Trump storms out of tense, rain-plagued NBC interview

President Donald Trump lasted through probing questions about his Iran war strategy and repeated weather disruptions during an interview with US broadcaster NBC -- but angrily stormed out when confronted over his unfounded claims of election fraud.

"You're a one-sided, crooked network. Sorry. Let's call it quits because I've had enough. Thank you, darling. Have a good time," Trump told "Meet the Press" host Kristen Welker before standing up and walking out of the interview that aired Sunday.

The interview, filmed Friday, was conducted on a farm in Wisconsin, where Trump was addressing farmers. A tractor and hay bales served as a backdrop.

The interview was interrupted several times by weather and audio issues as torrential rain pounded the roof, making it difficult to continue the conversation.

"Is that wind or what?" Trump asked at one point.

"Hear that sound?" he said later. "That sound of thunder, lightning, rain."

Welker asked her technical

crew if they should stop.

"No. People will understand -- we're on a farm," the president replied.

Several questions followed about Iran, nuclear weapons and his campaign pledges to keep the United States out of foreign wars.

"First of all, I didn't guarantee no war. Why would I have built

the strongest military in the world?" he said, then accusing Welker of being "a big liberal, a big progressive."

"No, I'm just a journalist," she countered.

Trump went on to say: "I don't like these endless wars. This is not an endless war. We've been doing this for three months."

The tone escalated again

as the discussion turned to Trump's proposed taxpayer-funded program to compensate people he believes were victims of partisan prosecution under his predecessor, Joe Biden.

"I don't know what's going to happen with the weaponization fund," he said. "I love the idea because people like you, the fake dirty press, the crooked press, people like stupid Biden ... they destroyed people. They sent people to jail who did nothing wrong."

"There is no evidence for what you're saying," Welker said.

Trump reiterated past false claims that the 2020 election was "rigged" and said last week's primary in California was, too.

Welker held her ground, asking the president to present evidence.

"You are either crooked or you're stupid," Trump finally shot back before leaving the camera's view while Welker attempted to keep him engaged.

On Sunday, Welker told viewers that she had spoken with Trump on Saturday about the weather disruptions and that he had agreed to give her another interview.

France, Germany abandon joint fighter jet project: Berlin

France and Germany have agreed to abandon a joint fighter jet programme due to disagreements between the companies involved, Berlin said yesterday in a blow to European efforts to boost defence cooperation.

The Future Combat Air System (FCAS) programme was launched in 2017 to replace France's Rafale jets and the



Eurofighter planes used by Germany and Spain.

The project was seen as a key test of European efforts to work more closely on defence

as they seek to present a united front in the face of a hostile Russia at a time of souring ties with the United States.

But the multi-billion-dollar

programme was beset by disagreements between the firms involved -- France's Dassault Aviation and Airbus, which represents Germany and Spain.

A German government official told AFP that Chancellor Friedrich Merz and French President Emmanuel Macron had "reached the shared assessment that the companies will not be able to come together on building a joint combat aircraft.

Indian crew evacuated after 10 months stranded off Istanbul

Four Indian sailors who were stranded for 10 months on an abandoned container ship off the coast of Turkey have finally been taken off the vessel, an inspector told AFP yesterday.

The four had been trapped on board the *Mongolia-flagged Azra C*, which has been moored off Istanbul in the Sea of Marmara since August 2025.

The ship's purported owners were arrested in January in connection with a massive international drugs bust, leaving its fate and those on board in limbo.

"The hardship experienced by the

crew has come to an end," Selahattin Polat, Turkey representative of the International Transport Workers' Federation (ITF), told AFP.

The crew spoke of their distress last week, speaking to AFP via an intermediary.

The ITF and the Marine Employees' Solidarity Association (DAD-DER) had been providing the crew with fresh drinking water and basic necessities.

Under international maritime law, a ship must have sufficient crew members on board at all times to handle any emergencies -- whether in port or at anchor.

But Polat said they had not been replaced.

"The new crew did not arrive. The ship was left unmanned," he explained, saying "its security will be ensured by other means."

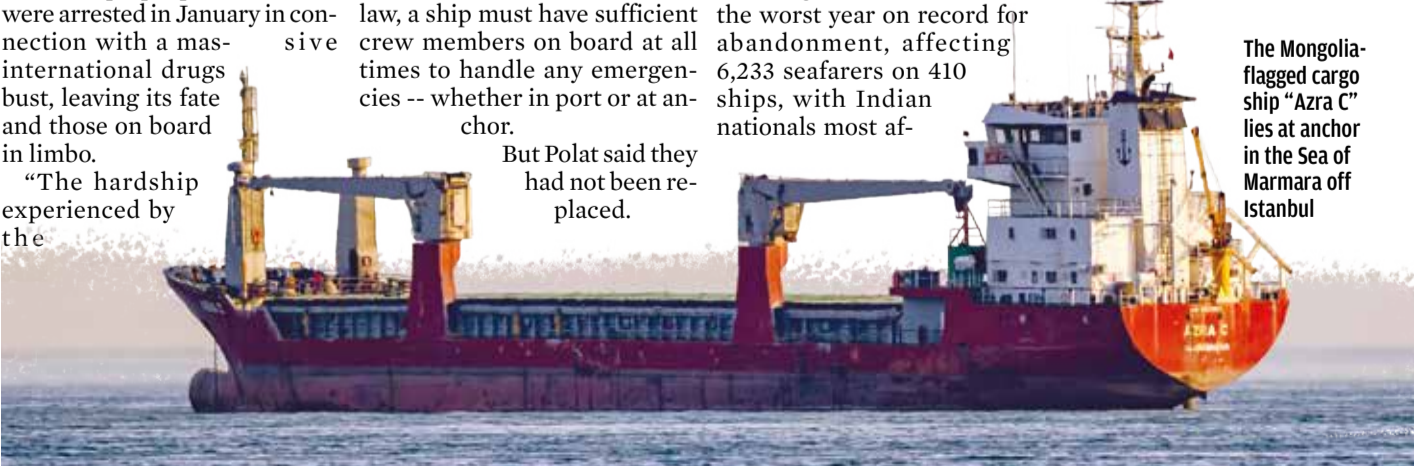
He said legal steps to deal with the abandoned ship were ongoing.

The case highlights a growing problem of vessel abandonments, which the ITF says has become a "systemic" problem in the maritime industry.

ITF figures show 2025 was the worst year on record for abandonment, affecting 6,233 seafarers on 410 ships, with Indian nationals most af-

ected. Turkey was the country where the most abandonments took place, accounting for 61 cases last year.

There are currently 15 foreign-flagged vessels classed as abandoned at anchor in the Sea of Marmara, which lies between the Bosphorus Strait that leads to the Black Sea and the Dardanelles Strait, the gateway to the Mediterranean.
