



Bahrain skies set for rare lunar eclipse tonight

Bahrain and the Arabian Gulf will witness tonight a rare total lunar eclipse.

Astronomers call it one of the year's most significant celestial events, lasting five hours and 27 minutes.

The moon rises at 5:44 p.m., enters Earth's penumbra at 6:28 p.m., and the partial eclipse begins at 7:27 p.m.

The total eclipse starts at 8:30 p.m., peaking at 9:11 p.m., turning the moon dark red, before fading by 11:55 p.m. **(Detailed report on Page 3)**

17-year-old held in France for 'plotting attacks'

French authorities have detained a 17-year-old on suspicion of plotting attacks against embassies or official buildings, sources close to the investigation said yesterday.

The teen was formally put under investigation and locked up on Friday, they said, confirming information first given by Le Parisien daily.

He was arrested on Monday at his parents' home where he lived in the western Sarthe region and suffered light injuries as he tried to escape police.

Bahrain Adopts AI Policing

Crackdowns show results as fugitives arrested

● AI to combat transnational crime

● 9 arrests and 17 extraditions

● 96 AML intel exchanges

Bahrain is taking international policing into the age of artificial intelligence. On the eve of the International Day of Police Cooperation, His Excellency Lieutenant-General Shaikh Rashid bin Abdullah Al Khalifa, the Minister of Interior, stressed that modern technologies and AI applications are now central to tackling organised crime across borders.

The Minister said that comprehensive security cooperation, powered by advanced technology, was essential to outpace criminals operating on a global scale. H.E. noted that the Ministry's approach follows the directives of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa, with the support of the government led by His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, Crown Prince and Prime Minister.

Concrete results

The Interior Minister's remarks were not just forward-looking rhetoric. Bahrain has already handed over nine internationally wanted individuals to requesting countries, while 17 fugitives were extradited from abroad.

In drug enforcement, the General Department of Criminal Investigations and Evidence exchanged 97 intelligence reports

with 12 countries, carried out 18 operations in partnership with seven nations, and intercepted four people at border crossings with narcotics.

The National Financial Investigation Center also exchanged 96 separate pieces of information with foreign counterparts in efforts to combat money laun-

dering and terrorist financing.

The Minister underlined that modern tools can sharpen the speed and accuracy of information sharing, a vital factor in

today's interconnected policing environment. H.E. highlighted Bahrain's alignment with the goals of INTERPOL and the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, positioning the Kingdom's initiatives within a global security framework.

Bahrain also paid tribute to the role of INTERPOL in supporting police worldwide, affirming its commitment to deeper collaboration with international organisations.

Future direction

The Ministry also pledged to continue enhancing the use of AI and emerging technologies in law enforcement, with the goal of faster response and more effective international coordination. Officials said Bahrain's ongoing contribution to INTERPOL networks would help cut crime rates and reinforce global stability.

Israel 'warning'

Gaza residents must leave for 'humanitarian zone'

The Israeli army urged Gaza City residents to leave for a "humanitarian zone" in the south yesterday ahead of a planned offensive to capture the territory's largest urban centre.

In a message to the city's residents posted on social media, army spokesman Avichay Adraee said: "Take this opportunity to move early to the (Al-Mawasi) humanitarian zone and join the thousands of people who have already gone there."

Adraee did not specify when

the new offensive would start, and another spokesman has previously said it would not be announced in advance to preserve the element of surprise.

The UN estimates there are about a million people in and around Gaza City, warning of a coming "disaster" if the Israeli military goes ahead with its plans to seize the city.

Israel has come under mounting pressure at home and abroad to call off the offensive and end the war in Gaza.

Its foe Hamas agreed to a ceasefire proposal last month

that involved a temporary truce and the staggered release of hostages held in Gaza.

Israel, however, has demanded the Palestinian group release all the hostages at once, lay down its arms and give up control of Gaza, among other conditions.

In a separate statement yesterday, the military said the humanitarian zone in the south had essential "infrastructure such as field hospitals, water pipelines, and desalination facilities, alongside the continued supply of food, tents, medicines, and medical equipment".

Bahrain, Azerbaijan to boost cooperation

● **Exchanging expertise in using AI for parliamentary work**

Bahrain and Azerbaijan, have discussed means of enhancing parliamentary cooperation and exchanging expertise. This came as His Excellency Mohammed Ibrahim Al Sisi Al Buainain, Secretary General of the Council of Representatives, met with Farid Hajiyeve, Head of the Civil Service and HR Department of the Milli Majlis of the Republic of Azerbaijan, at

the National Assembly headquarters. They reviewed the longstanding relations between the Kingdom of Bahrain and Azerbaijan, emphasising that these ties are supported by His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa and Azerbaijan President Ilham Aliyev, and by their commitment to advancing cooperation on all levels. Al Buainain highlighted the Council's efforts to develop partnership with the Milli Majlis, noting plans to expand cooperation in domains such as artificial intelligence for parliamentary work, digital archiving and smart legislative systems, and environmental sustainability. He outlined the Kingdom's experience in becoming the first

Hajj registration opens

● **More than 12,000 Bahraini citizens file preliminary applications within hours**

Registration for next season's Hajj opened on the official platform, and more than 12,000 citizens filed preliminary applications within hours. About 67 licensed campaigns are competing for the 1447 AH-2026 season. Initial applications run until 16 September, after which accepted applicants choose the campaign they wish to join. The launch set off a rush of adverts across social media. Operators pushed out short films, simple guides and offers on lodging, transport and hospitality. New entrants have joined in, which has sharpened the contest for bookings. Campaign owners say more than 25 operators may be unable to run trips this year given Bahrain's quota of 4,625 pilgrims.

Some struggled last season to reach the minimum of 90 pilgrims needed to operate, which explains the early push to secure names. Marketing has shifted towards clear, youth-minded messages that spell out services, prices and accommodation locations. Some operators are offering instalment plans aimed at lower-income pilgrims. Others trail steep conditional cuts, such as when four women register together with a permitted mahram, bringing the price down by more than 80 per cent. Some rely on social-media

personalities, while others prefer religious scholars to build trust. Interest from citizens and residents is rising, with early reservations reported alongside last season's facilitation measures and service levels cited by many campaigns. **Prices and schedules** With less than two weeks before applications close, prices and schedules are now public. First departures are due on 14 May 2026 with returns on 31 May. Announced prices vary by mode of travel and service tier, starting at about BD1,840 and rising above BD2,300.

Bahrain's Attorney General Dr. Ali bin Fadhel Al Buainain set a new direction for Arab judicial cooperation by proposing an annual legal research award at the fifth annual meeting of the Arab Public Prosecutors Association in Oman on September 2nd to 3rd.

The Attorney General said the award would recognize the best legal research from members of Arab prosecution offices, with emphasis on the significance of the subject and its potential benefits. He added that outstanding works would be disseminated on international platforms to boost knowledge exchange and strengthen regional legal systems.

Knowledge focus

In his opening remarks, Dr. Al Buainain praised the strong ties among Arab prosecution offices and stressed the importance of exchanging expertise and adopting the latest technologies to confront crime. He called for expanding cultural resources in the social and economic fields, saying that broader knowledge improves prosecutors' ability to evaluate matters correctly and serve the public interest.

Expanding cooperation

The Attorney General commended the steps taken by the association in recent years to advance the technical and technological capacities of public prosecution offices. Crypto crimes spotlight

On the sidelines of the meeting, prosecutors and experts held a symposium on cryptocurrency-related crimes and evidence seizure. The Kingdom of Bahrain's Public Prosecution presented its experience in investigating such crimes, sharing methods of collecting digital evidence and pursuing financial offenses.

The two-day summit concluded with a call to reinforce cooperation, share best practices, and adopt innovative approaches to strengthen Arab judicial systems in the face of evolving crime.

Bahrain set to witness rare total lunar eclipse lasting more than five hours

● Most significant celestial event to happen this year

The skies of Bahrain and the Arabian Gulf will light up with a rare astronomical spectacle tonight as a total lunar eclipse coincides with the full moon of Rabi' al-Awwal 1447 AH.

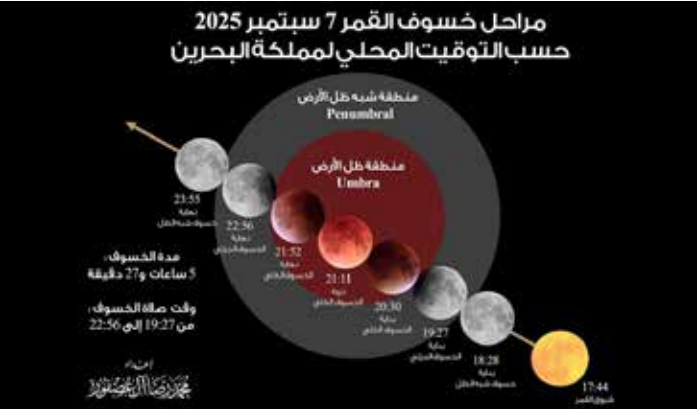
Astronomers say it will be one of the most significant celestial events of the year.

According to astronomer Mohammed Redha Al Asfour, the eclipse will last 5 hours and 27 minutes in all its stages, making it a long and striking occurrence.

The moon will rise at 5:44 p.m. local time and begin entering Earth's penumbra at 6:28 p.m.

The partial eclipse will follow at 7:27 p.m., leading to the total eclipse at 8:30 p.m., when the moon will turn a dramatic dark red due to the refraction of sunlight through Earth's atmosphere.

The eclipse will reach its peak at 9:11 p.m. before gradually

fading. The total phase ends at 9:52 p.m., with the moon leaving Earth's umbra at 10:56 p.m. and the penumbra at 11:55 p.m.

Adding to the uniqueness of the event, Saturn will appear alongside the moon throughout the eclipse, creating an excep-

tional viewing experience for skywatchers.

Al Asfour noted that the recommended time for the special eclipse prayer extends from the start of the partial eclipse at 7:27 p.m. until 10:56 p.m., a span of 3 hours and 29 minutes.

Calls for mosques to hold eclipse prayer

The General Administration of Sunni Endowments has invited mosque imams across the Kingdom to lead the special eclipse prayer this evening, coinciding with a rare total lunar eclipse.

The astronomical event will take place on Rabi' al-Awwal 15, 1447 AH, corresponding to September 7, 2025.

Expected to begin at 7:28 p.m., the eclipse will continue until 10:56 p.m., reaching its peak at 9:11 p.m.

The Endowments administration instructed imams to perform the prayer once the eclipse is sighted and confirmed.

Prophetic guidance

It also reminded worshippers

of the importance of following prophetic guidance in observing this prayer and reflecting on its spiritual meaning.

The statement further emphasised that the eclipse prayer highlights the great objectives and lessons of Islamic law, encouraging believers to seize the opportunity for worship and contemplation during this extraordinary celestial event.



The total eclipse will occur at 8:30 p.m. when the moon will turn a dramatic dark red due to the refraction of sunlight through Earth's atmosphere.

He explained that a lunar eclipse occurs when Earth's shadow blocks sunlight from reaching the moon as the Earth aligns directly between the sun and the moon.

This will be the first total lunar eclipse visible in Bahrain since July 2018 and will not be seen again until December 31, 2028.

Al Asfour urged astronomy enthusiasts and photographers to seize the opportunity to observe and document the rare phenomenon, emphasizing that the eclipse is safe to view with the naked eye.

Kingdom first in Middle East for ores and metals exports

Bahrain tops the Middle East for exports of ores and metals, with the category making up 54 per cent of the Kingdom's total merchandise exports, according to international trade data.

The share is well ahead of every other country in the region.

The figures show the weight of extractive and basic metal industries in Bahrain's export mix, led by the aluminium cluster centred on Aluminium Bahrain (Alba), along with iron and metal alloys.

These lines feed global mar-

kets with high value goods.

Across the region, Palestine placed second on 15.91 per cent. Jordan ranked third with 9.38 per cent, backed by phosphate and potash. Lebanon followed on 8.60 per cent.

Next came Iran on 6.47 per cent, Oman 6.45 per cent, Egypt 4.71 per cent, the UAE 4.53 per cent, Turkey 4.37 per cent and Cyprus 4.01 per cent.

Syria recorded 2.66 per cent, Qatar 2.33 per cent, Saudi Arabia 1.57 per cent and Kuwait 0.07 per cent.

The spread points to varied economic structures across these states, with some relying more on energy and services.

Bahrain Triples Qualifications

● Qualifications tripled in year

Bahrain has made a dramatic leap in education quality oversight, with the number of accredited qualifications tripling in just one year, according to the Education and Training Quality Authority (BQA) 2024-2025 performance report.

The report, released under the leadership of BQA Chief Executive Officer Dr. Mariam Hassan Mustafa, credited the Kingdom's progress to the vi-

sion of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa and the directives of His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister. Dr. Mustafa affirmed that investing in national competencies remains

the cornerstone for a more sustainable and prosperous future.

The report reviewed 76 public schools and 23 private schools, noting improvements across several institutions. Twenty-four public schools registered significant gains while 45 maintained their ratings. Eleven private schools improved their performance scores and seven others remained steady.

Kindergarten reviews were conducted for the first time, covering 22 institutions. The findings highlighted effective practices in children's social development and learning environments, with recommendations to strengthen child-initiated guided play.

The Minister of Municipalities and Agriculture has announced that the Riffa Walkway development project has reached 60 percent completion, with full delivery set by the end of this year.

Major upgrade

H.E. Wael bin Nasser Al Mubarak toured the site in the Southern Governorate, accompanied by senior officials including Undersecretary for Municipal Affairs Shaikh Mohammed bin Ahmed Al Khalifa and Southern Municipal Council chairman Abdullah Ibrahim Abdul Latif. The project, covering 36,018 square metres, will add significant recreational and service facilities once complete.

The revamp includes rehabilitated canopies, play-

grounds, lighting and public facilities, plus modern sports equipment. Asphalt repaving and painting works are under way, alongside landscaping improvements, with 400 new trees

opment momentum and provide residents with high-quality facilities. Council chairman Abdul Latif described the walkway as a vital destination for both locals and visitors, adding that

the upgrade directly responds to community calls for a better environment for sports and recreation.

According to the ministry, walkways remain a priority for development, with intensified greening programmes and service integration under way across parks, coasts and sports spaces. The Riffa project, officials say, will stand out as a model hub once completed by year-end.

88 postal operators suspend services to US over tariffs: UN

Postal traffic to the United States plunged more than 80 percent following Washington's imposition of new tariffs, with 88 operators worldwide fully or partially suspending services, the Universal Postal Union said yesterday.

The UPU, the United Nations' postal cooperation agency, is working on "the rapid development of a new technical solution that will help get mail moving to the United States again", its director general Masahiko Metoki

said in a statement.

US President Donald Trump's administration announced in late July that it was abolishing a tax exemption on small packages entering the United States from August 29.

The move sparked a flurry of announcements from postal services, including in Australia, Britain, France, Germany, India, Italy and Japan, that most US-bound packages would no longer be accepted.

The UPU said data exchanged between postal operators via its electronic network showed that

traffic to the United States was down 81 percent on August 29, compared to a week earlier.

"Furthermore, 88 postal operators informed the UPU they have suspended some or all postal services to the US until a solution is implemented," it said.

These included Germany's Deutsche Post, Britain's Royal Mail and two operators in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Based in the Swiss capital Bern, the UPU was established in 1874 and counts 192 member states. It sets the rules for international mail exchanges and makes recommendations to improve services.

Anthropic to pay \$1.5 bn over pirated books

Anthropic will pay at least \$1.5 billion to settle a US class action lawsuit over allegedly using pirated books to train its artificial intelligence models, according to court documents filed yesterday.

"This landmark settlement far surpasses any other known copyright recovery," said plaintiffs' attorney Justin Nelson. "It is the first of its kind in the AI era."

The settlement stems from a class-action lawsuit filed by

authors Andrea Bartz, Charles Graeber, and Kirk Wallace Johnson, who accused Anthropic of illegally copying their books to train Claude, the company's AI chatbot that rivals ChatGPT.

In a partial victory for Anthropic, US District Court Judge William Alsup ruled in June that the company's training of its Claude AI models with books -- whether bought or pirated -- so transformed the works that it constituted "fair use" under the law.

Matching training to the 21st century workplace

The tiny Egyptian clover bird lives with the fearsome Nile crocodile, entering its mouth to clean it's teeth for food and parasites. It is one creature that the croc never tries to crush between its powerful jaws. Sometime back, I remember seeing a cartoon in a HR magazine about inappropriate training, where a penguin trainee is standing on the back of the croc, saying "They said there was dental work to be learnt here." It was a funny and honest comment on some of the training schemes that young people undergo through government schemes – training that takes no account of the skills of the trainee or the market needs.

As we enter the new academic year for schools, colleges and polytechnics, every institution is aligned to make the most of changing workplace trends and technology, to equip students of today for the future. While the efforts are well-intended, I find that they are not backed by extensive and rigorous research that will help shape the pedagogy of our educational institutions and also attitudes. As an Arab culture, our society still places emphasis on how parents guide their children. Most parents are fixated on the CED formula - civil services, engineering and doctor (medicine). But the world has changed enormously since our times and even my children's teenage years. I read somewhere that the children entering kindergarten today, will find 50% new kinds of work that does not even exist today. We have seen this even in our time – would you have taken careers in gaming design or fitness or event management seriously for your kids? But parents today have to change their perspective and look at these options also for their children. And so should educational and training institutions and ministries such as the Ministry of Labour – the old order has most definitely given way to the new and unless all the stakeholders are aligned, we cannot make the future of our children a winning one.

Israel flattens Gaza high-rise as it tells residents to flee

Military warns residents to flee south as planned assault on Gaza City approaches

● Second high-rise destroyed in 48 hours

An Israeli strike flattened a high-rise in Gaza City yesterday -- the second in as many days -- after the military warned people to flee south to a "humanitarian zone" ahead of a planned offensive to capture the area.

Israel has been warning for weeks of a new assault on the territory's largest urban centre, without issuing a timeline.

It has stepped up air strikes in the area and operations on the city's outskirts despite calls to abandon the plan, which has sparked widespread fears it could worsen already-dire humanitarian conditions.

Yesterday, the military announced it struck a Gaza City high-rise, saying " Hamas terrorists installed intelligence gathering equipment and positioned observation posts in the building in order to monitor" Israeli troops, adding it had taken "measures to mitigate harm to civilians".

Witnesses identified the building as the Sussi residential tower and said it was destroyed, with video shared by Israeli Defence Minister Israel Katz showing the roughly 15-storey structure buckling to the ground in a cloud of dust and smoke.

"We're continuing," Katz said in the post, after having shared a video the previous day of another Gaza City high-rise being destroyed.

The military has said that in the coming days it will target structures deemed to be used by Hamas, particularly tall buildings.

It also issued an evacuation

order for another high-rise yesterday, warning of an imminent strike and telling people to leave to the south.

A military spokesperson had earlier called on residents to leave the city for Al-Mawasi, along the southern coast, where the army said humanitarian aid and medical care would be provided.

"Take this opportunity to move early to the (Al-Mawasi) humanitarian zone and join the thousands of people who have already gone there," spokesman Avichay Adraee said on social media.

Israel first declared Al-Mawasi a safe zone early in the war, but has carried out repeated strikes on it since, saying it targeted Hamas fighters hiding among civilians.

Gaza City residents said they believed it made little difference whether they stayed or fled.

"Some say we should evacuate, others say we should stay," said Abdel Nasser Mushtaha, 48, a resident of the city's Zeitun neighbourhood now sheltering in a tent in the Rimal area.

"But everywhere in Gaza there are bombings and deaths. For

the past year-and-a-half, the worst bombings that caused massacres of civilians have been in Al-Mawasi, this so-called humanitarian zone," he added.

"It no longer makes any difference to us," said his daughter Samia Mushtaha, 20. "Wherever we go, death pursues us, whether by bombing or hunger."

US in 'deep negotiation'

Israel has faced mounting domestic and international pressure to end the nearly two-year

war in Gaza.

Its foe Hamas agreed last month to a proposal for a temporary ceasefire and staggered hostage releases, but Israel has demanded the armed group release all the hostages at once, disarm and relinquish control of Gaza, among other conditions.

At the White House on Friday, President Donald Trump said the United States was in talks with Hamas over the captives being held in Gaza.

"We're in very deep negotiation with Hamas," said Trump. "There could be some (hostages) that have recently died, is what I'm hearing. I hope that's wrong, but you have over 30 bodies in this negotiation."

Armed men took 251 hostages during the October 2023 Hamas attack on Israel that sparked the war. The Israeli military says 47 remain in Gaza, including 25 believed to be dead.

"We said let them all out right now, let them all out, and much better things will happen for them," said Trump. "But if you don't let them all out, it's going to be a tough situation, it's going to be nasty."

India's Modi says ties with US still 'very positive'

Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi said yesterday New Delhi and Washington still shared "very positive" ties, after US President Donald Trump reaffirmed their personal friendship and downplayed his earlier remarks about "losing India" to China.

Trump and Modi have shared a strong bond since the US president's first term.

"Deeply appreciate and fully

reciprocate President Trump's sentiments and positive assessment of our ties," Modi wrote on X, adding that India and the United States shared a "very positive and forward-looking comprehensive and global strategic partnership".

Earlier, Trump told reporters that he "will always be friends with Modi".

"India and the United States have a special relationship. There is nothing to worry about," Trump said.

Seoul says over 300 South Koreans held in US battery plant site raid

More than 300 South Koreans were among 475 people arrested by US immigration officials in a raid on a Hyundai-LG battery plant being built in the southern US state of Georgia, the foreign minister in Seoul said yesterday.

Steven Schrank, a Homeland Security Investigations special agent in Atlanta, earlier said Thursday's operation was the largest single site raid carried out so far under US President Donald Trump's nationwide anti-migrant drive.

The raid stemmed from a "criminal investigation into allegations of unlawful employment practices and serious federal crimes" at the Hyundai Motor-LG Energy Solution

joint venture plant in the town of Ellabell, Schrank told reporters on Friday.

"This was not an immigration operation where agents went into the premises, rounded up folks and put them on buses," he said. "This has been a multi-month criminal investigation."

Foreign Minister Cho Hyun said at an emergency meeting in Seoul that, of the 475 arrested, "more than 300 are believed to be our nationals".

"We are deeply concerned and feel a heavy sense of responsibility over this matter," Cho said, adding that he would go to Washington for talks if necessary.

Schrank said that those arrested were "illegally present in the United States" and "working unlawfully".

Versace leads crowds bidding farewell to Giorgio Armani

Thousands of mourners paid homage yesterday to Italian fashion legend Giorgio Armani, who died this week aged 91, as his coffin was put on public display in Milan.

Italian fashion icon Donatella Versace was among those who filed past Armani's closed casket at the headquarters of his multi-billion-euro lifestyle company, which marked its 50th anniversary this year.

Adorned with a bouquet of white roses, the designer's closed wooden casket was laid out in a darkened room lit by paper candles, an image of Armani shown on a big screen.

The Italian died Thursday after months of fragile health and will be laid to rest at a private funeral on Monday.

Hundreds of people queued up for the start of the two-day public viewing at the Teatro Armani, the company's minimalist but luxurious headquarters in Milan.

Among the first mourners through the door was a large group of Armani staff, all in black mourning wear and black sunglasses.

"It's so emotional," said Silvia Albonetti, an Emporio Armani saleswoman. "He was an incredible man... sometimes curt, but human."

Tributes have flooded in for Armani from across the fashion industry and also Hollywood, where his understated but exquisitely tailored creations were beloved of the A-list.

Ferrari chairman John Elkann was also among the mourners yesterday, many of whom were greeted by the coffin by Armani's partner Pantaleo Dell'Orco.

Throughout his remarkable career, Armani kept top-to-bottom control of his company as it moved from fashion into luxury hotels, cosmetics, accessories and interiors.

When he died, he was one of the richest men in the world, with a net worth estimated at \$11.8 billion, according to Forbes magazine.

Venezuela's Maduro urges dialogue after Trump threat

Venezuelan leader Nicolas Maduro on Friday called for dialogue with Washington, hours after President Donald Trump threatened to shoot down Venezuelan military jets if they pose a danger to US forces.

Tensions between the two countries soared in recent days after the Pentagon accused Venezuela of buzzing its ships in the Caribbean following a deadly US strike on an alleged Venezuelan drug boat.

"None of the differences we have and have had can lead to a military conflict," Maduro said in a message broadcast on all of Venezuela's radio and television networks.

"Venezuela has always been willing to talk, to engage in dialogue, but we demand respect," he added.

As tensions mount, Washington is deploying F-35 warplanes to Puerto Rico as part of Trump's war on drug cartels.

The 10 aircraft will join US warships already present in the southern Caribbean as Trump steps up pressure on Maduro, whom the United States accuses of leading a drug cartel.

US Navy SEALs botched secret 2019 mission in North Korea: report

Elite US Navy SEALs launched an audacious operation in 2019 to plant a listening device in North Korea to spy on the country's reclusive leader Kim Jong Un, the New York Times reported Friday, but the mission quickly unraveled and culminated in the deaths of multiple civilians.

The operation came in the first administration of President Donald Trump during sensitive nuclear talks with Kim, whom the US leader met three times.

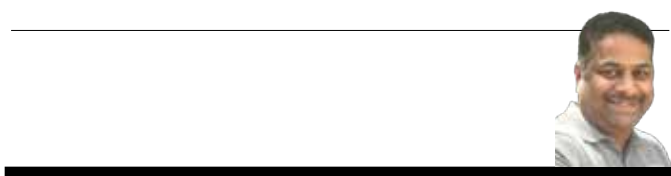
The mission was considered so risky that it required direct presidential approval, the Times said, but Trump insisted Friday he had no knowledge of the operation.

"I don't know anything about it. I'm hearing it now for the first time," the president told journalists.

Despite months of practice, the mission still went horribly wrong, the Times reported.

Flexfuels Can Power Future Mobility of Bahrain

Flex fuels or flexible fuels and biofuels are rapidly gaining attention around the world today as environmentally conscious consumers and carbon-footprint aware governments and organisations are increasingly including flex fuels in the future policies and planning. Flex fuels are those that can be used in automobiles whose engines are designed to run on a variety of gasoline-ethanol blends, most commonly up to E85 (85% ethanol, 15% gasoline). These engines have sensors and control systems that automatically adjust to the fuel mixture, optimising performance and emissions for different blends. Flex fuel technology needs changes in automotive engine design which in turn can help progress towards environmentally sustainable transportation.

Currently the majority of Bahrain's transportation needs are catered to by fossil fuels. But proactive initiatives by Bahrain have also helped in ramp up renewable fuel production, especially ethanol. Ethanol plays a very vital role in establishing a flex fuel system and thanks to policies such as the Renewable Energy Law and National Energy Efficiency Action Plan, Bahrain has accelerated ethanol production. Moreover the increasing demand for renewable fuels and support for sustainable energy has helped encourage advancements in production technology which is expected to grow at a significant compound annual growth rate of 8.2% between 2024 and 2030.

Bahrain's ethanol production is anticipated to progress well in the coming years, underpinned by increasing trends towards sustainability and technological advancements in biofuel production. Expanding feedstock diversification and continual innovation in processing techniques present significant opportunities for ethanol. Additionally, ongoing governmental support and rising local demand for cleaner fuel alternatives position the market future positively, despite potential challenges in raw material supply.

In order for a renewable fuel to successfully emerge as a viable and sustainable alternative to fossil fuel, the steady supply of the same is critical. In light of the inherent supply challenges existing in ethanol, Bahrain has done well to align its focus on used cooking oil (UCO) and date palm waste (DPW) to turn them zero-carbon diesel alternative and biofuel respectively. Purely from uninterrupted supply point of view, the locally produced and environmentally friendly fuel sources such as UCO and DPW are the need of the hour. Scientific studies have shown the possibility of extracting biofuel oil from the nuclei of date palms, a resource-rich waste product in Bahrain, suggesting a path for local biofuel production from agricultural waste.

“scary” and “freeing”. Johnson, 53, told Vanity Fair magazine: “You have to be willing to tap into all the stuff that you’ve gone through, and this was stuff that I had not explored on camera or otherwise. “I’m not a big therapy person, even though I’m an advocate for whatever it is you need. I found it so scary, but also, so nourishing and freeing. I ripped it open.” The Smashing Machine tells the story of Kerr’s rise to fame and his battle with substance abuse, and Johnson - who got

to know Kerr during his time as a wrestler - admits the story resonated with him. He told the publication: “I lost a lot of my friends to addiction and to suicide - in the late ’90s, early-to-mid 2000s, there were a lot of untimely, very early deaths.” Johnson added of the nerves he felt taking on the role: “It was very real. I had not experienced that in a very, very, very long time, where I was really scared and thinking, I don’t know if I can do this. Can I do this?

“I realized that maybe these opportunities weren’t coming my way because I was too scared to explore this stuff.” The Smashing Machine is due for release in October. It comes after Johnson previously opened up about his tactic for dealing with “screwy or wobbly” moments in life, insisting he tries to focus on the positive. He told ‘Extra’: “I think, trying to find joy around every corner, even if things are a little

screwy or wobbly, maybe in real life. “So, I’ve had a tendency over the years to not sweep it under the carpet but just, I know funky s*** is going on and I’m dealing with it, but let me try and find a place over here where I can be happy or smile or try and access some happy and joy. “I find myself doing that. It helps me deal with the not-joyous stuff.”

And once you let all that go, then you can really start.” Channing thinks his acting has actually benefited from the ups and downs he’s been through in his personal life. The movie star - who was married to actress Jenna Dewan between 2009 and 2019 - explained: “I’ve lived six or seven different lives. “Life gives you fuel. If you’ve really been heartbroken, and really been

in pain, and felt real, true aloneness ... I’ve experienced enough life that I have something to offer. The technique, and the ability to actually deliver.” Channing took a hiatus from leading film roles for nearly five years, starting around 2017, and the actor previously suggested that he benefited from the break. Channing confessed that his old work schedule was simply “untenable”. He told People in 2022: “I don’t have this grand plan, I don’t think I ever really did have a grand plan.

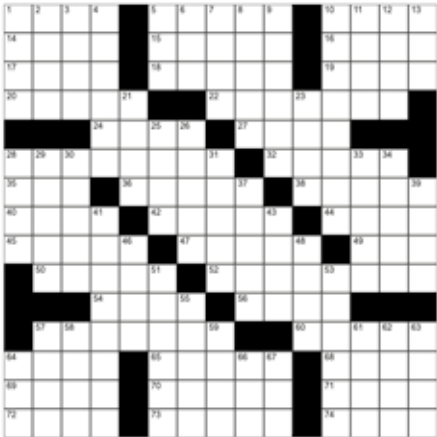

Marc Marquez continued his winning streak with a Catalunya MotoGP Sprint victory yesterday after his brother Alex Marquez crashed out in the lead.

Polesitter Alex Marquez was comfortably ahead on his Gresini Ducati but came to grief with four laps to go, allowing his older sibling to record a 14th triumph in 15 Sprint races this season. Alex claimed the other at Silverstone.

Alex Marquez flung his arms up and down in frustration in front of his home fans after picking himself up off the gravel, as six-time world champion Marc Marquez extended his overall lead to 187 points over his brother in second.

Fabio Quartararo came second in the sprint with Fabio Di Giannantonio third.

Marc Marquez's victory

"When Alex went down, I had thrown in the towel because he was going faster, but maybe at that moment he relaxed and the fall happened.

"He is still the favourite for tomorrow because he has the best pace."

Pedro Acosta on a KTM to stay behind his brother, who seemed untouchable until crashing on turn 10 of the ninth lap.

That allowed Yamaha rider Quartararo to come in second, 1.299s behind Marc Marquez.

Quartararo said that finishing second "means a lot for us, above all to be here fighting with the Marquez brothers.

"This result makes me feel very happy because we came from two very difficult races and I'm really pleased."

Last year's champion Jorge Martin, still looking for his best form after injury troubles, crashed out of the race in a collision with Franco Morbidelli in lap seven.

Francesco Bagnaia started in 21st on the grid, after his worst qualifying performance since 2022, and finished 14th.

Bahrain's under-23 Olympic football team reignited their AFC U23 Asian Cup 2026 qualifying campaign with a ruthless 10-0 win over Brunei Darussalam in Doha yesterday.

After a disappointing 0-2 defeat to India in their opening match, the young Bahrainis produced a relentless attacking display at Suheim Bin Hamad Stadium to claim their first points in Group H and keep their qualification hopes alive.

Five goals came in a sensational first half. Abdulla Obaidli struck twice, opening the scoring in just the third minute before adding a second midway through the half. Saud Mohsin, Abdulrahman Al Khayyat, and captain Mubarak Mohammed also found the net before the break to put Bahrain firmly in

control.

The scoring didn't stop there. Mohammed added his second goal in the 48th minute, Sayed Mahmood AlMoosawi made it seven in the 61st, Khalid Khalaf struck in the 71st, and Abdulla AlSubaiei rounded off the rout with goals in the 87th and 96th minutes.

The win was a welcome response for head coach Ali Abdulmajeed and his side, who had been under pressure to deliver following the setback against India. It also gave them a huge boost in goal difference, which is a factor that could prove decisive

Group H is now finely poised. Hosts Qatar lead the standings with two wins from two, after they beat India yesterday. Bahrain sit second with three points, level with India but ahead on goal difference thanks to their 10-0 thrashing of Brunei. Brunei are bottom of the group with no

points after suffering two heavy defeats.

Bahrain's win keeps them in contention to top Group H or at least finish among the four best

Bahrain's run at the FIBA U16 Asia Cup 2025 suffered another setback yesterday in Ulaanbaatar, with a heavy 95-62 defeat to Iran in the 5-8 classification stage. The result dropped Bahrain into today's 7th-8th place play-off against Chinese Taipei at 6:30 AM (BH time), while Iran advanced to contest 5th place against Korea.

Iran Dictates from the Outset

Iran seized control early, outscoring Bahrain 20-18 in the first quarter and 23-14 in the second. By halftime, the gap had widened to 43-32, as Bahrain struggled to match Iran's pace and rebounding. The third frame offered little respite, and Iran's dominant 30-11 fourth quarter sealed the 33-point victory.

Yasin MorovatHalabi led Iran with 23 points and 9 rebounds, ably supported by Alireza Rashidi's playmaking and defensive presence. Bahrain leaned heavily on Hassan Abdulkadir once more, who posted 20 points, 13 rebounds, and

5 assists, but lacked consistent support from teammates.

The Iranis will now play for 5th place against Korea at 9am today.

Q2: Iran Capitalizes on Errors

Bahrain briefly pulled within one at 23-22 after Hassan Abdulkadir and Ali AlHaddad scored inside. Yet Iran answered with an 11-0 run fueled by consecutive turnovers, capped by a Khosravi dunk. By halftime, Iran led 43-32, having forced Bahrain into rushed possessions and poor spacing.

Q3: MorovatHalabi Extends Control

The third quarter saw Yasin MorovatHalabi seize the spotlight. His perimeter shooting and drives inside extended Iran's cushion to 57-42. Bahrain found some relief through Mohamed Adel Abdulla's late three-pointer, but Iran's ability to punish every defensive lapse

ensured a 65-51 lead heading into the final frame.

Q4: Iran Closes Ruthlessly

Iran's fourth quarter was a masterclass in transition dominance. Back-to-back scores from Khosravi and MorovatHalabi stretched the margin past 20. Bahrain collapsed under turnovers and fatigue, as Iran ran out 30-11 winners in the final quarter, sealing a 95-62 triumph.

Verstappen pips McLaren pair to pole at Italian GP

Max Verstappen took pole position for the Italian Grand Prix yesterday, the reigning Formula One champion giving himself a chance at Monza of slowing McLaren's domination.

Dutchman Verstappen, who has won the last four world titles, will start in the front row alongside Lando Norris who was just ahead of his McLaren teammate and championship leader Oscar Piastri.

Having led for much of Q3, Verstappen snatched back first place in the final seconds of qualifying from Norris, who has been strong this weekend and

seemed to have pipped the Red Bull man.

Verstappen completed his rapid last lap in one minute and 18.792 seconds, 0.077sec ahead of Norris and 0.190sec faster

than Piastri, who leads Norris by 34 points at the top of the drivers' standings.

Norris almost missed a top 10 spot on the grid as he sat 11th before his final lap of Q2 sent him through with time already run out.

Ferrari pair Charles Leclerc and Lewis Hamilton were fourth and fifth, although seven-time champion Hamilton has a five-place grid penalty and will struggle to bring any joy to what has been a difficult first season with the Scuderia.

Another home hope, Kimi Antonelli, will start in seventh, one place behind his Mercedes teammate George Russell.

The Bologna-born teenager,

who was announced as a Mercedes driver at Monza last year, gave himself a good chance of turning around a rotten recent run.

French pair Pierre Gasly and Isack Hadjar are at the rear of the grid after failing to get past an extremely tight Q1 in which less than a second separated all 20 cars.

Gasly, who yesterday extended his contract with Alpine until 2028, is on the back row alongside Hadjar's Racing Bulls teammate Liam Lawson.

Hadjar, a 20-year-old F1 rookie, is unlikely to repeat last weekend's feat of a podium finish after only securing 16th spot on the grid.
