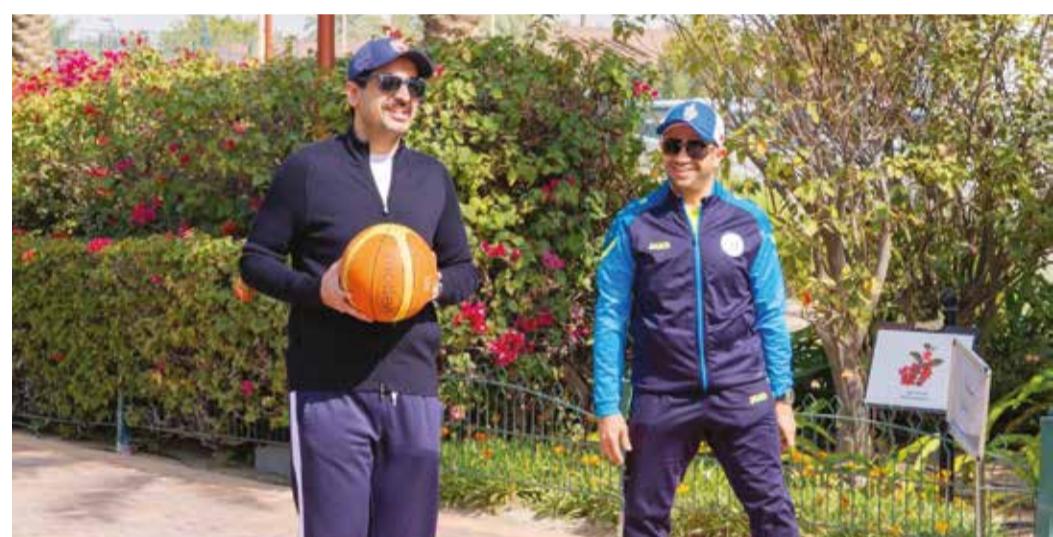


NPRA Celebrates Bahrain National Sports Day
