## Bahrain welcomes Azerbaijan-Armenia peace agreement

The Kingdom of Bahrain welcomed the signing of a peace agreement between the Republic of Azerbaijan and the Republic of Armenia, brokered by the US under the leadership of President Donald Trump.

A statement by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs expressed Bahrain's hope that the agreement would contribute to enhancing co-operation between the two countries, bringing prosperity, sustainable peace, and mutual benefit to their peoples and to all peoples of the Caucasus region.

## Hezbollah weapons depot blast leaves six soldiers dead

The Lebanese army said a blast at a weapons depot near the Israeli border killed six soldiers yesterday, with a military source saying the troops were removing munitions from a Hezbollah facility.

Under the truce that ended last year's war between Israel and Hezbollah, Lebanese troops have been deploying in the country's south and dismantling the Iran-backed militant group's infrastructure in the region.

The deaths come after the Lebanese government decided this week to disarm Hezbollah and tasked the army with drawing up a plan to complete the process by year end.

Hezbollah said it will ignore the cabinet's decision.

From Home to High Office, Bahrain's New Plan Strengthens Families and Elevates Women Leaders

● Family stability prioritised

● Women in leadership roles

The Supreme Council for Women, led by Her Royal Highness Princess Sabika bint Ibrahim Al Khalifa, has launched a two-year national plan that puts family stability and women's leadership at the heart of Bahrain's development agenda.

The plan sets four priority areas for the coming two years - family stability, decision-making and adoption, economic participation and quality of life. Each area will be addressed through five axes covering policy, budgets that respond to women's needs, awareness and training, auditing and monitoring, and follow-up and evaluation.

**Strong Families First**

The Council describes family stability as essential to women's empowerment, stressing that progress in women's lives cannot be achieved without a stable home environment. Planned initiatives include reviewing laws related to family affairs, improving social protection services, updating the national strategy for protection from domestic

violence, expanding family reconciliation offices to all governorates, and improving services for women with disabilities or those caring for persons with disabilities.

The budget axis will focus on gender-responsive housing programmes for all eligible women and coordinating national resources to meet women's needs during emergencies.

*Research cited by the Supreme Council for Women shows that institutions with gender balance in leadership roles record greater innovation and higher performance levels.*

Decision-making and adoption form the second major priority. Measures include supporting women's membership on boards of public joint-stock companies, increasing their participation in the judiciary and the diplomatic corps, and sustaining their presence in leadership positions in banking and other sectors.

Awareness work will promote gender balance laws, build women's leadership skills and encourage active participation in governance bodies. The plan also introduces a secondary school awareness kit that covers equal opportunity, communication skills, preventing violence and building self-confidence.

### Recognition That Inspires

The Her Royal Highness Princess Sabika bint Ibrahim Al Khalifa Award for the Advancement of Bahraini Women, along with the Her Highness Shaikha Hessa bint Salman Al Khalifa Award for Youth Volunteer Work, remain at the centre of the strategy. These awards aim to encourage institutions and individuals to advance women's empowerment, promote gender balance and inspire volunteerism, while recognising success stories that set examples for others.

By linking home and high office, the plan positions Bahraini women as equal partners in family and national life, ensuring their leadership and contributions are felt in every sphere.

# Bahrain Leads Gaza Condemnation

Bloc backs aid surge, Cairo rebuild

● 24-nation Arab-Islamic bloc

● Rejects Israeli Gaza takeover

Bahrain, alongside 23 other Arab and Islamic nations, has joined in strongly condemning Israel's stated intention to impose full military control over the Gaza Strip, warning that it would entrench occupation and

erase prospects for peace. The statement from the Ministerial Committee mandated by the Joint Extraordinary Arab-Islamic Summit on Gaza developments described the Israeli plan as a dangerous escalation and a flagrant violation of international law, aimed at imposing facts on the ground by force. It said this course of action was a continuation of grave violations including killing, starvation, forced displacement, annexation of Palestinian land and settler violence, which may amount to crimes against humanity.

The joint statement called for

an immediate and comprehensive cessation of Israeli aggression across the Gaza Strip, the West Bank and East Jerusalem, along with an end to violations against civilians and civilian infrastructure. It urged Israel, as the occupying power, to allow the unconditional entry of large-scale humanitarian aid, including food, medicine and fuel, and to guarantee relief agencies full operational freedom in line with international humanitarian law.

Efforts to secure a ceasefire and a prisoner-hostage exchange were backed by Egypt, Qatar and the US.

# Bahrain, Oman Ready for GCC Visa

New entrepreneurs body to drive Gulf travel

Bahrain and Oman are stepping up joint tourism efforts as the Gulf prepares to roll out a unified visa expected to transform regional travel.

Minister of Tourism, Her Excellency Fatima bint Jaffer Al Sairafi, said the close, long-standing ties between the two nations continue to grow, especially in tourism, which she described as a vital driver of economic growth.

She made the remarks during a reception hosted by Her

The minister said Bahrain would continue to work with Omani counterparts in the exhibitions and conferences sector to exchange expertise and open more opportunities for collaboration.

For her part, Hujaija bint Jaffer Al Said praised the ministry's role in developing the tourism sector and in opening new avenues for cooperation to

serve mutual interests.

The launch comes as the GCC moves toward introducing its Grand Tours visa, which will allow visitors to travel across all six-member states with a single permit, creating fresh opportunities for joint tourism packages and multi-country itineraries.

The Bahraini-Omani Entrepreneurs Association aims to align with such regional initiatives, potentially positioning the two countries as early leaders in integrated Gulf tourism.

# Judgment day

Appeal rulings on 14 August in Saar fatal crash and drug case



A tragic ending for a family

A Bahraini man convicted in two separate cases, one over a fatal crash and the other for drug use, will hear the outcomes of both appeals on 14 August after the Second High Criminal Appeals Court set judgment for the same day. The 29-year-old was sentenced to six years in prison for causing the deaths of a couple and their son in a collision in Saar, and a further three years for possessing drugs for personal use, making a total of nine years.

### Driving licence

In the traffic case, the Seventh Minor Criminal Traffic Court also ordered his driving licence to be revoked for a year after his release and the confiscation of the vehicle used. The court found that on 30 May he drove into the opposite lane without caution, exceeded the legal speed limit by more than 30 per cent, and was under the influence of drugs and alcohol when his vehicle struck the victims' car, killing three and seriously injuring two children.

Prosecutors told the court that his conduct caused a tragedy for one family and asked for the harshest penalty available, saying he drove with complete disregard for road safety.

### Sentence

In the drug case, defence lawyer Ahmed Touq called for the three-year sentence to be overturned and his client acquitted. He said the judgment relied on findings not supported by the file and that there was no technical report proving cannabis or any other drug was present in the defendant's urine, despite the ruling stating otherwise.

He also argued that the investigation was invalid, noting that the search warrant was dated 4 June, five days after his client was already in custody, and said this undermined the case. The defence maintained there was no incident that could be treated as an arrest in progress.

### Home search

Touq said the home search broke Articles 70, 73 and 74 as it was carried out without the defendant or another resident present. He claimed officers locked themselves in a room, allowed no one else inside, and did not show any seized items afterwards. He said there was no proof that a plastic bag with traces of cannabis belonged to his client, nor that it contained any measurable quantity.

The drug charges stemmed from the accident inquiry, when anti-narcotics officers searched the defendant's home under a prosecution warrant and found cannabis.

### Fine

The First Minor Criminal Court sentenced him to three years in prison, fined him BD3,000, and ordered the seized material confiscated. In the traffic case, the prosecution also charged him with driving while impaired to the point of losing control, driving while intoxicated, making an illegal overtaking manoeuvre into oncoming traffic, ignoring traffic signs, causing property damage, and endangering lives and property.

# Pain brings justice

Ex-wife wins BD50,000 compensation over acid attack in mall car park

A Bahraini man and his nephew have been ordered by the High Civil Court to pay BD50,000 to his former wife after throwing a corrosive liquid on her in a shopping mall car park, leaving her with severe burns and a 60 per cent permanent disability. The pair had earlier been found guilty by the High Criminal Court, with the verdict upheld by the Supreme Criminal Appeals Court, and each was sentenced to 10 years in prison.

### Facts

With the criminal judgment final, the civil court said the facts were established and required compensation for both the physical and emotional harm. Kumail Al Alawi, acting for the claimant, said the attack caused permanent scarring, re-



stricted movement and lasting harm that could not be undone. He filed the civil case on her behalf, seeking BD50,000 for material and moral damages. **Harm** In its reasoning, the court said the Civil Code makes anyone who causes harm liable for compensation, and when more than one person is responsible, they are jointly liable.

It added that a criminal judgment that has ruled on the facts binds the civil court, which cannot revisit the matter. The ruling said the final criminal judgment proved both defendants carried out the attack, meeting the requirements for tortious liability. **Medical report** A forensic medical report found the claimant suffered 60

per cent disability, severe disfigurement, limits to her movement and psychological trauma. The court assessed BD45,000 for material loss and BD5,000 for moral harm. Both defendants must pay the full BD50,000, along with court costs and legal fees.

# Asian man imprisoned for 15 years for drug trafficking

An Asian man has been sentenced to 15 years in prison and fined BD5,000 for trafficking in drugs. The First High Criminal Court ordered his deportation once the term is served and ruled that the seized items be confiscated. The case began after the Anti-Narcotics Directorate was informed of a parcel sent from an African country and arriving via Bahrain International Airport. When a customs officer scanned it, the image revealed clothing concealing drugs, packed with care to disguise their presence. The directorate prepared an



operation to arrest the person who came to collect it. The defendant turned up to receive the package and was detained along with his car.

Both were handed to the Anti-Narcotics Directorate. A search of his vehicle and home uncovered marijuana and a precision scale

He admitted that he had taken delivery of the shipment at the request of another man. Investigations pointed to an organised group smuggling drugs into Bahrain.

### Profit

According to the findings, the operation was led by a man who arranged for large quantities to be brought in and sold for profit, with the defendant acting as the receiver, storekeeper and distributor. A laboratory report confirmed that the seized material contained a controlled substance. Examination of the defendant's phone found images and videos of drugs along with a precision scale.

# Four jailed for forcing woman into prostitution

Four men have been jailed for five years and fined BD2,000 each for forcing a woman into prostitution in Bahrain. The High Criminal Court ordered them to cover the cost of returning her to her home country and barred them from re-entering the kingdom after their release. The case centred on events in 2025, when the woman travelled to Bahrain at the invitation of the first defendant, believing she would work as a hairdresser. She had secured a work visa, paid for her ticket and was met

at the airport by the first and second defendants. **Passport** They took her passport and demanded she engage in prostitution for money. When she refused and asked to be sent home, they assaulted her and threatened her with prison. Some time later she was moved to another flat, guarded by the second and third defendants. There, she said, she was again forced into prostitution under threats while being kept inside against her will.



### Inquiries

Police inquiries supported her account, leading to the arrest of the four men. Prosecutors said they had trafficked her by moving and housing her for the purpose

of prostitution through force, threats and deceit, taking advantage of her vulnerable state. They were also accused of holding her unlawfully, depriving her of her liberty through violence and threats for profit, and relying entirely on the money she earned from prostitution.

# Call for bank branch to serve Madinat Salman residents

Banks are being pressed to open a branch in Madinat Salman, with Northern Municipal Council member Bassem Abu Idrees saying discussions have already taken place with

several institutions. He said the city's rapid growth, now spread across three residential complexes and home to nearly 30,000 people, had made a local branch a necessity. Madinat Salman contains over 5,000 homes, split between villas and flats, yet residents must

travel to other areas to complete everyday banking, which can be especially taxing for older people and women. **Services** Abu Idrees called the move in step with Bahrain's strong position in the banking sector, adding that Madinat Sal-

man, planned as a model city, should offer all essential services, with banking among the priorities. Shops in the city are reaching their final fit-out stages and are expected to open soon. He said this was an ideal moment for banks to establish themselves,

serve residents and contribute to local trade. He expressed hope that national banks would take up the opportunity, make use of the city's modern infrastructure and provide full banking services that match the needs and expectations of its people.



# Budaiya Beach Becomes Safety Hub

As part of the effort, awareness brochures were distributed in several languages to reach all segments of society. Life jackets were also handed out to visitors, reinforcing the practical side of the safety message.

◆ **Armenia and Azerbaijan**

have committed to a lasting peace after decades of conflict, US President Donald Trump said after the South Caucasus rivals signed a deal welcomed on Saturday by Iran and Western nations. Armenian Prime Minister Nikol Pashinyan and Azerbaijan's long-time President Ilham Aliyev said Trump's mediation should earn him a Nobel Peace Prize -- an award the US leader has been vocal about seeking. The two former Soviet republics "are committing to stop all fighting forever, open up commerce, travel and diplomatic relations and respect each other's sovereignty and territorial integrity," Trump said at a White House signing event on Friday. However, the fine print and binding nature of the deal between the long-time foes remained unclear. The two leaders would have a "great relationship," Trump said.

◆ **North Korean troops** have started removing propaganda loudspeakers used to blare unsettling noises along the border, South Korea's military said

**North Korea removing border loudspeakers: Seoul military**

South Korea's defence ministry on Monday said it had begun removing loudspeakers from its side of the border as "a practical measure aimed at helping ease tensions with the North". South Korea had been blaring K-pop and news reports to the North in response to Pyongyang transmitting bizarre, unsettling noises along the border that had become a major nuisance for South Korean locals.

◆ **President Donald Trump** is moving to target Latin American drug cartels with the military, US media said Friday, after Washington designated several narcotics trafficking groups as "terrorist" organizations earlier this year. The New York Times reported that Trump has directed the Pentagon to use military force against cartels deemed terrorist organizations. The Wall Street Journal said the president ordered options to be prepared, with the use of special forces and the provision of intelligence support under discussion, and that any action would be coordinated with foreign partners. White House spokeswoman Anna Kelly, while not confirming the reports, said in a statement that Trump's "top priority is protecting the homeland, which is why he took the bold step to designate several cartels and gangs as foreign terrorist organizations."

**New York declares total war on prolific rat population**

New York, United States

New York is waging a war on multiple fronts to combat the near ubiquitous rats that plague city streets and the subways, leaving some residents afraid to let their children walk on sidewalks.

Faced with an overwhelming and ever-growing problem, officials have moved beyond gassing burrows to suffocate rodents and are now using high-tech mapping tools to try and sterilize the population.

Alongside targeted interventions, officials are mounting an effort to educate the public about the need to avoid leaving behind food waste that feeds and sustains the rat population.

Caroline Bragdon, director of neighborhood interventions for Pest Control Services within New York City's Department of Health, told AFP that the lack of food "stresses" rats and other vermin.

"Perhaps this forces them to go further in search of food, but perhaps they simply have fewer offspring," she said.

"That's usually what we're seeing. Fewer rats over time. Less breeding leads to less rat activity," Bragdon added.

The city is testing out an arsenal of different tools in the Harlem neighborhood, aiming to find new products and methods to tackle the rats.

For large, densely populated cities like New York -- with its 8.5 million inhabitants -- food sources for the rodents are bountiful, whether it's on sidewalks, in overflowing trash bins, or in parks.

Rats, which survive on practically the same diet as humans, can flourish even on items discarded as trash -- like soda cans thrown into recycling bins, or crumbs given to pigeons, warned Bragdon.

A rat needs one ounce (28 grams) of food per day to sustain itself, and it can have up to 12 offspring per litter.

During its short life of less than a year, it can have between five and seven litters.

The best way to counter the scourge of rats is to "remove their food source... So make it harder for them, then they're going to have to travel further to try and find something," said Alexa Albert, a supervisor for the city's pest control service.

**Zelensky warns on 'decisions without Ukraine'**

President Volodymyr Zelensky on Saturday warned that "decisions without Ukraine" would not bring peace and ruled out ceding territory to Russia.

"Ukrainians will not give their land to the occupier," he said on social media, as US President Donald Trump and Russian President Vladimir Putin prepare to hold a summit

next week in Alaska to discuss peace in Ukraine. "Any decisions against us, any decisions without Ukraine, are also decisions against peace. They will achieve nothing," he said, adding that the war "cannot be ended without us, without Ukraine".

Zelensky said Ukraine was "ready for real decisions that can bring peace" but said it should be a "dignified peace", without giving details.

and Donald Trump will meet in the US state of Alaska on August 15, to try to resolve the three-year conflict, despite warnings from Ukraine and Europe that Kyiv must be part of negotiations.

Announcing the summit on Friday, Trump said that "there'll be some swapping of territories to the betterment of both" Ukraine and Russia, without providing further details.

"Ukrainians will not give their land to the occupier," Zelensky said on social media hours later.

"Any decisions against us, any decisions without Ukraine, are also decisions against peace.

They will achieve nothing," he said, adding that the war "cannot be ended without us, without Ukraine".

Zelensky also urged Ukraine's allies to take "clear steps" towards achieving a sustainable peace, during a call with Britain's Prime Minister Keir Starmer.

National security advisors from Kyiv's allies -- including the United States, EU nations and the UK -- were gathering in Britain on Saturday to align their views ahead of the Putin-Trump summit.

"It is truly important that the Russians do not succeed in deceiving anyone again," Zelensky said after a call with French President Emmanuel Macron, without

elaborating further.

Three rounds of negotiations between Russia and Ukraine this year have failed to bear fruit, and it remains unclear whether a summit could bring peace any closer as the warring sides' positions are still far apart.

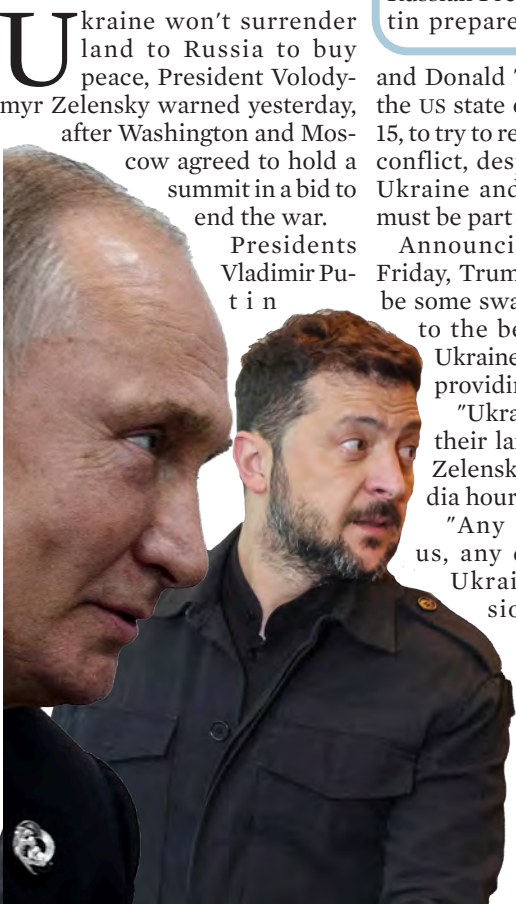
Putin has resisted multiple calls from the United States, Europe and Kyiv for a ceasefire.

Zelensky said Kyiv was "ready for real decisions that can bring peace" but said it should be a "dignified peace", without giving details.

Putin, a former KGB officer in power in Russia for over 25 years, has ruled out holding talks with Zelensky at this stage.

Zelensky has been pushing for a three-way summit and has frequently said meeting Putin is the only way to make progress towards peace.

In 2022, the Kremlin announced the annexation four Ukrainian regions -- Donetsk, Lugansk, Zaporizhzhia and Kherson -- despite not having full control over them. Russia had previously annexed the Crimean peninsula from Ukraine in 2014.



**IAF's S-400 shot down 5 Pakistani fighter jets during Operation Sindoor: Air chief marshal AP Singh**

Air Chief Marshal Amar Preet Singh yesterday confirmed that India shot down five Pakistani fighter jets during Operation Sindoor, the military move targeting terror infrastructure, launched to avenge the April 22 Pahalgam attack.

During an address in Bengaluru, the Air Chief Marshal said that the jets were shot down by the S-400 air defence systems. Apart from the five jets, one large Airborne Early Warning and Control (AEW&C) or early warning aircraft was also destroyed, he said.

"We have at least five fighters confirmed kills and one large aircraft, which could be either an ELINT aircraft or an AEW & C aircraft, which was taken on at a distance of about 300 kilometres," the Air Chief Marshal said, calling the downing of the aircraft the largest ever recorded surface-to-air kill. He also said that one half of the F-16 hangar at the Shahbaz Jacobabad airfield in Pakistan was "gone" and some aircraft inside were possibly damaged.

The IAF chief made the remarks while he was giving a briefing on how Operation Sindoor was planned and executed.

After the operation was

AIR CHIEF MARSHAL AMAR PREET SINGH

launched on May 7, India did confirm that some high-tech Pakistani Air Force jets were shot down, but did not give an exact number. Air Marshal AK Bharti, director general air operations, had said back then that India was

trying to get into the technical details to establish the exact number.

"We don't have the wreckage as their (PAF) planes were prevented from entering our airspace. But we have downed a few planes,"

he had said.

As the Air Chief Marshal confirmed the number of Pak jets shot down, he said India rendered such a huge blow to Pakistan's air defence systems that the neighbouring country realised it would lose more if the conflict continued.

"I can say that it was more of a high-tech war which was fought. In 80 to 90 hours of war, we were able to achieve so much of damage to air system that it was clear to them that if they continue, they are going to pay for it more and more," the Air Chief Marshal said.

He also said that India was able to get control of at least two command and control centres, like Murid and Chaklala. "At least six radars, some of them big, some of them small... We have an indication of at least one AEW&C in that AEW&C hangar and a few F-16s, which were under maintenance there," Singh was quoted as saying by news agency ANI.

Notably, US President Donald Trump recently claimed that five jets were lost during the India-Pakistan conflict. The US President has time and again claimed credit for brokering a ceasefire between the two countries, a claim New Delhi has always rejected, asserting there was no third party intervention.

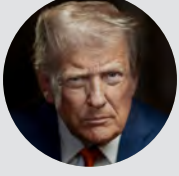

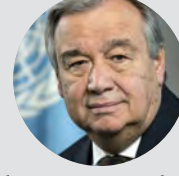

London's Metropolitan Police said Saturday officers had arrested at least 150 people for supporting Palestine

"We've now arrested 150 people in Parliament Square," the force said in a post on X, adding

"there are still people holding placards supporting Palestine Action" and that "officers are steadily working through the crowd making further arrests".

## Four astronauts home from space station after successful splashdown

An international crew of four astronauts is back home on Earth Saturday after nearly five months aboard the International Space Station, returning safely in a SpaceX capsule.

The spacecraft carrying US astronauts Anne McClain and Nichole Ayers, Japan's Takuya Onishi and Russian cosmonaut Kirill Peskov splashed down off California's coast at 8.44 am local time (1534 GMT).

Their return marks the end of the 10th crew rotation mission to the space station under NASA's Commercial Crew Program, which was created to succeed the Space Shuttle era by partnering with private industry.

The Dragon capsule of billionaire Elon Musk's SpaceX company detached from the International Space Station (ISS) at 2215 GMT on Friday.

The capsule's dizzying, 17-hour drop back down to Earth was slowed when it re-entered the atmosphere, then further reined in by the deployment of huge parachutes.

After the capsule splashed down, it was recovered by a SpaceX ship and hoisted aboard. Only then were the astronauts able to breathe Earth's air again, for the first time in months.

The astronaut team, known as Crew-10, conducted numerous scientific experiments during their time on the space station, including studying plant growth and how cells react to gravity.

Their launch into space in March allowed two US astronauts to return home after being unexpectedly stuck on-board the space station for nine months.

When they launched in June 2024, Butch Wilmore and Suni Williams were only supposed to spend eight days in space on a

test of the Boeing Starliner's first crewed flight.

However, the spaceship developed propulsion problems and was deemed unfit to fly back, leaving them stranded in space.

NASA announced this week that Wilmore has decided to retire after 25 years of service at the US space agency.

Last week, US astronauts Zena Cardman and Mike Fincke, Japan's Kimiya Yui and Russian cosmonaut Oleg Platonov boarded the ISS for a six-month mission.

## Internships are not free slave labour

Come July-August and there is always a scramble in the student community, aged 15 and upward, to secure internships. And this is always followed by a rash of press releases and photos from companies, showcasing their internship programmes and interns to show that they are nurturing the workforce of tomorrow. But, in speaking to my children and their friends, I have found that the term 'internship' is loosely used in Bahrain and could be anything – it could be a valuable, tightly-scheduled and planned learning experience in a modern workplace which will help youngsters understand workplace dynamics and give them an insight into what career they want to follow. Or it could be a holiday time-pass where the company has no real plan to give the interns a feel for the work they do but are merely ticking the box. Here the youngsters unfortunately find themselves used as errand boys and girls, not picking up any real insights into the work they signed up for and emerging from the internship with nothing better than a knowledge of feeding the photocopier.

Damaging as this is, there is a third type of internship which is far worse. It is the "free" internship where the intern is taught the ropes of the assigned job and given excellent grounding in what is expected. The company usually has a proper duty description and mentors in the workplace to guide the intern. However, the whole exercise is a sham – because the internship is not a paid one. The intern is not paid anything and while they learn a lot, by not paying them a fair salary for their work, the company is missing a major lesson – it is not teaching them to value themselves or their talent in the marketplace. In addition, it can be considered being taken advantage of – companies should know better than to expect free service from rookie workers and if they cannot pay a fair wage to interns, why then, they should not hire them and pretend they are doing them a favour.

An internship serves as a mutually beneficial relationship where students gain hands-on experience, industry knowledge, and practical skills, while companies benefit from fresh perspectives, energy, and the potential for future talent. To do it right, I believe that the Ministry of Labour must ask all companies hiring interns to submit a detailed Internship Plan well in advance along with what the company will pay the interns. Only after this has been approved must companies be allowed to flaunt their interns.

## Teen shooter wounds three in Times Square: NYPD

A 17-year-old boy opened fire and wounded three people in New York City's heavily touristed Times Square early yesterday, the New York Police Department said.

The shooting occurred around 1:20 am (0520 GMT) following a "verbal altercation", an NYPD spokesperson told AFP without giving further details.

An 18-year-old woman's neck was grazed, while a 19-year-old man and a 65-year-old man's lower limbs were injured, police said.

None of the injuries was considered to be life-threatening.

The three victims were taken to New York City's Bellevue



Hospital, where they were determined to be in stable condition.

"The perpetrator has been taken into police custody, and a firearm has been recovered," the NYPD spokesperson added. The suspect had not been formally charged.

The shooting occurred at 44th Street and Seventh Avenue, an intersection in the middle of the city's theater district, which draws tens of thousands of tourists a day.

# Grok, is that Gaza?

AI image checks mislocate news photographs

This image by AFP photo-journalist Omar al-Qattaa shows a skeletal, underfed girl in Gaza, where Israel's blockade has fuelled fears of mass famine in the Palestinian territory.

But when social media users asked Grok where it came from, X boss Elon Musk's artificial intelligence chatbot was certain that the photograph was taken in Yemen nearly seven years ago.

The AI bot's untrue response was widely shared online and a left-wing pro-Palestinian French lawmaker, Aymeric Caron, was accused of peddling disinformation on the Israel-Hamas war for posting the photo.

At a time when internet users are turning to AI to verify images more and more, the furore shows the risks of trusting tools like

Grok was trained using a purpose-built supercomputer called "Colossus," constructed in just 19 days—a remarkable feat, given that similar data centers usually take around four years from planning to installation.

Hamas's October 7, 2023 attack on Israel, Mariam weighed 25 kilograms, her mother told AFP. Today, she weighs only nine. The only nutrition she gets to help her condition is milk, Modallala told AFP -- and even that's "not always available".

Challenged on its incorrect response, Grok said: "I do not spread fake news; I base my answers on verified sources."

The chatbot eventually issued a response that recognised the error -- but in reply to further queries the next day, Grok repeated its claim that the photo was from Yemen.

The chatbot has previously issued content that praised Nazi leader Adolf Hitler and that suggested people with Jewish surnames were more likely to spread online hate.

**Radical right bias**

Grok's mistakes illustrate

the limits of AI tools, whose functions are as impenetrable as "black boxes", said Louis de Diesbach, a researcher in technological ethics.

"We don't know exactly why they give this or that reply, nor how they prioritise their sources," said Diesbach, author of a book on AI tools, "Hello ChatGPT".

Each AI has biases linked to the information it was trained on and the instructions of its creators, he said.

In the researcher's view Grok, made by Musk's xAI start-up, shows "highly pronounced biases which are highly aligned with the ideology" of the South African billionaire, a former confidante of US President Donald Trump and a standard-bearer for the radical right.

Asking a chatbot to pinpoint a photo's origin takes it out of its proper role, said Diesbach.

"Typically, when you look for the origin of an image, it might say: 'This photo could have been taken in Yemen, could have been taken in Gaza, could have been taken in pretty much any country where there is famine'."

AI does not necessarily seek accuracy -- "that's not the goal," the expert said.

Another AFP photograph of a starving Gazan child by al-Qattaa, taken in July 2025, had already been wrongly located and dated by Grok to Yemen, 2016.

That error led to internet users accusing the French newspaper Liberation, which had published the photo, of manipulation.

**'Friendly pathological liar'**

An AI's bias is linked to the data it is fed and what happens during fine-tuning -- the so-called alignment phase -- which then determines what the model would rate as a good or bad answer.

"Just because you explain to it that the answer's wrong doesn't mean it will then give a different one," Diesbach said.

"Its training data has not changed and neither has its alignment."

Grok is not alone in wrongly identifying images.

When AFP asked Mistral AI's Le Chat -- which is in part trained on AFP's articles under an agreement between the French start-up and the news agency -- the bot also misidentified the photo of Mariam Dawwas as being from Yemen.

For Diesbach, chatbots must never be used as tools to verify facts.

"They are not made to tell the truth," but to "generate content, whether true or false", he said.

"You have to look at it like a friendly pathological liar -- it may not always lie, but it always could."

## New Zealand complete crushing innings win over Zimbabwe

New Zealand completed a crushing win by an innings and 359 runs on the third day of the second Test against Zimbabwe at Queens Sports Club on Saturday.

Zak Foulkes, playing in his first Test match, took five for 37 as Zimbabwe were bowled out for 117 in their second innings.

Nic Welch, batting at number three, made an unbeaten 47 and stood virtually alone against the New Zealand pace attack.

It was the third-biggest win by an innings in Test history.

England beat Australia by an innings and 579 runs at The Oval in London in 1938. Australia defeated South Africa by an innings and 360 runs in Johannesburg in 2001/02.

"We bowled well in the first innings after losing the toss," said Mitch Santner, who captained New Zealand in both Tests in the absence of the injured Tom Latham.

"And the batsmen got through some tough periods with their partnerships and then cashed in."

New Zealand's previous biggest win — and Zimbabwe's previous heaviest

defeat — was by an innings and 301 runs when the two teams met in Napier in 2011/12.

Zimbabwe suffered their sixth successive defeat — four of them by an innings — since beating Bangladesh in Sylhet in April.

New Zealand declared their first innings closed on their overnight total of 601 for three.

It took only three balls for Matt Henry to start the home team's collapse when he bowled Brian Bennett for his second duck of the match.

Henry had Brendan Taylor caught at second slip and Jacob Duffy caught Sean Williams off his own bowling before Matthew Fisher had Zimbabwe captain Craig Ervine held at third slip.

Foulkes, who briefly returned to New Zealand after a triangular Twenty20 series but was recalled after Nathan Smith was injured in the first Test, took the next five wickets.

Foulkes had match figures of nine for 77.

Devon Conway, who scored 153 for New Zealand, was player of the match while Henry, who took 16 wickets across the two matches, was player of the series.

After back-to-back defeats to Japan (32-30) and Egypt (36-28), Bahrain's U19s hopes of reaching the main round at the 11th IHF Men's Youth World Championship had already been dashed. But yesterday at Cairo Stadium, the Bahrainis refused to go quietly, battling past South Korea 36-33 in front of 4,000 fans to claim their first win of the tournament.

Fast Start, Firm Finish

Coached by Raed Al Marzouq and assisted by Ahmed Tarada, Bahrain led 16-13 at halftime and never relinquished control. Their attack clicked from all angles — 67% shooting efficiency on 54 attempts — and they punished Korea with a 16/23 breakthrough success rate. Playmaker Abbas Ali was flawless (9/9), while Mohamed Aadam's seven goals from the line were a constant menace. Salman Al Showaikh was named man of

Korea's Resistance

Hermansen made 72 appearances for Leicester, winning the Championship title in 2024. He impressed last season as the Foxes were relegated from the Premier League.

West Ham were in the hunt for a new goalkeeper after Poland's Lukasz Fabianski left at the end of last season. Hermansen will compete with Alphonse Areola, 32, who played 26 times in the Premier League last season.

## As temperatures touch 50C, Dubai runners turn to indoor marathon

Early on Saturday, as temperatures soared outside, a sprawling shopping centre in Dubai echoed to the squeak of sneakers as hundreds of people joined "Mallathon" -- an indoor, air-conditioned race.

The government-backed initiative aims to encourage exercise during August, often the United Arab Emirates' hottest month, and make use of Dubai's giant malls which are otherwise empty at that time.

Running outside during summer in the Gulf, one of the world's hottest regions where temperatures sometimes top 50C, is unpleasant and even unsafe for many.

"If you run outside, it's not healthy at all because temperatures are around 40C to 50C," said one runner who gave his name as Rai, his platinum-blond hair pulled back with a headband.

Participants wearing "Dubai Mallathon" T-shirts and sports gear ran and walked past closed stores along vacant, marbled halls that were set to be teeming with shoppers hours later.

Throughout August, nine of the city's shopping centres -- including the cavernous Dubai Mall, one of the world's biggest -- are open daily for runners and walkers from 7am-10am.

On weekends, runners can enter organised 10km, 5km or 2.5km races at designated malls, complete with podium presentations and prizes.

During Saturday's race at the City Centre Mirdif mall, two robots buzzed around the participants, who paused to take selfies with them.

Others waited in line to use electric bikes that powered blenders to make healthy smoothies.

Mall rats

Mallathon is backed by Dubai Crown Prince Sheikh Hamdan bin Mohammed bin Rashid Al

Maktoum, 42, whose public profile projects him as an exemplar of active living.

It is one of a number of attempts to steer Dubai's car-loving, mall-rat population towards exercise, including the 30x30 challenge, where residents are encouraged to exercise 30 minutes a day for a month.

Obesity rates in the energy-rich Gulf country regularly top global charts.

A study published by The Lan-



cet in March predicted a staggering 94 percent of UAE males would be overweight or obese by 2050 -- the highest in the world.

Partly to blame is the furnace-like heat that ravages the region for several months a year, and is steadily growing more intense.

The UAE had its hottest April on record this year, and then breached its May high two days in a row. On August 1, temperatures reached 51.8C, just shy of

the national record of 52C.

Menna, a 36-year-old Egyptian who has lived in Dubai for 15 years, said there was "no way" she would exercise outside in the summer.

But in the mall, "we have air-conditioning, first aid, water... there's everything that you need."

"It motivates you more when other people are doing it too," she added.

Fouzeyya Faridoon, head of so-
