Inmates' Ashura rituals go 'smoothly and freely'

he Ashura Commemoration in the reform and rehabilitation centres went smoothly and freely.

This assessment was made by a delegation from the Council of Commissioners at the National Institution for Human Rights (NIHR), led by Ali Ahmed Al Derazi, after they visited the Jau Correction and Rehabilitation Centre and the Dry Dock Detention Centre for several days.
