Emma Stone 'too afraid' of her 'own mental health' to launch own Instagram account

Emma Stone is "too afraid" of her "own mental health" to launch an Instagram account.

The 37-year-old actress much prefers being a "lurker" and looking

at other people's content rather than creating a profile on the photo-sharing site in her name.

Asked if she would ever start a lifestyle website, she told Rolling Stone magazine: "One hundred percent no."

"That's why I don't even have Instagram. I'm too afraid of my own mental health to be engaged

in that way, and that's why I'm such a lurker and love following other people's stuff."

The Bugonia star is to feature in a brand-new commercial for Squarespace, in which the company helps her to acquire her own website domain name.

A 30-second version of Emma's

Squarespace ad will air between the first and second quarters of Super Bowl LX on Sunday.

Filming the commercial led to Emma wondering why she hadn't bought her own website name beforehand, and the star admitted it was a "lack of foresight" on her part.

She said: "I don't know what I never actually did that.

Squarespace kind of had to deal with my lack of foresight.

"So I'm very grateful they did or else the commercial really would not have worked.

"It would have been weird if you went to EmmaStone.com and it was ... I don't even know what might have been going on over there."

Elton John accuses UK tabloids publisher of 'abhorrent' privacy breaches

Pop icon Elton John yesterday accused the publisher of two UK tabloids of "abhorrent" privacy invasions "outside even the most basic standards of human decency" as he testified at London's High Court.

Giving evidence in the joint legal action against Associated Newspapers Ltd (ANL) -- the publisher of the Daily Mail and The Mail on Sunday -- John claimed the papers had unlawfully accessed his and his family's medical records.

Other complainants in the case include Prince Harry, King Charles III's younger son, and actor Liz Hurley.

"I have found The Mail's deliberate invasion into my medical health and medical details surrounding the birth of our son Zachary abhorrent and outside even the most basic standards of human decency," John wrote in a witness statement released as he began testifying by video link.

Wearing a green blazer and purple tie, the 78-year-old

musician who has a rocky relationship with British tabloids appeared furious while giving evidence.

He and his husband David Furnish -- who testified on Thursday -- accuse the UK publisher of using unlawful means to gather information used in 10 articles between 2000 and 2015.

ANL has strongly denied claims made against its journalism calling them "lurid" and "preposterous".

Hurley, a friend of the couple, and Prince Harry each took the stand in the first two weeks of the trial.

The seven claimants suing ANL also include actor Sadie Frost, and two other public figures.

The case "contains the most horrendous things in the world that you can ever suffer from a privacy point of view," John told the trial, which is in its third week and expected to last until March.

The "Rocket Man" singer alleged that all three of the family's landlines "were hacked, including the junction box at the end of the road".

Kristen Stewart feels "haunted" by Princess Diana, and the mere thought of the late royal leaves her in tears "at any moment".

The 35-year-old actress and director portrayed the late Princess of Wales - who died in a car accident in Paris in 1997,

aged 36 - in 2021 psychological drama film Spencer, and now whenever Kristen thinks about Diana she becomes emotional.

Kristen also told how she cannot drive around London or Paris without thoughts of Diana invading her mind.

Speaking about being "haunted" by Diana, she told the Daily Telegraph newspaper: "I still

am. "I can't drive round this city, and Paris for that matter, without thinking about her. All the love that poured out of this woman... I can cry about her at any moment."

The 5ft 5in American star thought Spencer director Pablo Larrañaga was "insane" for casting her as the British royal, and

he pleaded with the filmmaker to cast someone else - but he refused.
