## Kate Winslet has 'regrets' over working with Woody Allen, Roman Polanski

Despite starring in iconic films and playing famous characters over several decades, Kate Winslet isn't pleased with all of the professional choices she's made. In an interview with Vanity Fair, the Oscar winner, 44, opened up about her time in front of the camera, including her collaborations with directors Woody Allen and Roman Polanski -- both of whom have been marred by accusations of sexual misconduct. The topic arose when Winslet said she hoped to do her "best when it comes to setting a decent example to younger women." "It's like, what was I doing working with Woody Allen and Roman Polanski?" she pointed out. "It's unbelievable to me now how those men were held in such high regard,

so widely in the film industry and for as long as they were. It's disgraceful." The "Titanic" star added that now, she must "take responsibility for the fact that I worked with them both." "I can't turn back the clock," she said. "I'm grappling with those regrets but what do we have if we aren't able to just be truthful about all of it?" The star appeared

in Polanski's "Carnage" in 2011 and in Allen's "Wonder Wheel," which debuted in 2017. Allen has been the subject of public scrutiny since beginning a relationship with Soon-Yi Previn, the adopted daughter of his former partner Mia Farrow. Per People magazine, he was also accused of sexual abuse against his adopted daughter Dylan Farrow in 1993. Dylan addressed the allegations for the first time in a 2014 letter published in the New York Times that she was "sexually assaulted" by the director. Allen has denied her allegations.

## Jolie donates to kids' lemonade stand

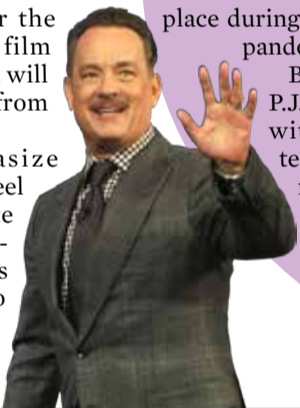
## Tom Hanks to restart shooting Elvis Presley's biopic 6 months after contracting coronavirus

Almost six months after contracting and recovering from coronavirus, actor Tom Hanks is all set to restart working in the untitled biopic of American musician Elvis Presley in Australia where he had contracted the virus. According to Variety, the director of the film Baz Luhrmann had confirmed that the produc-

tion for the film will restart and Hanks has already returned to Australia for the same. "We're back to, as Elvis liked to say, 'taking care of business!' It is a real privilege in this unprecedented global moment that Tom Hanks has been able to return to Australia to join Austin Butler and all of our extraordinary cast and crew to commence production on 'Elvis,'" Variety quoted Luhrmann as saying.

The production for the Warner Bros backed film which halted in March will begin in Queensland from September 23. "I cannot emphasize enough how lucky we feel in the current climate that the state of Queensland, and Queenslanders in general, have been so supportive of this film," said Luhrmann.

## Anne Hathaway in talks to join Doug Liman's 'Lockdown'

American actor Anne Hathaway is in talks to star in filmmaker Doug Liman's upcoming project 'Lockdown'. According to Variety, the forthcoming movie is a heist and romantic comedy taking place during the COVID-19 pandemic. Bankrolled by P.J. van Sandwijk with Alison Winter, the script of the movie is written by Steven Knight. Producers are aiming to begin

shooting by the end of September, reported Variety. However, more details of the movie and the other casting of the flick are yet to be officially announced. Hathaway, who won an Oscar for 'Les Miserables' in 2012, was recently seen in movies like 'Ocean's 8', 'Serenity', 'Dark Waters', and 'The Hustle'. The 37-year-old actor was also seen in Netflix's political thriller 'The Last Thing He Wanted'. Her upcoming project includes 'The Witches' by Robert Zemeckis, which is a remake for Warner Bros. The movie is set to be released in 2021.

## Lindsay Lohan is sued by HarperCollins for failing to write a book

Lindsay Lohan is reportedly being sued by publishing company HarperCollins for failing to write a book despite being paid a handsome advance to do so. HarperCollins claim that Lohan, 34, breached a contract that she signed with them in March 2014, with a promise to turn in the title - rumoured to be a tell-all biography - by May 2015, which never materialized. In legal documents filed by the publishing house, they claim Lohan was given a revised date

of March 2017 to get it finished, and that they even paid her an advance of \$365k against future royalties, TMZ reports. DailyMail.com has reached out to representatives for the Mean Girls star, who has so far been unavailable for comment. Legal documents obtained by the site reportedly say that HarperCollins told Lohan the deal was off in September of 2018, and asked for their money back. However, Lohan allegedly never returned the funds she received. The Parent Trap star is being sued for the \$365k ad-

vance, as well as interest and legal charges. In 2014, it was reported that Lohan was set to sign a staggering \$1 million deal to write her memoir for HarperCollins. The news came after Lohan spent time in rehab 2013, and reportedly kept a much-discussed diary, where she allegedly wrote a list of the

famous men she had slept with. 'It's more or less an autobiography, but she had a minimal number of sample pages,' a source told PageSix at the time. In 2014, during an appearance on - where else - but Andy Cohen's Watch What Happens Live, Lohan spoke about her list of lovers, which must have clearly caught the attention of the publishing industry.
