## Seth Rogen declares second season of The Studio will reflect the loss of Catherine O'Hara

Seth Rogen says the second season of *The Studio* will reflect the loss of Catherine O'Hara.

The actor, 43, who co-created the *The Studio* alongside Evan Goldberg, spoke about the impact of *Home Alone* star Catherine's death after she passed away earlier this year aged 71, describing the show as now feeling "a little anchorless" without her.

In an interview with *The Times*, Seth said about the future of *The Studio*: "If anything, we're acknowledging the idea that we are a little anchorless."

"But, honestly, that is a part of

life and what we all experience.

"And so while we try not to dwell too much on heavy themes in this show, they will be there in this second season. We are not ignoring it."

Evan, 43, added: "It has been an unbelievable challenge.

"Obviously, emotionally, deal-

ing with the loss, but also when it comes to the show itself.

"We wrote it for her to be there. We had it all set, and the shock waves permeate throughout the entire new season. It's been difficult. You worded it better than we could - she was the anchor, and now the anchor is gone."

Catherine, known for roles in *Schitt's Creek* and *Home Alone*, died on 30 January from a pulmonary embolism after missing the start of filming for the show's second season.

She had starred in the first season as studio executive Patty Leigh, a role that later earned her a posthumous win at the SAG

Awards on 1 March, making her the first woman to receive the honour after death.

Following Catherine's death, Seth and other cast members withdrew from an Apple TV+ event scheduled for 3 February. In a joint statement, Apple and Lionsgate said: "We are all heartbroken by the loss of Catherine O'Hara.

"An undeniable legend, icon, and incomparable talent, Catherine elevated every project she was a part of, including the singular genius she brought to her role on *The Studio*, and every transcendent performance she gifted to us."

Seth later accepted Cathe-

rine's award on her behalf at the SAG Awards.

He said: "I was asked to assume the honor of accepting this award on O'Hara's behalf.

"I know she would have been honored to receive this award from her fellow performers who I know she respected so much. She was such a big fan of all of yours."

## Zendaya hints that Euphoria will come to an end after season three

Zendaya has indicated that *Euphoria* will come to an end after the forthcoming third season.

The acclaimed HBO series will return to screens this weekend after a four-year hiatus and the 29-year-old actress, who portrays the troubled Rue Bennett in the series, has suggested that it will bring the show to its conclusion.

Quizzed on *The Drew Barrymore Show* if season three spells the end for *Euphoria*, Zendaya said: "I think yeah."

Barrymore asked the question again,

The Drama actress replied:

"Yes, I think so."

Zendaya added:

"Rue taught me so much about life... that crew has also seen me grow up. I owe so much to that show. Rue taught me much about empathy and about redemption. She taught me a lot, and I'm very grateful for all of it."

The eight-episode third series of *Euphoria* begins on Sunday (12.04.26), with the four-year delay partly caused by creator Sam Levinson's decision to jump the ensemble cast - which also includes Sydney Sweeney, Jacob Elordi and Maude Apatow - forward five years so they are out of high school and into adult life.

Zendaya previously described how filming season three of *Euphoria* felt like "trying to get eight episodes in at once" because of her packed schedule - as she has roles in movies *The Odyssey*, *Spider-Man: Brand New Day* and *Dune: Part Three* all still to come this year.

Asked what fans can expect from the new season, she told *Variety*: "I've seen a little bit, but gosh, it was a whirlwind.

"I did what I do in eight

months in like four months, so I was just like - it was like trying to get eight episodes in at once.

"It just flew by for me! But I'm excited, I hope it turns out beautifully."

Zendaya recently suggested that she is planning to "go into hiding" this year as she fears the public will get "sick" of seeing her because of the sheer number of projects she has coming out.

She told *Fandango*: "I just hope people don't get sick of me, and I really appreciate everyone who supports any of the movies [and] supports my career in any kind of way.

"I'm deeply appreciative.

"I just hope you guys don't get sick of me this year because I'll tell you what - I'm disappearing for a little bit."

## Dakota Johnson 'really likes' Role Model

Dakota Johnson and *Role Model* have been dating since "late last year".

The 36-year-old actress and *Role Model* were recently spotted kissing and holding hands in Los Angeles, and an insider has now revealed that it's "definitely more than a fling".

Despite this, Dakota is keen to progress things cautiously, following her split from Coldplay's Chris Martin in 2025.

Meanwhile, Dakota previously claimed she was "lucky" that she was allowed to discover her own sexuality.

The actress - who is the daughter of Don Johnson and Melanie Griffith - revealed that she feels fortunate to have grown up in such an open-minded household.

The *Fifty Shades of Grey* star told *Bustle*: "I was lucky that I grew up with a mom who was very open - at times maybe too open - about sexuality, but it was always like, whatever you're into and when you want to have sex, you just let me know and we'll get birth control.

"It was really healthy, and it made me feel like I was allowed to discover my sexuality on my own,

which I think is such a gift.

"We've progressed so much in some societies, for people to be allowed to say that they feel neither here nor there in terms of gender. That's an incredible thing. It's such a leap forward."

By contrast, Dakota acknowledged that other parts of the world aren't so forward-thinking.

The movie star - who lives in Malibu, California - added: "Then there's Alabama, and Texas, and the rest of the world that is in complete disarray."
