Israel yesterday announced its decision to take control of Gaza City, triggering swift and widespread criticism from the international community, including Saudi Arabia, China, Turkey, the United Kingdom, and the UN's human rights chief.

In a strong rebuke, Saudi Arabia's Foreign Ministry posted on X (formerly Twitter), saying Riyadh "categorically condemns [Israel's] persistence in committing crimes of starvation, brutal practices, and ethnic cleansing against the brotherly Palestinian people."

In a separate statement, also

posted on X, the ministry added that it "condemns in the strongest and most forceful terms the decision of the Israeli occupation authorities to occupy the Gaza Strip."

Under the newly approved plan by security cabinet, the Israeli army "will prepare to take control of Gaza City while distributing humanitarian assistance to the civilian population outside combat zones", Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's office said yesterday.

Before the decision, Netanyahu had said Israel planned to seize complete control of the Gaza Strip, but did not intend to govern the territory where nearly two million people are on

the brink of famine.

"We don't want to keep it," the premier told US network Fox News on Thursday, adding Israel wanted a "security perimeter" and to hand the Palestinian territory to "Arab forces that will govern it properly without threatening us".

Netanyahu's office said a majority of the security cabinet had adopted "five principles", including demilitarisation of the territory and "the establishment of an alternative civil administration that is neither Hamas nor the Palestinian Authority".

Hamas denounced the plan as a "new war crime", while staunch Israeli ally Germany took the extraordinary step of

and Karbala after feeling tired and exhausted. In a separate incident, Hajj Sayyid Salman Al-Abbar, from Manama, died in the city of Kadhimiya. Final farewell The funeral for the two men was held on Monday, with their bodies buried in Al-Ghari Cemetery in Najaf. Family members and mourners attended the burial to pay their respects. Arbaeen marks the end of a 40-day mourning period for martyrdom of Imam Hussein, drawing millions of pilgrims each year to holy sites in Iraq.

Man dies after being found in abnormal condition on public street

A 42-year-old man who was discovered in an abnormal condition on a public street has died while being transported to hospital. The Ministry of Interior confirmed the incident, stating that the man — whose nationality and other details remain undisclosed — was found by emergency police patrols. He was taken to hospital by the national ambulance service, but succumbed en route. The ministry added that the competent authorities have taken all necessary legal measures.

Arab League signs academic cooperation deal with University for Peace under Bahrain's chairmanship

Under Bahrain's chairmanship of the Council of Arab Ambassadors in Geneva, the Arab League has signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with the University for Peace (UPEACE) to strengthen academic cooperation in the fields of peace, development, and human rights. The signing ceremony took place at the headquarters of the Arab League Mission in Geneva and was attended by Ambassador Abdulla Abdullatif Abdulla, Bahrain's Permanent Representative to the United Nations Office and other international organisations in Geneva; Hichem Bayoudh, Permanent Observer of the League of Arab States to the United Nations Office at Geneva; David Fernández, Permanent Observer of UPEACE to the United Nations Office in Geneva; alongside several Arab ambassadors accredited in Geneva and a delegation from UPEACE. Ambassador Abdulla said the agreement reflects efforts to deepen partnerships between the Arab League and international academic institutions. He noted that the collaboration will allow Arab professionals to benefit from the University for Peace and UN programmes, especially in the area of multilateral relations, and will support broader goals of peacebuilding and sustainable development.



Massive warehouse fire in Muharraq

Appeals court allows BD20,000 Gulf verdict to take effect

● Commercial dispute filed by a Gulf-based businessman

● Foreign judgment met all legal conditions for enforcement

The Supreme Civil Appeals Court has ruled that a BD20,000 judgment issued by a court in a Gulf country in a commercial dispute is en-

The appeals court noted that under Bahrain’s Civil and Commercial Execution Law, foreign judgments may be enforced in the Kingdom, provided they meet the same conditions required for enforcing Bahraini rulings in the issuing country.

forceable in Bahrain. The decision came in response to a case filed by a Gulf-based businessman against a local contracting company over unpaid commercial transactions. The court overturned an earlier lower court ruling that had rejected

the enforcement request on the grounds that the foreign judgment was not final. However, appeals judges found the ruling to be conclusive and binding, as the appeal window had passed. Lawyer Abrar Bukheet, rep-

resenting the claimant, said her client had initially filed the case in his home country after a business dispute with the Bahraini company’s owner. The foreign court ordered the defendant to pay nearly BD20,000 in penalties and

outstanding dues. A retrial request was denied, prompting the claimant to seek enforcement through Bahrain’s courts. The appeals court cited Bahrain’s Civil and Commercial Execution Law, which allows

enforcement of foreign judgments under reciprocal terms—provided certain conditions are met. These include confirming that Bahraini courts had no jurisdiction over the case, that due process was followed, the ruling was final, and it did not conflict with any previous Bahraini judgment. The court confirmed that the Gulf ruling met all requirements, including carrying the executory formula and the authority of res judicata. It accepted the appeal, overturned the lower court’s decision, and approved enforcement of the foreign judgment within the Kingdom.

Insurance firm ordered to pay BD8,910 in total loss vehicle claim

The Commercial Court has ordered an insurance company to pay BD8,910 to the owner of a 2019 Infiniti vehicle, which was declared a total loss following an accident that led to engine failure. The court also ruled that the insurer must cover part of the legal costs, expert fees, and case expenses, while retaining ownership of the car’s remains. The case was brought by the vehicle’s owner through lawyer Ahmed Tawk, after the insurer refused to cover the cost of replacing the engine. The accident occurred on July 29, 2024, when the car suffered front-end damage in a collision, including a punctured radiator that caused coolant loss and, subsequently, engine failure. However, the court-appointed expert concluded that the engine failure was directly linked to the accident. The report explained that coolant loss caused by the damaged radiator, combined with the day’s heat and pressure inside the cooling system, led to the failure rapidly—leaving no realistic opportunity for the driver to prevent it. The expert valued the vehicle at BD9,000 before the crash and BD1,800 as scrap, with estimated repairs at BD13,000, deeming the damage a total loss. The insurer, in its defence, claimed the damage resulted from the owner’s actions after the accident, alleging he continued to drive the car without safeguarding the engine. It submitted an opposing report from its own appointed expert.

Kingdom ramps up maternal health efforts

Training and awareness As part of these plans, accredited training workshops have been rolled out for healthcare personnel, alongside awareness campaigns for mothers. Officials said this underlines a commitment to enhancing maternal and child care services, and to entrenching breastfeeding as a key pillar of community health.

Policy support


Bahrain has adopted several supportive measures, including promoting the ‘Baby-Friendly Hospitals’ initiative, tightening oversight of breast-milk substitute marketing, introducing maternity leave legislation, and encouraging dedicated breastfeeding rooms in workplaces. The ministry said these steps

contribute to the Kingdom’s sustainable development goals and promote healthy societal practices. The ministry reaf-


firmed that such programmes are designed to build a healthier, more sustainable society for future generations.

Survey Highlights Shift in Gaza Coverage Practices

Adoption moves from novelty to norm

- 390 journalists surveyed
- Gaza war coverage focus
- Al Arabiya sets benchmark

A survey of Arab journalists has revealed a significant shift in attitudes toward the use of drones in conflict coverage, with Al Arabiya's reporting from Gaza emerging as a benchmark for quality and audience engagement.

The study, conducted by researcher Haya Abdulrahman Barzan and published in Arab Media & Society magazine, drew on responses from a deliberate sample of 390 Arab journalists.

It was framed within the Diffusion of Innovations theory, which examines how new technologies are adopted across professional fields.

Tech embraced

Most respondents viewed drone technology as both useful and effective for covering the

Gaza war, saying it enhanced the quality of news reporting and increased public interaction with the stories.

The research also found that a

majority of participants placed high value on Al Arabiya's drone coverage, seeing it as a model for others in the Arab media landscape.

Professional shift

The findings suggest drones are no longer viewed as a novelty in war reporting, but as an estab-

lished tool with clear benefits for accuracy, storytelling, and audience reach.

The study reflects a broader readiness among Arab journalists to integrate emerging technologies into their work, particularly in high-stakes environments such as conflict zones.



The first journalistic use of drones dates back to 2011, when The Daily in the U.S. used one to capture tornado damage in Alabama.

MP Alawi urges stronger support measures for Bahraini women

MP Jaleela Alawi, Chair of Parliament's Services Committee, has welcomed the signing of a unified memorandum of understanding (MoU) between the Ministries of Interior, Justice, and Social Development, the Supreme Council for Women, and the Royal Humanitarian Foundation.

She said the agreement aims to strengthen coordination in supporting Bahraini women, particularly in urgent humanitarian cases.

Alawi highlighted the social and economic pressures some women face, including divorce, domestic violence, or sudden hardship due to the death of a breadwinner or job loss. The MoU, she explained, es-

establishes a collaborative framework to address such cases swiftly and efficiently by allocating available resources based on clear priorities.

She called for further integration of this initiative into national plans and programmes, urging expanded access to free legal aid for divorcees and victims of domestic violence through the Ministry of Justice's legal aid offices. She

also advocated for the inclusion of female-headed households in housing and social support schemes, streamlined administrative procedures, and the creation of a unified national database to track critical cases and enable joint action by the relevant authorities.

Alawi additionally proposed exploring fast-track in-kind and cash assistance from the Royal Humanitarian Foundation for women facing severe hardship.

She stressed the importance of public awareness campaigns to ensure that available support services reach those eligible and are used effectively.

Alawi commended all participating institutions and affirmed that the Services Committee stands ready to support any legislation or proposals aimed at expanding social protection for Bahraini women and families.

Legal Reform Bill nears final review

To finish within two months

A draft law to rewrite Bahrain's legal profession, requiring insurance, barring lawyers from public posts, and imposing fines of up to 10,000 dinars, has almost cleared Parliament's Legislative and Legal Affairs Committee, according to sources familiar with the matter.

The committee expects to finish its review within two months. Once done, the bill will be passed to the Bureau, which will decide when to put it before the full chamber.

The draft introduces several new requirements, starting with compulsory professional liability insurance. Lawyers would need to maintain an active policy throughout their time on the roll. Those found in breach may face a written warning, suspension, a requirement to attend training, or a financial penalty. The bill also expands the definition of misconduct to include violations of any regulation issued under the law. Civil and criminal liabilities remain untouched.

The penalty of 'reprimand'

is removed. Warnings must be issued in writing. A ban from practice becomes a formal suspension.

Trainee lawyers

Trainee lawyers would face tighter restrictions. They would only be allowed to represent clients in minor courts, using their own name, and always under the direct supervision of a qualified lawyer. They would not be allowed to open their own office. Joining the profession would also require passing a training course and an entrance exam approved by the ministry.

Article 4 of the bill states that legal practice may not be combined with roles in government, Parliament, state bodies, banks, companies or associations. A Royal Decree may grant an exception, but only following Cabinet recommendation.

A central roll will be kept by the ministry. It will include lawyers' names, places of residence and offices of work. The roll will be divided into categories for practising, non-practising and trainee lawyers. Further sub-rolls will cover those licensed to appear before specific courts, including minor, major, appeals, cassation and constitutional.

Foreign lawyers

Foreign lawyers may, under specific terms, appear in Bah-

raini courts if paired with a local lawyer licensed to practise at the top level. They are barred from handling criminal, administrative or Sharia matters.

Eligibility

Eligibility rules remain unchanged in principle. Lawyers must be Bahraini, of full legal capacity, hold a law degree and be of sound character. A new rule would require them to submit proof of valid insurance from a licensed Bahraini provider. The minister will decide the minimum coverage amount for each lawyer category.

Article 12 removes reference to the Minister of Justice and Islamic Affairs in relation to removal from the roll for non-payment. A lawyer struck off for failing to renew must pay both the late and re-entry fee to be listed again.

Article 13 instructs lawyers who stop practising, either permanently or temporarily, to request transfer to the non-practising roll. Those who return may apply to move back to the practising or trainee roll, depending on their status.

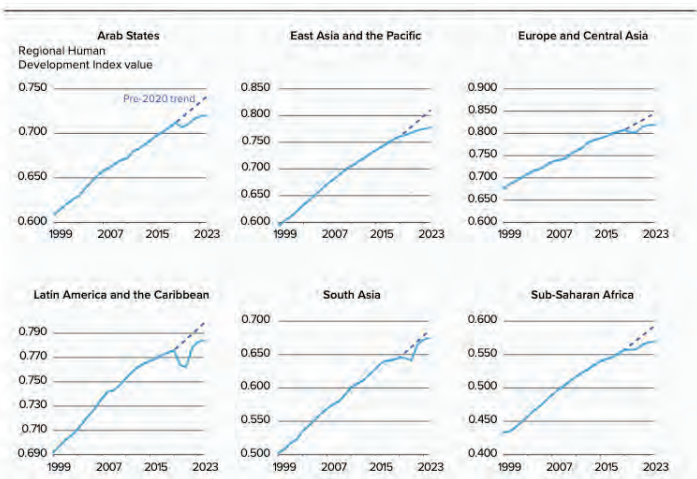
If the committee completes its work on time, the bill may be scheduled for debate before the end of the year. The proposed law rewrites how the legal trade is structured and supervised in Bahrain.

Development Programme, recording a Human Development Index (HDI) score of 0.899. The index measures performance in health, education and income. The United Arab Emirates

topped the Arab list, taking 15th place globally with a score of 0.940. Saudi Arabia followed in

37th place with 0.900, placing just ahead of Bahrain. Qatar came fourth in the Arab

world and 43rd worldwide with 0.886. Oman was fifth regionally and 50th globally on 0.858, while Kuwait placed sixth among Arab states and 52nd overall with

0.852. In North Africa, Algeria ranked 96th globally with a score of 0.763. Jordan and Egypt shared 100th place on 0.754. Lebanon was 102nd with 0.752, followed by Tunisia in 105th with 0.746. Libya ranked 110th on 0.721, Morocco 120th on 0.710, and Iraq 126th on 0.695. Palestine was last among Arab states, in 133rd place with 0.674. The HDI is calculated using life expectancy at birth, mean years of schooling and educational attainment, and gross national income per capita. Scores range from zero to one, with higher values indicating stronger development in those areas.

Gold futures hit a record high yesterday after reports of an unexpected tariff on the precious metal, while stock markets fluctuated as investors tracked US President Donald Trump's latest moves. Oil prices added to losses from the previous day on news of a meeting between Trump and Russian leader Vladimir Putin, perhaps as early as next week, which raised hopes of a truce with Ukraine. Gold futures reached a new intraday high at \$3,534.10 an ounce after the Financial Times reported that Washington had classified one-kilo bars, the most traded type of bullion on Comex -- the world's biggest futures market, as subject to "reciprocal" tariff rates.

One-kilo bars make up the largest part of Switzerland's gold shipments to the United States. Imports from Switzerland face a 39-percent recipro-

cal tariff from Thursday. The FT said 100-ounce bars would also face the levy. The levy caused "shock and confusion" in markets, said Han Tan, chief market analyst at Nemo.money trading group. The gold future price pulled

back to \$3 an ounce. Spot gold prices sat around \$3,400 an ounce. Saxo Bank analyst Ole Hansen said banks invest in gold futures to protect themselves from price swings in the physical bullion market.

OpenAI releases ChatGPT-5 as AI race accelerates

OpenAI released a keenly awaited new generation of its hallmark ChatGPT on Thursday, touting "significant" advancements in artificial intelligence capabilities as a global race over the technol-



ogy accelerates. ChatGPT-5 is rolling out free to all users of the AI tool, which is used by nearly 700 million people weekly, OpenAI said in a briefing with journalists. Co-founder and chief executive Sam Altman touted this latest iteration as "clearly a model that is generally intelligent." Altman cautioned that there is still work to be done to achieve the kind of artificial general intelligence (AGI) that thinks the way people do. "This is not a model that continuously learns as it is deployed from new things it finds, which

is something that, to me, feels like it should be part of an AGI," Altman said. "But the level of capability here is a huge improvement." Industry analysts have heralded the arrival of an AI era in which genius computers transform how humans work and play. "As the pace of AI progress accelerates, developing superintelligence is coming into sight," Meta chief executive Mark Zuckerberg wrote in a recent memo. "I believe this will be the beginning of a new era for humanity." Altman said there were "orders of magnitude more gains" to come on the path toward AGI. "Obviously... you have to invest in compute (power) at an eye

watering rate to get that, but we intend to keep doing it." Tech industry rivals Amazon, Google, Meta, Microsoft and Elon Musk's xAI have been pouring billions of dollars into artificial intelligence since the blockbuster launch of the first version of ChatGPT in late 2022. Chinese startup DeepSeek shook up the AI sector early this year with a model that delivers high performance using less costly chips. 'PhD-level expert' - With fierce competition around the world over the technology, Altman said ChatGPT-5 led the pack in coding, writing, health care and much more. "GPT-3 felt to me like talking to a high school student -- ask a question, maybe you get a right

answer, maybe you'll get something crazy," Altman said. "GPT-4 felt like you're talking to a college student; GPT-5 is the first time that it really feels like talking to a PhD-level expert in any topic." Altman expects the ability to create software programs on demand -- so-called "vibe-coding" -- to be a "defining part of the new ChatGPT-5 era." In a blog post, British AI expert Simon Willison wrote about getting early access to ChatGPT-5. "My verdict: it's just good at stuff," Willison wrote. "It doesn't feel like a dramatic leap ahead from other (large language models) but it exudes competence -- it rarely messes up, and frequently impresses me."

However Musk wrote on X, formerly Twitter, that his Grok 4 Heavy AI model "was smarter" than ChatGPT-5.



The release of "open-weight language models" comes as OpenAI is under pressure to share inner workings of its software in the spirit of its origin as a nonprofit.

French firefighters optimistic
after controlling vast wildfire



◆ French authorities said yesterday that they were counting on better weather conditions to help put out the country's biggest wildfire in at least half a century after firefighters finally managed to bring it under control. The fire near the Mediterranean coast ravaged a vast area of the Aude department at the peak of the summer tourist season, killing one person and wounding several others. Experts

say European countries are becoming ever more vulnerable to such disasters due to intensifying summer heatwaves linked to global warming. Firefighters announced that the Aude blaze was brought under control on Thursday, though it would still take several days before it is completely extinguished.

◆ Ten people are dead and 33 missing after flash floods and mudslides in northwest China's Gansu province, state media reported yesterday, the latest in a series of lethal weather events to hit the country. Natural disasters are common across China, particularly in the summer, when some regions experience heavy rain while others

bake in searing heat. Chinese President Xi Jinping ordered "utmost effort" in rescuing the missing people yesterday, state broadcaster CCTV said.

◆ Japan's weather agency issued a special heavy rain alert for the southern region of Kagoshima yesterday, warning "lives are at risk" as authorities told half a million people to evacuate. Television footage showed brown, fast-flowing water overflowing its banks to inundate homes in Kagoshima.

US raises bounty on
Venezuela's Maduro to \$50 mn

The United States doubled its bounty on Venezuelan President Nicolas Maduro -- who faces federal drug trafficking charges -- to \$50 million on Thursday, a move Caracas described as "pathetic" and "ridiculous".

Washington, which does not recognize Maduro's past two election victories, accuses the South American country's leader of leading a cocaine trafficking gang.

"Today, the Department of Justice and State Department are announcing a historic \$50 million reward for information leading to the arrest of Nicolas Maduro," Attorney General Pam Bondi said in a video on social media.

"He is one of the largest narco-traffickers in the world and a threat to our national security."

The previous bounty was set in January at \$25 million.

Venezuelan Foreign Minister Yvan Gil said Bondi's "pathetic" bounty was "the most ridiculous smokescreen we

have ever seen."

"The dignity of our homeland is not for sale. We reject this crude political propaganda operation," Gil said on Telegram.

In 2020, during President Donald Trump's first term in office, Maduro and other high-ranking Venezuelan officials were indicted in federal court in New York on several charges including participating in a "narco-terrorism" conspiracy.

The Justice Department accused Maduro of leading a cocaine trafficking gang called "The Cartel of the Suns" that shipped hundreds of tons of narcotics into the United States over two decades, earning hundreds of millions of dollars.

Investigators say the cartel worked hand-in-hand with the rebel Revolutionary Armed Forces of Colombia (FARC), which the United States has labeled a terrorist organization.

Bondi said Maduro also had worked with the Venezuelan gang Tren de Aragua and Mexico's Sinaloa cartel.

Putin seeks ally support

Putin consults Xi and Modi before possible high-stakes meeting with Donald Trump

Russian President Vladimir Putin yesterday held consultations with the leaders of China and India, seeking support from his key allies ahead of a likely summit with Donald Trump.

The calls came hours before a deadline from the US president on Moscow to halt its Ukraine offensive or face crippling new economic sanctions, expected to target Russia's key trading partners.

Both Washington and Moscow have confirmed a Putin-Trump meeting is set to take place, possibly as early as next week.

Trump has spent his first months in office trying to broker peace in Ukraine after boasting he could end the conflict in 24 hours -- but his efforts so far have failed to yield a breakthrough.

He also wants countries such as China and India to cut their purchases of Moscow's oil and gas, a key source of revenue that Kyiv and the West say funds its army.

Trump earlier this week hiked tariffs on India over its purchases of Russian oil, which have surged since February 2022 when Moscow launched its campaign.

The Kremlin said yesterday that Putin had updated Chinese President Xi Jinping on "the main results of his conversation" with US special envoy Steve Witkoff who visited Moscow earlier this week.

Xi expressed support for a

"long-term" solution to the conflict, the Kremlin said.

China's Xinhua state news agency quoted Xi as having told Putin: "China is glad to see Russia and the United States maintain contact, improve their relations, and promote a political settlement of the Ukraine crisis."

Moscow and Beijing have deepened political, economic and military ties since Russia's offensive.

China has portrayed itself as a neutral party in the conflict, but never denounced the offensive or called for Russia to withdraw.

'Only fair'

Putin also spoke by phone to India's Prime Minister Narendra Modi, after both countries condemned the new US tariffs over New Delhi's oil purchases.

Neither side elaborated on what had been discussed.

Xi and Modi have both tried to tout their own peace initiatives for Ukraine, though they have gained little traction.

Trump's deadline for Russia to strike a peace deal or face new sanctions -- expected to target its trading partners -- was set to pass later yesterday.

Asked by reporters in the Oval Office if that deadline still held despite the upcoming summit, Trump did not give a clear an-

swer.

"It's going to be up to (Putin)," Trump said. "We're going to see what he has to say."

Three rounds of talks between Russia and Ukraine have failed to yield a breakthrough and it remains unclear whether a summit would bring peace any closer.

On the streets of Moscow expectations were also low.

"Hope for the best, prepare for the worst," Irina, a 57-year-old lawyer, told AFP.

"To be honest, I have no hopes," she added.

Putin has resisted multiple calls from the United States, Europe and Kyiv for a ceasefire.

He has also ruled out holding talks with Volodymyr Zelensky at this stage, a meeting the Ukrainian president says is necessary to make headway on a deal.

Tens of thousands of people have been killed since Russia launched its offensive, with millions forced to flee their homes in eastern and southern Ukraine.

Indian PM Modi says had 'good' conversation with Putin

Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi said he had "a very good" conversation with Russian President Vladimir Putin yesterday, during which they discussed Ukraine and ways to strengthen bilateral ties.

"Had a very good and detailed conversation with my friend President Putin. I thanked him for sharing the latest developments on Ukraine," Modi posted on social media. "I look forward to hosting President Putin in India later this year."

The telephone call between the two leaders came after US President Donald Trump imposed punishing tariffs on India.

Trump on Wednesday announced he would double levies on Indian goods to 50 percent over New Delhi's purchasing of Russian oil, a key revenue source for Moscow's war in Ukraine.

A first salvo of 25 percent tar-

iffs on Indian goods took effect on Thursday, with the additional 25 percent set to apply in three weeks.

Berlin suspends military exports amid concerns over Gaza City offensive

Merz questions Israeli military strategy

Humanitarian crisis in Gaza deepens

485 million euros in exports since 2023

Germany will halt the export of military equipment to Israel that could be used in the Gaza Strip, Chancellor Friedrich Merz said yesterday, reacting to Israel's plan to take control of Gaza City.

The arms export freeze marks a drastic change of course for Germany, which has long been one of Israel's staunchest international allies.

Merz said it was "increasingly unclear" how the latest Israeli military plan would help achieve the aims of disarming Hamas and freeing the remaining Israeli hostages.

"Under these circumstances, the German government will not authorise any exports of military equipment that could be used in the Gaza Strip until further notice," he said in a statement.

Berlin "remains deeply concerned about the suffering of the civilian population in Gaza," he added.

Israel has until recently enjoyed broad support across the political spectrum in Germany, a country still seeking to atone for the World War II murder of more than six million Jews.

Between the Hamas attack of October 7, 2023 that started the Gaza war and May this year, Germany approved defence exports

worth 485 million euros (\$565 million) to Israel.

The deliveries included fire-arms, ammunition, weapons parts, electronic equipment and armoured vehicles, the government said in June.

Merz reiterated that "Israel has the right to defend itself against Hamas' terror" and that "the release of the hostages and negotiations on a ceasefire are our top priorities".

"The disarmament of Hamas is imperative. Hamas must not play a role in Gaza in future," he said.

But he added that "the new military push agreed by the Israeli security cabinet makes it increasingly unclear how these

goals are to be achieved".

Germany's Central Council of Jews called Merz's decision "disappointing" and said the government should "correct course" and increase pressure on Hamas instead.

Gaza suffering 'unbearable'

Merz's decision is a dramatic step for Germany, where the chancellor's tone towards Israel has been sharpening in recent months as the dire humanitarian situation in Gaza deteriorated further.

Vice Chancellor Lars Klingbeil of the Social Democrats welcomed the "just decision", saying "the humanitarian suffering in Gaza is unbearable".

A poll published this week by public broadcaster ARD found that 66 percent of Germans expected the government to exert greater influence over Israel to change its actions in Gaza.

However, while often voicing concern, Germany had so far

avoided major concrete steps.

It refrained from following France, Britain and Canada, which have announced plans to recognise a Palestinian state in September, saying recognition must come at the end of Israeli-Palestinian negotiations.

Berlin has also opposed the suspension of the EU-Israel Association Agreement, which had been under review by the bloc.

Global alarm has been growing over the suffering in Gaza, where a UN-backed assessment has warned that famine is unfolding.

German air force planes have joined others with humanitarian aid airdrops over the war-battered coastal territory.

Merz said that "with the planned offensive, the Israeli government bears even greater responsibility" for providing aid to Gaza and again urged "comprehensive access" for UN agencies and aid groups.

Families of Air India crash victims demand release of flight recorders

Preliminary report cites fuel cutoff

Legal action against Air India, Boeing considered

65 families represented by US law firm

Families of the victims of June's deadly Air India crash demanded yesterday the immediate release of the aircraft's two flight recorders, saying delays were eroding their trust in the investigation.

A total of 241 people on board the London-bound Boeing 787 Dreamliner were killed when the plane crashed shortly after take-off from Ahmedabad in western India on June 12.

Another 19 people were killed on the ground.

A preliminary investigation report by India's Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau said fuel

to the jet's engines was cut off moments before impact.

The report did not offer any conclusions or apportion blame for the disaster, but indicated, based on the cockpit voice recording, that one pilot asked the other why he cut off fuel. The second pilot responded that he had not.

"We are formally demanding the immediate release of

the Cockpit Voice Recorder and Flight Data Recorder -- the black box," said Imtiaz Ali Sayed, a family member of several victims.

"These devices contain vital information that can reveal the truth behind this horrific tragedy," he said in a media statement.

Sayed, whose younger brother, his wife and their two children were killed in the crash, said he

was speaking on behalf of 60 families "who share the same pain and unanswered questions".

"Every day without answers deepens the pain of our loss and erodes public trust in aviation safety," he said.

Some of the families are exploring legal action against Air India and Boeing, the plane's US manufacturer, their lawyer said.

Beasley Allen Law Firm, representing 65 families from India and Britain, met relatives in Vadodara city, south of Ahmedabad, yesterday after visiting the crash site.

"Suppose the flight data recorder and cockpit voice recorder indicate that there is a defect with the aircraft... in that case, the options are to bring a defective product or a product liability claim in the United States for those claims," he told reporters.

Mboko wins Montreal crown

18-year-old wildcard topples four-time Slam champ Osaka in three-set thriller

● **Mboko wins 2-6, 6-4, 6-1**

● **First WTA title in first final**

Canadian teenager Victoria Mboko conquered four-time Grand Slam champion Naomi Osaka 2-6, 6-4, 6-1 on Thursday, capping a fairytale run at the WTA Canadian Open with her first WTA title.

Mboko, 18 and playing in her first WTA final, denied Osaka her first tour-level title since the 2021 Australian Open, wearing down the Japanese star, 27, who has struggled to find consistency since returning from maternity leave early in 2024.

Mboko, who was ranked outside the top 300 to start the season and had climbed to 85th entering the week, is now projected to rise to 34th in the world.

Before an ecstatic center court crowd of 11,000, she converted eight of her nine break points, seizing her fourth win of the week over a Grand Slam winner.

She ousted former Australian Open champion Sofia Kenin in the second round and toppled reigning French Open champion Coco Gauff in the fourth before saving a match point en route to a semi-final victory over former Wimbledon winner Elena Rybakina.

“It’s been an incredible week,” Mboko celebrated as she held up the trophy.

Displaying vintage power and precision, Osaka gave her inexperienced opponent little room to maneuver in the first set, gaining an early break on the way to a 3-0 lead and pocketing the set when Mboko, who had 22 unforced errors in the set, mis-fired on two forehands to drop her serve a second time.

Mboko turned the tide in a second set that featured seven total breaks of serve. Osaka looked bewildered as Mboko ramped up the pressure, the Canadian breaking her at love for a 5-2 lead.

Serving for the set, however, Mboko coughed up three double faults and was broken. Osaka capitalized on the reprieve with a hold at love, but Mboko took the set in the next game when Osaka sailed a forehand long on set point.



Osaka was on the ropes again in the third game, drawing a warning for batting a ball skyward in frustration after missing her first serve on break point -- which she surrendered with another errant forehand.

That launched a run of five straight games for Mboko.

Winners were proving hard to come by for both players, and when the Canadian saved four break points to hold for a 3-1 lead, Osaka had a mountain to climb that finally proved too steep.

When Osaka smacked a backhand into the net on match point, Mboko dropped to the court as the crowd -- who had backed her all the way with chants of “Allez Vicky” -- roared out one more ovation.

Osaka, who came into the tournament ranked 49th in the world, had appeared energized in Montreal after a coaching shakeup.

She posted her best performance in a WTA 1000 tournament since she reached the final at Miami in 2022, but her disappointment came through as she addressed the crowd at the trophy ceremony.

Venus Williams falls at first hurdle in Cincinnati

Venus Williams rallied from 4-1 down in the first set but could not maintain momentum, the seven-time Grand Slam champion falling 6-4, 6-4 to Jessica Bouzas Maneiro in the first round of the ATP-WTA Cincinnati Open on Thursday.

Williams, 45, was competing for the second time in three weeks after returning to the WTA tour in Washington in her first tournament in 16 months.

Williams won her first-round match in Washington before bowing out to Magdalena Frech in straight sets.

Bouzas Maneiro, ranked 51st, was thrilled by the sense of occasion on the opening day of the tournament, the last major tuneup prior to the August 25 start of the US Open.

“It was not easy at all,” the Spaniard said of taking on Williams. “She’s a legend, it was a privilege to play against her.”

Bouzas Maneiro said her 87-minute win was “like a dream”.

Shelton triumphs in Toronto thriller

Shelton overcomes Khachanov in three sets to capture biggest title of his career

- First US Canadian Masters win since 2003
- Defeats Khachanov 6-7, 6-4, 7-6
- Climbs to world No. 6

Ben Shelton became the first American to win an ATP Masters 1000 title in Canada in more than two decades as he defeated Karen Khachanov 6-7 (5/7), 6-4, 7-6 (7/3) in Toronto final on Thursday.

The 22-year-old will rise one place to sixth in the world rankings, overtaking 24-time Grand Slam singles champion Novak Djokovic in the table.

“It’s a surreal feeling,” said Shelton, who is the first American since Andy Roddick in 2003 to win the Canadian trophy. “It’s been a long week. It was not an easy path to the finals.

“But my best tennis just came out when it mattered the most.”

The victory in two and three-quarter hours denied 11th seed Khachanov a chance at a second Masters shield

more than six years after he won his first at Paris Bercy in 2018.

Shelton, his right quadriceps muscle heavily strapped and at times appearing to be in some discomfort, stormed through a final set tiebreaker with leads of 3-0 and 5-2 on his opponent.

The left-hander lined up four match points and converted on the second to clinch the biggest title of his career.

The American fired 16 aces as he used his powerful serve to fuel the emotional comeback victory.

He had lost serve to fall behind 4-3 in the opening set, but pegged Khachanov back to level the set at 5-5 before Khachanov, seeded 11th, took the first set -- after saving three set points in the 12th game.

Khachanov sealed the 64-minute opener on his first chance with a leaping volley winner which Shelton

could not touch.

For the second night in a row in a showpiece match, glitches in the heralded computerized line calling technology caused commotion.

The problem came to light in the fifth game of the second set, when the audio went out and left the players uncertain as to what balls were in and which were out.

After six minutes of discussion while play was halted, the system came back to

Shelton, loudly encouraged by his father-coach after almost every point, managed to break for a 5-4 lead and held the margin as he saved four break points in the next game before sending over a winner which left Khachanov on the ground trying to make the return.

With victory secured, Shelton scrambled into the stands to celebrate with his father, former

Liverpool’s Slot hints at fresh Isak bid despite ‘attacking power’

Liverpool manager Arne Slot refused to rule out an improved bid for Newcastle’s Alexander Isak as the Premier League champions consider adding to their formidable firepower, with Darwin Nunez set to leave for Saudi Arabia.

After a quiet first year in the transfer market under Slot the Reds have spent almost £300 million (\$402 million) on forwards Florian Wirtz and Hugo Ekitike as well as full-backs Milos Kerkez and Jeremie Frimpong.

Nunez is one of a number of significant exits that will help recoup much of that outlay as the Uruguayan closes in on a £46 million move to Al Hilal.

Liverpool reportedly had a £110 million bid for Isak turned down by Newcastle, who are seeking a British transfer record fee.

The Swedish striker has not been part of the Magpies’ pre-season preparations and has been told to train on his own by Newcastle.

“You never talk about players that are not yours,” Slot said at his pre-match press conference ahead of Sunday’s Community Shield against Crystal Palace at

PSG to sign Lille goalkeeper Lucas Chevalier: source

European champions Paris Saint-Germain have reached an agreement with Lille to sign highly-rated goalkeeper Lucas Chevalier, a source close to the negotiations said yesterday.

Chevalier, 23, will sign a five-year contract and command a fee of around 40 million euros (\$46.5 million).

He was nominated on Thursday for this year’s men’s Yashin Trophy for best goalkeeper at the Ballon d’Or gala after exceptional performances in Ligue 1 and the Champions League last season.

Lille finished fifth in Ligue 1 last season and qualified for the Europa League.

Chevalier’s arrival is likely to pose questions over the future of Italian international ‘keeper Gianluigi Donnarumma at PSG.

It is believed PSG sporting director Luis Campos has given Chevalier certain guarantees about his place in the

squad, and the Frenchman’s ability with his feet would align more with Luis Enrique’s style of play.

All of which would point to Donnarumma, 26, being relegated to the role of back-up.

A position that would be little to the taste of Italy’s number one, who was named the world’s best goalkeeper in April by the CIES Football Observatory.

PSG have previously dabbled with having a first-choice ‘keeper for league matches and another for European and cup matches, however this system rarely bore fruit in the past.

Donnarumma, who was outstanding as PSG won the Champions League for the first time in their history last term, is in the final year of his contract and would likely interest Premier League clubs.

Indeed England seems the most plausible option for Donnarumma, with both Manchester clubs and Chelsea showing interest.
