Britain issues 'ultimatum' to defiant Iran

London

British foreign minister Liz Truss urged Iran yesterday to sign up to the 2015 nuclear deal, saying it was "the last chance" to do, just a day before talks were expected to resume.

"This is really the last chance for Iran to sign up and I strongly urge them to do that because we are determined to work with our allies to prevent Iran securing nuclear weapons," she told the Chatham House think tank.

"So they do need to sign up to the JCPOA (the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action) agreement, it's in their interests to do so."

Bahrain to buy one million Valneva COVID-19 vaccine doses

Bahrain has signed an agreement with French-based company Valneva SE to supply one million doses of its coronavirus (COVID-19) vaccine known as VLA2001.

The announcement of the advance purchase agreement was made yesterday, said a company statement.

This is the second purchase agreement Valneva has secured for VLA2001 since reporting positive data for its Phase 3 clinical trial Cov-Compare.

Valneva has initiated a rolling submission process with the



Bahrain has already authorised the emergency use of seven vaccines, namely Sinopharm, Pfizer/BioNTech, AstraZeneca's Covishield, Johnson & Johnson, Sputnik V, Sputnik Light and Covaxin.

Franck Grimaud, Chief Business Officer of Valneva, said:

"We are grateful to the Bahraini government for their trust and confidence in our vaccine and are eager to work with them

to start helping to address the pandemic evolution in the Middle East. Subject to regulatory review and approval, we plan to start deliveries in the first quarter of 2022."

Last month, Valneva announced that the European Commission signed an advanced purchase agreement for up to 60 million doses of VLA2001.

In October, Valneva reported positive results from the Phase 3 trial Cov-Compare of its inactivated, adjuvanted COVID-19 vaccine candidate, VLA2001. The trial recruited a total of 4,012 participants 18 and older across 26 trial sites in the UK.



HM King to open 'place of worship'

Catholics to celebrate official inauguration today of Our Lady of Arabia Cathedral in Awali in solemn ceremony

● Consecration will take place tomorrow at 10am

His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa will officially inaugurate the largest Catholic church in the Gulf region – the Our Lady of Arabia Cathedral – at 11am today, a day before it will be consecrated in front of a small congregation.

Located in Awali, the ark-shaped structure will be able to accommodate 2,300 worshippers and is intended to serve as a reference point for the Apostolic Vicariate of Northern Arabia, which includes Bahrain, Kuwait, Qatar and, formally, Saudi Arabia.

Present in the solemn inauguration ceremony are His Eminence Cardinal Luis Antonio Tagle, Prefect of the Congregation for the Evangelisation of Peoples, and His Excellency Archbishop Eugene M. Nugent, Apostolic Nuncio to Kuwait and Apostolic Nuncio in the Kingdom of Bahrain.

The entire community of northern Arabia is currently headed by Cardinal Tagle following the death in April last year of Bishop Camillo Ballin, Apostolic Vicar for Northern Arabia, who was the driving force behind the project.

It is part of a complex of around 95,000 square feet in Awali, a small municipality in the centre of the country, which has a population of 1.7 million people.

Aside from the cathedral, the palm tree-lined complex features a multi-purpose building,

a courtyard, and a two-story parking area.

The cathedral's altar, baptistry, pews and other furnishings are crafted in Italy.

The cathedral is topped with an octagonal dome, a deeply symbolic geometric detail that can be seen in a number of churches around the world such as the Basilica of San Vitale in Ravenna, Italy, and Germany's Aachen Cathedral.

HM the King personally pre-

sented a detailed three-foot-long model of the cathedral to Pope Francis in 2014.

In 2011, the Vatican officially proclaimed Our Lady of Arabia as the Catholic patron saint of the vicariates of Kuwait and Arabia.

Later that year, the Holy See reorganised the Vicariate of Kuwait, giving it the new name of the Apostolic Vicariate of Northern Arabia, and including the territories of Qatar, Bahrain and

Saudi Arabia.

The inauguration of the cathedral follows HM King Hamad's official invitation to the pope to visit Bahrain.

Shaikh Khalid bin Ahmed bin Mohammed Al Khalifa, HM King's Adviser for Diplomatic Affairs, personally delivered the invitation when he met Pope Francis and Cardinal Secretary of State Pietro Parolin on Nov. 25.

New conditions for transferring Bahraini 'sea fishing' licence set

Works, Municipalities Affairs and Urban Planning Minister Essam bin Abdulla Khalaf has issued a decision setting new controls for the transfer of a Bahraini fishing licence from one person to another from the second-degree relatives of the licensee.

The conditions stipulate that the person requested to transfer the licence must meet the conditions for obtaining it in accordance with the provisions of the Bahrain Fishing, Exploitation and Protection Law, that the licence to be transferred is valid, and that the licensee should not have any violation related to the licence referred to the Public Prosecution, the courts or any official body.

The new decision also stipulates that the marine fishing licence shall be transferred to

another person if it is proven that the licensee is unable to practise sea fishing due to illness or physical or mental disability, according to a decision or a medical certificate approved by the competent medical authorities, and that the licensee is over 60 years of age.

The decision also includes the permissibility of transferring the fishing licence in the event of the death of the licensee with the approval of the Maritime Control Department to one of the heirs who meets the conditions for obtaining the licence.

Planting 110,000 seasonal flowers

The Northern Region Municipality has planted 60,000 seasonal flower seedlings of various types as part of its plans and programmes to beautify streets and public places, as well as increase green spaces.

Flowers such as zinnias and marigolds were planted on Shaikh Hamad Street in Hamad Town.

Some 50,000 different types of flowers, such as petunias, were also planted in Hamad City and Budaiya Street.

The Director General of the Northern Region Municipality, Engineer Lamia Al Fadala, said that the municipality launched its production of the season flowers in the Hamad Town nursery.

It includes 40,000 marigolds and 20,000 zinnias.

Main sewage water carrier project underway in Hidd Industrial Area

Work has started to construct the main sewage water carrier in Hidd Industrial Area.

The project includes the construction of a main sewage conveyor line with a total length of 3.3 kilometres, of which 1.1 km will be implemented using the Open Cut method.

The remaining 2.3 kms will be excavation using Micro Tunneling machines, and three pumping stations will be re-established.

The project will contribute to reducing the cost of operation and maintenance of the old pumping stations.

It will also raise the capacity of the sewage network, from 2,300 cubic metres per day to approximately 24,000 cubic metres per day, to serve the current and future industrial facilities in the region, he added.

The final wastewater will be carried out at the Muharraq treatment plant to make the most of its capacity.

The project falls within the national strategic plan set by the ministry for the wastewater sector as a basis for planning,

developing and expanding networks and treatment systems in Bahrain with the rapid urban development, with the aim of achieving sustainable development for this sector and providing the best services to all regions.



in recent months but Das said inflation could trend higher in the immediate future and sustained high core inflation was a matter of policy concern.

However, with the recent cuts in fuel taxes, RBI expects core inflation to start trending lower over the medium term.

The RBI has slashed the repo rate by a total of 115 basis points (bps) since March 2020 to soften the blow from the coronavirus pandemic and strict containment measures.

"RBI will continue to rebalance liquidity conditions in a non-disruptive manner while maintaining adequate liquidity to meet the needs of the productive sectors of the economy," Das said.

"The objective is to re-establish the 14-day VRRR auction as the main liquidity management operation," he added.



Das said the Indian economy was relatively well-positioned on the path to recovery, but it cannot be immune to global spillovers or to possible surges of infections from new mutations including the Omicron variant.

India's central bank held its key lending rate at a record low yesterday, saying growth was a priority as it warned of risks from inflation and the new Omicron variant on the economic recovery.

Even as the Reserve Bank of India retained its accommodative policy stance, it outlined plans to drain surplus liquidity in the banking system, raising the chances of a hike in a key borrowing rate early next year.

The central bank's monetary policy committee held the lending or repo rate (INREPO=ECI) at 4%. The reverse repo (INRREP=ECI) or borrowing rate was also kept at 3.35%.

India's economy expanded 8.4% in the September quarter from a year earlier, the fastest pace among major economies, but economists say the pandemic situation is a wild card.

"The overarching priority of RBI at this stage is revival of growth. Price stability is also our concern, so therefore at this moment, without losing sight on the requirement of price stability, we will concentrate on growth," Governor Shaktikanta Das told a news conference.

The MPC retained its full-year economic growth projection at 9.5% and also kept its retail inflation outlook unchanged at 5.3%.

Inflation has been within the RBI's 2-6% target range

Weak oil hurts stocks; Dubai rises

Most stock markets in the Gulf ended lower yesterday, weighed by falling oil prices as investors assessed the impact of the Omicron coronavirus variant on the global economy and fuel demand.

Brent crude futures were up 32 cents, or 0.4%, at \$75.76 a barrel at 1220 GMT, after earlier falling by more than \$1.

Saudi Arabia's benchmark index (.TASI) dropped 1.1%, with Al Rajhi Bank (1120.SE) losing 2.3% and Banque Saudi Fransi (1050.SE) sliding 4.5%.

The Saudi-led coalition fighting in Yemen said on Tuesday it bombed military targets in the capital Sanaa after the Iran-aligned Houthis launched ballistic missiles and armed drones into Saudi Arabia, including at Aramco oil facilities in Jeddah.

The tit-for-tat violence has escalated dramatically over the last months despite efforts by the United States and the United Nations to engineer a ceasefire in the seven-year-old war.

Renault Zoe goes from hero to zero in safety rating

French carmaker Renault yesterday received a blow for its popular Zoe electric model, as the European New Car Assessment Programme (NCAP) gave it a zero-star safety rating in tests that are standards for Europe.

The carmaker, which is cutting costs and working to turn around its performance after overstretching itself over years of ambitious global expansion, also received a one-star rating for its lower-cost electric Dacia Spring model.

"Renault was once synonymous with safety," Euro NCAP secretary general Michiel van Ratingen said in a statement. "But these disappointing results for the ZOE and the Dacia



Spring show that safety has now become collateral damage in the group's transition to electric cars."

Renault said in a statement the Zoe was a safe vehicle, which met all regulatory safety standards.

"These standards are constantly evolving and are becoming more and more strict in all areas, especially in terms of security," the company added. "Renault is therefore continually improving its offer in order to comply with the regulations

UAE's Silal and Agthia to build 200,000 tonne grain silos

The United Arab Emirates' Silal and Agthia signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) yesterday to build ten grain silos with a capacity of 200,000 metric tonnes in Zayed port in Abu Dhabi by the end of 2022, state news agency (WAM) reported.

Israel budget deficit falls to 4.6% of GDP

Israel posted a budget deficit (ILBUD=ECI) of 4.6% of gross domestic product in the 12 months to November, down from 5.5% in the year to October, the Finance Ministry said yesterday.

The improvement has come amid an economic rebound that has led to higher than expected tax revenue. Over the past 11 months, tax income is up 23.1% from the same period in 2020.

In shekel terms, the deficit was 600 million shekels (\$193 m), to bring the gap to 47.7 billion shekels since the start of the year.

The finance ministry last month trimmed its 2021 budget deficit target to 5.5-5.7% of GDP from 6.8% due to higher than expected tax revenues, reflecting a rapid economic recovery from the coronavirus pandemic.

Major outage at Amazon Seattle

A major outage in Amazon's cloud computing network Tuesday severely disrupted services at a wide range of US companies for more than five hours, the latest sign of just how concentrated the business of keeping the internet running has become. The incident at Amazon Web Services mostly affected the eastern US, but still impacted everything from airline reservations and auto dealerships to payment apps and video streaming.

◆ **Judges at the International Court of Justice examining Armenian allegations** that Azerbaijan breached a convention against racial discrimination on Tuesday ordered Azerbaijan to prevent incitement of racial hatred against Armenians and protect Armenian prisoners of war. The court has yet to rule on a similar case from Azerbaijan's side, who filed a countersuit alleging violations of the same UN anti-discrimination treaty. In October last year, Azeri troops drove ethnic Armenian forces out of swathes of territory they had controlled since the 1990s in and around the Nagorno-Karabakh region, before Russia brokered a ceasefire.

A recent surge in supply has caused a new problem, however: many African countries are finding they do not have the capacity to manage the shots, some of which come with a short shelf life.

France frees man who was held over suspected Khashoggi link



suspected links to the killing of journalist Jamal Khashoggi was released yesterday after officials concluded it was a case of mistaken identity, Paris prosecutors said. French law enforcement sources on Tuesday named the man as Khaled Aedh Al-Otaibi, the same name as a former member of the Saudi Royal Guard listed in U.S. and British sanctions documents and a U.N.-commissioned report as having been involved in Khashoggi's killing in Turkey. The Saudi Embassy in Paris had said late on Tuesday the arrested person “has nothing to do with the case in question.”

◆ **The probe into last year's deadly Beirut port blast has been cleared** to resume after being suspended for more than a month on legal claims against its lead investigator, judge Tarek Bitar, a judicial source said. A Beirut court rejected the last of the suits preventing Bitar from questioning top officials on Tuesday. “They have reversed the decision that had led to the suspension of the probe and he can now resume his work for sure,” Nizar Saghih, head of the Legal Agenda, a research and advocacy organisation, told Reuters. The resumption could be temporary should further legal complaints be filed, he said.

Scholz takes over as German chancellor, ending Merkel era

- Social Democrat receives clear majority in parliament
- Scholz takes oath of office after nomination by president
- Merkel hands over chancellery amid various challenges

German lawmakers elected Social Democrat Olaf Scholz as chancellor yesterday, ending 16 years of conservative rule under Angela Merkel and paving the way for a pro-European government that has promised to boost green investment.

Scholz, 63, who over the past four years served as vice chancellor and finance minister in coalition with Merkel, got a clear majority of 395 votes from lawmakers in the lower house of parliament, Bundestag President Baerbel Bas said.

Wearing a black face mask, Scholz waved as he received a standing ovation from lawmakers and lavish bouquets of flowers and a basket of apples from the leaders of the parliamentary parties.

Scholz was formally nomi-

nated by President Frank-Walter Steinmeier in the nearby Bellevue Palace before returning to parliament to take the oath of office in front of lawmakers and become Germany's ninth chancellor since the end of World War Two.

Scholz swore, among other things, to devote his energies to the welfare of the German people. But he did not ask for God's help, a phrase that is usually included in the oath of office and was spoken by Merkel.

Back in Bellevue Palace, the ministers of the new cabinet received their appointment certificates from the president.

In the afternoon, Merkel will officially hand over the chancellery to Scholz as the country faces a brutal fourth wave of coronavirus infections and challenges to its democratic order from authoritarian governments.

Japanese billionaire Maezawa blasts off into space

Japanese billionaire Yusaku Maezawa set out to become the first space tourist in more than a decade to travel to the International Space Station (ISS) when he blasted off on Wednesday, a voyage he sees as a dry run for his planned trip around the moon with Elon Musk's SpaceX in 2023.

The 46-year-old fashion magnate and art collector successfully launched from the Baikonur cosmodrome in Kazakhstan along with his assistant Yozo Hirano, who will document the journey, as well as Russian cosmonaut Alexander Misurkin.

Maezawa, a space enthusiast who has been training for the journey for months, has become a household name in Japan thanks to his penchant for private jets, celebrity girlfriends and cash giveaways to

Twitter followers, in a country known for its conformist corporate culture.

Maezawa plans to upload footage of his flight to his YouTube channel, which has 795,000 followers. He has called on his supporters to give him 100 ideas of things to do in space, and said he plans to play badminton aboard the ISS.

The cost of Maezawa's trip was not disclosed but some reports have put the price tag for tourist space flights as high as \$50 million.

Maezawa is also set to become the first private passenger on the SpaceX moon trip and has begun searching for eight people to join him, requiring applicants to pass medical tests and an interview.

Pfizer, BioNTech Omicron varia

BioNTech and Pfizer said yesterday a three-shot course of their COVID-19 vaccine was able to neutralise the new Omicron variant in a laboratory test and they could deliver an Omicron-based vaccine in March 2022 if needed.

In the first official statement from vaccine manufacturers on the likely efficacy of their shot against Omicron, BioNTech and Pfizer said that two vaccine doses resulted in significantly lower neutralising antibodies but that a third dose of their vaccine increased the neutralising antibodies by a factor of 25.

Blood obtained from people that had their third booster shot a month ago neutralised the Omicron variant about as effectively as blood after two doses fought off the original virus first identified in China.

“Ensuring as many people as possible are fully vaccinated with the first two dose series and a booster remains the best course of action to prevent the spread of COVID-19,” Pfizer boss Albert Bourla said in the statement.

Though the necessity remains unclear, the companies said they would continue their effort to bring an Omicron-specific COVID-19 vaccine to market, which

It has been ascertained that Gen Bipin Rawat, (his wife) Mrs Madhulika Rawat and 11 other persons on board have died," the Air Force said in a statement.

Rawat, 63, was appointed as India's first Chief of Defence Staff by Prime Minister Narendra Modi's government in late

2019. The position was set up with the aim of integrating India's three military services - the Army, the Navy and the Air Force.

Several of the bodies were badly burnt, two government sources said. "Some bodies were so charred that they could not be

immediately identified," one of the sources said.

Modi said he was deeply saddened by Rawat's death. "A true patriot, he greatly contributed to modernising our armed forces and security apparatus," the prime minister said.

In a tweet, Defence Minister Rajnath Singh called Rawat's death "an irreparable loss to our armed forces and the country."

The Indian Air Force ordered an inquiry into the cause of the accident.

India has dozens of Mi-17s in service. They are widely deployed to transport senior army personnel and government ministers.

"This is a safe, proven helicopter, I have travelled on it in difficult situations," former army chief J.J.Singh said.

An infantryman with over four decades of military service, Rawat served along India's border with China, the disputed Kashmir region and on a United Nations mission in Africa, before taking charge of the Indian army in late 2016.

In New Delhi, Defence Minister Singh visited Rawat's official residence and the state broadcaster said Modi had summoned a meeting of the cabinet committee on security yesterday evening.

Omicron reported in 57 countries, hospitalisations set to rise: WHO

The Omicron variant has been reported in 57 nations and the number of patients needing hospitalisation is likely to rise as it spreads, the World Health Organization said yesterday.

The WHO, in its weekly epidemiological report, said more data was needed to assess the severity of disease caused by the Omicron variant and whether its mutations might reduce protection from vaccine-derived immunity.

"Even if the severity is equal or potentially even lower than for Delta variant, it is expected that hospitalisations will increase if more people become infected and that there will be a time lag between an increase in the incidence of cases and an increase in the incidence of deaths," it said.

On Nov. 26, the WHO declared the Omicron variant, which was first detected in southern Africa, a variant of concern. It is the fifth SARS-CoV-2 strain to carry such a designation.

The number of reported COVID-19 cases in South Africa doubled in the week to Dec. 5 to more than 62,000 and "very large" increases in incidence have been seen in Eswatini, Zimbabwe, Mozambique, Namibia and Lesotho, it said.

The spread of Omicron, coupled with enhanced testing and low vaccination rates may have played a role, it added.

published by researchers at the Africa Health Research Institute in South Africa on Tuesday, saying that Omicron can partially evade protection from two doses of the Pfizer/BioNTech vaccine, suggesting also that a third shot might help fend off infection.

A lab analysis at the university hospital of Frankfurt, Germany,

however found a reduced antibody response to Omicron even after three shots.

The US-German vaccine partners also struck an optimistic tone on the prospect of their shot protecting against any severe disease from Omicron, even though the lab data did not yield new insights on that.

The vast majority of surface structures on the Omicron spike protein targeted by the T-cells, which typically emerge after vaccination, are not affected by Omicron's mutations, they said.

"The companies believe that vaccinated individuals may still be protected against severe forms of the disease," they added.

UK PM apologises for staff joking about Christmas lockdown party

British Prime Minister Boris Johnson apologised yesterday after a video surfaced showing his staff laughing and joking about a party in Downing Street during a Christmas COVID-19 lockdown last year when such festivities were banned.

For more than a week, Johnson and his team have repeated that no rules were broken in late 2020 after the Mirror newspaper reported there had been several parties including a wine-fuelled gathering of 40 to 50 people to mark Christmas.

Yesterday, he said he was furious over the video, which was shown by ITV late on Tuesday, but that he had been repeatedly assured there had not been a party.

Opposition Labour Party

leader Keir Starmer accused Johnson of "taking the public for fools", while Ian Blackford of the Scottish National Party called for Johnson to resign.

"I apologise unreservedly for the offence that it has caused up and down the country and I apologise for the impression that it gives," he told parliament.

Disciplinary action would be taken if it was found that rules were broken, he said.

"But I repeat ... that I have been repeatedly assured since these allegations emerged, that there was no party and that no COVID rules were broken."

He also pledged to "get on with the job", accusing the opposition for trying to "muddy the waters about events or non-events of a year ago".

After days of denials, the video aired by ITV, Allegra Stratton, who was then Johnson's press secretary, was shown at a 2020 Downing Street rehearsal for a daily briefing laughing and joking about a reported gathering.

In the video, a Johnson adviser asks Stratton: "I've just seen reports on Twitter that there was a Downing Street Christmas party on Friday night - do you recognise those reports?"

Stratton, standing before British flags at an official Downing Street lectern, says: "I went home." She then laughs and smiles. "Hold on. Hold on. Um. Er. Arh." She appears lost for words and looks up.

Ukraine welcomes Biden-Putin call as path to deterrence and de-escalation

Ukraine's Foreign Minister Dmytro Kuleba told Reuters yesterday that talks between US President Joe Biden and Russian President Vladimir Putin had enabled "deterrence and de-escalation".

In the first reaction by a senior Ukrainian official about Tuesday's video call between Biden and Putin, Kuleba welcomed US efforts to bring Russia to the negotiating table.

But he added that the priority was drawing up a deterrence package to ward Moscow off any further military escalation.

Ukraine and its NATO allies have sounded the alarm about Russian troop movements near Ukraine's borders this year, sparking worries that a simmering conflict in eastern Ukraine could erupt into open war between the two neighbours.

"The contact itself serves (as) deterrence and de-escalation," Kuleba said in written remarks about Tuesday's call.

"We appreciate the crucial diplomatic engagement of the US in efforts to bring Russia back to the table of negotiations."

Biden warned Putin on Tuesday that the West would impose "strong economic and other measures" on Russia if Russia launched a new offensive against Ukraine, while Putin demanded guarantees that NATO would not expand farther eastward.



Pakistan beat Bangladesh by an innings in race against dying light

Off-spinner Sajid Khan claimed 4-86 and finished with a match haul of 12 wickets as Pakistan defied fading light to beat Bangladesh by an innings and eight runs and take the two-Test series 2-0 in Dhaka yesterday.

All-rounder Shakib Al Hasan let Bangladesh's middle order in a brave resistance but could not salvage a draw as the hosts' last wicket fell just minutes before sunset.

Shakib top-scored for Bangladesh with 63 off 130 balls and in the process made an all-round career double of 4,000 runs and 200 wickets, the quickest in history and beating a record long held by Ian Botham.

But despite a 51-run partnership with Mehidy Hossain for the seventh wicket, Bangladesh's hopes were dashed when Pakistan skipper Babar Azam trapped his teammate.

"I felt that I needed to bowl at that stage and really happy I got that wicket," said Babar of his maiden Test wicket.

"Our batsmen and especially

openers gave us a good start and our mindset was just to dominate despite the bad weather," he added.

dimming, which prevented Pakistan's fast bowlers from bowling at the tail-enders.

Mushfiquur Rahim and Liton Das earlier scored 48 and 45 runs respectively for Bangladesh, but two wickets apiece from Hasan Ali and Shaheen Afridi held the side to 25-4 after Pakistan forced the follow-on.

Mushfiquur made decent partnerships with Liton and Shakib before he was run out on the stroke of tea.

"In the second innings we had an opportunity to play better than the first," said Bangladesh captain Monimul Haque.

"Though some of our senior players played well, we couldn't hang on."

The hosts could only add another 11 runs to their first in-

The sixth race is also for a HH Shaikh Khalid bin Hamad Al Khalifa Cup, and it is to be held over a six-furlong straight with a BD10,000 prize. Buffer Zone representing Victorious, Dark Shadow of Al Mohamediya Racing and Ibn Arabi of Al Afoo Racing are tipped to have a chance amongst the field of imported horses.

Cummins savours 'dream start' as England slump to 147 all out

Pat Cummins took five wickets in a scintillating start to his captaincy as Australia routed England for 147 on the opening day of the Ashes at the Gabba yesterday.

After England skipper Joe Root won the toss and opted to bat, the Australian pace bowling trio of Cummins, Mitchell Starc and Josh Hazlewood ran riot to bundle the tourists out in just 50.1 overs.

Cummins, in his first game as Test captain since taking over from Tim Paine, claimed 5-38, while Starc took 2-35 and Hazlewood 2-42 as the English batters failed to adapt to the bounce and movement of a Gabba green top. England made a disastrous

start to the series when they lost Rory Burns to the first ball of the match, Starc bowling the left-hander around his legs.

Dawid Malan, who scored six, and Root, for a duck, quickly followed as a shell-shocked England slumped to 11-3.

"It was a dream start really -- it wasn't a bad toss to lose and I thought we all bowled really well and did our jobs," Cummins said.

"To keep them to 150 was a tremendous start. I was really proud of how consistent and composed everyone was.

Bahrain bids to host 2023 FIFA Beach Soccer World Cup

Bahrain is bidding to host the 2023 FIFA Beach Soccer World Cup.

This was announced yesterday by the Bahrain Football Association (BFA), who have already submitted an official request to football's international governing body FIFA.

Bahrain is one of five countries hoping to win the rights to stage the event. The others are Colombia, the UAE, Seychelles and Thailand.

BFA president Shaikh Ali bin Khalifa Al Khalifa affirmed that the request to host the competition comes in line with the visions of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa and His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, Crown

Prince and Prime Minister, who are keen to further Bahrain's status as an important destination for various major sporting events.

Shaikh Ali said that the Kingdom has already achieved great success in hosting international football competitions in the past, and that he has great con-

fidence in the capabilities of the country and its people in hosting another major event for the first time.

Shaikh Ali noted that the BFA will spare no effort in its bid for the 2023 FIFA Beach Soccer World Cup at the organisational, administrative, technical, marketing and media levels.

The FIFA Beach Soccer World Cup is currently being held every two years. This year, it took place in August in Moscow, with 16 nations taking part.

Bahrain have appeared just twice in the competition, first in 2006 and then again in 2009. The Bahrainis reached the quarter-finals in their debut appearance, but then did not make it through in their return to the competition three years later.
