Muharraq Moves to **Ensure Pool Safety**

Pool safety inspections begin

Violators face legal action

uharraq Governorate has launched a summer-long crackdown on swimming pools that fail to meet health and safety standards, aiming to prevent accidents and protect residents during the peak holiday season.

Brigadier General Jassim Mohammed Al Ghattam, Deputy Governor of Muharraq Governorate, said inspections are now underway through a joint committee comprising officials from relevant ministries and authorities.

The campaign is targeting or unauthorised pools. both licensed and unlicensed pools to ensure full compliance with legal, health and security regulations.


