Campaigning took place mostly on social media and local TV channels due to COVID-19 restrictions. The current government is due to resign after the elections. Sheikh Nawaf al-Ahmad al-Sabah took the reins as emir in September following the death of his brother.

Vessel attacked off Yemen's coast

A vessel was attacked off the coast of war-torn Yemen, a UK-based maritime organisation said yesterday days after an explosion rocked an oil tanker docked at a Saudi port. The United Kingdom Maritime Trade Operations (UKMTO), citing reports from ships in the vicinity, said it was aware of an attack late Friday against a merchant vessel, without giving further details. It later released a statement the incident was over. "Incident is now complete. Vessel and crew are safe." The report comes 10 days after a Greek-operated vessel docked at Saudi Arabia's port of Shuqaiq was rocked by an explosion in an attack that a Riyadh-led military coalition blamed on Yemeni rebels.

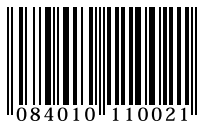

Signs of thaw emerge in Qatar-Gulf dispute

Saudi says hopes to reach a deal with Qatar soon at Manama Dialogue

Signs of thaw in the bitter Qatar-Gulf crisis emerged at the IISS Manama Dialogue 2020 yesterday with a top Saudi Minister announcing that the Kingdom is looking forward to reaching an agreement with Qatar soon. "There has been a progress in the last few weeks," said Prince Faisal bin Farhan Al Saud, the Saudi Minister of Foreign Affairs. He was speaking during a plenary session on the second day of the premier security summit that has ministers, chiefs of defence and intelligence and the expert and opinion-forming communities from all around the globe. the Kingdom is hopeful of concluding the dispute with Qatar very soon. The deal thus reached "will be satisfactory to all parties involved," he said. The minister also assured that the Kingdom will continue to work closely with its allies and the resolution reached thus will be "one that involving all parties in the dispute." ald Trump's senior adviser Jared Kushner had held talks in Doha on Wednesday following a visit to Saudi Arabia. Reuters quoting an unnamed source said that Washington is working towards "taking what's an agreement in principle and getting it signed." Kuwait's Emir Sheikh Nawaf al-Ahmad al-Sabah on Friday welcomed the developments, state-run news agency KUNA said. The US Secretary of State Mike Pompeo, speaking remote-

ly at a Bahrain summit on Friday, said the United States was "very hopeful" to resolve the dispute. In a Twitter post, Qatar's foreign minister, Sheikh Mohammed bin Abdulrahman Al-Thani, welcomed the Kuwaiti statement as "an imperative step" towards resolving the rift. On the Palestinian and Israel conflict, Prince Faisal bin Farhan Al Saud said the focus should now be on getting them back to the negotiation tables. When asked about Saudi joining the Abraham Accords, the minister said that the Kingdom is completely open to full normalisation of relations with Israel, but for that to remain sustainable Palestinians should get their state. The summit ends today with a concluding plenary session on "New Security Partnerships in the Middle East." Before that, the summit will hold its fourth and fifth plenary sessions on "Diplomacy, Proliferation and Regional Security" and "Defence Diplomacy and Modernisation in the Middle East", respectively.

Doha had been set with 13 demands, ranging from closing Al Jazeera television and shuttering a Turkish base to cutting links to the Muslim Brotherhood and downgrading ties with Iran, which shares a significant gas field with Qatar.

Saudi Arabia, the United Arab Emirates, Bahrain and Egypt imposed a diplomatic, trade and travel embargo on Qatar since mid-2017.

Bahrain's Coast guard patrols arrested two men with 235 kilograms of shrimp caught illegally using bottom trawl nets.

Coast Guard commander said the men aged 50 and 34 years are caught from Ras Abu Jarjour.

As per a ministerial resolution (205) for 2018, fishing using trawling nets are banned in the Kingdom.

Bottom trawling is a method of fishing that involves dragging heavily weighted nets across the seafloor, in an effort to catch fish. It's a favoured method by commercial fishing companies because it can catch large quantities of product in

Doctor in the dock for cheating patients

A doctor has landed in the police custody for allegedly charging his patients for performing surgeries at Salmaniya Medical complex where services are free of cost for citizens.

The public prosecution has referred him to a competent court for urgent trial, scheduled to start this Tuesday.

Case files say, the doctor who consulted patients at a private hospital in the Kingdom transferred his patients to Salmaniya Medical Complex to perform surgeries.

Despite the hospital offering such services free to citizens, the Financial and Administrative Control Bureau found that the doctor deliberately kept his patients in the dark, and persuaded the gullible citizens to spend their money.

Bahrain has a universal health care system, dating back to 1960. Government-provided health care is free to Bahraini citizens and subsidised for

non-Bahrainis.

Authorities found that the patients believing that they are bound to pay for the expenses, paid the doctor excessively.

Police also seized money thus received by the doctor from his bank accounts.

Patients told investigators that the doctor gave them receipts of Salmaniya Medical Complex for the payment made, which later turned out to be counterfeit.

The accused allegedly received BD1000 to BD1500 for performing operations at the Salmaniya Medical Complex from each of his patients.

The Head of the Financial Crimes and Money Laundering Prosecution said they completed an investigation based on a report received from the Ministry of Health.

The Public Prosecution recorded the statements of the auditor of the Office of Financial and Administrative Supervision and the executive director of the private hospital in which the accused works on a part-time basis.

The prosecution collected testimonies of the patients as well as verified amounts the accused received from patients in the private hospital.

Bahrain is always with the two-state solution when it comes to resolving the Israel-Palestinian conflict, said Bahrain’s Minister for Foreign Affairs.

“We are with the two-state solution which is in line with the Arab peace initiative,” said Abdullatif bin Rashid Al Zayani as he also called on both parties to get to the negotiation table.

Bahrain, the minister said, stand ready to help both Palestine and Israel in resolving the differences.

The minister said: “At the negotiating table, we are fully prepared to provide any assistance, support, and advocacy for our

Palestinian brothers, within the decisions that are in line with United Nations and Arab League resolutions.”

The minister was speaking during the second plenary session on day two of the IISS Manama Dialogue 2020.

On the goods and products manufactured in the West-Bank and Golan Heights, the minister said the Kingdom has already made its stance clear regarding products from Israel and elsewhere.

“I received a call from the Palestinian Minister of Foreign Affairs after signing the agreements with Israel, and I assured him that our position in Bahrain on the Palestinian-Israeli issue is very clear,” the minister said.

Bahrain’s Ministry of Industry and Commerce in a statement issued earlier clarified that the ministry is committed to the firm position of the government of Bahrain and the United Nations, the League of the Arab States and the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation, regarding Israeli settlements in the West Bank and the Syrian Golan Heights.

Do not view Middle East as a source of all conflicts

The Minister for Foreign Affairs has urged the world not to view the Middle East as a region from which all problems stems.

Do not view the Middle East as a “source of all conflicts and instability that must be contained,” Abdullatif bin Rashid Al Zayani told the summit pointing to the importance of building a region that adopts dialogue and mutual respect.

The challenges to security in the region directly affect the entire world, the minister said highlighting the existence of threats that must be deterred “some of which stem from malicious government threats or proxy wars.”

In this regard, the minister said that the Middle East security is tightly-linked to global security and that connection has grown stronger in recent times. The minister said that there are parties who are working to subvert the regional security and in that sense the international security.

Deterring them, the minis-

ter said, will be through vigilance and resilience, for which we need a robust, flexible and multilayer deterrence which includes electronic, economic, technologic and active diplomacy.

The situation, the minister said, also calls for the need to ensure that our infrastructures are strong enough to withstand

and overcome any potential threat - direct or by proxies- for which international cooperation is critical.

He further revealed having a strategic dialogue between China and the Gulf Cooperation Council countries, where the discussion focuses on “all economic fields and cooperation, and security policies.”

Avoiding the virus myths

The COVID-19 virus has spawned thousands of myths and fake claims – alongside the frontliners, the brave hearts and warriors who are fighting to right this topsy-turvy world, there are many who are looking to make a fast buck from the disease that has robbed the world of a whole year of progress. I have lost count of the number of sanitisers and disinfectants which claim to prevent the virus attack – a claim that is partly true but only if supported with other safety measures such as wearing face masks, observing social distancing and avoiding crowds and gatherings.

The slowdown of the virus’ relentless attack in Bahrain has been largely due to the absolute scientific temperament of all the authorities charged with braking the march of the disease.

Now comes news that Bahrain’s Ministry of Health and the University of Bahrain have conducted rigorous research into claims that UV light destroys the COVID-19 virus. The study has found definitive evidence that the claim is a tall tale. Does the UV light destroy germs? Yes. But to extend this to destruction of the COVID virus and ask people to buy these lights is a fake claim that is making money for the manufacturers and has no scientific backing.

The slowdown of the virus’ relentless attack in Bahrain has been largely due to the absolute scientific temperament of all the authorities charged with braking the march of the disease. As the vaccine makes its way to our shores, we will no doubt hear about why we should or should not take the shot, who is first priority in the queue and many more unfounded details that will confuse us. Let us listen to our government in this matter. Our leaders and government have done a sterling job of containing the virus and we must continue to repose our trust in them.

Britain and EU agree to more talks in final push for Brexit

British Prime Minister Boris Johnson and European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen instructed their negotiators to resume trade talks on Sunday in a last ditch attempt to bridge significant differences.

Acknowledging the distance in their positions, the leaders' decision to resume talks that had stalled over three of the thorniest issues suggests both sides still believe they can secure a deal governing almost \$1 trillion of trade a year.

But it was not clear whether either had changed their positions to allow a breakthrough that has proved elusive since Britain left the EU on Jan. 31 and entered a transition period with

most rules unchanged that runs until the end of the year.

Johnson, a figurehead for Britain's campaign to leave the EU, must be able to convince Brexit supporters that he has secured a clean break, reclaiming what he called during last year's election campaign the country's sovereignty.

Von der Leyen does not want to offer too much to London for fear of encouraging other member states to leave and must also deliver a deal that does not alienate any of the 27.

Irish Prime Minister Micheal Martin welcomed the decision to resume talks, saying on Twitter: "Every effort should be made to reach a deal."

British and EU negotiators paused trade talks on Friday to call in their leaders to try to narrow the gaps and get an agreement after a week of negotiations failed to bridge significant divergences between the two sides.

In a joint statement, the two leaders said that while recognising the seriousness of their differences, "we agreed that a further effort should be undertaken by our negotiating teams to assess whether they can be resolved".

"No agreement is feasible if these issues are not resolved," they said after speaking for more than an hour on Saturday. "We are therefore instructing our chief negotiators to reconvene tomorrow in Brussels. We will speak again on Monday evening."

Black people hold just 4pc of Tesla's US leadership role

Black employees make up just 4 per cent of Tesla Inc's American leadership roles and 10% of its total workforce in the country, the electric carmaker has disclosed in its first U.S. diversity report.

Women comprise 17pc of the company's US leadership roles - directors and vice presidents - and 21pc of the overall workforce, according to the report. The figures for Asian, Black and Hispanic people combined are

33pc and 60pc.

The carmaker noted, though, that leadership roles were a "very small cohort", or less than 0.4pc, of its workforce.

Elon Musk's Tesla, whose meteoric rise has seen it become the most valuable auto company in the world and worth about \$550 billion, acknowledged the lack of representation.

"We know that our numbers do not represent the deep talent pools of Black and African American talent that exist in the U.S at every level - from

high-school graduates to professionals," it said in the Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Impact Report here 2020 published on Friday.

"While women are historically underrepresented in the tech and automotive industries, we recognize we have work to do in this area," it added.

News in brief

At least 17 killed in Brazil bus plunge

◆ At least 17 people have died in eastern Brazil after a bus fell 15 metres off a bridge, newspaper Estado de Minas Gerais reports. Twelve people died at the scene while five died in hospital, news portal G1 reported, citing the fire department. Nearly 30 other people were injured in the accident, which occurred near the locality of Joao Monlevade in Minas Gerais state about 1.30pm.

Mine collapse in Nicaragua traps at least 10

◆ A mudslide in an unlicensed gold mine in Nicaragua trapped at least 10 workers, state-run media reported. Crews began work to try to rescue the miners after the accident in the La Esperanza region of southern Nicaragua. Vice President Rosario Murillo, who is also the government spokeswoman, did not say how many miners were in the shaft when it collapsed or if there were fatalities.

Suspect in deadly 1982 Paris attack extradited from Norway

◆ A suspect in a deadly 1982 attack at a Jewish neighbourhood in Paris arrived in France after being extradited from Norway, airport officials said. Walid Abdulrahman Abu Zayed, 62, landed at around 8:00 pm (1900 GMT) at Paris' Charles de Gaulle airport from Oslo, where he had been living since 1991.

Trump to appear in Georgia in gamble over control of US Senate

◆ President Donald Trump ventured out of Washington for his first political appearance since his election defeat to Joe Biden, campaigning in Georgia where two run-off races will decide the fate of the US Senate. The president took the stage at 7:00 pm (0000 Sunday GMT) in the southern city of Valdosta, exactly one month before special January 5 elections. It is just under a month since he was declared the loser in the presidential race.

Coal mine accident in China's Chongqing kills 18

◆ Eighteen people have died after being trapped in a mine in China's southwestern city of Chongqing, the official Xinhua news agency said, the region's second such accident in just over two months. The dead were among 24 people trapped underground by excessive levels of carbon monoxide gas at the Diaoshuidong coal mine, the agency said, adding that one survivor had been rescued while search efforts continue.

Trump orders withdrawal of US troops from Somalia

The pullback is part of a larger effort to reduce US troop levels abroad before Donald Trump leaves office in January

● The United States has about 700 troops in Somalia

President Donald Trump has ordered nearly all American troops to withdraw from Somalia, US officials said, part of a global pullback by the Republican president before he leaves office next month that will also see him drawdown forces in Afghanistan and Iraq.

The United States has about 700 troops in Somalia focused on helping local forces defeat the al Qaeda-linked al Shabaab insurgency. The mission has received little attention in the United States, but has been considered a cornerstone of the Pentagon's global efforts to combat al Qaeda. In a statement, the Pentagon sought to play down the implications of a withdrawal that experts have said could undermine secu-

rity in Somalia. "While a change in force posture, this action is not a change in US policy," the Pentagon said. "The US will retain the capability to conduct targeted counterterrorism operations in Somalia, and collect early warnings and indicators regarding threats to the homeland." The United States already pulled out of Somalia's cities of Bossaso and Galkayo earlier this

year. As of last month, US troops were still in the southern port city of Kismayo, Baledogle airbase in the Lower Shabelle region, and in the capital Mogadishu. A US defence official, speaking on condition of anonymity, said nearly all US forces would leave Somalia, although some would remain in Mogadishu. The Pentagon statement, which was unsigned, said an unspecified number of forces in Somalia

would be moved to neighbouring countries, allowing them to carry out cross-border operations. Others would be reassigned outside East Africa. A congressional aide, speaking on condition of anonymity, said the withdrawal comes at a difficult time for Somalia, ahead of both parliamentary and presidential elections, and will present an early dilemma for President-elect Joe Biden.

14 Indians to return home after 10-month detainment in Yemen

After a ten-month long ordeal in Yemen, 14 Indian nationals are on their way back to homeland after being freed by their Houthis captors. The sailors were part of a crew of 20 including five Bangladeshi nationals and an Egyptian. The detained group also includes two men from the south Indian state of Kerala, T.K Praveen from Vadakra, and Mustafa from Trivandrum. Their release came after the intervention of the Indian Embassy in Saana and Indian Foreign Affairs minister. Sudheer Tirunilath, a Social worker in Bahrain, said, "We knocked several doors for the release of the detained Indian including that of the United Na-

tions. Very happy that they are finally released after tremendous efforts" He said the group is now on their way back and had reached Dubai Airport. "UAE embassy officials will receive them at Dubai Airport and will make arrangements for their further travel to India," Tirunilath said. He said the group would fly to Bombay today and will take a connection flight to Kannur. They are to land in Kannur by 11:30 am today. Praveen, the Chief Officer of the Ship, thanked Sudeer Thirunilath for his tremendous help. "Our experience during the first few months were terrible, with us left with only a pair of cloths. They also took away all our money and mobile phones," he said.

"Mostly the food given was not fit for consumption." "We only got back our mobile phone after spending five months in captivity." The crew said they also witnessed the horrors of the war on Yemen during those days where airstrikes are seen through windows.

"We saw a building being reduced to rubble in an explosion," Praveen added. The crew members were disowned by their Oman-based employer following their arrest after their fleet of three commercial ships carrying 4-wheel vehicles set out from Oman on 3 February and were supposed to reach Saudi Arabia in just over two weeks. However, on 12 February the ships were caught up in rough weather in the Gulf of Aden, causing one of the ships to sink. The crew then, reportedly, anchored the remaining ships in war-torn Yemen only to end up in the captivity of Yemeni coast guard. After four days of interrogation, they were then moved to a hotel in Sanaa and were locked up.

Russia begins COVID-19 vaccinations in Moscow

Russia is starting its Covid-19 vaccination programme, with clinics in the capital Moscow inoculating those most at risk from the virus

Moscow began distributing the Sputnik V COVID-19 shot via 70 clinics yesterday to the most exposed groups, marking Russia's first large-scale vaccination against the disease, the city's coronavirus task force said.

The Russian-made vaccine will first be made available to doctors and other medical workers, teachers and social workers because they run the highest risk of exposure to the disease.

"You are working at an educational institution and have top-priority for the COVID-19 vaccine, free of charge," read a phone text message received by one Muscovite, an elementary school teacher, early yesterday.

President Vladimir Putin has ordered a nationwide voluntary vaccination programme to begin next week. He said Russia will have produced 2 million vaccine doses within the next few days.

The head of the Russian Direct Investment Fund (RDIF), Kirill Dmitriev, said in an interview with the BBC on Friday that Russia expects to give the vaccine to about 2 million people this month.

"Over the first five hours, 5,000 people signed up for the jab - teachers, doctors, social workers, those who are today risking their health and lives the most," Mayor Sergei Sobyenin wrote on his personal website on Friday.

Russia has already vaccinated more than 100,000 high-risk people, Health Minister Mikhail Murashko said earlier this week during a separate presentation to the United Nations about Sputnik V.

Among the first people signing up to the Moscow roll-out, Nadezhda Ragulina, an administrator at a Moscow clinic, said she wanted the vaccine as she had witnessed many COVID-19 patients.

"This is my decision... Some people close to me also have had an experience (of COVID-19). That's why I want to protect myself,

my relatives, to obtain the immunity," she told Rossiya-24 state TV channel.

Moscow, a city of around 13 million people, has been the epicentre of Russia's coronavirus outbreak. It reported 7,993 new cases yesterday, up from 6,868 the day before and well above the daily tallies of around 700 seen in early September.

The age for those receiving shots is capped at 60. People with certain underlying health conditions, pregnant women and those who have had a respiratory illness for the past two weeks are barred from vaccination.

Russia has developed two COVID-19 vaccines, Sputnik V which is backed by the Russian Direct Investment Fund and another developed by Siberia's Vector Institute, with final trials for the both yet to be

completed.

Scientists have raised concerns about the speed at which Russia has worked, giving the regulatory go-ahead for its vaccines and launching mass vaccinations before full trials to test its safety and efficacy had been completed.

The Sputnik V vaccine is administered in two injections, with the second dose is expected to be given 21 days after the first.

Deputy Prime Minister Tatiana Golikova said on Friday that the vaccinated should avoid public places and reduce their intake of medicine and alcohol, which could suppress the immune system, within the first 42 days after the first jab.

Moscow closed down all public places including parks and cafes, with exception for delivery, in late March, with police patrolling the streets looking for those violating the rules. Restrictions were eased from mid-June, however.

Russia as a whole reported 28,782 new infections yesterday, its highest daily tally, pushing the national total to 2,431,731, the fourth-highest in the world.

In October, certain restrictions such as remote learning for some secondary school children and a 30% limit on the number of workers allowed in offices were introduced again.

Thousands pay tribute to Thai royals amid calls for reform

Thousands of people gathered in Bangkok yesterday to show their devotion to the Thai monarchy on the birthday of King Maha Vajiralongkorn's late father, after months of street protests led by a youth movement demanding reform to royal powers.

King Vajiralongkorn led a candle lighting ceremony in front of the Grand Palace in Bangkok to pay tribute to his father King Bhumibol Adulyadej, who died in 2016 after reigning for seven decades - during which he was seen by many as a symbol of national unity.

The king was joined by thousands of loyalists, wearing the royal colour yellow and waving national flags.

In recent months, the monarchy in Thailand has become a target for a youth-led protest movement that accuses the current king and the government led by a former army chief Prayuth Chan-ocha of expanding royal powers to a level not seen since the absolute monarchy ended in 1932.

The protesters broke long-standing taboos by openly criticising King Vajiralongkorn for taking direct control of two military units and the wealth of the Crown Property Bureau, valued in tens of billions of dollars.

Violence erupts during Paris protest against Macron's security law

Scores of hooded anarchists launched projectiles at riot police, smashed up shop fronts, torched cars and burned barricades during a demonstration in the French capital yesterday against police violence and a draft security law.

The police fired back volleys of tear gas and made repeated charges at groups of troublemakers for close to three hours. One group of anarchists ransacked the branch office of a bank, throwing piles of paperwork onto a fire outside.

It marked the second consecutive of weekend of unrest in Paris, provoked by recent episodes of police brutality and President Emmanuel Macron's security plans, which the demonstrators say would restrict

civil liberties.

Rallies also took place in Marseille, Lyon, Lille and other French cities.

Thousands of people had begun marching peacefully in Paris, waving banners that read "France, land of police rights"

and "Withdrawal of the security law", when the clashes erupted between police and 'Black Bloc' anarchists.

Paris police said that some 500 "casseurs" - which translates as hoodlums or rioters - had infiltrated the protest, according to

The beating of a Black man, music producer Michel Zecler, by several police officers in late November intensified anger. That incident came to light after closed circuit television and mobile phone footage circulated online.

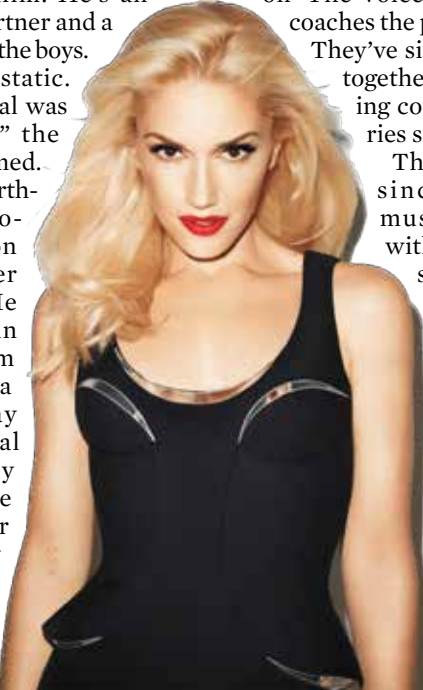

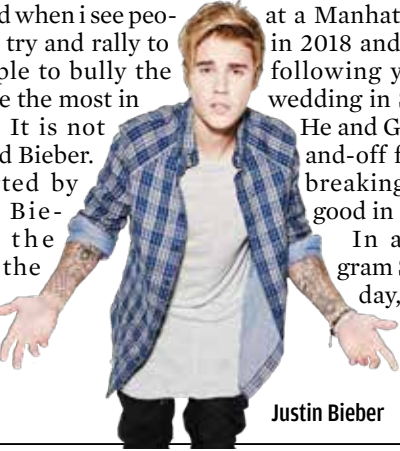

Bieber posted on his Instagram Story on Thursday night, “This sad excuse of a human just encouraged people on the video to literally go after my wife telling people to say that my previous relationship was better so on and so forth.” “It is extremely hard to choose

the high road when i see people like this try and rally to gather people to bully the person i love the most in this world. It is not right,” added Bieber. As reported by Page Six, Bieber tied the knot with the 24-year-old supermodel Baldwin

at a Manhattan courthouse in 2018 and celebrated the following year with a big wedding in South Carolina. He and Gomez dated on-and-off for years before breaking things off for good in early 2018. In another Instagram Story on Thursday, Bieber said he wouldn’t let the fan’s actions “steal my joy.”

Yuki Tsunoda battled back from a disappointing start to take an impressive victory yesterday in the Formula 2 Feature Race, held as

part of this weekend's F1 Rolex Sakhir Grand Prix.

Meanwhile, the drivers' title fight has been extended to the final event of the 2020 season as current leader Mick Schumacher maintained his lead on the standings at 14 points from chief rival Callum Iloft.

Prema Racing, on the other hand, which features Schumacher and Robert Shwartzman as their drivers, clinched the teams' championship.

Tsunoda started the 48-lap Feature in pole position but immediately lost two places at the start. He headed into the first turn of lap one behind Nikita Mazepin of Hitech Grand Prix and Shwartzman.

But the Carlin ace was able to make a late charge for the victory and regained first place on lap 44 amidst a hotly contested battle amongst the leaders. He held on until the end and took the chequered flag in 52:59.396

place despite a five-second penalty for speeding in the pit lane, while Mazepin (+6.280s) had to settle for third. He finished ahead of Felipe Drugovich, Shwartzman and Iloft.

Schumacher had a brilliant race to take seventh on the final classification after starting all the way from the back of the

grid in 18th. He also set the race's fastest lap of 1:04.087, earning him an extra two points on the championship standings.

The drivers' title battle now goes down to the wire and will be decided Sunday in the weekend's Sprint Race, which will be the final event of the season.

Prema won their teams' ti-

tle today after improving to 382 points, going beyond the reach of Uni-Virtuosi with 342.5.

Jehan Daruvala of Carlin will start from pole position in the Sprint Race, following the reverse grid rule of F2. The curtain-closer will be held over 34 laps and it is scheduled for a 3.20pm start.

The FIA Formula 2 Championship was rebranded from the GP2 Series in 2017. Two of its three champions since then are now stars in Formula 1, including Charles Leclerc (2017 champ) and George Russell (2018). Nyck de Vries (2019 winner) last competed in Formula E and the FIA World Endurance Championship

Manchester United roared back to beat West Ham 3-1 on Saturday and climb into the top four of the Premier League as fans returned to the English top-flight for the first time in nine months.

Ole Gunnar Solskjaer's men fell behind at the London Stadium but a three-goal blitz from Paul Pogba, Mason Greenwood and Marcus Rashford turned the tables at the London Stadium.

United, who have won nine successive league games on the road, are now fourth in the table, one point ahead of Manchester City, who earlier cruised past Fulham 2-0.

United, who started with Bruno Fernandes and Rashford on the bench, were second best in the first half and fell behind to a Tomas Soucek goal seven minutes before half-time.

But, with 2,000 fans inside the ground, Solskjaer threw on Rashford and Fernandes for the start of the second half and United were a changed side.

Bottas captured pole with a blistering lap of 53.377 seconds in Q3, beating out teammate George Russell—driving in place of Lewis Hamilton this weekend—by just 0.026 seconds to lock out the front row for Mercedes for the second successive weekend. Bottas commented after qualifying: “It’s great to be on pole, I’m happy with that, but this wasn’t my best qualifying. My second run in Q3 was decent, but I think there was still a bit of time missing in Turn 7 and 8. I was the first car out on track on the final run, so I didn’t have a tow and ultimately couldn’t improve. It was fairly close in the end, so I’m pleased it was enough for pole position. “It’s great to see George in P2 and that we managed to lock out the front row for the team. I’m not really surprised to see him up there, he kept improving
