**Paramilitary attack on Sudan village kills 28**

**S**udanese paramilitary forces have killed at least 28 people in an attack on a village south of the capital Khartoum, a local doctors' committee said yesterday. The Rapid Support Forces (RSF) carried out a "massacre" in "the village of Um Adam" 150 kilometres (93 miles) south of the city on Saturday, the Sudan Doctors Committee said in a statement. Sudan's war between the military, under army chief Abdel Fattah al-Burhan, and the RSF, commanded by his former deputy Mohamed Hamdan Daglo, began last April 15. Many thousands of people have been killed, including up to 15,000 in a single town in the war-ravaged Darfur region.

**Royal iftar banquet**



His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince and Prime Minister, yesterday attended an iftar banquet hosted by the Crown Prince and Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, His Royal Highness Prince Mohammed bin Salman bin Abdulaziz Al Saud, at Al-Safa Palace in Mecca. The iftar banquet was held in honour of HRH Prince Salman's visit to Saudi Arabia. His Royal Highness emphasised that meetings between Bahrain and Saudi Arabia are a continuation of the approach taken by previous generations and reflect the deep-rooted historical relationship between the two Kingdoms and their peoples. The Pakistan Prime Minister, His Excellency Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif, and a number of senior officials, also attended the iftar banquet.

**Path to peace**

**Displaced Palestinians walk home as Israel partially pulls troops out of south Gaza**

**I**srael pulled its forces out of the southern Gaza Strip yesterday in a partial withdrawal that came half a year into the war sparked by the attack by Hamas fighters on October 7. After the troops left areas in and around the largely destroyed city of Khan Yunis, a stream of displaced Palestinians walked there, hoping to return to their homes from temporary shelters in far-southern Rafah. An Israeli security expert said the withdrawal in no way means the war is over. The Israeli army said a "significant force" would stay on elsewhere in the besieged territory as Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu said Israel was "one step away from victory". Muhammad Yunis, 51, a Palestinian in northern Gaza, sees nothing but loss. "Isn't the bombing, death and destruction enough?" he asked. "There are bodies still under the rubble. We can smell the stench." On a day when talks toward a truce deal were set to resume in Cairo, Netanyahu also stressed that "there will be no ceasefire

without the return of hostages". He is facing intense pressure at home, from families and supporters of hostages seized by the militants, and from a resurgent anti-government protest movement. "Israel is ready for a deal, Israel is not ready to surrender," he told his cabinet in a speech to mark six months since Hamas's unprecedented attack on southern Israel. Israel has faced growing global opposition to the war, and a chorus of outrage over the killing of seven aid workers of the US-based food charity World Central Kitchen in a drone strike on April 1. Vast areas of Gaza have been turned into a rubble-strewn wasteland, and British Foreign Secretary David Cameron on

**In the bloodiest ever war in Gaza, at least 33,175 people have been killed in the besieged Palestinian territory in Israel's campaign of retaliation for the Hamas attack of October 7, according to Gaza's Hamas-run health ministry.**

Sunday warned the "prospect of famine is real" in Gaza. Charities have accused Israel of blocking aid, but Israel has defended its efforts and blamed shortages on groups' inability to distribute assistance once it gets in. Netanyahu has come under heightened pressure from Israel's top ally the United States to work toward a truce and hostage deal and to allow vastly more aid into the territory.

**Zelensky warning**

**Ukraine to 'lose' war if US Congress withholds aid**

**U**krainian President Volodymyr Zelensky said yesterday that Kyiv will lose the war against Russia if the US Congress does not approve military aid to battle Moscow's invasion. Republicans in Congress have been blocking tens of billions of dollars in military assistance for Kyiv for months. "It is necessary to specifically tell Congress that if Con-

gress does not help Ukraine, Ukraine will lose the war," Zelensky said during a video meeting of Kyiv-organised fundraising platform United24. Zelensky said it would be "difficult" for Ukraine to "stay" (survive) without the aid. He said that "if Ukraine loses the war, other states will be attacked." Russia's invasion of Ukraine has dragged on for more than two years.

## Industry Ministry intensifies monitoring campaigns ahead of Eid Al-Fitr

# Road to safety

Parliament proposes tougher penalties in Kingdom's battle against careless driving

● **Imposing minimum of six-month jail term and fine of no less than BD1,000 for causing fatal accidents**

Bahrain's parliament is considering a proposal to significantly increase penalties for traffic accidents resulting in death.

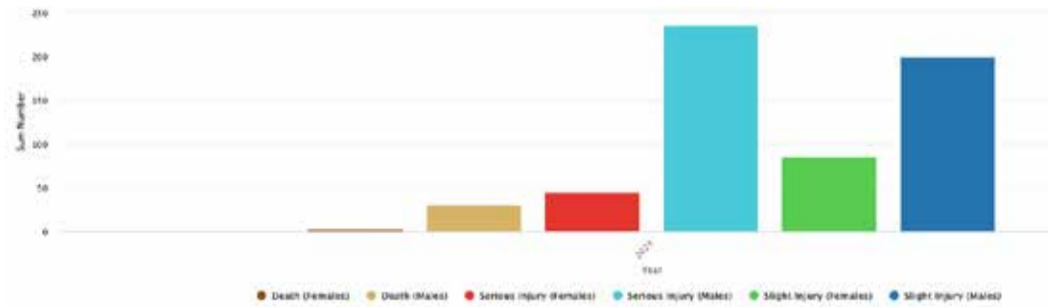
The proposed amendment to Law No. 23 of 2014, spearheaded by MP Abdullah Khalifa Al Romaihi and a group of MPs, aims to deter reckless driving and improve road safety.

The proposed amendment would impose a minimum of six months imprisonment and a fine of no less than BD1,000 for causing a fatal accident. This penalty aligns with the current punishment for overtaking a red light and causing a death. The proposal comes amid concerns about a rise in careless driving and disregard for traffic regulations.

**Data revealed**

While the proposal focuses on drivers, pedestrians also contribute to some accidents. Data from the Information & eGovernment Authority (iGA) reveals that crossing and running on roads resulted in serious injuries for 15 and 17 individuals, respectively, in 2023.

According to the statistics Manama reported the highest number of serious injuries in 2023, with 89 incidents. Riffa

(80), Muharraq (44), Hamada Town (24), Sitra (32), and Hidd (16) followed. Notably, no accidents were reported in Hawar Island that year.

A concerning report by the iGA reveals 70 deaths, along with 1,234 injuries and 848 injury accidents.

Experts warn that the rising

number of vehicles on Bahrain's roads could lead to a significant increase in traffic accidents.

As previously reported by The Daily Tribune, this surge in registered vehicles, currently at 575,294 cars and 27,675 motorcycles according to data from the iGA, is likely to cause congestion on highways in the future. This congestion creates a higher risk of accidents, posing a potential threat to road safety.

# Seriousness of interpellation request under evaluation

MP Mohammed Al Rifai, one of the prominent requesters of the interpellation of Minister of Transportation and Telecommunications, His Excellency Mohammed Al-Kaabi, has announced that the Committee to Examine the Seriousness of Interpellation is scheduled to commence its work today.

The committee will hold its first meeting to study the seriousness of the interpellation and submit its report to the Council within just one week.

In a statement to our sister newspaper Al Ayam, Al Rifai stated that the committee, composed of committee chairs and their deputies, excluding MP Mohammed Al Hussaini as one of the signatories to the request,

will evaluate the interpellation request and provide a recommendation for acceptance or rejection.

Regardless of the committee's recommendation, whether for acceptance or rejection, the report will be presented to the Council for a vote after the Eid holiday. Ultimately, the Council will have the authority to accept or reject the interpellation request.

According to parliamentary sources, MP Hisham Al Awadhi, due to his seniority, will chair the Committee to Examine the Seriousness of Interpellation.

The formation of the "Seriousness Committee" comes after several MPs submitted a request to interpellate the Min-

ister of Transportation and Telecommunications regarding the final report of the Gulf Air.

# Digital governance

Shura Council approves proposal to regulate advertising on social media

The Shura Council gave its approval yesterday to a proposal aimed at regulating advertising and promotion activities on social media platforms.

The proposal, submitted by Shura Council members Talal Mohammed Al Manaei, Dr. Jihad Abdullah Al Fadhel, Abdulrahman Mohammed Jamsheer, Juma Mohammed Al Kaabi, and Reda Ibrahim Monfaredi, has been met with support from the council, marking an important step towards establishing comprehensive guidelines for advertising practices in the digital realm.

Before voting on the proposal, the Shura Council deliberated on the report presented by the Services Committee. The rapporteur of the committee, Talal Mohammed Al Manaei, expressed his satisfaction with the proposal, highlighting its objectives and potential impact.

One of the key aspects emphasised by Al Manaei is the need for official oversight of advertising and promotion on

social media platforms.

He explained that the proposed law outlines general principles while leaving the specific measures and methods for implementing these principles to be determined through executive decisions.

"This approach allows for flexibility and adaptability in response to emerging developments. The proposed law focuses on the general framework, which includes requirements for obtaining prior licenses to engage in advertising activities, specifying the obligations of

license holders, outlining the necessary compliance measures, identifying prohibited advertising content, and delineating the supervisory authority of the ministry," he explained.

### License

Furthermore, Al Manaei clarified that the proposed law includes provisions that criminalise engaging in advertising and promotion activities on social media without obtaining a license from the ministry.

It also addresses the dissemination of advertising materials

that contravene the restrictions outlined in Article 7 of the proposed law. These measures are crucial for maintaining societal stability, protecting essential interests, and safeguarding individuals' rights.

Al Manaei pointed out that the proposed law contributes to supporting and empowering social media influencers by establishing a regulated legislative framework for advertising and promotion activities.

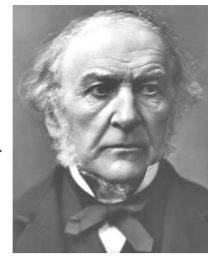

◆ **Serbian police announced** yesterday that a suspected accomplice in a two-year-old toddler's hit-and-run death died in custody, in a case that has shocked the country. Danka Ilic went missing on March 26 in the eastern city of Bor. After a frantic search police said Thursday that the girl was killed after being struck by a car and two suspects were arrested. On Saturday the police said two suspected accomplices were arrested for helping one of the main suspects move her body from a landfill, where it was previously disposed after the accident, to an unknown location most probably on March 28. According to a police statement, the 40-year-old suspect "D.D.", who was in 48 hours of detention, died early Sunday morning after falling ill in the police department in Bor.

◆ **Donald Trump's campaign** said it took in more than \$50 million at a single fundraising event Saturday in Florida -- the latest salvo in a swaggering, high-stakes battle for big money with Joe Biden. While spending huge sums of money on campaigning may not be something to brag about in some countries, it's often a source of pride for US political candidates. And this year, raising big bucks is as important as ever, with the November 5 presidential election expected to be the most expensive electoral cycle in US history. The Republican former president and the Democratic incumbent have been working to outraise each other for months, boasting about each new significant cash infusion.

◆ **Trump rakes in \$50 mn as fundraising war with Biden heats up**

◆ **France is to introduce** a five euro (\$5.50) penalty for people who fail to turn up for millions of doctors' appointments missed each year, the prime minister said Saturday. The fine was one of several measures announced by Prime Minister Gabriel Attal to boost a health service struggling to keep up with increasing demands from an ageing and growing population. "We cannot allow this," Attal said of the 27 million consultations that the main doctors' union says are wasted each year by patients not turning up. Attal said the measure could free up between 15 million and 20 million appointments for other patients.

◆ **France to fine patients who miss medical appointments**

◆ **Russia yesterday said** that a Ukraine drone attack hit the Moscow-controlled Zaporizhzhia Nuclear Power Plant, as the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) urged restraint. The Zaporizhzhia atomic plant, Europe's largest, has been occupied by Russian forces since the start of their 2022 Ukraine offensive.

◆ **Russia says Ukraine drone hit Zaporizhzhia nuclear plant**

"The Ukrainian Armed Forces attacked the dome of the sixth power unit of the Zaporizhzhia Nuclear Power Plant," the Moscow-controlled management of the plant said on social media. It said there was no radioactive release as a result of the attack.

'Our version of Formula 1'

Villagers aboard Cambodian-flagged wooden carts ran their oxen at high speed on Sunday in an annual race to safeguard the centuries-old tradition as concerns mount over development encroaching on racing grounds. Despite scorching sun, hundreds of people flocked to see 46 pairs of oxen take part in the competition, which took place at an empty field in Kampong Speu province, west of capital Phnom Penh.

The oxen, adorned with colourful masks or headgear, must sprint around a one-kilometre (0.62-mile) dirt track. "It is our version of Formula 1" organiser Khat Sokhaly told AFP. "We race ox-carts because they are on the brink of disappearance."

The event is held every year to mark the end of the rice harvesting season and to welcome the Khmer New Year in mid-April. "During the modern era (in other places), they race cars, but we race ox-carts so that the legacy of our ancestors won't disappear," cart driver Tang Sreang, 43, told AFP.

Culture officials said the ox-cart race was organized with the aim of preserving the tradition -- which stretches back hundreds of years -- for future generations.

"It is our heritage, so we must preserve it," Sun Meanchey, director of Kampong Speu's culture department, told AFP. He also voiced concerns that grounds for such races are being taken over by homes and factories.

"What worries me is that in the future when our country is more developed, rice fields will be replaced by factories," Sun Meanchey said.

Israeli withdrawal likely just troop 'refit'

Israel's partial withdrawal from the southern Gaza Strip is likely so its troops can "rest and refit," rather than a move towards a new operation, the White House said yesterday.

"They've been on the ground for four months, the word we're getting is they're tired, they need to be refit," National Security Council spokesman John Kirby told ABC's "This Week," though he stressed that it was "hard to know exactly what this tells us right now."

Kirby spoke hours after Israel, which has been under increasing pressure from Washington over the conflict's spiraling death toll, pulled all its troops out of southern Gaza, including from the city of Khan Yunis, according to the military and Israeli media.

The Israeli Defence Forces (IDF) said a "significant force" will continue to operate in the rest of Gaza, which it invaded after an October 7 attack by Palestinian group Hamas.

That attack resulted in the deaths of 1,170 Israelis and foreigners, most of them civilians, according to an AFP tally based on official Israeli figures.

Troops out of Khan Yunis, southern Gaza

Israel yesterday pulled all its troops out of southern Gaza, including from the city of Khan Yunis, the military and Israeli media said, after months of fierce fighting with Hamas militants left the area devastated.

But the military said a "significant force" will continue to operate in the rest of the besieged Gaza Strip.

"The 98th commando division has concluded its mission in Khan Yunis," the army said in a statement to AFP. "The division left the Gaza Strip in order to recuperate and prepare for future operations."

"A significant force led by the 162nd division and the Nahal brigade continues to operate in the Gaza Strip and will preserve the IDF's freedom of action and its ability to conduct precise intelligence based operations," the statement said.

At least 33,175 people have been killed in the Palestinian territory in Israel's retaliatory campaign, according to Gaza's Hamas-run health ministry.

Kirby said he would let the IDF "speak to their operations."

"As we understand it, and through their public announcements, it is really just about rest and refit for these troops that have been on the ground for four months and not necessarily, that we can tell, indicative of some coming new operation for these troops," he said.

Netanyahu says Israel 'one step from victory'

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu yesterday said Israel was "one step away from victory" in the Gaza war and vowed there would be no truce until Hamas frees all hostages.

He was speaking in a cabinet meeting marking six months of the war that broke out on October 7 after an unprecedented attack on Israel by Hamas. "We

are one step away from victory," Netanyahu said. "But the price we paid is painful and heart-breaking."

Speaking as truce talks were expected to resume in Cairo with international mediators, he said: "There will be no ceasefire without the return of hostages. It just won't happen."

He stressed that "Israel is not ready to surrender."

Water level in Russia's Orsk 'critical' as Kremlin warns of more floods

A major flood in the Russian city of Orsk forced thousands of people to evacuate, with Moscow reporting a "critical" situation Sunday and warning of expected dangerous water levels in Siberia.

Russia has introduced a "federal emergency" situation in the southern Orenburg region, where the Ural river has flooded Orsk and now threatens the main city of Orenburg.

Rwanda commemorates 30 years since genocide

Rwanda's President Paul Kagame yesterday said the international community had "failed" his country during the 1994 genocide, as he paid tribute to victims 30 years after Hutu extremists tore apart the nation.

"Rwanda was completely humbled by the magnitude of our loss. And the lessons we learned are engraved in blood," Kagame said in Kigali during a solemn ceremony to commemorate a 100-day massacre that claimed the lives of 800,000 people, largely Tutsis but also moderate Hutus.

"It was the international community which failed all of us, whether from contempt or cowardice," he said, addressing an audience that included several African heads of state and former US president Bill Clinton, who had called the genocide the biggest failure of his administration.

In keeping with tradition, the ceremonies on April 7 -- the day Hutu militias unleashed the carnage in 1994 -- began with Kagame placing wreaths on mass graves and lighting a remembrance flame at the Kigali Genocide Memorial, where more than 250,000 victims are believed to be buried.

Rwandans will also stage a march and hold a candlelit vigil in the capital for those killed in the slaughter.

The tiny nation has since found its footing under the iron-fisted rule of Kagame, who led the rebel militia which ended the genocide, but the scars of the violence remain, leaving a trail of destruction across Africa's Great Lakes region.

The international community's failure to intervene has been a cause of lingering shame, with African Union chief Moussa Faki Mahamat saying in Kigali that "no one, not even the African Union, can exonerate themselves from their inaction."

"Let us have the courage to recognise it, and take responsibility for it."

Trump again likens himself to Nelson Mandela

Republican White House hopeful Donald Trump on Saturday compared himself to South African anti-apartheid icon Nelson Mandela, sparking quick and virulent criticism from President Joe Biden's campaign team.

The 77-year-old Trump has been indicted in four different criminal cases, all of which could end in jail time for the billionaire real estate mogul. In one of those cases, he stands accused of paying hush money to a onetime porn star before the 2016 presidential election, which he won over Democratic candidate Hillary Clinton.

That trial is set to begin on April 15, and Judge Juan Merchan has imposed a partial gag order on Trump, who has frequently attacked the judge on social media.

On Saturday, Trump let loose on his Truth Social platform, accusing Merchan of infringing upon his First Amendment rights to

free speech and expression, and breaking the law.

"If this Partisan Hack wants to put me in the 'clink' for speaking the open and obvious TRUTH, I will gladly become a Modern Day Nelson Mandela -- It will be my GREAT HONOR," Trump wrote.

Mandela spent 27 years in prison before being released and eventually serving as South Africa's president. He died in 2013.

Trump previously compared himself to Mandela at a 2023 rally, and has also likened himself to Jesus Christ.

Biden's campaign team quickly went on the offensive after Saturday's post from Trump, the Democratic incumbent's likely challenger in the November election.

"Imagine being so self-centered that you compare yourself to Jesus Christ and Nelson Mandela all within the span of little more than a week: that's Donald Trump for you," Team Biden said in a statement.

Burglars steal car from Newcastle star Isak's home

Newcastle striker Alexander Isak has been targeted by burglars who stole a car from the Sweden international's home.

Isak's house at Darras Hall in Northumberland was hit by the robbers on Thursday, just 48 hours before he played in Newcastle's 1-0 win at Fulham on Saturday.

Northumbria Police said it received a report of a burglary from a property at around 1005 BST on Thursday.

"The offence is believed to have taken place earlier that day. It was reported that offenders gained entry to the property and took a vehicle from the address," a police spokesperson said.

"The vehicle was later found abandoned in the Dissington area,

and the occupants had fled the scene."

It is not known whether Isak or his family were at home at the time of the burglary.

The break-in came three months after Isak's Newcastle team-mate Joelinton had his home burgled.

The Brazilian midfielder was not at his house, which is also in the Darras Hall estate, at the time, but received a security alert on his phone as it happened.

Wealthy Premier League stars have long been prime targets for burglars, with Manchester City winger Jack Grealish's Cheshire home raided in December.

The thieves took jewellery and watches during City's Premier League clash against Everton.

The property of a person who dies intestate is distributed to the person's heirs as provided for in the law. The heirs are the persons related, either by blood or marriage, to the deceased person who share in the estate of a person who died intestate.

According to current substantive laws, a written will is an important legal document explaining how to distribute the property after the death of the maker of the will, the "testator". So, the testator, knows all details regarding the distribution of his property before his death and there are very specific guidelines from him to others to follow suit. Of course, there is great personal and physiological relief in this arrangement. Whereas, on the other hand, the property of a person who dies intestate "without a will" is normally distributed according to the current substantive laws in the country, whether he likes that or not, makes no difference because he has no will to leave a "will" to be followed after his death.

The estate of a person who dies intestate is handled in almost the same way as the estate of a person who dies after preparing a will. However, there are differences. A major difference, is that the person who manages the estate is called an "administrator" rather than as an "executor". The administrator is appointed by the Court rather than by the "will" prepared by a testator. Mostly, closest relatives of the deceased petitions the Court to be appointed as administrator. Notice of this appointment is sent to other persons who are entitled to share in the estate.

The property of a person who dies intestate is distributed to the person's heirs as provided for in the law. The heirs are the persons related, either by blood or marriage, to the deceased person who share in the estate of a person who died intestate. The substantive laws in each country, determine the heirs and how much percentage or amount they are entitled to receive. The closer the relationship of the heir to the deceased, the greater the share that the heir receives.

In US, details of how much each heir is entitled to are provided for in the law of each state. Examples, if spouse only without children, all estate to be passed to the spouse. If spouse and children, one third to the spouse and two thirds to be shared by the children. If children with no spouse, children to receive everything. It is important to mention that, definition of children includes adopted children.

If a person dies intestate and no living blood relatives can be found, the estate becomes the property of the country's state. This could be, inter alia, a clear disadvantage to die intestate.

# Dominant Verstappen wins Japanese GP in Red Bull one-two

Red Bull's Verstappen wins Japanese Grand Prix ahead of teammate Perez, extending early championship lead

● **Leclerc finishes fourth, while Norris battles for podium but settles for fifth**

Max Verstappen said Red Bull must capitalise on their early season dominance after romping to victory in yesterday's Japanese Grand Prix ahead of teammate Sergio Perez.

The triple world champion claimed his third win in the four races so far this year and on this evidence the Dutchman and Red Bull will take some stopping once again.

Verstappen failed to finish in Australia a fortnight ago because of a brake issue but starting from pole he controlled the race at Suzuka from start to finish.

"I know there will be tracks coming up that might not be so favourable for us," said Verstappen, who took the chequered flag 12.5sec ahead of the Mexican Perez.

"But then of course when we do get to the tracks where we can be quick, we have to really

take advantage of it and score maximum points as a team."

Ferrari's Carlos Sainz, who triumphed in Melbourne, was third in dry, sunny conditions at Suzuka.

Verstappen has taken an early stranglehold on the world championship on 77 points, with Perez on 64 and Sainz's Ferrari teammate Charles Leclerc on 59. Mercedes boss Toto Wolff told reporters after the race that "no one is going to catch Max this year".

"Basically the rest of the season now is the best of the rest,

that's the fact," said Wolff.

Verstappen said this week that Suzuka was one of his favourite circuits and he has now won the Japanese Grand Prix three times in a row.

"Of course Melbourne felt like a bit of a hiccup," he said.

"But what we did today was what we want to do, and that's what we aim to do every single weekend."

Perez was also coming off a weekend to forget after finishing fifth in Australia.

He did not complete the race last year at Suzuka but was com-

fortable in holding off Sainz for second.

"I think we have a good momentum," said Perez.

"Last year here was probably my worst weekend, so I think if we are strong here, I think we can be strong anywhere else.

"It's been a good weekend."

Early drama

Leclerc, who started from eighth on the grid, came home in fourth.

McLaren's Lando Norris, second in last year's race, was fifth ahead of Aston Martin's Fernando Alonso.

and both slammed into the wall before getting out unscathed, but their race was over.

The action resumed from a standing start and Verstappen picked up from where he left off ahead of Perez.

"Whenever I needed to go faster I could, whenever I needed to look after my tyres I could," said Verstappen.

"That's always a nice feeling to have when you're driving."

Verstappen and Perez consolidated their positions, leaving Norris fighting for third against the two Ferraris.

A late lock-up cost the McLaren driver his chance of a podium finish.

Sainz said finishing third was "very satisfying".

"We kind of knew our race pace was better than our qualifying pace -- still probably not enough to go for a win," said the Spaniard.

"Given how the race pace on the Red Bull is, it's almost impossible to think about a win."

The championship resumes in a fortnight's time with the Chinese Grand Prix in Shanghai.

It will be the first time the event has been held since 2019, before it was curtailed by the pandemic.

## Shelton, Tiafoe into ATP Houston final

Ben Shelton and defending champion Frances Tiafoe set up an all-American showdown at the ATP U.S. Clay Court Championship in Houston on Saturday after advancing to the final in contrasting fashion.

Shelton booked his place in an ATP Tour final for only the second time after battling past Argentina's Tomas Etcheverry 6-7 (4/7), 6-4, 6-4.

Tiafoe meanwhile found the going slightly easier, booking his meeting with Shelton after a straight sets win over Italy's Luciano Darderi.

It means Shelton and Tiafoe will meet in the final for only the

second time. Shelton defeated Tiafoe in four sets at their previous meeting in the quarter-finals of last year's U.S. Open.

"You have a lot of time out here, playing on clay," Shelton said. "The game just moves a little bit slower, you have more time to process."

"I tried to use that to my advantage today."

Tiafoe meanwhile is the first defending champion to reach the Houston final since Steve Johnson in 2018.

"Great performance from me today," said Tiafoe, who is relishing his second meeting with Shelton.

comfortable, without threatening too often, but fell behind on the stroke of half-time when defender Ryan Sailor lunged into a rash challenge in the box on Colorado's French forward Kevin Cabral.

The Rapids' Brazilian forward Rafael Navarro drilled home the penalty to give Colorado a 1-0 lead at the break.

Messi was brought on after the interval and made an instant impact.

After just 12 minutes on the field, the Argentine World Cup-winner brought Miami level when Franco Negri crossed low from the left and Messi fired home off the inside of the post.

Busquets was then introduced and Miami took the lead on the hour -- Messi bursting forward from midfield, feeding David Ruiz down the right and his cross was coolly converted by debutant Leonardo Afonso.

## Kasatkina battles past Pegula to reach Charleston final

The defeat marked a disappointing end to the tournament for Pegula, who had advanced to the last four after an incredible Houdini act in the quarter-finals when she saved four match points before squeezing past Victoria Azarenka.

# Man Utd draw feels like a defeat for Liverpool in title race, says Van Dijk

Liverpool squander lead to draw 2-2 against Manchester United in Premier League

● **United's Mainoo scores sensational goal, leveling the match after Salah's penalty**

Liverpool captain Virgil van Dijk said a dramatic 2-2 draw at Manchester United yesterday felt like a defeat after throwing away two points in the Premier League title race.

The visitors dominated the majority of the game but needed a Mohamed Salah penalty six minutes from time to avoid defeat after spectacular strikes from Bruno Fernandes and Kobbie Mainoo.

The draw leaves Liverpool behind leaders Arsenal on goal difference and just one point ahead of Manchester City with seven games remaining in the tightest of title races.

Despite United's struggles this season, Liverpool have failed to beat Erik ten Hag's men in three meetings this season.

United edged a thrilling FA Cup quarter-final 4-3 three weeks ago and emerged with a 0-0 draw at Anfield in December.

"It feels like a loss," said Van Dijk. "It is our fault again."

"We had so many chances and we should finish the game off."

Should the Reds fail to mark Jurgen Klopp' final season in charge by winning a 20th Eng-

lish top-flight title, to match United's record, they will look back on this day and wonder how they failed to win.

For Liverpool, it was a similar story from the FA Cup tie as they wasted a series of chances to extend their lead and ended up getting hit by the United sucker punch.

Liverpool finished the first half with 15 shots to United's

none.

Andre Onana produced one fine save to deny Dominik Szoboszlai but Liverpool were guilty of consistently letting the hosts off the hook.

Liverpool did lead 1-0 at half-time as Luis Diaz fired in Darwin Nunez's header from a corner.

But Szoboszlai, Salah and Darwin Nunez were all wasteful in front of goal.

"Being 1-0 up at Old Trafford and having a 15-0 shooting stat is incredible," said Klopp. "Besides that we could have been calmer or clearer in moments."

"Just stay calm. We are where we are and we keep giving it a

proper go. Do I wish we had 10 points difference? Of course. We take what we got and keep going."

The 18-year-old has enjoyed a meteoric rise this season and produced the biggest moment of his career so far by curling into the top corner.

Klopp was incandescent on the touchline at his players for allowing Mainoo to get his shot off and immediately reacted by sending on Harvey Elliott and Cody Gakona.

Elliott was the man felled by an Aaron Wan-Bissaka lunge for

the penalty and Salah kept his cool to score for the 14th time in 15 games against United.

But Liverpool failed to find a winner to hand Arsenal the advantage in the title race thanks to the Gunners' nine-goal lead on goal difference.

A point also does little to aid United's hopes of qualifying for next season's Champions League.

Ten Hag's men are 11 points adrift of fourth-placed Aston Villa having blown late leads three times in the past eight days.

United's new co-owner Jim Ratcliffe was in attendance and Ten Hag's future as manager remains unclear going into next season.

"On one side I am disappointed that we have dropped seven points in one week after being in winning positions, but we have to blame ourselves for making stupid mistakes," said Ten Hag.

"On the other side I am very proud. You see how we are improving and the potential of this squad is amazing."
