## Parliament backs HM King's roadmap on Jobs and Growth

● Council reviewing key laws on AI, cybersecurity and digital transformation.

MPs have unanimously approved His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa's economic diversification programme, endorsing key priorities from job creation to national identity, according to a draft reply prepared.

Announced in the Royal Address opening the fourth ordinary session of the sixth legislative term, the programme sets out a national agenda focused on empowering youth and women, strengthening foreign policy and security, and accelerating economic development.

Lawmakers praised HRH Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, for enhancing coordination between state bodies and launching new initiatives to support jobseekers.

### Press

On the legislative side, the draft reply highlights the ratification of Law No. 41 of 2025, which amends Decree-Law No. 47 of 2002 regulating the press, printing and publishing. The Council pledges support for training and modern professional systems to strengthen

The reply identifies digital transformation, artificial intelligence and non-oil sectors as central to future growth. MPs note that the Council is reviewing draft laws on AI governance, cybersecurity, digital government and updated data-protection rules as part of building a knowledge-based economy.

### Research fund

To support national innovation, the draft proposes a research and innovation fund for projects in AI, advanced technologies and sustainable energy. It calls for more future-focused academic specialisations in universities, their inclusion in scholarship plans, and enhanced national training to equip young Bahrainis with digital, leadership and entrepreneurship skills.

### Renewables

MPs encourage wider investment in renewable energy, green industry, space technology and the creative economy. They urge improvements in labour-market data, job quality and the effective use of existing government schemes. More flexible legislation, they add, would help attract investment and boost competitiveness. Stronger oversight systems are needed to monitor government performance, protect public funds, control debt and ensure fair access to services.

### Values, identity

Lawmakers welcomed the King's call to link scientific progress with Bahrain's values and identity. They support the creation of a national identity centre and encourage more cultural and digital content showcasing Bahraini heritage, along with school and community programmes that promote tolerance.

On social policy, the Council stresses updating the social protection system to meet the needs of families and children while increasing opportunities for youth and women in decision-making.

### Arab cause

MPs also reaffirm support for the King's stance on Arab causes, especially Palestine, and his efforts to prioritise the issue during Bahrain's term on the UN Security Council.

The reply endorses measures to strengthen the readiness of the Bahrain Defence Force, the Interior Ministry and the National Guard, and supports national efforts to protect the marine environment.

## Over 70,800 firms onboard as wage compliance reaches 99.4%

Over 70,800 private-sector firms have joined Bahrain's Wage Protection System (WPS) since its launch on 1 May 2021.

In a reply to MP Abdulhakeem Al Sheno, the Labour Ministry said the second WPS version, launched on 21 October 2025, gives regulators stronger tools to track salary payments and flag violations. The upgrade was developed with the LMRA, Central Bank of Bahrain, Benefit Company and licensed financial institutions, offering more accurate, sector-level data than the earlier system.

Compliance is measured by whether wages are paid on time and through CBB-licensed channels, including bank accounts and prepaid cards.

The ministry recorded 65 violations in 2022, 61 in 2023, 115 in 2024, and 225 up to October 2025 — equal to 0.66% of enrolled firms, putting overall compliance at 99.4%. For enforcement, the LMRA reviews wage records before issuing work permits. Inspectors issue warnings, give up to a month for corrections, then revisit before filing violations and referring persistent cases to the Public Prosecution.

Women make up the majority of Bahrain's jobseeker register, the Ministry of Labour told Parliament, with 12,196 of the 17,402 people recorded in 2024 being female.

The ministry said it aims to ensure that every registered unemployed citizen is offered at least three job opportunities before the end of 2025.

15 November, 11,574 jobseekers had attended three or more in-person interviews with employers, and 2,172 had been hired, with employment counted only when registered as an insured employee with the Social Insurance Organisation.

**5,206 men**

The 2024 register shows that 10,325 jobseekers hold a bachelor's degree or higher, 6,153 have secondary education or less, and 924 hold a diploma. Men accounted for 5,206 of the total, making female graduates the largest group in the current pool.

Replying to MP Jaleela Alawi Al Sayed Hassan, the ministry confirmed that it aims to complete a minimum of three employer interviews for each registered jobseeker by 31 December 2025.

**Job security**

The ministry also addressed concerns about job security after wage support ends. Dismissal cases are tracked with Tamkeen, and reasons are verified. If a termination is linked to the end of wage support, the

employer's details are sent to Tamkeen, and the ministry will suspend new vacancies for that establishment on the National Employment Platform.

Wage support is designed to taper over time, dropping to 30% in the third year, and labour supply tenders are excluded. In cases of workforce reductions due to full or partial closures, Bahraini workers are prioritised under the private-sector Labour Law, including Article 110.



The National Employment Platform remains open to eligible Bahraini jobseekers who are unemployed, not retired, not students, without a commercial registration, and aged 18 to 60.

## Three face-to-face interviews per jobseeker

The Labour Ministry said it has set a minimum target of three in-person interviews for every registered jobseeker in 2025.

The move follows a directive issued on 28 September 2025 by HRH Crown Prince and Prime Minister Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa.

In a written reply to First Deputy Speaker Abdulnabi Salman, the Ministry clarified that these three "opportunities" refer only to documented face-to-face interviews with employers held at the Ministry; initial online applications are not counted.

The Ministry also checks wage levels before listing vacancies. Minimum salaries are set at BD500 for university graduates, BD430 for diploma holders, and BD350 for secondary certificate holders or below, with adjustments made based on specialisation and market demand.

Progress will be tracked by the completion of three documented interviews per jobseeker, and hires are counted only after registration with the General Organisation for Social Insurance confirms employment. Interviews are scheduled and overseen by Ministry representatives, with follow-ups to monitor employer selections and hiring steps.

# Fast-track Al Hajar dialysis centre, councillor urges

High demand for dialysis drives call to fast-track Al Hajar centre

- Councillor urges quick approval of new kidney and dialysis centre
- Facility to ease hospital strain and reduce patient travel
- Built-in parking to ensure safe, convenient access

Municipal Councillor Tareq Al Farsani has called on health authorities to fast-track the new kidney treatment and dialysis centre in Al Hajar, Block 463, and to include well-organised parking as part of the project. He highlighted that patients with kidney failure currently face long waits and overcrowded wards in public hospitals, with demand

for regular dialysis increasing each year. While the Ministry of Health has said the centre is part of future plans, Al Farsani stressed that the pressure on existing services means the project cannot wait. Locating the centre close to local homes, he said, would reduce the strain on hospital emergency rooms and dialysis units and make it easier for patients to access specialist care through nearby primary services. Al Farsani also called for built-in, clearly marked parking, which would improve traffic flow, prevent unsafe stopping, and make it easier and safer for patients and their families to reach the centre. He added that the new facility would save residents from long drives to larger hospitals and the stress of finding available dialysis slots, especially for those on fixed treatment schedules. The councillor urged the relevant authorities to approve the project quickly and prioritise its construction, saying it is

## Turning sentences into second chances

Parliament reviews reform bill

In response to concerns raised by the International Labour Organization (ILO) over compulsory work alongside imprisonment, Bahrain has drafted an amendment requiring most inmates to take part in rehabilitation and training programmes instead of being assigned “employment” duties. The proposal, issued under Royal Decree No. 68 of 2025 at Riffa Palace, has been referred to Parliament. The Foreign Affairs, Defence and National Security Committee will review it as the main committee, with the Legislative and Legal Affairs Committee providing comments. The revised text makes rehabilitation and training compulsory for all inmates, except for remand detainees or those unable to participate due to health reasons. Programmes should, where possible, match an

inmate’s existing skills or profession. Executive regulations will outline the programmes, maximum hours, allowances, eligibility conditions, and rules for external training in coordination with relevant bodies. The draft also addresses civil liability for occupational injuries and professional diseases arising from participation in the programmes. The Cabinet endorsed the draft for parliamentary referral on 17 November 2025. The amendment also modernises Penal Code terminology, replacing references to “prison” and “prisons” with Reformation and Rehabilitation Centres, while focusing on preparing inmates for social reintegration and aligning Bahrain’s penal system with international labour standards.

## Parliament may get three months to finalise accounts

Lawmakers in Bahrain may extend the Council of Representatives’ deadline for closing its accounts from 30 days to three months if a new bill tabled on Tuesday is approved. The proposal seeks to amend

Article 219 of Decree-Law 54 of 2002 on the Council’s Rules of Procedure. The General Secretariat would prepare the chamber’s final account, have it audited, and submit it to the Speaker within three months of the financial year’s end. The Speaker would then refer it to the Bureau, which may pass it to the Financial and Economic Affairs Committee before presenting it to the full chamber for discussion and approval. The Financial and Economic Affairs Committee said the extra time would allow for more accurate audited figures, reduce the workload on the General Secretariat, and give the National Audit Office adequate time to complete its review. In a written opinion, the government expressed support, noting the proposal aligns with constitutional and legal requirements. Article 113 of the Constitution requires the state’s final account to be submitted to the Council within five months of year-end and approved by both chambers before publication. The amendment would also harmonise the Council’s schedule with other financial laws, including the state budget law (Decree-Law 39 of 2002), the Unemployment Insurance Fund, the Future Generations Reserve, and the Central Bank of Bahrain, and mirrors a recent Shura Council amendment. The Legislative and Legal Affairs Committee examined the draft, backing the title, preamble, and new wording of Article 219. It recommends approval in principle, with the law to take effect the day after publication in the Official Gazette, keeping both chambers aligned in managing public accounts.

# 11,000 jobseekers on allowance in October

Ministry says eligibility rules unchanged amid ongoing support for jobseekers

● **11,452 Bahrainis received unemployment allowance in October, ministry tells Parliament**

● **Majority on support for over a year; system tracks eligibility under the 2006 law**

● **Jobseekers choose vacancies via the National Employment Platform with no cap on applications**

More than 11,000 Bahrainis were receiving unemployment allowance in October 2025, the Labour Ministry told MP Khalid Buanaq, stressing that it has no plan to restrict eligibility.

The ministry said 11,452 jobseekers were on the allowance that month, noting that the total changes daily as people find

work or fall outside the legal criteria set under Decree-Law 78 of 2006. Of the October figure, 3,479 had been receiving the allowance for less than a year, 6,258 for one to five years, and 1,715 for more than five years.

Responding to questions about opportunities offered to long-term recipients, the ministry said there is no limit on how many roles a jobseeker may apply for through the National Employment Platform. Employers upload vacancies, after which the ministry checks salary, qualification and specialism before publishing them. The ministry does not nominate candidates or contact them directly; jobseekers choose roles themselves, with the system blocking applications that do not match the required qualification or specialism.

Jobseekers with no work experience re-

ceive automated guidance if they fail to apply for enough roles. Continued inaction leads to an in-person meeting with an employment specialist, who explains how to use the platform.

The ministry pointed to Article 24 of the Unemployment Insurance Law, which re-

moves entitlement if a jobseeker refuses two suitable opportunities. Since long-term recipients are still receiving the allowance, it said, they have not met the refusal threshold.

It also detailed steps taken after HRH Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa directed the ministry on 28 September 2025 to ensure each registered jobseeker is offered three opportunities before year-end. Measures included boosting private-sector vacancies, extending ministry working hours to 7am-7pm, expanding interview rooms and parking, increasing staff, and strengthening the platform with the Information and eGovernment Authority.

Jobseekers remain on the register until employed and recorded as insured with the Social Insurance Organisation, the ministry added.



## BD5,000 utilities claim upheld despite five-year limitation argument

A civil appeal court has upheld a ruling ordering an electricity and water subscriber to pay BD5,000 in unpaid bills dating back 11 years, rejecting her claim that the case should be dismissed because it exceeded the five-year time limit.

The Electricity and Water Authority filed the lawsuit after the woman failed to settle her electricity and water charges over more than a decade. Her lawyer argued that the claim was time-barred under Article 368 of the Civil Code, which limits the state's ability to recover

er taxes and certain government fees to five years.

However, the court ruled that the article does not apply in this case. It explained that electricity and water bills are payments for services, not government fees or taxes, and therefore fall

outside the scope of the five-year limit.

In its decision, the court cited constitutional court principles that distinguish taxes and fees from other types of state revenue. Payments for public utilities such as electricity, wa-

ter, telecommunications, transport, aviation and healthcare, it noted, are treated more like commercial charges for services provided.

The court also found that the subscriber had indeed benefited from the services during the disputed period, and records showed she had been renting the property at the time. The Authority submitted detailed statements of the outstanding amounts, which the court said accurately supported the claim.

The appeal court therefore upheld the original order requiring her to pay BD5,000, in addition to court costs and BD100 in legal fees.

## India central bank cuts rates amid US trade deal limbo

- **Benchmark repo rate is now down by 25 basis points to 5.25%**
- **The bank had already cut rates more than 100 basis points this year**

India's central bank cut interest rates yesterday and signalled more could be on the way as low inflation provided room to help cushion the world's fifth-largest economy against US President Donald Trump's tariff blitz.

The decision also comes after the rupee hit a record low against the dollar this week -- having dropped around five percent in 2025 -- owing to ongoing worries about the lack of a trade deal with Washington

and impact of the levies on the country's goods.

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) cut the benchmark repo rate, the level at which it lends to commercial banks, 25 basis points to 5.25% after a unanimous vote by its monetary policy committee.

Some analysts had expected officials to stand pat, given that the bank had already cut rates more than 100 basis points this year and economic growth hit a six-quarter high in July-September.

But a majority had argued that easing price pressures and mounting risks to India's economic outlook stemming from Trump's tariffs justified a reduction.

With US tariffs sitting at 50%, exporters are warning of cancelled orders and widespread job losses, while analysts say the tolls could knock up to 80 basis

points off economic growth this year.

And while Indian officials remain optimistic of finalising the first phase of a trade deal by the end of the year, neither side has announced a breakthrough.

RBI Governor Sanjay Malhotra said the monetary policy committee also agreed to pump cash into the financial system through buying government bonds and a \$5 billion foreign exchange swap.

**Sinking rupee**

Malhotra added that the central bank had decided to maintain "a neutral stance", suggesting there was room for further rate cuts.

Vishal Goenka, co-founder of IndiaBonds.com, said the reduction in borrowing costs was timely.

"Interestingly, the forward expectations of inflation have

come much lower, opening the door for another rate cut if required before the end of the financial year," he said in a statement.

Indian policymakers have been faced with multiple challenges this year including the sinking rupee and slumping exports.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has unveiled sweeping consumption tax cuts and pushed through labour law reforms after economic growth hit

**Reserve Bank of India (RBI) Governor Sanjay Malhotra**

a four-year-low in the fiscal year that ended March 31.

Easing inflation also allowed the RBI to cut rates for the first time in nearly five years in February and follow it up with two more in April and June, before holding steady in the past two meetings.

Since then, lower food prices pushed retail inflation to a record low of 0.25 percent in October, which is well below

the central bank's medium-term target of four percent.

The economic slump has also been halted, with GDP growth coming in at a better-than-expected 8.2 percent in the three months ending September 30.

But Trump's trade policies continue to darken the economic outlook and have also partially contributed to the rupee falling to a record low of 90.42 per dollar this week as overseas investors fled. The unit bounced back Friday to sit around 89.98.

Tariffs have also started to bite, with India's overall exports falling 11.8% year-on-year in October, led by a drop in US-bound shipments.

The International Monetary Fund economic growth forecast for the year to March from 6.4% to 6.2%, citing a "baseline assumption of prolonged 50% US tariffs".

Penguins queue in Paris zoo for their bird flu jabs

A curious seagull strolled nonchalantly through the penguin enclosure at a zoo in Paris.

It looked harmless enough but the seagull could pose an existential threat to the penguins with a devastating bird flu outbreak killing hundreds of millions of birds across the world over the last few years.

That is why 41 Humboldt penguins were queued up near their pool in the Paris Zoological Park on a cold December morning at the start of influenza season.

A zookeeper whispered some reassuring words to one called Cissou as a veterinarian injected him with his annual bird flu vaccine shot.

After getting his jab, Cissou waddled off back into his enclosure.

Around 10 zoo staff took the chance to weigh and measure the penguins, collecting feathers, taking blood samples, examining their feet and

checking their microchips.

In a month, the young penguins born this year will get a booster shot.

The zoo, which is in Vincennes park in the east of the French capital, has never detected a case of bird flu.

But it is home to wild birds such as crows, magpies, geese and parakeets, and an outbreak would be catastrophic for the zoo animals.

Last week French health authorities warned this bird flu season is already looking like it will be the worst in a couple of years.

Bird flu was detected in Antarctica for the first time early last year, causing concern among scientists about the fate of the penguins there.

Sylvie Laidebeure, a vet at the Paris zoo, told AFP "these animals are generally threatened in their natural habitat" as she inserted a needle into the breast of a Humboldt penguin, which are classified as vulnerable by the International Union for Conservation of Nature.

America First strategy realigns foreign policy

Trump strategy shifts from global role and vows 'resistance' in Europe

Focus shifts from global to regional

Latin America now top priority

Calls to end mass migration

President Donald Trump laid out a radical realignment of US foreign policy yesterday, shifting the longtime superpower's focus from global to regional, brutally criticizing Europe as facing "civilizational erasure" and putting a top priority on eliminating mass migration.

The national security strategy, meant to flesh out Trump's norms-shattering worldview, elevates Latin America to the top of the US agenda in a sharp reorientation from longstanding US calls to focus on Asia to face a rising China.

"In everything we do, we are putting America First," Trump said in a preamble to the long-awaited paper.

Breaking with decades of attempts to be the superpower, the strategy said that the "United States rejects the ill-fated concept of global domination for itself."

It said that the United States would also prevent other powers, namely China, from dominating but added: "This does not mean wasting blood and treasure to curtail the influence of all the world's great and middle powers."

The strategy called for a "re-adjustment of our global military presence to address urgent threats in our Hemisphere," starting with migration.

"The era of mass migration must end," the strategy said.

The strategy made clear that the United States under Trump would aggressively pursue similar objectives in Europe, in line with far-right parties' agendas.

In extraordinary language in addressing close allies, the strategy said the administration would be "cultivating resistance to Europe's current trajectory within European nations."

Germany quickly hit back, saying that it does not need "outside advice."

The strategy pointed to Europe's slide in share of the global

economy -- which is the result largely of the rise of China and other emerging powers -- and said: "This economic decline is eclipsed by the real and more stark prospect of civilizational erasure."

"Should present trends continue, the continent will be unrecognizable in 20 years or less."

As Trump seeks an end to the Ukraine war that would likely favor Russia gaining territory, the strategy accused Europeans of weakness and said the United States should focus on "ending the perception, and preventing the reality, of NATO as a perpetually expanding alliance."

Updated 'Monroe Doctrine'

Trump since returning to office in January has ordered sweeping curbs on migration, after a political career built on fanning fears that America's white majority is losing its status.

The strategy speaks in bold terms of pressing US dominance in Latin America, where the Trump administration has been striking alleged drug traffickers



The strategy employs stark language, warning that Europe could become "unrecognizable in 20 years or less" if current demographic and economic trends continue

at sea, intervening to bring down leftist leaders including in Venezuela, and loudly seeking to take charge of key resources such as the Panama Canal.

The strategy cast Trump as modernizing the two-century-old Monroe Doctrine, in which the then young United States declared Latin America off-limits to rival powers.

"We will assert and enforce a 'Trump Corollary' to the Monroe Doctrine," it said.

The strategy paid comparatively little attention to the Middle East, which has long consumed Washington.

Pointing to US efforts to increase energy supply at home

and not in the oil-rich Gulf, the strategy said: "America's historic reason for focusing on the Middle East will recede."

The paper said it was a US priority for Israel to be secure, but stopped short of the fulsome language on Israel used even in the first Trump administration.

China still competitor

On China, the strategy repeated calls for a "free and open" Asia-Pacific region but focused more on the nation as an economic competitor.

After much speculation on whether Trump would budge on Taiwan, the self-ruling democracy claimed by Beijing, the strategy made clear that the United States supports the decades-old status quo, but called on allies Japan and South Korea to contribute more to ensure Taiwan's defense from China.

The strategy predictably puts little focus on Africa, saying the United States should transition away from "liberal ideology" and an "aid-focused relationship" and emphasize goals such as securing critical minerals.

US presidents usually release a National Security Strategy in each White House term. The last, released by Joe Biden in 2022, prioritized winning a competitive edge over China while constraining a "dangerous" Russia.

Flooding kills two as Vietnam hit by dozens of landslides

Heavy rain in Vietnam triggered flooding that killed at least two people and caused more than a dozen landslides, state media said yesterday, adding to what authorities called the "most unusual" year of natural disasters in

the country's history.

South-central Vietnam has been lashed by weeks of heavy rain, submerging hundreds of thousands of homes in coastal tourism hotspots and causing deadly landslides in mountainous regions.

Downpours inundated thou-

sands more homes in Lam Dong province on Thursday and killed at least two people, the Voice of Vietnam news outlet reported.

It added that 16 landslides struck the province, damaging roads and bridges and forcing the evacuation of hundreds of homes.

# Russia commits to India energy

Putin promises ongoing energy shipments amid broad India-Russia cooperation talks

● Russian leader promises uninterrupted fuel

● Modi praises Russia's reliability

Russian President Vladimir Putin said yesterday he was ready to continue “uninterrupted shipments” of fuel to India.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi, who is hosting Putin at a summit in New Delhi dominated by energy, defence and trade talks, thanked the Russian leader for his “unwavering commitment towards India”.

Putin, on his first visit to close partner India since the Ukraine war, was given a red-carpet welcome with an honour guard and 21-gun salute.

“Russia is a reliable supplier of oil, gas, coal, and everything that is required for the develop-

ment of India's energy,” Putin told Modi after talks.

“We are ready to continue uninterrupted shipments of fuel for the fast-growing Indian economy,” he added, according to an official translator.

Modi said that “energy security has been a strong and important pillar of the India-Russia partnership,” and while he ref-

erenced nuclear power, he made no specific reference to oil.

Modi addressed “my friend” Putin and praised New Delhi and Moscow's longstanding ties.

“We have agreed on an economic cooperation program until 2030,” Modi told Putin, after officials exchanged a raft of agreements spanning jobs, health, shipping and chemicals.

“This will ensure that our trade and investment are diversified, balanced, and sustainable.”

Bilateral trade reached \$68.7 billion in 2024-25 -- almost six times higher than the pre-pandemic levels -- but Indian exports accounted for only \$4.88 billion.

Besides discussions around cutting-edge defence hardware, which includes air defence systems, fighter jets, and nuclear submarines, New Delhi will push for easier access to the wider Russian market.

Defence ministers met as part of the talks, Indian foreign ministry official Vikram Misri said, but no final deal was struck.

## Lebanon president says country does not want war with Israel

Lebanese President Joseph Aoun yesterday told a United Nations Security Council delegation his country does not want war with Israel, days after civilian representatives from both sides held their first talks in decades.

Despite a November 2024 ceasefire that was supposed to end more than a year of hostilities between Israel and the Iran-backed militant group, Israel has kept up strikes on Lebanon and has also maintained troops in five south Lebanon areas it deems strategic.

During his meeting with UN Security Council ambassadors, Aoun said the Lebanese “do not want war again, the Lebanese people have suffered enough and there will be no going back”, according to a statement from the presidency.

Aoun called on the envoys to support the Lebanese army's efforts to disarm non-government groups. The army expects

to complete the first phase of its government-approved plan by the end of the year.

“The Lebanese army will play its full role... The international community must support and assist it.”

Aoun called there was “no going back” on the decision, “even if it requires some time, because the Lebanese are tired of military confrontations”.

Following “a new round of negotiations” that began on Wednesday, Aoun stressed “the need to pressure the Israeli side to implement the ceasefire and withdraw, and expressed his hope for pressure from the delegation”.

## Sri Lanka issues fresh landslide warnings as death toll hits 607

Heavy rains triggered fresh landslide warnings in Sri Lanka's worst-affected central hills yesterday, as the death toll from last week's Cyclone Ditwah jumped to 607.

The National Building Research Organisation (NBRO), which monitors the stability of mountain slopes, said heavy rainfall could further saturate the hills and make them unstable.

“Since rainfall within the past 24 hours has exceeded 150 millimetres, if the rains continue, evacuate to a safe location to avoid the risk of landslides,” the NBRO said in a statement.

The latest deluge was brought on by the onset of the monsoon rains, although some of the earlier flooding that began last week has started to subside.

The Disaster Management Centre (DMC) said 607 people had been confirmed dead, with many of those previously unaccounted for now presumed killed in the devastating mudslides.

The number of missing was revised down from 341 to 214, while the number of people affected rose to just over two million.

The number of people in state-run refugee camps fell further to 150,000 from a peak of 225,000 as floodwaters receded in and around the capital Colombo.

### Fresh IMF talks

Addressing parliament yesterday, Dissanayake said he had asked the IMF to delay the release of the sixth instalment of a \$2.9 billion bailout loan in order to negotiate a bigger payout.

“The IMF board was to sign off on releasing \$347 million on December 15, but we have now asked them to put it off because we want time to negotiate a bigger instalment,” Dissanayake said.

He said fresh talks with the Washington-based lender of last resort were essential, because the country's economic situation had drastically changed following the disaster across the island.

Yesterday's new landslide alert covered areas not previously identified as high risk.

## Bahrain End Arab Challenge Cup Strong

Bahrain closed their Arab Challenge Cup campaign with a hard-fought 3-2 win over hosts Jordan yesterday at Princess Sumaya Hall in Amman, capping a tournament that began with high expectations and ended with a welcome return to winning form.

The Bahrainis entered the event chasing a historic first Arab Challenge Cup title while riding a remarkable run of achievements: bronze at the Islamic Solidarity Games in November, silver at the West Asia Championship, a historic AVC Nations Cup gold — the kingdom's first-ever AVC title — and last year's Arab Men's Championship crown.

They opened the tournament with a confident 3-0 sweep of Palestine, but momentum

stalled with three consecutive defeats to Egypt, Kuwait and eventual champions Tunisia.

Against Jordan, however, Bahrain rediscovered their rhythm. They controlled the opening sets 25-12 and 25-19, before Jordan rallied to take the third 25-23 and dominate the fourth 25-15. In the decisive fifth set, Bahrain steadied their play and closed it out 20-15 to seal the win.

The match stats reflected Bahrain's sharper edge in key moments, with the visitors producing 19 points won on serve to Jordan's 15, and registering a six-point scoring streak, compared to the hosts' four.

Bahrain finish the inaugural edition with five points, earned from victories over Palestine and Jordan, wrapping up their campaign on a positive note after a challenging mid-tournament stretch.

## LeBron scoring streak ends as Hachimura, Reaves lift Lakers

Rui Hachimura drilled a buzzer-beating three-pointer to lift the Los Angeles Lakers to a 123-120 victory over the Toronto Raptors on Thursday as LeBron James's incredible streak of double-digit scoring games ended.

With the NBA's leading scorer Luka Doncic absent for personal reasons, Austin Reaves delivered a double-double of 44 points and 10 assists for the Lakers in a clash of East and West second-placed teams.

James scored eight points and handed out 11 assists, in-

cluding the pass from the top of the key to Hachimura in the corner for the game-winner.

"That was crazy," Japanese

forward Hachimura said. "I never had a game-winner before."

James saw his streak of 1,297 games with 10 or more points end -- a run that began in January 2007.

But the league's all-time leading scorer said he didn't hesitate to dish to Hachimura on the final play, with his path to the basket blocked and Reaves also under pressure.

"Just playing the game the right way," said the 40-year-old James, who is in his unprecedented 23rd season. "Always make the right play. That's how I was taught the game."

# Norris tops crucial Abu Dhabi practice

Championship leader sets the pace in second practice at the Yas Marina Circuit

● **Lando Norris leads Max Verstappen by 0.363 seconds**

● **Oscar Piastri struggles, finishes 11th**

● **George Russell third for Mercedes**

Series leader Lando Norris completed a 'double top' to boost his bid for a maiden drivers' world championship ahead of title rival Max Verstappen in yesterday's twilight second practice for this weekend's decisive season-ending Abu Dhabi Grand Prix.

The 26-year-old Briton clocked a best lap in one minute and 23.083 seconds in his McLaren to outpace Red Bull's four-time world champion by 0.363sec with Mercedes' George Russell third, 0.079 further behind.

Championship leader Norris has a 12-point lead over Verstappen, who is seeking a record-equalling fifth consecutive title, with McLaren team-mate Oscar Piastri a further four points back.

A podium finish will be enough for Norris to clinch the title in Sunday's three-way showdown at the Yas Marina Circuit where Verstappen could become the fourth driver to take the title

without leading the championship – a feat previously achieved by John Surtees (1974), James Hunt (1976) and Sebastian Vettel (2010).

The 2010 race, with four contenders, was the last time more than two drivers contested the title at the final race.

Piastri, who missed the opening practice to allow a rookie reserve to take his car, was down in 11th after reporting balance problems. He was six-tenths adrift.

Oliver Bearman was fourth for Haas ahead of Sauber's Nico Hulkenberg and Gabriel Bortoleto, Racing Bulls' Red Bull-

bound rookie Isack Hadjar and Ferrari's Charles Leclerc.

Two-time champion Fernando Alonso was ninth for Aston Martin and Italian rookie Kimi Antonelli 10th in the second Mercedes.

Seven-time champion Lewis Hamilton, who was one of the nine drivers who sat out the opening session, was 14th for Ferrari as he ends a forlorn debut season with the Italian team at a circuit where he has enjoyed three victories.

After an early fastest lap by Bearman, top spot was swiftly traded by several drivers in the cooling conditions as the track

## McLaren will make 'practical' call on team orders in Abu Dhabi, says boss Brown

McLaren boss Zak Brown yesterday confirmed his team will exercise team orders to secure the drivers' title in Sunday's decisive season-ending Abu Dhabi Grand Prix if it becomes clear during the race that only one remains a contender.

Speaking to reporters at a team chiefs' news conference at the Yas Marina Circuit following opening practice, Brown stressed that the team will "use common sense" and abandon their 'papaya rules' guaranteeing total equality and freedom to race.

"In the sense of team orders, as long as both drivers have a chance to win the world championship – which they clearly do sitting here right now – then it's business

as usual and they're free to race," said Brown.

"Obviously we'll be practical and realistic. If, as the weekend develops, as the race develops, it becomes clear that one has a significantly better chance than another, then we're a team that wants to win the drivers' championship and we will race accordingly to do whatever we can to get whoever that driver is in front to try and win the race.

"Our team orders have been around giving equal opportunity to win the championship, but as the race plays out, if it becomes clear that both can't, then we're going to do what's in the best interest of the team and try and win the drivers' championship."

temperature dropped from 39 degrees in the opening session to 28 and the floodlights came on.

That drop improved the conditions and prospects for some teams, dusk bringing more grip and speed as Norris re-established his supremacy ahead of Verstappen with Russell in pursuit in his revived Mercedes.

By mid-session, after switching from mediums to softs, they were separated by three-tenths

with Piastri down in 10th, six-tenths adrift, after missing the earlier run to allow reserve rookie driver Pato O'Ward to enjoy a session.

The Australian reported balance issues on his car, evidenced by a big lock-up at Turn Six, as he continued to struggle for pace with 20 minutes remaining and most focussing on long run preparation for the race on hard compounds.
