Asian worker sentenced to life for killing roommate during prayer

Appeal court appoints lawyer; **Next hearing set** for October 12

♦ he High Criminal Court of Appeal has decided to appoint a defense lawyer for an Asian worker sentenced to life imprisonment for the premeditated murder of his roommate, whom he fatally struck with a brick while the victim was performing prayer.

The court also ordered the confiscation of the murder weapon and the defendant's deportation following the completion of his sentence.

The next hearing has been scheduled for October 12.

According to case details, the incident occurred on March 8, 2025, when the defendant deliberately killed his colleague after planning the crime and preparing a rough-edged red brick as a weapon.





Vought was swiftly confirmed by the Senate for a second stint as OMB director in February 2025. But it was tech tycoon cy in what he saw as a bloated Elon Musk who wielded the cost-cutting chainsaw in the early months of the Trump administration.

That reportedly irritated Vought, who disagreed with parts of Musk's approach, sources told The New York Times.

But the OMB director was on board for the abrupt dismantling of government agencies.

The death of at least nine children, all aged under five, since late August, in the states of Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan have been linked to a cough medicine they were prescribed. India's health ban cough syrup ministry Saturday said laboratory tests on linked to child samples of the syrup the children had consumed revealed it was contaminated with diethylene glycol (DEG), a toxic substance used in industrial solvents that can be fatal if ingested even in

small amounts. "The samples are found to contain DEG beyond the permissible limit," the ministry said in a statement. The product sold under the brand name Coldrif Cough Syrup was manufactured by Sresan Pharma at a unit in the southern state of Tamil Nadu. "The sale of this syrup has been banned throughout Madhya Pradesh," said Mohan Yadav, chief minister of the centra

French deputies detained in Israel declare hunger strike

Aubry called on French authorities to repatriate their nationals. Israel detained 30 French

citizens after intercepting the Global Sumud Flotilla, a fleet of 45 ships that aimed to break Israel's siege on Gaza and deliver humanitarian aid to Palestinians deploys warships in the territory.

◆ Bangladesh's defence force said it has deployed warships and patrol aircraft as part of a special surveillance operation to protect a prized fish from illegal fishing during its spawning season. The herring-like hilsa, Bangladesh's national fish and a

much-loved delicacy in West Bengal in neighbouring India, return from the Bay of Bengal to rivers each year to lay eggs. Bangladeshi authorities said on Saturday they had imposed a three-week ban on

fishing from October 4-25 to safeguard the spawning areas. The defence force's Inter-Service Public Relations said in a statement that 17 navy warships and patrol helicopters had been deployed to enforce the ban and protect the fish.


