Bahrain Grand Prix set to kick off 2021 Formula One season

The opening round of the 2021 FIA Formula 1 World Championship will be taking place in Bahrain, following the release yesterday of a revised 23-race calendar.

F1 announced that the new season is set to kick off in Sakhir. The dates remain unchanged as the motor-sport spectacle takes Bahrain International Circuit (BIC) by storm from March 26 to 28.

The traditional first round in Australian has been postponed to later in the year due to the current situation regarding COVID-19. The move is part of a series of changes made by F1 that were confirmed yesterday.

This year's race will mark the third time Bahrain hosts the F1 season-opener. BIC also previously held the championship's first round in 2006 and 2010.

Key members of the House Judiciary Committee introduced a single article of impeachment on Monday that has already gathered at least 218 cosponsors, according to a congressional aide

involved in the process, meeting the majority needed for passage in the House.

It'll be precisely one week from the day that a pro-Trump mob stormed the Capitol and sent lawmakers scrambling for cover, while Capitol Police struggled to hold off the violent crowd.

Five people, including a Capitol Police officer, died as a result of the riots. The episode sent Democrats into a furious rush to punish Trump for what they've described as "willful incitement of insurrection."

"Because the timeframe is so short and the need is so immediate and an emergency, we will also proceed on a parallel path in terms of impeachment,"

Majority Leader Steny Hoyer (D-Md.) told reporters. "Whether impeachment can pass the United States Senate is not the issue."

The impeachment effort itself will dominate the final week of Trump's presidency, and is almost certain to come to a historic result: the first time in history a president has been impeached twice.

After the House vote, the articles are expected to move immediately to the Senate, where Majority Leader Mitch McConnell has indicated a trial — presided over by Supreme Court Chief Justice John Roberts — likely won't start until the upper chamber returns on Jan. 19.

Iran set to execute second wrestler amid outcry

London

The Iranian regime is set to execute a second wrestler just months after it hanged champion athlete Navid Afkari amid international pleas for clemency.

Mehdi Ali Hosseini, 29, was arrested in 2015 and charged with murder following a group brawl.

Britain's Daily Mail newspaper reported that he is expected to be imminently executed because the victim's family refused to pardon him.

Ali Safavi, an official from the foreign affairs committee of the Paris-based National Council of Resistance of Iran, said the NCRI and other regime critics "strongly condemn the ruling religious dictatorship


for its intention to execute" Hosseini.

"The NCRI is opposed to capital punishment as a matter of principle. As evident in the past four decades, the clerical regime uses executions — political and otherwise — as a means to instil an atmosphere of terror and intimidation in society to thwart the eruption of uprisings by an increasingly enraged

and discontented population, which seeks regime change," Safavi said.

"These executions are carried out in blatant breach of internationally recognised standards, including due process."

Fellow Iranian wrestler and London 2012 Olympic champion Hamid Sourian has called for Hosseini's execution to be cancelled.

● **American Trade Zone established in the Kingdom**

The Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Tourism yesterday signed a memorandum of understanding, establishing the American Trade Zone in the Kingdom of Bahrain.


Minister Zayed bin Rashid Al Zayani sealed the deal yesterday morning with US Secretary for Trade Wilbur Ross.

"The availability of economic opportunities in our region is an ideal opportunity for American companies to invest and expand their business by establishing in the Kingdom of Bahrain," said Al Zayani.

He said that the deal would usher in wider horizons for strengthening the joint trade

relations in accordance with the advantages of the Free Trade Agreement binding Bahrain and the US.

Ross stressed the importance of Bahrain as a strategic and commercial partner of the US, adding that the platform would maintain the stability and ensure the progress of the American trade in the Gulf region.

"The signing of this memorandum comes to reinforce this common commitment and the close relationship between the

two countries," he added, affirming the commitment of the Department of International Trade at the US Department of Commerce, to work with Bahrain to achieve the American Trade Zone.

The establishment of the American Trade Zone in the Kingdom is expected to contribute to enhancing economic, commercial and industrial cooperation and pushing the bilateral trade between the two countries to further horizons.

The two countries will promote the American Trade Zone as a regional centre for trade, manufacturing, logistics and distribution among American companies in the Kingdom, the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) markets and beyond.

The American Trade Zone in Bahrain will allow US companies to operate in an area equipped for goods exchange activities and comprehensive logistical solutions, in addition to facilitating export operations through Khalifa Bin Salman Port, Bahrain International Airport and King Fahd Causeway or through any other ports to be established in the future in the Kingdom via specialised customs solutions.

The signing of the agreement will further reinforce the long-standing partnership between the US and Bahrain, which have a long history of solid economic and security cooperation.

'From one year to three years'

MPs pass bill setting 'precondition' before foreign worker can transfer to another employer

● **MPs Kamal and Hashem say it contradicts international laws and returns to sponsorship system**

The House of Representatives has passed a bill that aims to increase the period set for a foreign worker to spend with an employer, from one year to three years, as a precondition for the right to move to another employer.

MP Dr Sawsan Kamal expressed her rejection on the proposal, saying: "The extension of the period of compulsion is a step backwards and a

violation of human rights represented in the free movement of the worker. It is a clear return to the sponsorship system that we have gone beyond by looking at the worker's rights and not violating them."

The bill aims to amend Paragraph (a) of Article (25) of Law No. (19) of 2006 regarding the regulation of the labour market and its amendments, and the corrective measures for the residency of tens of thousands of workers.

Dr Kamal said it was inconsistent with the International Convention for the Protection of the Rights of All Migrant Workers and Members of Their Families, as well as the principles of the International Labor Organization.

"These international conven-

tions and principles do not allow restricting the freedom of the worker to move from one job to another," said Dr Kamal said.

"We are proud in the Kingdom of Bahrain that we are the first Gulf country to abolish the

sponsorship system by issuing Law No. 19 of 2006. Some of the Gulf Cooperation Council countries followed us."

Deputy MP Falah Hashem confirmed that the work permit for the worker is two years while the proposal exceeds the first work contract.

This proposal contradicts international agreements signed by Bahrain, Deputy MP Hashem said, indicating that it will again open the door for the implementation of the sponsorship system.

One of the sponsors of the proposal, MP Mamdouh Al Saleh, said that it would secure practical stability for employers and the survival of their workers, pointing out that international organisations close their eyes to European countries and are biased against the Gulf states.

"This law will also protect the rights of the Bahraini employers," he said.

Three doctors found guilty over premature twins death

Convicted of 'manslaughter and negligence' but secure temporary freedom after posting BD1,000 bail each

The three doctors being linked to the death of new-born twins Fatima and Zahra have been found guilty of manslaughter and negligence.

One of them, a Bahraini male doctor, was slapped with a three-year jail sentence, while the two female doctors, Bahraini and Indian, got 12 months imprisonment.

They, however, secured temporary freedom after posting BD1,000 bail each pending the outcome of their appeals.

A nurse was acquitted due to insufficient evidence against the defendant.

An investigation was carried out after the Bahraini father had claimed that he was handed over his dead premature babies by Salmaniya Medical Complex (SMC) "in bags", only to find out that they were still alive at the time of their burial in Bilad Al Qadeem graveyard in the Capital Governorate.

A document he shared online showed that the shocking incident took place on October 16 last year, a day after the delivery. A report from the hospital read that the man brought back the babies on the same day he received them.

The report mentioned that one of the babies was dead when the father came back to the hospital, while the other one died at the neonatal intensive care unit few hours later.

Issued by the Chief of Medical Services at SMC, the report read: "The patient came to SMC on October 15, 2020 at 8:00 pm, and she was in a state of abortion at 22 weeks of pregnancy,

and the result was two new-borns. After examining them by the medical staff, they found at the time that there were no signs that they were alive and they were handed over to the father on October 16, 2020 at 9:30 a.m."

The report also mentioned: "On the same day, the father brought the new-borns to SMC, and after examining them by the medical staff, it was found that one of them was dead and the other was making a crying sound. The new-born was admitted to the neonatal intensive care unit for premature infants, but the she passed away on the same day at 9:30 pm."

Swift action

A press statement was soon issued by the Health Ministry, quoting Government Hospitals Acting CEO Dr Ahmed Al Ansari, who affirmed that an investigative committee was immedi-

ately formed after being notified about the incident.

"A special investigation committee was formed under the chairmanship of Chief of Medical Services at SMC Dr Nabeel Al Asheeri, in accordance with the Civil Service Law. A doctor was suspended from working

at SMC until the completion of the investigation committee's work," Dr Al Ansari confirmed.

The official emphasised that the necessary legal measures will be taken against whoever is found to be in default according to the results of the investigation committee, adding that the investigation is being carried out in cooperation with the Health Ministry and the National Health Regulatory Authority (NHRA), under direct supervision of the Supreme Council of Health.

Dr Al Ansari added: "Providing distinguished services to the visitors of SMC and all government hospitals and maintaining the health and safety of everyone is a permanent priority.

"It is not possible to be lenient or hesitant in taking what is required against those who fail to perform the tasks entrusted to them, in accordance with the approved medical procedures and standards."

Bahrain Olympic Committee (BOC) has called on the international sports community and the International Olympic Committee (IOC) to take a decisive and supportive stance over Bahraini world bodybuilding champion Sami Ibrahim Al Haddad's detention in Qatar.

BOC called for the immediate release of Al Haddad and his companions. They were arrested by the Qatari authorities on January 8 while on a fishing trip on Bahrain territorial waters.

BOC described the arrest as

a flagrant violation of international laws and covenants.

BOC sent an official address to IOC president Thomas Bach demanding the international sport community and IOC to take a supportive stance to release the Bahraini athlete out of belief that sport is a message of love and peace between people and a way to achieve the noble Olympic values of friendship, respect and tolerance between all countries.

Asian man awaits trial in labour camp murder case

● The suspect confessed to committing the crime due to personal disagreement with the victim

The Public Prosecution has ordered to remand a 37-year-old Asian man who is accused of stabbing to death a fellowman, 33, at a labour camp in Salmabad in the Northern Governorate last week.

Northern Governorate Chief Prosecutor Abdulrahman Al Mannai affirmed that the suspect has been detained pending further investigations in order to refer the case to the concerned criminal court.

The Chief Prosecutor said the case was initially reported by Al Khamis Police Station before the prosecution imme-

diately launched its investigations into the incident.

"The Public Prosecution began its investigations and moved to the crime scene upon receiving the report. The victim's body and the location of the incident were examined, and then the coroner was assigned to conduct a forensic medical examination," said Al Mannai.

He also confirmed that according to witnesses, the suspect confessed to interrogators that he committed the crime due to personal disagreement with the victim. No further information on both men's nationalities were disclosed.



Another zero COVID-19 deaths; 316 new cases and 275 additional recoveries

There were zero deaths from the coronavirus (COVID-19) in Bahrain for the second consecutive day yesterday, while 316 new cases and 275 additional recoveries were reported.

The death toll stands at 356, while there is a total of 92,920 survivors from the respiratory ailment.

Following 10,911 tests, fresh infections included 126 expatriate workers and 171 from contacts of active cases, while 19 were travel-related.

A total of 48 are receiving treatment with 20 critical and 2,899 in stable condition.

The total tests done in Bahrain increased to 2,497,331.




Sand storm leaves significant risk factor for human health

University of Bahrain’s Sustainable Operations Technology Professor Dr Majeed Safar Jassim has called for more regional cooperation to promote green development in the region, reduce aerosols and improve air quality.

A study prepared by Dr Jassim, in cooperation with Environmental Engineering Associate Professor Dr Glnur Joshknur, has found out that about 74% of the classification of aerosols is dust.

The study, which employed



comprehensive monitoring maps, showed that the deserts surrounding the region are sources of dust.

The research, which estimates the spatial and temporal variability of the optical depth of aerosols and demonstrates their quality specifications for the years 2008-2019, used the NASA Global Modeling Method (MERRA-2).

The research was published in the International Journal of Environmental Science and Technology, a publication of Springer, and its articles are included in the Science Citation Index Expanded and SCOPUS.

The research was carried out by two students, Muhammad Zaid and Omar Malik, at the bachelor’s degree in the Department of Chemical Engineering.

Dr Jassim, who heads the chemical engineering department at the university, said: “Air pollution is a global threat as it

affects climate change, vision and human health. Therefore, the use of scientific research in the field of air quality is important for the Kingdom of Bahrain because it is located in a geographical area known for its desertification and harsh climate.”

He pointed out that fine particles are one of the main pollutants of air as their increased concentration causes environmental challenges to many major cities

in the world. As for aerosols, they are solid or liquid particles suspended in the air, indicating that through remote sensing, it can re-analyse pollutants in the atmosphere after they were developed by climate and environmental scientists in the Global Office for Modeling and Data Representation (GMAO) of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA).

He stated that this study analysed its information obtained temporarily and spatially from these satellites for a geographical area that includes the Kingdom of Bahrain, and the physical optical depth property (AOT) was used for the first time in Bahrain, which is a measure of how dust particles block sunlight.

He said that the technology is using satellites to analyse air quality monthly and annually in

the period 2008-2019. The researchers were able to classify aerosols into types: dust, sea salt, organic carbon, black carbon, and sulphates, and thus the quality of air originating naturally or from other sources was determined by analysing a chemical simulation rooted in the retrospective analysis of the special modern era.

Time plan to develop Salmaniya pharmacy services

The Ministry of Health has set a time plan to ensure the continuity of quality and safe health care services at the Salmaniya Medical Hospital Pharmacy.

This plan was launched at an earlier time and is subject to evaluation and monitoring

to ensure its progress with the start of the new programmes and projects of Salmaniya Medical Complex.

The services development project will be implemented in the first plan in a reception office to classify patients according to the type of service for dispensing prescriptions and

home delivery of medicines.

The second plan will depend on several things, including a co-operation mechanism between government hospitals and health centers; a list of available and most needed medicines; reports to estimate the quantity of medicines that are required for each centre; longer working hours

with weekends for some clinics; modern security devices for drug safety; and an alarm system and surveillance cameras.

It also includes special storage equipment; security system at pharmacy entry gates; and electronic registration system for narcotic drugs for some neuropsychiatric diseases.

Google launches \$3 million fund to fight vaccine misinformation

The Google News Initiative yesterday launched a global open fund to fight misinformation about COVID-19 vaccines, worth up to \$3 million.

The "COVID-19 Vaccine Counter Misinformation Open Fund" aims to support journalistic efforts to effectively fact-check misinformation about the COVID-19 immunisation process, the initiative belonging to Alphabet's Google said in a blog post.

"While the COVID-19 infodemic has been global in nature, misinformation has also been used to target specific populations," it added.

"Some of the available research also suggests that the audiences coming across misinformation and those seeking fact checks don't necessarily overlap."

The fund will accept pro-



jects looking to expand the audience of fact-checks, particularly to groups disproportionately hit by misinformation.

Applications will be reviewed by team of 14 jurors from across the academic, media, medical and non-profit sectors, as well as representatives from the World Health Organisation.

In December, the Google News Initiative pledged \$1.5 million to fund a COVID-19 vaccine media hub to support fact-checking research.

Volkswagen brand 2020 sales drop but recovery seen in December

German carmaker Volkswagen said yesterday that sales of its core brand dropped by 15 per cent to 5.3 million vehicles in 2020 as the outbreak of coronavirus and lockdowns imposed to restrict infections hit car dealerships around the world.

Volkswagen said it had seen sales recovering in December compared to previous months, rising by 19.5pc in western Europe and 14.7pc in North America. It added that demand for its electric models jumped by 158% on the year, to 212,000 vehicles.

"We are well on the way to achieving our goal of becoming



the market leader in battery electric vehicles," VW brand CEO Ralf Brandstatter said in a statement.

For the year as a whole, Volkswagen brand sales fell by 23.4pc in western Europe and by 17.1pc in North America, while the smallest drop was in China, at 9.9pc.

Oil hits 11-month high, just below \$57

Saudi plans to cut output to stop inventories from building up

Oil hit an 11-month high just below \$57 a barrel yesterday as tighter supply and expectations of a drop in US inventories offset concerns over rising coronavirus cases globally.

Saudi Arabia plans to cut output by an extra 1 million barrels per day (bpd) in February and March to stop inventories from building up. The latest US supply reports are expected to show crude stocks fell for a fifth straight week.

Brent crude was 79 cents, or 1.4 per cent, higher at \$56.45 a barrel by 1304 GMT and earlier hit \$56.75, the highest since last February. US West Texas Intermediate (WTI) gained 89 cents, or 1.7pc, to \$53.14.

"Saudi Arabia in particular is ensuring through its additional voluntary production cuts that the market is undersupplied if anything," said Eugen Weinberg of Commerzbank.

The Saudi cut is part of an OPEC-led deal in which most producers will hold output steady in February. Record cuts by OPEC and its allies in 2020 helped oil recover from historic lows in April. Some analysts see further gains as likely.

GM to launch BrightDrop electric delivery vehicle business

General Motors Co staked its claim in the growing electric delivery vehicle business yesterday, with Chief Executive Mary Barra outlining plans for its first BrightDrop commercial vans to be delivered to FedEx by year-end.

The move will put GM squarely in competition in the commercial sector with crosstown rival Ford Motor Co as well as startups such as Rivian, Arrival and Canoo that are developing electric commercial vehicles for customers from Amazon to Hyundai Motor.

Fueled in part by the COVID-19 pandemic, GM estimates the US market for parcel and food delivery will climb to more than \$850 billion by 2025. And it is one sector that EV sales leader Tesla has yet to crack.

Barra said BrightDrop will offer delivery and logistics customers such as FedEx a range of products and services that leverage the automaker's expertise in electrification and fleet management.

The BrightDrop EV600 will use a version of GM's Ultium battery system that will power many of the company's future electric vehicles, including the Hummer EV pickup and the Cadillac Lyriq crossover.

Twitter suspends 70,000 accounts linked to pro-Trump QAnon conspiracy ♦ Twitter announced it has suspended "more than 70,000 accounts" linked to the QAnon conspiracy theory following the attack on the US Capitol by a mob of President Donald Trump's supporters. The social network began its purge Friday, shortly after it had permanently suspended Trump's account for language that could incite violence. "Since Friday, more than 70,000 accounts have been suspended as a result of our efforts, with many instances of a single individual operating numerous accounts," Twitter said in a blog post.

Donald Trump and his deputy Mike Pence met in the Oval Office, a senior official said, signaling a common front as Democrats press the vice president to have the president removed from office as unfit. ♦ The two had a good conversation, the administration official said of the meeting, their first since last week's assault on the US Capitol. According to the official, Trump has no intention of resigning his office before his term comes to an end on January 20.

Pentagon presses ahead with Afghanistan troop drawdown despite law barring it ♦ The US military has not halted a US troop withdrawal from Afghanistan, the Department of Defense said, despite a new law prohibiting further reductions without the Pentagon sending Congress an assessment of the risks. "Currently, no new orders have been issued which impact the progression of the conditions-based drawdown expected to reach 2,500 (troops) by Jan. 15, 2021," it said in a statement.

The Trump administration announced it was returning Cuba to the US list of state sponsors of terrorism, a move that could complicate any efforts by the incoming Biden administration to revive Obama-era detente with Havana. Just days before Republican President Donald Trump leaves office, Secretary of State Mike Pompeo said Cuba was being listed for "repeatedly providing support for acts of international terrorism" by harboring US fugitives and Colombian rebel leaders.

Gold mine explosion in China traps 22 workers underground ♦ Chinese authorities have dispatched rescue workers to a gold mine in the country's northeast after 22 workers were trapped underground following an explosion, Xinhua news agency reported. The accident happened at 2 p.m. local time on Sunday in Xicheng Township, located in eastern Shandong province. Rescue workers have so far been unable to contact the trapped miners because the blast damaged the communication signal system, the report said.

Indonesia retrieves crashed plane's flight data recorder

Flight data recorder could explain why the aircraft nosedived into the sea after takeoff

Indonesia continues search for debris of Sriwijaya Air flight SJ 182

Indonesian divers yesterday retrieved from the sea bed the flight data recorder (FDR) of a Sriwijaya Air plane that crashed into the Java Sea with 62 people on board at the weekend, officials said.

Divers had also found a separate radio beacon, raising hopes that the cockpit voice recorder (CVR) it was connected to could soon be found and reveal what caused the plane to lose control moments after takeoff.

"We are sure that, because the beacon that was attached to the cockpit voice recorder was also found around the area, so with high confidence, the cockpit voice recorder will soon be found," military chief Hadi Tjahjanto said at a news conference.

With few immediate clues on what happened after takeoff, in-

vestigators will rely heavily on the flight recorders to determine what went wrong.

The Boeing 737-500 plane plunged into the sea on Saturday, four minutes after it departed from Jakarta's main airport and disappeared off radar screens.

It was the second major air crash in Indonesia since 189 people were killed in 2018 when a Lion Air Boeing 737 MAX plunged into the Java Sea soon after taking off from Jakarta. The jet that

crashed on Saturday was of a largely different design.

The National Transportation Safety Committee (KNKT) expects to download the FDR data within two to five days, its chief Soerjanto Tjahjono said.

"Hopefully we will be able to unveil the mystery of what caused this accident ... so this becomes a lesson for all of us to avoid this in the future," Soerjanto said.

site, as well as personal effects, such as wallets containing identification cards.

The plane had been headed to Pontianak on Borneo island, about 740 km (460 miles) from Jakarta.

The KNKT's initial findings showed the plane's engine was running when it hit the water, based on jet parts retrieved from the sea.

"The damage on the fan blade showed that the engine was still working on impact. This is consistent with the hypothesis that the plane's system was still working at 250 feet altitude," Soerjanto said.

Afghan president expresses grief over civilian deaths in airstrike

Afghan President Ashraf Ghani expressed grief over the deaths of civilians in an airstrike by the country's military, a move that came a day after government officials said only Taliban fighters had been killed.

Locals in the southern province

of Nimroz on Sunday said the airstrike by the Afghan air force had resulted in the deaths of 14 civilians, but government officials denied the claim. Residents later brought the bodies of the deceased to the provincial capital in protest.

In a statement, Ghani said he was "deeply saddened" over the civilian casualties from the air-

strike in the Khashrod district of Nimroz province.

He said he had instructed authorities to reach out to the families of the victims.

Residents of the affected area, angered by the Nimroz governor's statement that those killed were Taliban fighters, said they would launch protests if the official did not apologise.

Fire kills eight in Russian apartment block

A fire in an apartment block killed eight people in the Russian Urals city of Yekaterinburg, the local branch of Russia's Investigative Committee said.

Investigators from the Sverdlovsk region said a child was among those killed and that a criminal case had been opened to determine the cause of the fire and establish measures that could prevent a similar incident in the future.

The fire was reported at 2:58 a.m. local time (2158 GMT on Monday) and contained by firefighters before being extinguished a little over an hour later, the regional emergency services ministry said.

"In conditions of heavy smoke, the gas and smoke protection service organised the evacuation and rescue of residents through a burning doorway," the ministry said.

Investigation into who etched 'Trump' on manatee's back

Wildlife authorities in Florida appealed for help in identifying who was responsible for scratching the name "Trump" on to the hide of a manatee.

The appeal by the Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS) came after the Citrus County Chronicle published video that clearly showed the name of the US president etched on to the back of one of the large, slow-moving marine mammals.

Pompeo says Al Qaeda has new home base in Iran

Pompeo confirms Al-Qaeda's second-in-command was killed last year in Tehran

● Mike Pompeo announced sanctions on several individuals and a \$7 million reward for information on an Al-Qaeda member

US Secretary of State Mike Pompeo alleged yesterday that arch-enemy Iran has become a new "home base" for Al-Qaeda worse than Afghanistan, an assertion questioned by experts.

In a speech a week before leaving office, Pompeo confirmed a New York Times report that Al-Qaeda's second-in-command was killed last year in Tehran, although he did not say that Israel carried it out.

"Al-Qaeda has a new home base. It is the Islamic Republic of Iran," Pompeo said in a speech at the National Press Club.

"I would say Iran is indeed the new Afghanistan -- as the key geographic hub for Al-Qaeda -- but it's actually worse.

"Unlike in Afghanistan, when Al-Qaeda was hiding in the mountains, Al-Qaeda today is operating under the hard shell of the Iranian regime's protection."

He urged more international pressure, calling the alleged alliance a "massive force for evil all over the world."

President Donald Trump's hawkish top diplomat stopped short of urging military action, saying: "If we did have that option, if we chose to do that, there's a much greater risk in executing it."

But he announced sanctions on several individuals and a \$7 million reward for information on an Al-Qaeda member he said was believed to be in Iran identified both as Muhammad Abbatay or Abd al-Rahman al-Maghrebi.

Iran, a Shiite clerical state, is ideologically opposed both to

Al-Qaeda and the Islamic State group, extreme Sunni movements that are predominantly Arab, and has fought on fronts abroad against both.

Many experts believe that Tehran has allowed Al-Qaeda operatives to use its territory -- comparatively safe from the US military -- to provide guarantees that the extremists will not target Iran.

Pompeo acknowledged that late Al-Qaeda founder Osama bin Laden himself "considered Al-Qaeda members inside the Islamic Republic of Iran to be hostages" and that there was no evidence Iran backed the September 11, 2001 attacks, mostly carried out by Saudi nationals. But Pompeo, a former CIA

chief, said that Iran in recent years has permitted Al-Qaeda greater freedom of movement including issuing travel documents, and that the group has "centralized leadership" in Tehran.

"Tehran has allowed Al-Qaeda to fund-raise, to freely communicate with other Al-Qaeda members around the world and perform many other functions that were previously directed from Afghanistan and Pakistan," Pompeo said.

Pompeo has championed a hard line on Iran including sweeping sanctions that have ravaged its economy.

Trump says 'tremendous anger' in nation over impeachment

With the House set to impeach, President Donald Trump is blaming Democratic congressional foes for "tremendous anger" in the country and last week's deadly attack on the Capitol by his supporters after he urged them on their way.

The embattled president, in his first remarks to reporters since last week's attack, took no responsibility yesterday for the deadly mob invasion of the building but also said he wanted "no violence."

Trump defended his fiery rally remarks to a protest crowd last week as "totally appropriate," and he showed no remorse for the following attack, the most serious and deadly domestic incursion at the Capitol in the nation's history.

On impeachment, Trump said it's "a really terrible thing that they're doing."

"To continue on this path, I think it's causing tremendous danger to our country, and it's causing tremendous anger," he said. "I want no violence."

The president spoke as he left for Texas to survey the border wall with Mexico. He took no questions.

Impeachment ahead, the House will first try to convince the vice president and Cabinet to act even more quickly to remove Trump from office, warning he is a threat to democracy in the remaining days of his presidency.

Afghan forces foil plan to assassinate top US envoy

Afghan authorities said yesterday they had foiled a plan by the jihadist Islamic State group to assassinate the top US envoy in Kabul, as a wave of targeted killings continue to rock the country.

Intelligence officers dismantled a four-member IS cell in

the eastern province of Nangarhar that had planned to murder Ross Wilson as well as Afghan officials, the National Directorate of Security said.

Wilson, the US Charge d'Affaires in Kabul, has steadfastly condemned a series of assassinations in the capital and other cities of prominent Afghans including journalists, activists and politicians in recent months.

"The main assassin and facilitator of the cell, Abdul Wahed, had planned to assassinate the US ambassador in Afghanistan as well as some high ranking Afghan officials," the NDS said in a statement.

"Their plan was foiled with their arrest."

Israel's Netanyahu removes Trump from his Twitter banner photo

Israeli Prime Benjamin Netanyahu dropped US President Donald Trump from the banner photo of his Twitter account yesterday in an apparent break with a political ally facing possible impeachment.

A photo of Netanyahu sitting next to Trump at a White House meeting had long taken pride of place on the official @netanyahu account, testimony to the conservative Israeli leader's close ties with the Republican president and his popularity in Israel.

Early yesterday, another photo, showing Netanyahu being injected with the coronavirus vaccine, topped the page, along with the slogan for Israel's inoculation campaign: "Citizens of Israel, we are returning to life".

Netanyahu had kept the photo of his meeting with Trump, long in lockstep with him over a tough policy towards Iran and the Palestinians, on the site even after the Republican president's defeat by Democrat Joe Biden in the US election in

November.

The photo was briefly replaced with a Hanukkah holiday-themed image last month, raising media speculation that Netanyahu had decided to distance himself from Trump.

But when the eight-day Jewish festival was over, Trump reappeared - although no longer alone with Netanyahu in a photo.

Instead, Netanyahu posted a banner image of himself with the president and the foreign

No explanation was given on Netanyahu's site for Trump's disappearance, a day before the U.S. House of Representatives was expected to begin considering his second impeachment on after last week's storming of the Capitol.

Trump's own account was permanently suspended by Twitter on Friday due to what the social media giant described as the risk of further incitement to violence.

In televised remarks on Thursday, Netanyahu called the events at the Capitol a "rampage" and said he was certain American democracy would prevail.

The "Borat" star took to Twitter on Monday to call for the prompt banishment of Trump's YouTube account.

"Virtually every social media company has removed Trump...EXCEPT YouTube," the 49-year-old performer wrote. "Trump's YouTube channel is STILL showing videos of his election lies to MILLIONS of people!"

In his plea to the masses, Cohen tagged YouTube CEO Susan Wojcicki as well as Google CEO Sundar Pichai and urged the close-working pair to "do the right thing" by canceling Trump's channel "to save democracy."

Google and YouTube both fall under parent company, Alphabet.

While it remains unclear if Cohen's decree will fall on deaf ears, in the early hours of Monday, Trump's YouTube channel had 2.73 million subscribers, *Newsweek* reported. As of the time of this article's publishing, the president's account appears to have jumped slightly to 2.74 million.

"Facebook just banned Trump!" Cohen exuded in a tweet at the time. "Retweet and tell @Twitter and @jack--Suspending Trump for a FEW HOURS for inciting a violent attack on the U.S. Capitol is NOT ENOUGH. Stop letting Trump use Twitter to incite violence and undermine democracy!"





Stage nine of the Dakar Rally took competitors around a looped stage, leaving and returning to Neom; 579km in total, with 114km of road and 465km of special stage driving. Bahrain Raid Xtreme driver, Nani Roma, was reunited with his support team after two days of the marathon stage, with no overnight assistance. Roma began the day's stage on the shores of the Red Sea, tracking the coast for a stage of mixed driving conditions; sandy coastline followed by rocky terrain.

The two-time Dakar Rally winner experienced almost no problems throughout the lengthy stage, paying testament to the Hunter's competitiveness, returning the BRX T1 car to the bivouac in an almost immaculate condition, despite a long and testing day of driving.

Roma continued his consistent run of form through stage nine, finishing in 10th with a stage time of 05:12:06, +21:39 behind the leader. This result means Roma maintains his po-

sition in 5th overall, +2:42:38 behind the leader, reducing the gap to fourth place by 16 minutes and is now just 26 minutes behind Jakob Przygonski.

Commenting after arriving back at the bivouac in Neom, Bahrain Raid Xtreme driver, Nani Roma said: "At the beginning of the stage it was very beautiful, right next to the sea. Then we went into the rocky areas, which I didn't like very much. It was a really long stage, but we did well. Alex did a good job on navigation and I tried to be as focused as possible. The car was fantastic, and we are looking forward to tomorrow. We will go out and try not to make any mistakes and see how we do - catching fourth is defi-

nately possible."

Speaking from Neom after his forced withdrawal from the Dakar Rally following yesterday's marathon stage, Bahrain Raid Xtreme driver, Sebastien Loeb said: "This isn't the result we were expecting. When we arrived here in Saudi, we wanted to secure a top position. In the end it was a bit complicated, but we know that Dakar is a tough race. Overall, I think we had a good performance; the Hunter showed good pace and reliability. We had two main problems that made us lose a lot of time - they are not big problems and will be easy to solve ahead of our next races. I am not worried about that. I am sorry that we have had to stop the rally early,

We redoubled our efforts on Nani's car last night, doing a bigger service than we would usually do on a standard evening to ensure we had a trouble-free day today, which we did. The competitiveness of the Hunter is clear, and we will be keeping our focus on the cars in front for the rest of the stages. We are using each stage as a learning for 2022 where we'll be going after the win, rather than protecting our position, as we've had to do this year."

Sultan shaping up for possible US fight in US

Whether or not it's a world title bout, it doesn't matter at all for Filipino one-time world title challenger Jonas Sultan.

What is important for him is to get the opportunity to fight in the United States this year. That is what he is praying hard and hoping for.

"I hope to fight this year to give national pride," said the super flyweight fighter who is currently in Los Angeles, California undergoing training.

The 29-year-old slugger is keeping himself in top shape and ready for action as soon as he gets the call.

"I'm always ready. At anytime I'll be given a fight this year," said Sultan, who is best remembered for beating World Boxing Organization bantamweight champion Johnriel Casimero in an IBF 115-pound title eliminator in 2017.

Sultan was brought to the US by former conqueror and reigning International Boxing Federation (IBF) super flyweight titleholder Jerwin Ancajas and trainer manager Joven Jimenez in October last year to serve as their sparring partner and training buddy.

Sultan, 16-5 with 10 knockouts, is grateful for having given that opportunity.

"It's been going well. I am really happy that I'm helping them improve their skills and at the same time they also help me develop my footwork, timing, balancing, power and speed," said Sultan, who also sparred

with Tokyo Olympics-bound middleweight fighter Eumir Felix Marcial.

"I have also learned a lot with coach Joven. I learned good defensive stance particularly after counter-punching without losing my balance, and improved my footwork," he added.

Two years ago in Fresno, California, Sultan fought Ancajas and lost via unanimous decision in an all-Filipino battle for the world title. Before that, he beat current WBO bantamweight champion Johnriel Casimero three years ago in a world title

eliminator in Cebu.

Sultan, Ancajas and Marcial - along with Jimenez - are in the US honing their boxing skills under the care of MP Promotions President Sean Gibbons.

Sultan has enumerated his wish list composed of former world champion Roman Gonzalez, reigning World Boxing Association super flyweight champion Joshua Franco and World Boxing Organization (WBO) super flyweight titlist Kazuto Ioka.

But even if it's not a world title bout, the Zamboanga del Norte-born Sultan said he is willing and ready to fight any one of them in the US.

Sultan has dropped out of the world rankings but he believes that he'll be back for another run at a title especially now that he has been training with one of the best super flyweights in the world in Ancajas.

The region's premier drag racing series returns to Bahrain International Circuit (BIC) this week for another exciting season of intense head-to-head battles.

The 2021 Bahrain Drag Racing Championship kicked off with the first of five rounds yesterday evening and will continue until Friday at "The Home of Motorsport in the Middle East".

Many leading drag racers and their crews from Bahrain and across the Gulf are in the fray, all of whom will be competing for victories, championship points and all-important bragging rights.

The season is set to feature racing in 13 categories for both cars and motorbikes.

The first round begins with two days of Test and Tune Tuesday and Wednesday from 7pm to 12midnight. Qualifying will then be held on Thursday from 4pm onwards, setting the brackets for Race Day on Friday.

The 2021 season of the Bahrain Drag Racing Championship continues until April. Following this week's opener, round two is set to take place from February 9 to 12, followed by round three from February 23 to 26.

The fourth and penultimate meeting will then take place between March 9 and 12, which leads up to the championship-finale from April 13 to 16.

The 2021 champions will then be honoured at the end-of-season awards ceremony, slated for April 17.

The new campaign is being organised and run by BIC, the Bahrain Motor Federation and the Bahrain Drag Racing Club.

Bahrain will host the opening round of the 2021 FIA Formula 1 World Championship following the release yesterday of a revised 23-race calendar.

F1 announced that the new season is set to kick off in Sakhir on its original dates from March 26 to 28.

The traditional first round in Australia has been postponed to later in the year due to the current situation regarding COVID-19. F1 racing is therefore set to start one week later than earlier planned.

The move is part of a series of changes made by F1 and confirmed yesterday.

Whilst the dates for the Bahrain race remain as previously announced, the changes mean that this year will mark the third time the F1 season will be starting at BIC. The championship-opener was also previously held in Sakhir in 2006 and 2010.

BIC Chief Executive Shaikh Salman bin Isa Al Khalifa commented: "We thank F1 for trusting us with hosting the 2021 season-opener under the revised schedule. It is an honour to

be kicking off the new season and we look forward to welcoming back the F1 family to Bahrain.

"We are also pleased to see Australia on the calendar later in the year and wish them and everyone else in F1 the very best as we prepare for the new season."

More details on the 2021 Formula 1 Gulf Air Bahrain Grand Prix will be announced soon.

The Melbourne race has been rescheduled and will now take place November 18 to 21 following an agreement between F1 and Australian authorities.

Other revisions to the calendar include: the Chinese Grand Prix not taking place on its planned date, with a possible rescheduling of the race later in the season; the addition of Imola on April 18; the Saudi Arabia and Abu Dhabi Grands Prix both moving a week later (December 5 and December 12, respectively); and the race marked as TBC on the calendar will be announced in due course and will take place on the new date of May 2.

These revisions are subject to FIA World Motor Sport Council approval. F1 president and CEO Stefano Do-

menicali said: "It has been a busy start to the year at Formula 1 and we are pleased to confirm that the number of races planned for the season remains unchanged.

"The global pandemic has not yet allowed life to return to normal, but we showed in 2020 that we can race safely as the first international sport to return and we have the experience and plans in place to deliver on our season.

F1 pre-season test dates in Bahrain set

Following the announcement of the revised F1 calendar for 2021, it was reported yesterday that the dates for the pre-season F1 tests at Bahrain International Circuit (BIC), which has replaced the originally planned venue of Barcelona, will take place March 12 to 14.

This is according to leading motor racing website autosport.com, which stated that F1, the FIA and the F1 teams have all formally agreed to do the single three-day test session in preparation for the new season.

"It is great news that we have already been able to agree a rescheduled date for the Australian Grand Prix in November and are continuing to work with our Chinese colleagues to find a solution to race there in 2021 if something changes.

"We are very excited to announce that Imola will return for the 2021 season and know our fans will be looking forward to the return of Formula 1 after the winter break and our revised season opener in Bahrain.

"Obviously, the virus situation remains fluid, but we have the experience from last season with all our partners and promoters to adapt accordingly and safely in 2021."

"In the interest of cost saving, testing has been restricted to just three days in 2021, which means one and a half days of running for each driver," the report added.

Bahrain has hosted pre-season F1 testing in the past, as well as in-season testing.

The F1 sessions will not be the only testing action at BIC in March, as the FIA Formula 2 Championship will also be holding its pre-season tests March 9 to 11.

F2 will be holding the first round of its 2021 season in support of the Bahrain Grand Prix.

Bahrain confirm plans to play in Asian volleyball championship

The Bahrain Volleyball Association (BVA) have confirmed their intentions to participate in this year's Asian Men's Volleyball Championship, to be held in Japan this September 12 to 19.

The BVA announced yesterday that they have submitted their application for the senior men's national team to the Asian Volleyball Confederation (AVC), and must now await the total number of entrants.

According to tournament regulations, only 16 nations will be able to take part. Eleven countries have already qualified, including hosts Japan, and 10 teams based on the rankings of the previous Asian championship held in 2019, namely Iran, Australia, South Korea, Chinese Taipei, China, Pakistan, India, Qatar, Kazakhstan and Thailand.

The five other slots will go to one team each from the five AVC sub-zones, namely West, East, Central and Southeast Asia, along with Oceania. Based on these, it will be determined if Bahrain will need to play in a qualification tournament or if they will get an automatic berth.

The national team did not participate in the previous Asian championship.
