoriously tricky.

"Max didn't make any mistakes. I gave it my all today and got close," said Norris.

The night race in tropical Singapore was declared the first official Formula One "Heat Hazard".
