Hostel shooting

The attack is the latest in a string of mass shootings that have shocked the crime-weary country of 63 million people, which suffers one of the highest murder rates in the world.

Withdrawal call

Qatar and Egypt, guarantors of the Gaza ceasefire, called yesterday for the withdrawal of Israeli troops and the deployment of an international stabilisation force as the necessary next steps in fully implementing the fragile agreement.

The measures were spelt out in the US- and UN-backed peace plan that has largely halted fighting.

Budget pressure

Government urges MPs to review proposed state-backed SME fund amid legal concerns

The government has urged MPs to reconsider a bill proposing the creation of a state-backed fund for micro, small, and medium enterprises (SMEs).

It warned that the initiative overlaps with Tamkeen's existing role.

Authorities also cautioned that the fund could place additional pressure on the budget and the Fiscal Balance Programme as Parliament debates the draft on Tuesday.

The Financial and Economic Affairs Committee has continued to back the bill in principle after rewriting much of its text.

Title

Changes included adding micro businesses to the scope, updating the draft's title, and inserting a new article consolidating the fund's powers in a single section.

The committee also tightened key definitions and clarified the conditions for who can benefit from the fund, ensuring a more precise and structured framework for implementation.

Under the committee's version, the fund would be set up as a public body with its own legal personality and financial and administrative independence, overseen by a minister named by decree.

Support

It would aim to support the Bahraini private sector by backing citizen-led projects in industrial, craft-based, knowledge-based and technological fields.

The government argues that many of the fund's aims and tools are already covered by the

Labour Fund under Law 57 of 2006, which supports Bahraini enterprises through grants, business support and loan schemes with local banks.

They also say the draft lacks the economic and financial studies needed to test the case for a new fund and measure its likely cost.

Concerns

The government has raised legal concerns too, saying clauses on discounts and exemptions from government fees and services cut across existing rules, while proposed funding sources

and incentives touch laws on state land, customs, industrial zones and municipal charges.

The amended draft would allow the fund to support feasibility studies, training and business support, and offer help through

soft loans, guarantees and other incentives.

Its income would come from state budget allocations, land offered by private owners for long-term use and investment, transfers from Tamkeen, allocations from the Future Generations Reserve, grants and donations, and returns on its own investments, with the bill stating that the fund's assets would be treated as public money for the purposes of the Penal Code.

View

Tamkeen has backed the government's view, saying micro, small and medium enterprises already make up the bulk of its institutional support.

The Bahrain Chamber of Commerce and Industry has also warned against overlap with other support vehicles, while associations representing smaller firms support the bill, saying a dedicated fund would widen opportunities for entrepreneurship and help local businesses grow.

MPs will weigh these competing views when the draft comes to a vote. If it passes in its amended form, it will move to the Shura Council.

The MPs say the result fits

the state's aim of raising the profile of Bahraini sport beyond the Gulf.

Al Sayed said the request was made on an urgent basis, calling for financial rewards and suitable recognition for the team.

She said action should come quickly to back the players and encourage young Bahrainis to keep pushing for results.

The proposal also argues for clear, direct ways to reward athletes soon after major wins, saying this approach would help teams prepare better for future tournaments and build a stronger culture of recognition in sport.

Police upgrade

Shura Council reviews major updates to police law, contract row and internal structures

Two draft laws will go before the Shura Council today, with members due to discuss changes to the law governing the police force and a separate proposal linked to the value threshold for legal review of government contracts.

The Council will look at a report by the Foreign Affairs, Defence and National Security Committee backing amendments to the Public Security Forces Law of 1982, as covered by Decree-Law No. 26 of 2025.

The committee said the draft seeks to update the legal and admin base for police work, match changes affecting posts within the Ministry of Interior, add certain categories to the force and strengthen workplace discipline.

The proposal would change the law's name to the 'Bahrain Police Law'.

Title

The committee said this is meant to use a more accurate title for policing duties and to tie the name to tasks such as keeping public order, protecting public safety, preventing accidents



and risks, and tackling crime.

It would also update terms and job titles and introduce new parts of the ministry's structure, including a Ministry of Interior Council and two specialist committees, one for officers and one for personnel, as outlined in Article 4.

The committee said the draft would reorganise the rewards and assistance funds, setting out their resources and spending areas while allowing the minister to add other resources by decision.

It added that the bill would organise the Royal Police Academy and training institutes, giving the Minister of Interior power to issue internal rules on entry, study, training and post-graduate work.

In the same sitting, members will review a report by the Legislative and Legal Affairs Committee urging rejection of a draft amendment to Article 2 of Law No. 60 of 2006 on the reorganisation of the Legislation and Legal Opinion Commission.

The committee argued that

the aim of the proposal is already covered by other bodies that check and monitor government contracts before signing and during delivery.

Warning

It warned that expanding the scope of referrals could increase the number of contracts sent to the commission and slow review of deals with economic weight, which could delay related interests.

It also said the proposal runs against the purpose of the 2010 amendment that raised the mandatory referral threshold from BD100,000 to BD300,000 in response to higher prices and a rise in the volume and range of government purchasing.

The committee said the commission's role in this area is tied to legal opinion and formal and procedural checks, rather than a general check of all government contracting.

Al Budaiya farmers' market faces severe parking crisis

Al Budaiya's farmers' market is facing a severe parking crisis, with available spaces far below the number of weekly visitors.

Improperly parked vehicles frequently block others, creating chaos and making it extremely difficult for drivers to enter or exit the lot.

Drivers had no choice but to either wait for the offending vehicles to move or attempt risky manoeuvres onto the curb, a solution not viable for many cars without causing damage.


The incident highlighted the daily frustrations and hazards that visitors face.

Insufficient

Traffic police are present but insufficient to manage the persistent problem.

Calls to authorities often produce delayed or no responses from the owners of the illegal parked cars, allowing some drivers to ignore calls from the police entirely and worsen the congestion.

The situation requires ur-

gent action: increasing the presence of traffic vehicles, enforcing stricter penalties for illegal parking, and providing shuttle buses from the spacious Diraz beach parking lot which is just two minutes away, to transport visitors directly to the market.

Measures

Implementing these measures could significantly reduce congestion, enhance safety, and improve the overall visitor experience.

With this crisis recurring weekly, decisive action is essential to restore order and prevent further disruption at Al Budaiya's farmers' market.

Nine social media accounts in trouble for 'spreading hate'

It stressed the importance of responsible use of social media platforms, enhancing public awareness, and safeguarding the community from the dangers of misuse, while adhering to the law and upholding the authentic traditions and values of Bahraini society.

Lawyer exposes engine scam at local auto workshop

A lawyer uncovered a case of fraud at a local auto workshop while repairing a relative's vehicle.

Taqi Hussein Taqi discovered that the garage had carried out improper work and replaced functional parts with damaged ones. He documented the violations and proceeded with legal action, ultimately convincing the court, which ruled in favor of the vehicle owner and ordered the workshop to pay compensation.

Repair

According to Taqi, the vehicle driven by the first plaintiff – and owned by the second plaintiff – had broken down, prompting them to hand it over to the defendant for repair.

After inspection, the workshop claimed the vehicle required a replacement engine, engine mount, and alternator base, quoting a repair cost of approximately BD 500.

After collecting the vehicle, the first plaintiff discovered that it continued to experience significant issues and was not operating normally.

The workshop later claimed that additional parts had burned

out or stopped working, including two mounts, the fan motor, alternator guard, integrated electrical converters, and injectors.

Replacement

The defendant then alleged that the vehicle's computer system was also damaged and needed replacement, yet continued to delay returning the vehicle.

Taqi added that the plaintiff eventually received the vehicle without the problem being resolved. Further inspections revealed that the main issue lay in the transmission.

Multiple specialized workshops informed the plaintiff that the defendant had replaced good parts with worn-out, used components while falsely claiming they were new.

The lawyer explained that his client filed a criminal report



and a complaint with the Consumer Protection Directorate at the Ministry of Industry and Commerce.

A technical expert was appointed to examine the vehicle and review exchanged messages and voice notes.

For additional verification, the vehicle was sent to an independent workshop to assess the replaced engine.

The expert concluded that the installed engine was in poor condition and required replacement, confirming that the workshop had not carried out the repairs properly.

As a result, the workshop was deemed responsible for

funding the paid amount and returning the vehicle's original engine, which it still had in its possession.

In its ruling, the court stated that it found the expert report credible and based on sound technical grounds.

It dismissed the workshop's objection regarding the expert's specialization, noting that the expert had relied on a certified workshop's assessment, which detailed the engine defects and recommended a full replacement.

The court therefore ordered the defendant to compensate the plaintiff for the cost of the replaced engine.

Urgent proposal as MPs call for fixed Mazaya instalments for remaining 77%

Three thousand Mazaya households got a BD100 reduction, but MPs now want the monthly bill fixed for the remaining majority, warning that repeated renewals keep pushing costs up.

The urgent proposal calls for the monthly instalment under the old Mazaya scheme to be fixed for the group not covered by the Prime Minister's latest decision.

It also asks the Cabinet to look at a non-refundable grant for those left outside the

that a single rule for the old scheme would remove the gap between groups and ease pressure on household budgets.

In the explanatory note, the MPs cited constitutional principles on justice, social solidarity and equal opportunity, as well as the state's duty to provide housing for low-income citizens.

They also welcomed the Crown Prince and Prime Minister's earlier direction to lighten the load for some Mazaya beneficiaries and said they hoped the same help would extend to the rest.

Mazaya is one of Bahrain's main home-financing routes, run through bank partnerships and designed to give citizens more choice over where they live.

MPs said it has helped many families move away from wait-

ing for housing units while easing the waiting list, but said the split in support has left a large share of beneficiaries still facing rising monthly instalments

◆ **An overnight exchange** of gunfire and shelling at a major Pakistan-Afghanistan border crossing killed four civilians and one soldier, Afghan officials said yesterday, the latest flare-up of fighting between the two countries despite a ceasefire since deadly clashes in October. Five other civilians were wounded, an Afghan government spokesman, Hamdullah Fitrat, said in a video statement. The local hospital at the Pakistani border town of Chaman said three people suffered minor injuries during the fighting. Each side accused the other of launching "unprovoked" attacks at the crossing between Chaman and Spin Boldak, in southern Afghanistan.

◆ **German Chancellor** Friedrich Merz heads to Israel on Saturday for his first visit since taking office, aiming to reaffirm traditionally solid ties that were shaken during the Gaza war. Merz stopped in Jordan briefly on Saturday for talks with King Abdullah II, which Merz told reporters afterwards had focused largely on the fragile peace process in Israel and the Palestinian territories. Speaking before flying on to Israel, Merz urged more humanitarian aid to flow into Gaza and Hamas fighters to lay down their weapons. He said Jordan and Germany both remain committed to a negotiated two-state solution. "There can be no place for terrorism and antisemitism in this shared future," Merz said. In Jerusalem on Sunday, Merz is scheduled to visit the Yad Vashem Holocaust memorial before meeting Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu. Merz, who took power in May this year, has repeatedly criticised Israel's relentless military campaign, which has killed tens of thousands of Palestinians.

Germany's Merz makes first visit to Israel as chancellor

◆ **Flavio Bolsonaro** said Friday his father, jailed ex-president Jair Bolsonaro, has chosen him to lead Brazil's powerful conservative movement. Flavio Bolsonaro, a senator, took to social media to declare himself heir to a political dynasty that transformed and at times dominated Brazilian politics. It makes him an instant contender to become Brazil's next president in elections in October 2026. Flavio's father Jair Bolsonaro was unlikely to run after being sentenced to 27 years in prison for plotting a coup. The 70-year-old ex-president has also suffered a series of medical problems since being stabbed in a 2018 assassination attempt. He is still trying to appeal that sentence and win a pardon from lawmakers. But Friday's announcement signals a passing of the political torch.

Four arrested after food thrown at Britain's Crown Jewels

London police said four people were arrested yesterday after food -- purportedly apple crumble and custard -- was thrown at a display case containing Britain's priceless Crown Jewels in the Tower of London.

The city's Metropolitan Police said officers responded "following reports of criminal damage to a display case, containing the State Crown" and that "four protesters threw suspected food onto the case before two left the scene".

A little-known, self-proclaimed civil resistance group called Take Back Power claimed responsibility, saying its members had thrown apple

crumble and custard at the case. It posted a video of the incident on social media showing a young woman planting a foil tray containing the crumble up against the glass pane, followed by a young man splattering custard from a tub on top of it. The Imperial State Crown, worn by King Charles III at the end of his 2023 coronation ceremony and at formal occasions like the State Opening of Parliament, could be seen shimmering inside the case.

Both suspected perpetrators in the footage wore t-shirts with "take back power" and a logo plastered on the front. "Democracy has crumbled!" the young woman yelled, as the custard-throwing man added "Britain is broken."

The measures were spelled out in the US- and UN-backed peace plan that has largely halted the fighting in the Palestinian territory, though the warring parties have yet to agree on how to move forward from the deal's first phase.

Disarming Hamas not first priority in Gaza: Turkish top diplomat

Venezuela's Machado to receive peace prize in Oslo: Nobel Institute

Machado would be considered a "fugitive"

Venezuelan opposition leader Maria Corina Machado, who lives in hiding in her country, has confirmed she will travel to Oslo to receive her Nobel Peace Prize, the head of the Nobel Institute told AFP yesterday.

"I was in contact with Machado last night (Friday) and she confirms that she will be in Oslo for the ceremony," Kristian Berg Harpviken said.

"Given the security situation,

we cannot say more about the date or how she will arrive," he added.

Venezuela's attorney general, Tarek William Saab, told AFP last month that Machado would be considered a "fugitive" if she travelled to Norway to accept the peace prize, which she was awarded on October 10.

The Nobel Peace Prize ceremony formally handing over the award is to take place on Wednesday in Oslo.

Opposition activism in Venezuela has been muted since the arrest of some 2,400 people during protests that followed the most recent reelection of President Nicolas Maduro

in July 2024.

Machado has accused Maduro of stealing the election, a claim backed by much of the international community.

Machado, in hiding since August 2024, is a supporter of US President Donald Trump and agrees with Washington's assessment that Maduro heads a drug cartel.

The Nobel Peace laureate has welcomed a beefed-up US military presence in the region, which has seen strikes on alleged drug boats.

No breakthrough at Ukraine-US talks

Three days of talks between Ukrainian and US officials produced no apparent breakthrough yesterday, with President Volodymyr Zelensky committing to further negotiations toward "real peace," even as Russia launched another series of drone and missile strikes on its neighbor.

Zelensky said he joined his negotiators for a "very substantive and constructive" call with US envoys Steve Witkoff and Jared Kushner, as part of the third day of meetings in Florida.

"Ukraine is committed to continuing to work honestly with the American side to bring about real peace," Zelensky said on Telegram, adding that the

parties agreed "on the next steps and the format of the talks with America."

In Paris, French President Emmanuel Macron said he will meet Zelensky, British Prime Minister Keir Starmer and German Chancellor Friedrich Merz in London on Monday to "take stock" of the negotiations on the US-drafted plan on how to end the almost four-year war.

China's national security agency in Hong Kong summons international media representatives

China's national security agency in Hong Kong summoned international media representatives for a "regulatory talk" yesterday, saying some had spread false information and smeared the government in recent reports on a deadly fire and upcoming legislative elections.

Senior journalists from several major outlets operating in the city, including AFP, were summoned to the meeting by the Office for Safeguarding National Security (OSNS), which was opened in 2020 following Beijing's imposition of a wide-ranging national security law on the city.

Through the OSNS, Beijing's security agents operate openly in Hong Kong, with powers to investigate and prosecute national security crimes.

"Recently, some foreign media reports on Hong Kong



have disregarded facts, spread false information, distorted and smeared the government's disaster relief and aftermath work, attacked and interfered with the Legislative Council election, (and) provoked social division and confrontation," an OSNS statement posted online shortly after the meeting said.

At the meeting, an official who did not give his name read out a similar statement to media

representatives.

He did not give specific examples of coverage that the OSNS had taken issue with, and did not take questions.

The online OSNS statement urged journalists to "not cross the legal red line".

"The Office will not tolerate the actions of all anti-China and trouble-making elements in Hong Kong, and 'don't say we didn't warn you'," it read.

India's momentous stride towards economic modernization

In a historic decision, in November 2025, the Government of India announced the implementation of the four Labour Codes, namely on Wages, Industrial Relations, Social Security and Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions, by rationalising 29 existing, mostly pre-1950s labour laws. The implementation of the four Labour Codes will help transition the Indian economy beyond colonial-era structures and align with modern global trends.

The benefits of these labour reforms are expected to be compounded by the dramatic expansion in social-security coverage, which rose from about 19% of the workforce in 2015 to more than 64% in 2025. It may be recalled that in June this year, the International Labour Organization's (ILO) ILOSTAT database observed that India ranks second in the world in providing social protection coverage to 940 million citizens and further that the 45 percent increase marked the fastest expansion in social protection coverage worldwide.

The implementation of the four Labour Codes marks the next major step in this trajectory, further widening the social security net and embedding the portability of benefits across states and sectors. With expanded social security, stronger protections, and nationwide portability of entitlements, the Codes place workers, especially women, youth, unorganised, gig, and migrant workers, firmly at the centre of labour governance. By reducing compliance burden and enabling flexible, modern work arrangements, the Codes boost employment, skilling, and industry growth.

In particular, it is important to highlight that the use of digital platforms and Direct Benefit Transfers has been crucial in our journey towards economic modernization, and this continues to guide the application of the Labour Codes. Further, the National OSH Board will set harmonised safety and health standards across sectors. These and many other innovative features point towards a determined push in the sphere of labour governance in line with our self-reliant approach, also called Atmanirbharta.

The Codes lay the foundation for a protected, future-ready workforce and resilient industries. A simplified, efficient framework that draws upon the use of technology in the administration of labour laws through digital registration, licensing, and inspections for improved efficiency and transparency is significant. Equally significant are the simplification of procedures, the fostering of a business-friendly environment as well as enforcement through online, risk-based inspection mechanisms and objective implementation processes. It is therefore expected that the four Labour Codes will also have a positive effect in improving the ease of doing business within India.

Will EU give ground on 2035 combustion-engine ban?

The European Commission is due to review the target on December 10

Europe's embattled auto industry and its backers are ramping up pressure on the EU to relax its planned 2035 ban on new petrol and diesel car sales -- hoping for a decision by year end.

The European Commission is due to review the target on December 10 as part of a broader rescue plan for the sector but competing demands from member states and industry risk forcing it to push back the date.

The goal of switching a new cars to electric by 2035 was set in 2023 as a flagship measure of the EU's environmental

Green Deal and a key step towards the bloc achieving climate neutrality by 2050.

But two years on, calls are mounting to revise the target in the name of "pragmatism".

"Our sector has received the most stringent target as it was perceived to be one of the easiest to decarbonise," the European Automobile Manufacturers' Association (ACEA) said in a policy paper.

"But the reality has proven much more complicated."

Meanwhile, Chinese carmakers are flooding the European market with cheaper electric models, sparking fears of an unprecedented crisis among the bloc's manufacturers, with mass layoffs and factory closures looming.

"The ground is slipping beneath our feet," the

head of France's Plateforme automotive industry group Luc Chatel warned last month, saying the sector was the victim of "political and dogmatic choices, not technological ones".

Germany, Italy push for exemptions

German Chancellor Friedrich Merz has emerged as a leading voice in support of carmakers, urging Brussels to allow sales of plug-in hybrids, range-extenders and highly efficient combustion engines beyond 2035.

Italy wants new cars running on biofuels to remain legal after the deadline.

In the opposing camp, France wants to stick as closely as possible to the all-electric trajectory to safeguard massive investments

already made by its carmakers.

"If we abandon the 2035 target, forget about European battery plants," President Emmanuel Macron warned after an EU summit in October.

France is calling for EU support for battery production and proposing mandatory electrification of corporate fleets using European-made vehicles to avoid favouring Chinese brands. Germany opposes such fleet rules.

BMW chief Oliver Zipse argued in Brussels this week that making corporate fleets go fully electric would amount to bringing the combustion-engine ban "through the back door".

Lucien Mathieu, of the Transport & Environment advocacy group, warned meanwhile that exemptions for biofuels "would be a terrible mistake", citing their poor carbon record and unintended impacts such as deforestation.

What are 'rare earths' for?

Crucial for making smartphones, fighter jets and electric cars, "rare earth" metals have become a strategic bargaining chip since main producer China this year introduced restrictions on their exports.

As the EU unveils a plan on Wednesday for boosting European production of critical raw materials to reduce reliance on China, here are some facts about these 17 elements and their key uses:

Neodymium, praseodymium, dysprosium, terbium

Global raw production of rare earths increased from 220,000 tonnes in 2019 to 390,000 tonnes in 2024 -- an increase of 77 percent over five years, according to a benchmark commodities report by French research group Cercle CycloPe.

Four elements account for most of the sector's economic value: neodymium, praseodymium, dysprosium and terbium.

Magnets for wind turbines

These four "magnetic" rare earths are mainly used to make magnets, notably neodymium-iron-boron magnets -- about 10 times more powerful than conventional ones.

Use of the rare elements maximises magnets' performance while reducing size and weight, said Damien Ambroise, energy manager at French consultancy Bartle.

A single offshore wind turbine contains up to one tonne of such magnetic rare earths.

Fighter jets, golf clubs

Aviation is a major consumer of rare earths, especially for military plane manufacturing.

According to the US specialist newsletter Rare Earth Exchanges, US aerospace firm Lockheed Martin is the biggest American user of samarium, employed to make magnets that can withstand extremely high temperatures.

Each F-35 fighter jet requires more than 400 kilograms of rare earths, according to a report by the US Congressional Research Service.

Scandium is used to make light, strong aluminium-based alloys prized in aerospace -- and also in high-end sports gear such as golf clubs, bicycles and baseball bats.

Smartphones

Rare earths are also found in every smartphone, enhancing screen performance and enabling the phone to vibrate.

Each handset contains about three grams of them -- more than 3,700 tonnes overall for the 1.24 billion devices sold worldwide in 2024.

Electric and fuel vehicles

Each hybrid or electric vehicle battery and motor contains between 1.2 and 3.5 kilograms of rare earths, according to an estimate by France's Bureau of Geological and Mining Research.

They are also used in the manufacture of miniature motors, such as those that fold away a car's wing mirrors automatically when it is parked.

Combustion-engine vehicles use rare earths too, notably in catalytic converters. Lanthanum and cerium help cut fine particle emissions.

Oil, glass, lasers

In the chemical industry, cerium is widely used in oil refining and glass polishing -- as well as in flints for cigarette lighters.

Erbium is used in various medical fields, including dentistry, dermatology and ophthalmology.

Erbium and neodymium are also important in making lasers for industrial engraving and cutting.

Adding different rare earths alters the wavelength of the laser, and thus its use and colour, Ambroise said. "It makes for pretty colours in sound-and-light shows."



Despite their name, most rare earth metals aren't actually rare -- the problem is that they're usually scattered in tiny amounts, making them extremely difficult and costly to extract. For example, cerium is more common in the Earth's crust than copper, but you almost never find it in concentrated, mineable deposits. This is why the world relies heavily on a few specialised countries for processing, not mining.



Reds exit Arab Cup after heavy defeat to Algeria

● **Algeria dominated after an early Bahrain equaliser, with Berkane, Boulbina, and Benzia leading the rout**

● **Bahrain now face Sudan in a dead-rubber match on Tuesday**

Bahrain's Arab Cup campaign came to an early end last night after losing 5-1 to a resurgent Algeria in their Group D match at Khalifa International Stadium in Doha. Coming off a 2-1 defeat to Iraq and facing a side fresh from World Cup qualification, it was always an uphill task for the Reds, and Les Fennecs showed exactly why they were among the tournament favourites.

Bahrain thought they had the perfect start in the 8th minute when Abdulla Al Khalasi tapped in following chaos from a Mehdi Humaidan free kick. The joy was short-lived, however, as VAR confirmed that Mehdi Abduljabbar had been offside and interfering with play. Still, Bahrain's energetic start forced Algeria onto the back foot, even

prompting Algerian icon Yacine Brahimi to gesture to his teammates from the sidelines to settle down.

Algeria then struck first in the 24th minute. Youcef Atal controlled the ball wonderfully on the wing and sent in a sharp low delivery for Redouane Berkane to tap home. But Bahrain responded swiftly. Three minutes later, Humaidan sparked a sweeping move, feeding Madan on the byline before Abduljabbar redeemed himself with a composed close-range finish to make it 1-1.

Parity didn't last, though. In the 30th minute, Bahrain's high defensive line was brutally exposed. Berkane turned provider, threading a perfectly weighted diagonal pass to Adil Boulbina, who raced through acres of space before slotting past Omar Salem, starting in place of the injured Ebrahim Lutfalla. And from there, the Algerians began to assert full control.

Their dominance was rewarded on the stroke of halftime when Farid Chaal's long goal kick bounced dangerously into Bahrain's defensive third. A misjudged sliding challenge from Amine Bennadi sent Berkane tumbling, and earned Algeria a penalty that Yacine Benzia dis-

patched with ease to make it 3-1 at the break.

The second half began disastrously for Bahrain. Just three minutes in, Boulbina unleashed a powerful long-range effort that Berkane redirected with a header for Algeria's fourth. Minutes later, Sofiane Bendebka thought he had added another from a Benzia corner, only for the referee to disallow it for a

soft foul on Abduljabbar.

As the match wore on, Algeria continued to press, and with ten minutes remaining Brahimi threaded a perfect pass to Boulbina, who hammered in a low finish for 5-1 and his second of the night.

Despite the scoreline, Bahraini fans kept chanting until the final whistle. Their support couldn't prevent the inevitable.

With Iraq defeating Sudan 2-0 thanks to late goals from Mo-hanad Ali and Amjad Attwan, Bahrain bowed out of the Arab Cup, remained bottom of Group D without a point, and joined Sudan in exiting the tournament. Algeria and Iraq advance to the quarter-finals, leaving the Reds to face Sudan in a dead-rubber match on Tuesday at Education City Stadium.

Jaiswal hits ton as India thrash S. Africa to clinch ODI series

Visakhapatnam, India

India clinched the three-match ODI series 2-1 with a dominant nine-wicket win over South Africa in Visakhapatnam, driven by Yashasvi Jaiswal's maiden ODI century. Chasing 271, India cruised home with 10.1 overs to spare as Jaiswal struck an unbeaten 116 and shared a 155-run opening stand with Rohit Sharma, who made 75. Jaiswal, playing just his fourth ODI, reached his hundred off 111 balls and said he had focused on balancing aggression and rotation after failing to convert starts in earlier games.

Virat Kohli, coming off consecutive centuries, finished the chase with a boundary and remained unbeaten on 65 from 45 balls. Rohit dominated early, bringing up his 61st ODI fifty and becoming only the fourth Indian after Sachin Tendulkar, Kohli and Rahul Dravid to sur-


pass 20,000 international runs. His knock ended when Keshav Maharaj dismissed him for a 73-ball 75.

India's bowlers set up the win as Kuldeep Yadav and Prasad Krishna took four wickets each to bowl out South Africa for 270 in 47.5 overs. KL Rahul finally broke India's

20-match ODI toss-losing streak and opted to field, a decision that paid off despite an early South African surge.

Quinton de Kock smashed 106 off 89 balls—his seventh ODI hundred against India—and shared a 113-run stand with captain Temba Bavuma, who scored 48. But once Krishna struck twice in an over and later bowled de Kock, South Africa's innings faltered. Dewald Brevis (29) and Marco Jansen (17) attempted a rebuild, but Kuldeep removed both in quick succession to regain control.

Kuldeep finished with 4-41 as India wrapped up the innings, Maharaj left unbeaten on 20. The ODI victory provided some comfort after India's 2-0 Test defeat, helped by the return of veterans Rohit and Kohli, who now focus on 50-over cricket. The teams now move on to a five-match T20 series starting Tuesday in Cuttack.

Arsenal rocked by Aston Villa, Man City cut gap to two points

Aston Villa ended Arsenal's 18-match unbeaten run with a dramatic 2-1 win, blowing the Premier League title race open as Manchester City closed the gap to two points with a 3-0 victory over Sunderland. Emiliano Buendia struck in stoppage time to seal Villa's ninth win in ten league games, completing an impressive turnaround after a poor start to the season.

Arsenal, missing key defenders Gabriel Magalhaes, William Saliba and Cristhian Mosquera, struggled against Villa's attacking pace. Matty Cash fired the hosts ahead before Mikel Arteta introduced Viktor Gyokeres and Leandro Trossard at half-time. Trossard levelled with his 50th Premier League goal, and only a superb stop by Emi Martinez kept Martin Odegaard from scoring. But in the final seconds, Buendia smashed home the winner, leaving Arsenal frustrated. Arteta called the defeat "painful" but said it would test the team's resolve.

City capitalised with a comfortable win, as Ruben Dias and Josko Gvardiol scored before Phil Foden added a third. Chelsea's title push faded further after a 0-0 draw at Bournemouth, keeping them eight points off the top. Tottenham ended a poor run with a 2-0 win over Brentford,

'Champions of champions' crowned at **BIC**

Rotax MAX Challenge Grand Finals 2025 come to a thrilling close

Bahrain International Circuit (BIC), 'The Home of Motorsport in the Middle East', hosted today the final races in the Rotax MAX Challenge Grand Finals (RMCGF) 2025. The exciting action took place at BIC's world-class grassroots motorsport facility, Bahrain International Karting Circuit (BIKC), wrapping up an incredible week of wheel-to-wheel racing in Sakhir.

Champions

The winners from today's events in the RMCGF – crowning this season's Rotax MAX champions of champions in the Kingdom – were Benjamin Karajkovic from the UAE in the Micro MAX category, Tom Read

from the UK in the Mini MAX, Majus Mazinas from Lithuania in the Junior MAX, Macauley Bishop from the UK in the Senior MAX, Jannik Jakobs from Germany in the E20 Senior, Maurits Knopjes from the UAE in the E20 Master, Sem Knopjes from the Netherlands in the DD2, and Martynas Tankevičius from Lithuania in the DD2 Master.

Team Bahrain also had reason to celebrate, with Vedant Menon becoming the first-ever driver from the Kingdom to step onto an RMCGF podium. He took an impressive second place in the E20 Senior final.

Following the thrills in all eight categories, the podium ceremonies were held at the RMCGF's main stage at BIKC. The winners were awarded their respective trophies and medals by Rotax officials.

60 countries

This year's RMCGF featured nearly 400 of international karting's very best, coming from 60 countries around the world.

Menon was part of an 11-member squad that flew the Bahrain flag high in the meeting, with six of the karters in action in today's final races.

It was the third time that the RMCGF was hosted at BIKC, following the hugely successful 2021 and 2023 editions.

Benjamin Karajkovic won the Junior MAX final from eighth on the grid. He took the chequered flag in 12mins 37.687secs with a 0.362secs gap ahead of Bruno Miranda from Chile, while Dominic Vera Roa from Colombia came third 0.404s behind. Team Bahrain's Tariq Soofi was classified 31st in the

race. Tom Read took his Mini MAX final win despite starting from ninth. He completed the hotly contested 14-lap sprint in 13:56.721, narrowly pipping Marc Moia from Romania by 0.078s. Vicente Capela from Portugal joined them on the podium 0.267s back. Team Bahrain's Shaikh Ahmed bin Saqer Al Khalifa was classified 36th after suffering some kart trouble right at the very start.

Majus Mazinas triumphed in the Junior MAX final from eighth on the grid. He took the chequered flag in 16:58.675 – just 0.482s ahead of Jacob Ashcroft from the UK. Albie Lapper made it two British drivers on the podium with third place, 1.054s from Majus.

The Senior MAX final saw Macauley Bishop emerge victorious in 18:56.764 after 21 laps.

Despite starting 10th, he spearheaded an all-British podium, with Cian Geraghty finishing as runner-up 1.198s behind and Sean Butcher in third 4.924s adrift. Team Bahrain's Tye Meija put in a strong performance in the race, gaining six places to finish in 27th.

Meanwhile, Jakobs led Menon to the finish of the E20 Senior final after starting from the same positions. Jakobs triumphed after 10 laps in 9:17.649, while Menon was not far behind just 0.492s back. Leventre Simon from Hungary was third 1.621s from the victor.

Yousif Alaali

Team Bahrain's Yousif Alaali also had an impressive showing in the race, claiming a top 10 classification in eighth, 10.427s from Jakobs, while Mohammed Alhasan took 15th overall

one lap from the victor. Maurits Knopjes won the E20 Master final from pole as he completed the 10-lap final in 9:37.965. Julian Falivene from Argentina was second 0.514s behind, and Jorge Matos from Ecuador third 0.716s back.

In the DD2 Master final, run over 21 laps, Tankevičius stormed through the field having started 13th on the grid to win in 18:55.501. He narrowly beat Charles Seguin from France by 0.615s. Mat Kinsman from New Zealand completed the podium-placers 1.100s behind. The DD2 final saw Sem Knopjes take the chequered flag after 21 laps in 18:42.714. He too won from pole, with Jakub Bezel from the Czech Republic finishing as the runner-up with a 1.653s gap. Dawid Maslakiewicz from Poland took third 1.856s adrift.

Verstappen outguns McLarens to take key pole in **Abu Dhabi**

Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates

Max Verstappen grabbed pole position and a key advantage for today's decisive season-ending Abu Dhabi Grand Prix with a scorching late lap to beat title rivals Lando Norris and Oscar Piastri in Saturday's tense qualifying session.

Red Bull's four-time world champion clocked a best lap time of one minute and 22.207 seconds to beat series leader Norris by 0.201sec and Piastri by 0.230sec, ensuring that the three protagonists fill the top three places on the grid.

A nervy Norris needs to finish on the podium to land his maiden title while the 28-year-old Dutchman has to win and hope for assistance from others if he is to claim a record-equalling fifth consecutive drivers' title.

It was Verstappen's eighth pole this year and the 48th of his career.

The two McLaren drivers were disappointed at the outcome, knowing that the last 10 Abu Dhabi races have been won by the driver in pole position.

"Of course, I am incredible happy to be in first and that's the only thing we can do," said Verstappen, who has won four times in Abu Dhabi.

"That was great work from everyone and let's go out and

have some fun tomorrow."

Norris said he was disappointed to miss out on pole, but he would race to win on Sunday even if his 12-point lead over the 28-year-old Dutchman allows him to settle for second or third.

"Max did a good job so congrats to him," said Norris. "We did everything we could and my lap was pretty good. We weren't fast enough today. I still want to win and that's how I am going into the race."

Piastri, who is 16 points behind his teammate in the standings, is the outside in the three-way battle for the title and will be more than aware that there hasn't been a winner off the front row in the last 12 races in Abu Dhabi.

"My last lap in Q3 was pretty good and there wasn't a lot left in that," he said.

Hamilton failure

George Russell qualified fourth for Mercedes ahead of Ferrari's Charles Leclerc, two-time champion Fernando Alonso of Aston Martin, Gabriel Bortoleto of Sauber and Esteban Ocon of Haas.

Racing Bulls' Red Bull-bound rookie Isack Hadjar was ninth ahead of the man he will replace Yuki Tsunoda

Ferrari's seven-time champion Lewis Hamilton failed to proceed from Q1 for the third

consecutive race Hamilton was one of the first to clock a time at the start, his Ferrari repaired after a final practice crash earlier, but he finished two-tenths slower than Leclerc to become the first Ferrari driver to record three Q1 exits. He will start 16th on the grid but will perhaps take some solace from the memory of last season when he finished fourth in the race after again starting 16th.



Max Verstappen remains the youngest-ever winner of a Formula One Grand Prix – when he won the 2016 Spanish Grand Prix for Red Bull Racing, he was just 18 years and 228 days old, breaking the record previously held by Sebastian Vettel.
