# BD6mln investment fraud trial begins

352 victims pursue case against financial company as defendants deny charges

The First High Criminal Court yesterday opened the trial of the owner of a financial investment company, along with the company's CEO and two board members, accused of fraud, forgery, and embezzling over BD6 million from investors' funds, in addition to laundering the proceeds of these crimes.

The four defendants, who were previously released on bail, appeared in court and denied all charges.

Three lawyers announced their representation of 352 civil claimants, including lawyer Fadhel Al-Omari on behalf of 350 plaintiffs, and lawyers Sarah Atiq and another attorney representing two additional claimants.

Commitment

The Public Prosecutor, who attended the session, emphasized that the charges outlined in the referral order reflect the Public Prosecution's firm commitment to combating crimes that threaten the national economy and the investment sector—one of Bahrain's key economic pillars.

He affirmed that the prosecution exercises its full legal authority to address money laundering, embezzlement, and fraud in the private sector due to their harmful impact on society.

He noted that the case involves several interconnected crimes carried out as part of a well-organized criminal scheme, with each defendant playing a defined role for personal gain.

**Pleadings**

The prosecution will elaborate on its arguments in future pleadings, supported by what it described as conclusive testimonial and material evidence.

**Hearing**

The court adjourned the hearing until October 20 for the defense to present its arguments.

Earlier, the Head of the Financial Crimes and Money Laundering Prosecution stated that investigations began following a report from the National Financial Intelligence Center at the Ministry of Interior.

The report alleged that the company owner had defrauded investors, embezzled their funds using forged documents, and laundered the illicit proceeds.

**Actions**

Investigations revealed that the CEO and two board members facilitated the owner's actions within their areas of responsibility, enabling the embezzlement

of investor funds through fictitious transactions.

According to the report, the company owner engaged in suspicious financial activities, including issuing fake checks, making unjustified withdrawals and deposits, and recording unexplained payments not backed by contracts.

The findings indicated that he unlawfully appropriated investors' funds, prompting the Public Prosecution to initiate a comprehensive probe.

**Fictitious deals**

The investigation determined that the main defendant exploited his authority to defraud investors by promoting fictitious business deals using forged commercial records.

He falsely claimed that certain entities had applied for financial funding.

## Road projects on track



His Excellency Ibrahim bin Hassan Al Hawaj, Minister of Works, conducted a field visit to review progress on the flyover project linking Shaikh Isa bin Salman Causeway to Avenue 105 in the Buseiteen area, as part of the ministry's efforts to enhance traffic flow and improve infrastructure between the Muharraq and Capital Governorates. The visit was attended by Shaikh Mishaal bin Mohammed Al Khalifa, Undersecretary at the Ministry of Works, and Ahmed Sami Al Tajer, Assistant Undersecretary for Roads at the Ministry of Works. Al Hawaj was briefed on the latest project updates, noting that it includes the construction of a two-lane flyover in each direction to carry traffic from Manama via the Shaikh Isa bin Salman Causeway to the Muharraq Ring Road through Avenue 105 in Buseiteen, as well as traffic from the Muharraq Ring Road towards Muharraq city.

# Non-Oil Sectors Power Growth

Professional and technical activities lead expansion

- Economy grows 2.5% in Q2
- Non-oil GDP up 3.5%
- Diversification efforts gain strength

Bahrain's economy achieved a 2.5 percent real growth rate in the second quarter of 2025, according to preliminary figures released by the Information and eGovernment Authority (IGA). At current prices, the economy expanded by 2.3 percent compared to the same period of the previous year.

The data reflects the Kingdom's continued economic momentum, supported by the strong performance of non-oil sectors, which recorded a 3.5 percent increase at constant prices and 5.3 percent at current prices for the quarter. The IGA noted that this outcome underscores the ongoing national efforts to diversify income sources and strengthen the contribution of non-oil activities to Bahrain's



overall growth.

Meanwhile, oil GDP registered a 2.6 percent decline at constant prices and a 14.2 percent decrease at current prices, mainly due to lower global oil prices

and reduced production volumes.

Among individual sectors, professional, scientific, and technical activities posted the highest growth at 12 percent,



Non-oil activities now account for most of Bahrain's GDP, reflecting steady progress toward economic diversification.

followed by wholesale and retail trade at 6.7 percent and real estate activities at 4.7 percent, all at constant prices.

At current prices, professional, scientific, and technical activities continued to lead with 12.7 percent growth, while information and communication activities grew by 10.9 percent and accommodation and food services by 10.4 percent.

These results highlight the sustained expansion of Bahrain's non-oil economy and demonstrate the country's progress in achieving a balanced, diversified, and competitive growth model across key sectors.



## 'Committed' hygiene awareness campaign

‘Fast-track permits for fire-hit homes’

Abdullah Al Qubaisi, Northern Municipal Council member, has called for immediate exemptions to issue building and maintenance permits for homes damaged by fires. He said the move is meant to take account of the humanitarian and social needs of families who lost their housing and to speed up rehabilitation and repair. Al Qubaisi said the proposal aims to let affected owners re-



build or carry out restoration as quickly as possible in cases that cannot bear delay. He noted that some properties carry violations dating back more than ten years, which he said would be time-barred under Article 18 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. He added that the measure

is directed at certain cases: families whose homes were destroyed in full, with priority for widows and orphans; shared dwellings that are hard to separate from an engineering stand-

point; incidents that resulted in a death; and houses that can be fixed during maintenance provided any breach, if present, is removed. Aim Al Qubaisi said the aim is to help affected families and keep their social and living stability. He warned that delays in issuing permits, or refusals in these cases, deepen the hardship of residents who lost their homes and belongings. The Council member also pointed to the financial and psychological strain many families face after sudden incidents, and called for exceptional flexibility in applying the rules to allow rebuilding without bureaucratic obstacles.

Bahrain third in Arab world for cheapest internet

Bahrain placed third in the Arab world and 27th worldwide in CEOWORLD Magazine's 2025 internet price ranking, with data averaging \$0.57 per megabyte. Qatar leads the Arab list, seventh globally, at \$0.13 per megabyte. The UAE comes next regionally, 17th worldwide, at \$0.32. Saudi Arabia follows Bahrain in fourth place across the Arab states and 35th globally at \$0.73, with Kuwait fifth regionally and 45th worldwide at \$1.09. Oman ranks sixth in the Arab bracket and 58th worldwide at \$1.27. Egypt stands seventh and 92nd at \$1.97. Algeria takes eighth and 103rd at \$2.11, and Libya ninth and 105th at \$2.14. The table continues with Iraq 10th in the region and 114th worldwide at \$2.33; Lebanon 11th and 115th at \$2.35; Tunisia 12th and 116th at \$2.36.

# 'Veggie burgers' face grilling in EU parliament

Championed by green advocates as much as mindful eaters, the days of plant-based "steaks" and "veggie burgers" may be numbered under plans up for a vote in the European Parliament today. Concerns over the greenhouse gas emissions from livestock farms have in recent years driven more Europeans towards vegetarian and vegan diets, seen by advocates as a healthier al-

ternative to regular meat consumption. But many European livestock farmers -- and the politicians who represent them -- see plant-based foods that mimic meat as a threat, and one more challenge facing a troubled sector. "It's not sausage, and it's not steak, plain and simple. Let's call a spade a spade," said Celine Imart, a right-wing EU lawmaker pushing for such terms to be banned for non-animal-based products.

"It's everyone's right to eat alternative proteins -- made from plants, laboratories, tofu or insect flour," said Imart, who besides her work in parliament farms cereals on the side. "But calling it 'meat' is misleading for the consumer," she told AFP. If Imart's proposal becomes law, a long list of labels including "sausage" and "burger" would be reserved for foods containing meat. That prospect is still some way

off. Even if parliament backs the proposal, it still needs to be negotiated with the EU's 27 member states. And the outcome of Wednesday's vote is uncertain, with the boss of Imart's centre-right EPP party, Manfred Weber, saying the ban was "not at all a priority". "People are not stupid, consumers are not stupid when they go to the supermarket and buy their products," he told report-

ers. It is not the first time veggie burgers have found themselves in the crosshairs of European lawmakers. A similar call to ban such terms was rejected in 202

# WTO hikes 2025 trade growth outlook but tariffs to bite in 2026

WTO raised its forecast for trade volume growth in 2025 to 2.4%

● Slashed 2026 outlook from 1.8% to 0.5%

AI-related goods and a surge in exports to the United States to beat President Donald Trump's tariff hikes boosted global merchandise trade growth this year, the World Trade Organization said Tuesday.

However, the picture is bleak for 2026, the WTO warned,

as the impact of those tariffs kicks in.

The WTO raised its forecast for trade volume growth in 2025 to 2.4% -- up from 0.9% in August -- and slashed its 2026 outlook from 1.8% to 0.5%.

"Global merchandise trade outpaced expectations in the first half of 2025, driven by increased spending on AI-related products, a surge in North American imports ahead of tariff hikes, and strong trade among the rest of the world," the WTO said, as it published its updated global trade outlook.

In an unusual move, the global trade body has revised its estimates several times this year due to uncertainties surrounding the new tariffs imposed by the Trump administration.

Since returning to office in January, Trump has slapped several waves of new tariffs on imports entering the United States.

His administration has imposed a basic tariff of 10% on all countries since April, with much higher rates for some economies.

Measured reaction to tariffs "Countries' measured response to tariff changes in general, the growth potential of AI, as well as increased trade among the rest of the world -- particularly among emerging economies -- helped ease trade setbacks in 2025," WTO chief Ngozi Okonjo-Iweala said.

The WTO said artificial intelligence-related goods -- including semiconductors, servers, and telecommunications equipment -- drove nearly half of the overall trade expansion in the first six months of the year, rising 20% year-on-year in value terms.

Over those six months, "42% of global trade growth came from AI-related goods -- far out of proportion to their 15% share in

world trade", Okonjo-Iweala told a press conference. But the former Nigerian finance minister said trade resilience this year should not fool countries into "complacency".

"Today's disruptions to the global trade system are a call to action for nations to reimagine trade and together lay a stronger foundation that delivers greater prosperity for people everywhere," she said.

She noted that apart from a few countries, most WTO members have not imposed tit-for-tat tariffs on the United States "like it was in the 1930s" during the Great Depression, praising them for sticking to WTO rules.

'So much uncertainty' The report predicted that all regions will record weaker import performance in 2026 as higher tariff rates and heightened trade policy uncertainty bite.

Okonjo-Iweala said that look-

ing ahead to 2026, "the fact is there is so much uncertainty it is hard to be conclusive".

The WTO's global GDP growth projection is 2.7% this year and 2.6% in 2026. Services export growth is now expected to slow from 6.8% last year to 4.6 in 2025, and further down to 4.4% next year.

# Stocks falter, gold shines as traders weigh political turmoil

Wall Street stocks turned lower yesterday and gold closed in on \$4,000 per ounce as investors weighed the US government shutdown and political turmoil in France.

Wall Street rose at the open, however, with sentiment still buoyed by a multi-billion-dollar partnership deal between ChatGPT developer OpenAI and chipmaker Advanced Micro Devices (AMD).

AMD shares jumped 7% in early deals Tuesday after double-digit gains on Monday, helping the S&P 500 and tech-heavy Nasdaq Composite set fresh record highs.

“Investors continue to ‘follow the money’ when it comes to anything to do with generative artificial intelligence,” David Morrison, senior market analyst at Trade Nation, said in a note.

“This is despite fears that the whole investment thesis looks increasingly incestuous, as money gets pumped around companies within the sector,” Morrison said.

But Wall Street’s three main indices turned lower during morning trading amid a bout of profit-taking.

In Europe, the Paris stock market edged back up after a sell-off, even as President Em-

manuel Macron faced a call from his first prime minister, Edouard Philippe, to resign over a deepening political and budget crisis.

London and Frankfurt also ended broadly stable, but the euro fell further against the dollar.

Philippe, who himself aspires to become president, urged Macron to call for an early presidential election.

“He must take the decision that is worthy of his function, which is to guarantee the continuity of the institutions by

leaving in an orderly manner,” Philippe told the RTL broadcaster.

The latest crisis erupted after Prime Minister Sebastien Lecornu, appointed less than a month ago, stepped down on Monday after failing to rally support for his new government.

Macron later ordered him to make a last-ditch effort to rally support for a coalition government, but there was no sign of progress.

Meanwhile gold approached within \$10 of hitting \$4,000 per



ounce.

“Gold has benefited from multiple catalysts this year, including tariff uncertainty, stubborn inflation, and a falling US dollar,” said analyst Bret Kenwell at eToro.

“Uncertainty around the government shutdown and prospects of lower interest rates have only seemed to fan the flames of this year’s rally,” he added.

The US government shutdown stretched into a seventh day, with Republicans and Democrats appearing no closer to an

agreement.

Bets on the Federal Reserve cutting interest rates this month and the political crisis in France are adding to the allure of gold, a safe-haven asset.

Kathleen Brooks, research director at trading group XTB, said the rally on the precious metal is part of the “debasement” trade.

“This trading theme is driving demand for alternative assets such as gold and crypto, as the dollar faces a long-term decline and fiscal concerns continue to rise around the world,” she

added.

In Asia, Tokyo eked out another record following the weekend election of a pro-stimulus advocate to lead Japan’s ruling party, before paring gains to close flat.

The election of Sanae Takaichi -- expected to become Japan’s prime minister this month -- ramped up optimism that she will kick-start the economy through stimulus measures.

Yields on 30-year Japanese bonds hit their highest level, reflecting fears the country’s already colossal debt will balloon further.

## Trump says 25% tariffs on heavy trucks start Nov 1

Washington, United States

President Donald Trump said Monday that a steep US tariff on imported heavy trucks would begin on November 1, postponing the date that he initially threatened to impose such duties. “Beginning November 1st, 2025, all Medium and Heavy Duty Trucks coming into the United States from other Countries will be Tariffed at the Rate of 25%,” Trump wrote in a post on his Truth Social site.

This is a monthlong delay from the October 1 start date he vowed in an earlier social media post unveiling the new duty.

The Trump administration launched a so-called Section 232 probe into imports of trucks earlier this year to determine their effects of national security, setting the stage for Trump’s announcement.

Trump has used such investigations, under the authority of the Trade Expansion Act of 1962, to impose tariffs on various imported goods -- in efforts to boost US manufacturing and punish countries that he says are taking advantage of his country.

## No air traffic control at LA area airport amid US govt shutdown: governor

A busy California airport had no air traffic controllers on Monday evening, the state’s governor said, as the effects of a US government shutdown rippled across the country.

Hollywood Burbank Airport, which connects Los Angeles to the rest of the country, was set to be without qualified staff in the control tower for around six hours, Governor Gavin Newsom said.

“Thanks @realDonaldTrump!” wrote Newsom on X. “Burbank Airport has ZERO air traffic controllers from 4.15pm to 10pm today because of YOUR government shutdown.”

The Federal Aviation Authority (FAA), which regulates flying in the US, said departures to the airport were delayed by around two-and-a-half hours.

“BUR TOWER ATC ZERO. RATE REDUCED DUE TO STAFFING,” it said in an advisory.

Broadcaster ABC7 said its reporters had spoken to people at the airport who confirmed the tower would be unstaffed.

The staff said duties at Burbank would be handled by a team in San Diego, which would speak to pilots coming in and going out of the airport.

In a statement to AFP, a spokesperson for the airport said “operations are continuing.”



“We are advising passengers to check with their airline -- before arriving at the airport -- for updates on possible delays or cancellations,” the statement said.

The development comes as a nationwide government shutdown enters its second week, with Donald Trump’s Republican Party at odds with Democrats over how to pay for many of the US government’s functions.

Most federal workers have been placed on enforced leave, and are not being paid during the shutdown.

But those doing jobs considered essential, like air traffic controllers, are expected to continue to work, albeit without pay.

Political commentators have said it is only a matter of time before this system -- effectively one of good will -- breaks, and staff begin to call in sick while

they are not being paid.

Democrats are refusing to provide the votes the ruling Republicans need to reopen federal departments, unless an agreement is reached on extending expiring “Obamacare” health care subsidies and reversing some cuts to health programs passed as part of Trump’s signature “One Big Beautiful Bill.”

The nonpartisan Congressional Budget Office estimated the bill, which was signed into law on July 4, would strip 11 million Americans of health care coverage, mainly through cuts to the Medicaid program for low-income families.

That figure would be in addition to the four million Americans whom Democrats say will lose health care next year if the health insurance subsidies are not extended -- while another 24 million Americans will see their premiums double.

## OpenAI unveils ChatGPT app integration feature

San Francisco, United States

OpenAI on Monday unveiled a new feature for ChatGPT, the leading generative AI model with 800 million weekly users, enabling it to interact with everyday apps like Spotify and Booking.com.

Chief Executive Sam Altman announced the new tool to a crowd of enthusiastic developers gathered in San Francisco for the company’s annual “Developer Day.”

The new feature, Apps SDK, allows ChatGPT to interact with various apps to select music, search for real estate or explore hotel and flight booking sites.

Initial partners including Booking.com, Canva, Coursera, Figma, Expedia, Spotify and Zillow launched Monday in markets where their services operate.

Additional partners, including Uber, AllTrails and DoorDash, are expected later this year.

However, the feature is not yet available in Europe,

where rules on deployment of data-heavy AI tools are stricter.

The move marks a significant expansion of ChatGPT’s capabilities, blending traditional interactive elements like maps and playlists with conversational AI.

Users could, for example, ask “Spotify, make a playlist for my party this Friday” and have the music streaming app intervene within the chat.

ChatGPT can also suggest apps when relevant to the conversation.

For example, if a user is discussing buying a new home, ChatGPT can turn to the Zillow app to browse listings matching their budget on an interactive map inside ChatGPT.

News in brief

◆ **At least 15 people** were killed Tuesday when a landslide triggered by torrential rains hit a passenger bus in northern India's Himachal Pradesh state, authorities said. The rescue workers and local villagers at the accident site were digging for survivors from under heavy boulders and mounds of earth. The incident happened at night in Bilaspur, about 60 miles (100 kilometres) from Shimla, the capital of the picturesque Himalayan state. "15 deaths have been confirmed so far," the local government said in a statement. State Chief Minister Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu "expressed deep sorrow and anguish over the tragic bus mishap," the statement added. "Three children have been rescued alive and were being treated" at a local hospital, and the rescue operations were ongoing.



**Landslide kills at least 15 bus passengers in northern India**

◆ **Britain's financial** regulator yesterday proposed that lenders pay consumers £8.2 billion (\$11 billion) in compensation after some car loans were deemed unlawful. "Many motor finance lenders did not comply with the law or the rules. Now we have legal clarity, it's time their customers get fair compensation," the Financial Conduct Authority's chief executive Nikhil Rathi said in a statement. The regulator said payouts on "an expected 14 million unfair motor finance agreements could start next year, under an industry-wide compensation scheme proposed by the FCA". Individuals would receive an average £700 in compensation, it added.

**UK regulator proposes £8.2 bn compensation for bad car loans**

◆ **President Donald Trump** struck a friendly tone with Canadian Prime Minister Mark Carney yesterday, hailing progress towards a trade deal but offering few concrete concessions on steep US tariffs. Trump repeatedly showered praise on "great leader" Carney, who was under pressure at home to show progress from his second visit to the White House since taking office in April. "I think they're going to walk away very happy," Trump told reporters as he sat alongside Carney in the Oval Office. "And I think we've come a long way over the last few months, actually, in terms of that relationship." **Shhhh! California bans noisy TV commercials**

Los Angeles, United States

Noisy TV commercials were banned in California on Monday, with a new law that demands pitchmen turn the volume down. Viewers in the United States have long complained that advertisements can be much louder than the program they are streaming. One minute they are engrossed in a peaceful nature documentary and the next they are scrambling for the remote to quieten a man shouting about a new treatment for his flatulence. Now a new law in America's most populous state says commercials cannot be any louder than the content they interrupt. "We heard Californians loud and clear, and what's clear is that they don't want commercials at a volume any louder than the level at which they were previously enjoying a program," Governor Gavin Newsom said after signing the bill into law. The legislation rewrites outdated laws that only regulated broadcast and cable providers to now include streamers.

**Trump says 'real chance' of Gaza peace deal**

Trump said that US negotiators were involved in the talks

● **World leaders** yesterday urged Hamas to release the Israeli hostages, on the second anniversary of the attack which sparked the war in Gaza.

US President Donald Trump said yesterday there was a "real chance" of a Gaza peace deal, as Hamas and Israeli negotiators held indirect talks on the second anniversary of the October 7 attack.

"We are very close to making a deal on the Middle East that will bring peace to the Middle East," Trump told reporters in the Oval Office alongside Canadian Prime Minister Mark Carney.

Trump said that US negotiators were involved in the talks now taking place in Egypt. The White House said on Monday that Trump's special envoy Steve Witkoff and son-in-law Jared Kushner would play a role.

"There's a real chance that we could do something," Trump said. "I think there's a possibility that we could have peace in the Middle East. It's something even beyond the Gaza situation. We want a release of the hostages immediately."

"Our team is over there now, another team just left, and other countries, literally every country in the world, has supported the plan."

Trump added that the United States would to "everything possible to make sure everyone adheres to the deal" if Hamas and Israel do agree on a ceasefire to end the war.

**Hamas: 'Historic response' -**

Hamas insisted that the October 7 attack was a "historic response" to Israel's actions against the Palestinian people.

"We reaffirm that the Al-Aqsa Flood on October 7 was a historic response to attempts to eradicate the Palestinian cause," Fawzi Barhoum, a senior Hamas official, said in a televised speech.

**Spain: 'End genocide' -**

Spanish Prime Minister Pedro Sanchez, one of the most vocal critics in Europe of Israel's offensive in the Palestinian territory, decried the Hamas attacks and demanded Israel end the "genocide of the Palestinian people".

"It is a day to reiterate our strong condemnation of terrorism in all its forms, to call for the immediate release of the Israeli hostages," the Socialist leader wrote on X.

"And to demand that (Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin) Netanyahu stop the genocide of the Palestinian people and open a humanitarian corridor," he added.

**Qatar says Israel should have already ceased fire under Trump plan for Gaza**

Doha, Qatar

Qatar's foreign ministry spokesman said yesterday that Israel should have ceased operations in Gaza already in line with US President Donald Trump's peace plan.

"Regarding the ceasefire, this question should be directed first to the Israeli occupation government. It was supposed to actually cease fire if the statements made by the prime minister there regarding adherence to the Trump plan were true," Majed al-Ansari told reporters in Doha.

Ansari was cautious on the Egypt peace talks.

"I have no doubt that this round of negotiations is a process in which all parties are strongly committed to reaching a consensus, but there are many details to consider," he said. He said the plan's clauses "require practical interpretation on the ground, which of course requires communication with all parties".

He said it was still "early" to discuss the future of Hamas's political bureau in Doha, after Israel hit the group's leadership in the Qatari capital last month. The Hamas bureau, which Qatar hosts with US blessing, has helped Doha mediate in the conflict, he said, adding: "As long as there is a need for a channel (of communication with Hamas), there is a need for this".

**Dubai airshow bars Israeli companies from exhibiting**

Dubai, United Arab Emirates

Israeli defence companies have been barred from the upcoming Dubai Airshow after a "technical review", its organiser said yesterday, without providing further details, two years into the devastating Gaza war.

Registrations were withdrawn for all six Israeli defence companies that were due to take part, said Tim Hawes, managing director of Informa Markets, which organises the show. "The (Israeli) exhibitors that were previously coming won't be participating," said Hawes, on the sidelines of a press conference to announce details of the exhibition.

"There was a technical review which we do of all companies that take part in the show," he said, adding the decision had been taken by the airshow's technical committee.

Hawes did not elaborate on the reasons for the decision. The next edition of the biennial airshow, one of the world's biggest, takes place in November. Israel's inaugural participation in 2023 was overshadowed by the start of the Gaza war. Israeli defence exhibitions were empty and unstaffed at the start of the show. Tuesday marks the two-year anniversary of the October 7, 2023 attacks by Hamas that triggered the war, which has left tens of thousands dead and much of Gaza in ruins.

**UN chief demands end to Gaza hostilities, immediate release of hostages**

Geneva, Switzerland



The United Nations chief yesterday demanded the immediate and unconditional release of all hostages held in Gaza, and an end to hostilities in the war-ravaged Palestinian territory, Israel and the region.

Speaking on the second anniversary of the Hamas October 7, 2023 attack on Israel that sparked the war in the Gaza Strip, Antonio Guterres de-

cried a "humanitarian catastrophe on a scale that defies comprehension".

"I have said it time and again, and I am repeating it today with even greater urgency: Release the hostages, unconditionally and immediately," he said in a statement.

"End the suffering for all... Put an end to the hostilities in Gaza, Israel and the region now. Stop making civilians pay with their lives and their futures."

"After two years of trauma, we must choose hope. Now."

# Denmark to ban social media for under-15s

AFP | Copenhagen, Denmark

Denmark said yesterday it planned to introduce a social media ban for children under the age of 15.

Prime Minister Mette Frederiksen did not specify which social media networks would fall under the ban, nor how it would work in practice, as she announced the initiative in a speech to parliament at the opening of its autumn session.

The bill, the timeline of which remains unspecified, would authorise parents to let their child use social media from the age of 13.

"The cell phone and social media are robbing our children of their childhood," Frederiksen said, arguing that 60 percent of Danish boys aged 11 to 19 preferred to stay home over spending time with friends.

Australia has been a leader in global efforts to prevent internet harm among young people.

In late 2024, its parliament adopted a ban on social media for under-16s, though there are still almost no details on how the measure would be enforced.

Platforms such as Facebook, Snapchat, TikTok and YouTube fall under the Australian ban's

remit.

And in June, Greece proposed setting an "age of digital adulthood" across the 27-country European Union, meaning children would not be able to access social media without parental consent.

# Pro-Gaza protests flare in UK on anniversary of attack

Thousands of students protested in London and other UK cities yesterday, defying a plea from British Prime Minister Keir Starmer to skip demonstrations on the second anniversary of Hamas's October 7 attack on Israel.

Chanting "Free Palestine", students from several London universities walked out of classes at 2:00 pm (1300 GMT) to march through the centre of the British capital.

Rallies or events including vigils were also held in other UK cities, including Edinburgh, Glasgow, Sheffield and Manchester.

Writing in The Times newspaper, Starmer alleged that regular pro-Palestinian protests had been used "to attack British Jews for something over which

# French sex offender Pelicot says man who abused his ex-wife knew she was asleep

Dominique Pelicot, one of France's worst sex offenders, said yesterday the only man appealing his conviction for sexually abusing Pelicot's ex-wife, knew she would be asleep and even asked for help assaulting her.

Husamettin Dogan is seeking to overturn his conviction for raping Gisele Pelicot, whose ex-husband had for over a decade recruited strangers to abuse her while she was drugged.

"I never forced anyone, they never needed me," Dominique Pelicot, 72, said in court after being extracted from prison to testify on the second day of the trial in the southern city

of Nimes.

He said that Dogan knew from the start that Dominique Pelicot was looking for someone "to abuse (his) wife while she was asleep."

Dogan protests his innocence, saying he was not a "rapist" and insisting he thought he was participating in a libertine couple's sexual game.

"I never said that," Dominique Pelicot said.

Dogan visited the couple's home on June 28, 2019. He said he only realised that something was wrong when he heard the woman snoring.

But Dominique Pelicot said that Dogan had even asked him to lift his inert wife's leg to "help him penetrate her from the side."

"I have no interest in speaking ill of anyone, except to tell the truth," he added.

In December, Dogan was one of 50 men found guilty of sexual abuse at Dominique Pelicot's invitation and sentenced to nine years in prison.

During the first trial, which lasted for nearly four months last year, Gisele Pelicot, 72, waived her anonymity, becoming an international icon and a symbol in the fight against sexual violence.

# Trio wins physics Nobel for quantum mechanical tunnelling

Briton John Clarke, Frenchman Michel Devoret and American John Martinis won the Nobel Prize in Physics

The Nobel jury noted that their work had “provided opportunities for developing the next generation of quantum technology, including quantum cryptography, quantum computers and quantum sensors”.

Quantum mechanics describes how differently things work on incredibly small scales.

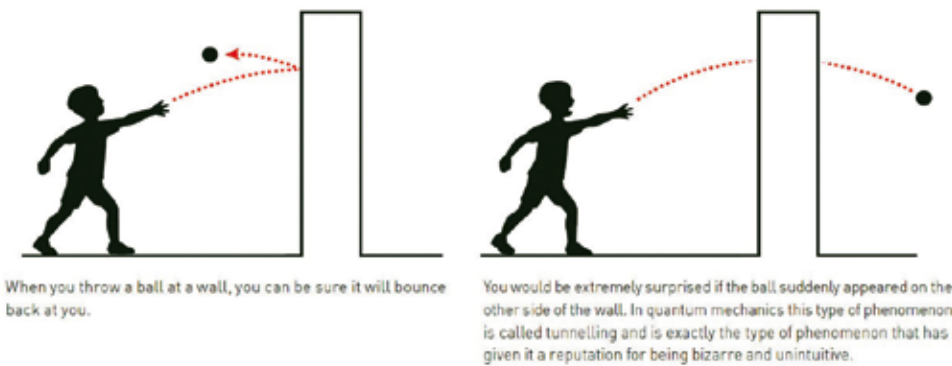
For example, when a normal ball hits a wall, it bounces back. But on the quantum scale, a particle will actually pass straight through a comparable wall -- a phenomenon called “tunnelling”.

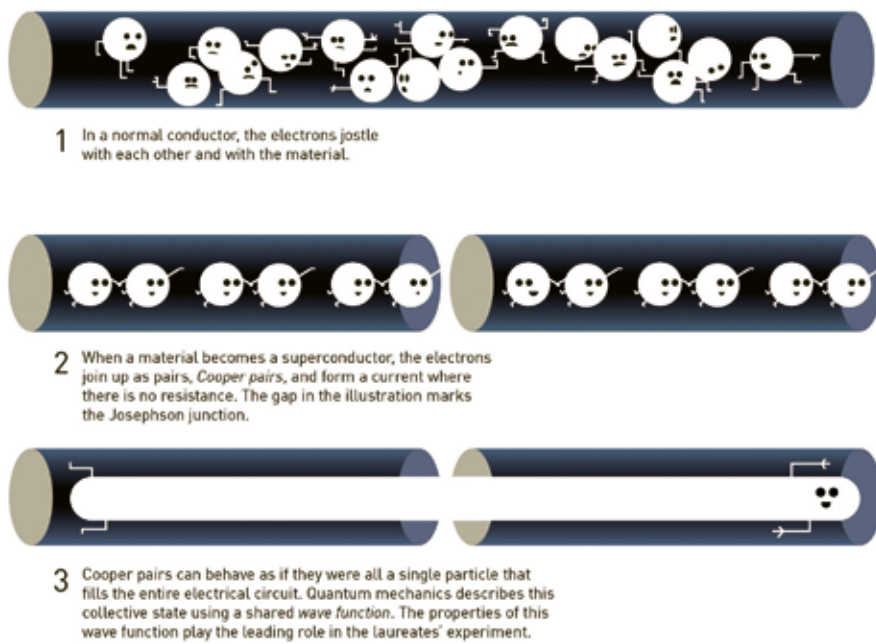

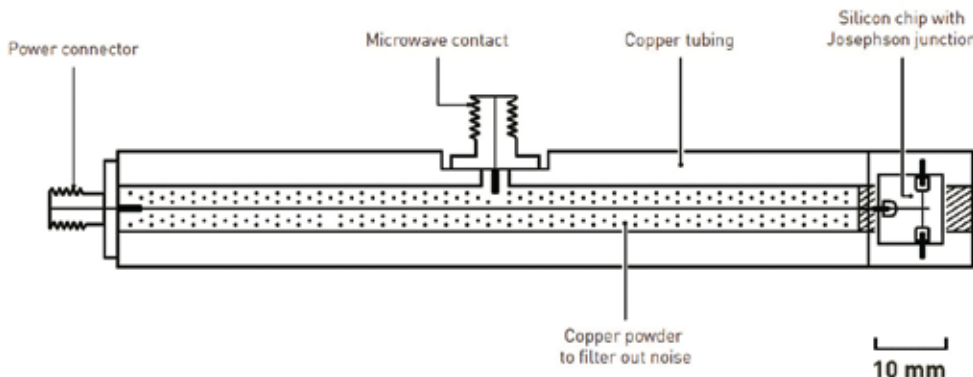


When you throw a ball at a wall, you can be sure it will bounce back at you.

You would be extremely surprised if the ball suddenly appeared on the other side of the wall. In quantum mechanics this type of phenomenon is called tunnelling and is exactly the type of phenomenon that has given it a reputation for being bizarre and unintuitive.

John Clarke, Michel Devoret and John Martinis constructed an experiment using a superconducting electrical circuit. The chip that held this circuit was about a centimetre in size. Previously, tunnelling and energy quantisation had been studied in systems that had just a few particles; here, these phenomena appeared in a quantum mechanical system with billions of Cooper pairs that filled the entire superconductor on the chip. In this way, the experiment took quantum mechanical effects from a microscopic scale to a macroscopic one.

“What these scientists were able to do was to basically do that, but on an electric circuit,” Ulf Danielsson, secretary of the Nobel physics committee and a professor of theoretical physics at Uppsala University, told AFP.

In experiments carried out in the 1980s, the scientists showed that quantum tunnelling can also be observed on a macroscopic scale -- involving multiple particles -- by using superconductors.

“This prize is awarding an experiment that brings the scale up to the macroscopic scale, scales that we can understand and measure through human standards,” Danielsson said.

## ‘Surprise of my life’

“It is also enormously useful, as quantum mechanics is the foundation of all digital technology,” Olle Eriksson, chair of the Nobel Committee for Physics, said in a statement.

Clarke, 83, is a professor at the University of California, Berkeley.

Devoret, 72, is a professor at University of California, Santa Barbara and is listed as a professor emeritus at Yale University.

Martinis, born 1958, is also a professor at the University of California, Santa Barbara.

“To put it mildly, it was the surprise of my life,” Clarke told reporters via telephone during the prize announcement, about learning of his award.

Clarke explained that the scientists had been focused on the physics of their experiments and had not realised at the time the practical applications that could follow.

“It certainly had not occurred to us in any way that this discovery would have such a significant impact,” Clarke said.

Asked about how their discoveries had affected everyday life, Clarke noted that he was speaking to the audience via his mobile phone.

“One of the underlying reasons that the cell phone works is because of all this work,” Clarke said.

## ‘Brain drain’

In a subsequent interview with the Nobel Foundation, Clarke stressed that the discovery was a joint effort.

“I could not imagine accepting the prize without the two of them,” he said.

Like many Nobel laureates, the trio’s research was carried out in the United States.

Major US institutions typically dominate the Nobel science prizes, due largely to the US’ longstanding investment in basic science and academic freedoms.

“The fact that Michel Devoret went to the US is an example of the brain drain,” Eleanor Crane, a quantum physicist at King’s College London, told AFP.

But at the same time, Crane noted that this trend “is being reverted right now with a new administration”.

The physics prize is the second Nobel of the season, following Monday’s medicine prize to a US-Japanese trio for research into the human immune system.

The economics prize wraps up the 2025 Nobel season on October 13.

The Nobel consists of a diploma, a gold medal and a \$1.2-million cheque, to be shared if there is more than one winner in a discipline.



Quantum mechanics allows a particle to move straight through a barrier, using a process called tunnelling. As soon as large numbers of particles are involved, quantum mechanical effects usually become insignificant. The laureates’ experiments demonstrated that quantum mechanical properties can be made concrete on a macroscopic scale.

The Ocean’s Eleven star added: “He surrounded himself with people that he paid.

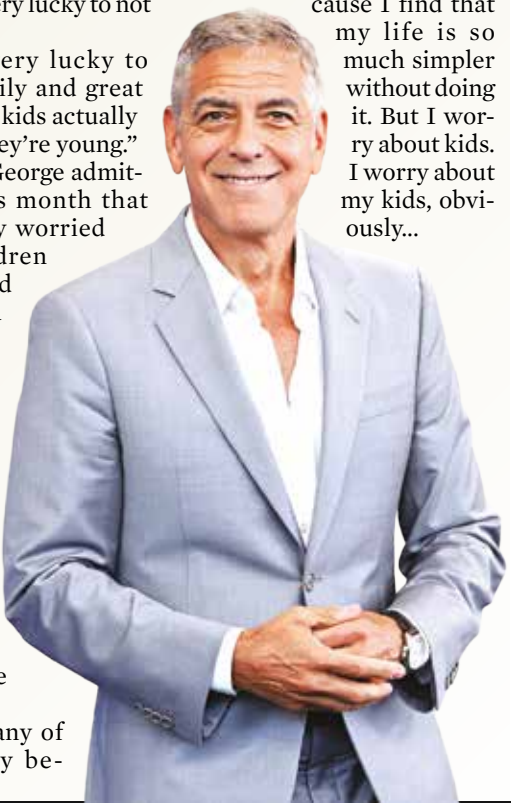
And I’ve been very lucky to not have to do that.

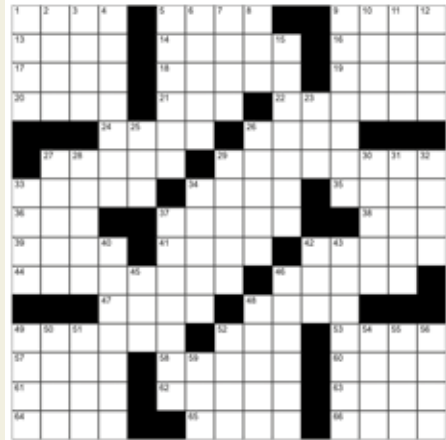

# Salah slump worries Liverpool

Salah's work ethic and defensive effort under scrutiny as Liverpool struggles intensify

- No goals in five of seven games
- Chelsea exploited gaps on Salah's flank
- Liverpool slip from Premier League top spot

Mohamed Salah is Liverpool's "Egyptian King", but the forward's crown has lost a little of its lustre during a disappointing spell in which his work ethic has come under fire.

Salah was below his best again in Liverpool's damaging 2-1 defeat at Chelsea on Saturday as he wasted several chances and failed to help out in defence.

He has been absent from the scoresheet in five of Liverpool's seven Premier League games this season and the champions have suffered as a result.

The loss at Stamford Bridge was Liverpool's third in eight days as Arsenal leapfrogged them to the top of the table.

Salah has scored just three goals and provided three assists in nine appearances in all competitions this season.

Even more alarming than Salah's statistics, mediocre by his stellar standards, was the sight of the 33-year-old taking little interest when Liverpool were under seige against Chelsea.

Without any protection from the forward, Liverpool right-back Conor Bradley was hauled off at half-time after earning a booking as he struggled to keep Chelsea at bay.

The killer ball for Estevao Wilian's stoppage-time winner came from Salah's right flank, with Marc Cucurella advancing unchecked to set up the Brazilian's goal.

Cucurella revealed Chelsea manager Enzo Maresca told them exploit the defensive space vacated by Salah.

"We know that Salah is always

ready for the counter-attack so we practised that and the manager said that the space might be there," he said.

Salah's lethargic display was in keeping with a major dip in form since the closing stages of last season.

He scored 29 goals in 38 league matches, earning the Premier League Golden Boot as Liverpool powered to a record-equalling 20th English title.

But after scoring twice in a 3-1 win against Southampton in March, Salah's influence has waned.

### 'You need to help'

He netted just twice in his last 11 games in all competitions, with Liverpool crashing out of the Champions League against Paris Saint-Germain during his power outage.

After Liverpool clinched the title, Salah

boasted he had convinced Reds boss Arne Slot to let him concentrate on scoring and creating at the expense of defending.

"I told him as long as you rest me defensively, I will provide offensively. I will show you the numbers. So I'm glad that I did," he said.

But giving Salah so much freedom is starting to backfire as opponents expose the gaping holes left by that plan.

Former Manchester United and England star Wayne Rooney has joined the growing chorus of disapproval over Salah's work rate.

"We know he doesn't always get back and defend as much. But in the Chelsea game his full-back is getting torn apart and he's watching," he said on the BBC's Wayne Rooney Show.

"When it's going well and

you are scoring goals, the team will put up with that. But over the last week I'd question his work ethic.

"Those leaders in that dressing room should be telling him 'You need to help out'. He's looked a little bit lost over the last week."

Former Liverpool midfielder Danny Murphy agrees with Rooney.

"It feels like Mohamed Salah's lack of defensive work has become a little problem for Liverpool, especially against the better teams," he said.

Slot must solve the issue if Liverpool are to emerge from their malaise.

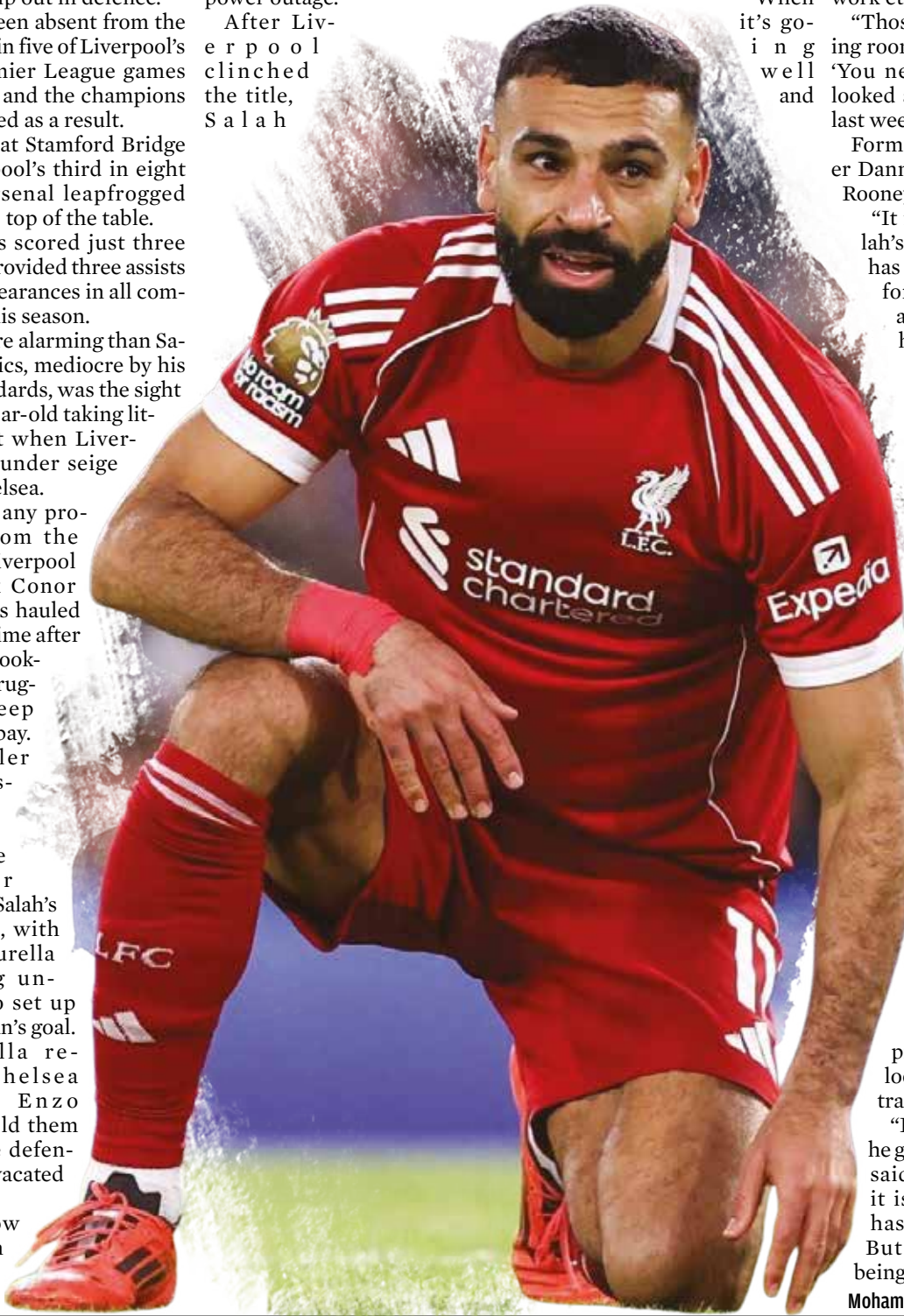
Intriguingly, he left Salah on the bench for the first hour of the Champions League defeat at Galatasaray last week, while conceding that decision might have led to his lack of sharpness against Chelsea.

"That's interesting. Did he create so much because he didn't play during the week or did he miss the chances because he missed a bit of sharpness that he could have had if he would played against Galatasaray? We will never know," the Dutchman said.

For now, Slot is preaching patience as he looks to get Salah back on track.

# Kane open to extended Bayern stay

England captain says Premier League comeback less likely as Bayern success continues

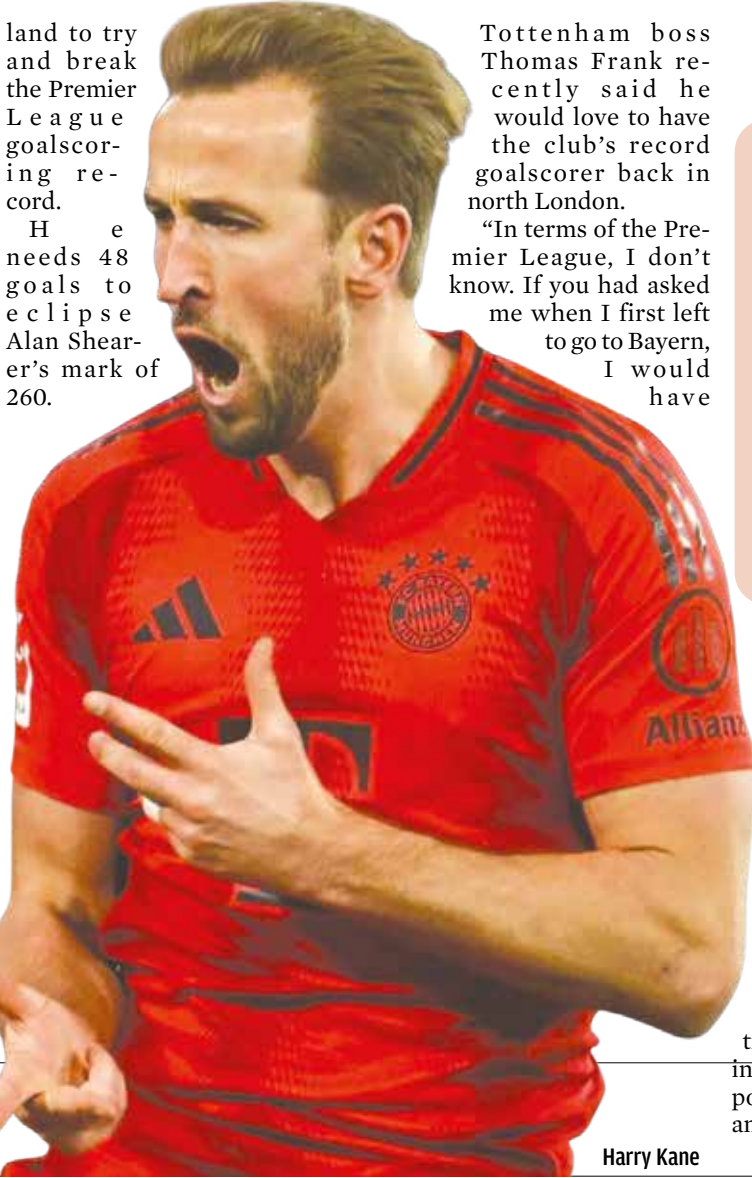
Harry Kane is considering extending his stay at Bayern Munich after the England captain claimed his interest in returning to the Premier League has cooled. Kane has made a fast start to the season at Bayern, scoring 18 goals in 10 games to fuel the German champions' Bundesliga title defence. The 32-year-old, who has netted 103 goals in 106 appearances for Bayern, is under contract in Munich until 2027 and is "fully all in" ahead of possible negotiations over a new deal. "In terms of staying longer, I could definitely see that," said Kane, who has reported for England duty ahead of a friendly with Wales and a World Cup qualifier in Latvia. "I spoke openly a couple of weeks ago that I have not had those conversations with Bayern

three sets. The tournament continues this evening with Round of 16 matches in both the Boys' and Girls' Singles categories, as well



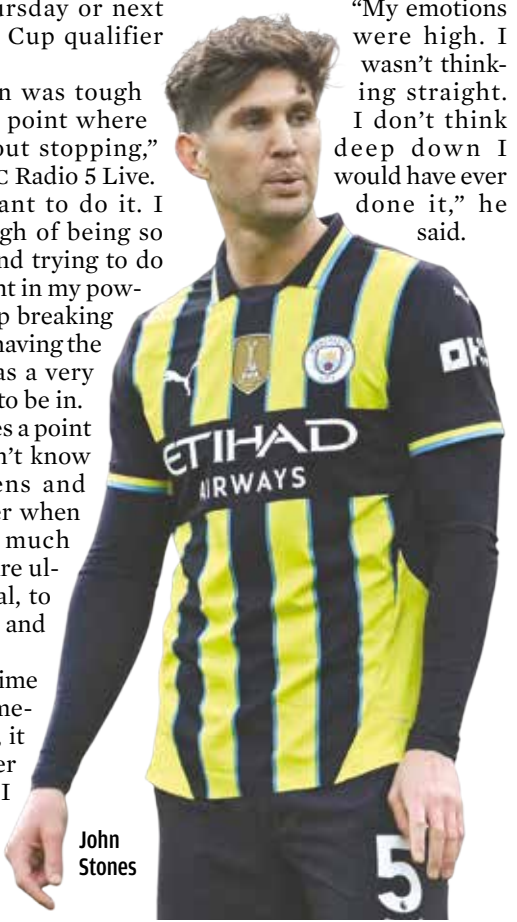

## Man City star Stones considered retiring after injury woes

Manchester City defender John Stones says he considered retiring last season as he struggled to cope with recurring injury problems. Stones spent most of the last campaign on the sidelines due to foot and hamstring injuries. The 31-year-old made just 24 appearances for City and England before his season ended prematurely in February. He is fit again and could make his first appearance under England boss Thomas Tuchel in the friendly against Wales on Thursday or next week's World Cup qualifier in Latvia. "Last season was tough for me, to the point where I thought about stopping," Stones told BBC Radio 5 Live. "I didn't want to do it. I had had enough of being so professional and trying to do everything right in my power, to then keep breaking down and not having the answers. It was a very difficult place to be in. "There comes a point where you don't know why it happens and it's even harder when you put in so much effort, or you are ultra professional, to be able to play and be available. "When that time comes and something happens, it would be easier to say, 'Well I didn't do X, Y and Z, that's why', but when you do it,

it's then mentally challenging. Hopefully I don't go back to that place." Stones has been unable to make more than 27 appearances in a league campaign for City since signing from Everton in 2016. He has won six Premier League titles, two FA Cups, two League Cups and the Champions League during his time at the Etihad Stadium. And the centre-back, who has been in the England squad at five major tournaments, said he quickly realised he couldn't walk away from the sport. "My emotions were high. I wasn't thinking straight. I don't think deep down I would have ever done it," he said.

## World MotoGP champion Marquez to miss two races with fracture

Newly-crowned world champion Marc Marquez was on Monday ruled out of the next two races after suffering a fracture and ligament injury to his right shoulder in the Indonesia MotoGP race. The Spaniard was shunted off his Ducati at high speed on the first lap of the Indonesia MotoGP on Sunday. Ducati said the Spaniard had "suffered a fracture at the base of the coracoid process and a ligament injury to his right shoulder," but ruled out any

connection with a previous shoulder injury. Marquez's medical team in Madrid have "opted for a conservative treatment plan, involving rest and immobilisation of the affected shoulder until it is fully healed and the fracture is clinically consolidated," Ducati said. This rules Marquez out of the Grand Prix in Australia (October 17-19) and another at Malaysia (October 24-26). That leaves two more races at Portugal (November 07-09) and Valencia (November 14-16) of the 22 race program.



# Djokovic vanquishes exhaustion to push through to Shanghai quarters

Serb shrugs off ankle scare and exhaustion to keep Shanghai Masters title hopes alive

● **Beat Spain's Jaume Munar 6-3, 5-7, 6-2**

● **Survived medical timeouts and long rallies**

**N**ovak Djokovic banished exhaustion and played through an ankle injury scare to make it to the quarterfinals of the Shanghai Masters yesterday, beating Spain's Jaume Munar 6-3, 5-7, 6-2.

The victory keeps Djokovic on track as the favourite to take a record-extending fifth title in the Chinese financial hub, with other top seeds already withdrawn or knocked out.

The 38-year-old almost looked like he might not be able to continue when the match went to a decider, but conjured

up the energy to break his decade-younger opponent twice in the third set.

"Thank you, thank you everyone, I love you!" he shouted in Chinese to the adoring

crowd before leaving court almost immediately after play finished.

The 24-time Grand Slam champion had

a good start, breaking in the fourth game, but shortly afterwards had to take a medical break when his left ankle slid out behind him as he rushed towards the net.

He grimaced in pain as he was attended to by an on-court physio, but managed to re-

sume to hold the fifth game.

Djokovic received treatment briefly again during a break in play in the second set, and looked increasingly fatigued, crouching over frequently in between rallies.

Serbian-flag-waving Chinese fans roared in support, but 41st-ranked Munar ultimately broke in the 12th game after an unforced error from his opponent.

An agonised Djokovic dropped to the floor and remained played out on court with his chest heaving, as his team rushed over.

But he picked himself up and in the third set had an incredible revival, breaking in the first and seventh games and sending the stadium into a frenzy.

Djokovic is the highest-ranking player left in the competition.

World number one Carlos Alcaraz withdrew from the tournament to rest, and second, third and fourth-ranked Jannik Sinner, Alexander Zverev and Taylor Fritz have all been eliminated.

The event in Shanghai has been beset by injuries, as players have battled temperatures

of over 30 Celsius and humidity levels peaking at over 80 percent.

Sinner was forced to retire on Sunday after being seized with extreme cramps.

World number 11 Holger Rune, who has also struggled with the conditions, called yesterday for tennis authorities to bring in a heat policy for events like Shanghai.

The Dane is through to the last eight after he took out France's Giovanni Mpetshi Perricard 6-4, 6-7 (7/9), 6-3.

## Raducanu retires from opening match in Wuhan heat with dizziness

**E**mma Raducanu had her blood pressure and other vitals checked before retiring from her Wuhan Open first-round match with dizziness when down 6-1, 4-1 to American Ann Li yesterday.

The British world number 30 appeared to be struggling with the conditions as temperatures soared to 30 C, forcing tournament organisers to apply the heat rule in the first two days of competition.

Raducanu broke in the opening game of the match but immediately lost her advantage and would not win another game in a 28-minute first set.

The 2021 US Open champion received medical attention five games into the second set.

She made the call to retire, sending Li into a second-round meeting with ninth-seeded

Ekatrina Alexandrova.

The heat rule allows players to take a 10-minute break between the second and third sets, and means the tournament can partially or fully close the roof to protect players from the heat.

In the Raducanu-Li match the roof was partially closed.

Earlier, four-time major champion Naomi Osaka claimed her first-ever victory at the Wuhan Open with a hard-fought 4-6, 7-5, 6-3 victory over Canada's Leylah Fernandez.

In a tense two-hour 30-minute affair, the 11th-seeded Osaka fired 41 winners and 56 unforced errors.

Osaka, who is playing in Wuhan for the first time since 2017, awaits in-form Linda Noskova or Kazakhstan's Yulia Putintseva in the second round.
