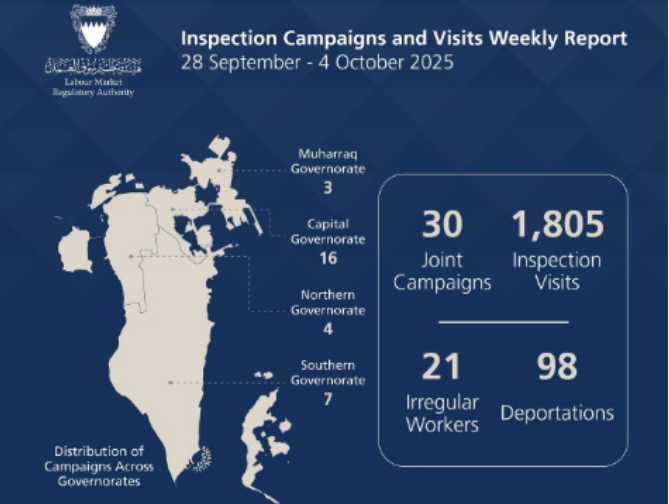

## 21 illegal workers detained and 98 violators deported

The Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) announced that 21 violating and irregular workers were detained and 98 violators deported following 1,835 inspection campaigns and visits conducted across the Kingdom between September 28 and October 4, 2025.

The inspection campaigns and visits also resulted in monitoring a number of violations related to the provisions of a number of regulating laws, especially the Labour Market Regulatory Authority and the Residency Laws in the Kingdom of Bahrain, noting that legal measures were taken regarding the observed violations.

It pointed out that 1,805 inspection visits were carried out on various shops in all governorates, in addition to 30 joint inspection campaigns, 16 campaigns in the Capital Governorate, 3 campaigns in the Muharraq Governorate, 4 campaigns in the Northern Governorate and 7 campaigns in the Southern Governorate.

The government entities that participated in the campaigns are the Ministry of Interior, represented by the Nationality, Passports and Residence Affairs (NPRA), the Governorate's respective Police Directorate and the General Directorate of Verdict Enforcement and Alternative Sentencing, as well as the Social Insurance Organization and the Bahrain Tourism and Exhibitions Authority.

**T**he Telecommunications Regulatory Authority (TRA) of the Kingdom of Bahrain has announced the publication of its “Guidelines for Reducing Fraudulent SMS”, developed in close collaboration with the Kingdom’s mobile network operators (MNOs).

This initiative follows the formation of a strategic working group by the TRA and the operators to collectively address key online safety issues impacting mobile users. Through this joint effort, it was identified that fraudulent SMS—used in scams targeting consumers—poses a significant and growing threat to users in Bahrain.

The new guidelines provide operators with clear measures and technical requirements to detect, block,

and mitigate fraudulent SMS activity, ensuring consumers are better protected from scams. They also include provisions for user education, reporting mechanisms, and compliance with Bahrain’s regulatory and data protection laws.

# OpenAI signs multi-billion dollar chip deal with AMD

OpenAI signed a multi-year partnership Monday with chipmaker Advanced Micro Devices as the ChatGPT-maker continues an investment spree to secure massive amounts of computing power for rolling out generative artificial intelligence. The companies announced

the plan to develop AI data centers that the chipmaker said would bring in tens of billions of dollars in new revenue over the next five years.

AMD's share price surged 35 percent when markets opened on news of the agreement that would see the company deliver six gigawatts worth of chips to the ChatGPT-maker.

OpenAI sits at the center of an AI investment bonanza to power the promised artificial intelligence revolution.

It oversees the Stargate project, which has secured \$400 billion of the \$500 billion planned by 2029 for giant data centers in Texas, New Mexico and an undisclosed site in the US Midwest. The deal with AMD fol-

lows a contract with Nvidia for more than \$100 billion in equipment intended to increase OpenAI's generative AI capabilities.

Nvidia's graphics processing units (GPUs) are by far the dominant player in the AI field, with its products integrated into the company's software ecosystem, making it harder for rivals to

compete.

"This is all incremental to our work with NVIDIA (and we plan to increase our NVIDIA purchasing over time). The world needs much more compute..." wrote OpenAI CEO Sam Altman on X.

California-based AMD generates the bulk of its revenue from CPU sales -- processors used for

personal and business computers that are less powerful than GPUs.

Data server giant Oracle saw its share price skyrocket by 35 percent last month when it announced its own deal with OpenAI.

OpenAI also signed a chip deal with South Korea's Samsung and SK Hynix.

# Paris stocks slide as French PM resigns, Tokyo soars

Stock markets diverged yesterday as a deepening political crisis in France sent Paris into a tailspin while a new Japanese ruling party leader buoyed shares in Tokyo.

Gold pushed ever closer to \$4,000 an ounce as the US government shutdown and expected interest cuts from the Federal Reserve boosted the precious metal's attractiveness.

The euro fell against main rivals and French borrowing costs spiked as Sebastian Lecornu, who had been prime minister for less than a month, resigned just 14 hours after naming a largely unchanged cabinet.

France's "fractured parlia-

ment is making it nearly impossible to pass a budget that reduces the fiscal deficit", said Jack Allen-Reynolds, deputy chief eurozone economist at Capital Economics.

"With government borrowing running at more than 5% of GDP and the debt ratio rising, the risk premium on French government bonds will continue to widen," he added.

Shares in French banks BNP Paribas, Societe Generale and Credit Agricole all shed more than three%.

London also dipped but Frankfurt's stock exchange ended the day flat.

On Wall Street, both the S&P 500 and tech-heavy Nasdaq Composite sat next to record

highs as AI deals overshadowed concerns over a government shutdown that dragged into a second week.

Shares in Advanced Micro Devices (AMD) jumped more than 33% after the chipmaker announced a multi-year partnership with OpenAI to develop AI data centres which should bring it tens of billions of dollars in new revenue over the next five years.

In Asia, Tokyo surged almost 5% to a record high and the yen sank on bets the new leader of Japan's ruling party will loosen monetary policy to kickstart the economy.

Sanae Takaichi, likely to become Japan's prime minister this month, has previously

backed aggressive monetary easing and expanded government spending.

Traders are "enthused by the new Japanese leader, who promises to reignite stimulus to light a fire under the Japanese economy," said Chris Beauchamp, chief market analyst at trading platform IG.

The yen weakened more than 1% against the dollar and hit a record low against the euro.

Yields on 30-year Japanese bonds rose sharply reflecting fears the country's already colossal debt will balloon further.

After her victory Saturday, Takaichi pledged first to implement measures to address inflation and boost Japan's economy, rural areas and primary industries.

"She has said that the Bank of Japan should not raise interest rates, which is feeding demand for stocks and weighing on long term bond yield," said Kathleen Brooks, research director at trading group XTB.

"The decline in the yen is also a sign that the market is pricing out the prospect of BoJ rate hikes this year," she added.

Oil prices jumped nearly 1% after OPEC+ agreed at the weekend to boost supplies by 137,000 barrels a day -- less than initially expected.

"The limited supply adjustment was seen as a supportive move that would help offset a glut in the oil market while still signalling confidence in global demand levels," said Trade Nation analyst David Morrison.

# U and Morocco tweak trade deal covering W. Sahara

The European Union and Morocco have agreed to alter a trade deal to cover imports from the disputed Western Sahara region, Brussels said yesterday.

The move comes after the EU's top court last year ordered the farm produce agreement to be scrapped after a challenge from Western Saharan independence movement the Polisario Front.

The new deal means that goods coming from the region

will now have to clearly specify their origin to receive preferential tariffs.

In its 2024 judgement, the ECJ said product labels "must indicate Western Sahara alone as the country of origin of those goods, to the exclusion of any reference to Morocco, so as to avoid misleading consumers as to the true origin of those goods".

Morocco, an important trading partner with the 27-nation EU, views the Western Sahara as an integral part of its territory.

# Surging numbers of children using e-cigarettes: WHO

E-cigarettes are fuelling an "alarming" new wave of nicotine addiction, with millions of children now hooked on vaping, the World Health Organization warned Monday.

In countries that have the data, children are on average nine times more likely than adults to vape, the WHO said.

The UN health agency said the industry was promoting vapes as supposedly less harmful products than cigarettes -- but in fact was aggressively targeting young people and getting children addicted.

More than 100 million people are vaping, according to the WHO's first global estimate of e-cigarette use.

"The numbers are alarming," the agency said.

They include at least 86 million adults, mostly in high-income countries, and at least 15

million children aged 13 to 15.

"E-cigarettes are fuelling a new wave of nicotine addiction," Etienne Krug, the WHO's director of health determinants, promotion and prevention, said in a statement.

"They are marketed as harm reduction but, in reality, are hooking kids on nicotine earlier and risk undermining decades of progress."

Globally, people are smoking less, with the number of tobacco users dropping from 1.38 billion in 2000 to 1.2 billion in 2024, while the world's population has swelled.

## Brazil's Lula asks Trump to remove tariffs in 'friendly' phone call

Brasília, Brazil

**P**resident Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva on Monday urged US President Donald Trump to remove punitive tariffs on Brazil in the first-ever official talks between the two leaders.

After months of diplomatic animosity, Lula and Trump spoke for 30 minutes in a "friendly tone" and Lula raised the possibility of an in-person meeting in Malaysia next month, the Brazilian presidency said in a statement.

Lula "requested the removal" of tariffs imposed on his country's products and sanctions against Brazilian officials.

Diplomatic ties have become increasingly strained between Washington and Brasilia in recent months, with Trump angered over the trial and conviction of his ally, the far-right former president Jair Bolsonaro.

Trump has imposed a 50-percent tariff on Brazilian products and imposed sanctions against several top officials, including a top Supreme Court judge, to punish Brazil for what he termed a "witch hunt" against Bolsonaro.

The phone call came after what first appeared to be a chance encounter on the sidelines of the UN General Assembly last month that led Trump to hail his "excellent chemistry" with Lula.

# US government shutdown enters second week

● **Republicans are digging in their heels, with House Speaker Mike Johnson telling his members not even to come to Congress unless the Democrats cave.**

**T**he US government shutdown entered its second week yesterday, with no sign of a deal between President Donald Trump's Republicans and Democrats to end the crisis.

Democrats are refusing to provide the handful of votes the ruling Republicans need to reopen federal departments unless the two sides can agree on extending expiring "Obamacare" health care subsidies.

With the government out of money since Wednesday and grinding to a halt, Senate Democrats looked set to vote against a House-passed temporary funding bill for a fifth time.

The hard line taken by Democrats marks a rare moment of leverage for the opposition party in a period when Trump and his

ultra-loyal Republicans control every branch of government -- and Trump himself is accused of seeking to amass authoritarian-like powers.

With funding not renewed, non-critical services are being suspended.

Salaries for hundreds of thousands of public sector employees are set to be withheld from Friday, while military personnel could miss their first paycheck on October 15.

And Trump has radically upped the ante by threatening to fire large numbers of government employees, rather than just furlough them,

as has been done in every other shutdown over the years.

Republicans are digging in their heels, with

House Speaker Mike Johnson telling his members not even to come to Congress unless the Democrats cave.

"House Republicans think protecting the health care of everyday Americans is less important than their vacation," Democratic House Minority Leader Hakeem Jeffries said in a statement.

"We strongly disagree."

Red herring -

But Johnson said health funding was a red herring Democrats had wielded to force a shutdown, claiming to have addressed the issue in a sprawling domestic policy bill signed into law by Trump in July.

"Republicans are the party working around the clock every day to fix health care. It's not talking points for us. We've done it," Johnson told reporters at the US Capitol.

The nonpartisan Congressional Budget Office estimated that Trump's "One Big Beautiful Act" would in fact strip 11 million Americans of health care coverage, mainly through cuts to the Medicaid program for low income families.

That figure would be in addition to the four million Americans Democrats say will lose health care

next year if Obamacare health insurance subsidies are not extended -- while another 24 million Americans will see their premiums double.

Republicans argue the expiring health care subsidies are nothing to do with keeping the government open and can be dealt with separately before the end of the year.

As the shutdown begins to bite, the Environmental Protection Agency and the Education, Housing, Commerce and Labor departments have been the hardest hit by staff being furloughed -- or placed on enforced leave -- during the shutdown, The New York Times reported.

The Justice, Homeland Security and Veterans Affairs Departments, along with the Treasury and Office of Personnel Management have seen the least effects so far, according to the Times breakdown.

With members of Congress at home and no formal talks taking place in either chamber, a CBS News poll released Sunday showed the public blaming Republicans by a narrow margin for the gridlock.

Kevin Hassett, the director of the White House National Economic Council, said Sunday layoffs would begin "if the president decides that the negotiations are absolutely going nowhere." Trump has already sent a steamroller through government since taking office for his second term in January.

## Denmark to beef up checks against Russia's 'shadow fleet'

Copenhagen, Denmark

**D**enmark will step up environmental checks on oil tankers in a key shipping lane linking the Baltic and North Seas to crack down on Russia's "shadow fleet", Copenhagen said on Monday.

More than 60,000 ships sail past Skagen in north Denmark each year, of which dozens are suspected to belong to a flotilla of rickety ships used by Moscow to circumvent Western sanctions on Russia's fossil fuel exports.

The announcement comes after a vessel believed to belong to this "shadow fleet" was linked to mysterious drone sightings over Denmark last month, closing airports at a time of heightened East-West tensions over Russia's invasion of Ukraine.

"We're now reinforcing the control of basic environmental rules, so we can act in a more coherent and effective manner against petrol tankers and Russia's 'shadow fleet'," said Environment Minister Magnus Heunicke in a statement.

◆ **The United Nations'** cash-strapped refugee agency has shed nearly 5,000 jobs this year following swingeing cuts in international aid, its chief said yesterday. The UNHCR is facing a towering crisis: amid surging global displacement, humanitarian funding has been fast evaporating since US President Donald Trump returned to office in January. "Almost 5,000 UNHCR colleagues have already lost their jobs this year," Filippo Grandi said. "This is more than a quarter of our entire workforce," he said, warning that "that number is expected to grow". An agency spokesman told AFP that both full-time staff and people on temporary or consultancy contracts had lost their jobs.

afternoon prayers. Around half a dozen youngsters are still unaccounted for. "We hope we can conclude the recovery today (Monday), and we will return the bodies (to the families)," National Search and Rescue Agency (Basarnas) operations director Yudhi Bramantyo told a press conference yesterday. The collapse was Indonesia's deadliest disaster so far this year, Budi Irawan, the deputy head of the national disaster agency (BNPB), said.

Iran does not plan to immediately resume nuclear talks with European nations after they reimposed sanctions, the foreign ministry said yesterday. Britain, France and Germany, signatories to Iran's 2015 nuclear deal, reimposed sanctions on September 28, triggering in turn the return of UN sanctions under the so-called snapback mechanism. "We have no plans for negotiations at this stage," ministry spokesman Esmail Baqaei said, adding that Iran was examining the "consequences and implications" of the restart of sanctions initiated by the countries known as the E3. "Of course, diplomacy -- in the sense of maintaining contacts and consultations -- will continue," Baqaei said. "Whenever we feel that diplomacy can be effective, we will certainly make decisions based on the country's interests and priorities," he added.

**Leopard captured after wandering into Indonesian hotel**

A leopard was captured on Monday after it wandered into a hotel complex in one of Indonesia's most popular holiday destinations, sparking panic among guests.

The big cat was spotted on Monday morning outside a guest room on the second floor of a hotel in Bandung, the capital of West Java, Indonesia's most populous province.

The hotel management alerted firefighters, who then contacted the local conservation agency about the sighting. "We used a tranquiliser, and at around 10 am (0300 GMT) the leopard was taken out of the hotel," Agus Arianto, head of West Java's conservation agency, told AFP.

In late August, a leopard was reported to have escaped from a zoo located just five kilometres (three miles) from the hotel.

Agus said it would take time to determine whether the animal captured on Monday was the same one.

"Currently, the leopard is slowly regaining consciousness. It has started to growl," Agus said, adding that the animal would be taken to a conservation facility for observation.

Indonesia has seen other incidents involving escaped zoo animals in recent years.

In 2021, two Bengal tigers escaped from a zoo in Singkawang, West Kalimantan, after days of torrential rain created a hole near their enclosure.

A 47-year-old male zookeeper and several animals were found dead near the tiger cage.

One of the tigers was shot dead, while the other was captured alive.

Indonesia's zoos have long faced scrutiny, with some accused of animal cruelty and lax safety standards.

Swedish activist Greta Thunberg landed in Greece yesterday alongside scores of fellow campaigners expelled from Israel after trying to ship aid to Gaza, AFP journalists saw.

The 22-year-old climate campaigner was one of hundreds of people who had boarded a flotilla that tried to break through an Israeli blockade of the war-stricken territory.

Thunberg and 160 others landed at Athens International Airport, where crowds of activists welcomed them.

She called the Global Sumud Flotilla "the biggest ever attempt to break Israel's illegal and inhumane siege by sea".

"That this mission has to exist is a shame," she added, urging the world to act to prevent Israel's "genocide" of the Palestinians.

"We are not even seeing the bare minimum from our governments," Thunberg said.

Activists unfurled a huge Palestinian flag in the arrivals hall and chanted: "Freedom for Palestine" and "Long live the flotilla!"

**Parliamentarian 'beaten'**

One of those landing in Greece, Rima Hassan, a French-Palestinian member of the European Parliament, reported having been hit by Israeli police after the flotilla was intercepted.

"I was beaten by two police officers when they put me in the van," she told AFP.

**Indirect talks on ending Gaza war begin in Sharm El-Sheikh**

Cairo, Egypt

Delegations from Hamas and Israel on Monday began indirect talks in the Egyptian resort town of Sharm El-Sheikh on ending the nearly two-year war in Gaza, Egyptian state-linked media reported.

Al-Qahera News, which is linked to state intelligence, said the delegations "are discussing preparing ground conditions for the release of detainees and prisoners", in line with a proposal from US President Donald Trump to halt hostilities.

Egyptian and Qatari mediators are working with both sides to establish a mechanism "for the exchange of hostages held in Gaza for the Palestinian prisoners in Israeli jails, they added.

Behind closed doors and under tight security, negotiators will speak through mediators

shuttling back and forth, only weeks after Israel tried to kill Hamas's lead negotiators in a strike on Qatar.

The Hamas delegation, led by top negotiator Khalil al-Hayya who survived the attack in Doha, held a meeting with Egyptian intelligence officials ahead of the talks, according to an Egyptian security source.

This round of negotiations, launched on the eve of the second anniversary of Hamas's October 7, 2023 attack that sparked the war, "may last for several days", said a Palestinian source close to Hamas's leadership.

"We expect the negotiations to be difficult and complex, given the occupation's intentions to continue its war of extermination," he told AFP.

Trump, whose envoy Steve Witkoff and son-in-law Jared Kushner are expected in Egypt, has urged negotiators to "mov

**EU wants to be part of Gaza transitional body: Kallas**

Kuwait City, Kuwait

The European Union is seeking a role in US President Donald Trump's transitional authority for the Gaza Strip, its top diplomat Kaja Kallas told reporters on Monday.

"Yes we feel that Europe has a great role and we should be also on board with this," Kallas said, when asked if the EU wanted to take part in Trump's "Board of Peace".

The EU is a major aid donor to the Palestinians and has ties with both the Palestinian Authority and Israel, Kallas pointed out.

"I think Europe should be not only a payer, but we should also be a player," she said on the sidelines of an EU-Gulf Cooperation Council meeting in Kuwait.

Hassan said she and other detainees were kept in groups of up to 15 per cell on mattresses in a high-security Israeli prison.

The Greek foreign ministry said the "special repatriation flight" that landed in Athens carried 27 Greeks and 134 other nationals from 15 European countries.

Israel's foreign ministry said on Monday it had deported 171 activists overall to Greece and Slovakia.

Bratislava's foreign ministry confirmed that one Slovak had returned to the central European country, along with nine other people from the Netherlands, Canada and the United States.

The flotilla departed from Barcelona in Spain in early September and was intercepted by the Israeli navy off Egypt last week.

Israel has branded the flotilla an offshoot of Hamas, the Palestinian Islamist movement that it is battling to destroy in Gaza.

**Caracas warns of explosives plot at US embassy**

Caracas, Venezuela

Venezuela said Monday it had detected a plan by "extremists" to place explosives in the US embassy in Caracas, at a time of spiralling tension between the two countries.

Caracas has warned the United States of what it described as a "false flag operation" by right-wing extremists, Jorge Rodriguez, president of the National Assembly, said in a statement.

The Venezuelan government often accuses the opposition of plots. Caracas and Washington severed diplomatic ties in 2019, and the US embassy has been de-

serted, bar a few local employees. "We have reinforced security

measures at this diplomatic mission," added Rodriguez. The Unit-

ed States has made Venezuela the focal point of its fight against drug trafficking, while Venezuela's President Nicolas Maduro says Washington's true goal is regime change. President Donald Trump's administration has sent warships and planes to the Caribbean region and has bombed several small boats off the coast of Venezuela, killing at least 21 people.

Washington claims the strikes are stopping drugs from reaching the United States. The United States did not recognize Maduro's 2024 re-election, rejected by the Venezuelan opposition and much of the world as a stolen vote.

# Medicine Nobel to trio who identified immune system's 'security guards'

● Prize amount: 11 million Swedish kronor, to be shared equally between the laureates.

A US-Japanese trio yesterday won the Nobel Prize in Medicine for research into how the immune system is kept in check by identifying its "security guards", the Nobel jury said.

The discoveries by Mary Brunkow and Fred Ramsdell of the United States and Japan's Shimon Sakaguchi have been decisive for understanding how the immune system functions and why we do not all develop serious autoimmune diseases.

Sakaguchi, a professor at Osaka University, told a press conference in Japan he hoped the award would "serve as an opportunity for this field to develop further... in a direction where it can be applied in actual bedside and clinical settings".

The Nobel committee was unable to reach the two US-based laureates to break the news to them in person.

"If you hear this, call me," the secretary general of the Nobel committee, Thomas Perlmann, joked at the press conference announcing the winners.

The three won the prize for research that identified the immune system's "security guards", called regulatory T-cells.

Their work concerns "peripheral immune tolerance" that prevents the immune system from harming the body, and has led to a new field of research and the development of potential medical treatments now being evaluated in clinical trials.

"The hope is to be able to treat or cure autoimmune diseases, provide more effective cancer treatments and prevent serious complications after stem cell transplants," the jury said.

## Protecting the body

Sakaguchi made the first key discovery in 1995.

At the time, many researchers were convinced that immune tolerance only developed due

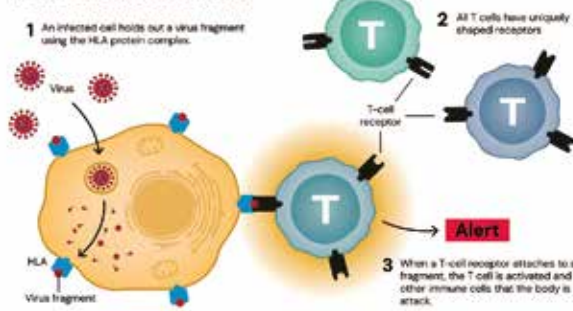

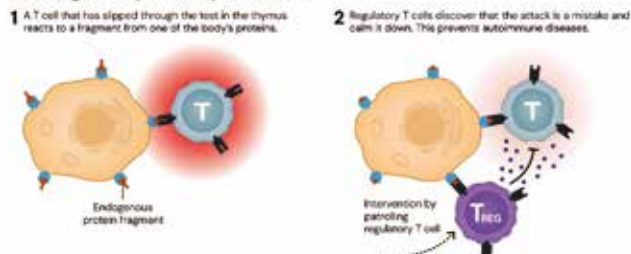

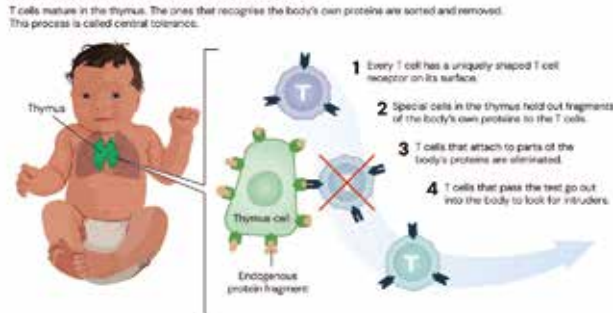

to potentially harmful immune cells being eliminated in the thymus, through a process called "central tolerance".

Sakaguchi, 74, showed that the immune system is more complex and discovered a previously unknown class of immune cells, which protect the body from autoimmune diseases.

Brunkow, born in 1961 and a senior project manager at the Institute for Systems Biology in Seattle, and Ramsdell, a 64-year-old senior advisor at Sonoma Biotherapeutics in San Francisco, made the other key discovery in 2001, when

they were able to explain why certain mice were particularly vulnerable to autoimmune diseases.

"They had discovered that mice have a mutation in a gene that they named Foxp3," the jury said.

"They also showed that mutations in the human equivalent of this gene cause a serious autoimmune disease, IPEX."

Two years later, Sakaguchi was able to link these discoveries. The trio will receive their prize -- a diploma, a gold medal and \$1.2 million split three ways -- at a ceremony in Stockholm on December 10.

# 35 years later, beloved East German car still sputters on

There are around 40,800 so-called Trabis registered in Germany today



- Trabi has achieved “cult status” because of its association with German reunification
- The car’s top speed of 112 kilometres (70 miles) per hour made it a laughing stock in West Germany
- The last Trabant, a candy pink model, was produced in 1991

With its boxy design, cramped interior and notorious clouds of blue smoke billowing from its exhaust, the Trabant is often referred to as the worst car ever made.

But somehow the plucky East German vehicle has refused to die out, with a dedicated group of enthusiasts still devoted to keeping refurbished models on the road.

As Germany prepares to celebrate 35 years of reunification on Friday, the number of Trabis on the streets is actually on the rise as the old rattletaps gain a new legion of fans.

There are around 40,800 so-called Trabis registered in Germany today, according to the KBA federal transport authority -- compared with about 33,000 ten years ago.

Glenn Kuschan, 58, counts several Trabant owners among the customers at his car repair

shop south of Berlin.

They include “all sorts”, Kuschan told AFP, from “older people who grew up with (Trabis) to young people who really want an original vehicle”.

Kuschan is the proud owner of 23 Trabis himself, including a white model that once belonged to his father and has clocked up more than 500,000 kilometres (nearly 311,000 miles).

The Trabi has achieved “cult status” because of its association with German reunification and the fall of the Berlin Wall, he said.

The first Trabis were produced in 1957, three years after the communist East German regime decided to create a car for

the people.

The bodywork was made of plastic mixed with paper or cotton fibre to save on steel imports.

The backseat windows did not open and the noisy two-stroke engine sent thick clouds of burnt oil and gasoline into the air.

The car’s top speed of 112 kilometres (70 miles) per hour made it a laughing stock in West Germany, where the likes of BMW and Mercedes owned the road.

But the car nonetheless became a beloved symbol of everyday life in East Germany, praised for its quirky design and durability.

**‘Indestructible’**

East Germans would put their name on a list and wait up to 15 years for their Trabant to come off the assembly line in one of three colours -- ivory, sky blue or peppermint green.

When the Berlin Wall fell in 1989, many East Germans drove to the border and sat in long queues in their Trabis with the engines spewing out fumes as they waited to cross.

After reunification, many East Germans sold the cars in favour of more sophisticated models, while thousands simply gave them away or abandoned them at the border.

The last Trabant, a candy pink

model, was produced in 1991.

Today, visitors to the Trabi Museum in Berlin can browse a collection of 20 of the little cars and even take a Trabant tour through the city.

Participants get to feel the thrill of driving a Trabi themselves as they are guided past some of Berlin’s most famous communist landmarks.

Thomas Schmidt, 49, who works at the museum and as a driver on the tours, said he “practically grew up in a Trabi” and now sees the car as “part of my identity”.

“It’s like a little endurance runner, it can do anything, it’s indestructible,” he said.

thing is that you can repair everything yourself”, he said, due to the “simple technology”.

“People used to say: if you have a hammer, pliers and some wire, you can get to Leningrad.”

# Mbappe ankle doubt for France qualifiers

Deschamps says injury “not serious” as France prepare for World Cup qualifiers

Kylian Mbappe will undergo medical examinations on his right ankle when he meets up with his international team-mates ahead of the latest round of 2026 World Cup qualifiers, France coach Didier Deschamps said yesterday.

The France captain sustained the knock at the end of Real Ma-

ดริด's 3-1 La Liga victory over Villarreal on Saturday, casting doubts over his availability to the national team for their upcoming qualifying matches against Azerbaijan and Iceland.

“I spoke with Kylian, he had a small niggle but it's not serious, otherwise he wouldn't be here today,” Deschamps told reporters at the French team's Clairefontaine base in Paris.

“We will take the time with medical staff to assess the situation and then see how it develops.

“I don't have any further information at this stage as the players will be arriving around 4 p.m. (1400

GMT), so we'll take stock (then) as usual,” he added.

Liverpool defender Ibrahima Konate is also due to undergo tests, after coming off in -

# Gloves off, Red run, vested interests: Singapore GP talking points

McLaren clinch constructors' title, but drivers' championship fight heats up

- **Piastrì, Norris clash in heated duel**
- **Verstappen closes gap in title race**
- **Piastrì skips team celebrations after row**

McLaren clinched the Formula One constructors title, but their drivers' tempers frayed in the heat of a Singapore Grand Prix won by the Mercedes of George Russell.

Here are three talking points from Sunday's night race, one of the most physically brutal tests of man and machine on the motor racing calendar:

**Gloves off for Piastrì, Norris**

With the constructors' championship safely tucked away for a second successive season, the question now is: will McLaren let the gloves come off in a head-to-head fight for the drivers' title?

If the start of the Singapore GP was anything to go by, the battle between Oscar Piastrì and Lando Norris over the last six races could be very spicy.

Norris forced his way past Piastrì into third place, barging his teammate out of the way in a wheel-to-wheel flashpoint.

After his crash in Baku two weeks ago and a petulant "it's not fair" outburst on Sunday, Piastrì's uber-cool persona from earlier the season is fading

fast.

Norris has reduced the deficit on the Australian to 22 points as they head to Austin in two weeks -- but more importantly he seems to have taken the psychological high ground.

It leaves McLaren team principal Andrea Stella with work to do to calm a fuming Piastrì, who was notably absent from the team's podium title celebrations.

"We will have good conversations," Stella told reporters. "We'll come back stronger and even more united."

"There's a lot at stake. That's

not only the championship points, but it's also the trust of our drivers."

**Verstappen turns up heat**

Any slip-ups from the feuding McLaren pair at the top of the drivers' championship are likely to be pounced upon by a resurgent Max Verstappen.

The McLarens finished behind the Red Bull of the four-time world champion for the third successive race.

Verstappen won in Monza and Baku, while his second place in Singapore behind race-winner

Russell has cut his gap with Piastrì to 63 points and with Norris to 41, with 174 points still up for grabs.

Should the McLarens clash again and, worse, fail to finish a race, the Red Bull in their mirrors will loom even larger.

"I think over the last few races we've definitely improved a lot," said Verstappen, who warned: "Hopefully next weekend we can do a little bit better."

**Jury out on vests**

The race in sweaty Singapore was declared the first official

Formula One "Heat Hazard" under new rules to keep drivers cool in sauna-like cockpits that can reach 60C.

Cooling vests could be worn by drivers and cars had to be fitted with equipment to make them work.

Wearing the vests is currently optional, but governing body FIA is considering making it mandatory from next season -- something that hasn't gone down well with most drivers.

Verstappen was adamant he would not be donning the vest any time soon.

"I haven't used the vest and I'm not intending to use it, because I feel like this needs to be a driver's choice," he said.

Carlos Sainz of Williams, who is the chairman of the drivers' association, said: "I'm happy not to make it mandatory. I agree with the guys that don't want to use it."

"If they don't want to because they feel really uncomfortable then don't use it."

Seven-time former champion Lewis Hamilton said a mandate would be "silly".

"They keep saying it's a safety issue, but there's no driver that's ever died from overheating during the race," said the Ferrari driver.

"It's like, it's just getting silly. That should be our choice."

Russell wore the vest as he won the race, but had reservations. "It isn't the perfect solution yet," said the Englishman.

The DP World Tour's Middle East swing is shaping up beautifully, with Tyrrell Hatton confirming he'll defend his Hero Dubai Desert Classic title from January 22-25. It will be the second of two big weeks in Dubai that lead straight into the Bahrain Championship.

Hatton's victory in Dubai back in January sparked a superb season, highlighted by a tied-fourth finish at the U.S. Open, top-20s
