**Pakistan fired 300-400 Turkish drones, says India**

Pakistan fired 300 to 400 Turkish drones in late Thursday night attacks on Indian military installations in or near 36 towns or cities across Jammu and Kashmir, Rajasthan, and Punjab - from Srinagar to Jaisalmer, and Pathankot - Colonel Sofiya Qureshi said in yesterday evening press briefing.

Pak drones were also sighted at the Siachen glacier base camp in Ladakh and in the Kutch area in Gujarat; the two are nearly 1,400km apart, which underlines the vast spread of the attack.

Fifty of the drones were shot down by air defence guns, Col



On the night of 8-9 May 2025, Pakistan carried out large-scale violations of Indian airspace, attempting to target military infrastructure with 300-400 drones across 36 locations from Leh to Sir Creek. Indian forces neutralized many using kinetic and non-kinetic means. An armed UAV strike on Bhatinda was also thwarted. India responded by launching drone strikes on four Pakistani air defence sites, destroying a radar. Pakistan escalated with artillery and drone attacks across the LoC, causing casualties. Alarmingly, Pakistan kept its civil #airspace open during the assault, endangering civilian flights

Qureshi said.

Another 20 were neutralised by jamming radio frequencies.

Most of the drones were unarmed, suggesting Pak may have tested India's defences. Many, however, fitted with cameras that may have relayed footage to ground stations in Pakistan.

Sources said Pak used Asiguard SONGAR drones that, according to the manufacturer, can be used "effectively in any kind of day/night military and security operations" and has a range of 5km.

The firing of hundreds of drones - all of which were intercepted or neutralised by India's air defence system - was a blatant violation of the ceasefire agreement, Col Qureshi said.

This, she said, included continuing small arms fire and artillery shelling across the Line of Control, or LoC, in Jammu and Kashmir, in which 16 Indians, including a soldier, were killed.

In response, Indian military inflicted 'heavy damage' on its counterpart, Col Qureshi said, having shot down the hundreds of drones and missiles, and also countered by disabling Pak air defence networks.

Debris from downed drones and missiles, Col Qureshi said, will be analysed and the re-



sults added to the pile of evidence linking Pak, or its Pak deep state, to terrorist attacks on India.

Some of this debris was found in Punjab's Amritsar.

**Bahrain welcomes Yemen ceasefire announcement**

Bahrain yesterday welcomed the Omani announcement of a ceasefire agreement in Yemen with the United States.

A statement issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs expressed hope that this step would contribute to ensuring the security and freedom of maritime navigation and international trade in the Red Sea and Bab al-Mandab Strait.

The ministry also affirmed the Kingdom's support for regional and international initiatives aimed at resolving conflicts through dialogue and diplomatic means.

**Trump suggests lower China tariff, says 80% 'seems right!'**

US President Donald Trump signaled on Friday that he could lower tariffs on Chinese imports, as the rival superpowers prepare for trade talks over the weekend.

"80% Tariff on China seems right!" Trump wrote on his Truth Social platform, which would bring them down from 145%, with cumulative duties on some goods reaching a staggering 245%.

**Generate, sell your own power**

New proposal aims to lower electricity bills, boost income from surplus energy

● Homeowners and businesses can install renewable energy systems—solar, wind, geothermal, or biogas

● Excess electricity can be fed back into the national grid

Got extra solar power? A new law could help you cash in.

Imagine this: your rooftop solar panels are generating more electricity than your home actually needs. What happens to all that extra energy?

Good news — a new law is in the works that could let you sell that surplus power back to the Electricity and Water Authority (EWA).



Under the draft legislation, homes and businesses would not only be allowed to generate electricity from renewable sources like solar, wind, geothermal, or biogas, but also feed any unused power directly into Bahrain's national grid.

The benefits? Plenty. Households could cut down their electricity bills, while the country reduces pressure on its main grid — a win-win, say supporters of the bill.

But don't start plugging in just yet. Connecting to the national grid without approval could lead to fines of up to BD10,000. Prior authorisation is a must. The law, proposed by five Shura Council members — Talal Al Manai, Dalal Jassim Al Zayed, Dr Mohammed Ali Hassan, Jumaa Al Kaabi and Ali Al Aradi — is set to be reviewed by the Council this Sunday.

**Here's what the draft law includes:**

- Who can produce renewable energy, how they connect, and what safety standards they must follow

- Mandatory agreements with EWA, which would oversee inspections, licensing, and enforcement

- A national registry of approved producers, contractors, and equipment, all maintained by EWA

- Strict technical rules to ensure that installations don't pose a risk to the wider grid

The Ministry would also have a major role: setting national goals, identifying suitable sites, deciding how much new renewable energy can be added each year, and managing tariff rates.

To boost investment, the bill proposes customs duty exemptions for all renewable and energy-saving systems and parts. It also recommends giving priority to local companies in government-funded green projects.

The aim, according to the bill's authors, is to create a supportive legal framework for green energy, help Bahrain meet its international climate goals, and reduce the state's spending on conventional electricity.

There's even an appeal process: if a producer disagrees with a government decision under the law, they can file a complaint with the Ministry within 30 days. If there's no reply, it's treated as a rejection — and they're free to take the case to court.

**US, Iran to hold new nuclear talks on eve of Trump travel**

The United States and Iran will hold a new round of nuclear talks Sunday in Oman, officials said, just ahead of a visit to the region by President Donald Trump.

Trump, who will visit three other Gulf Arab states next week, has voiced hope for reaching a deal with Tehran to avert an Israeli military strike on Iran's nuclear program that could ignite a wider war.

Iranian Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi said that Oman, which has been mediating, had proposed Sunday as the date and both sides had accepted.

"Negotiations are moving ahead and naturally, the more we advance, the more consultations we have, and the more time the delegations need to examine the issues," he said in a video carried by Iranian media.

"But what's important is that we are moving forward so that we gradually get into the details," Araghchi said.

Steve Witkoff, Trump's friend who has served as his globe-trotting negotiator, will take part in the talks, the fourth since Trump returned to the White House, according to a source familiar with arrangements.

"As in the past, we expect both direct and indirect discussions," the person said on condition of anonymity.

## Shura Council to vote on Bahrain-South Korea investment treaty

● Signed in December last year in Manama, the agreement outlines terms for protecting investors and their assets in both countries.

The Shura Council will vote on Sunday to ratify a landmark investment treaty with South Korea, paving the way for stronger legal protections for businesses and formalising a trade relationship valued at over BD 170 million.

Signed in December last year in Manama, the agreement outlines terms for protecting investors and their assets in both countries. It

plies to both current and future investments, and specifies that the English version will take precedence in case of any disputes over wording.

In April, the Council of Representatives approved the bill, and the Shura Council's Foreign Affairs, Defence, and National Security Committee has now completed its review, recommending that the full chamber pass the law as proposed.

According to the Finance Ministry, Bahrain's non-oil trade with South Korea amounted to BD 172.5 million last year, with BD 100.7 million in Bahraini exports and BD 71.8 million in imports. The ministry noted that the treaty aligns with Bahrain's broader efforts to attract direct foreign investment and generate jobs.

The Foreign Ministry confirmed that Bahrain and South Korea now maintain full diplomatic representation, with Bahrain's first ambassador to Seoul, Saud Hassan Al Nusuf, presenting his credentials last October. While Bahrain does not yet

have a trade attaché in South Korea, Jiwon Kim of the Economic Development Board represents Bahrain's investment interests in Seoul.

Legal experts from the Legislation and Legal Advice Commission have confirmed the agreement's compliance with the law. Under Bahrain's Constitution, international treaties such as this one require parliamentary enactment to take effect.

### Fair treatment

Key provisions of the agreement include ensuring fair and non-discriminatory treatment for investors, protection

from expropriation (except for public use with market-value compensation), and the free movement of profits, capital, and returns in an exchangeable currency. Disputes will first be attempted through negotiations, and if unresolved, may be taken to local courts or arbitration.

The treaty also specifies that neither country is obligated to reveal security-related information and that tax matters will be managed through existing agreements. Both sides retain the right to regulate financial services, including insurance and banking, as needed.


The Bahrain Chamber of Commerce and Industry has expressed support for the treaty, stating that it provides fair terms for investors while aligning with international norms.

The committee pointed out that Bahrain has signed 40 such treaties with countries like China, Japan, the United States, and Russia, and reminded members of previous agreements with South Korea, including one on air travel signed in 2023 and a double-taxation agreement dating back to 2013.

With growing trade ties between Bahrain and South Korea, particularly in technology, manufacturing, and energy sectors, the treaty is expected to ease Bahraini investors' access to the Korean market.

In line with Bahrain's 2030 economic vision, the committee endorsed the treaty, recommending the draft law be passed in its entirety to help further drive investment without imposing new costs on the state.

## New flyover on way to link Shaikh Isa bin Salman bridge with Busaiteen

A new flyover connecting Shaikh Isa bin Salman Bridge to Avenue 105 in Busaiteen is in the works, as part of the wider Muharraq Ring Road and Fourth Bridge development project.

The dual carriageway will feature two lanes in each direction, serving traffic between Manama and Busaiteen, and easing flow along the Muharraq Ring Road towards the capital.

Minister of Works Ibrahim bin Hassan Al Hawaj said the new route aims to relieve congestion at the busy junction of Shaikh Isa bin Salman Bridge and Al Ghous Highway, especially during peak hours.

He added that the flyover will greatly improve access for motorists travelling between Manama, Muharraq, Al Sayh, Diyar Al Muharraq, and nearby areas. Nass Contracting has been awarded the contract to carry out the construction.

# Final approval nears for 15% global tax on multinationals

Aligns with global efforts to prevent profit shifting and ensure fair contributions

Bahrain is moving closer to fully enacting a 15% minimum tax on large multi-

national companies, as the Shura Council prepares to review the measure this Sunday.

The proposed law targets global business groups earning over Euro 750 million annually, and is expected to inject around BHD 130 million a year into the national treasury.

Known as Decree Law No. 11 of 2024, the rule was introduced by royal decree last August while Parliament was in recess. It has already cleared the lower house earlier this month and now awaits the Shura Council's final sign-off — a largely procedural step, since the regime is already in force.

Under the new rules, multinationals operating in Bahrain that

pay less than 15% in tax on local earnings must now pay the difference to the National Bureau for Revenue.

**Not everyone will pay**

The law excludes certain groups from the tax, including government bodies, pension funds, and non-profits, provided they meet specific conditions.

**Why it matters**

This move aligns Bahrain with a global push, led by the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), to stop multinationals from shifting profits to low-tax jurisdictions. Bahrain joined the OECD's Inclusive Framework in

2018 and ratified major treaty changes in 2022.

The tax is calculated at the entity level, based on a company's adjusted accounting profit. If the effective tax rate falls below 15%, a top-up tax must be paid locally. Some exclusions apply, particularly for income linked to real economic activity such as staff and physical assets.

Simplified rules also apply to smaller groups with limited overseas exposure.

**Enforcement and penalties**


The National Bureau for Revenue is in charge of enforcing the law, which includes rules on registration, tax filings, audits, and penalties. Deliberate tax evasion

could lead to steep fines and even jail time.

The Shura Council's Financial and Economic Affairs Committee has recommended passing the law, which will close the legislative loop on Bahrain's role in the global minimum tax initiative.

Once approved, it will formally cement Bahrain's commitment to ensuring major global companies contribute fairly to the local economy.

As of early 2025, over 140 jurisdictions have agreed to the OECD's global minimum corporate tax deal, which sets a 15% minimum tax rate for multinational enterprises with annual revenues exceeding €750 million. This agreement, known as the "two-pillar solution," was first unveiled in 2021 and aims to curb tax avoidance and ensure fair taxation across countries

While more than 40 countries have enacted laws to apply the global minimum tax, some major economies, including the United States, have not fully committed to the agreement. In early 2025, President Donald Trump withdrew the U.S. from the OECD global tax deal, raising concerns about potential global tax conflicts

## No licence, no stage: Performers in Bahrain could soon need official approval to work

Actors, singers, dancers and musicians may soon need a licence to take the stage in Bahrain — or risk facing fines, bans or legal warnings.

A bold new draft law, up for review by the Shura Council this Sunday, proposes sweeping changes to the way artistic professions are regulated in the kingdom. If passed, it would make it illegal for anyone to earn money through recognised artistic work — from theatre and music to dance and instrumental performance — without prior approval from a designated ministry.

The legislation also targets visiting performers, who would be limited to short-term permits. Non-resident foreign artists would be subject to government-approved fees on contracts and public performances, a move aimed at levelling the playing field for local talent.

At the heart of the law is the creation of a national safety net for Bahrain's creative community. A state-backed 'Fund for Artistic Professions' would offer licensed Bahraini artists financial support, training opportunities and other professional benefits. Managed by a board appointed by the Cabinet, the fund would

draw income from artist memberships, foreign performance fees, investment returns and approved donations.

Shura members behind the proposal argue that the lack of legal safeguards has left local artists underpaid, undervalued and unprotected. "Art is not a luxury," the proposal states, "but a necessity that reflects and shapes the very fabric of society."

Offenders — both local and foreign — could face escalating penalties: first a written warning, then a ban on performing, and finally fines of up to BD100. Licensed artists, meanwhile, would receive a professional

card detailing their rights and responsibilities under the new system.

Supporters say the law also

serves a cultural purpose. By regulating who can perform, and under what conditions, it seeks to preserve Bahrain's artistic identity while encouraging a thriving, homegrown creative scene.

"The goal is equal opportunity," the law's backers say. "By setting fair terms for foreign performers, we give Bahraini talent the recognition and space it deserves."

The bill has been tabled by Shura Council members Nancy Khedouri, Dalal Al Zayed, Khalid Al Maskati, Redha Abdulla Faraj and Dr Mohammed Al Khuzai.

## Hand-over delay: Court orders developer to refund **BD151,000**

The High Civil Court has ruled that a property developer must refund BD151,000 to two Saudi citizens after fail-

ing to hand over a flat despite full payment. The court also ordered the developer to pay 3% annual interest on the amount from 9 January 2025 until full repayment is made.

In addition, the company is required to cover legal fees of BD1,000 and court costs totaling BD3,118.50, as well as BD10 for the enforcement notice. Lawyer Zainab Ali Madan represented the Saudi plaintiffs in the case.

The disputed apartment, Unit 1006 on the tenth floor of Building 951 in Dilmunia Island, was purchased on 14 Decem-

ber 2021. The buyers presented cheques and a bank transfer as evidence, asserting that despite full payment, the seller had failed to deliver the property or transfer the title, thus breaching the contract.

The court's decision was based on Article 140 of Bahrain's Civil Code, which permits the termination of a contract when one party fails to fulfil its obligations, provided the other party has upheld its part of the agreement. The court found that the buyers had fulfilled their obligations and were entitled to request termination of

the contract.

In support of their case, the plaintiffs submitted the sale agreement, payment records, and a formal demand for a refund sent to the seller. The court noted that the developer, a limited liability company, had not provided sufficient evidence to contest the claim.

The developer's lawyer argued that the case should be dismissed, questioning the authenticity of the submitted documents and requesting the originals. However, the court dismissed these arguments and affirmed the commercial na-

ture of the transaction, thereby applying the statutory interest rate.

# Eyes on the parks

Muharraq parks face crackdown over vandalism, drugs



Public parks in Muharraq could soon come under tighter watch, as the municipal council prepares to debate a new proposal to install surveillance cameras and deploy security guards amid growing concerns over vandalism, disturbances, and suspected drug use.

The plan, spearheaded by Councillor Mohammed Al Mahmoud, is set to be discussed in the council on Monday. It calls for cameras to be installed at entrances, walkways, children's play zones, and service areas, all connected to a central control room at the municipality. Recordings would be stored for 30 days.

In addition, security personnel—either municipal workers or licensed private guards—would patrol the parks throughout the day. Their responsibilities would include monitoring behaviour, assisting families, and reporting violations to authorities.

“With more people using our public parks, we’re seeing an increase in worrying behaviours,” said Mr Al Mahmoud. “Vandal-



ism, noise, and encroachments are damaging these spaces and pushing families away. We need to protect what we’ve built.”

Residents have raised the alarm over broken playground equipment, smoking in family zones, unsanitary conditions,

and groups lingering late into the night. Some say they’ve stopped bringing their children after dark.

To test the idea, the council is considering a pilot project at three key sites: Muharraq Grand Park, Qalali Park, and Busaiteen

Park. A review would take place six months after implementation.

If approved, signs would warn visitors about surveillance and penalties for damaging public property. The council is also weighing budget allocations

and potential partnerships with the Interior Ministry or private firms to handle the security. The proposal aims to restore

public confidence in Muharraq’s parks and make them safer, cleaner, and more welcoming for all.

## Sewerage projects to connect over 1,500 homes in Northern Governorate

Work to link 1,580 homes in the north of Bahrain to the national sewerage network is set to begin soon, according to MP Hassan Ibrahim Hasan.

The projects—part of the Works Ministry’s infrastructure plan—will cover properties in Saraya Bu Quwah, Jeblat Hebshi, and Al Sehla, all located within the Fourth Northern District.

In addition to sewerage extensions, the plan includes road

maintenance and the paving of unpaved roads. Each project has been prioritised based

on factors such as population density, technical feasibility, and available budget, Mr Hasan said.

In a written statement to Parliament, the Works Ministry noted that while much of the Northern Governorate is already connected to the national sewerage grid, several developed areas still require network access.

Among the upcoming works is a new sewerage network in southern Block 441 in Al Sehla, set to serve 101 homes. A second project will cover Blocks 447, 431, and 435 in Qadam and Jeblat Hebshi, connecting 604 properties. The largest scheme will be in Block 457 in Bu Quwah, where 875 homes are due to be connected. This project is expected to break ground shortly.

## A safe space for journalists, says MP Al Sayed on new media law

Bahrain’s new Press and Electronic Media Law marks a significant turning point for media freedom and legal clarity in the kingdom, according to Jaleela Alawi Al Sayed, chairwoman of Parliament’s Services Committee.

Describing the law as a “well-timed gift” to the country’s journalists on Press Day, she hailed it as a milestone in modernising Bahrain’s

media landscape and strengthening its legal framework.

One of the law’s most important features, she noted, is the scrapping of prison sentences for press-related offences. It also introduces long-awaited legal protections for online media outlets and social media news accounts, pulling them out of legal uncertainty and granting them recognition un-

der Bahraini law — as long as they operate within professional standards.

“This is a home-grown legal move that builds trust, shields journalists from prison, puts online platforms on firm ground, and lets the press do its job without second-guessing what’s allowed,” she said.

Al Sayed praised the collaborative effort behind the legislation, crediting the joint work of government bodies, Parliament — particularly her committee — and contributions from editors, reporters, and digital publishers. “The debates were long and detailed, but they showed that everyone involved wanted a law that reflects Bahrain’s standing as a regional media hub,” she said.

## Capital Council sees 86% of proposals approved by Works Ministry

Nearly 90% of proposals submitted by the Capital Mu-

nicipal Council during the current term have been approved by the Works Ministry, official figures reveal.

In a response to a parliamentary query, the Ministry confirmed it had received 146 proposals from the Council since

the start of the sixth legislative term. These included project ideas, policy suggestions, and draft decisions. Of these, 125 were approved, five are still under review, and only six were rejected.

Most proposals focused on planning, infrastructure repairs, and public services across Manama. The Ministry said the few rejections stemmed from legal or technical grounds—such as proposals falling outside the council’s authority or requiring assessments by other government agencies.

MP Mamdouh Al Saleh had requested a full breakdown of the council’s submissions, in-

cluding outcomes, reasons for rejections, and updates on implementation. He also sought budget figures for each project and projections for the 2025–2026 planning cycle.

The Ministry stated that decisions on rejections are based on Article 25 of the 2001 Municipal Law, which defines the council’s powers. It added that most suggestions were processed without issue.

**BD10.1 million national budget**

Capital projects in Manama are funded from a BD10.1 million national budget for 2023 and 2024, with allocations made in coordination with the Finance

Ministry. Budget planning for 2025 and 2026 is still underway.

For housing repairs, drainage, and fire damage, a separate BD1.1 million has been allocated to each municipal council under the Urban and Village Development Programme. Since 2022, the Capital Council has overseen 130 completed projects, including 64 renovations, 38 rainwater insulation jobs, and 28 fire-related repairs.

Overall, 157 requests were made under this programme, resulting in 269 tasks—since some applications involved multiple works. Each is reviewed based on need, eligibility, and funding availability.

Leo XIV says Church must fight 'lack of faith' in first mass as pope

Leo XIV urged the Catholic Church to "desperately" counter a lack of faith in his first homily as pope yesterday, a day after the modest cardinal largely unknown to the world become the first US head of the 2,000-year institution.

Chicago-born Robert Francis Prevost on Thursday became the 267th pope, spiritual leader of the world's 1.4 billion Catholics and successor to Argentina's Pope Francis, after a secret conclave by his fellow cardinals in the Vatican's Sistine Chapel.

In today's world, Leo warned in his homily to assembled cardinals, there are places or situations where "it is not easy to preach the Gospel and bear witness to its truth, where believers are mocked, opposed, despised or at best tolerated and pitied".

"Yet, precisely for this reason, they are the places where our missionary outreach is

desperately needed," said the new pope, 69, standing at the Sistine Chapel altar with Michelangelo's famed fresco of "The Last Judgment" behind him.

The former missionary deplored "settings in which the Christian faith is considered absurd, meant for the weak and unintelligent" and, in an echo of his predecessor Francis, said people were turning to "technology, money, success, power, or pleasure."

"A lack of faith is often tragically accompanied by the loss of meaning in life, the neglect of mercy, appalling violations of human dignity, the crisis of the family and so many other wounds that afflict our society," said Leo in Italian, wearing a white papal robe trimmed in gold as he addressed the seated white-robed cardinals.

In an apparent message to evangelical Christians, Pope Leo also warned that Jesus cannot be "reduced to a kind of charismatic leader or superman".

India says repulsed fresh attacks as death toll climbs

Over 50 reportedly killed as drone attacks intensify conflict between India and Pakistan

India claims repelling Pakistani drone and munition attacks overnight



The death toll from India and Pakistan's biggest clashes in decades reportedly passed 50 yesterday with each country accusing the other of sending waves of drone attacks.

The escalation between the nuclear-armed rivals follows an attack on tourists in Indian's Kashmir that reportedly killed 26 people on April 22 and Indian air strikes on "terrorist camps" on Wednesday.

In the third day of tit-for-tat exchanges since, the Indian army said that it "repulsed" Pakistani attacks using drones and other munitions overnight and gave a "befitting reply".

India also accused Pakistani forces on Thursday of targeting three military stations -- two in Kashmir and one in the neighbouring state of Punjab.

Five people were killed by Indian shelling overnight in areas along the heavily militarised Line of Control, Pakistani security and governments officials said.

In response, the Pakistan Army carried out a strong

counterattack, targeting three Indian posts across the Line of Control (LoC)," police official Adeel Khan, based in Kotli district where four of the deaths occurred, said.

In India's Kashmir, a police official said one woman died after heavy overnight shelling in Uri, some 100 kilometres (60 miles) from the state capital Srinagar, and two men were wounded.

In India's Jammu, Piyush Singh, a 21-year-old student, said: "Our [attack] is justified because we are doing it for whatever happened to our civilians."

Yesterday schools were closed on both sides of the Pakistan and Indian border in Kashmir and Punjab, affecting tens of millions of children.

At least 10 people, including a woman and two students of a

Catholic school, were killed in Pakistani strikes on Thursday.

The deceased students were from Christ School in Poonch, and their homes were adjacent to the school's boundary wall, he said.

American Vice President JD Vance has called for de-escalation, while underlining that Washington was "not going to get involved in the middle of a war that's fundamentally none of our business".

Several countries have offered to mediate, and Iranian Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi met his Indian counterpart Subrahmanya Jaishankar in New Delhi on Thursday, days after visiting Pakistan.

Diplomats and world leaders have pressured both countries for restraint.

Pakistan using terror groups as proxy forces: Indian diplomat

India's High Commissioner to the UK Vikram Doraiswami has accused Pakistan of continuing to sponsor terrorist groups while warning that New Delhi possesses the military capability to "punish them harder" if attacks escalate.

In an interview with Sky News, Doraiswami defended India's precision strikes on terrorist camps in Pakistani territory as a "measured response" to the April 22 Pahalgam attack that killed 26 civilians. "Our operations specifically avoided Pakistani military infrastructure," he stated, while showing images purporting to show Pakistani soldiers attending the funeral of a sanctioned terrorist.

The diplomat dismissed Pakistani claims of shooting down

Indian fighter jets as unverified, countering that Indian forces had themselves intercepted Chinese-made Pakistani aircraft. When pressed about China supplying 81% of Pakistan's arms, Doraiswami noted Beijing maintains relations with both countries and suggested the real issue is Pakistan's "30-year history of using terrorists as subconventional warfare."

The exchange comes as both nuclear-armed neighbours report increasing border clashes, with Doraiswami confirming Pakistani artillery has shelled civilian areas along the Line of Control for 15 consecutive days. While ruling out Indian-initiated escalation, he warned: "If Pakistan attacks our military, we will respond proportionately - and we have the capacity to hit with surgical precision."

Flights suspended at 24 Indian airports

India has suspended civilian flights at 24 airports in the north following fighting with nuclear-armed rival Pakistan.

Late Thursday, the Indian government released a list of 24 airports that have been closed for civilian flights, including in the cities of Jodhpur, Ludhiana and Amritsar near the western border with Pakistan.

Some of India's biggest air-

lines, including Air India, IndiGo and SpiceJet, have cancelled over 100 flights since Wednesday.

Local media reported the suspension of civilian flights may be lifted today morning.

Indian airlines have also issued advisories to passengers flying out from other airports, asking them to arrive at least three hours before departure, citing a government notification on enhanced security measures.

## Pakistan used civilian flights as shield, says Indian military

Pakistan deliberately endangered civilian airliners by keeping its airspace open after launching a “failed unprovoked drone” and missile attack earlier this week, using them as shields against potential Indian retaliation, the Indian military revealed yesterday.

Wing Commander Vyomika Singh, addressing a special briefing on Operation Sindoor, stated that despite initiating an attack on May 7th, Pakistan chose not to close its civil airspace at 8:30 PM local time.

“Pakistan is using civil airliner as a shield, knowing fully well that its attack on India would elicit a swift air defence response,” she asserted.

Wing Commander Singh emphasized the perilous nature of this tactic for unsuspecting passengers and international flights operating near the India-Pakistan

border.

During the briefing, she presented FlightRadar24 data illustrating a high air defense alert in the Punjab sector.

The data showed that while Indian airspace was completely clear of civilian traffic due to a declared closure, Pakistan continued to allow civil airlines to fly, including those on the Karachi-Lahore route. “Indian Air Force demonstrated considerable restraint in its response thus ensuring safety of interna-

tional civil carriers,” she stated.

In addition to this dangerous tactic, Colonel Sofiya Qureshi disclosed that Pakistan carried out multiple airspace violations and drone intrusions on the night of May 7th and 8th, specifically targeting Indian military infrastructure along the western border.

“On the night of May 7 and 8, the Pakistani army violated Indian airspace several times over the entire western border to target military infrastructure,” Colonel Qureshi said.

She further noted that heavy-calibre weapons were also fired along the Line of Control, and approximately 300 to 400 drones were used in infiltration attempts at 36 different locations. Preliminary forensic investigations of the downed drones suggested they were Turkish-made Asisguard Songar models, Colonel Qureshi added.

## Jaishankar calls for global unity against terrorism at Victory Day event

External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar on Thursday reaffirmed India’s firm stance against terrorism, describing it as a “shared threat to the international community” and calling for stronger global solidarity and cooperation.

He stated that India’s “resolute response is under way” in addressing the challenge.

Speaking at the 80th anniversary celebrations of Victory Day, Jaishankar drew parallels between the present and the cooperation that defined the Allied effort during World War II.

He highlighted India’s contributions to that war, mentioning campaigns in Burma, North Africa and Italy, as well as Indian support via the Persian Corridor to the Soviet Union and the aerial route over the Himalayas.

Acknowledging the Russian Embassy’s installation of a commemorative plaque in honour of Indian soldiers, the minister re-

marked on the enduring importance of such recognition.

Reflecting on changes in the global landscape since World War II, Jaishankar noted that while the world has evolved through decolonisation, expanded UN membership, and economic power shifts, the fundamental need for collaboration remains critical.

He emphasised the urgency of building a “more equal and contemporary global system,” advocating for reformed multilateralism inspired by past unity.

“Today is an occasion for hope and optimism, as also for remembrance,” he said, underlining his belief that international cooperation is more vital than ever.

Andrew Garfield broke down in tears as he honoured his family members who are believed to have perished in the Holocaust.

The 41-year-old actor delved into his family history for an episode of genealogy series 'Who Do You Think You Are?' and he traced his roots back to Poland revealing his Jewish great-grandfather Ludwig Garfinkel managed to flee to London in 1910, but three of Ludwig's sisters stayed behind and are believed to have been murdered at Nazi death camp Treblinka.

Andrew visited the site of Tre-

blinka and wept as he placed three stones on a memorial dedicated to all those from the family's hometown of Kielce who were killed at the camp.

The actor explained: "This is a memorial stone for the Jews from Kielce that met their ultimate fate here in Treblinka, which my great-grandfather's three sisters, we imagine, had to have been murdered.

"Szajndia, Dworja, Basia. Their lives were deemed so valueless and the Nazis attempted to erase even the memory of them, even their names, even any record of them.

"And they had succeeded in certain ways. They were just

normal girls, they were just normal women who just wanted a life, they wanted to live, to thrive, but this journey that we've been on has recovered my memory of them and my family's memory of them and I'm grateful for that.

"I wish I had known you better, I wish you peace."

The episode also followed Andrew's great-great-grandmother Chaja, who escaped by the Holocaust by moving to Brazil in 1936 to join her daughter Ruchla.

It was revealed that Ruchla's husband was the cousin of Władysław Szpilman, the Jewish musician whose story was told in Oscar-winning movie

'The Pianist' starring Adrian Brody.

learn new skills and tries to use them all in his movies.


He takes dance lessons to understand body movement and "emotion" and is "constantly training" in other pursuits.







# Man United, Spurs set up third all-English Europa League final

Manchester United thrash Athletic Bilbao 4-1 as Tottenham advance with 5-1 aggregate win over Bodo/Glimt


Manchester United are, improbably, 90 minutes away from qualifying for next season's Champions League after a 7-1 aggregate win over Athletic Bilbao to set up a Europa League final against Tottenham.

Ruben Amorim's men, who have endured a terrible Premier League campaign, came into Thursday's second leg at Old Trafford with a comfortable 3-0 cushion.

But the 4-1 scoreline gives a misleading impression of the match as the nervy home side struggled to gain a foothold after falling behind to a superb Mikel Jauregizar strike in the first half.

A triple substitution shortly after the hour mark changed the game, with substitute Mason Mount scoring two eye-catching goals and Amad Diallo creating havoc on the right.

Casemiro and Rasmus Hojlund scored the other goals as the nerves disappeared at Old



Trafford, giving way to a raucous party atmosphere.

"I think if you look at both games, it was so much tougher than if you look just to the result," said Amorim.

"We have so many weaknesses and you can understand that in the game, but we are fighting and we managed to pass. I think we deserve, if you look at the two games, to be in the final."

In the final, United will face Tottenham, who beat Norwegian champions Bodo/Glimt 5-1 on aggregate.

Amorim, who replaced the sacked Erik ten Hag in November, admitted the showpiece in Bilbao later this month would be his biggest match so far at the club.

"The money (in the Champions League) is not the most important, even the title," he said.

"To win a title as a coach is that feeling. It's that feeling that

we can do good things, the feeling to give something to our fans, especially in this kind of season."

## Premier League slump

United are heading for their worst finish in the English top-flight since they were relegated in 1974, though they cannot go down this season.

But it has been a radically different story in Europe, where they are the only team unbeaten in the Champions League, Europa League and Conference League.

The fact that United are pinning all their hopes on Europe's second-tier club competition is a sign of how far they have fallen since they were regularly competing at the sharp end of the Champions League.

They reached four Champions League finals under former manager Alex Ferguson, winning two of them.

Ex-Arsenal manager Arsene Wenger, now FIFA's head of global football development, believes it is not appropriate that the Europa League winners qualify for

the Champions League.

This is especially because five English teams will qualify for Europe's top club competition through the Premier League.

Rival teams will balk at the presence of United or Tottenham in next season's Champions League after their dire league form.

Both teams are guaranteed to finish outside of the European qualification places in the Premier League, with United currently in 15th and Spurs in 16th. But the rules are set and both

clubs have the chance to finish on a high.

Tottenham have beaten United three times this season, twice in the Premier League and once in the League Cup, but Amorim is not unduly perturbed.

"Every game has its history. So, we lost the three last games, we can win this one," said the former Sporting Lisbon boss.

"So, if you look at the odds, we are closer to win than to lose. Both teams are going to play like all or nothing in this kind of game. It's quite similar. The position of the coach is quite similar.

"I know that (Spurs manager) Ange (Postecoglou) has been there for one more year. It is different, the context, but we are struggling, both of us. So, I don't know what is going to happen."

## Bayern captain Neuer to return for Mueller's Munich farewell

# Liverpool wary over right-back void

Liverpool boss cautious on spending after Alexander-Arnold announces emotional departure

● **Alexander-Arnold's departure leaves Conor Bradley as sole right-back**

● **Slot cites affordability as barrier to top replacements**

Liverpool boss Arne Slot has warned excessive transfer fees could prevent him from signing a tailor-made replacement for Trent Alexander-Arnold.

The England right-back, whose contract expires in June, announced on Monday he would be leaving Liverpool, a club he has been with since he was a young boy, with the 26-year-old saying it was "easily the hardest decision I've ever made in my life".

Alexander-Arnold's future has been the subject of intense speculation this season, with the defender widely tipped

to join Spanish giants Real Madrid after helping Liverpool win this season's Premier League.

His exit leaves Liverpool short of cover in his position, with 21-year-old Conor Bradley, who has made 54 senior appearances, now their only recognised right-back.

"I think it would be a surprise if I were to tell you now 'Yes, we are looking at this and looking at that,'" Slot told a

pre-match press conference ahead of Sunday's game at home to Arsenal, currently second in the Premier League.

"We don't talk about contracts here so we don't talk about the positions or if we want to improve the team in certain areas."

The Dutchman added: "That's the most difficult thing for a club like Liverpool if you just won

the league is that it is not easy to find better players than we already have.

"And if they are there then they still need to be affordable and need to want to come.

"That last thing is mostly not a problem, by the way, but transfer fees sometimes are."

Slot confirmed Bradley will start Sunday's match at home to Arsenal but insisted that was not a reaction to Alexander-Arnold's announcement as the Republic of Ireland international would have been in the team for Chelsea last weekend had he been fully fit.

**'Not here to tell fans how to react'**

And while Alexander-Arnold's decision to end his 20-year association with Liverpool has provoked contrasting reactions among supporters and pundits, Slot said it was not his job to tell fans how they should feel about the situation.

Slot, in his first season at Anfield after replacing charismatic manager Jurgen Klopp, has yet to speak directly to Alexander-Arnold since the announcement, only communicating via WhatsApp. But he intends to hold face-to-face talks yesterday in order to gauge how the player is feeling about the fall-out from his decision.



## Liverpool's Salah voted Football Writers' Player of the Year

Mohamed Salah won the Football Writers' Association Player of the Year award for the third time yesterday after inspiring Liverpool's march to a record-equalling 20th English title.

Salah earned the prize after scoring 28 goals and producing 18 assists for Liverpool in the Premier League this season.

The Egypt forward broke the record for the most goal involvements in a 38-game Premier League campaign as Arne Slot's side romped to their first title since 2020.

Salah secured almost 90 percent of the football writers' votes, marking the biggest winning margin this century.

Liverpool centre-back Virgil van Dijk came second in the

contest, with Newcastle striker Alexander Isak third and Arsenal midfielder Declan Rice fourth.

Salah, who was previously given the award in 2017-18 and 2021-22, is now level with former Arsenal forward Thierry Henry as the only players to win it three times.

The

32-year-old recently ended speculation over his future by signing a new two-year contract to stay at Anfield until 2027.

Salah's decision to commit to Liverpool will make them favourites to win a record 21st title next season as they

look to move ahead of Manchester United as England's most successful top-flight club.

## IPL suspended for one week over India-Pakistan conflict

The Indian Premier League, the richest tournament in cricket, was suspended for one week yesterday because of the conflict between New Delhi and Pakistan.

"Further updates regarding the new schedule and venues of the tournament will be announced in due course," Devajit Saikia, honorary secretary of the Indian cricket board (BCCI), said in a statement.

"While cricket remains a national passion, there is nothing greater than the nation and its sovereignty, integrity and security of our country," the statement added.

Officials paused the T20 competition after a match Thursday was abandoned in Dharamsala, less than 200 kilometres (125 miles) from the northern city of Jammu, where explosions were report-

ed hours earlier.

On a third day of exchanges between the nuclear-armed neighbours yesterday, India said it repulsed a wave of Pakistani drone and artillery attacks overnight.

Officials in Pakistan reported more civilian deaths.

Pakistan cricket has moved the remaining matches in its own T20 league to the United Arab Emirates because of player safety.

Thursday's match in the IPL between Punjab Kings and Delhi Capitals was abruptly called off after 10.1 overs due to an apparent floodlight failure in the Himalayan hill town of Dharamsala.

The stadium was swiftly evacuated and players whisked out of the ground in the team bus, according to media reports.

IPL chairman Arun Dharmal was seen signalling to fans to leave the stadium.

## Howe urges Newcastle to fulfil Champions League expectation

Eddie Howe has challenged Newcastle to meet his expectations by qualifying for the Champions League.

Howe's side sit fourth in the Premier League with three games left to secure the top five finish that guarantees a place in Europe's elite club competition.

Newcastle can take a major step towards that target with a win against fifth-placed Chelsea at St James' Park on Sunday.

The Magpies are ahead of Chelsea only by virtue of goals scored, with Manchester City, Nottingham Forest and Aston Villa also engaged in the scrap for a top five place.

"It was an expectation that we placed upon ourselves, so I get what you're trying to say, but I

don't necessarily feel that way internally.

"Winning the cup final, I think, gave us a freedom and a new-found confidence off the back of achieving that. That gave us a bounce in the next few games. We elevated our performance off the back of that.

"But that feels like it was, in football terms, quite a while ago.

"Now we have to focus on these last three games knowing, for me, just how good the team can be. We have to set our expectations very high."

Howe believes Newcastle will have to produce one of their best performances this season if they are to secure a vital victory over UEFA Conference League finalists Chelsea.
