## Prince Hamzah is 'in my care': King Abdullah

Amman

Jordan's King Abdullah II said yesterday that his half-brother Prince Hamzah was "with his family, at his palace, in my care."

The prince signed a document on Monday pledging his support for King Abdullah after he was accused at the weekend of working with foreign parties and other Jordanians in a plot to destabilise the country.

"Hamzah today is with his family, at his palace, in my care," King Abdullah said in an address read out in his name on state television.

"Prince Hamzah pledged before the family to follow in the steps of the ancestors, remain loyal to their mission, and to put Jordan's interest, Constitution, and laws above all considerations."

# New era of bilateral ties

Bahrain and India agree to expand economic cooperation: Foreign Affairs Minister Al Zayani

● The two sides stressed the importance of the business and industry sector in pushing forward economic and commercial cooperation between them

Bahrain and India are embarking on a "new era" in their bilateral relations after agreeing to expand economic cooperation in various fields and at all levels, including the government level, as well as

This came as Foreign Affairs Minister Dr Abdullatifbin Rashid Al Zayani yesterday headed the Kingdom's delegation in the third meeting of Bahrain-India

High Joint Commission (HJC) held in New Delhi. Dr Al Zayani and Indian Minister of External Affairs Dr Subrahmaniyam Jaisankar co-chaired the meeting.

Dr Al Zayani led the third

ministerial meeting, accompanied by senior officials from both sides.

The meeting was also attended by Bahrain Ambassador to India Abdulrahman bin Mohammed Al Gaoud, the Director of the Afro-Asian Affairs Directorate at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ambassador Muna Abbas Radhi, and a number of Ministry officials.

Both sides, in particular, agreed to expand cooperation in oil and gas, infrastructure, investments, food processing, health, renewable energy, IT, data centres, cloud computing, space, tourism, education, culture, youth and sports.

The wide-ranging talks also focused on reviewing their current

levels of bilateral and political relations, high-level visits, bilateral institutional mechanisms, commercial and economic relations, as well as trends in bilateral trade and investment, and following up on agreements and memoranda of understanding.

The two sides discussed joint strategy and cooperation in the post-COVID-19 phase, vaccines and pharmaceuticals, cooperation in the fields of security and defense, consular/labour issues, and the integration of employment portals, in addition to culture, tourism, education, youth and sports. They also exchanged views on regional, international and multilateral issues and issues of common concern.
